FIG. 6 is a front elevation of FIG. 1;

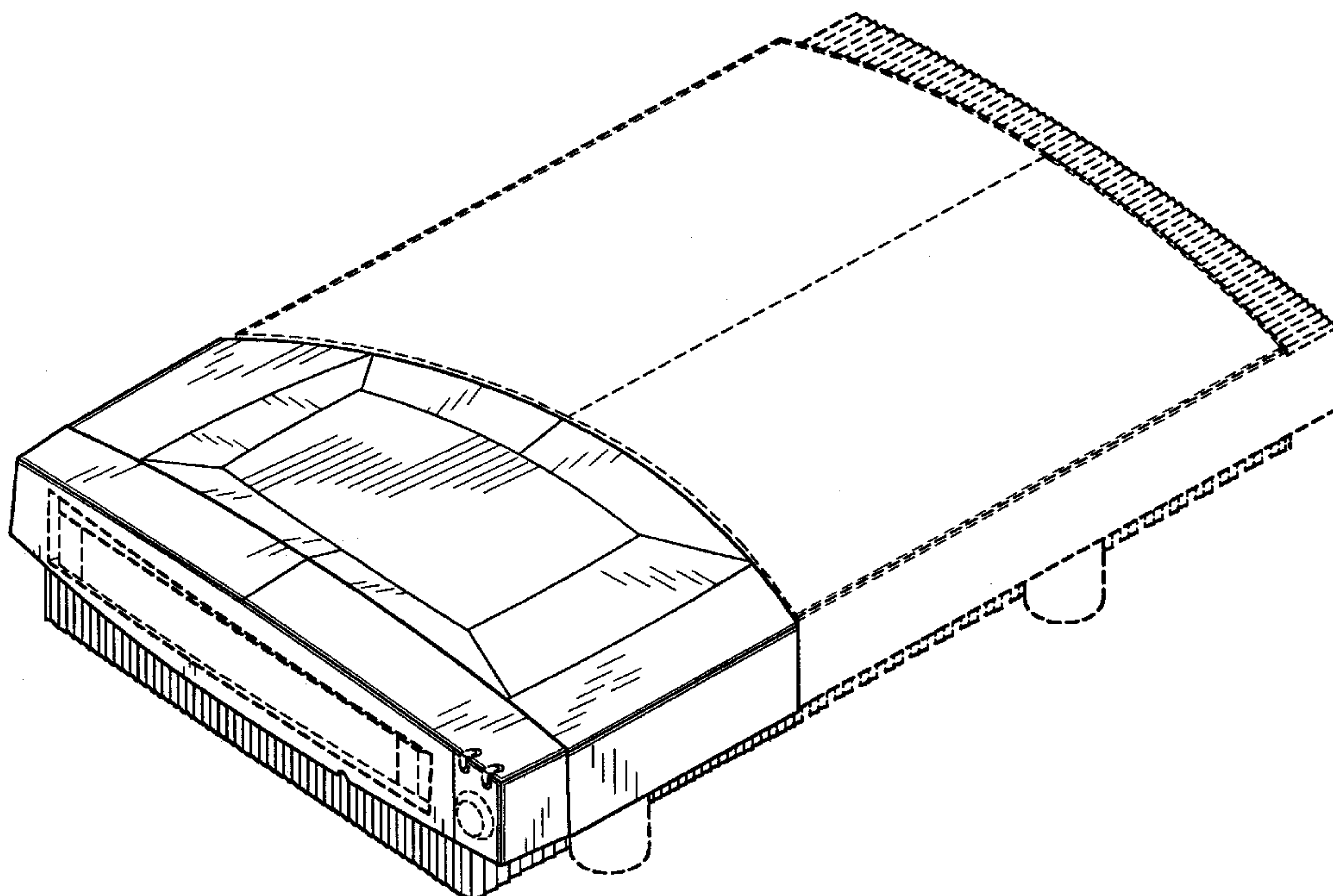
FIG. 7 is a side elevation of FIG. 1;

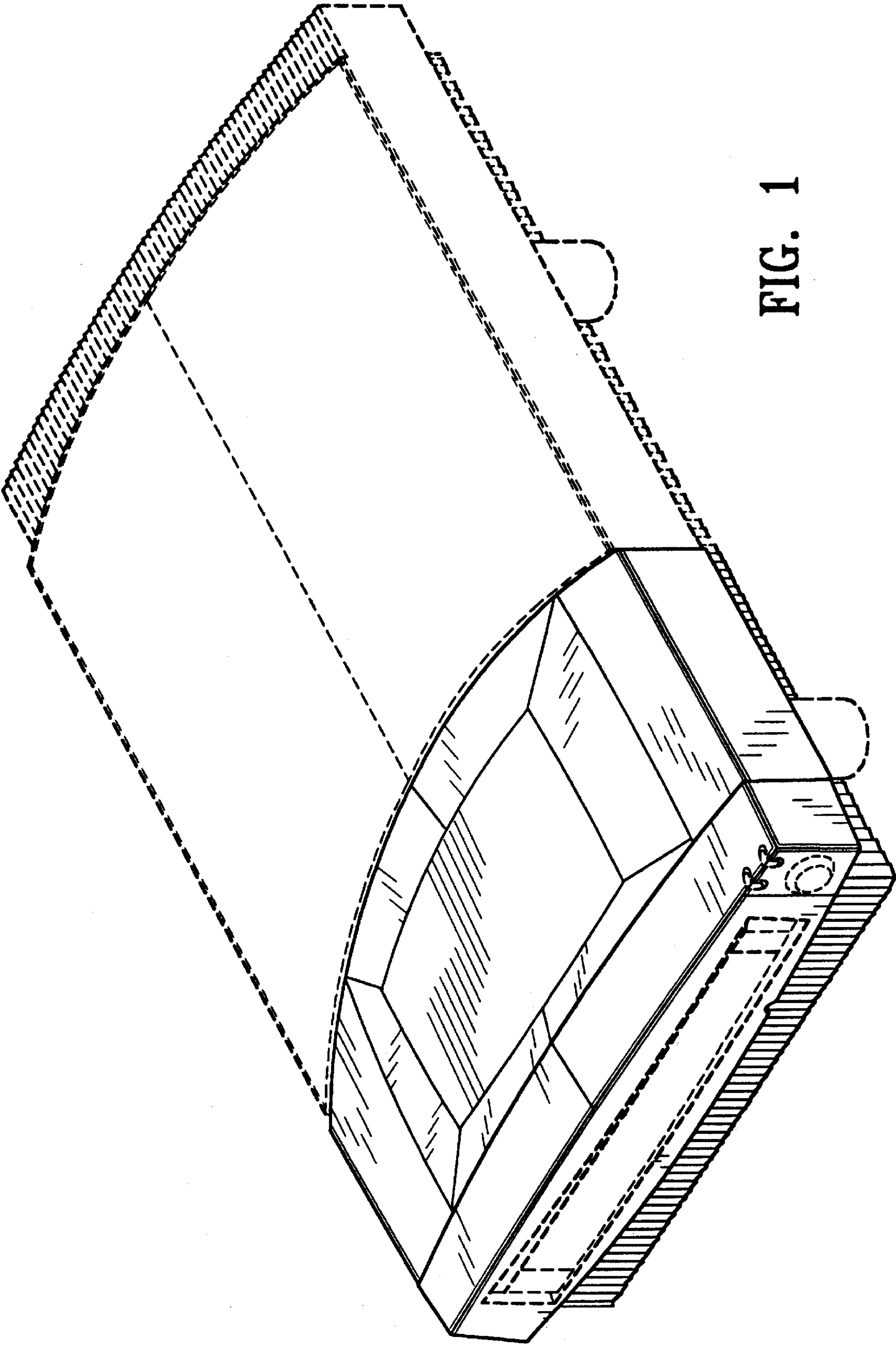

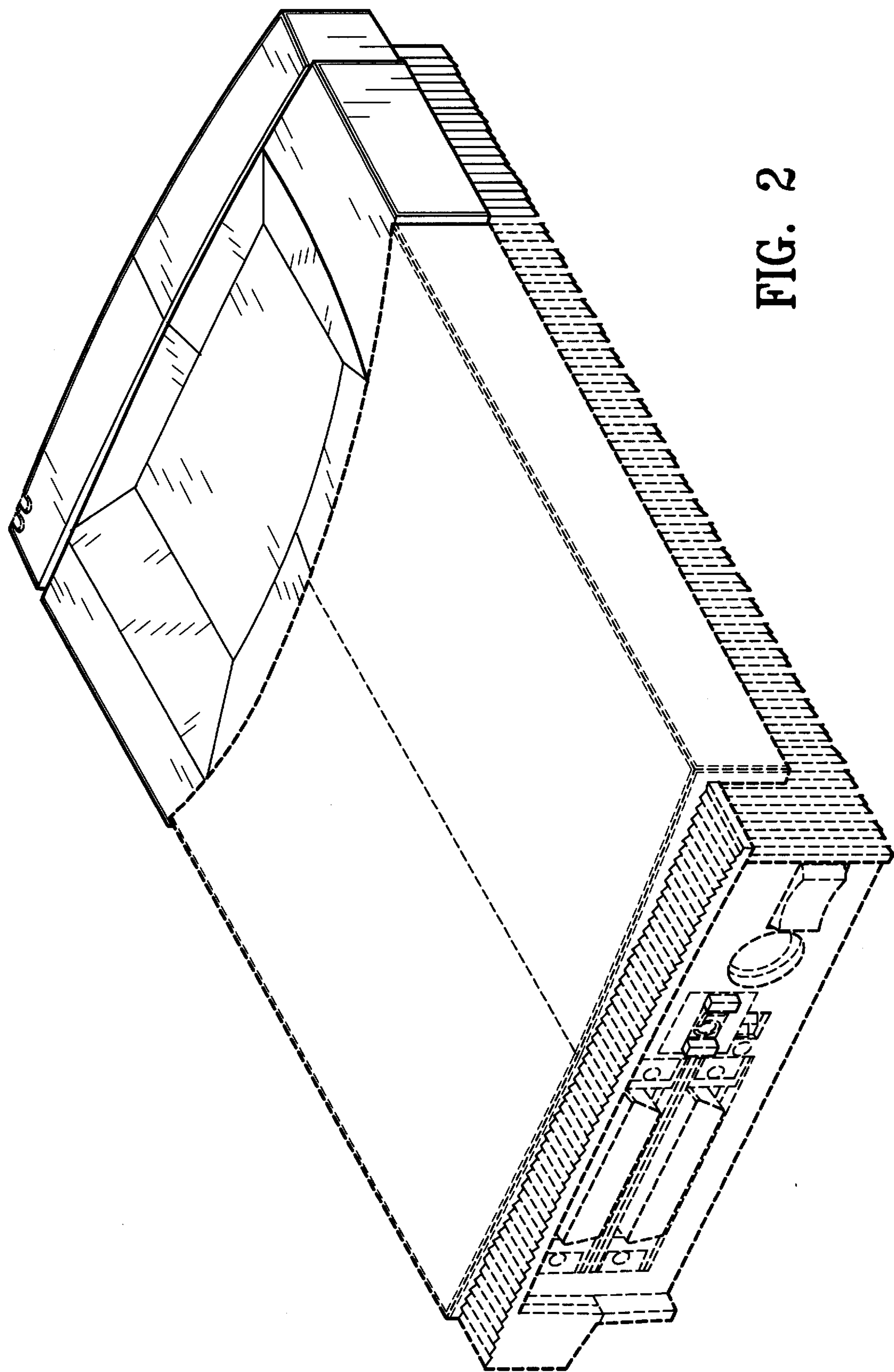

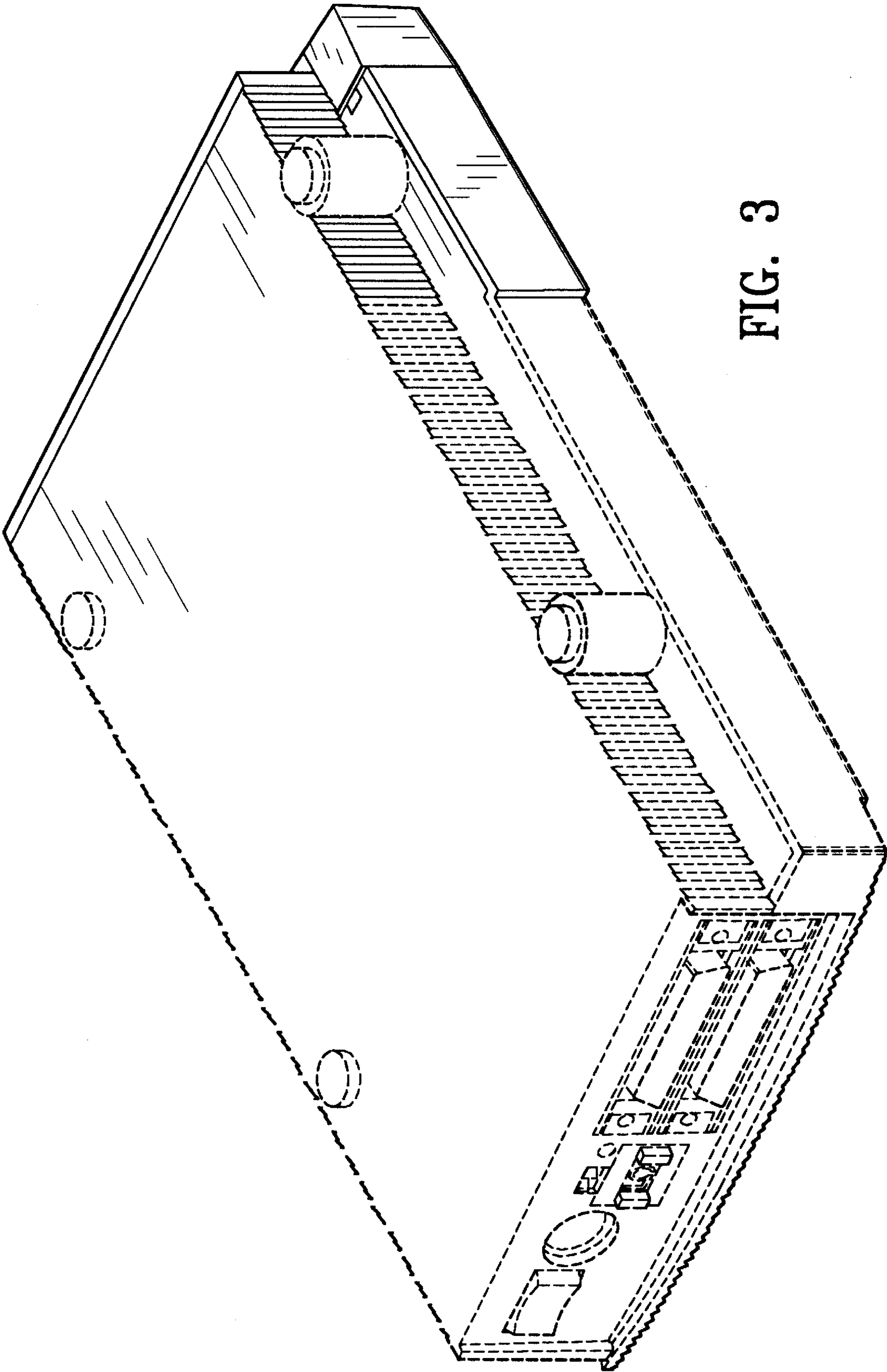

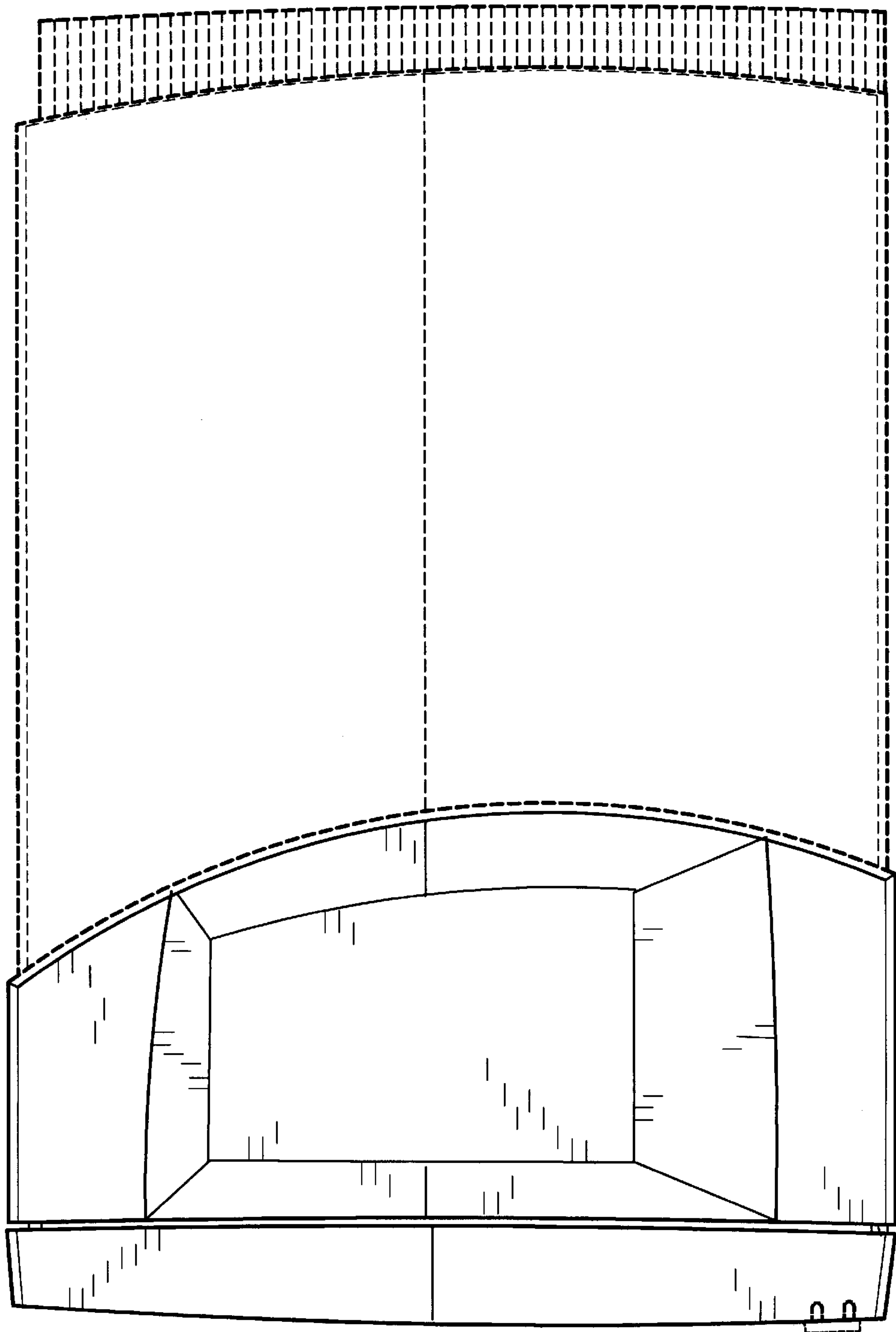
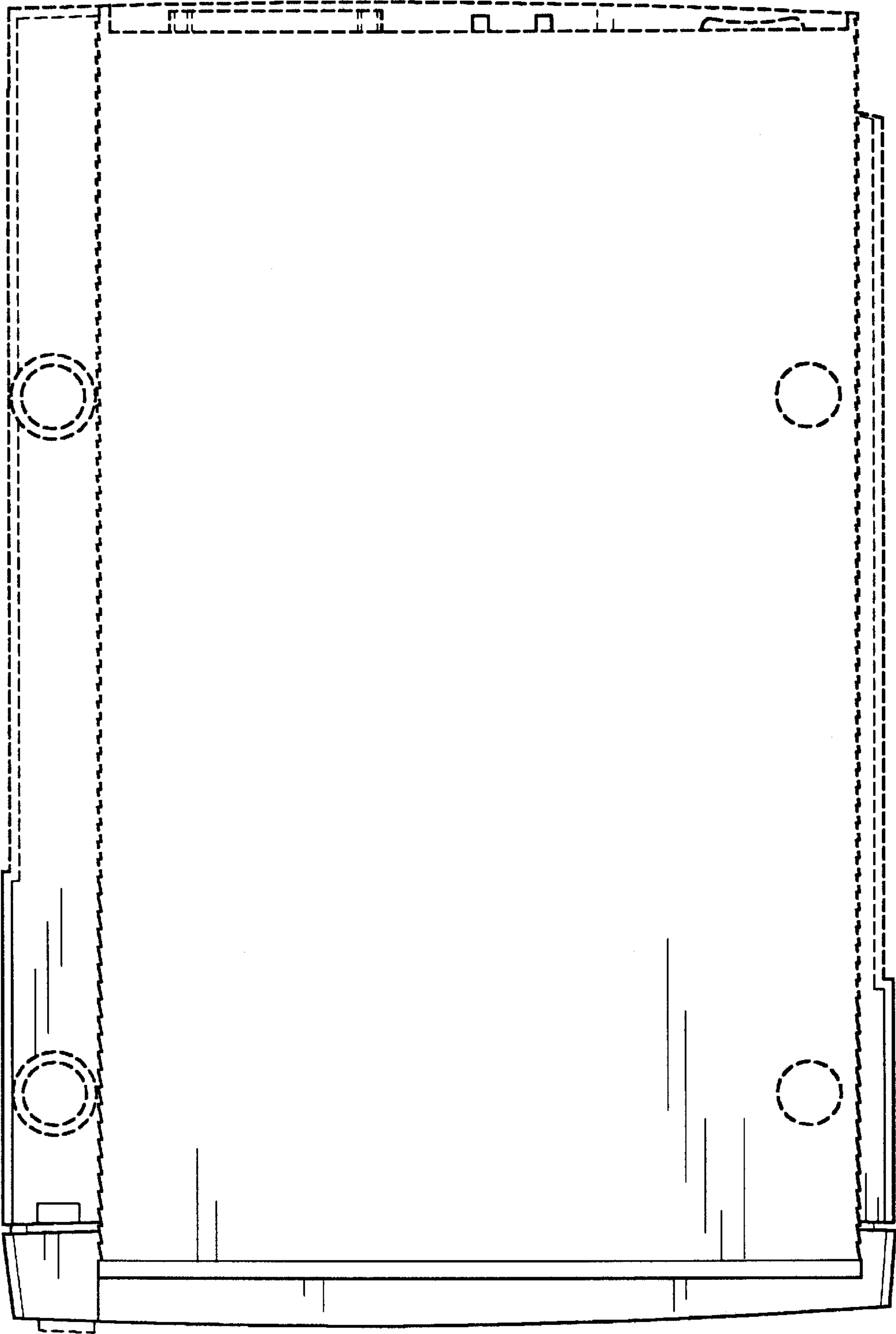

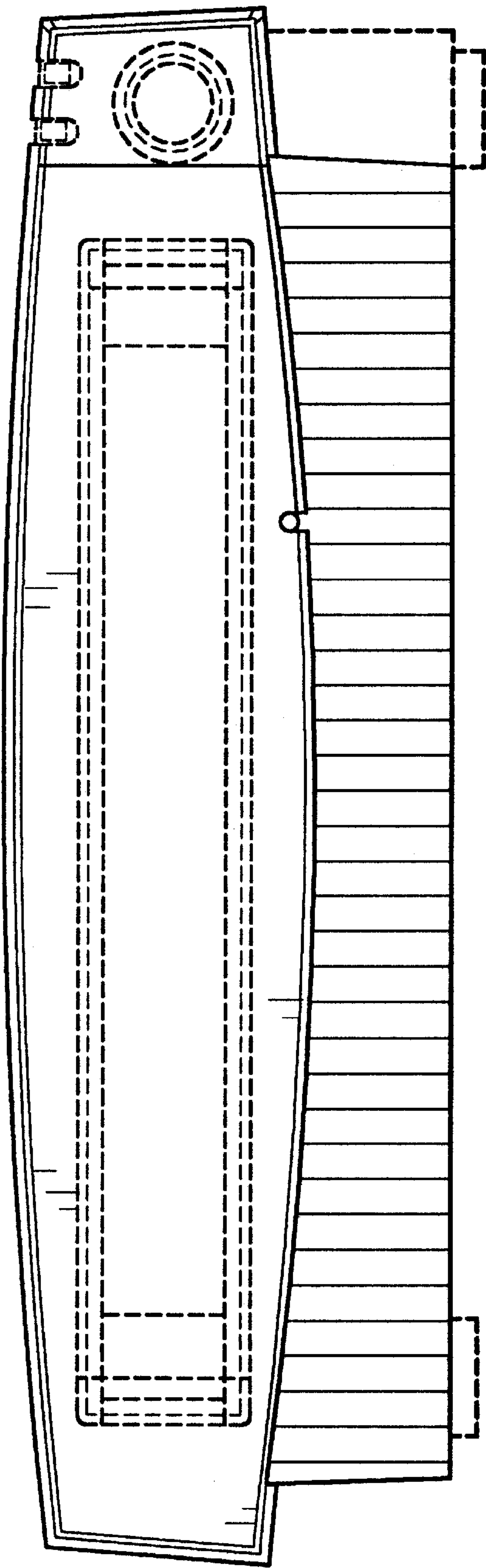

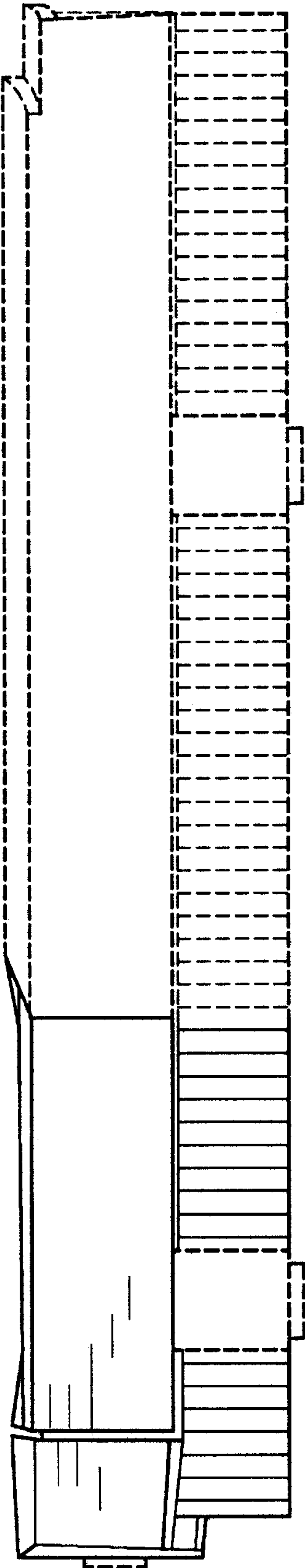

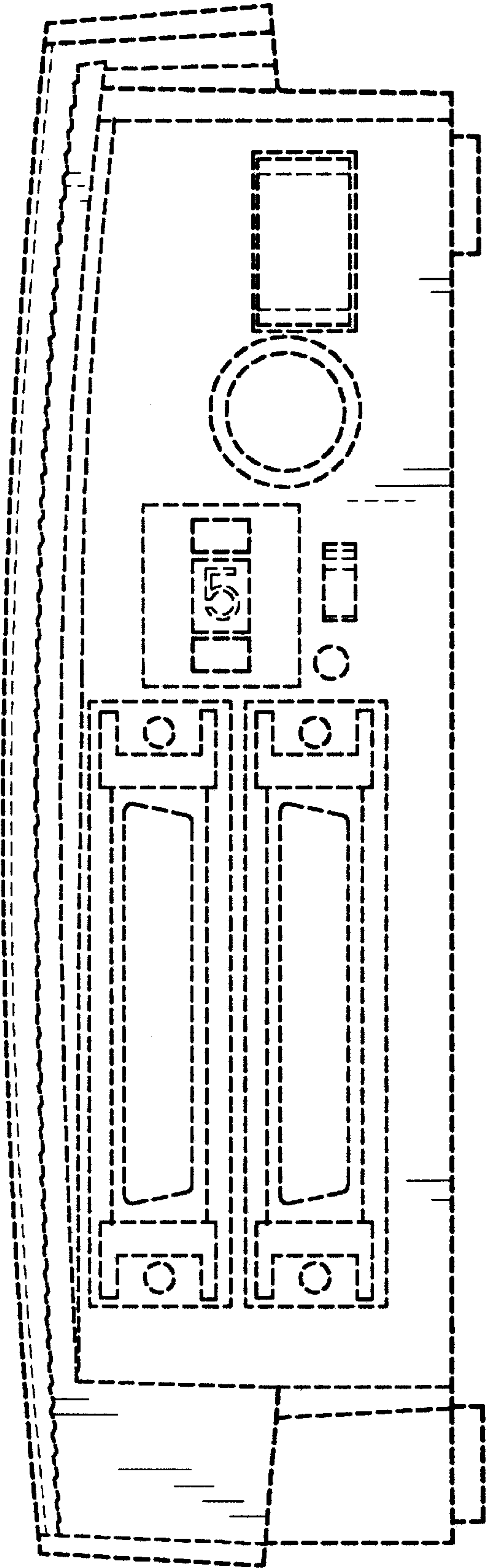

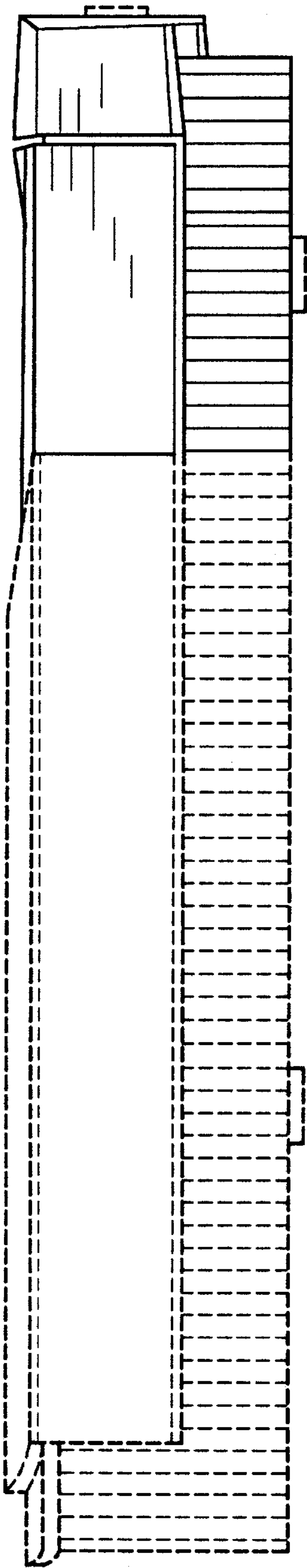
