FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a fishing pole holder, showing our new design; the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;

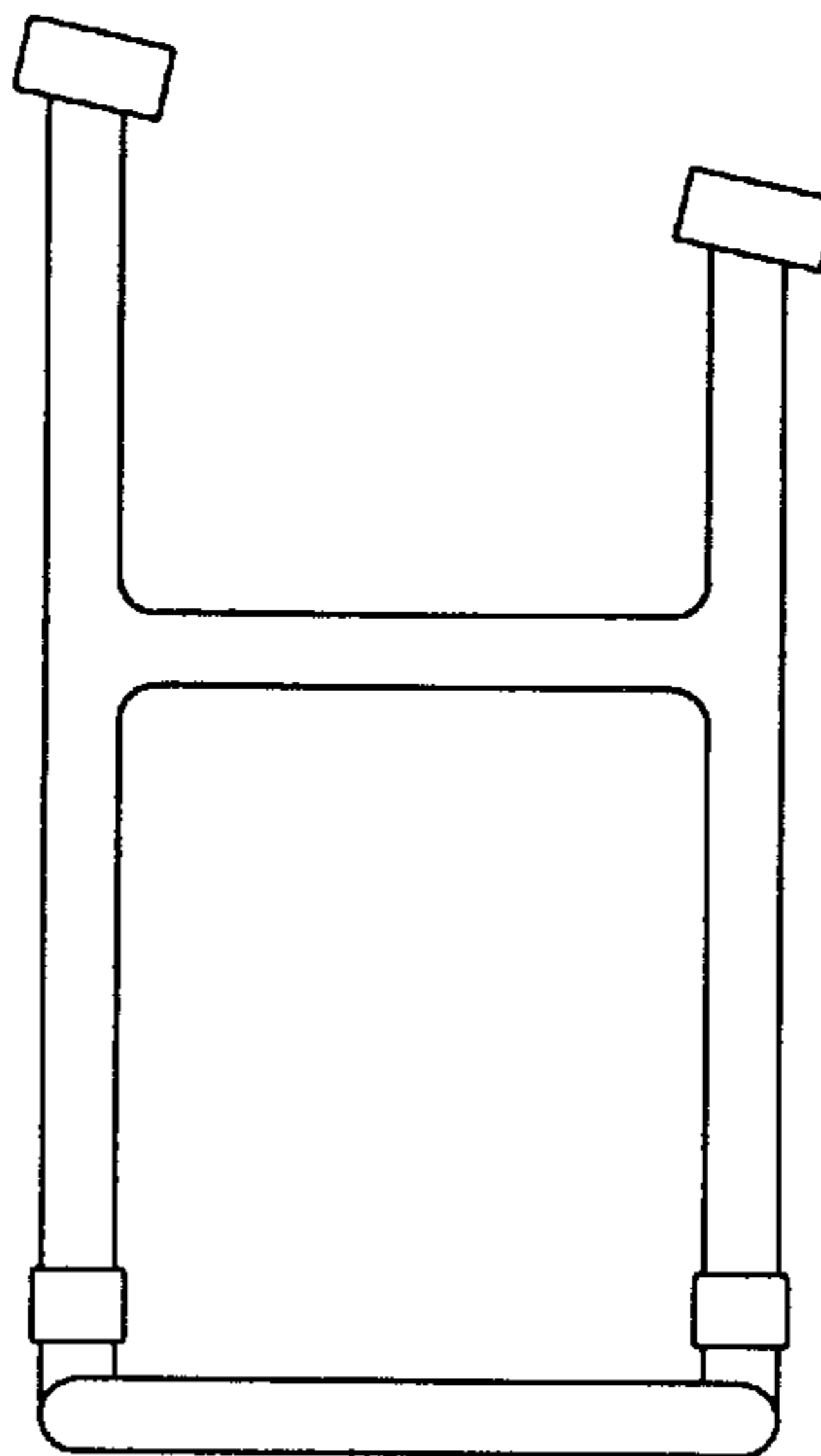
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

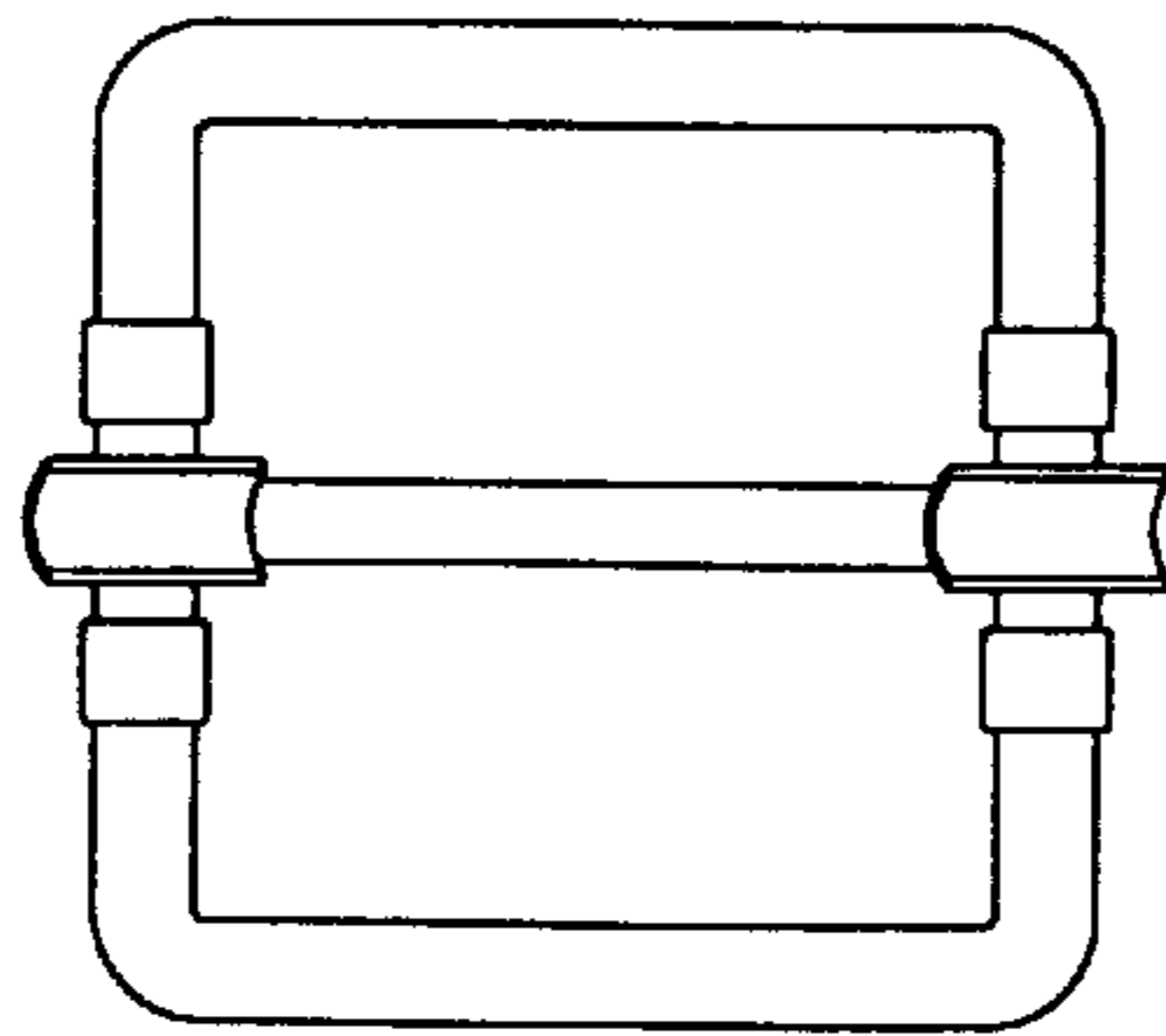

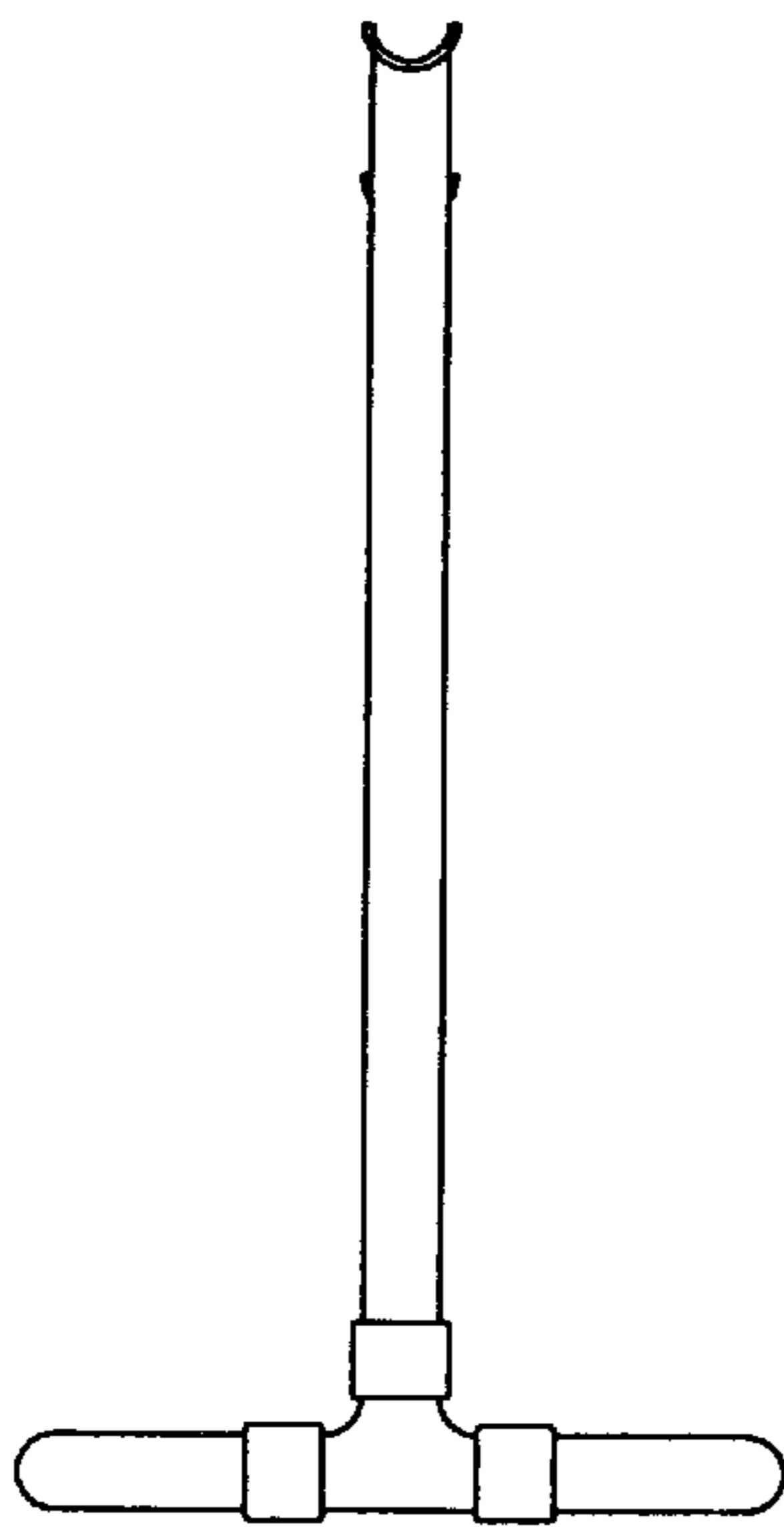

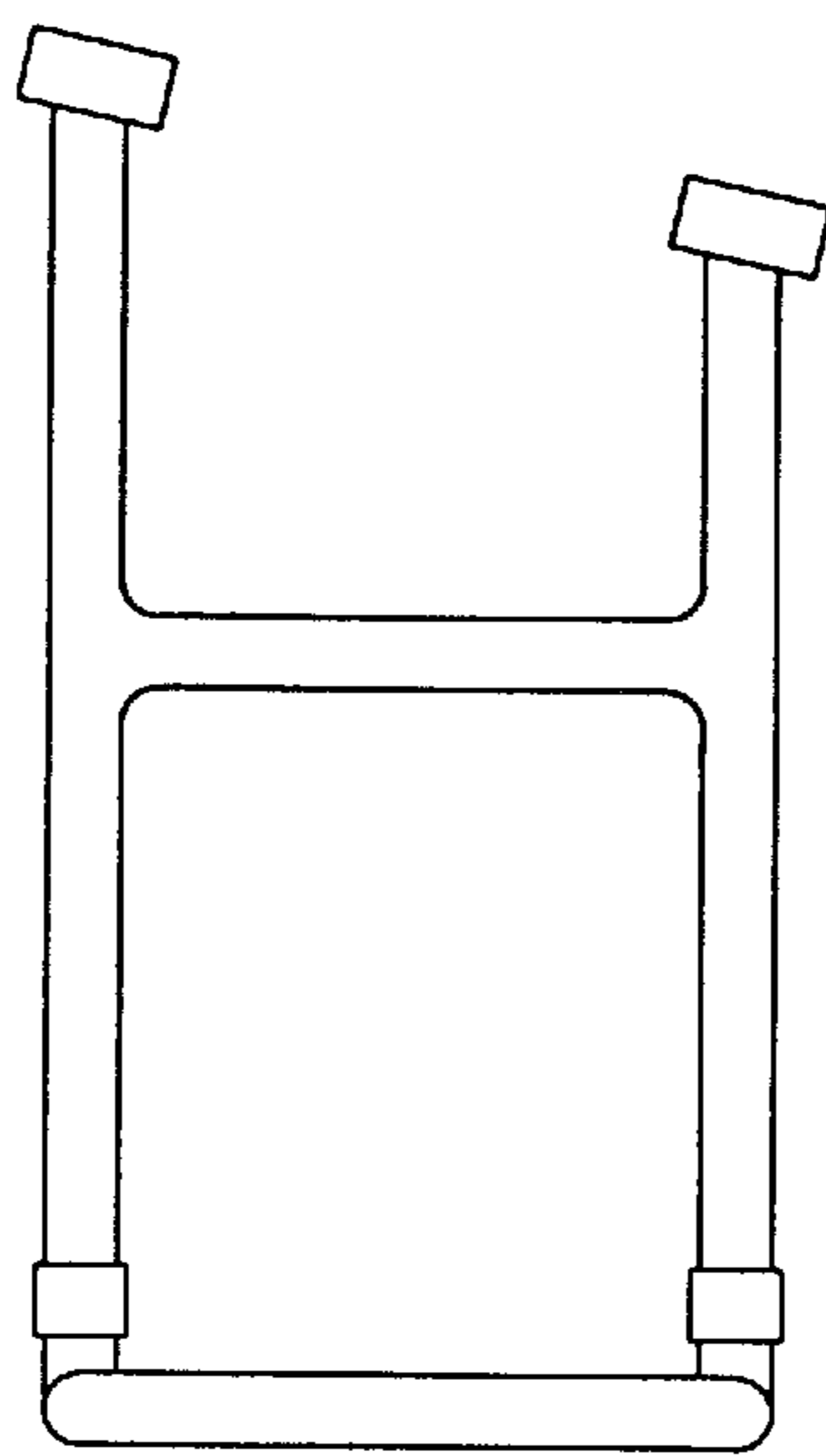

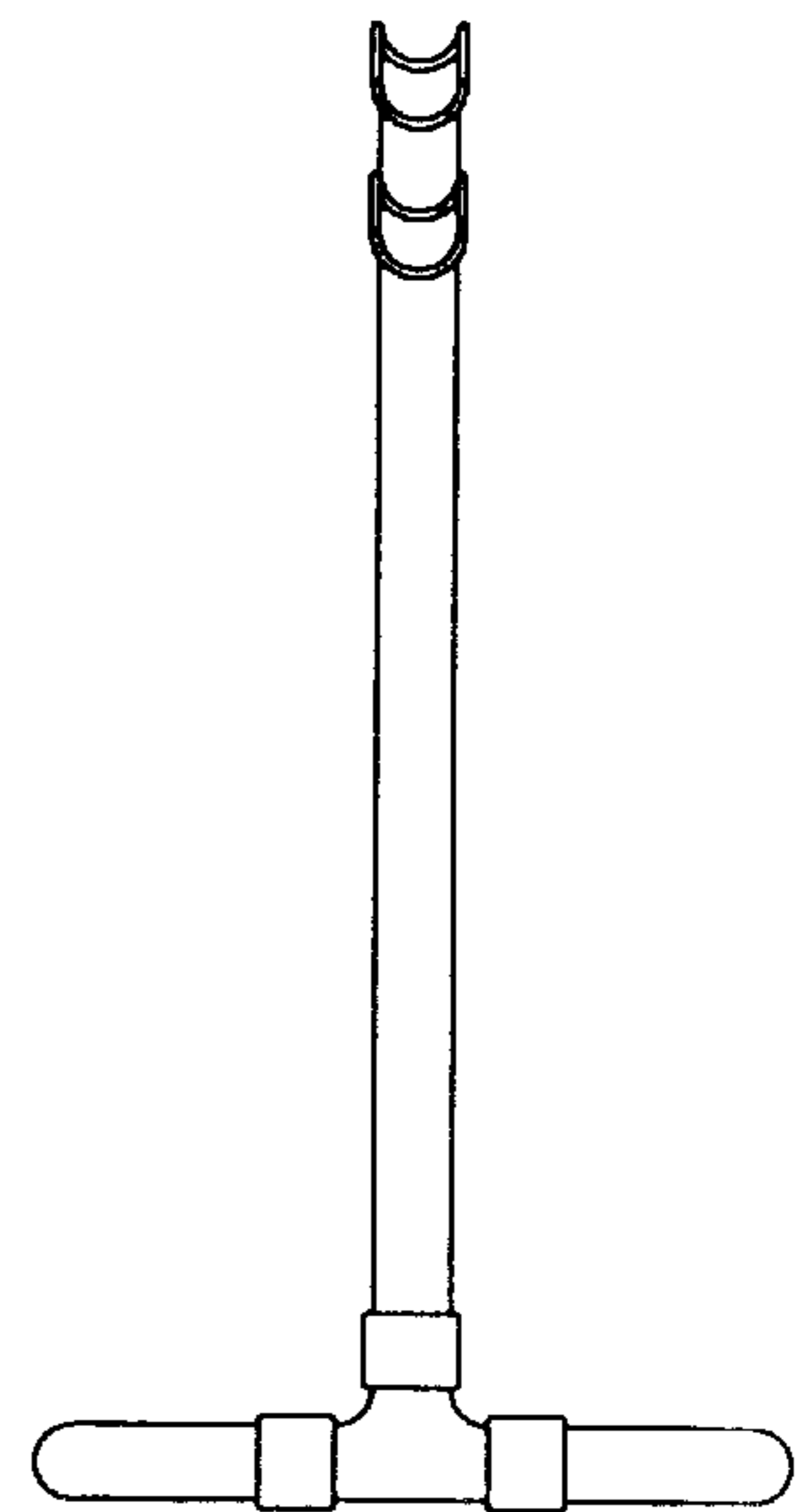

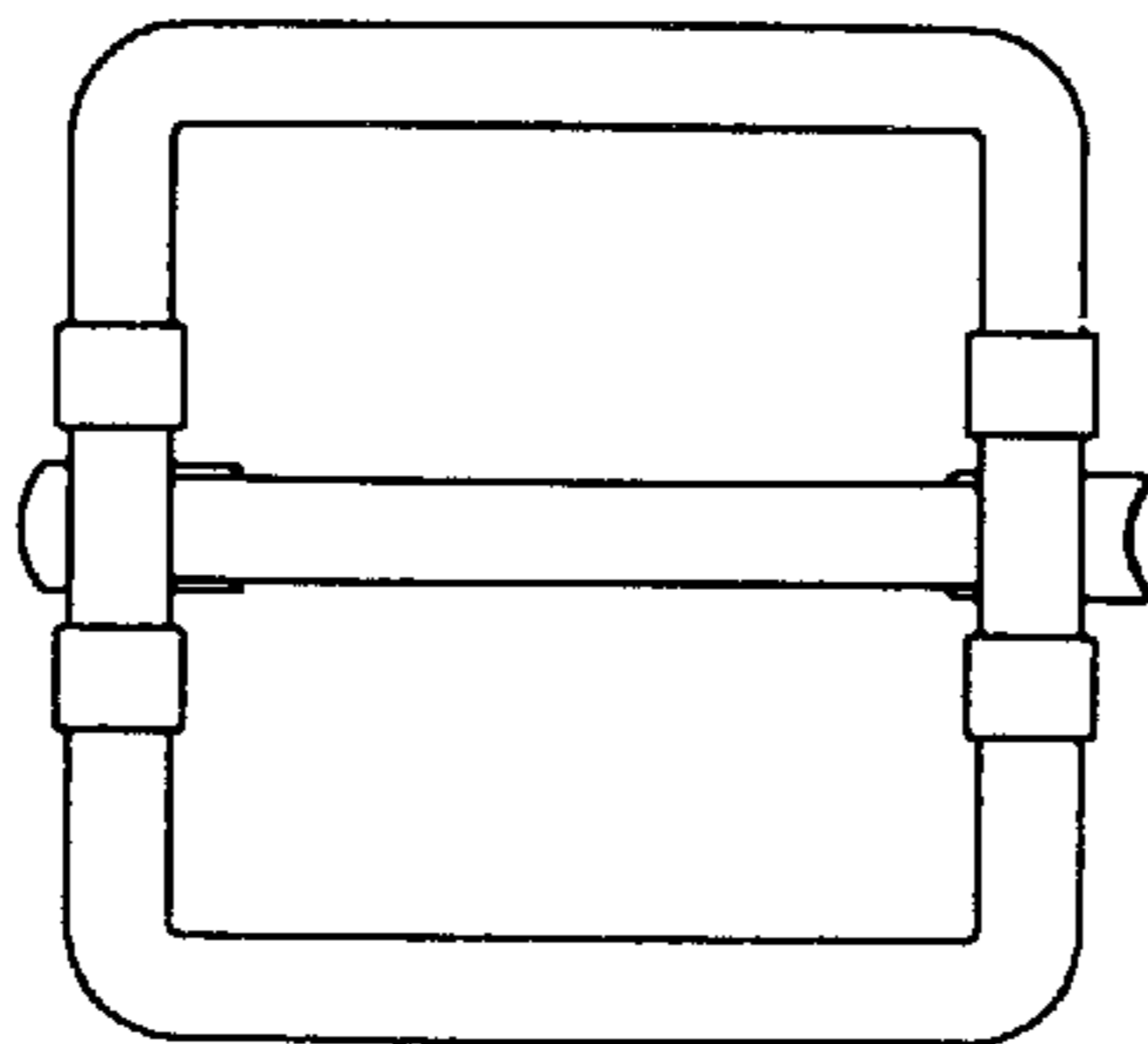
