The ornamental design for a gemstone, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a gemstone showing my design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view;

FIG. 3 is the right or left side view of this embodiment;

FIG. 4 is a perspective view of the bottom, side and left end of the gemstone showing my new design, the opposite side and right end being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view of a gemstone showing a second embodiment of my new design, the top view being like that of FIG. 1;

FIG. 6 is a bottom, right side perspective view of FIG. 5, the opposite side view being identical;

FIG. 7 is a bottom left corner perspective view of FIG. 5;

FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view of a gemstone showing a third embodiment of my new design, the top view being like that of FIG. 1;

FIG. 10 is a bottom left perspective view of FIG. 8, the opposite side being a mirror image;

FIG. 11 is a bottom plan view of a gemstone showing a fourth embodiment of my new design;

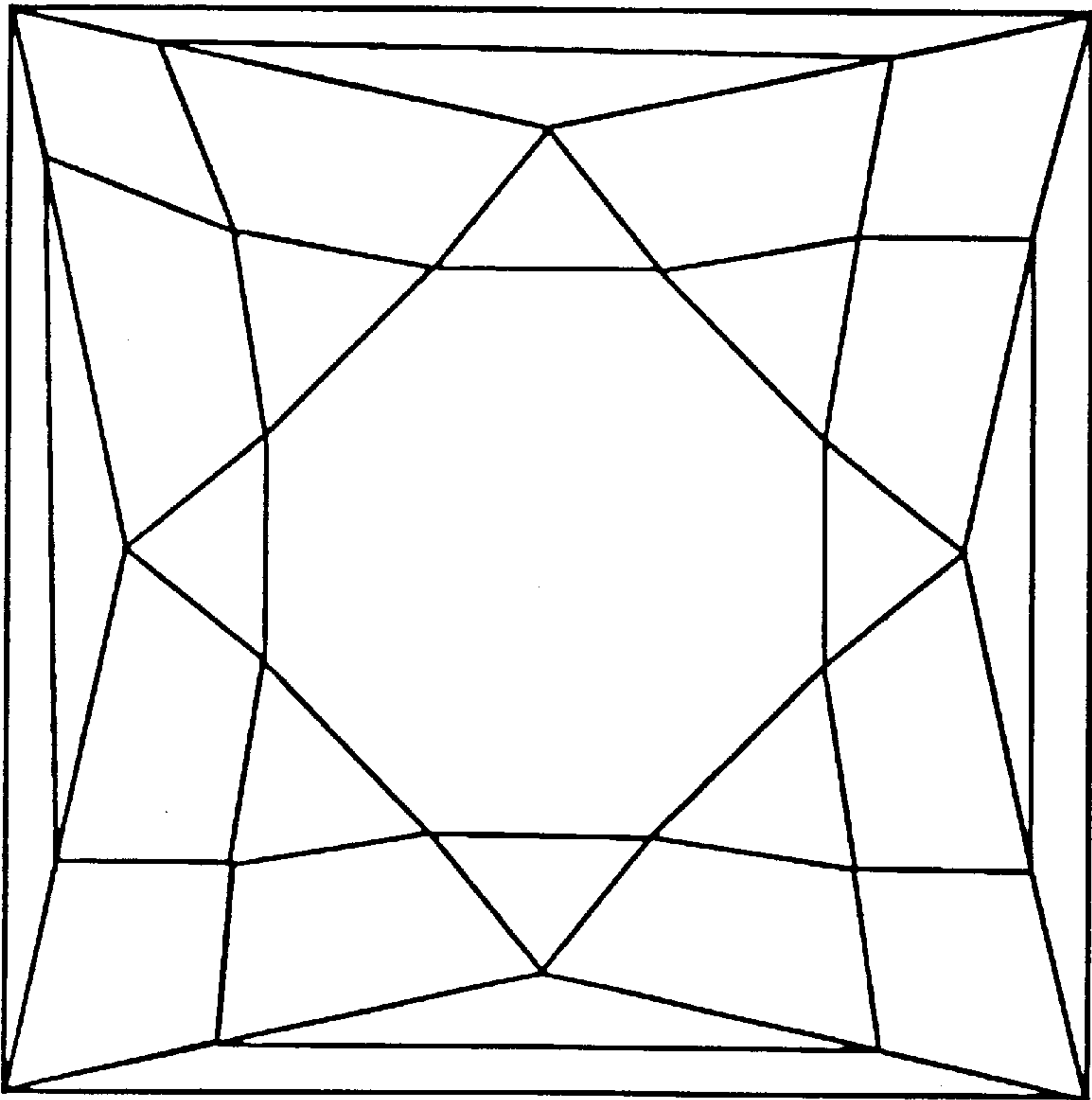
FIG. 12 is a top plan view of FIG. 11;

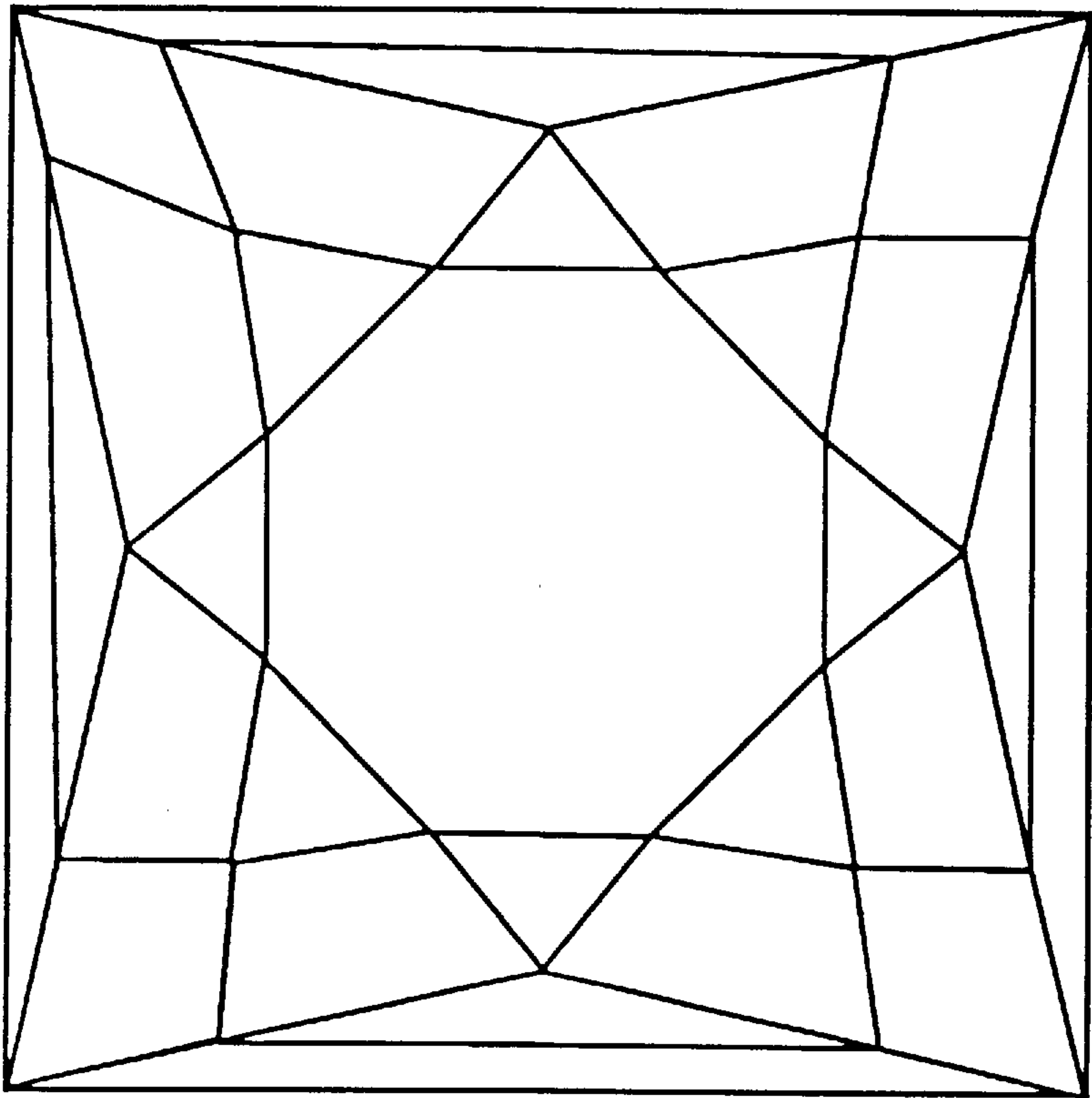

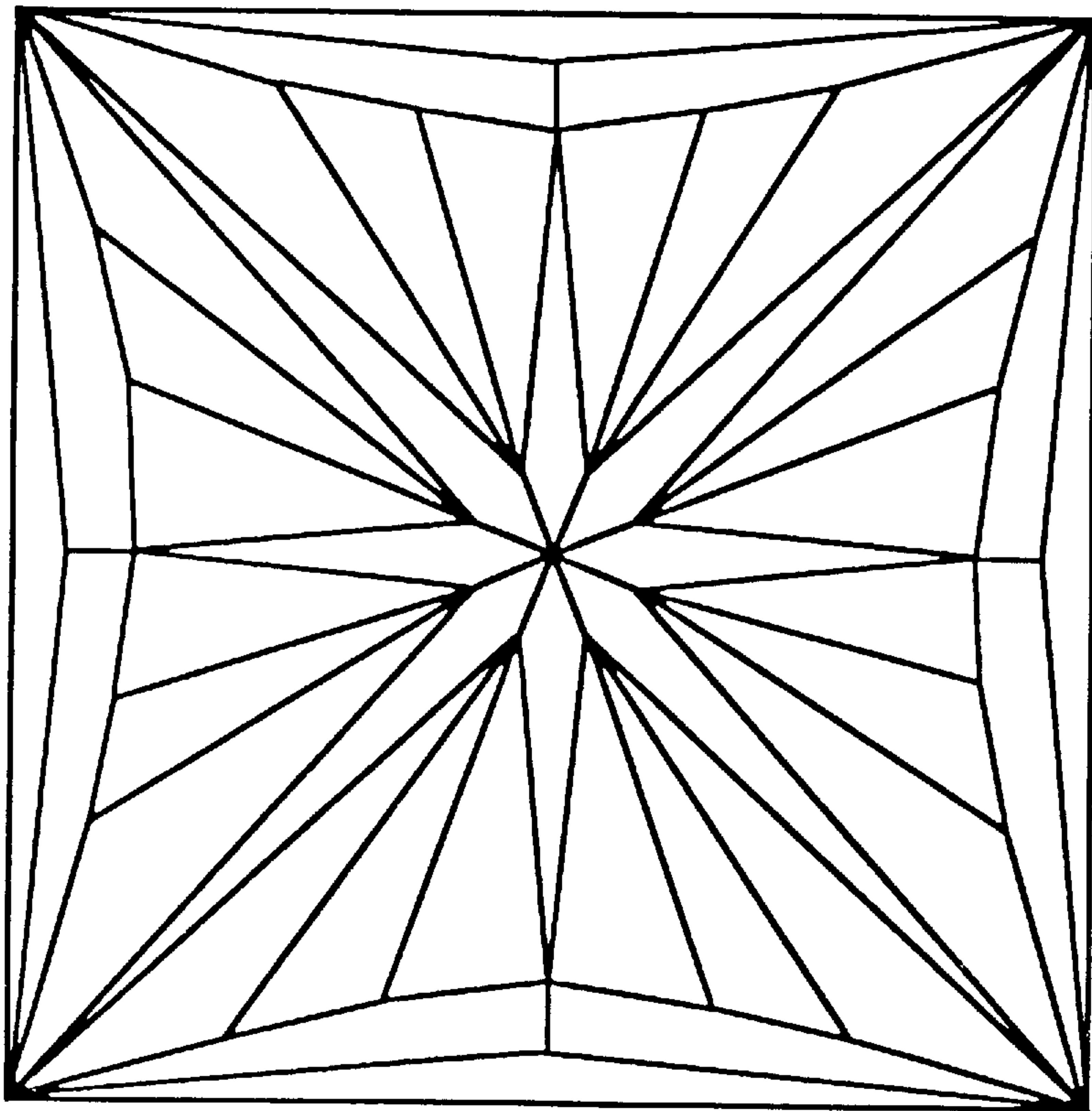

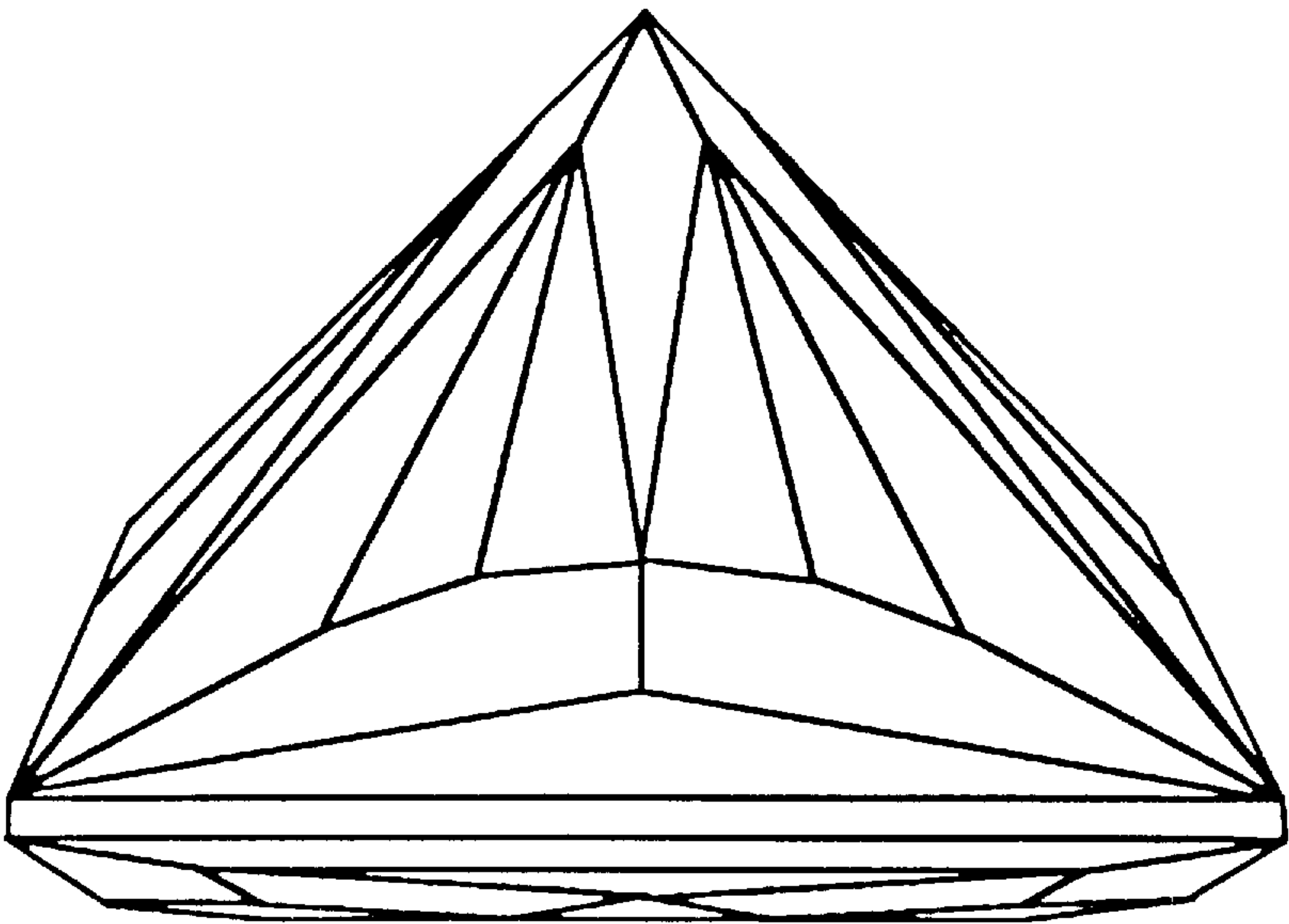

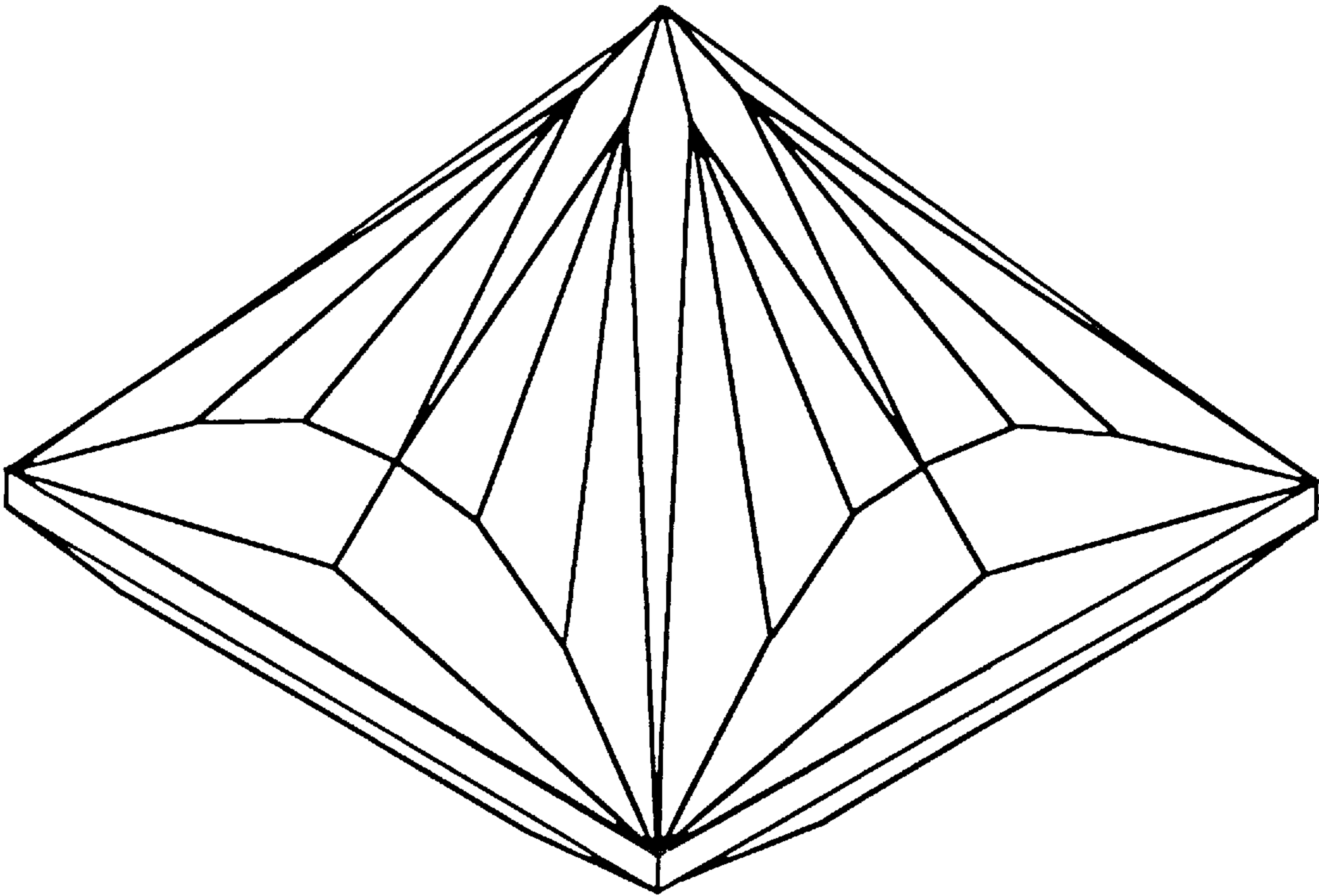

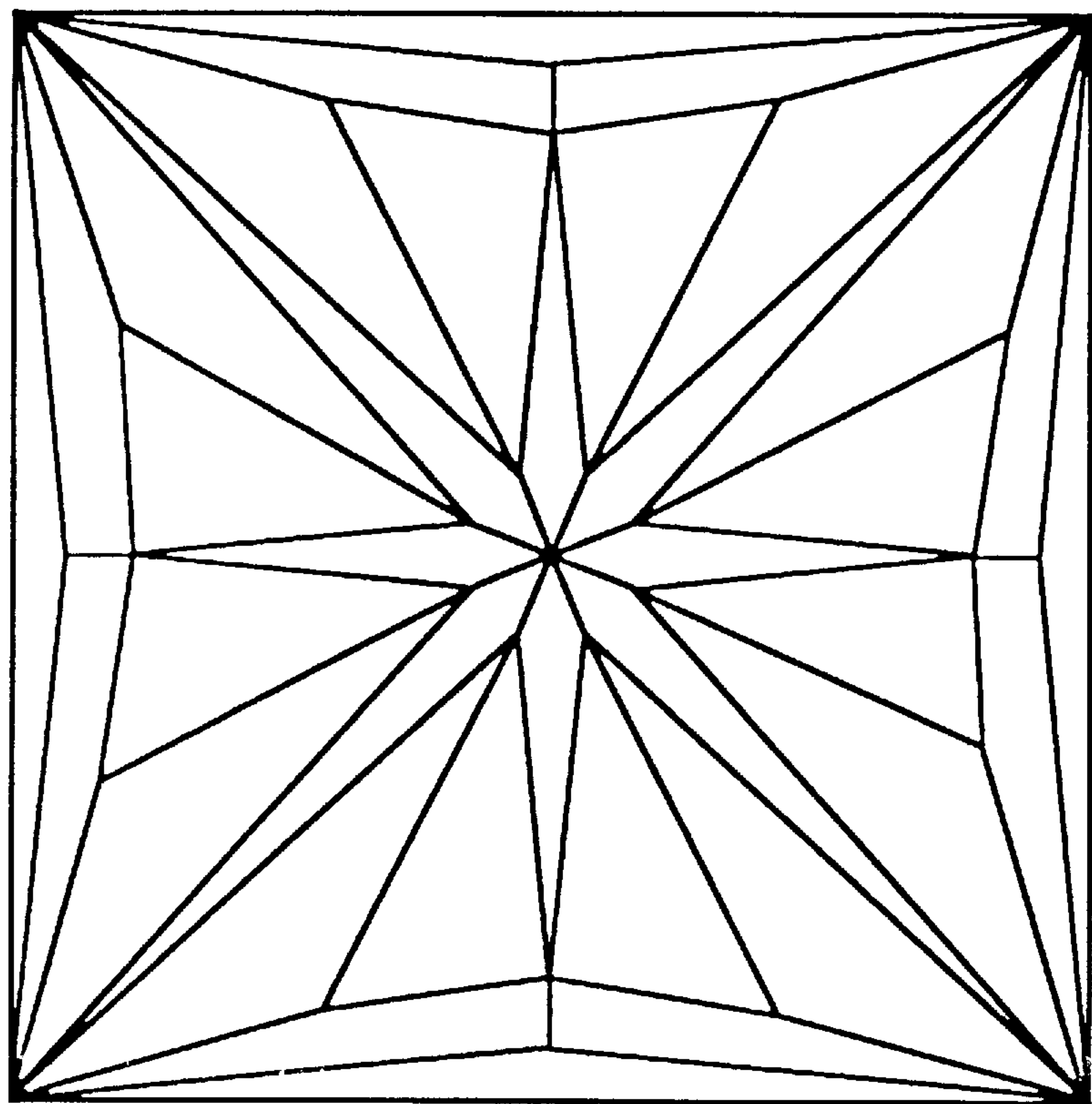

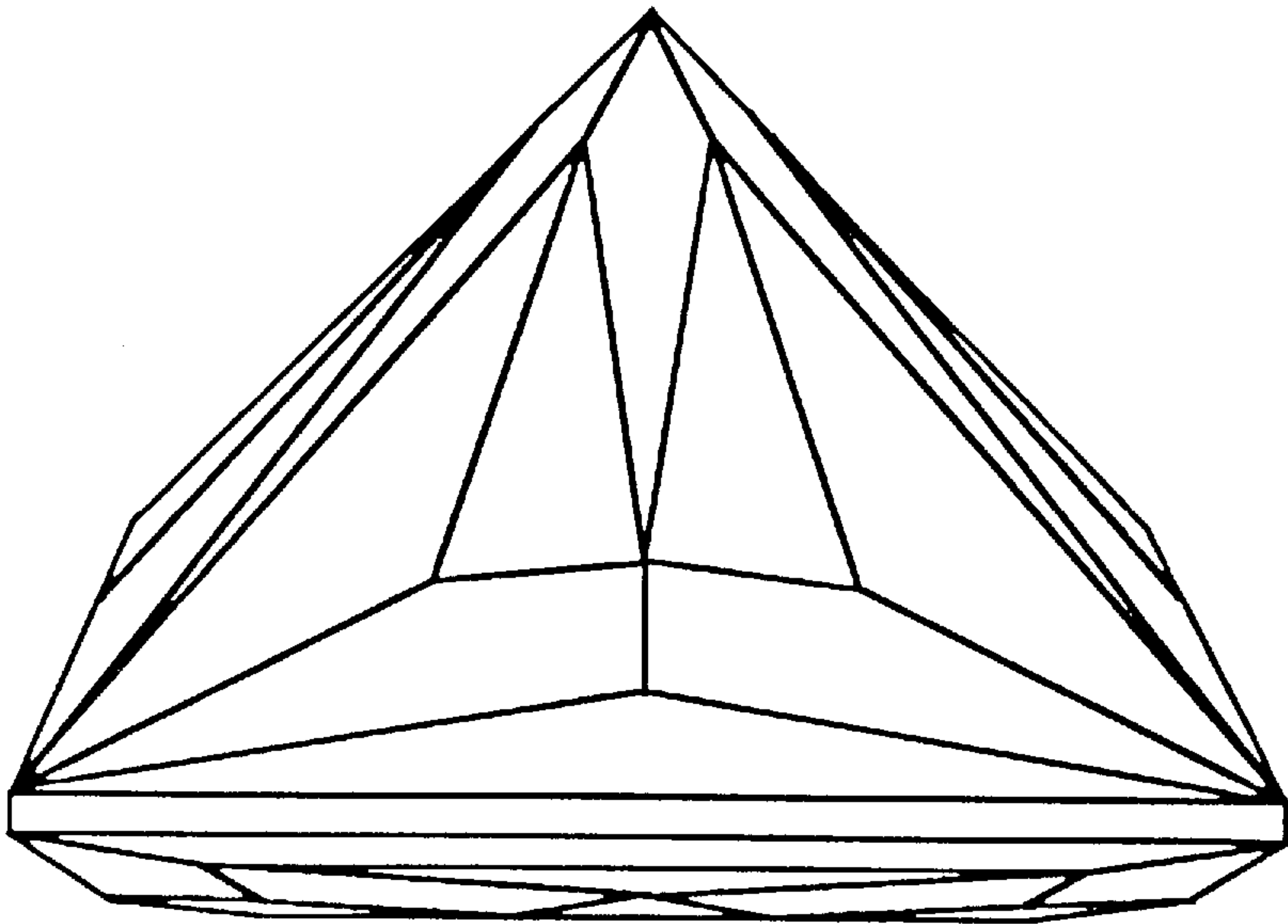

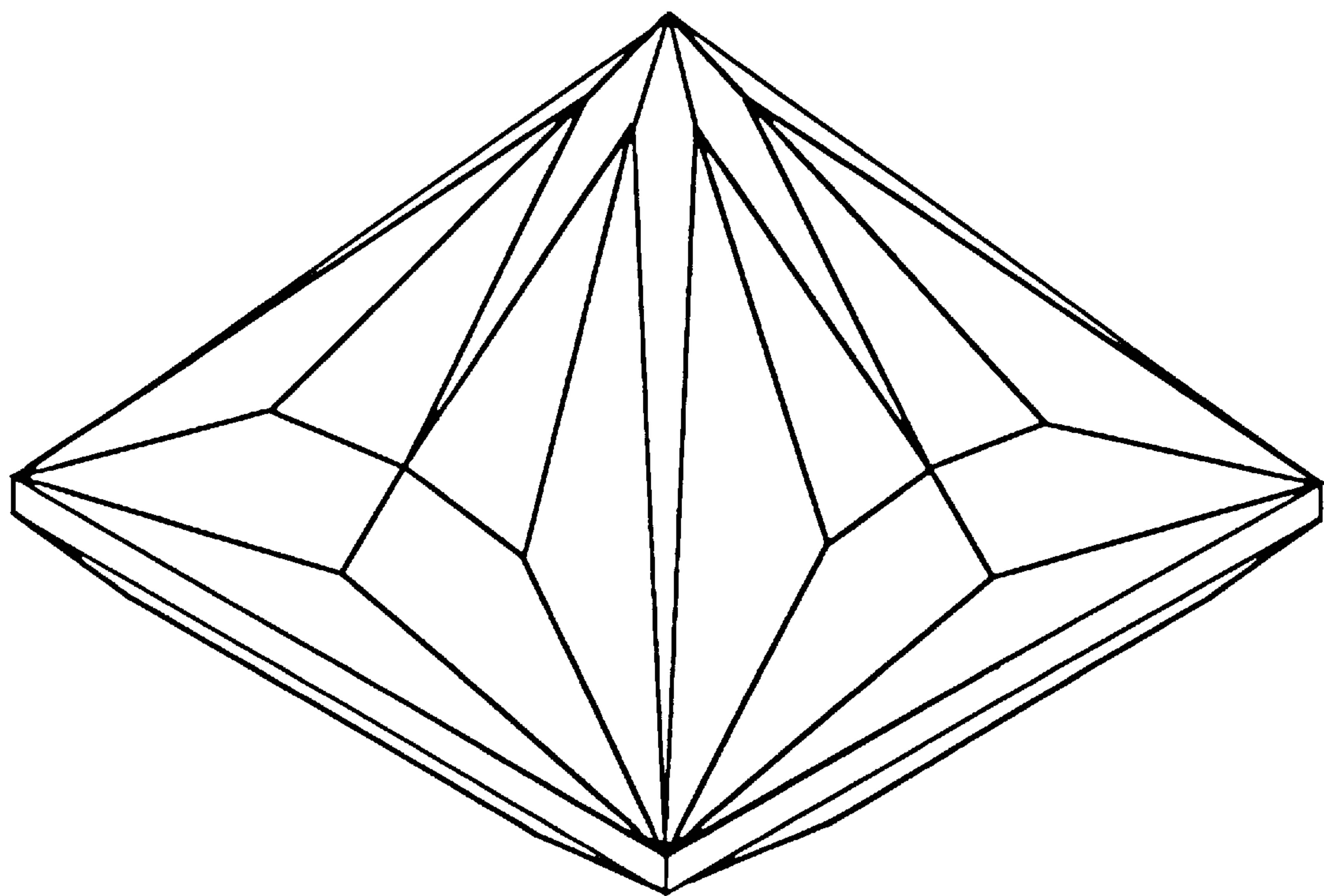

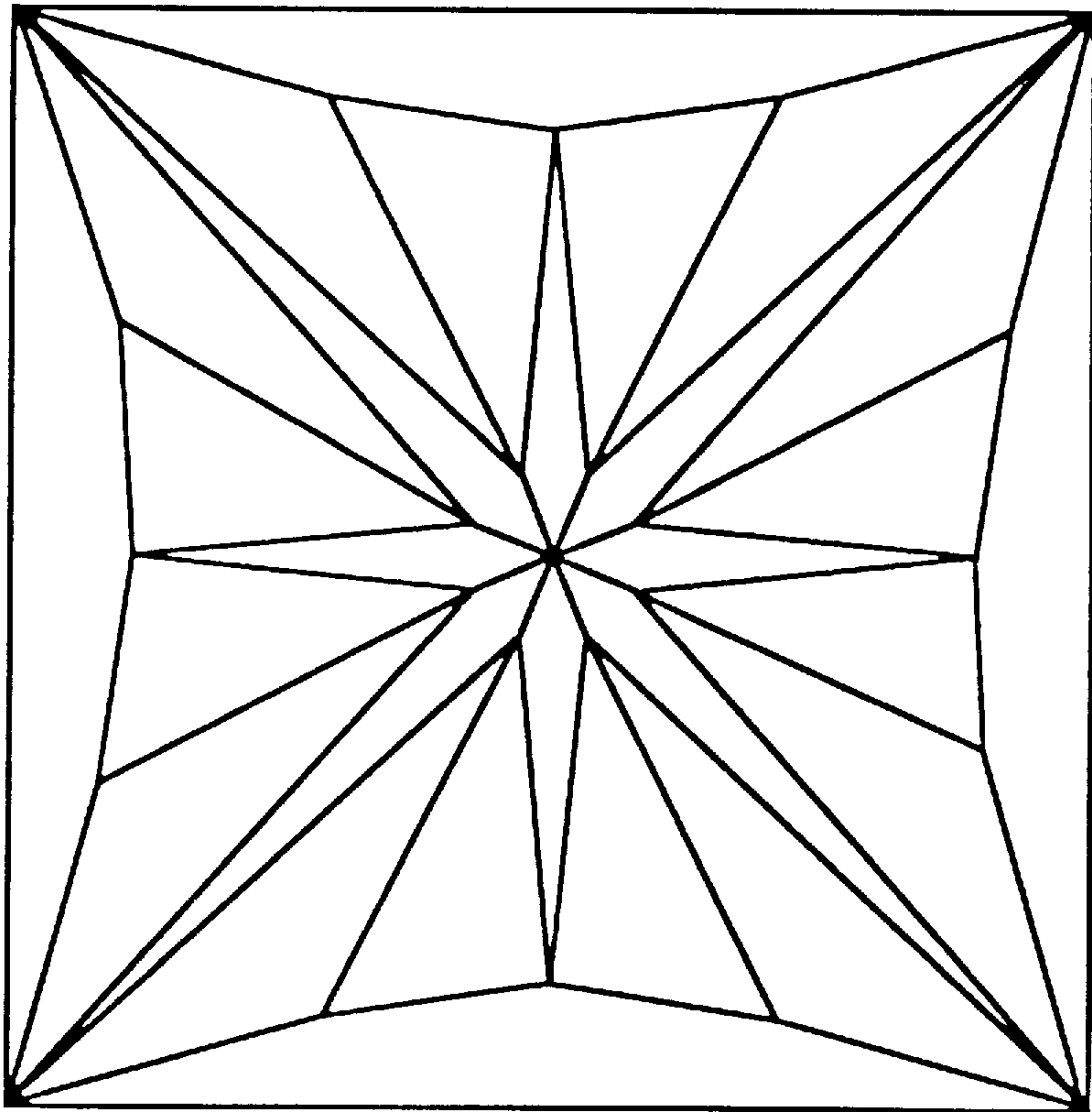

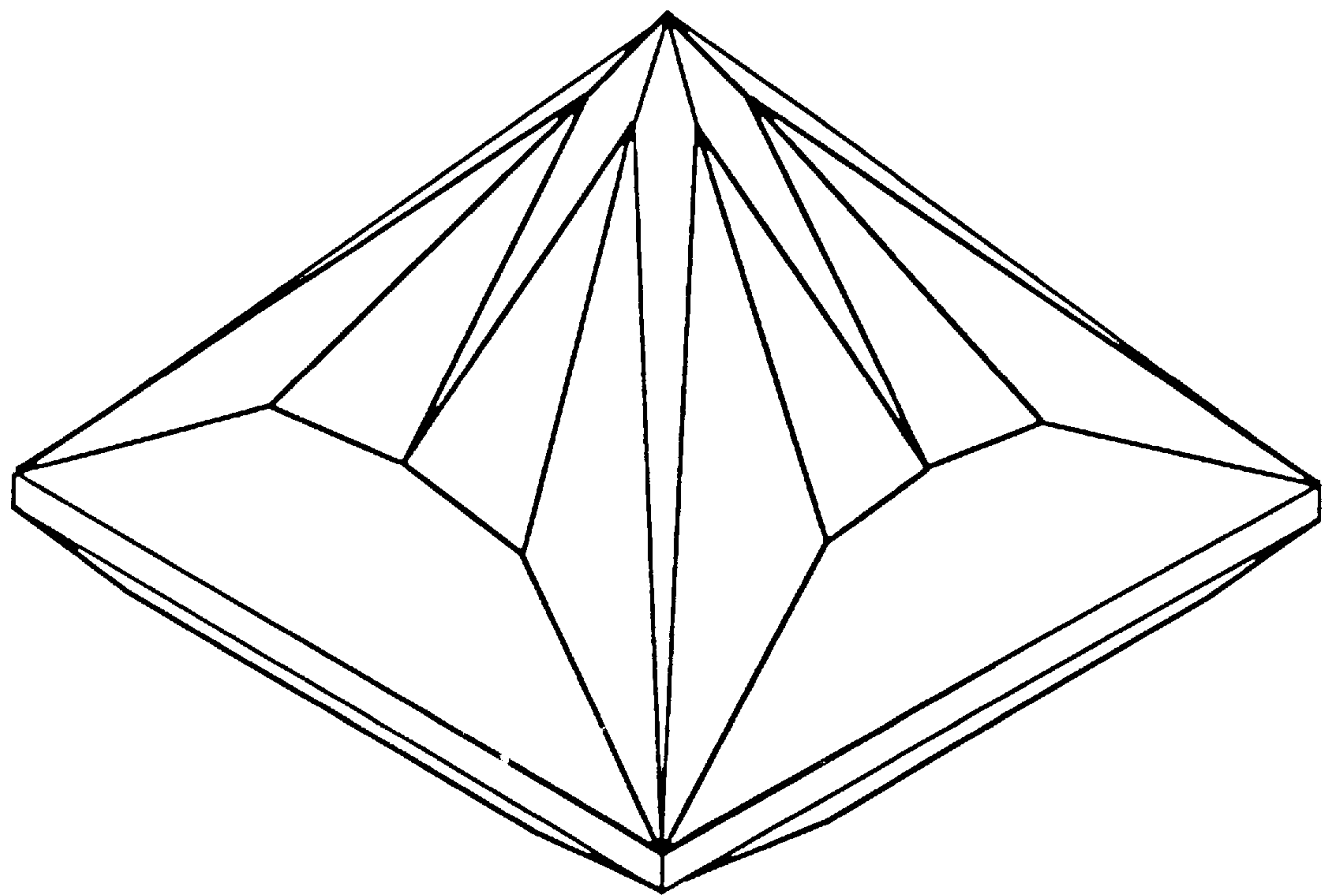

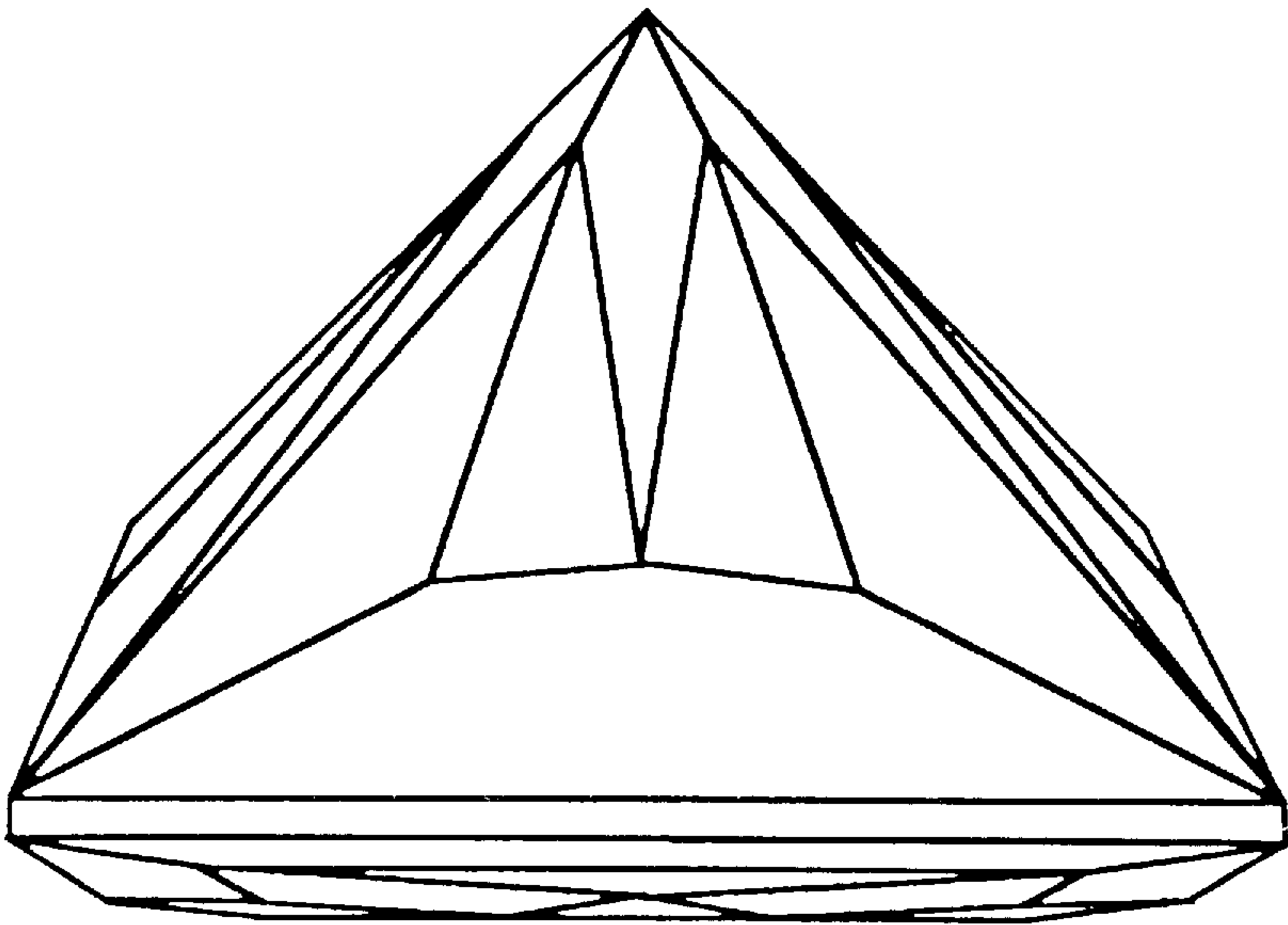

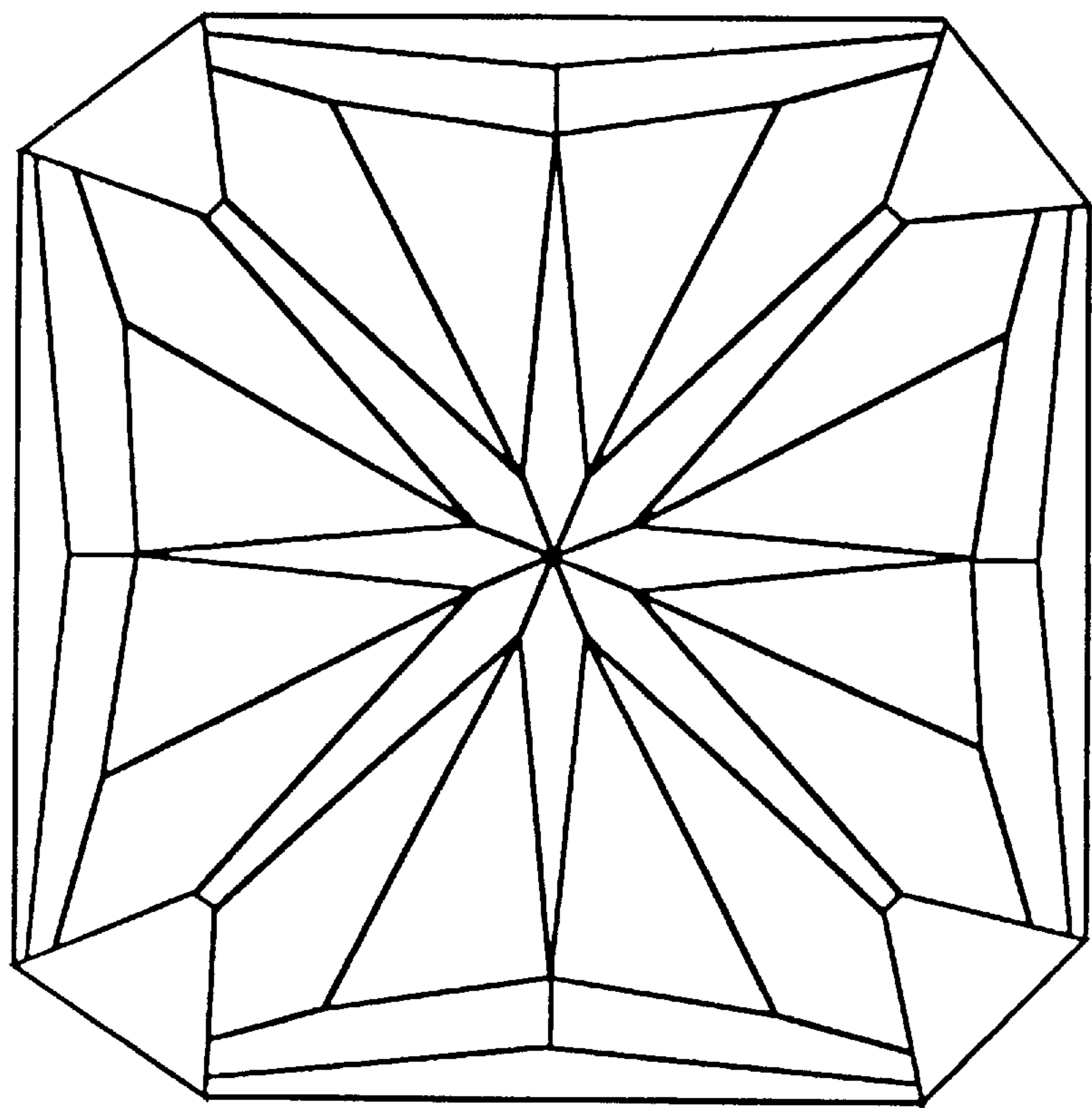

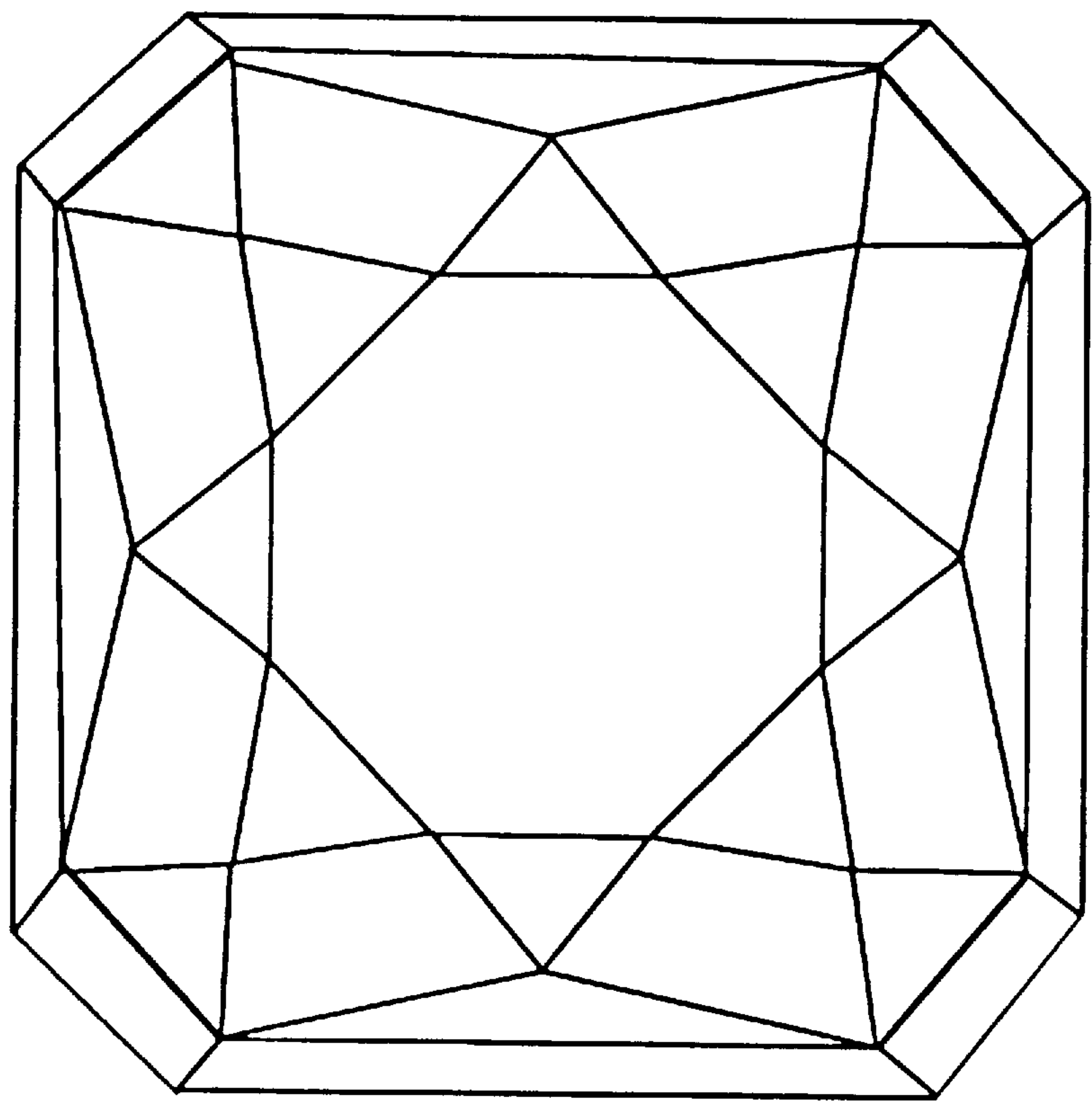

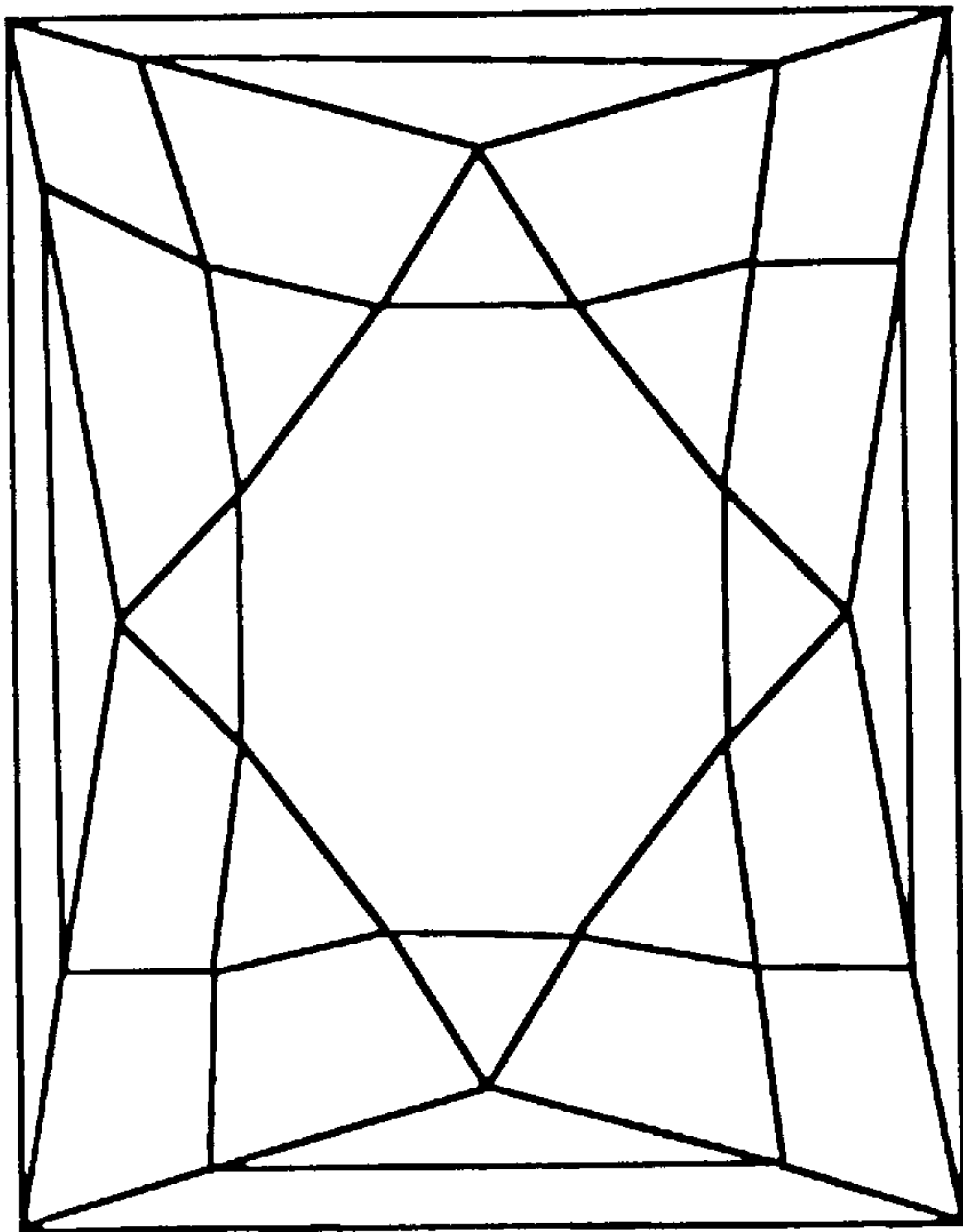

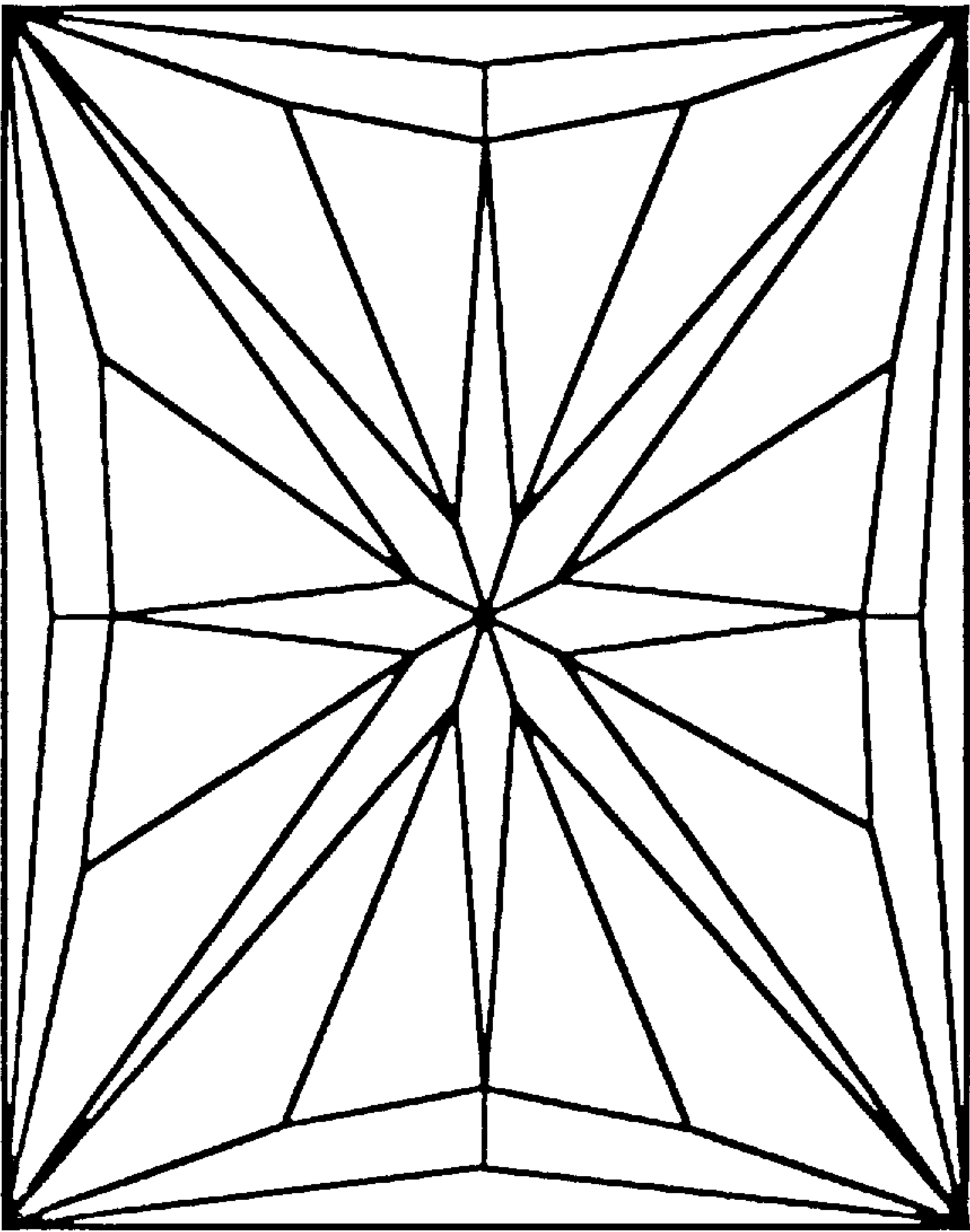

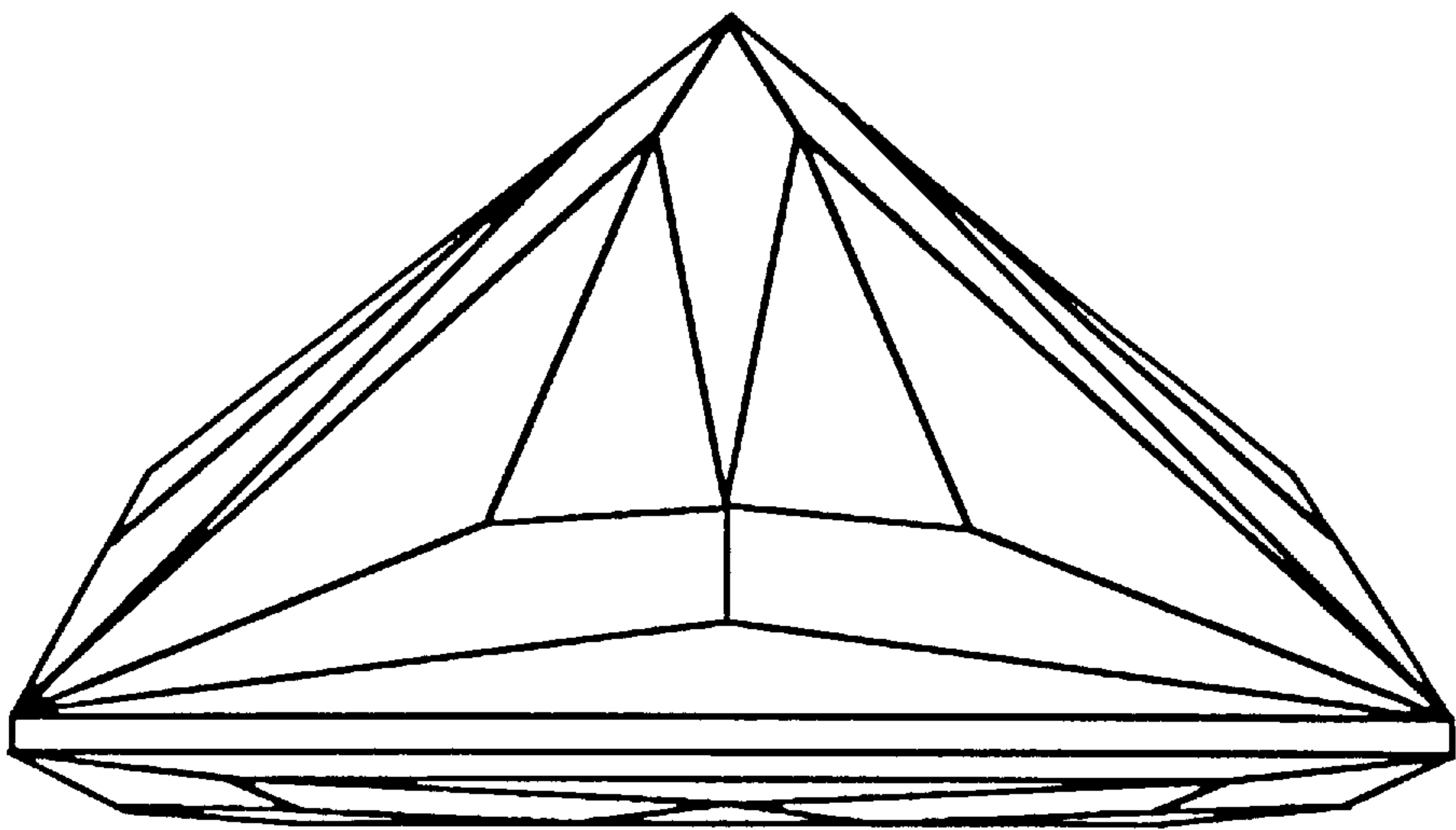

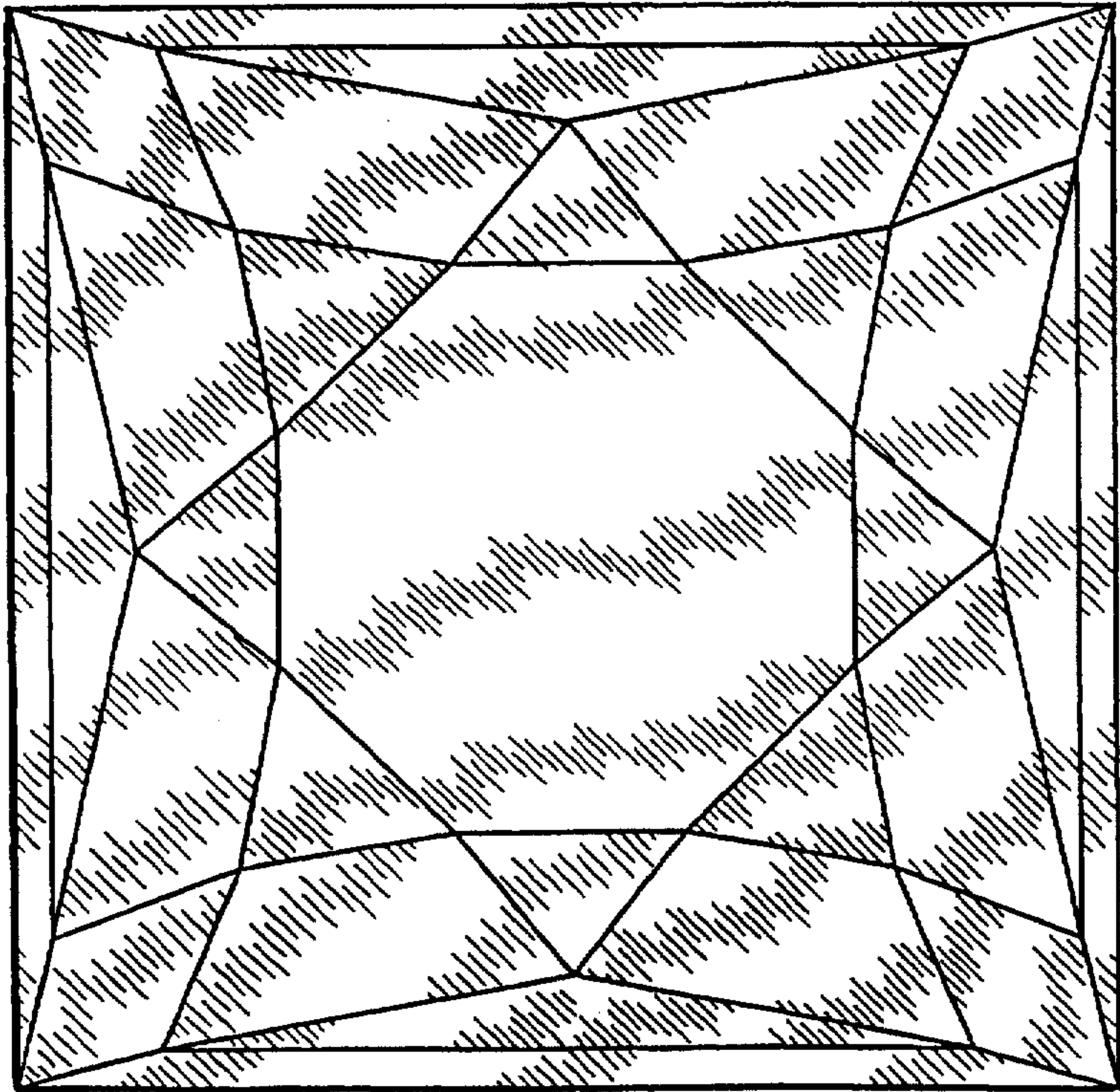
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DESCRIPTION

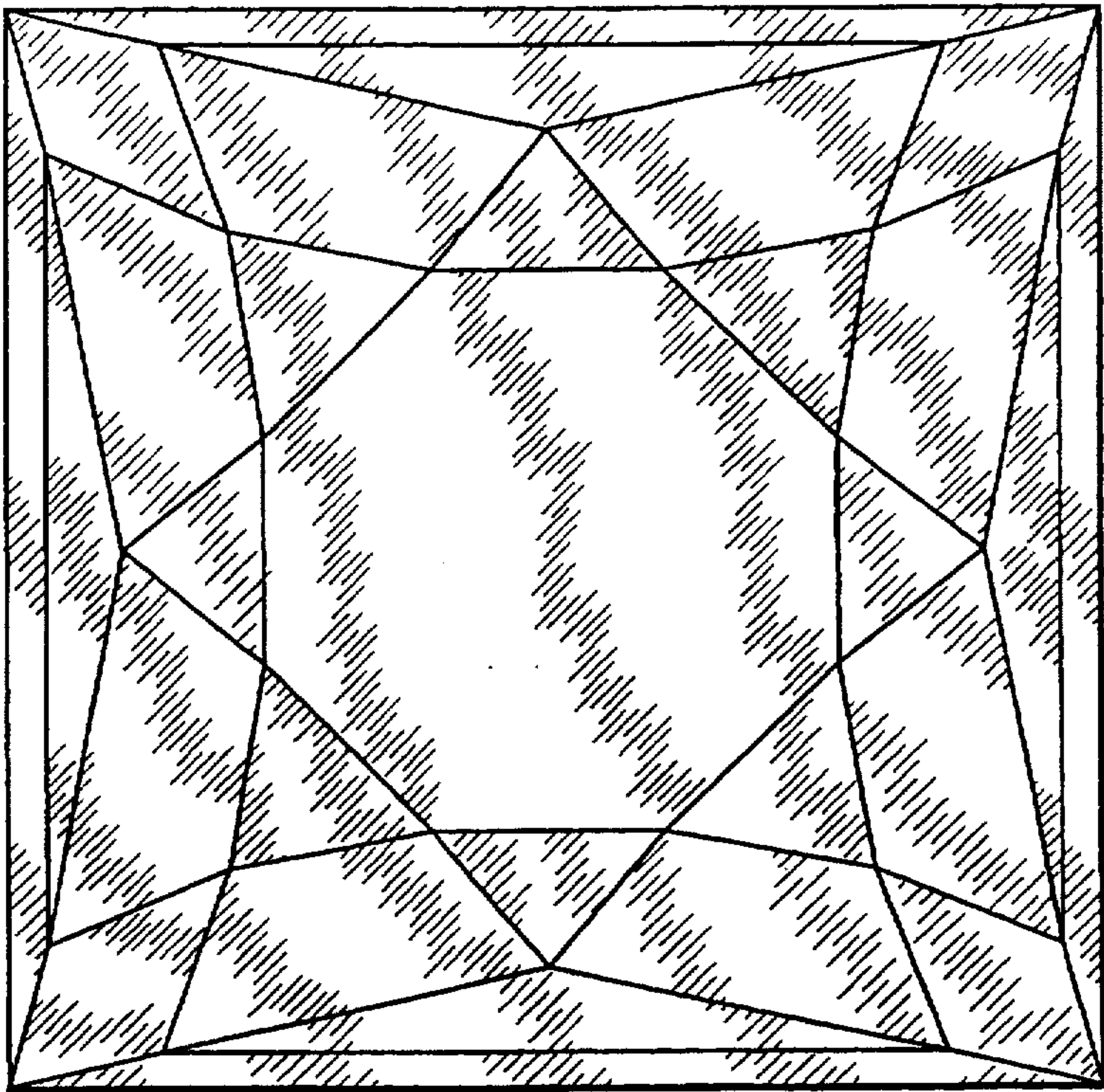

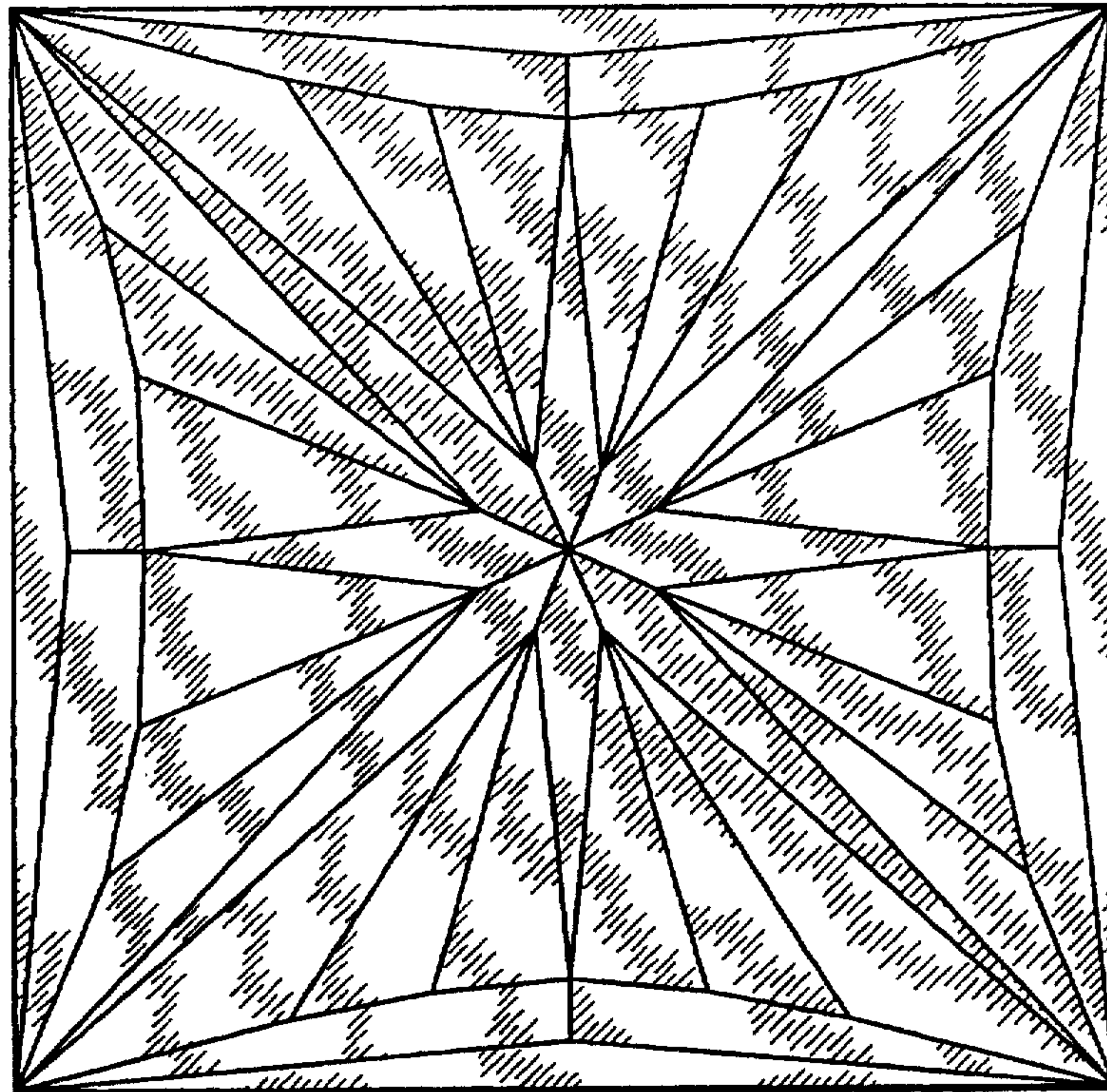

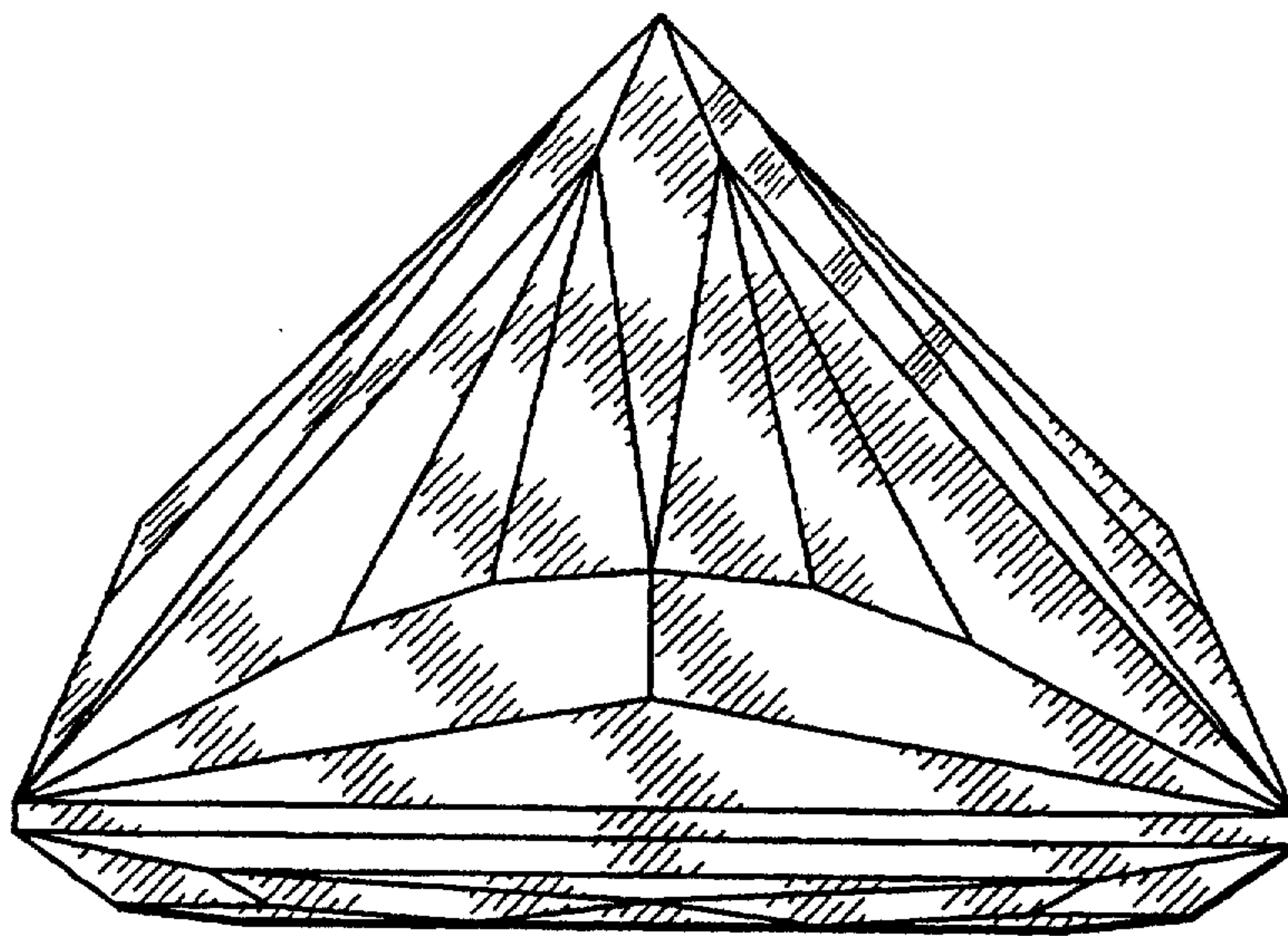

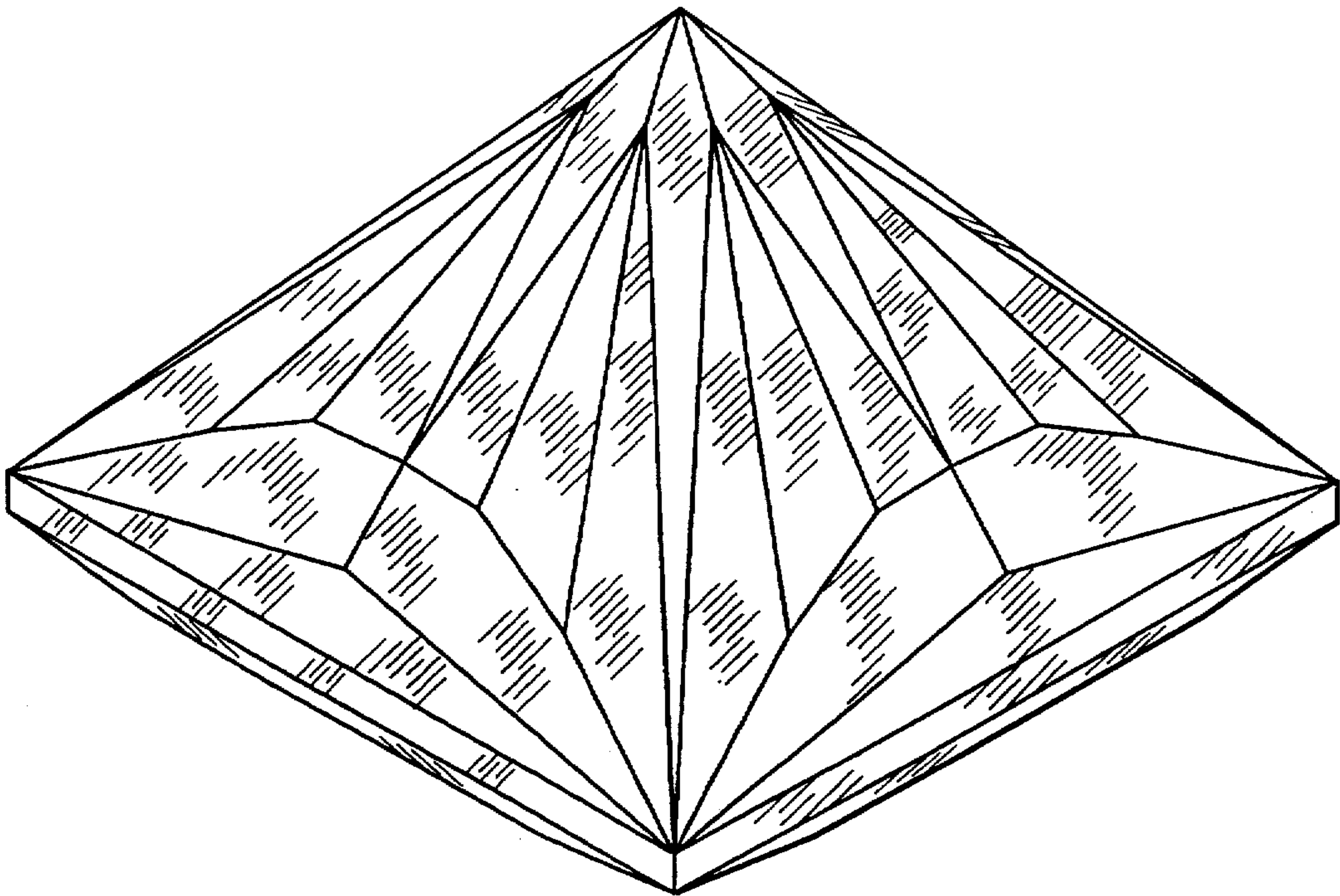

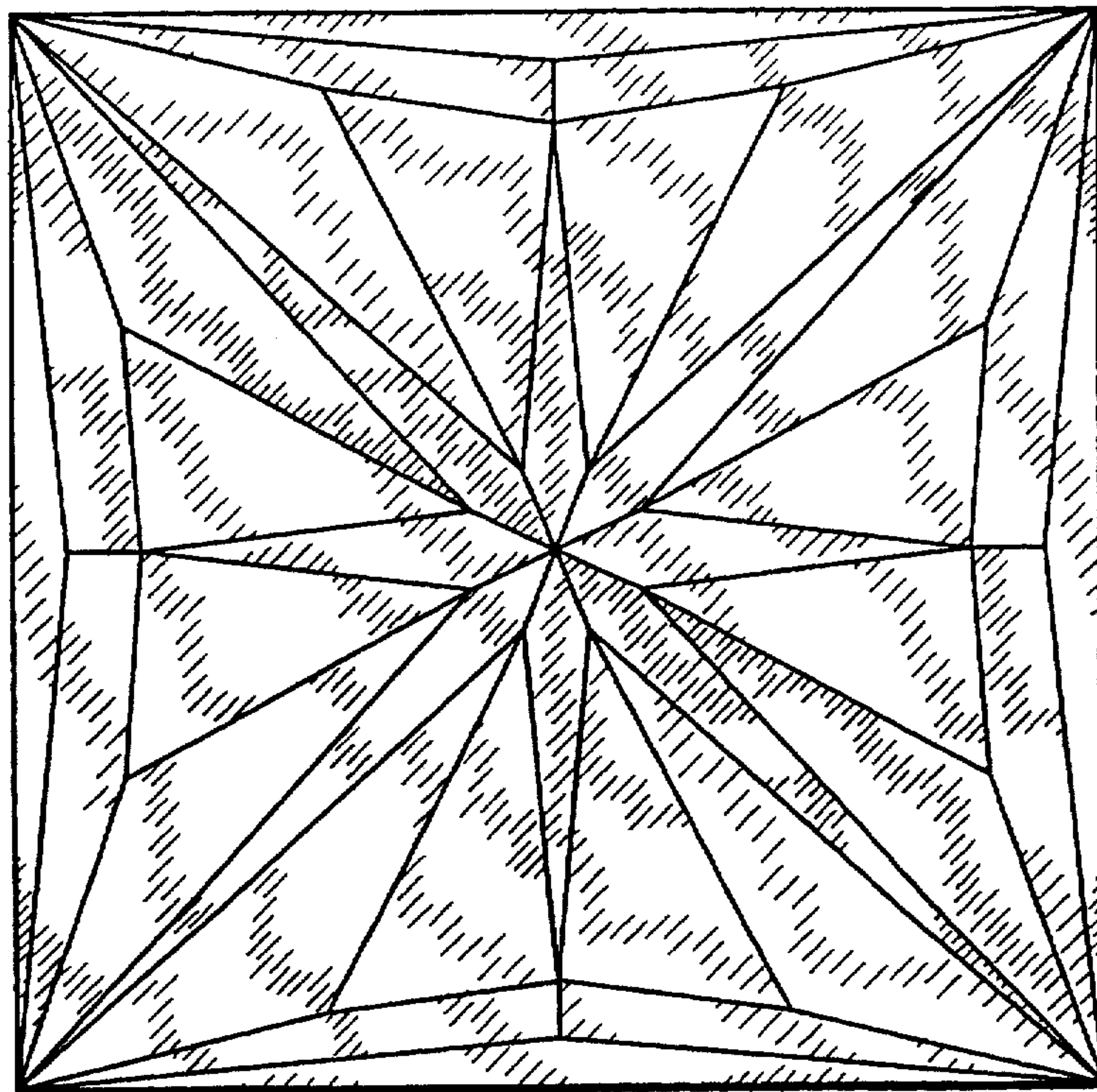

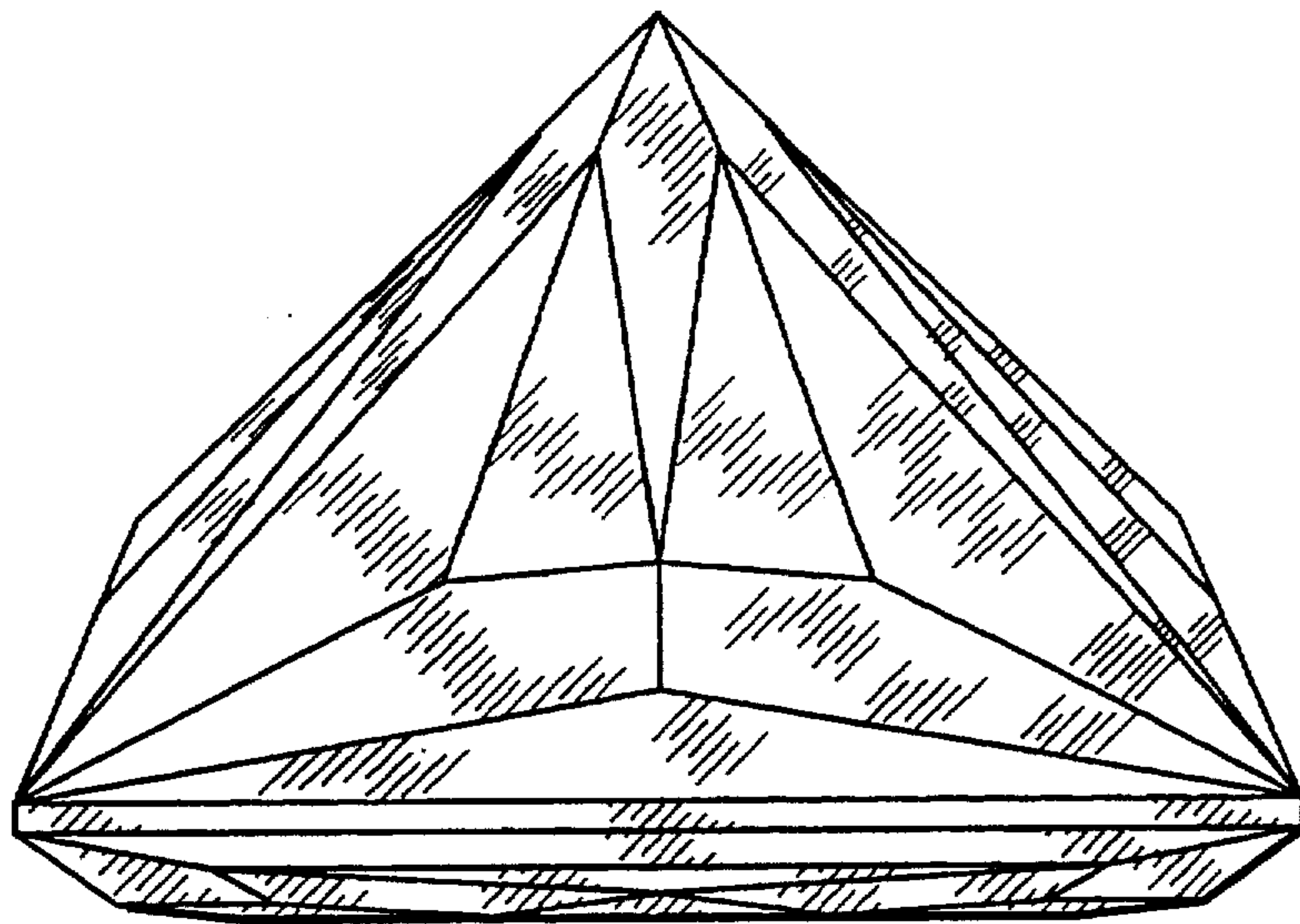

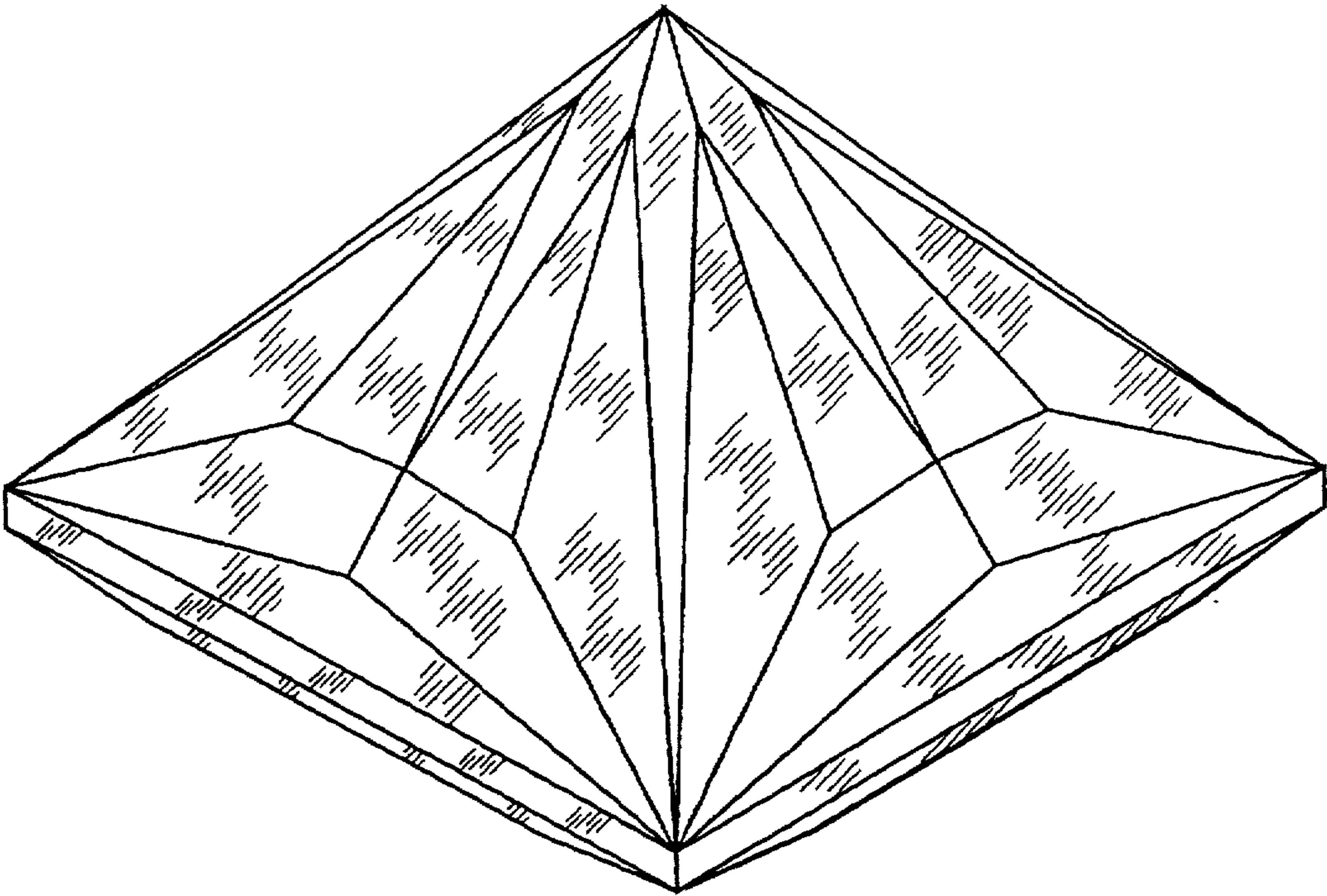

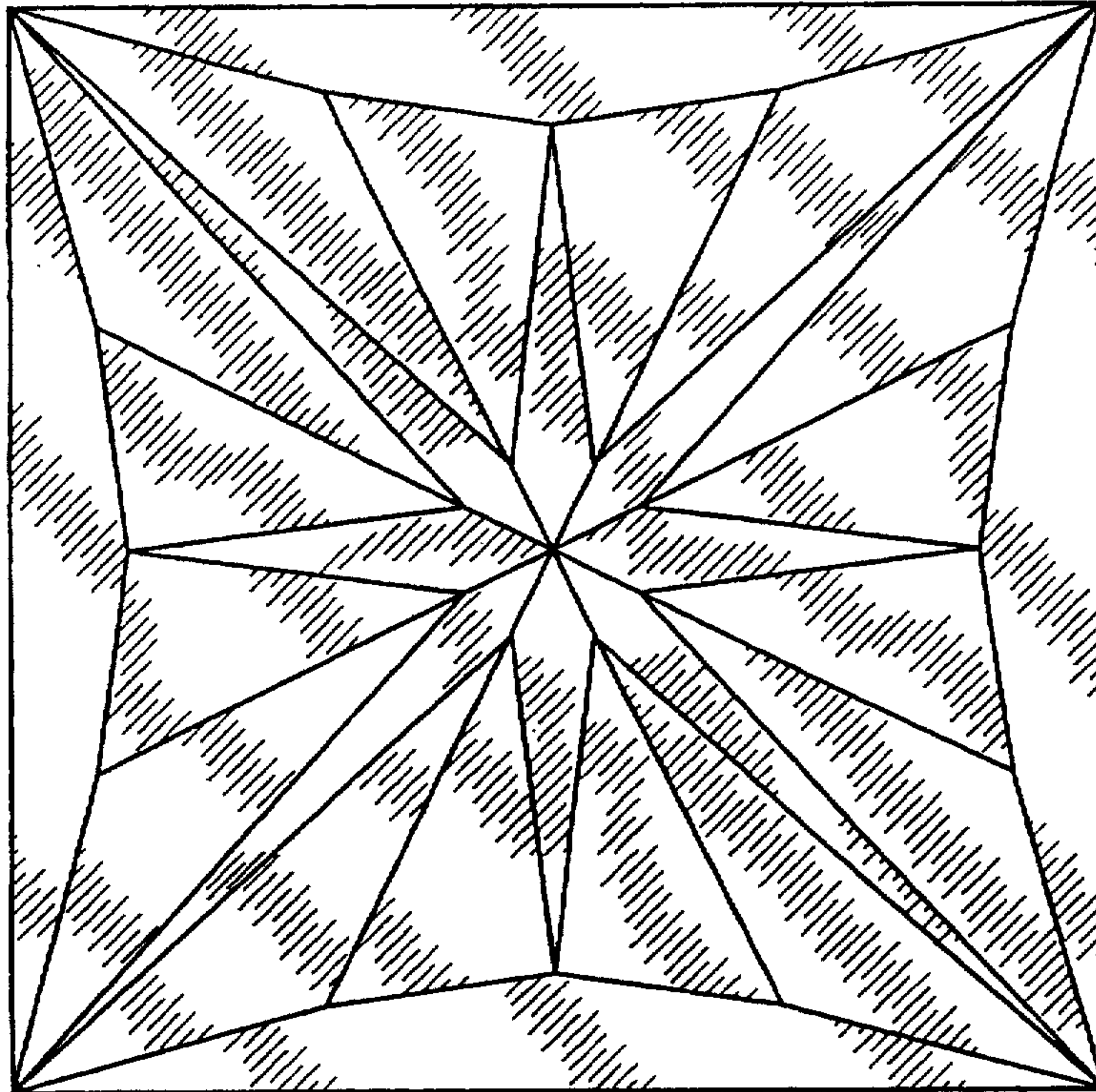

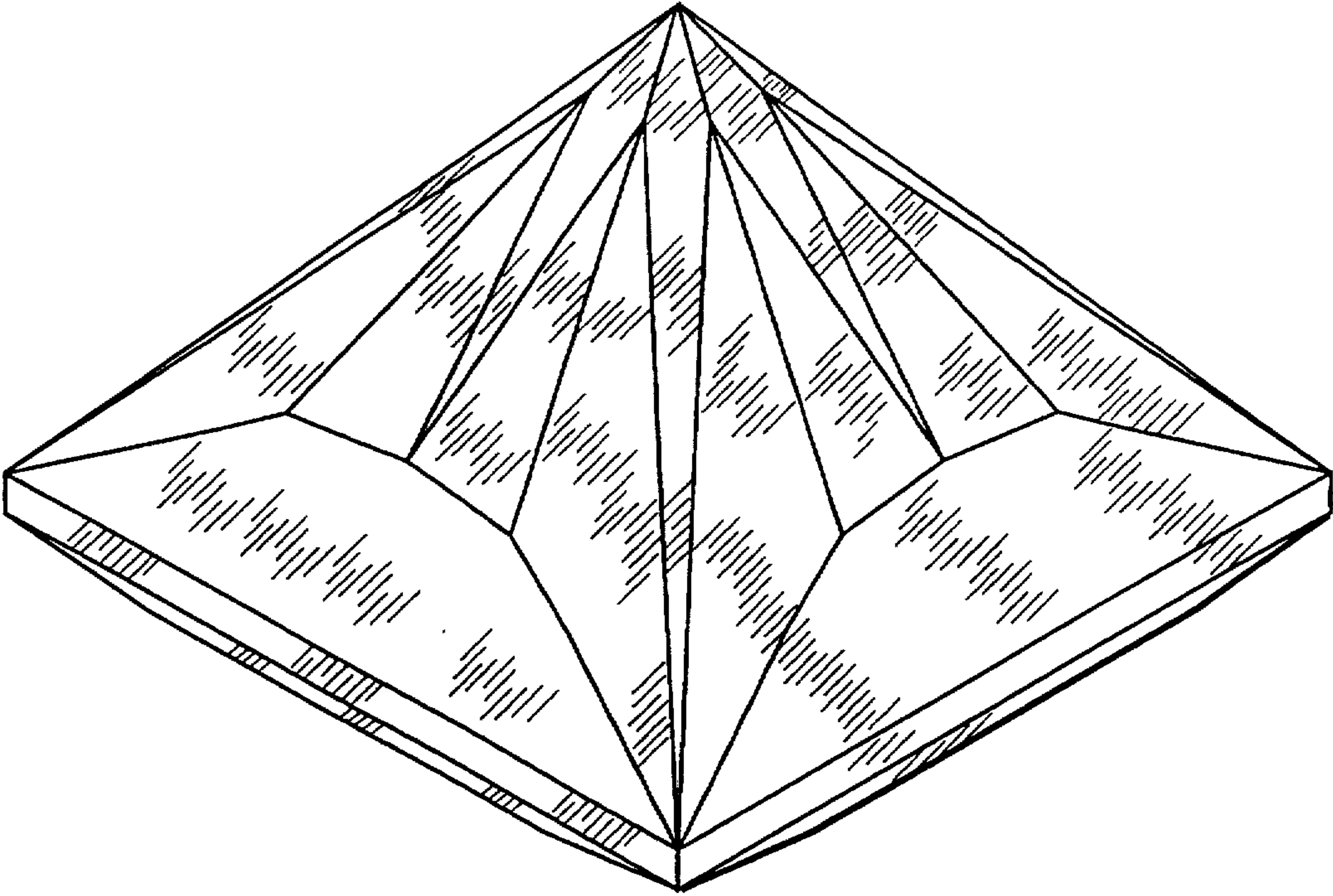

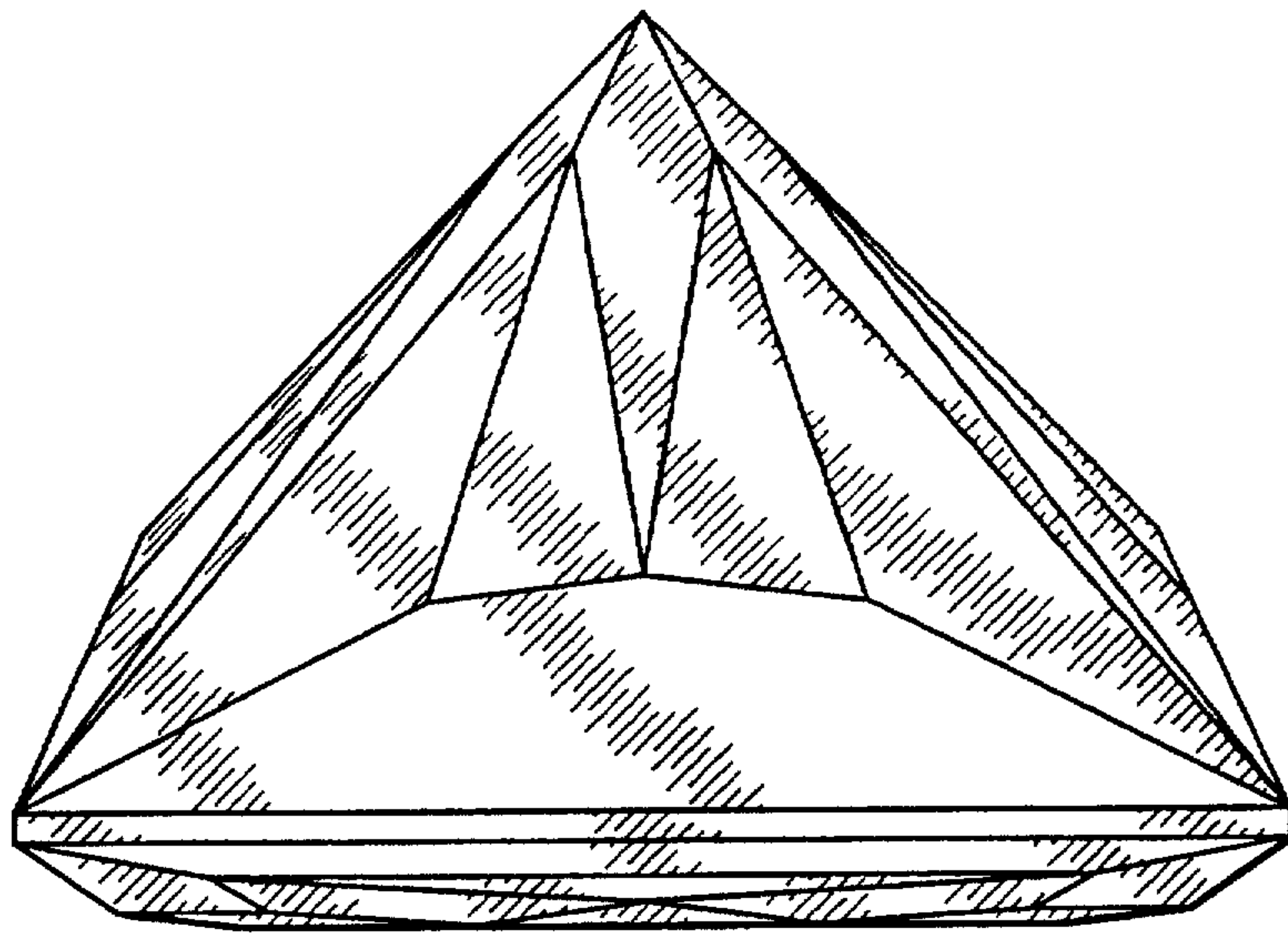

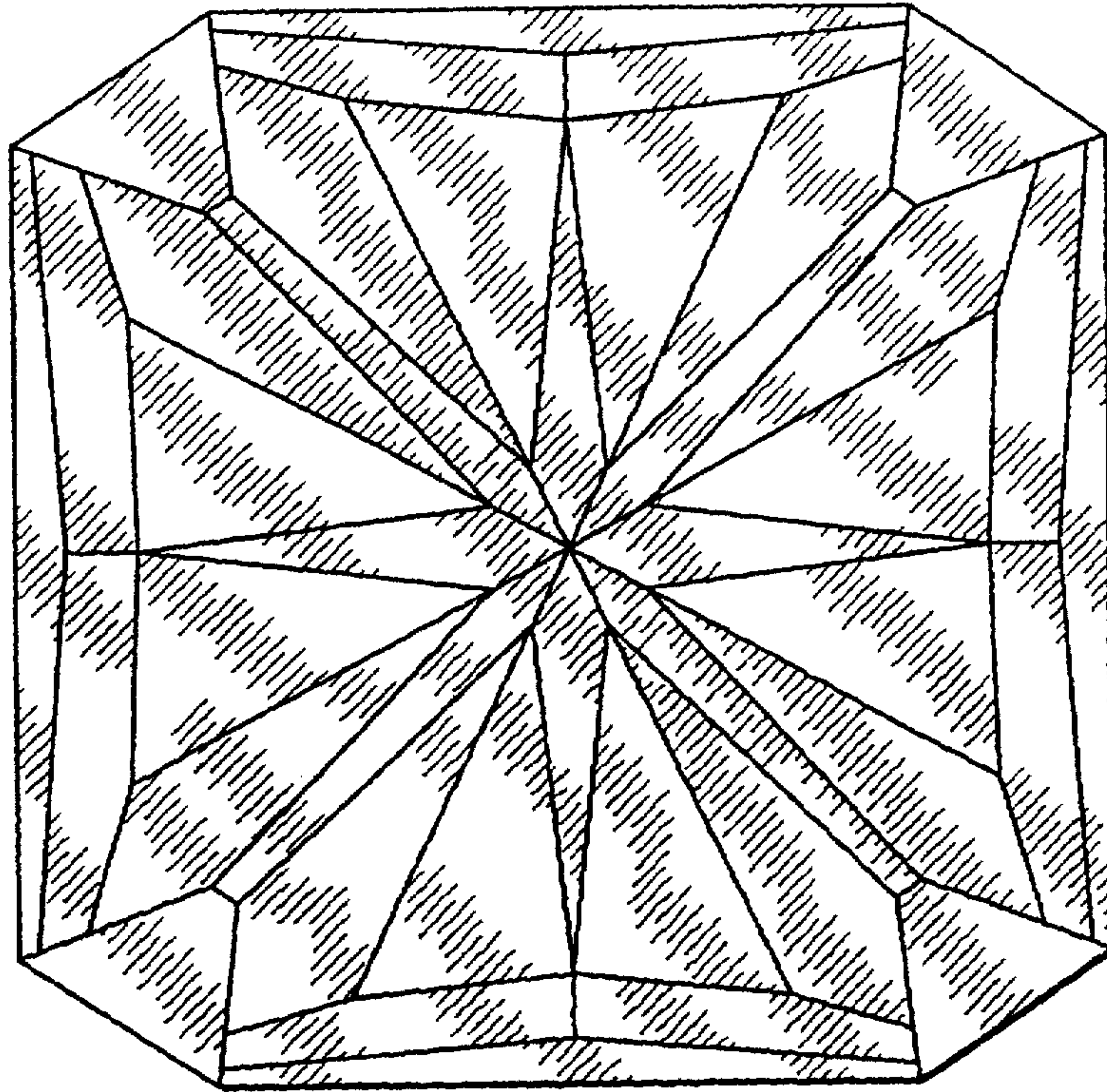

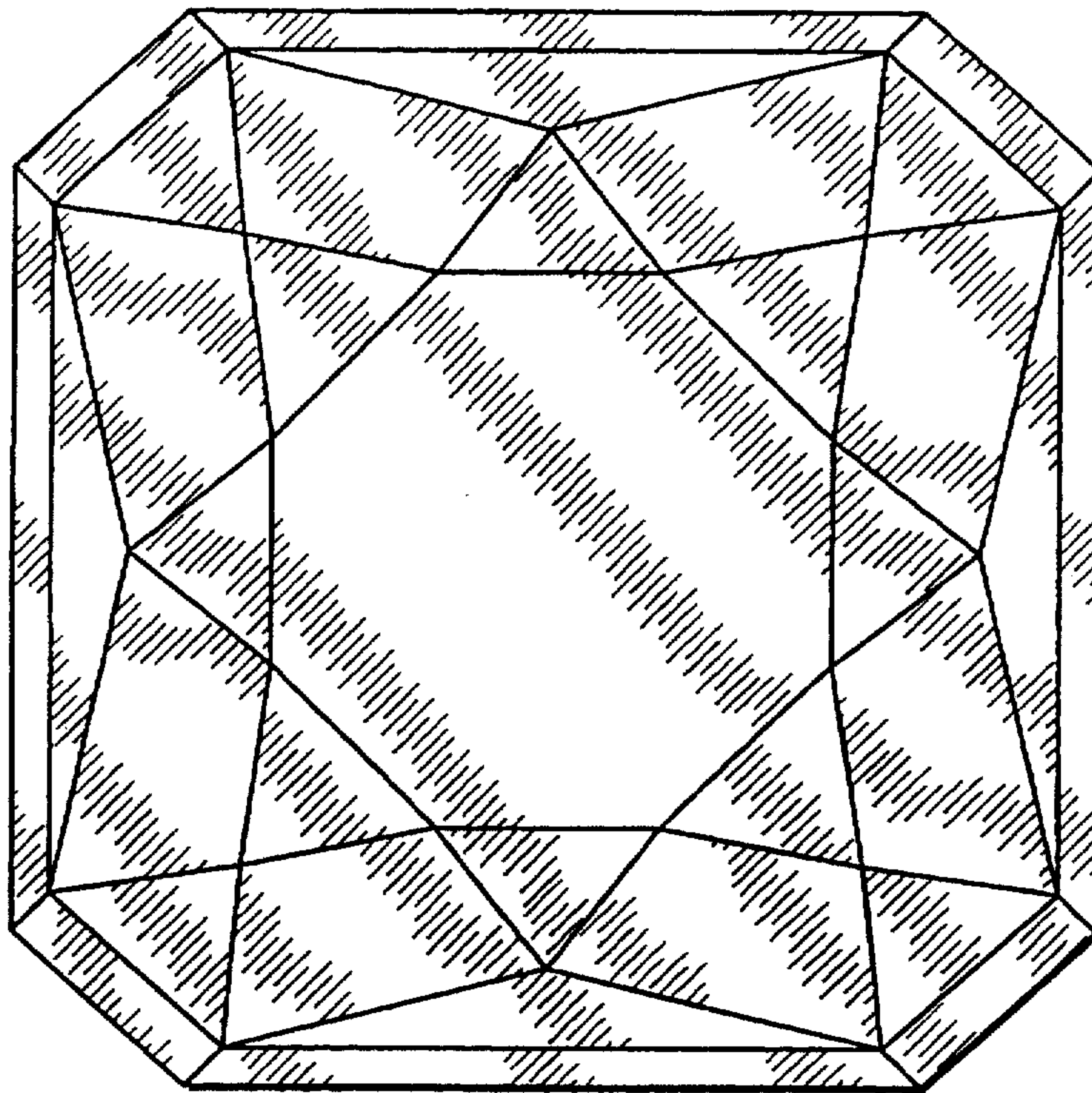

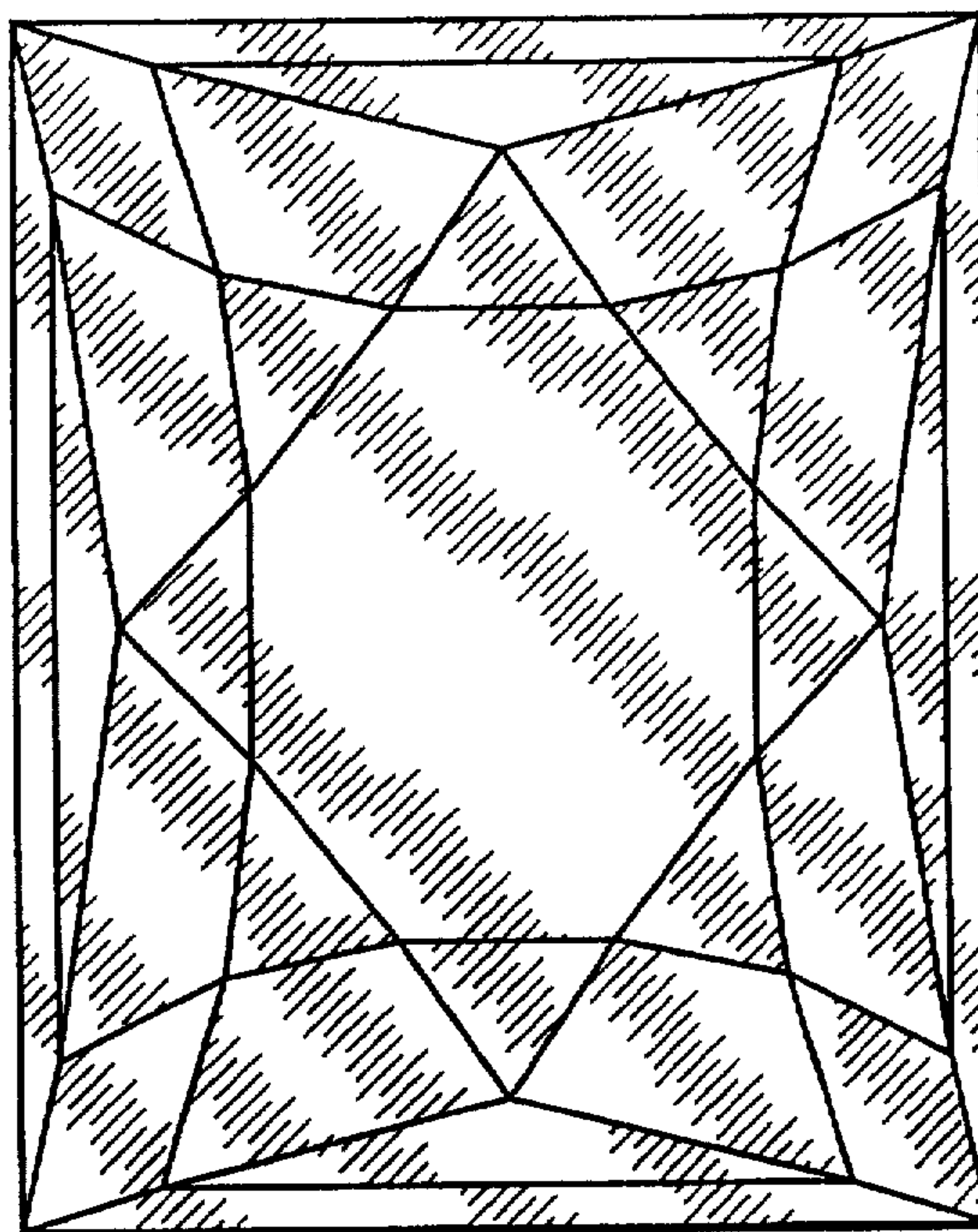

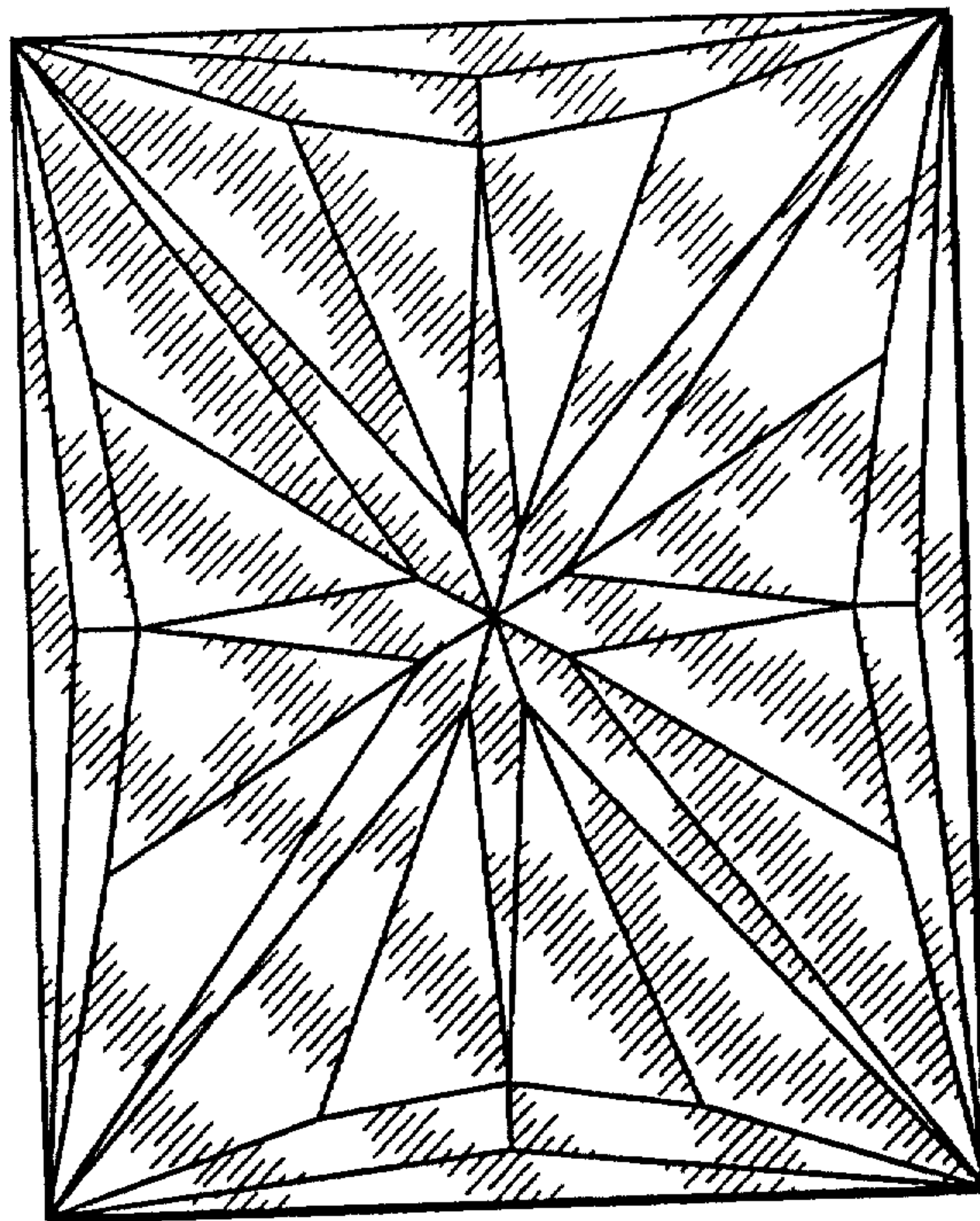

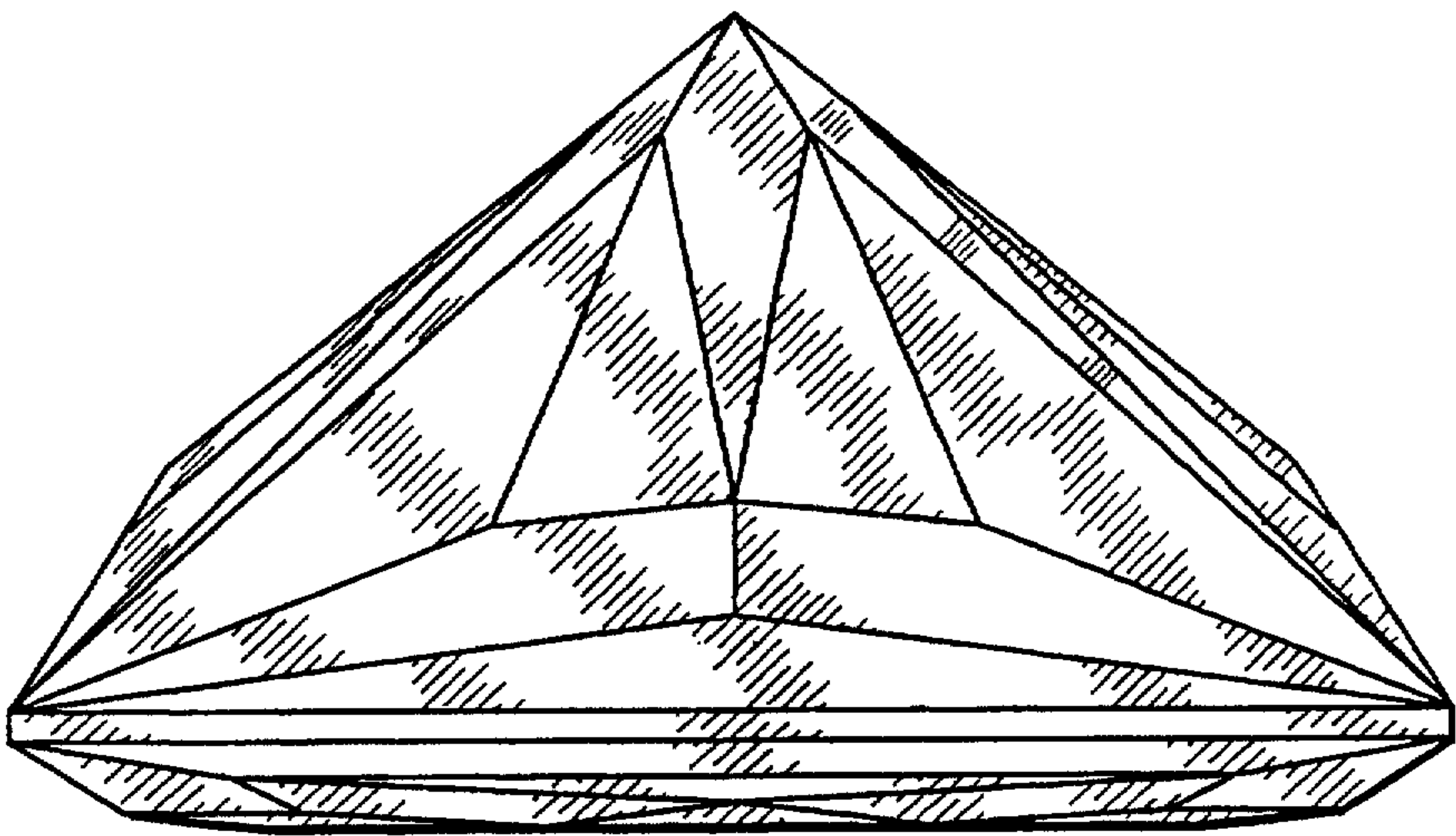
