[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined oil filter adapter and canister for an antique automobile, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a combined oil filter adapter and canister for an antique automobile showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a left side elevational plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational plan view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational plan view of FIG. 1 thereof;

FIG. 5 is a top elevational plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom elevational plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a front elevational plan view of FIG. 1 in a condition showing the canister portion as externally removably connected therewith;

FIG. 8 is a bottom elevational plan view in FIG. 7 thereof; FIG. 9 is a combined oil filter adapter and canister for an antique automobile showing a second embodiment of my new design, the solid line showing of canister has been removed for ease of illustration;

FIG. 10 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 9;

FIG. 11 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 9;

FIG. 12 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 9;

FIG. 13 is a top plan view of FIG. 9; and,

FIG. 14 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 9.

The broken line "oil filter" in FIGS. 1 and 7 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design; and, The broken line of "fitting couplers" in FIGS. 1, 2, 3, 4, 7, 9, 10, 11, 12 are for illustrative purpsoes only and forms no part of the claimed design.










