FIG. 3 is a front view of the nosepiece;

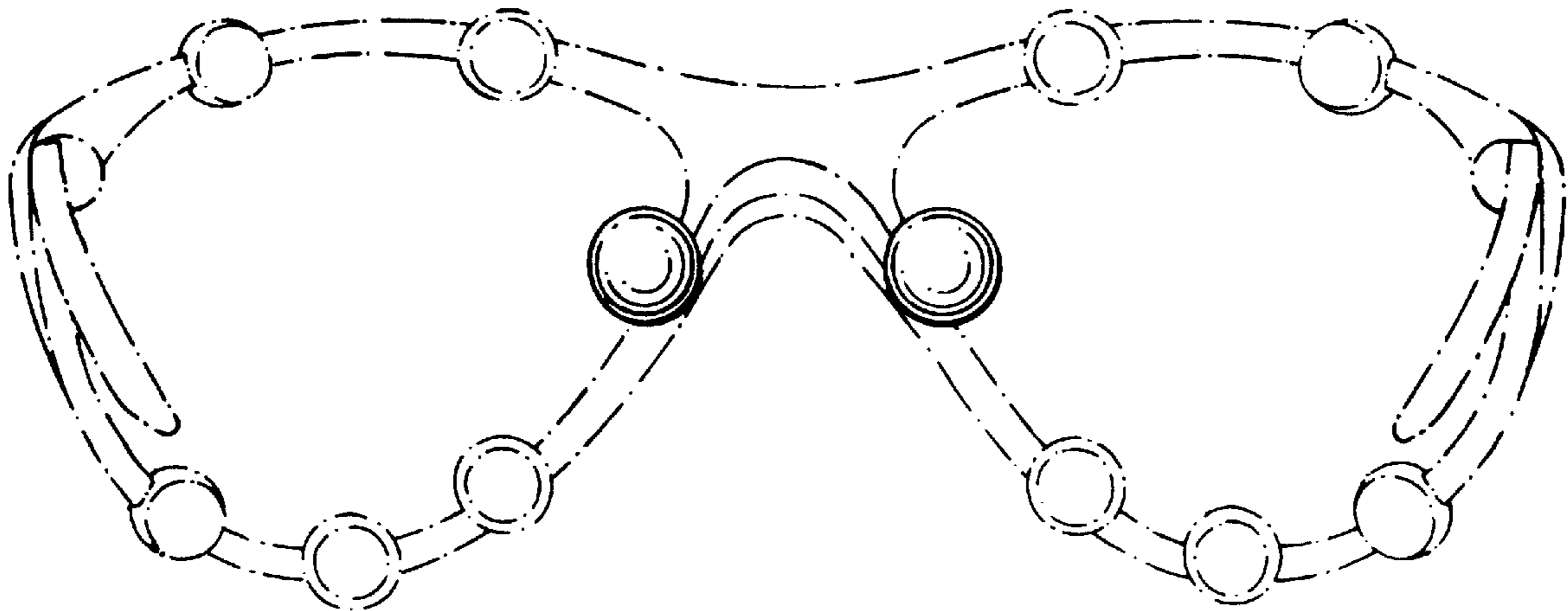
FIG. 4 is a bottom view of the nosepiece;

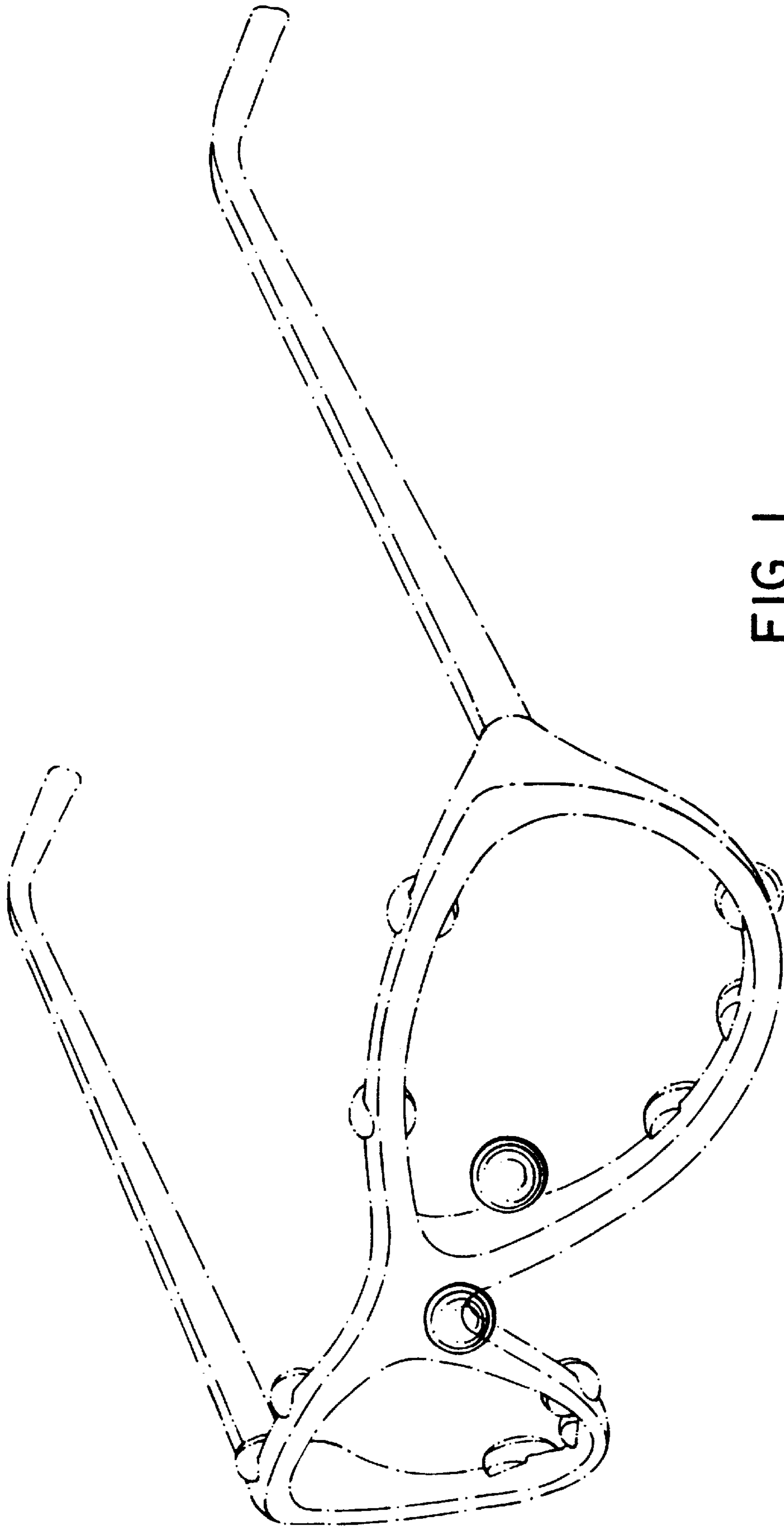

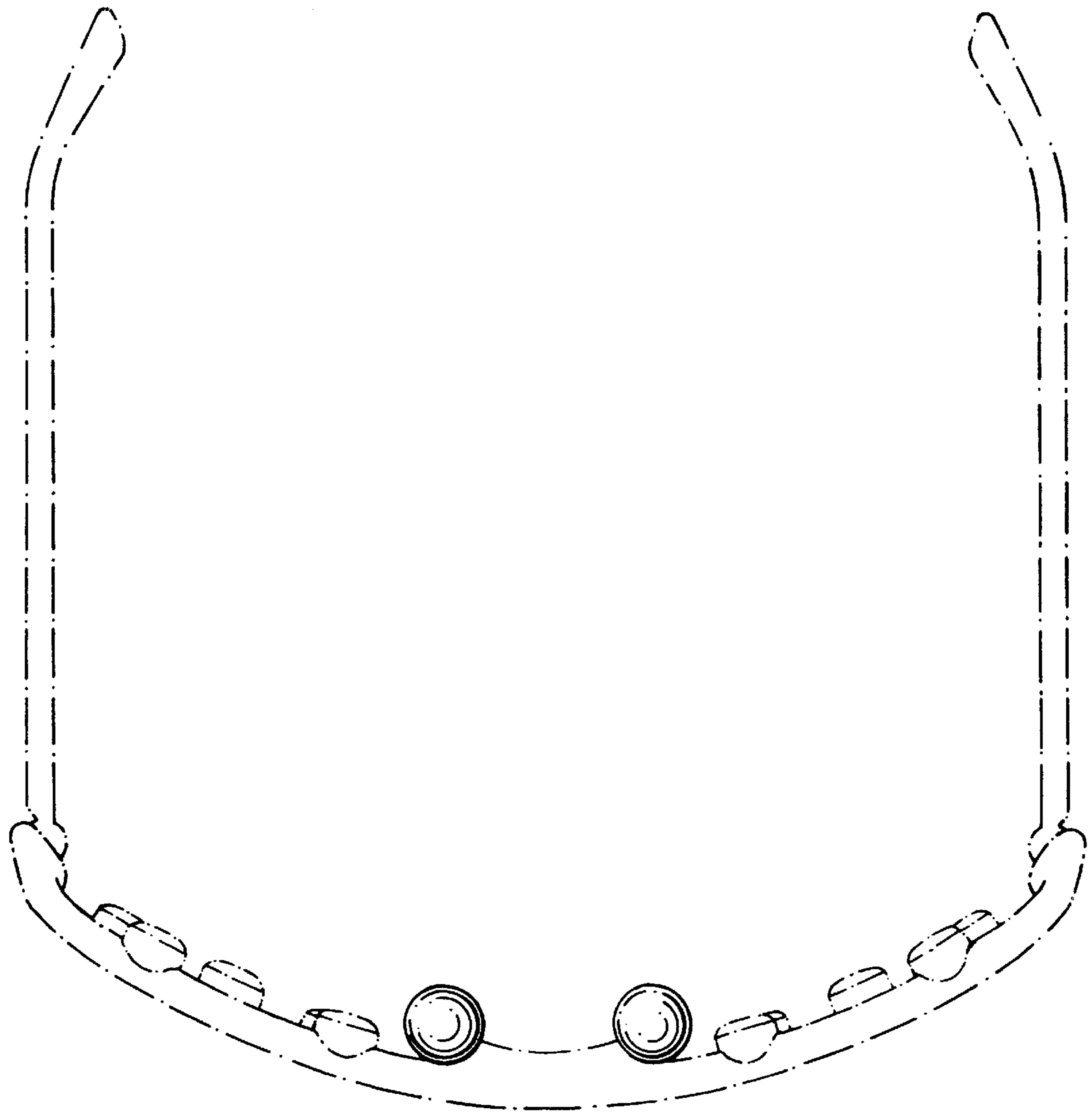

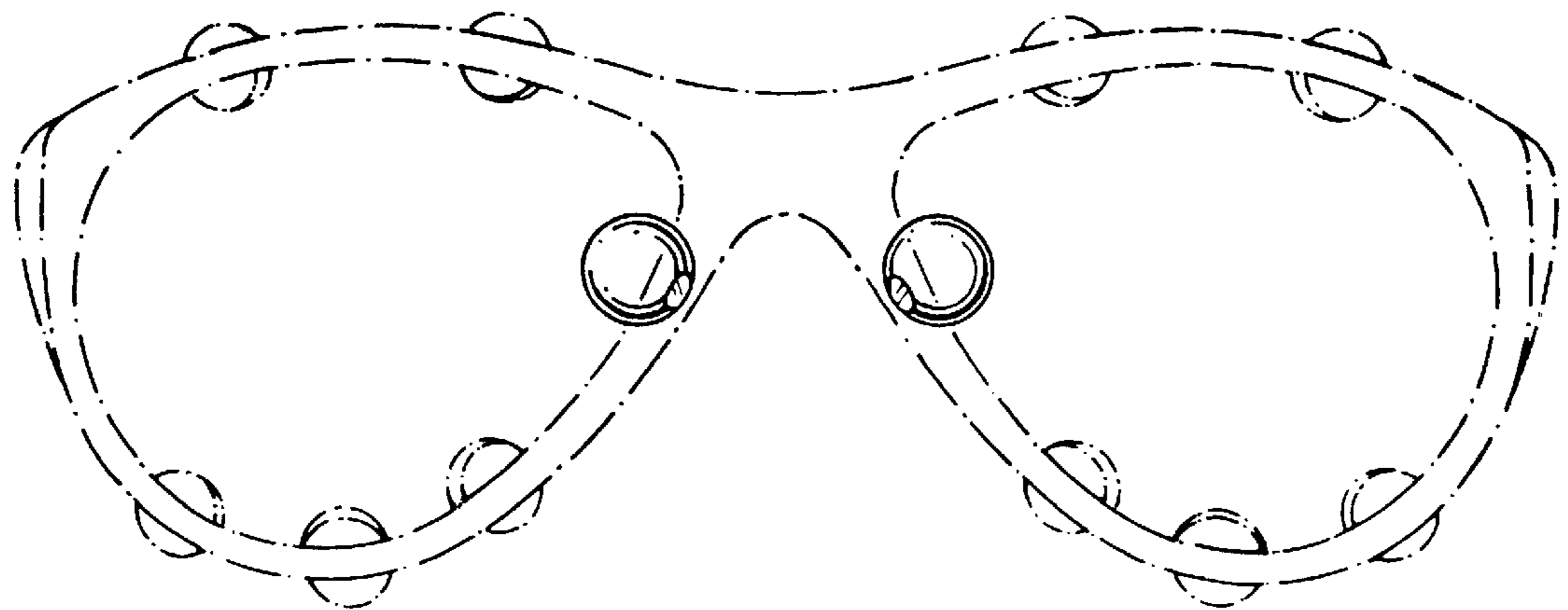

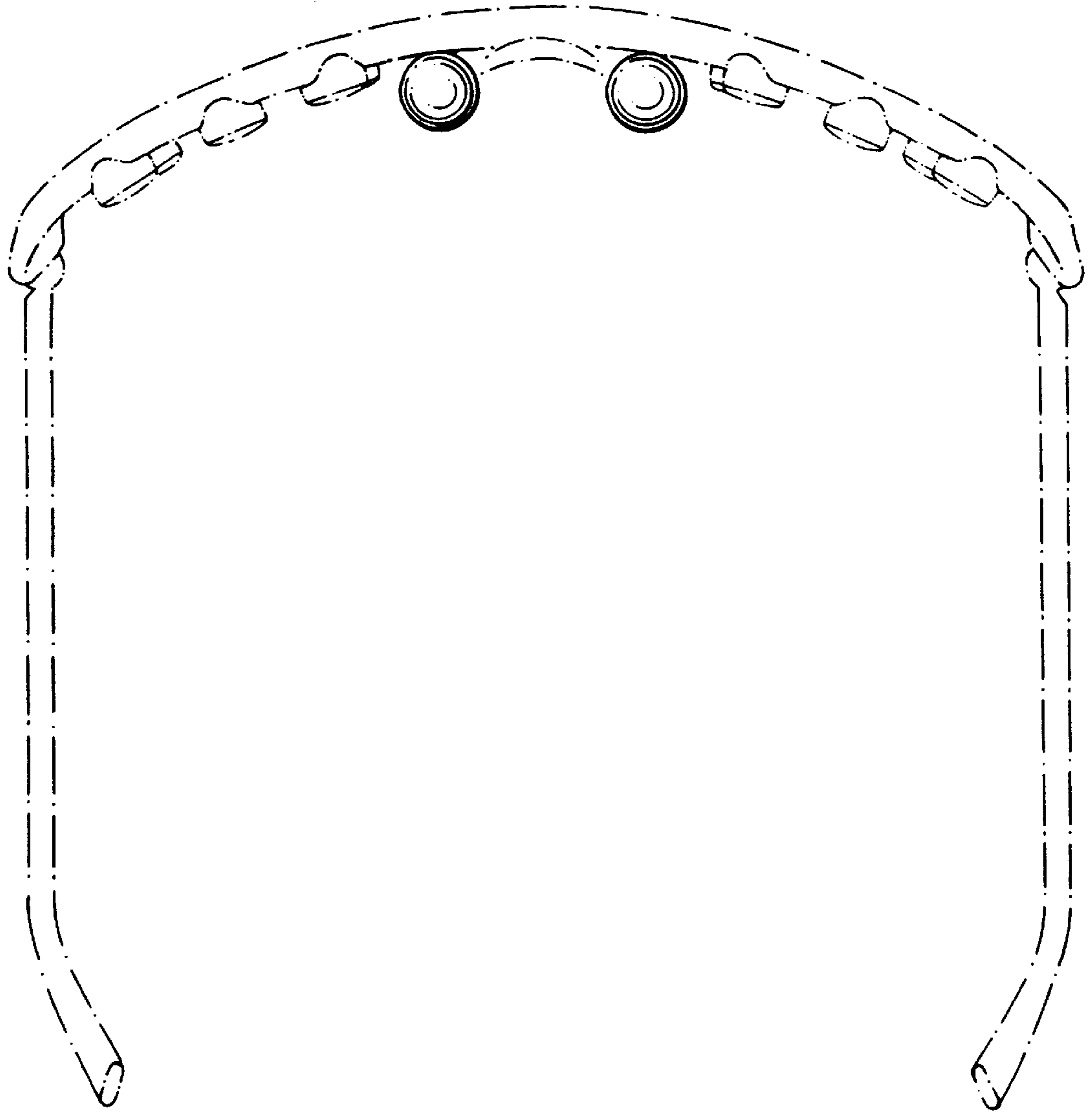

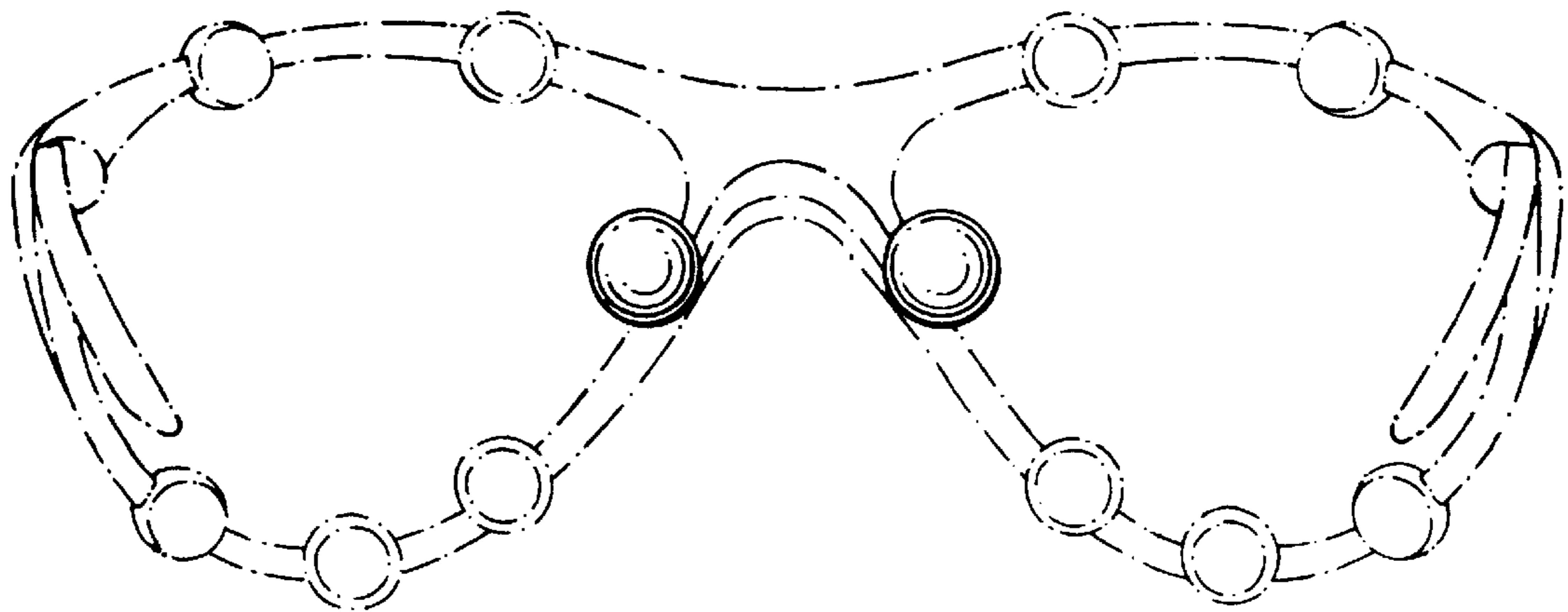

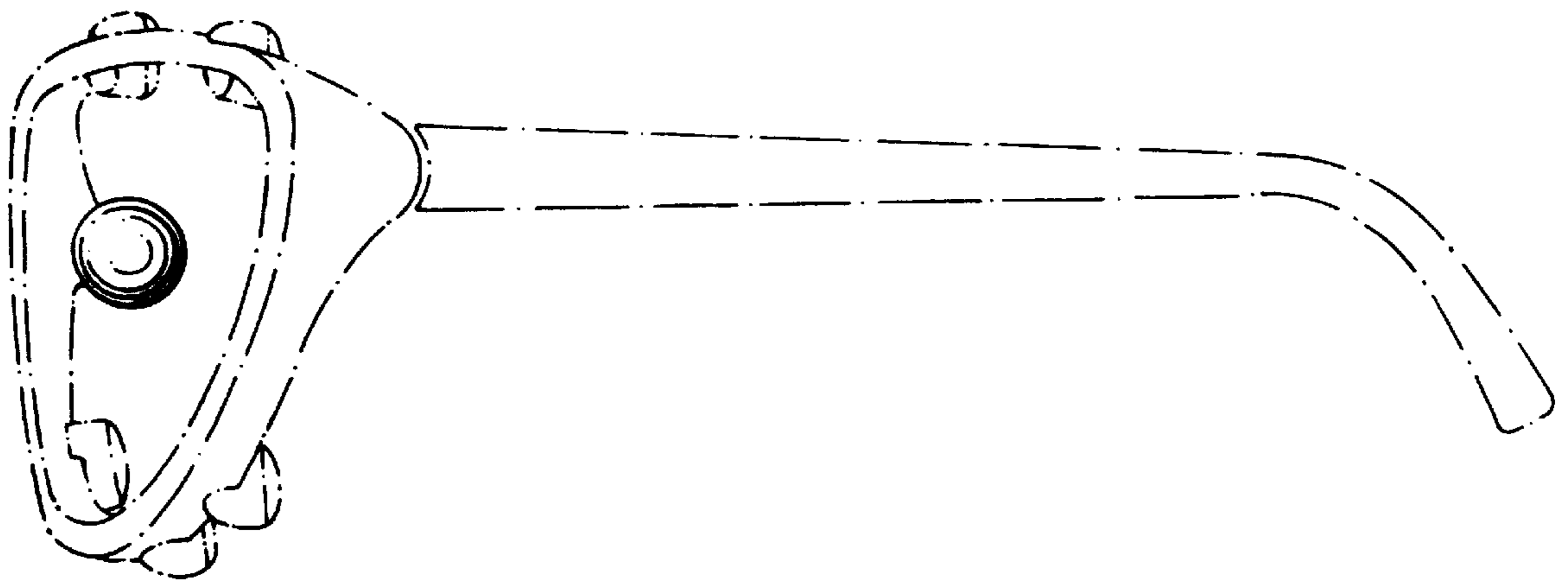
