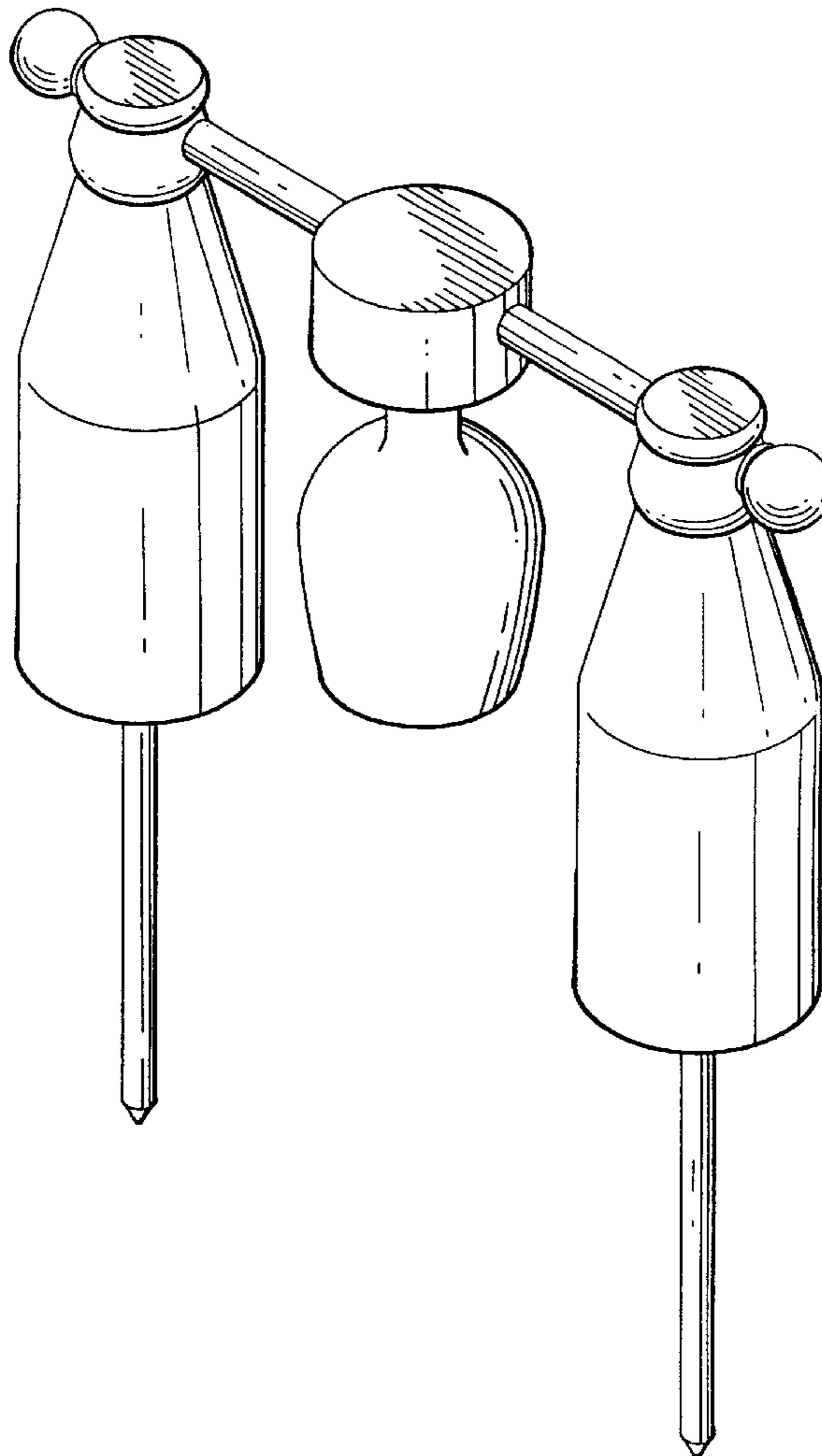
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a ball game target gate showing our new design;

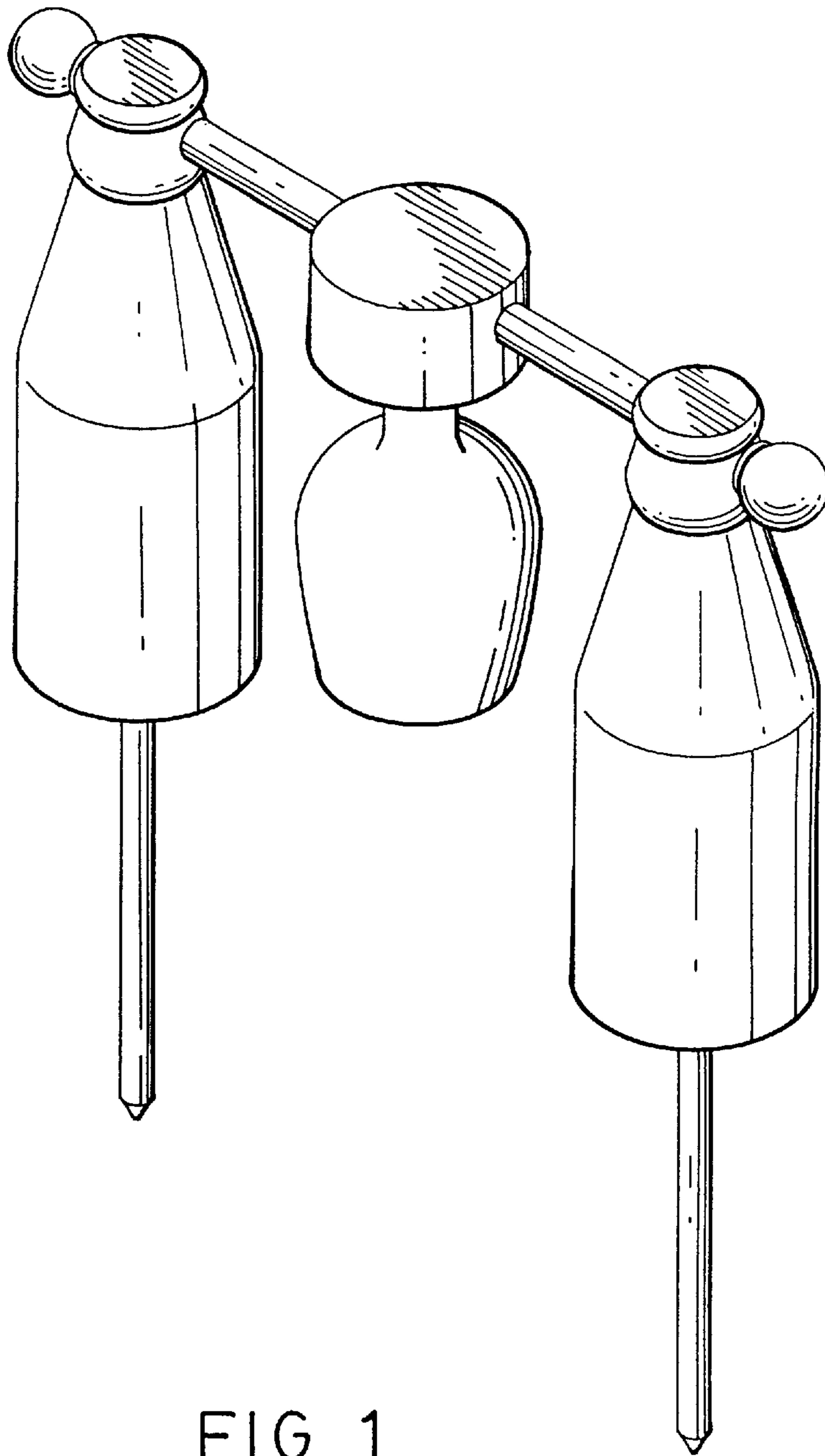

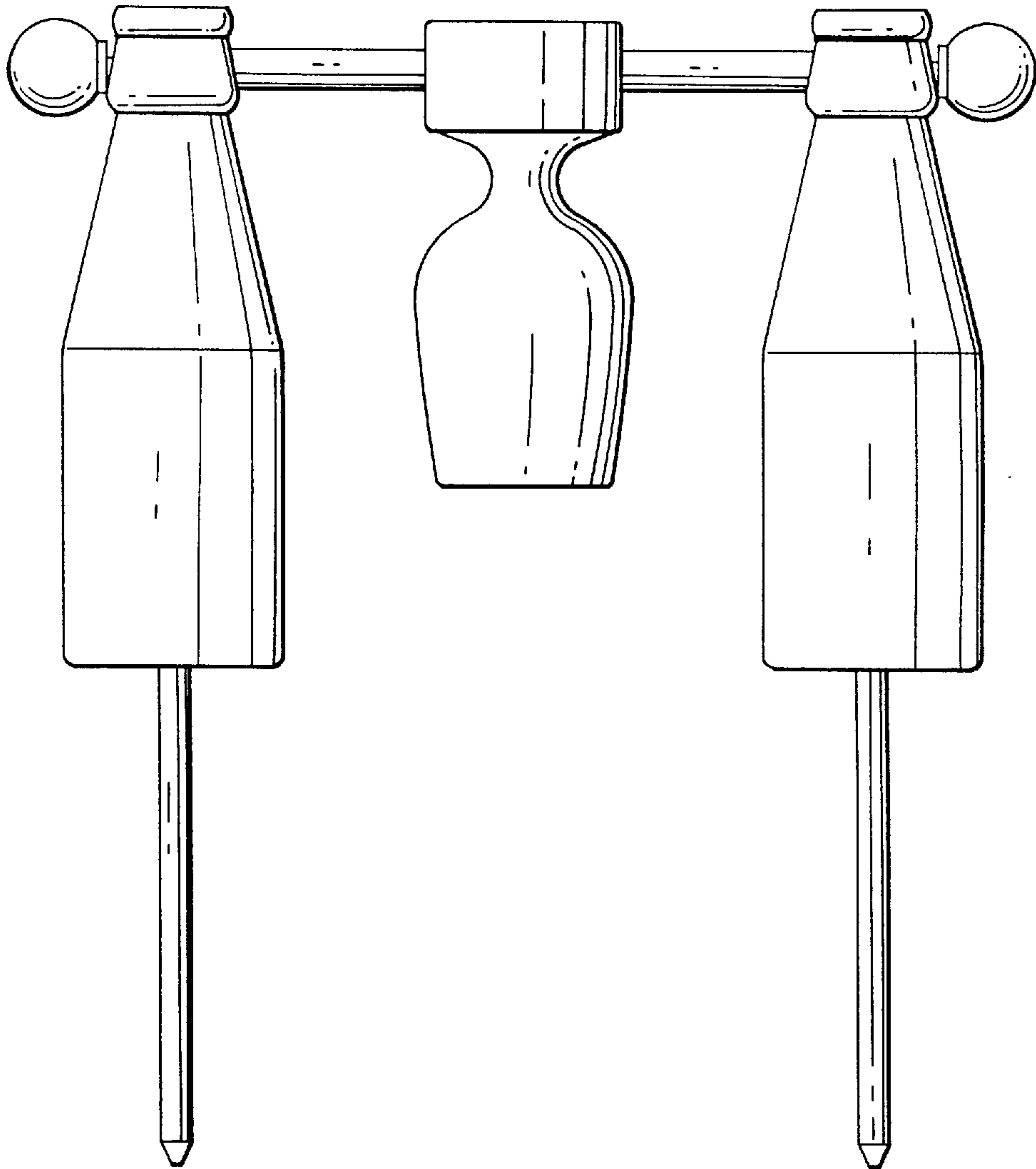

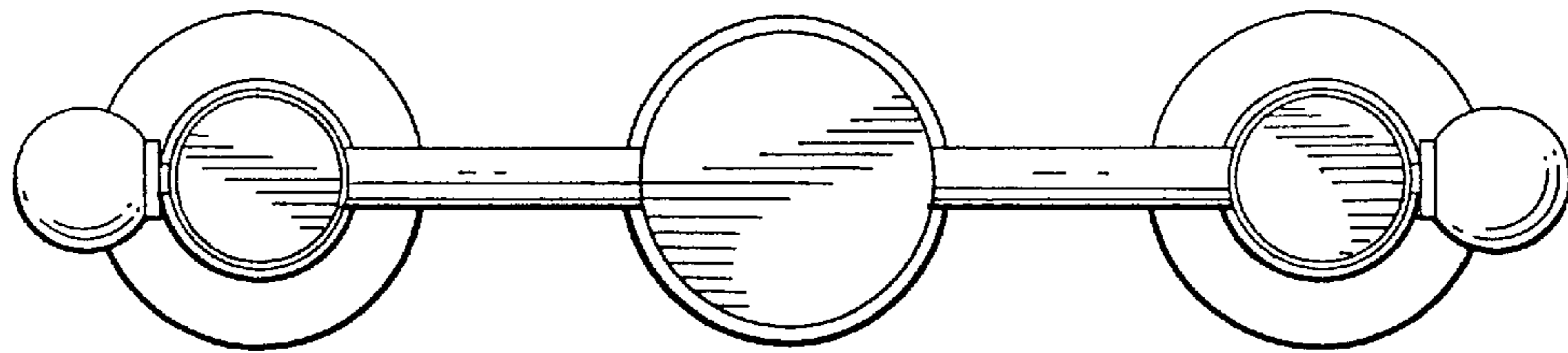

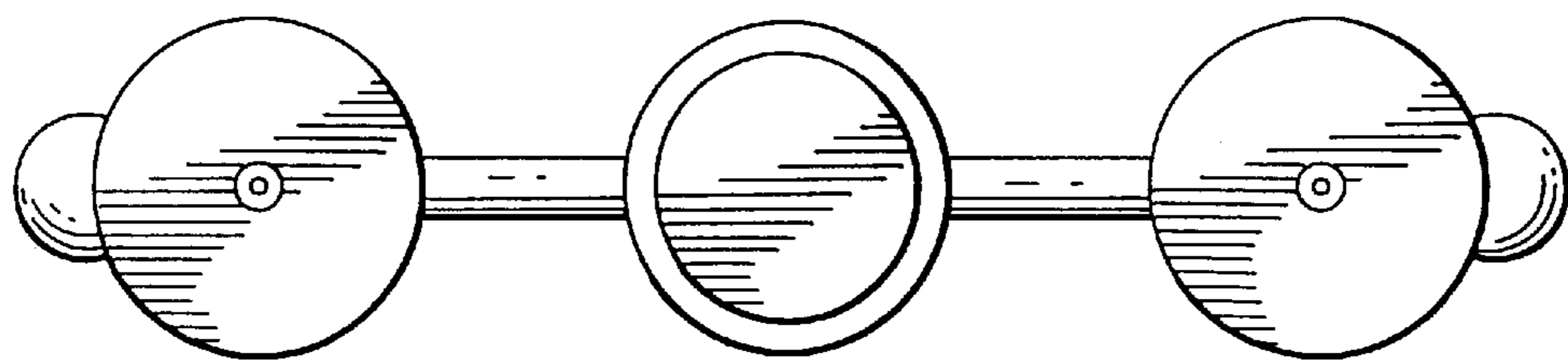

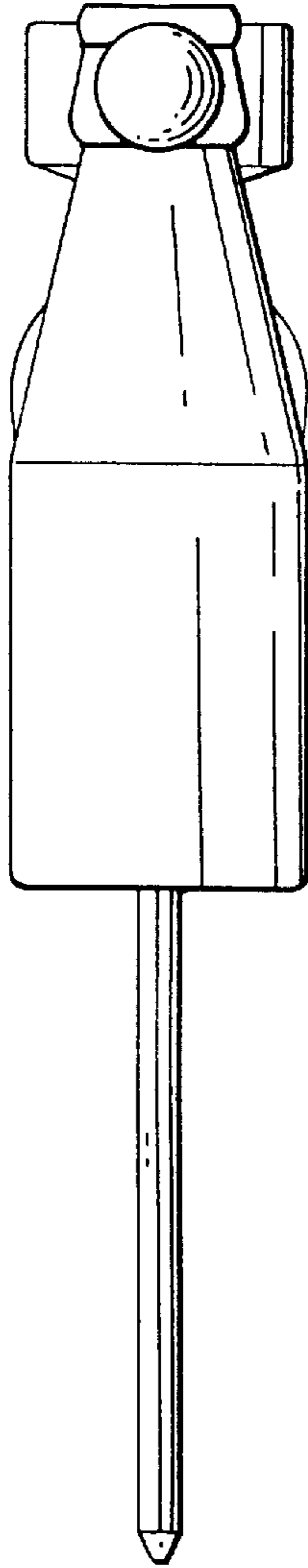

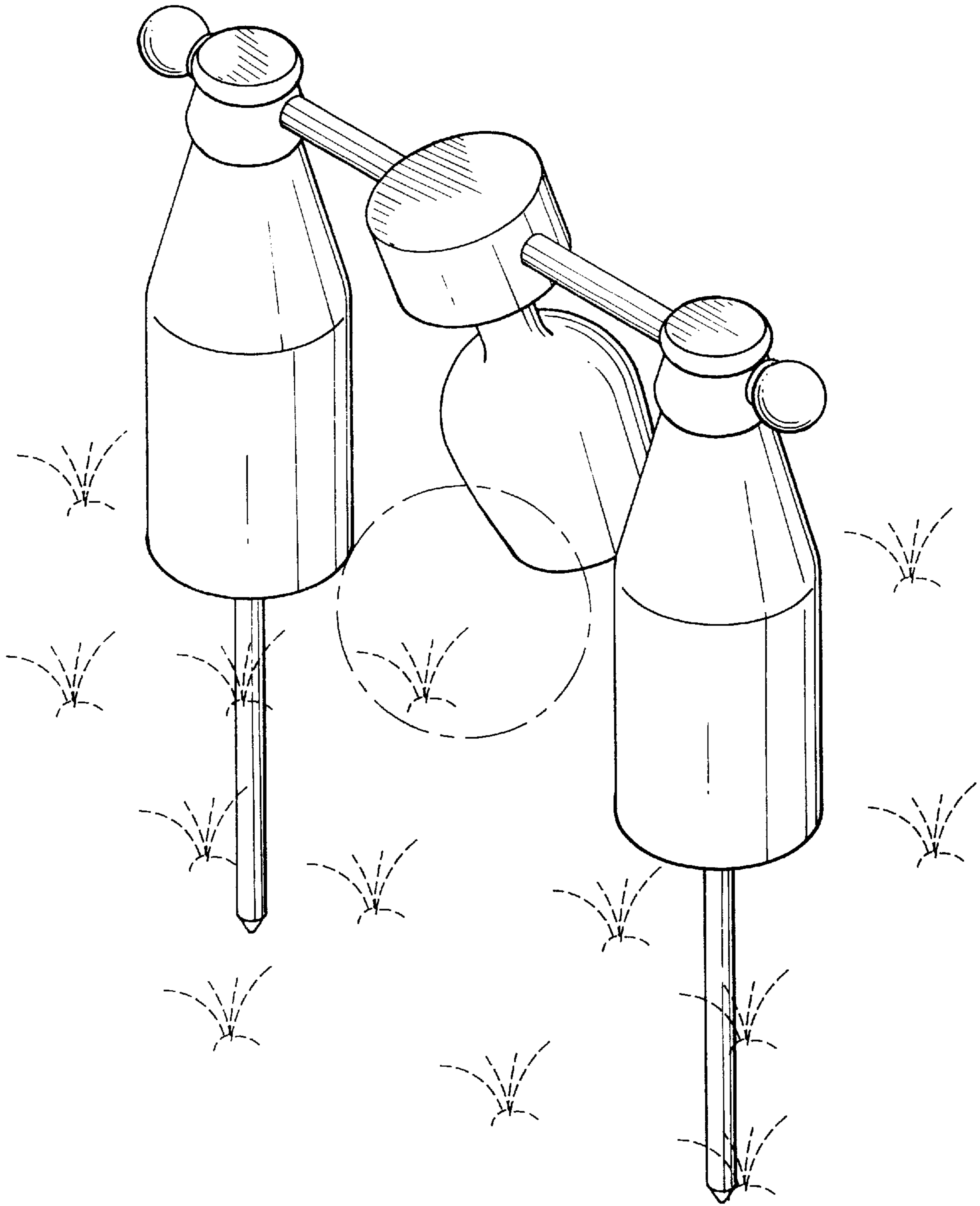
