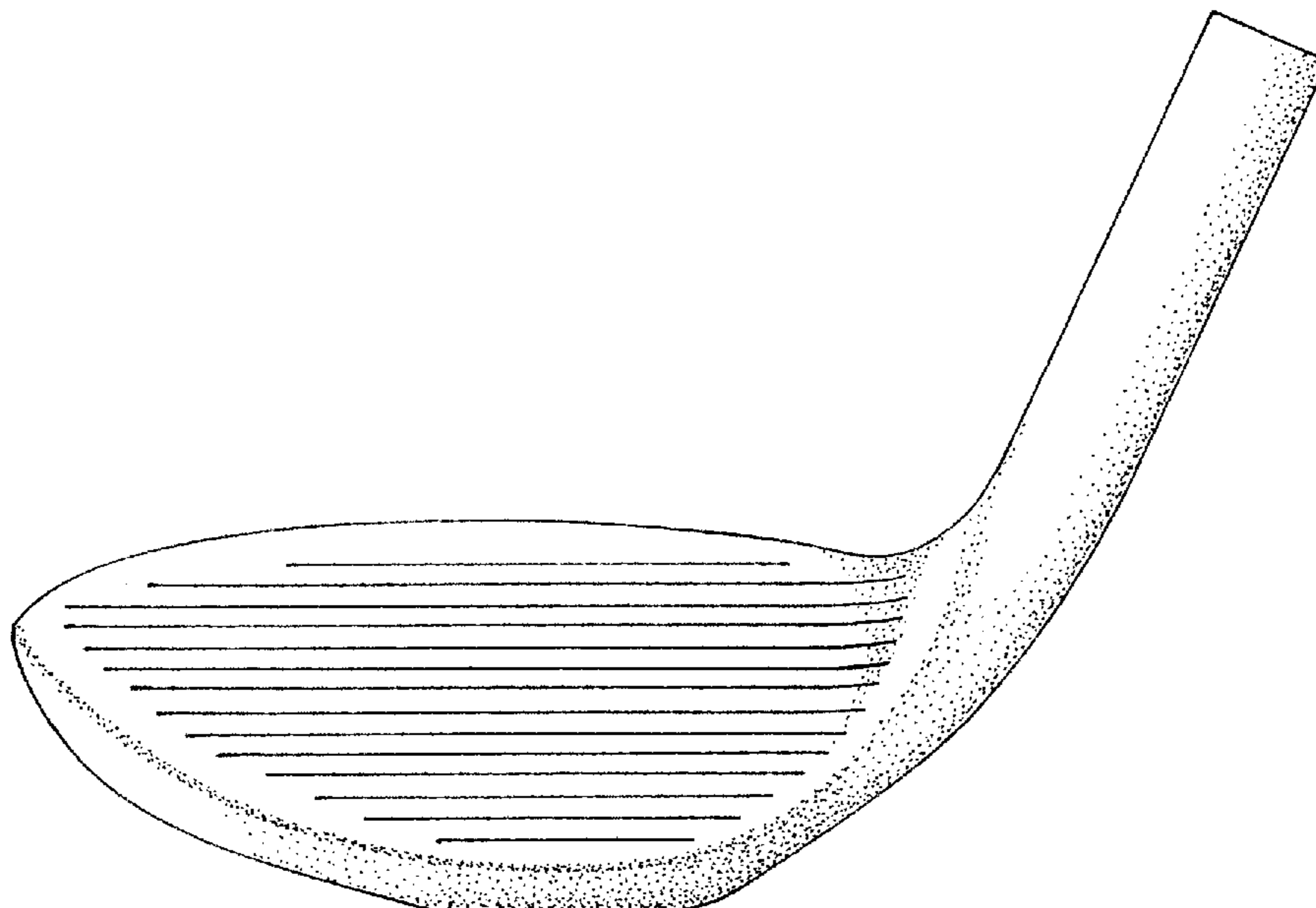
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a golf club head, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a new design for a club head;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view;
FIG. 3 is a top view;
FIG. 4 is a heel end elevational view;
FIG. 5 is a toe end elevational view;
FIG. 6 is a bottom view; and,
FIG. 7 is a bottom view of a second embodiment of the golf club head as disclosed in FIG. 1.
The undisclosed sides of the second embodiment are identical to that disclosed in the first embodiment.

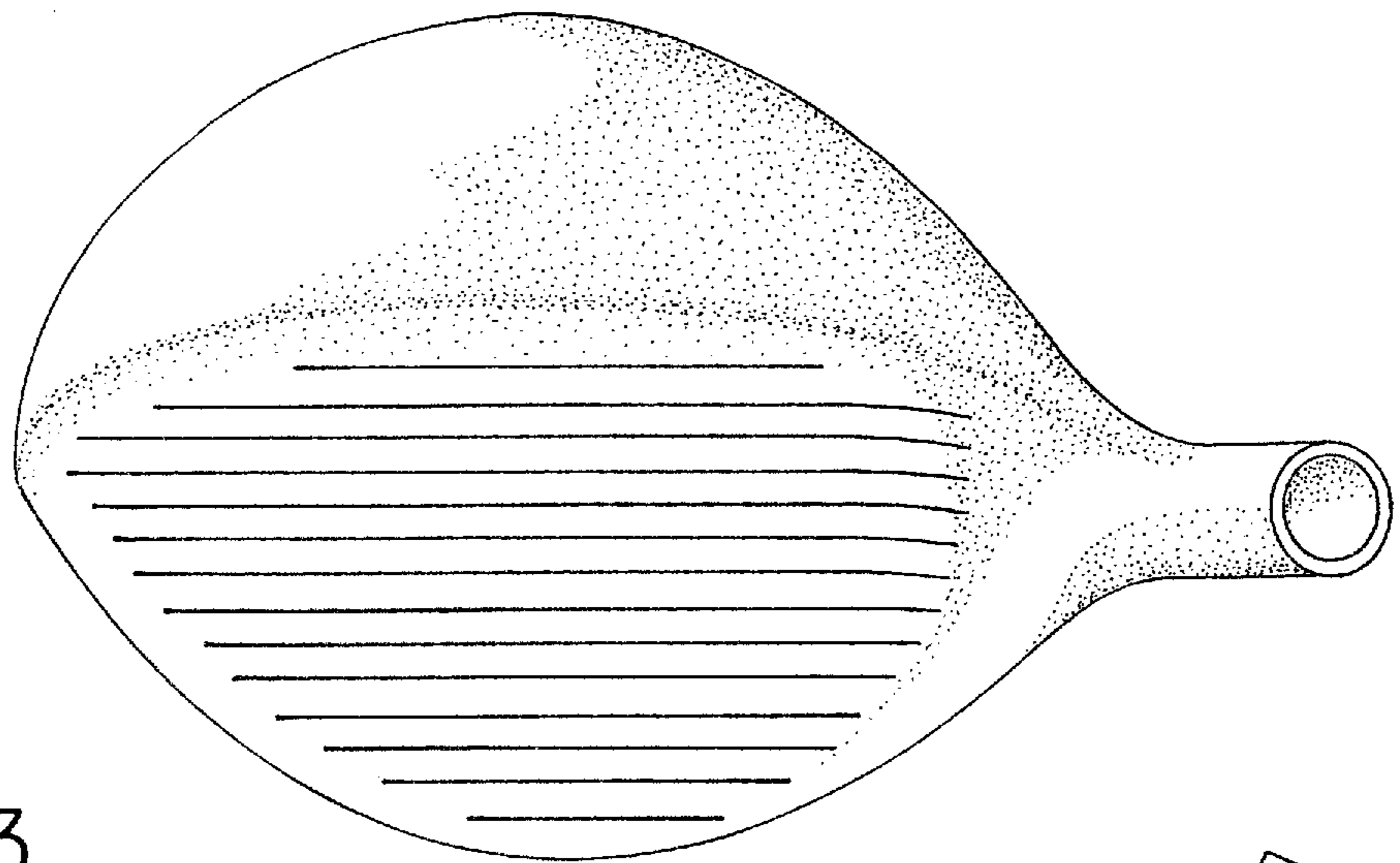

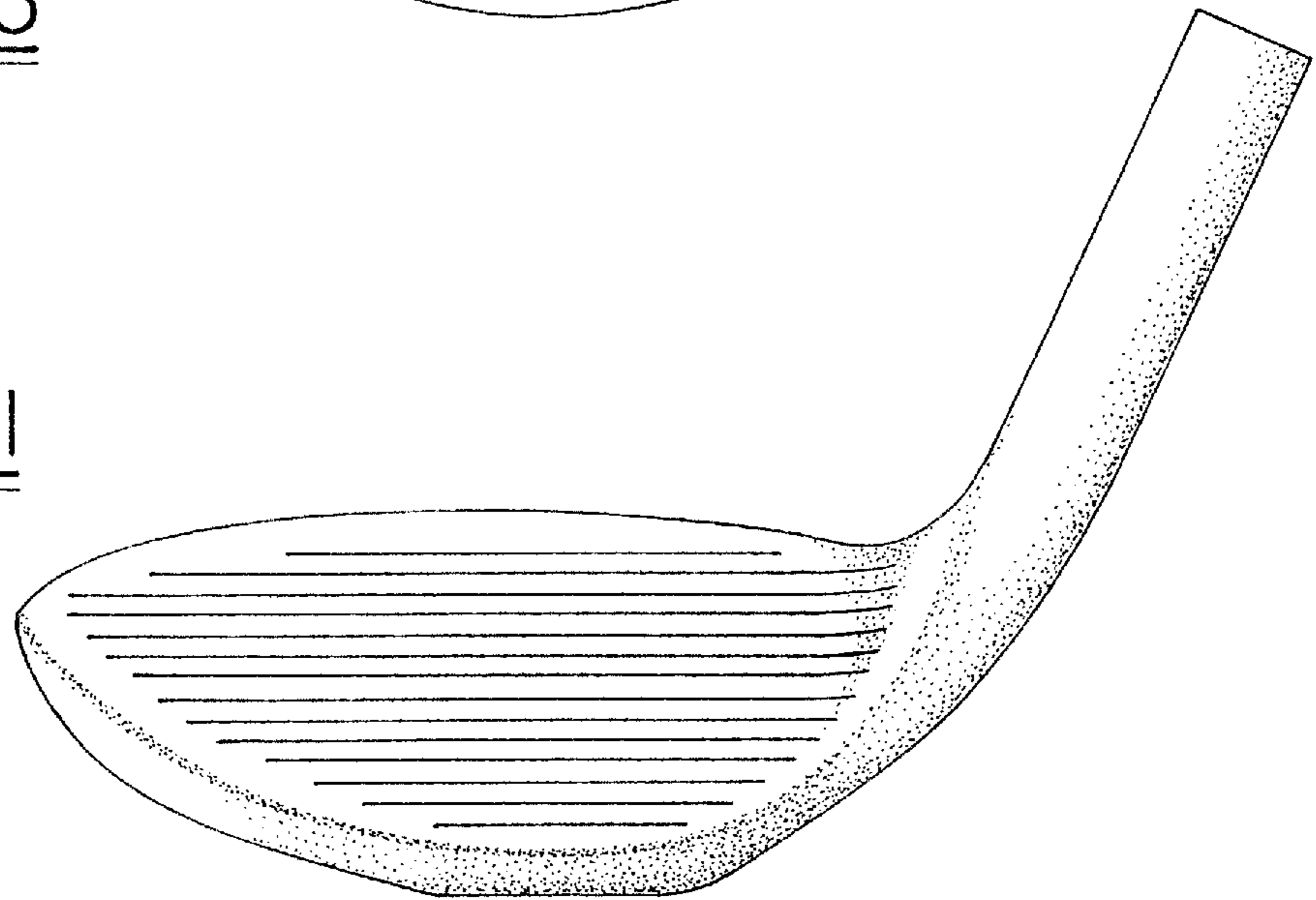

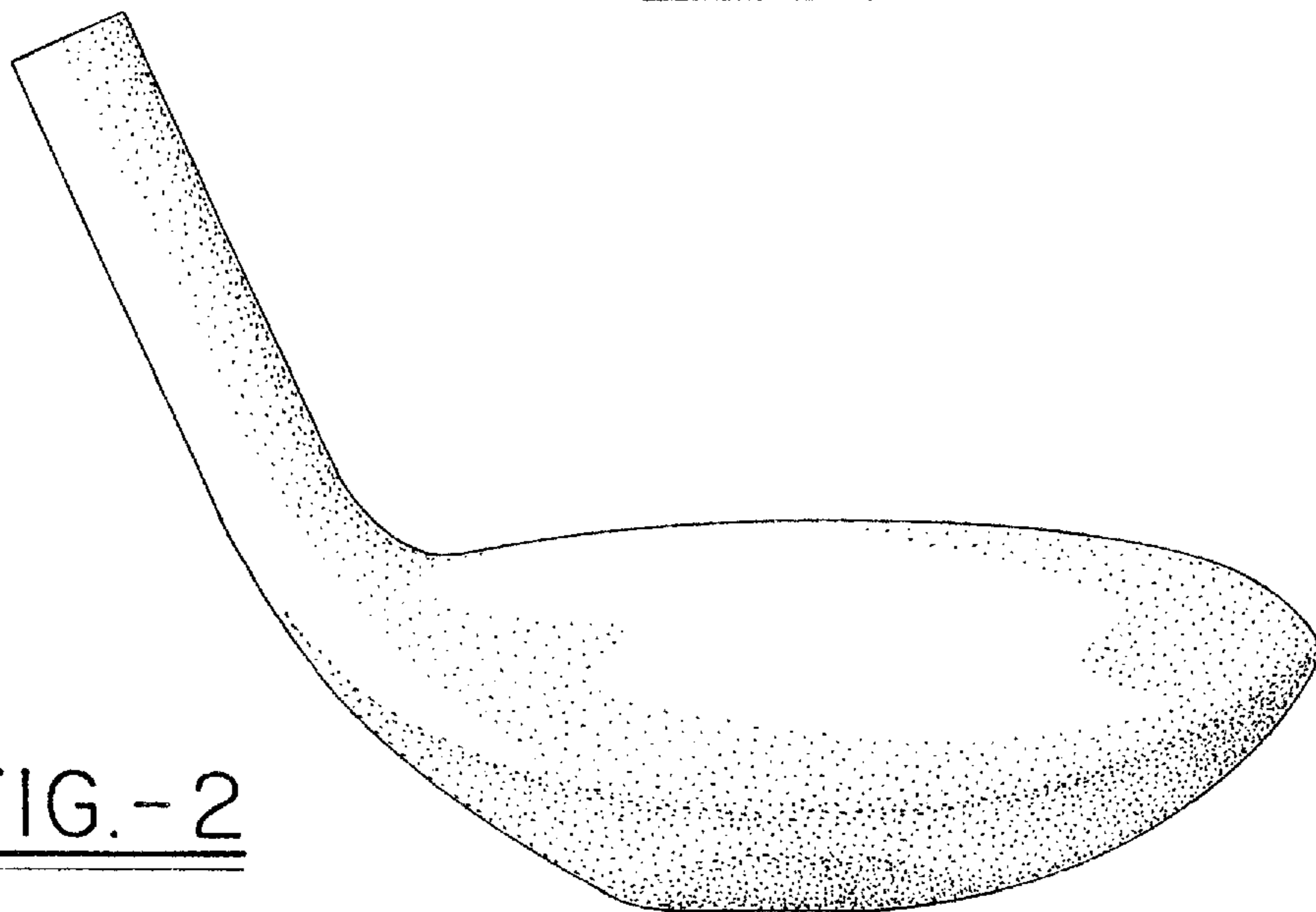

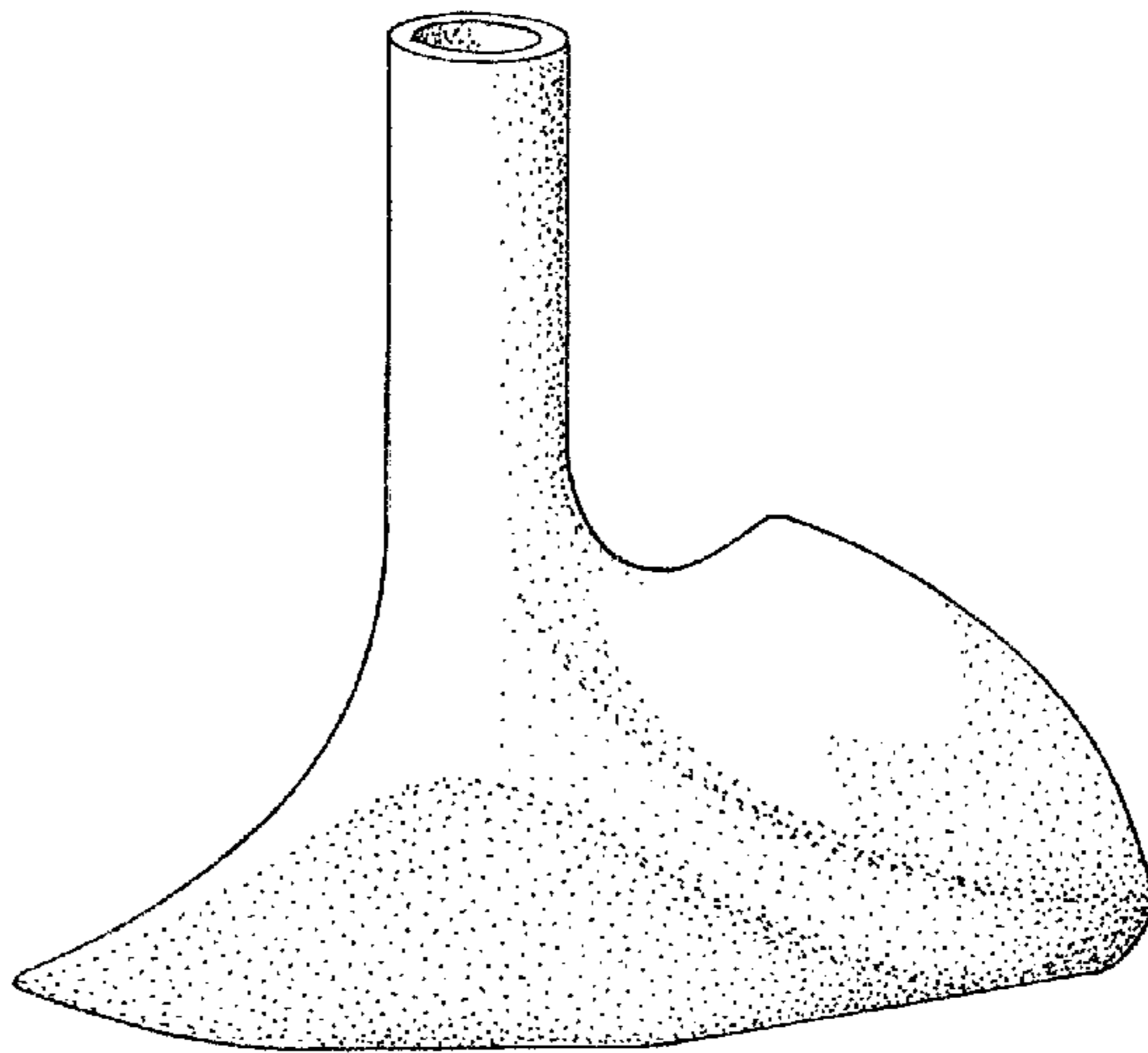

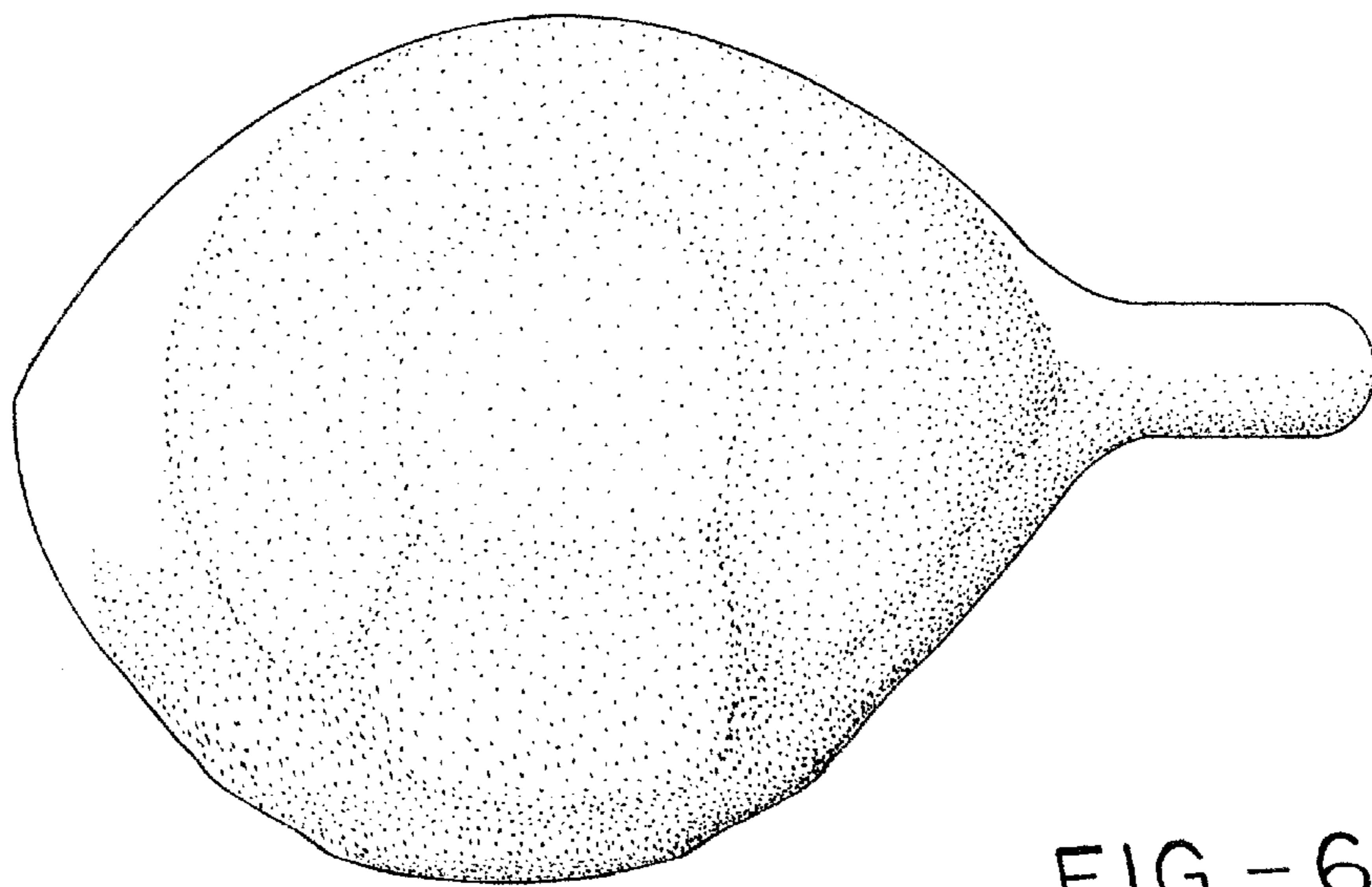
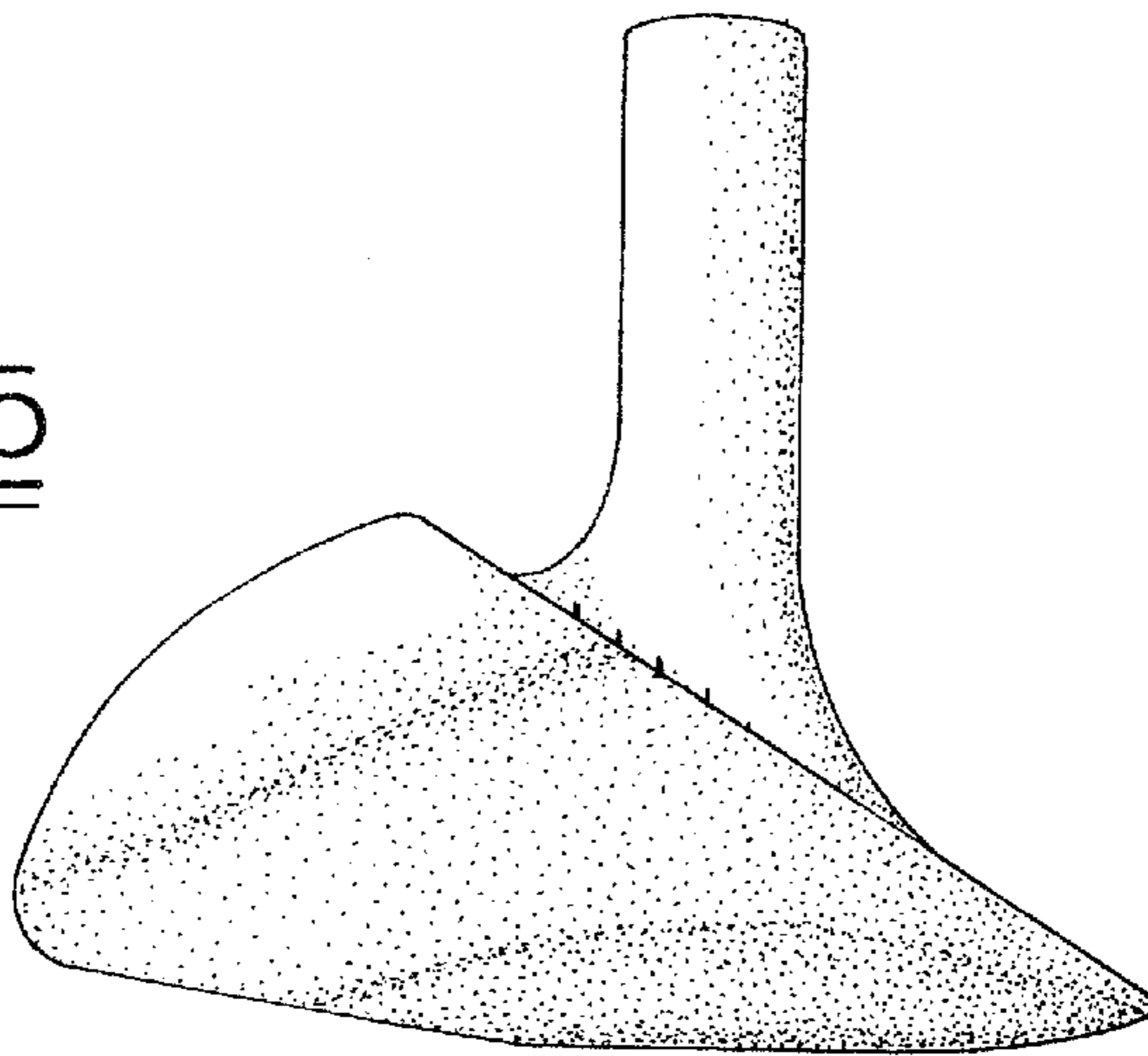

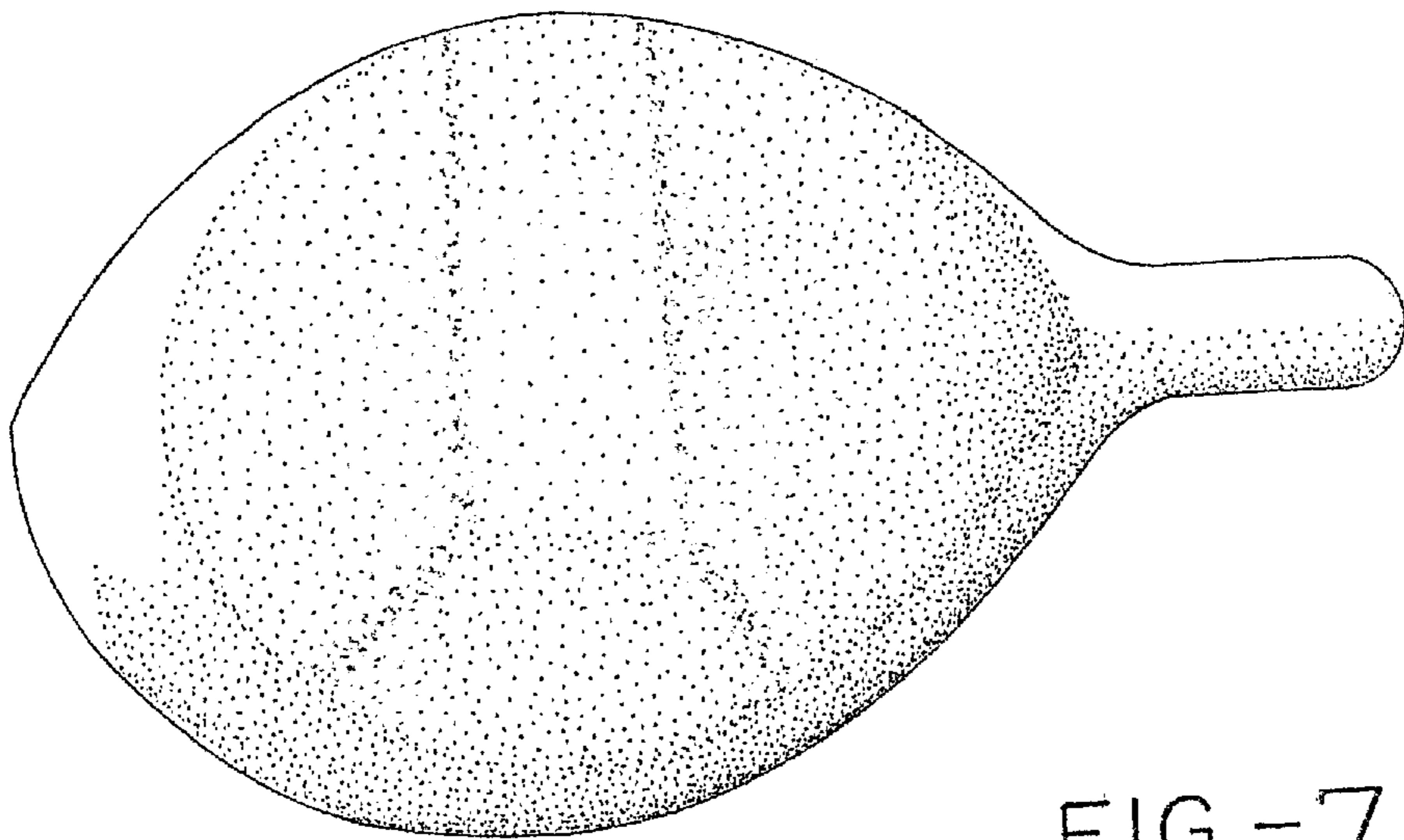
