[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a golf ball holder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a golf ball holder showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the golf ball holder;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the golf ball holder;

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of the golf ball holder;

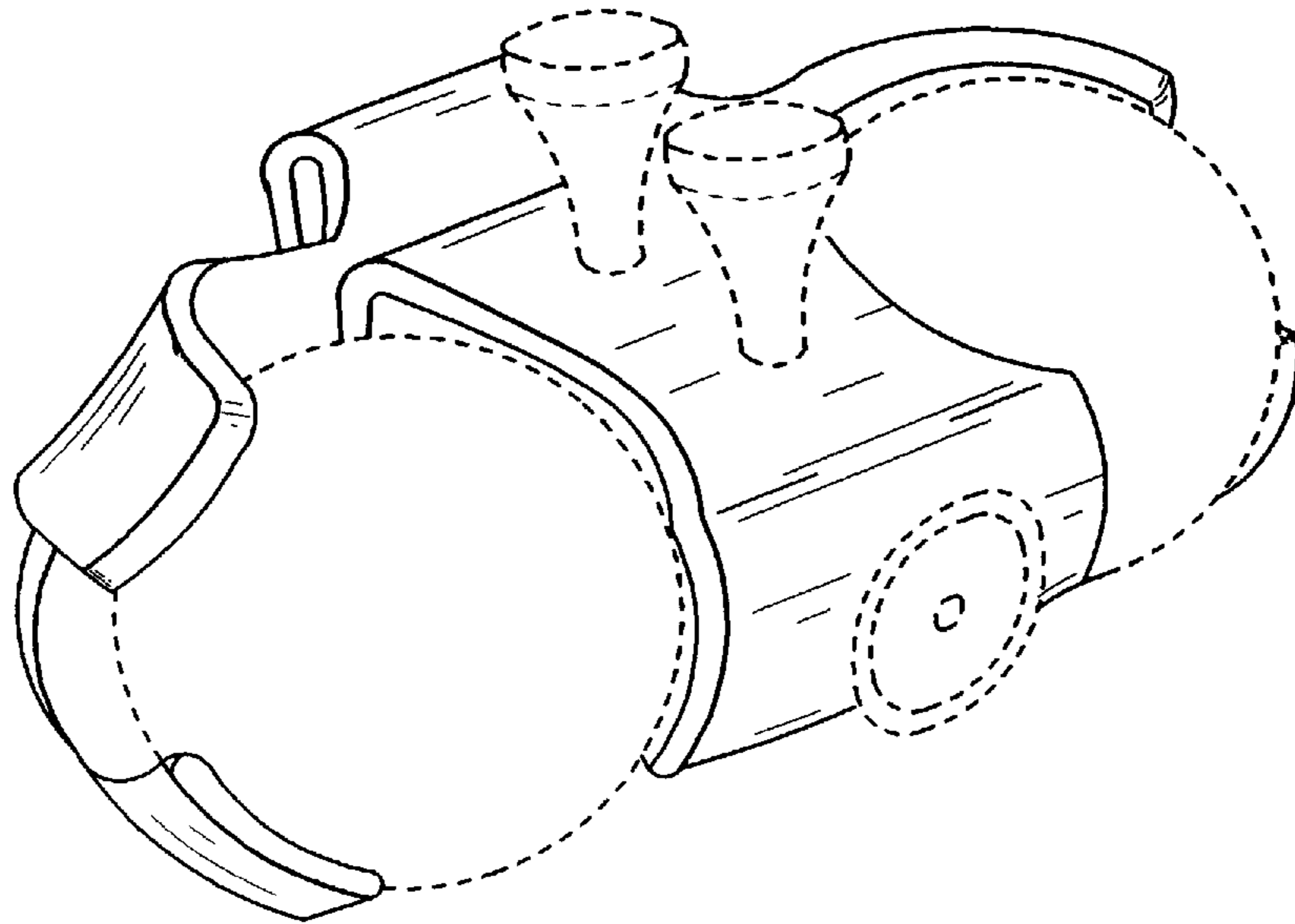
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view of the golf ball holder;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view of the golf ball holder; and,

FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view of the golf ball holder.

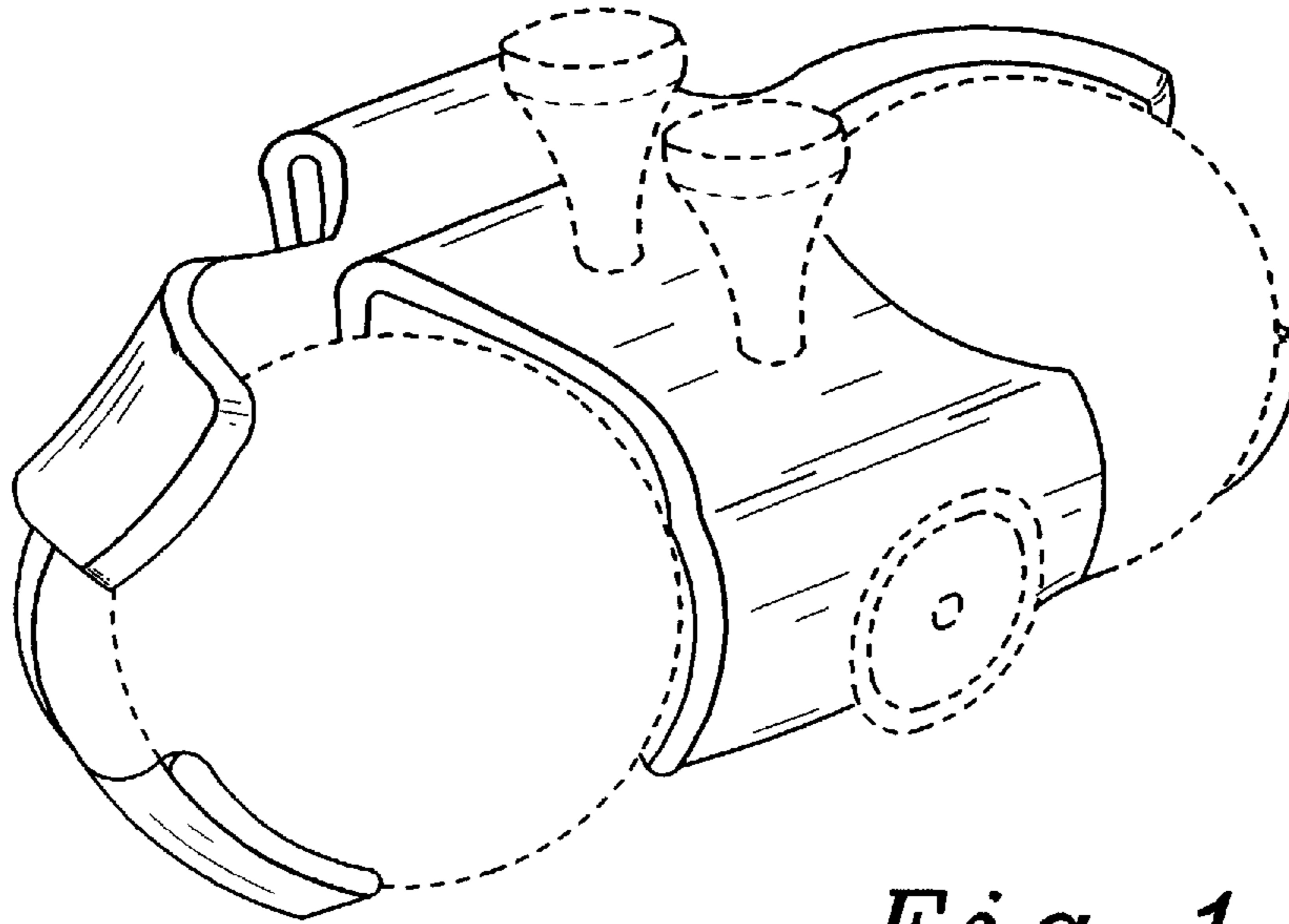

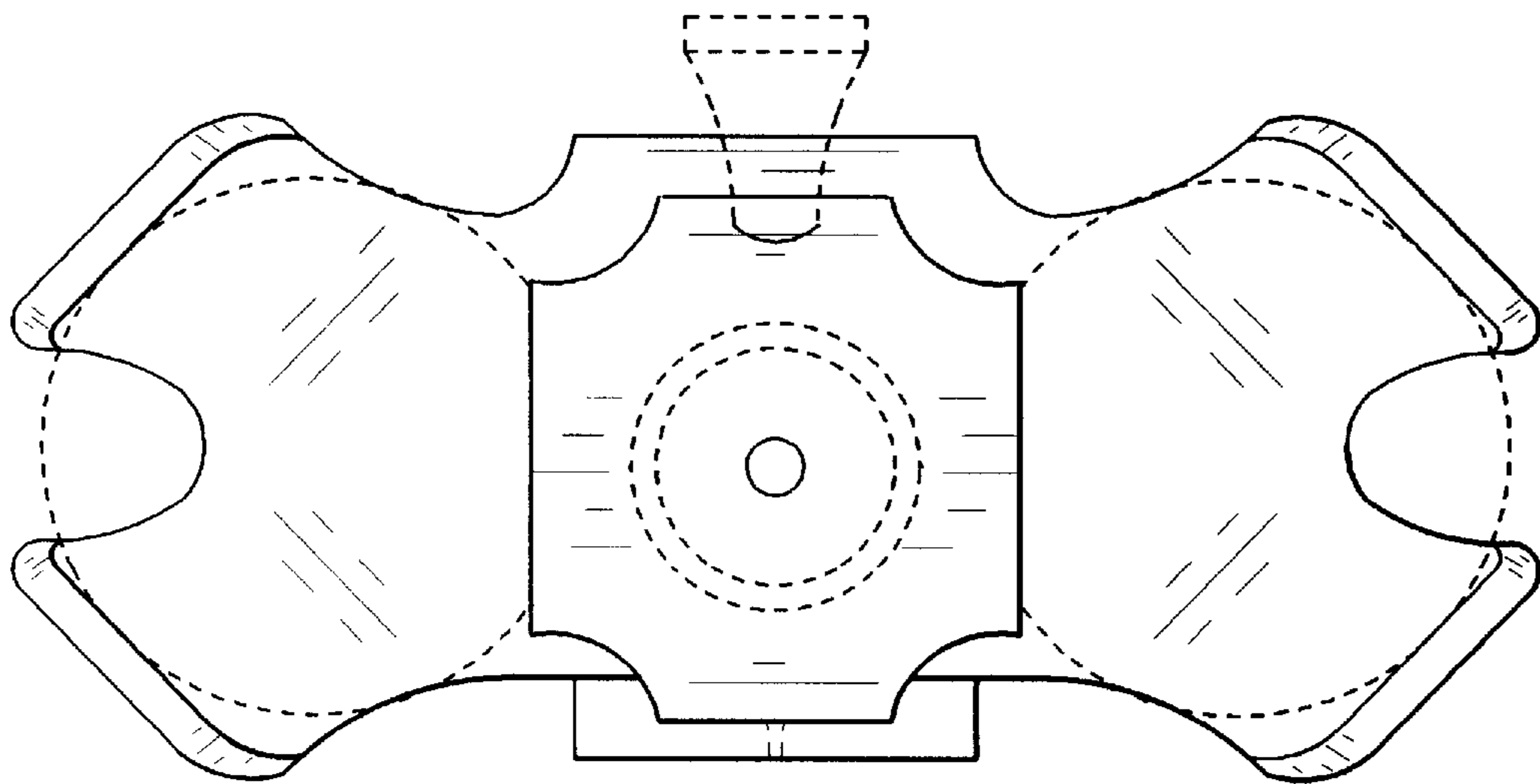

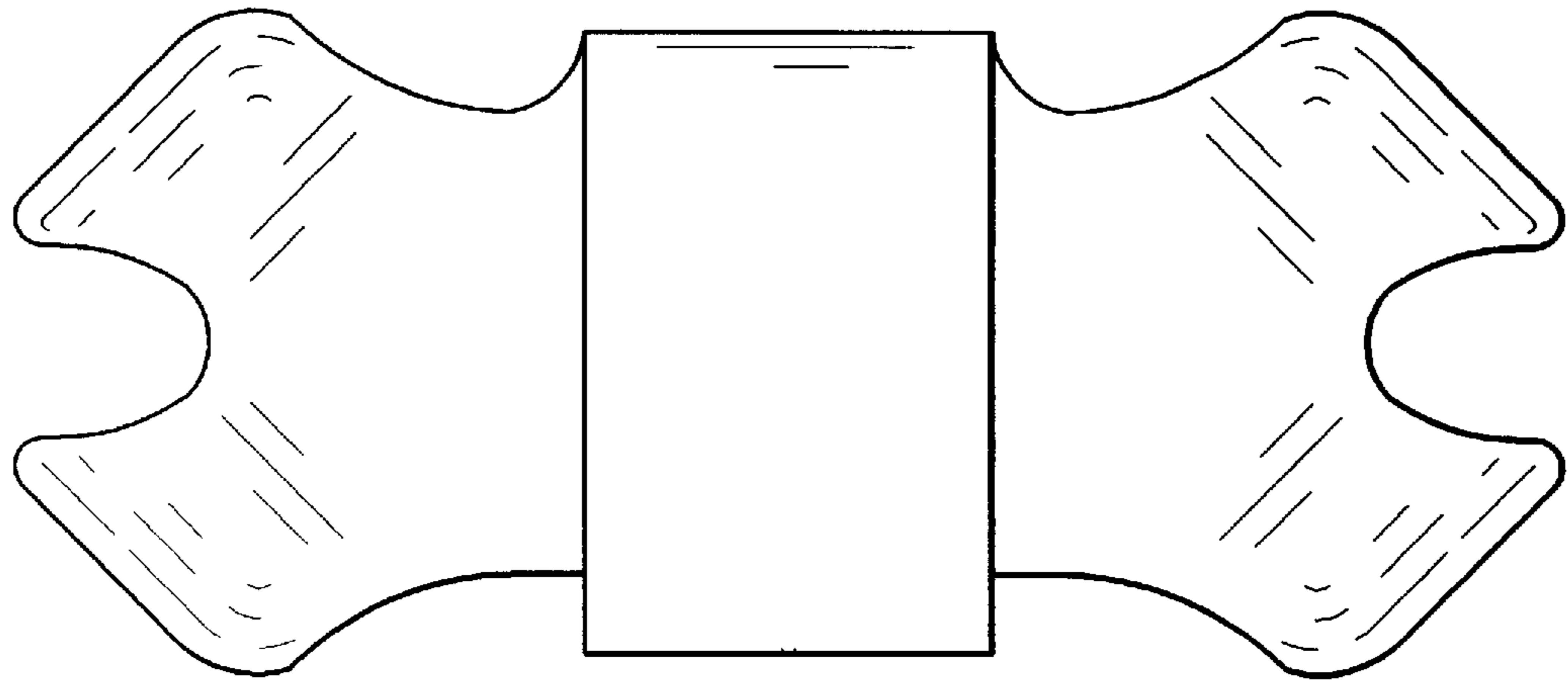

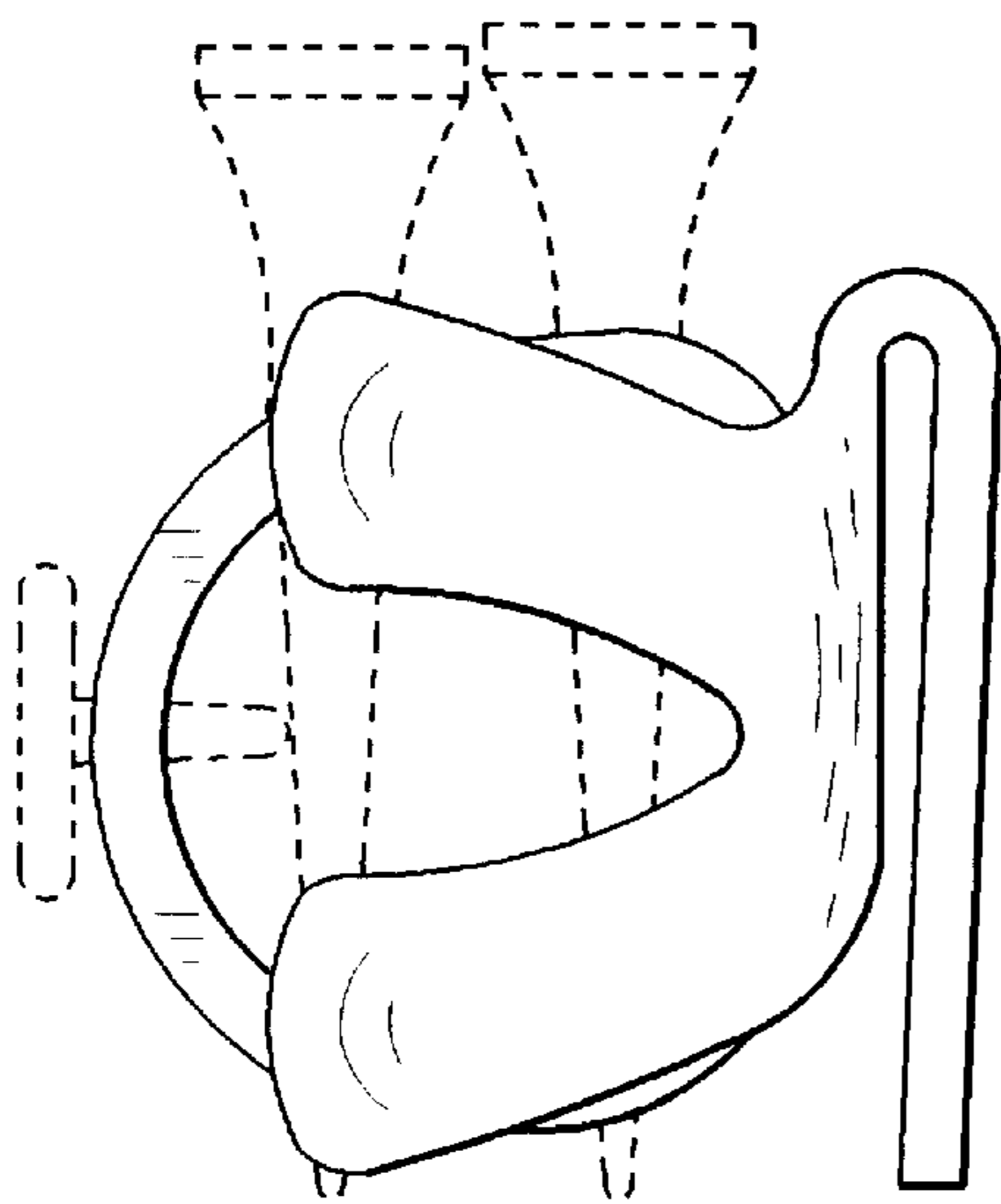

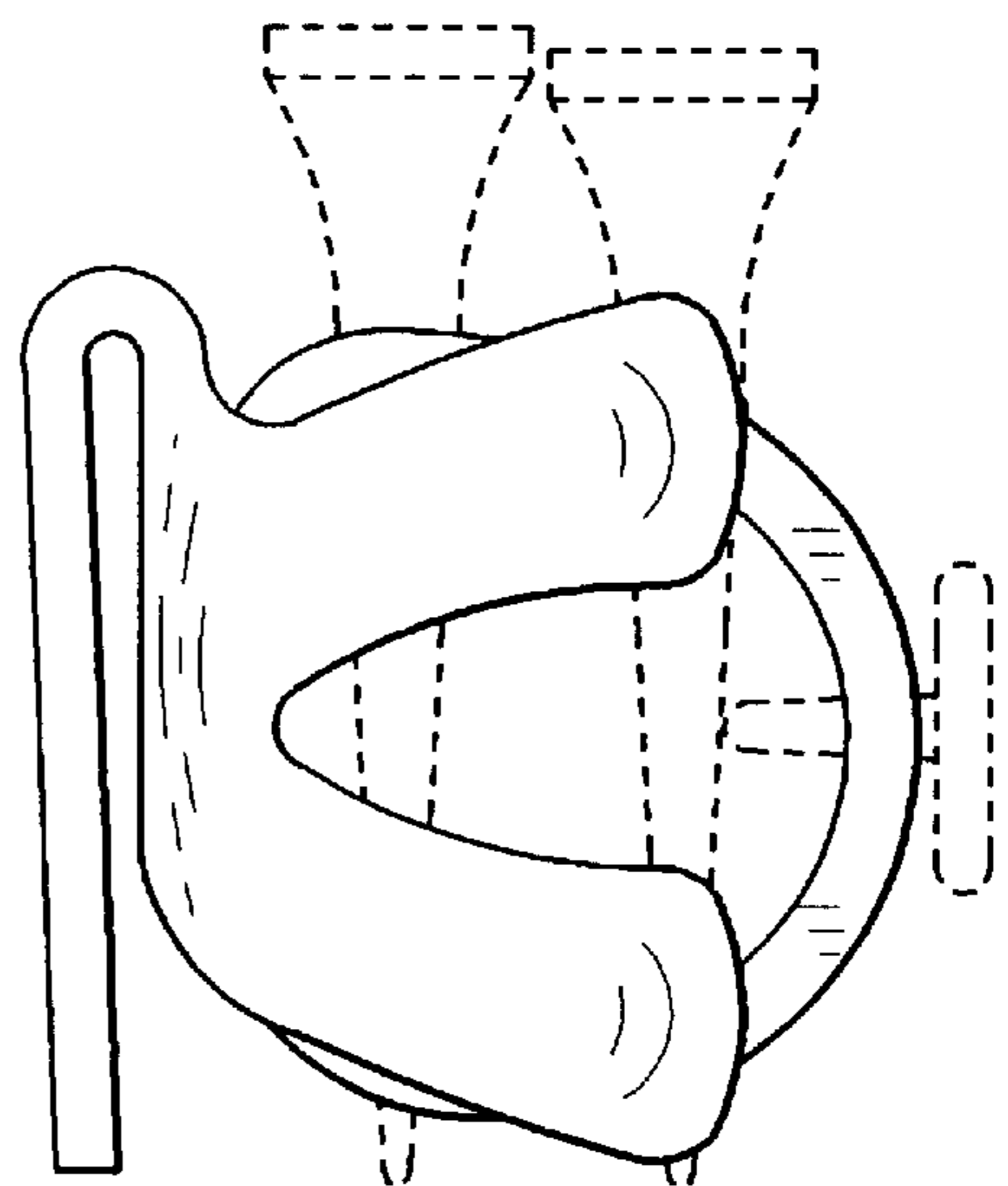

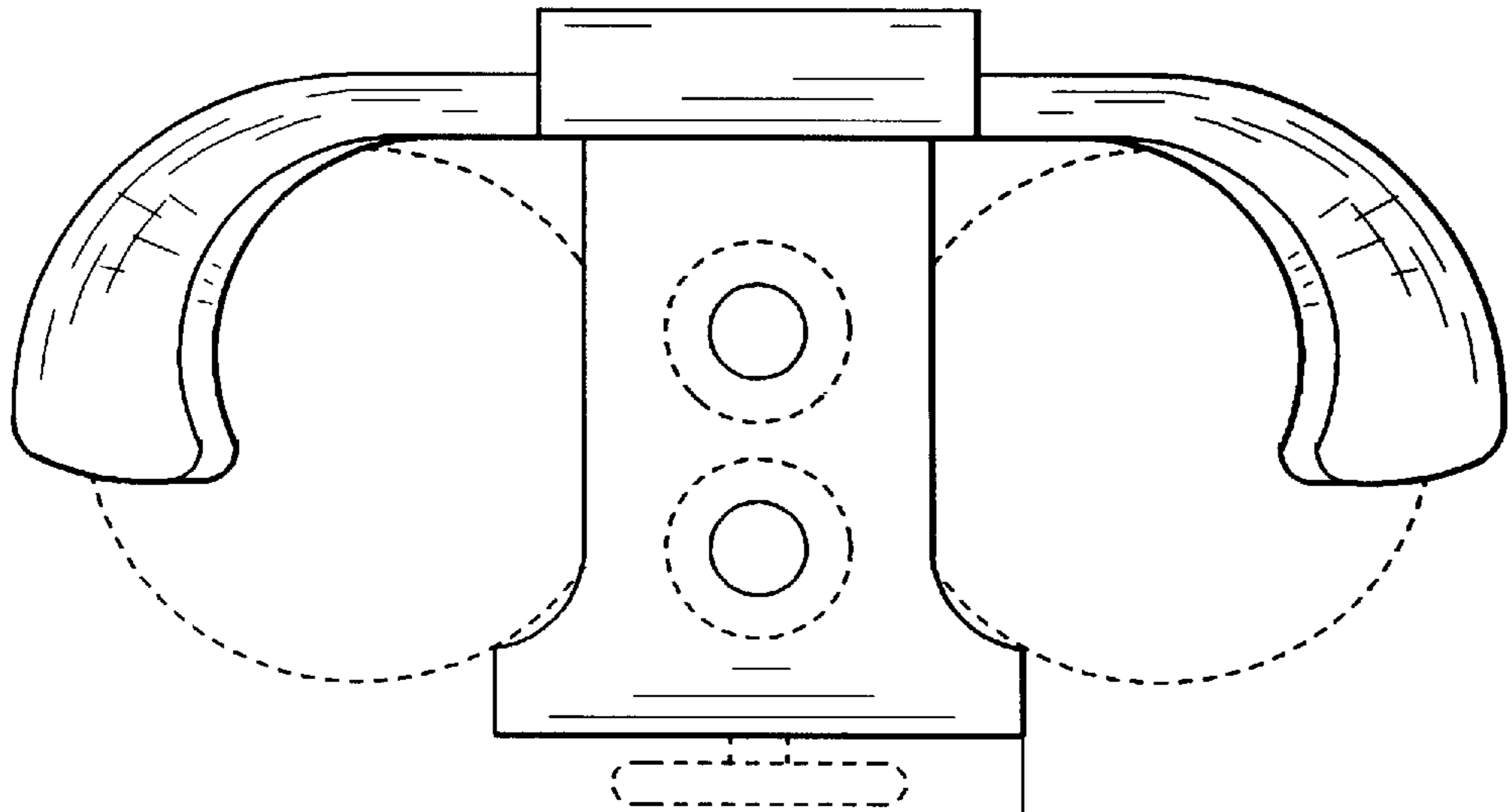

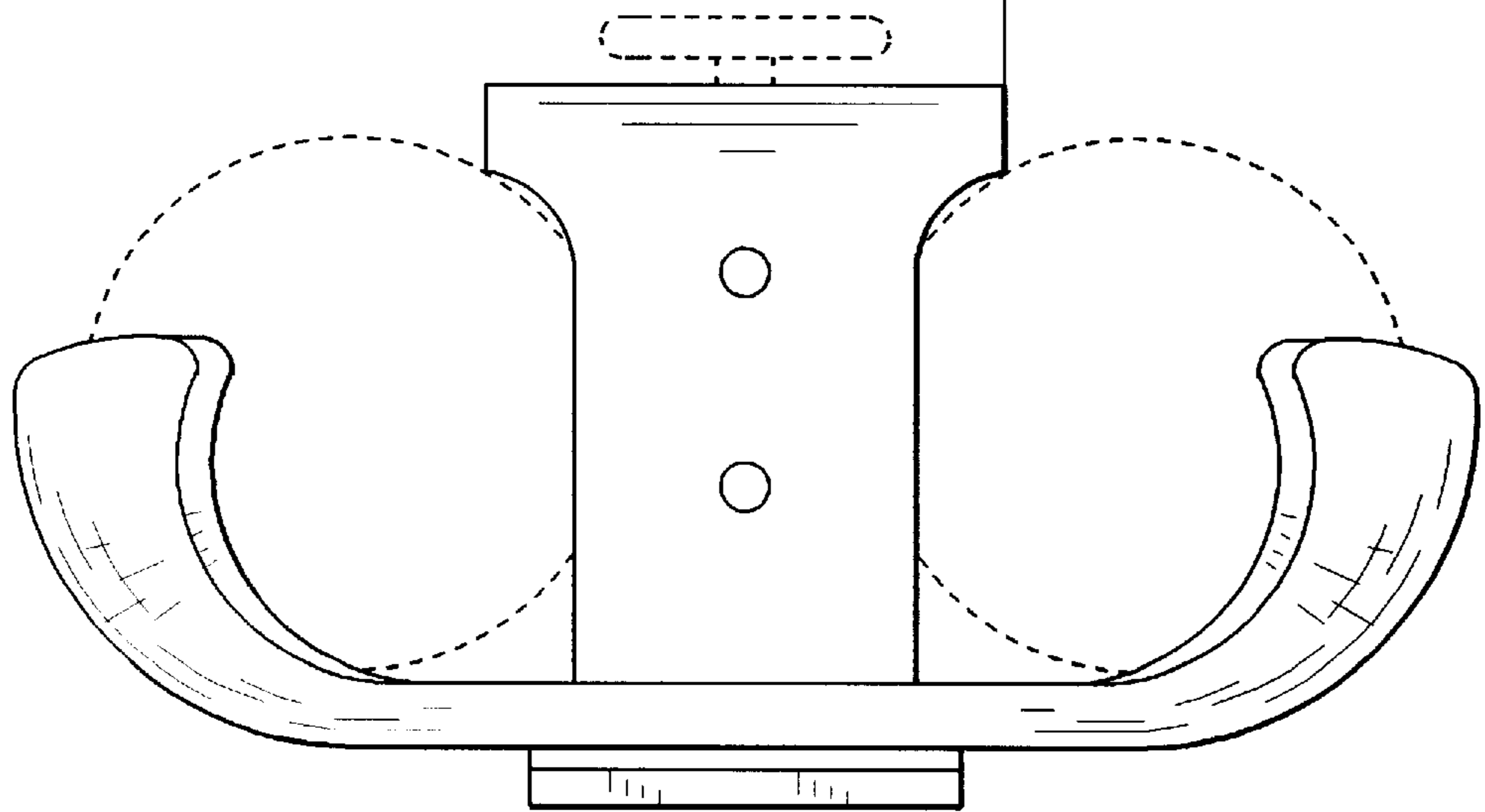
