FIG. 1 is a right side perspective view of a combined desk and hutch, showing my new design;

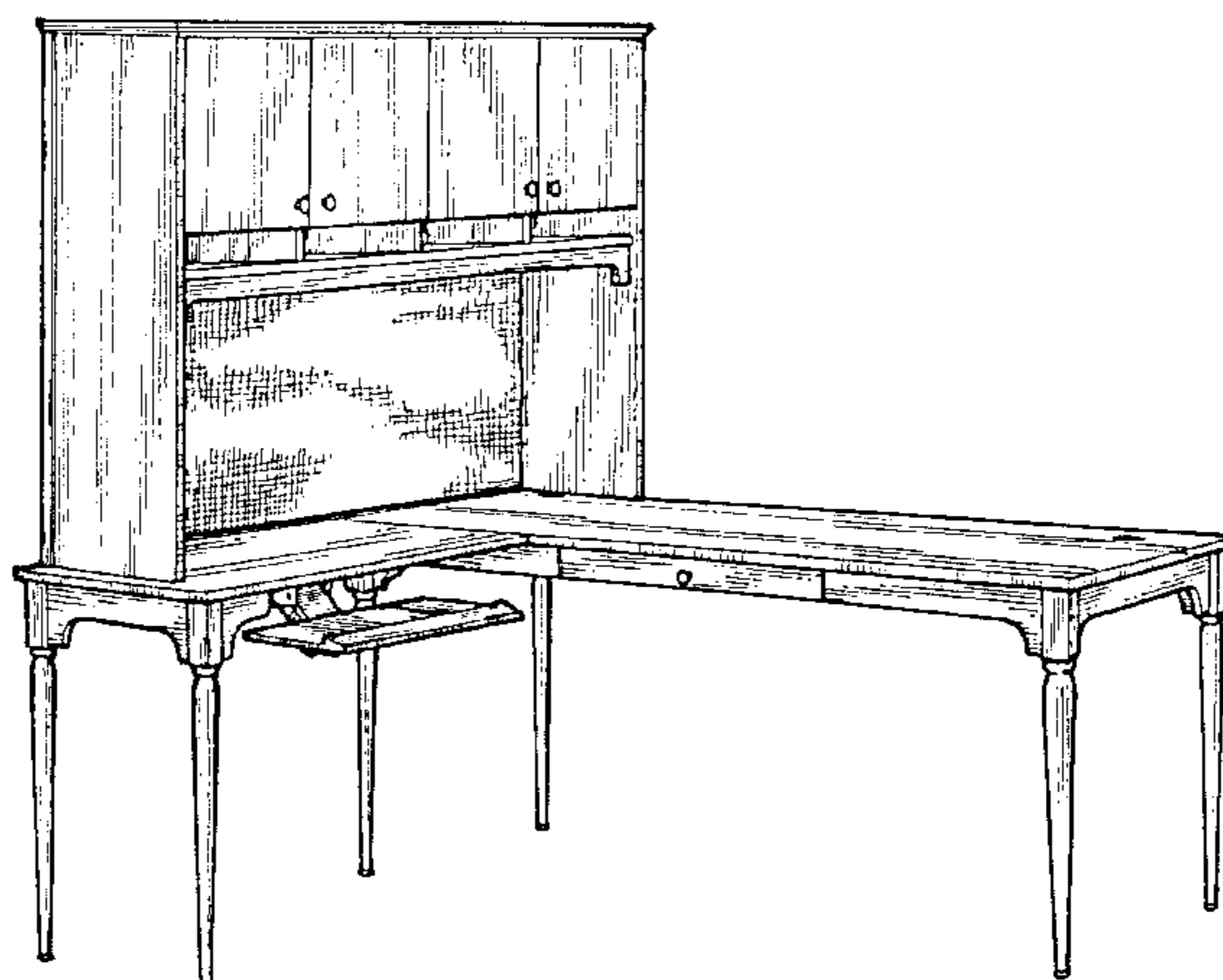
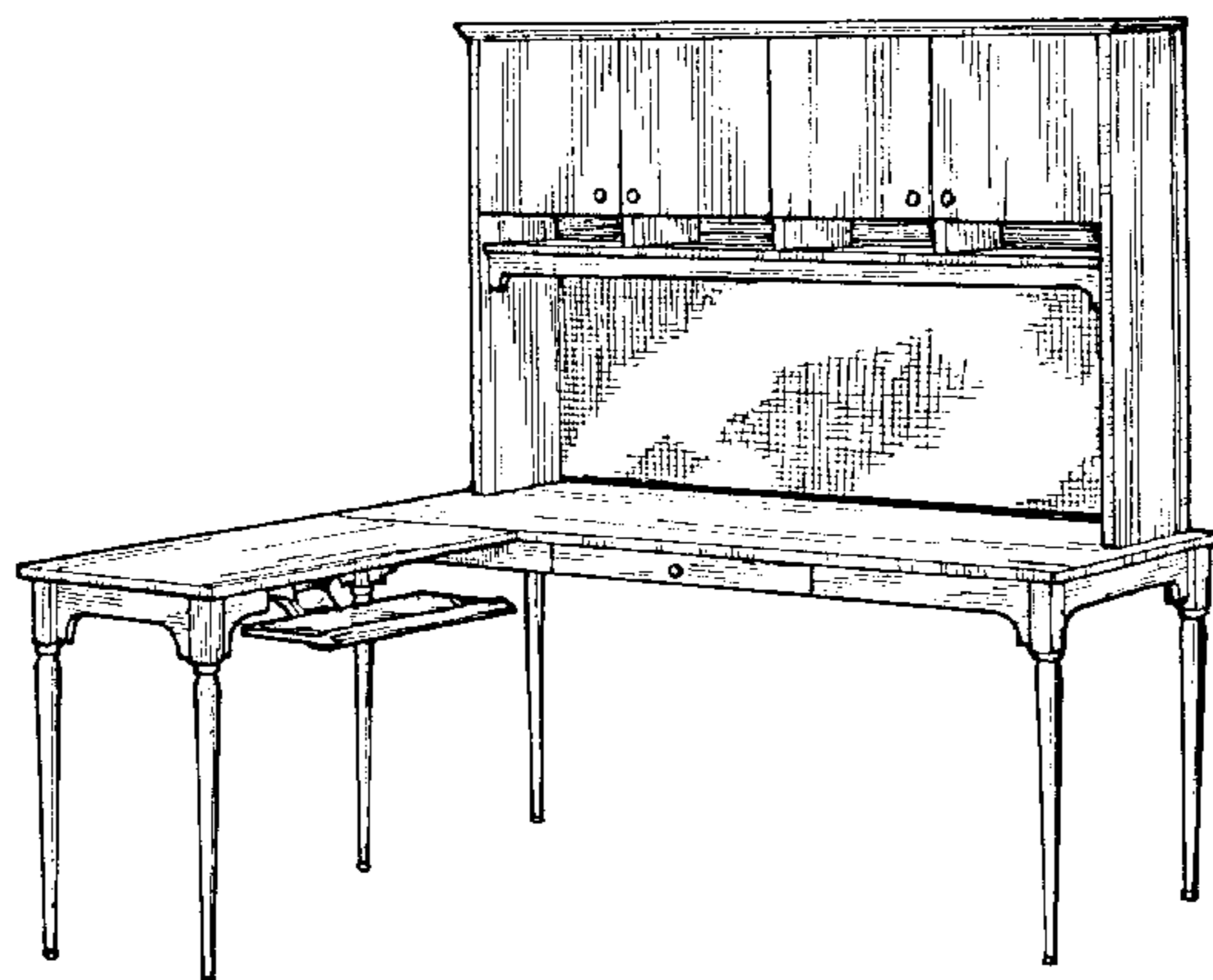
FIG. 2 is a right side perspective view, with the hutch in an alternate position of use;

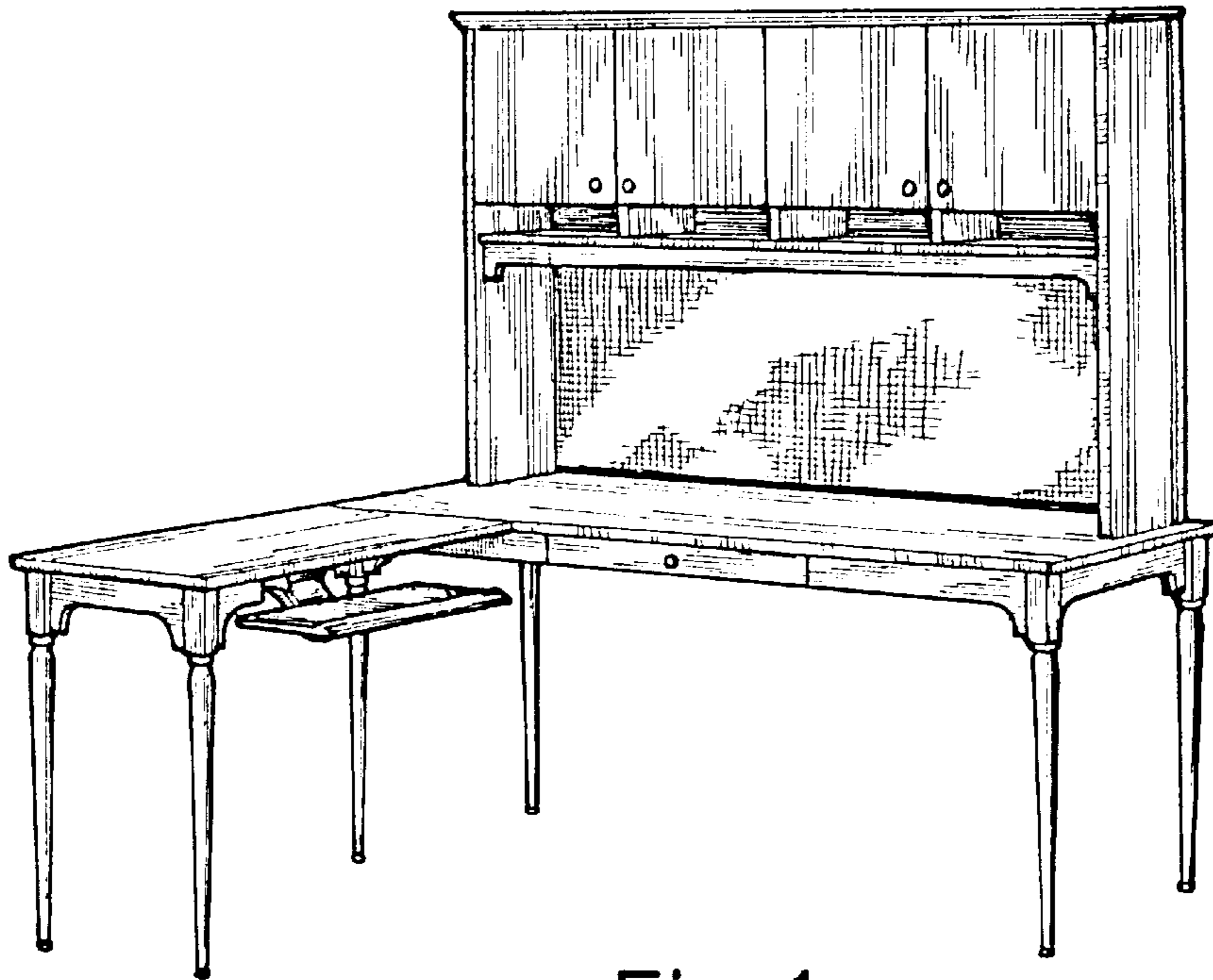

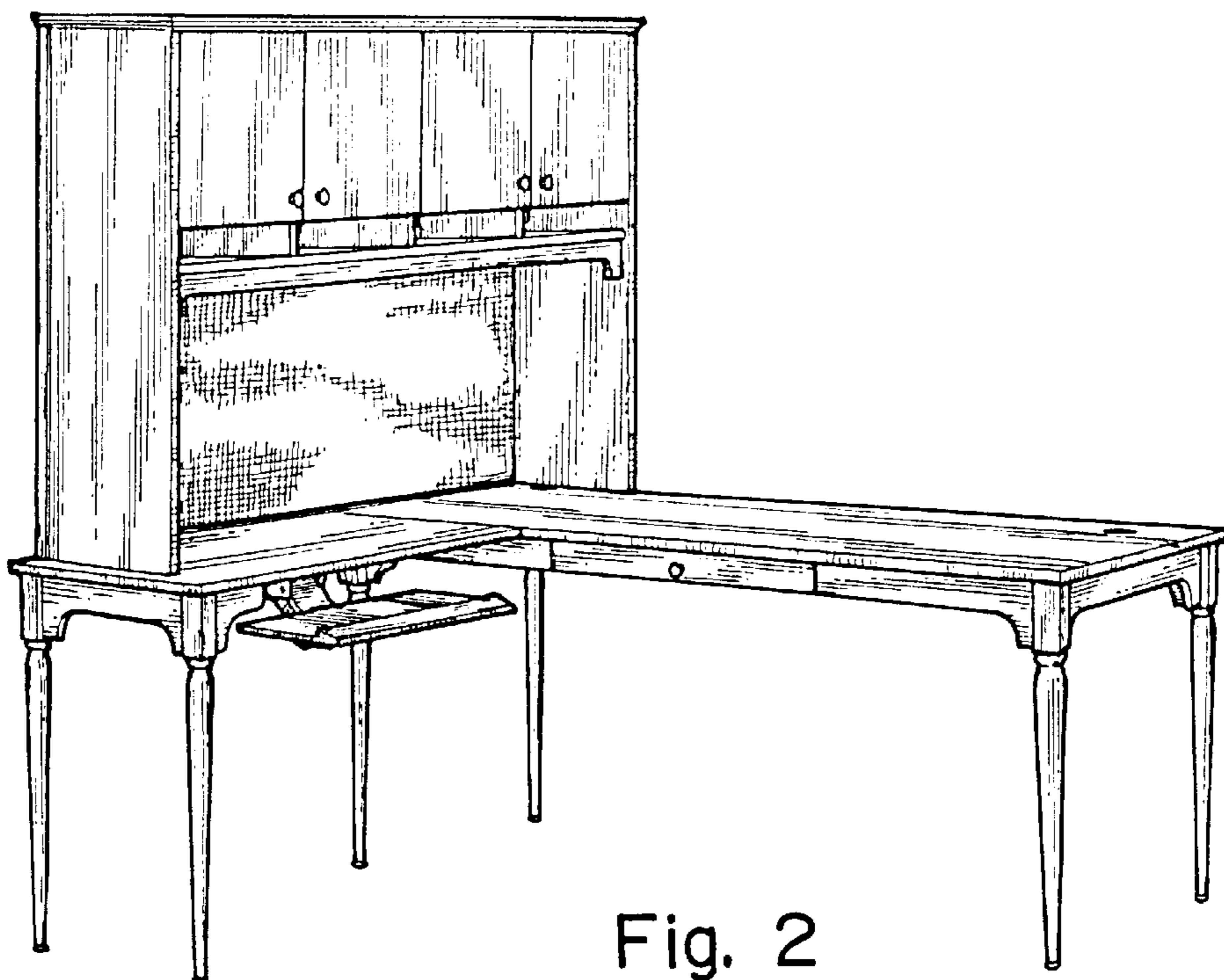

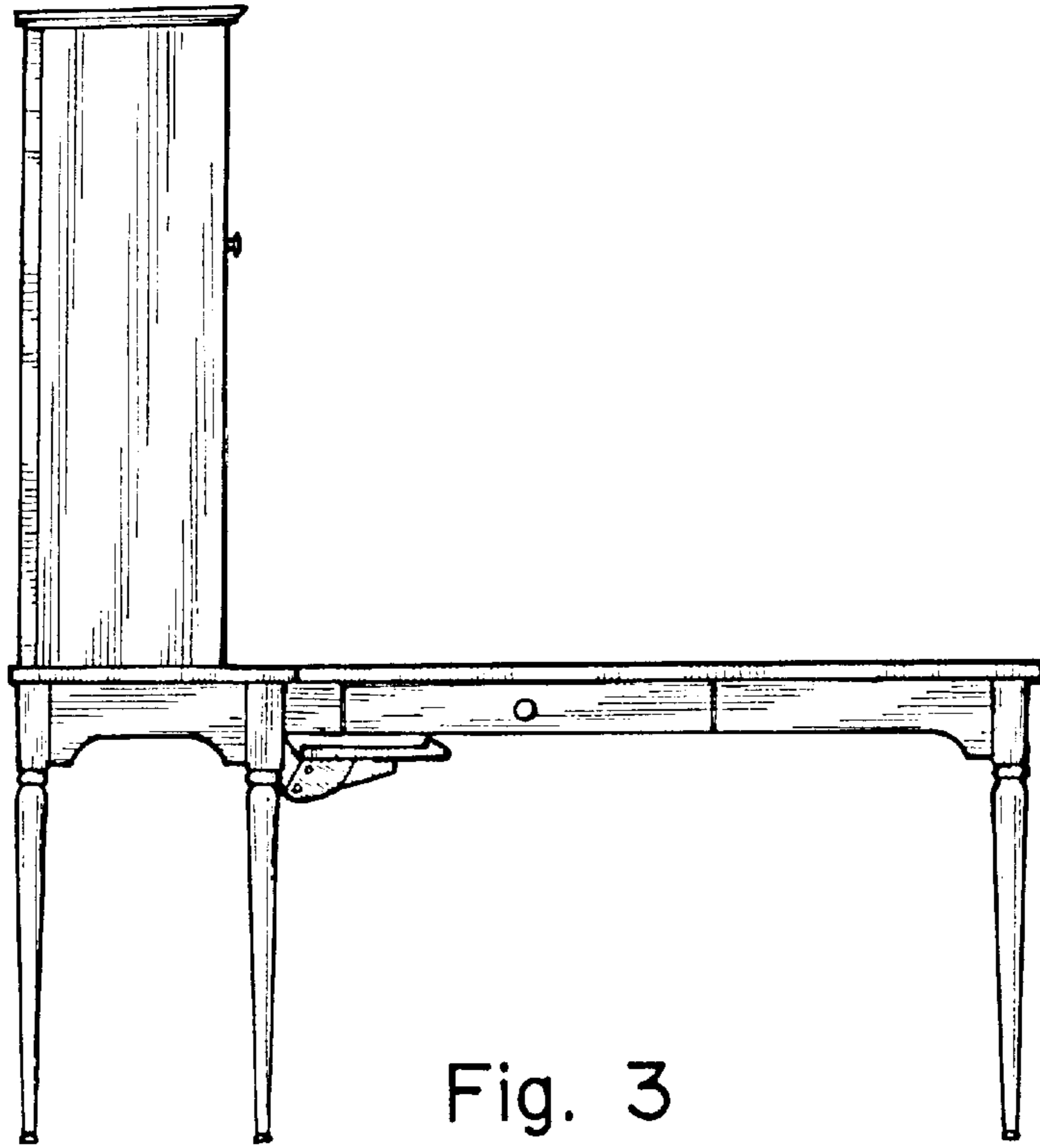

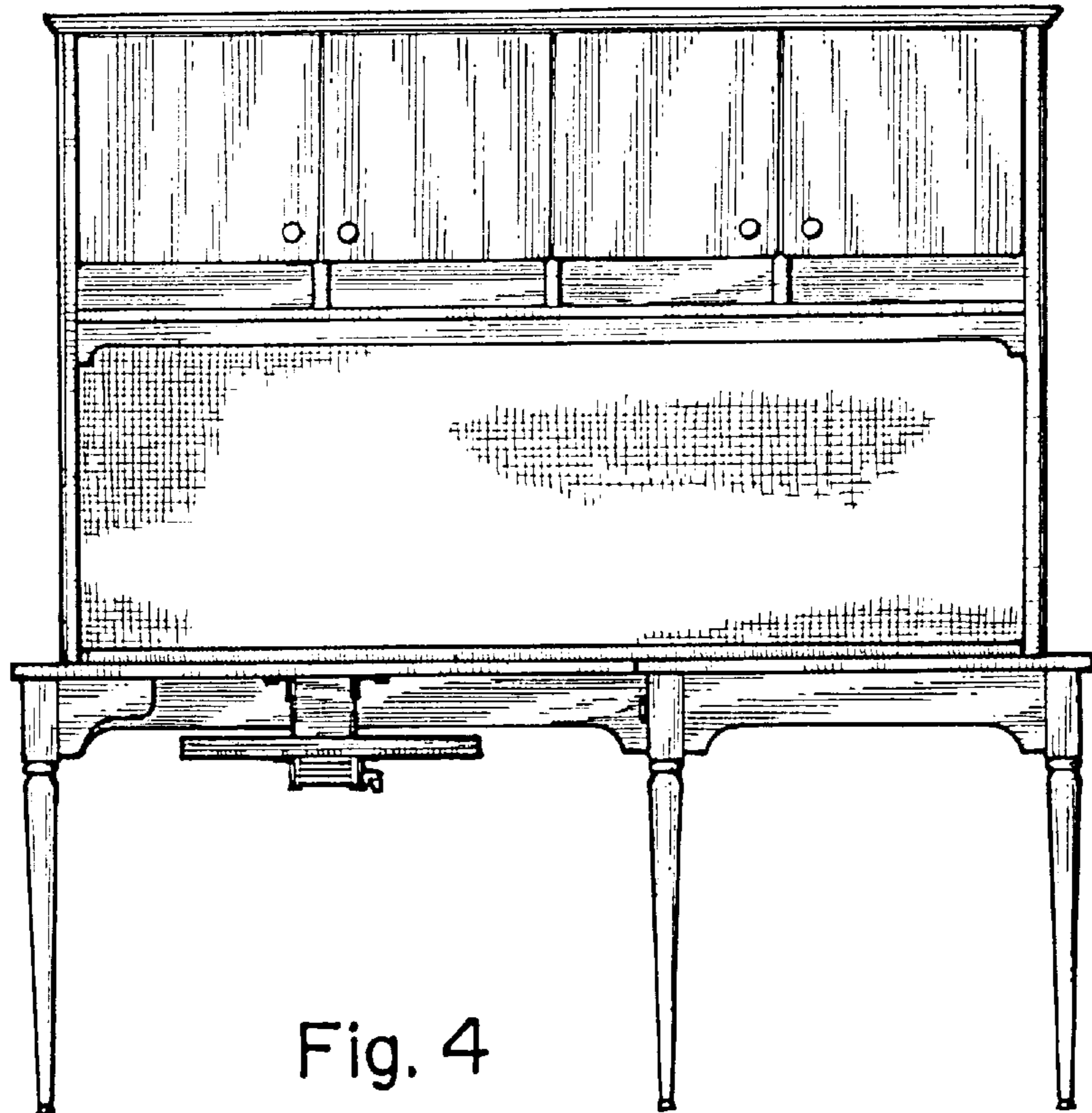

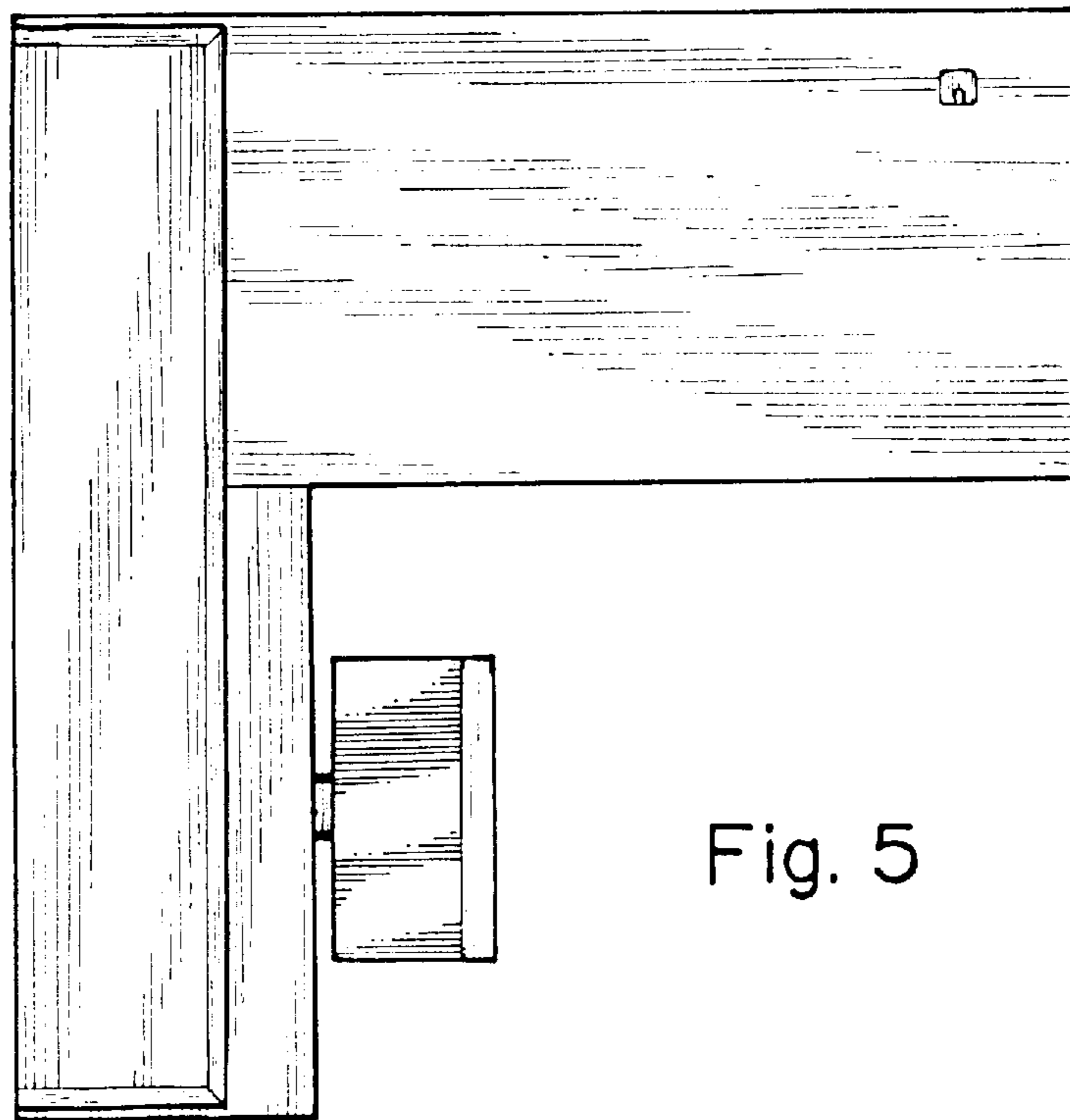
