The ornamental design for a container shoulder wall, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a container shoulder wall showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top view of the container shoulder wall in accordance with my new design; and,
FIG. 3 is a fragmentary cross-sectional view taken along the line 3—3 of FIG. 1.
The container shoulder wall of my invention is symmetrical so that all side views present the same appearance.
The broken lines showing a container top, a container side wall, and a container bottom are for the purpose of showing environmental structure only and form no part of my new design.

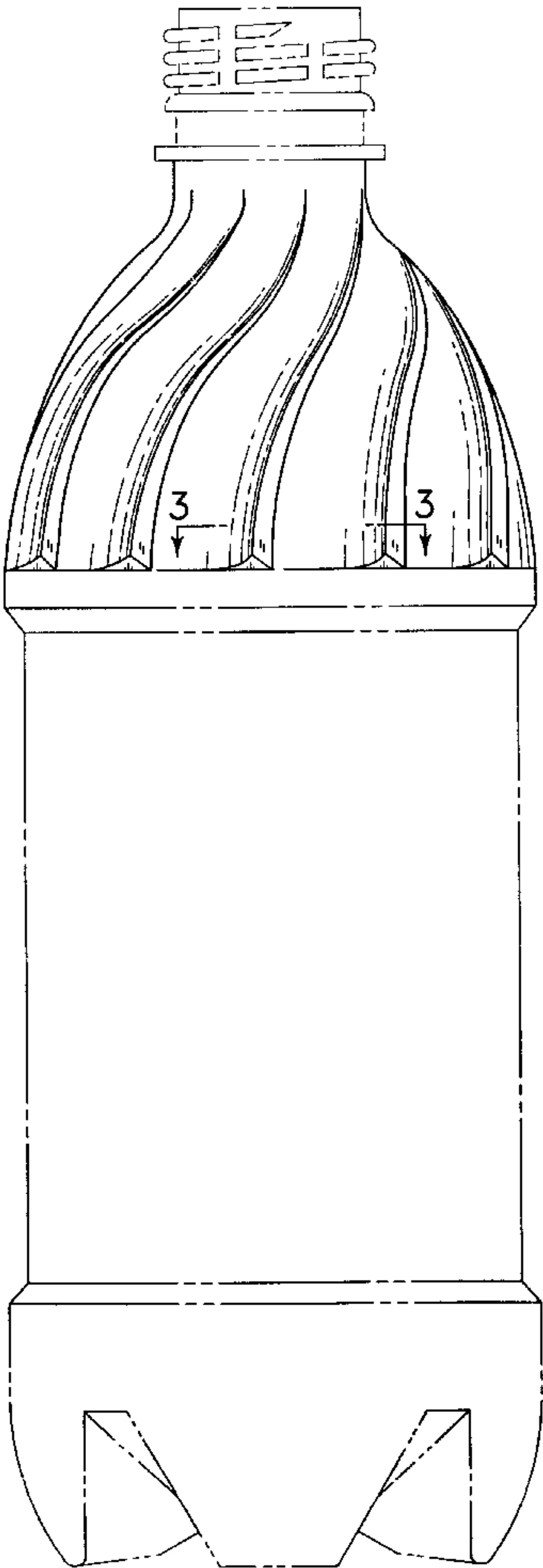

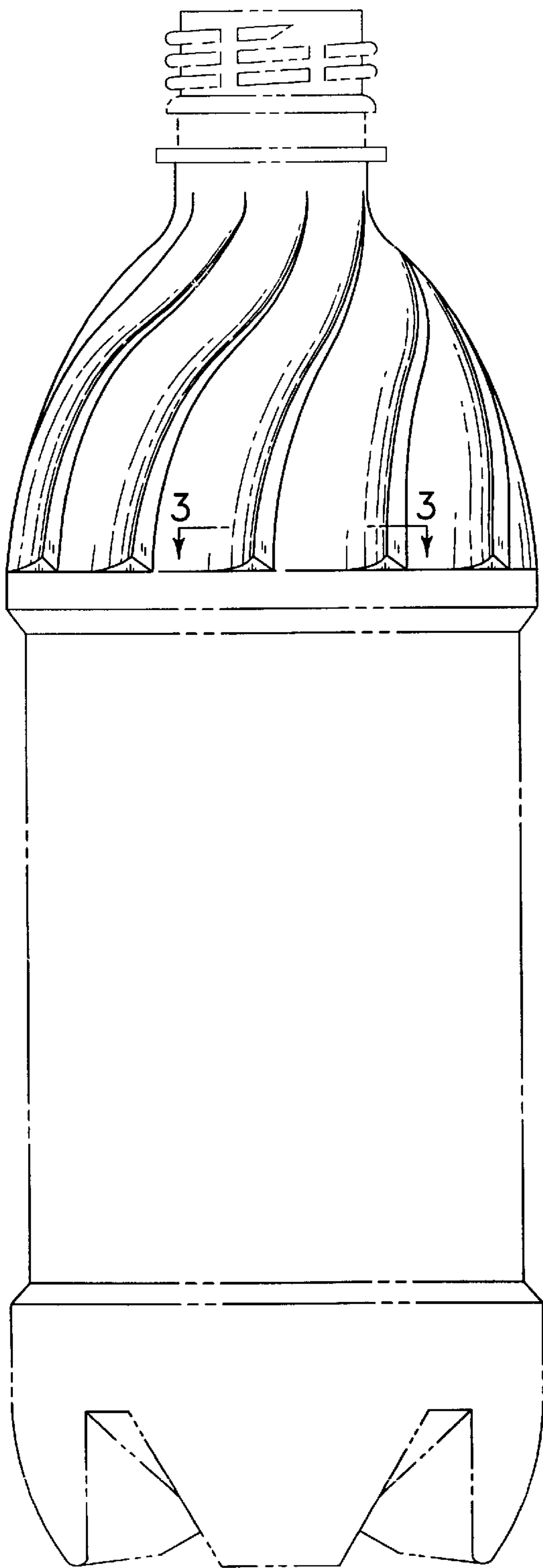

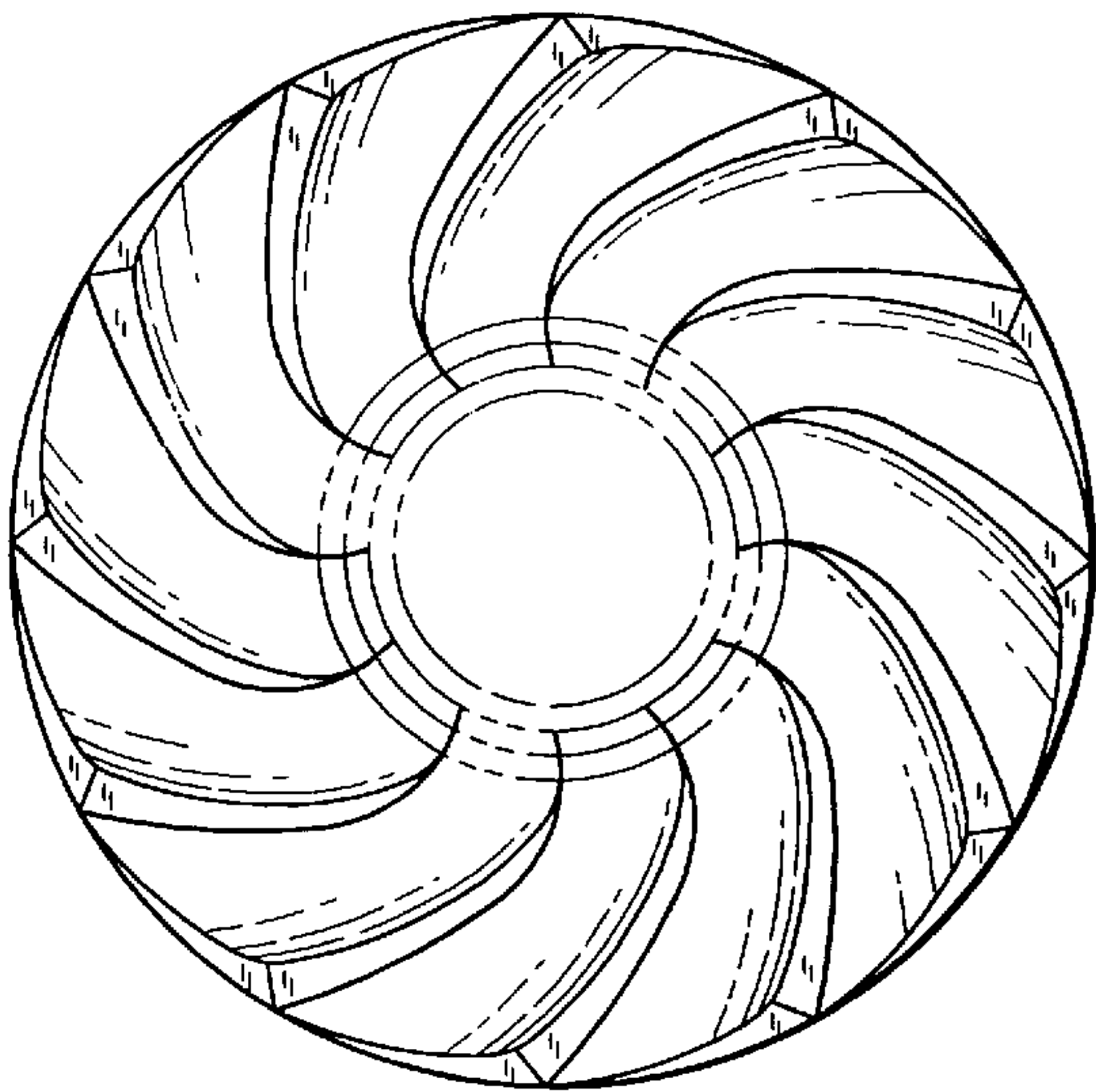
