DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the pet leash of the present invention;

FIG. 2 is a partial side elevational view taken along lines 2—2 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a partial side elevational view taken along lines 3—3 of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a partial right side elevational view taken along lines 4—4 of FIG. 1;

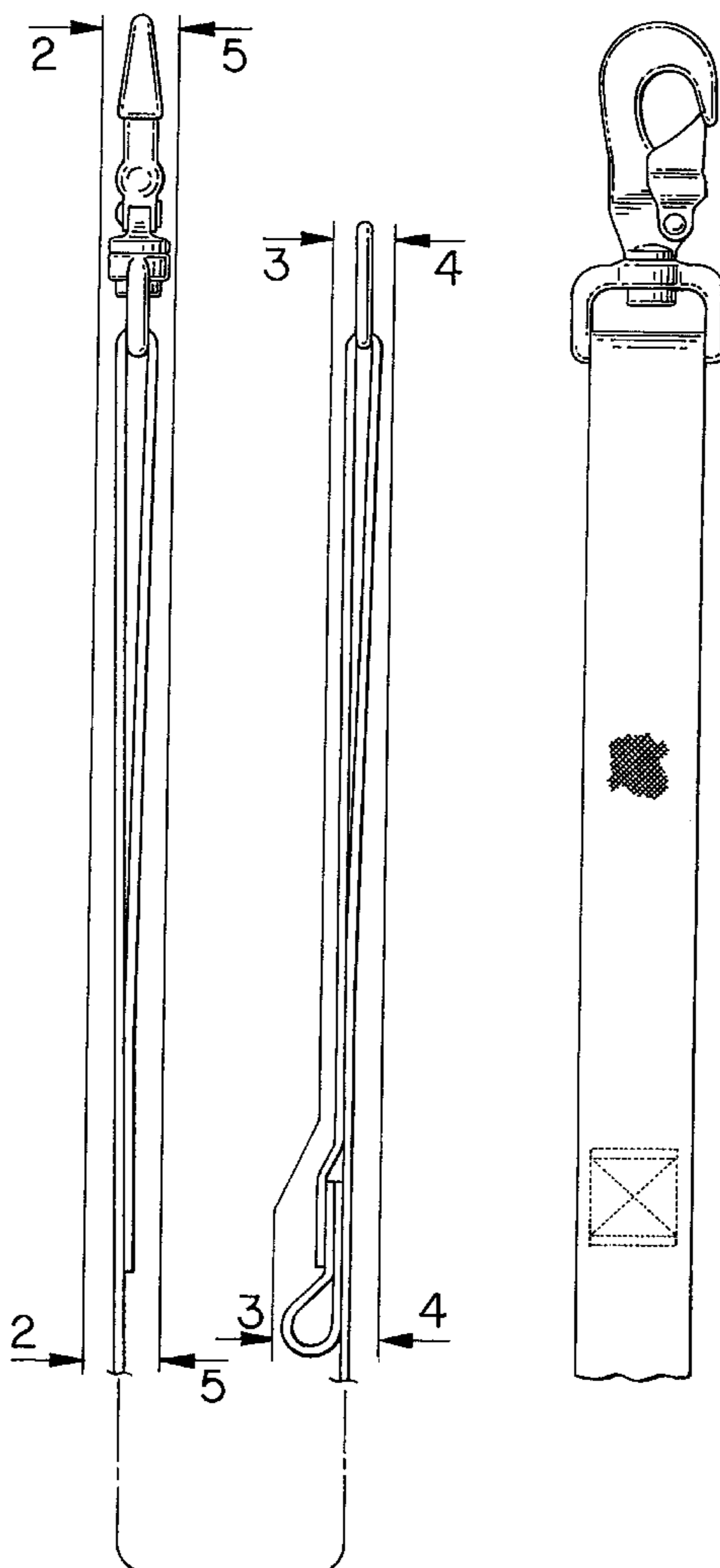
FIG. 5 is a partial right side elevational view taken along lines 5—5 of FIG. 1;

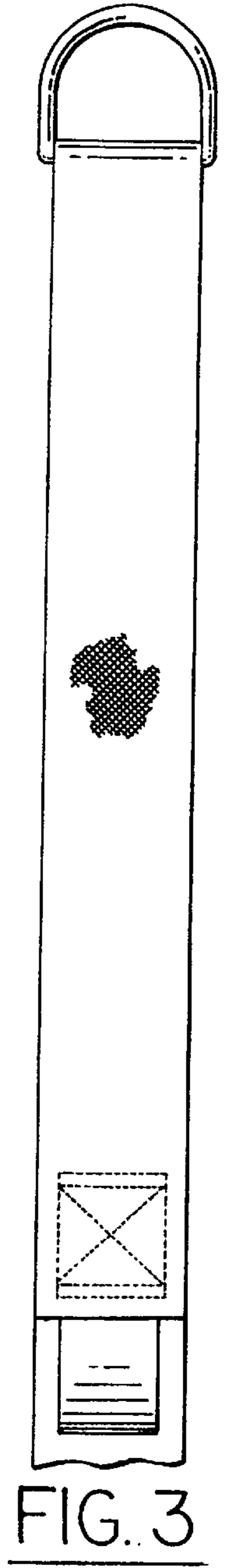
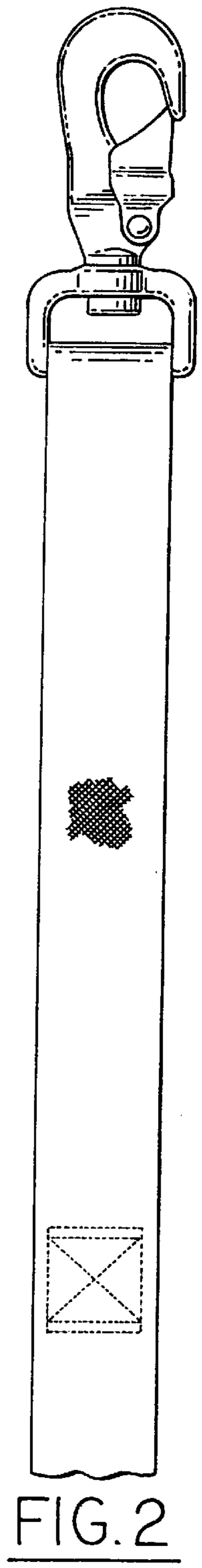
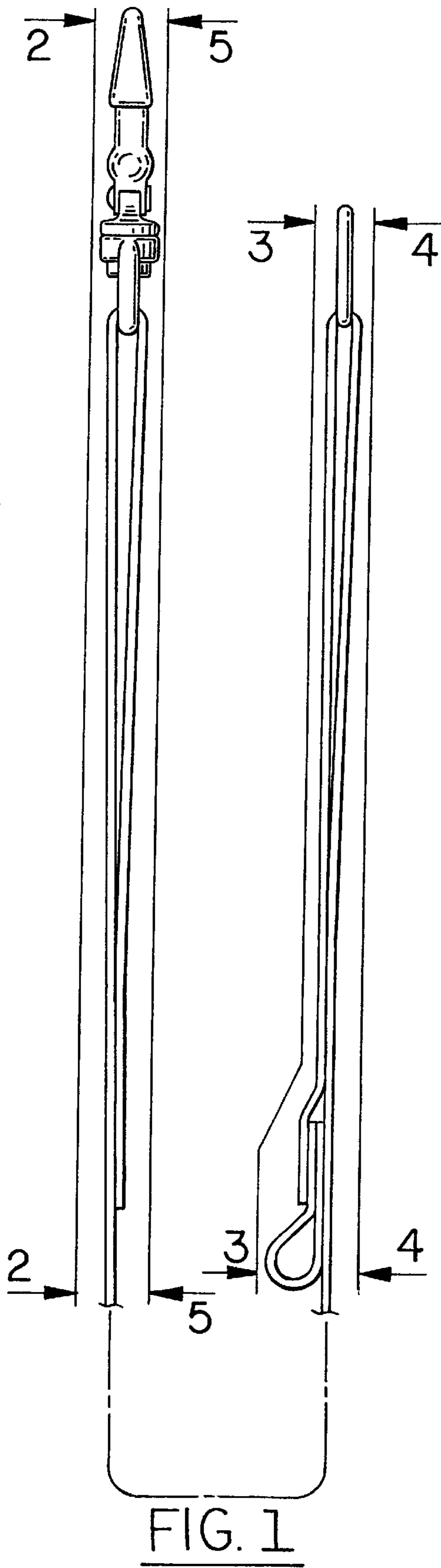
FIG. 6 is a rear view of the leash of FIG. 1 ; and,

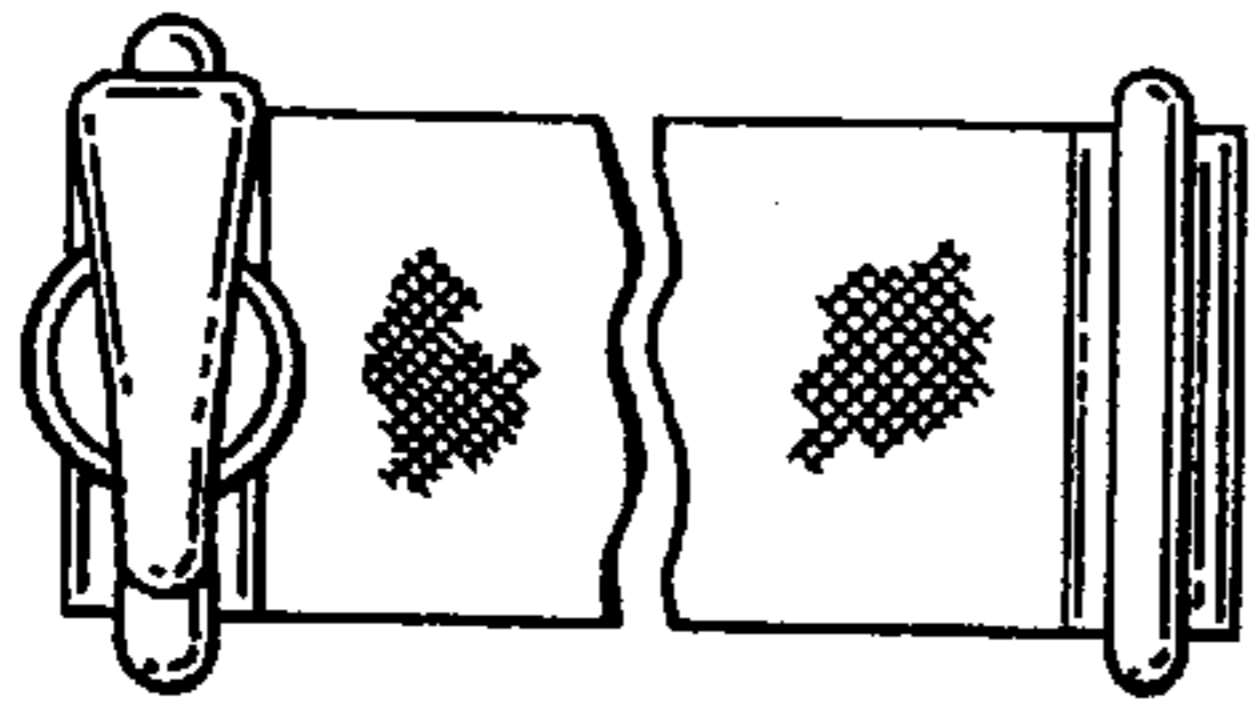

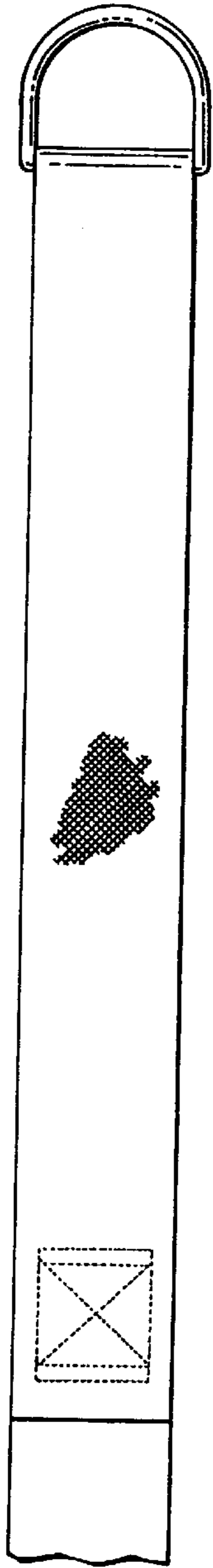

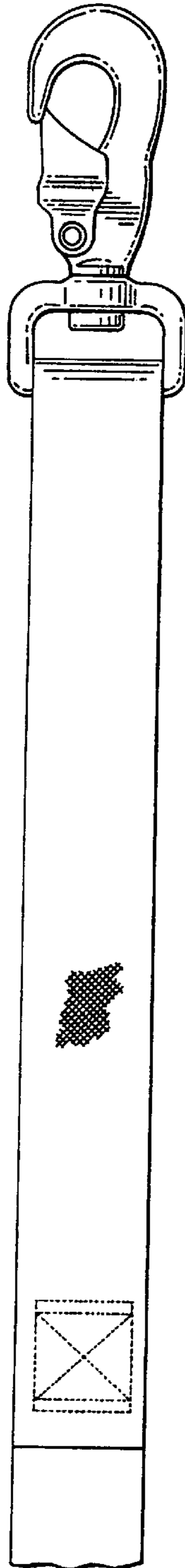

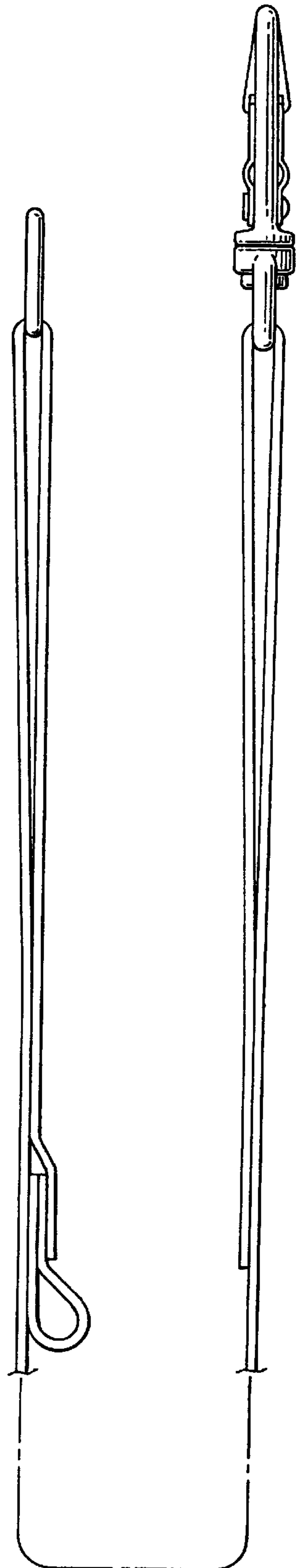
