The ornamental design for a drop shoulder creeper with T-bar support, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a drop shoulder creeper with T-bar support showing our new design;

FIG. 18 is a left side elevational view of FIG. 15;

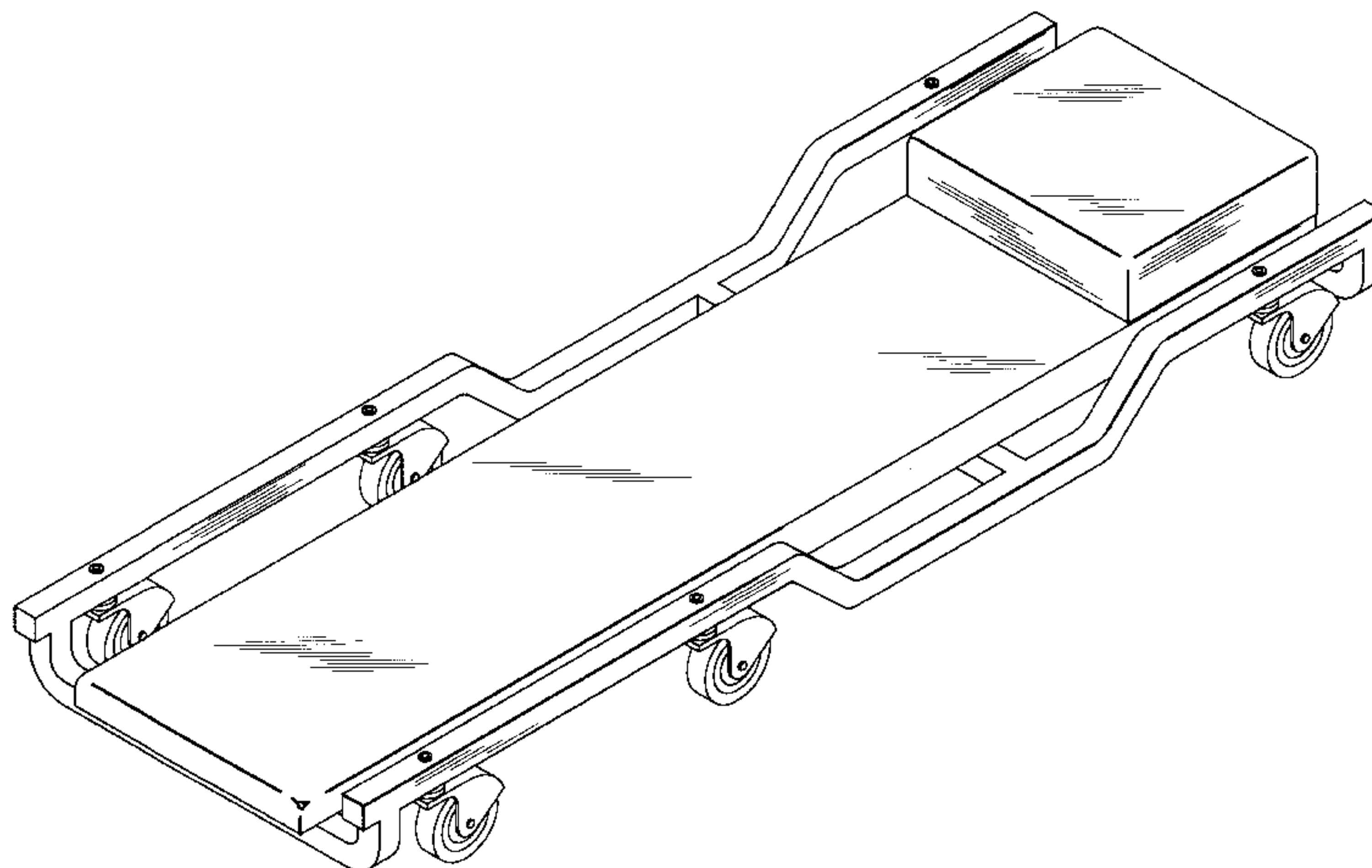
FIG. 19 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 15

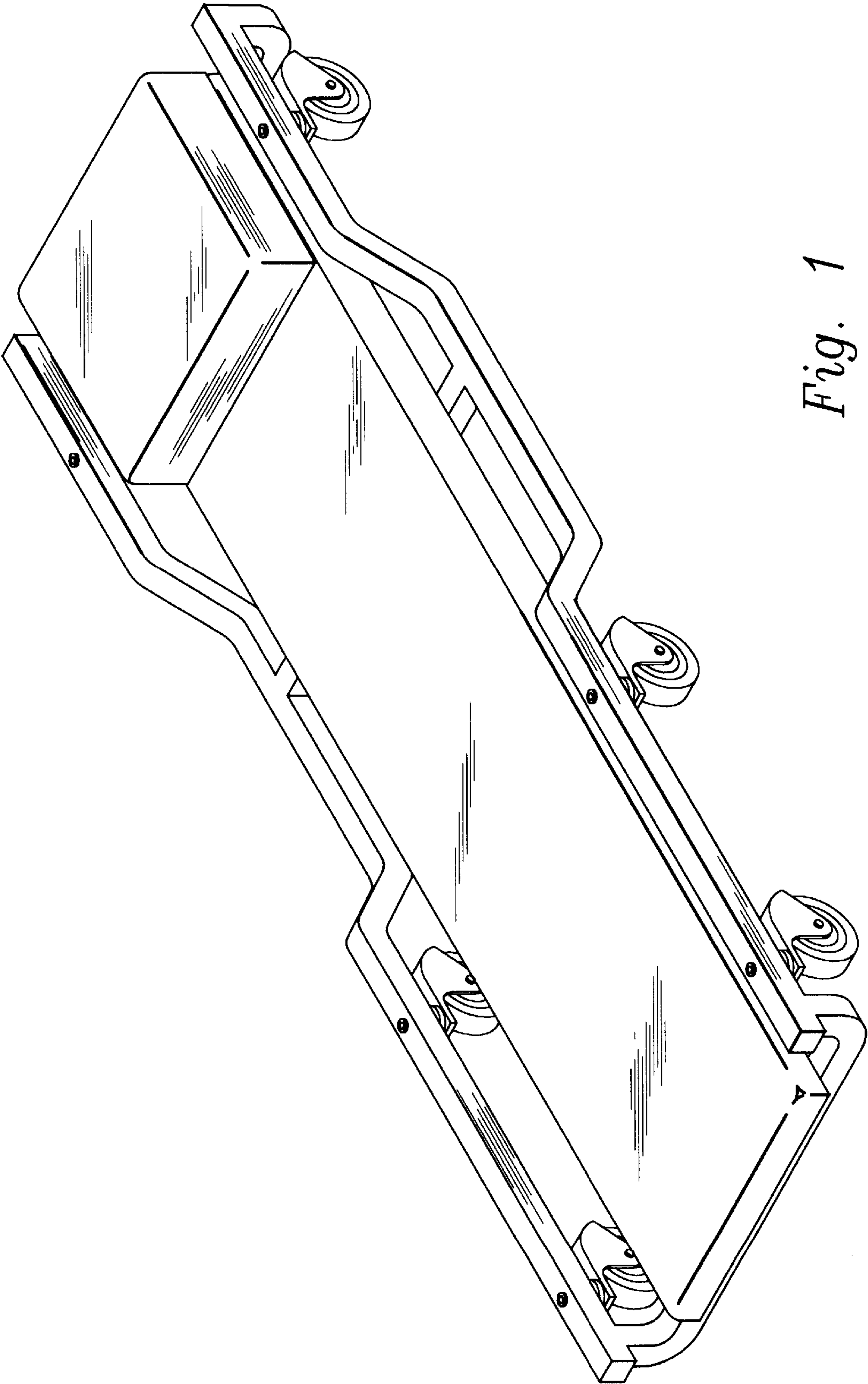

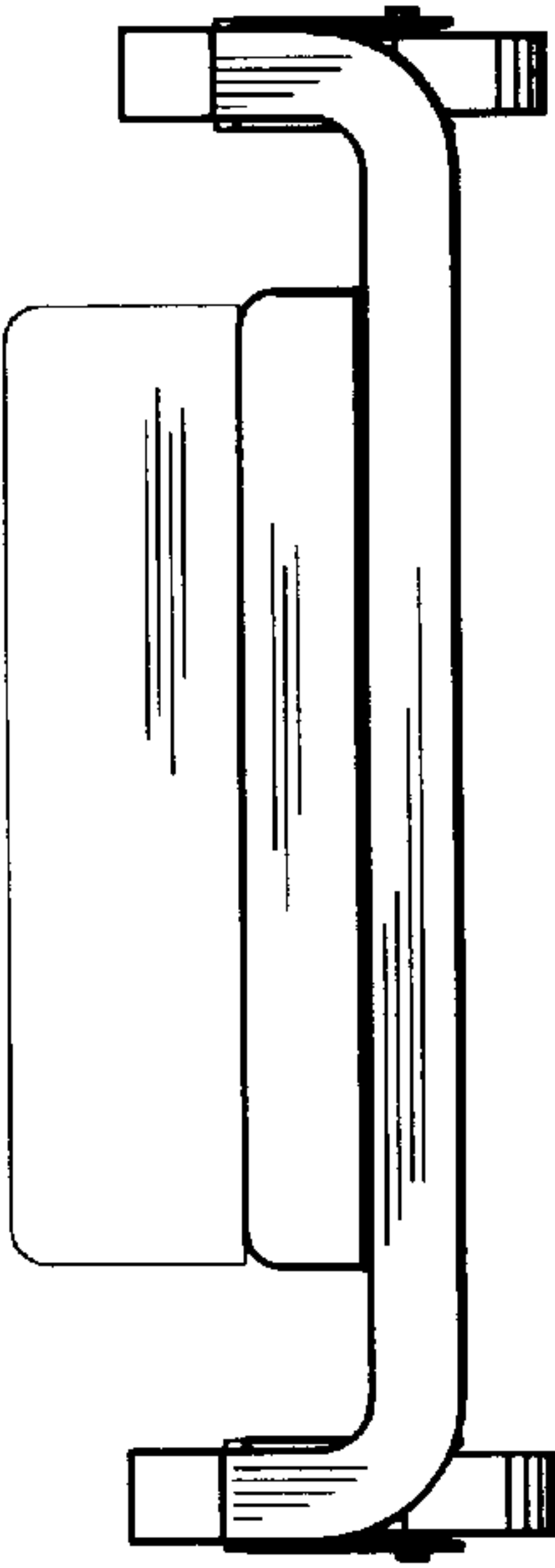

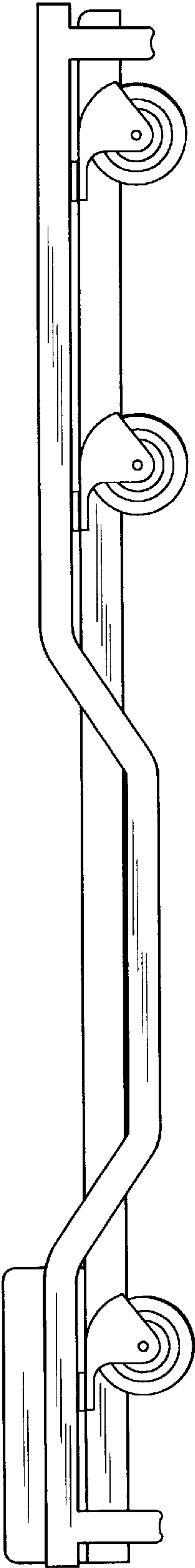

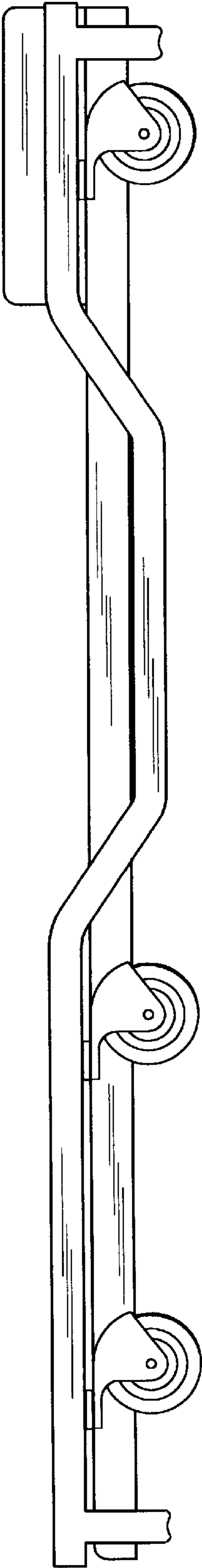

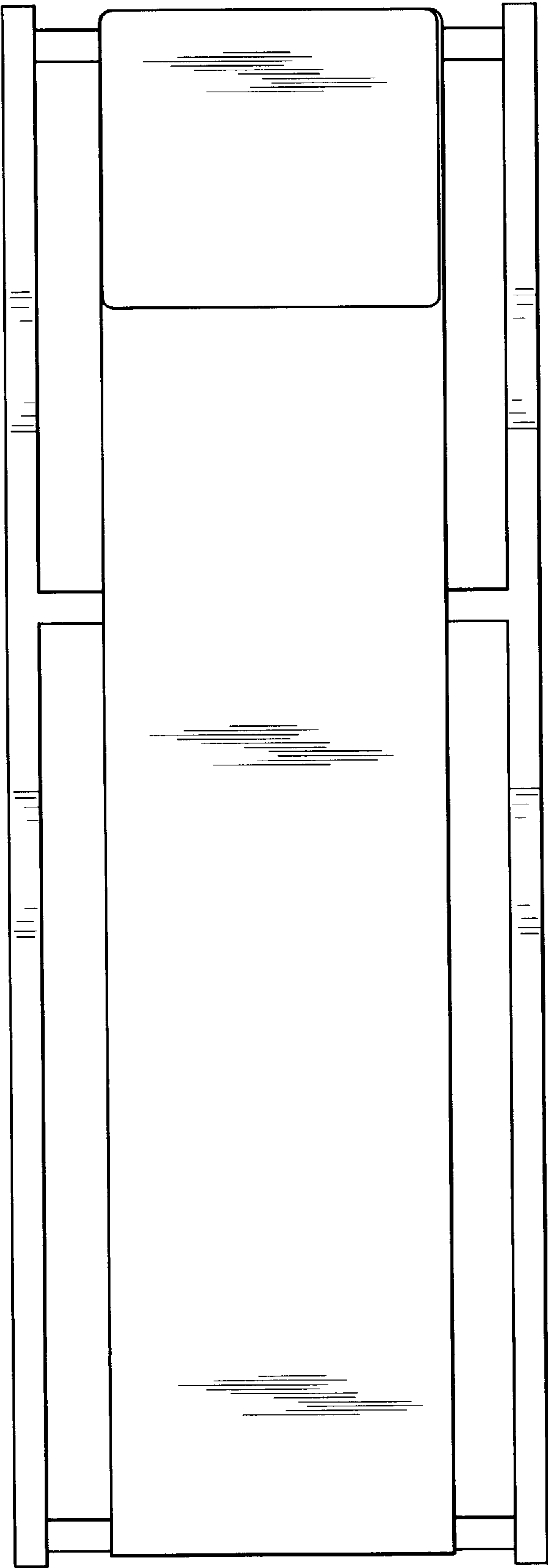

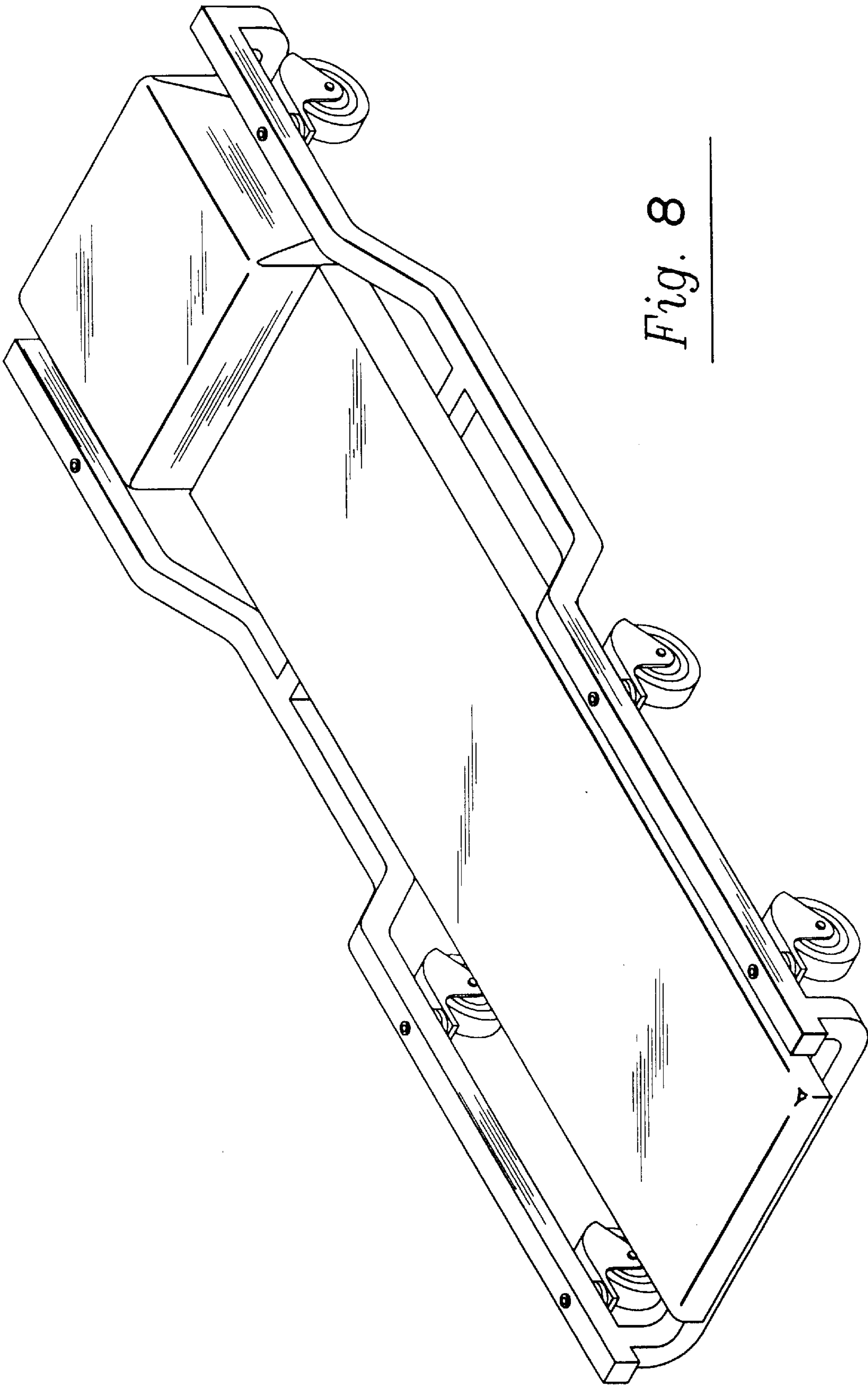

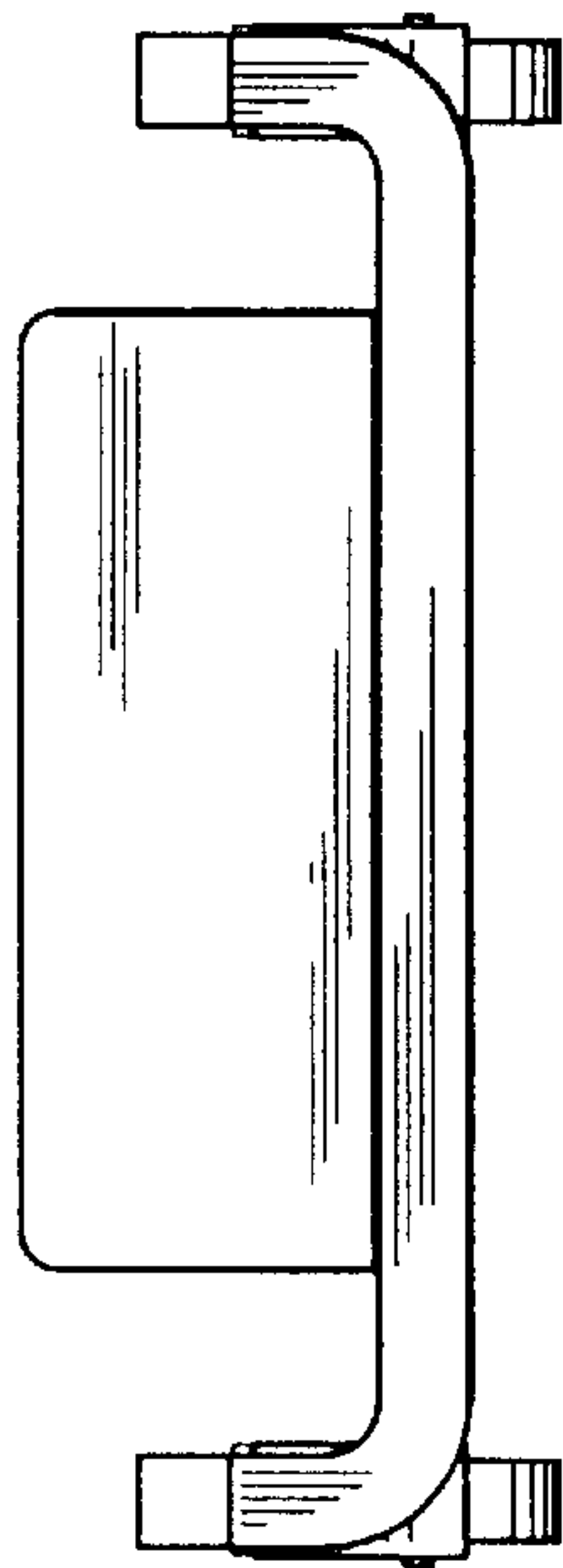

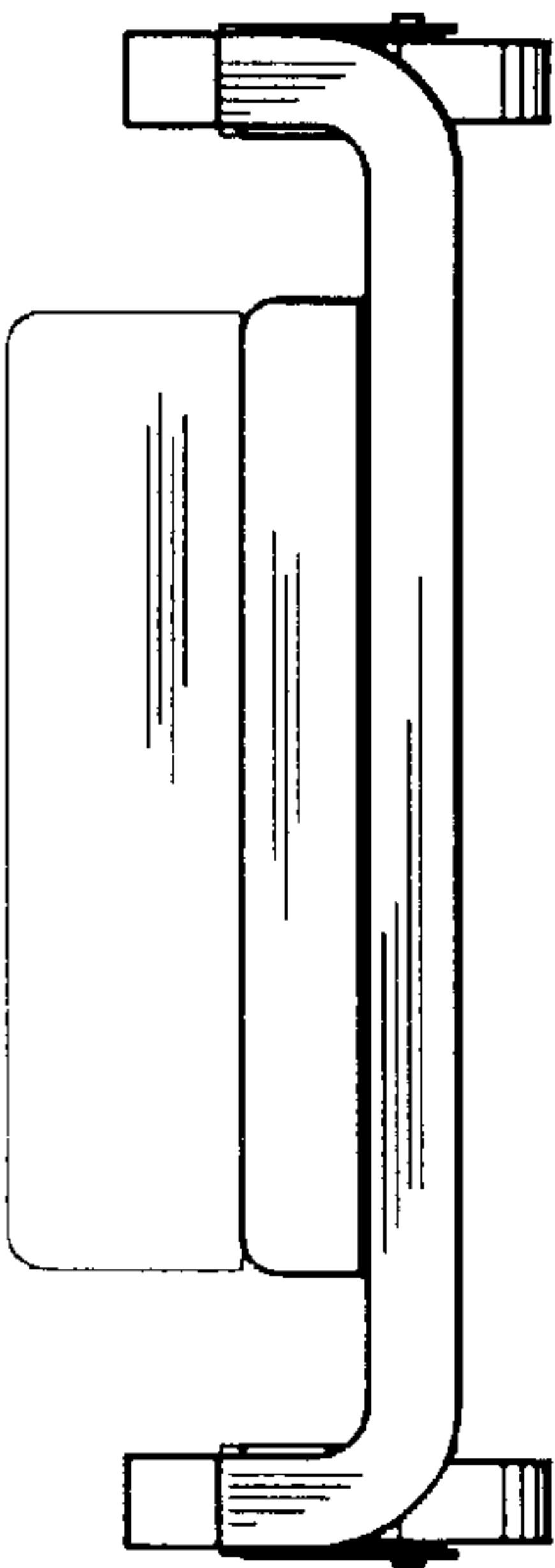

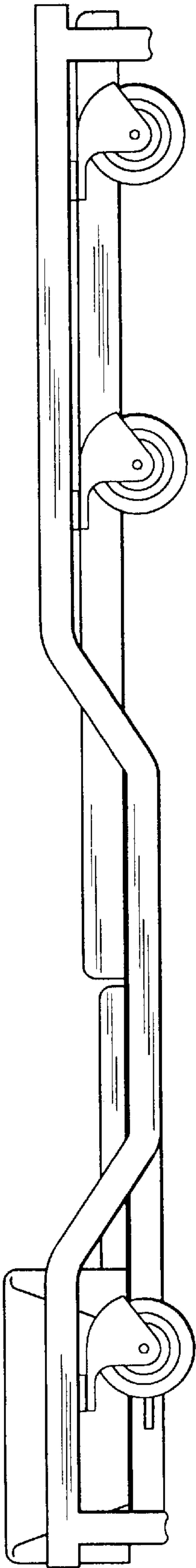

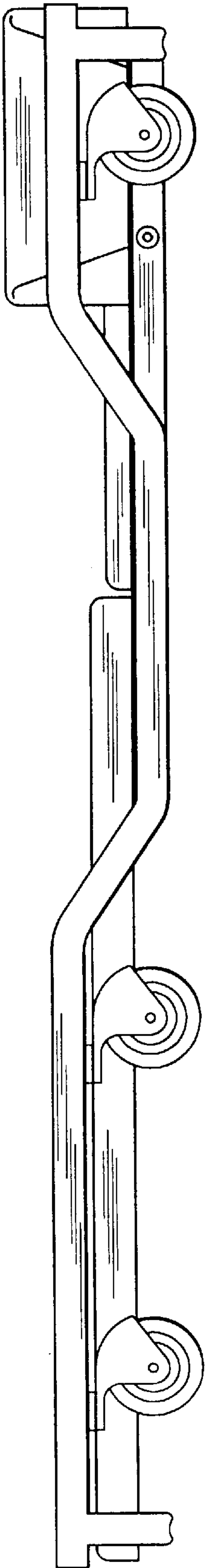

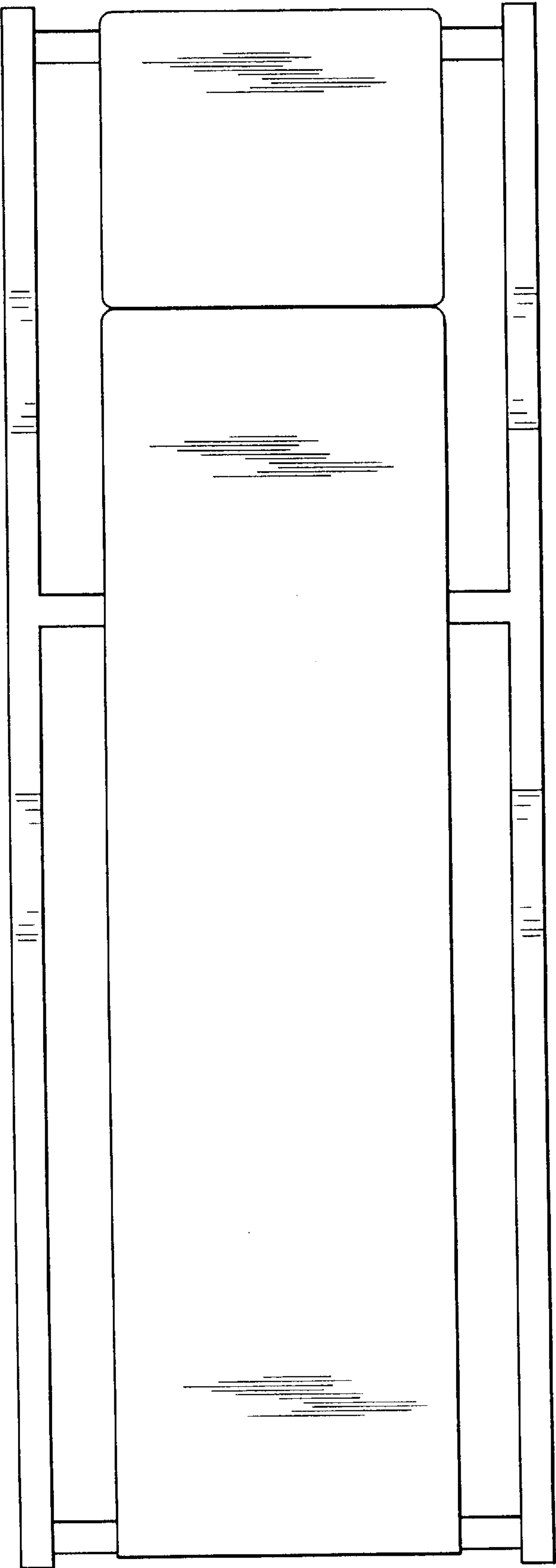

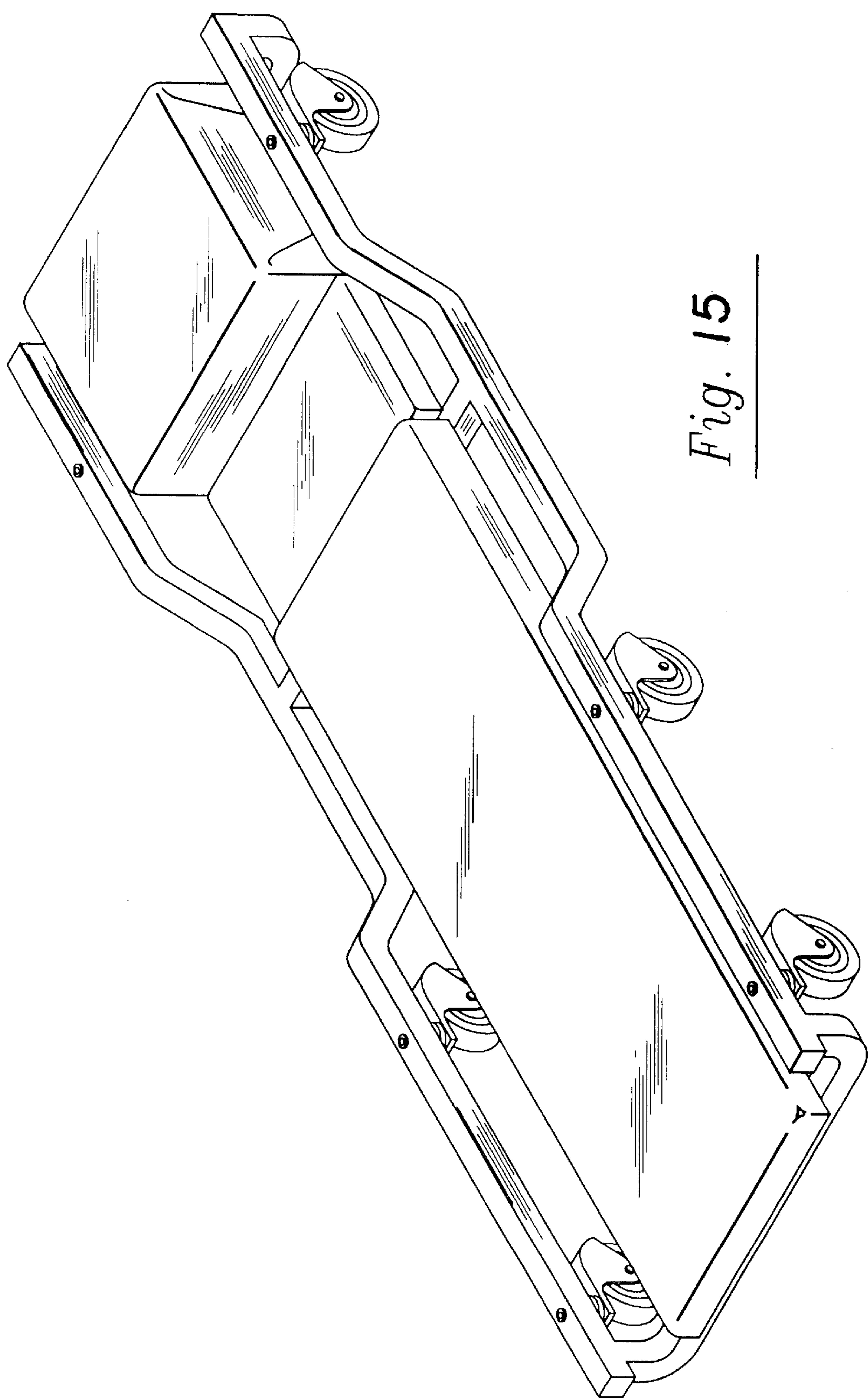

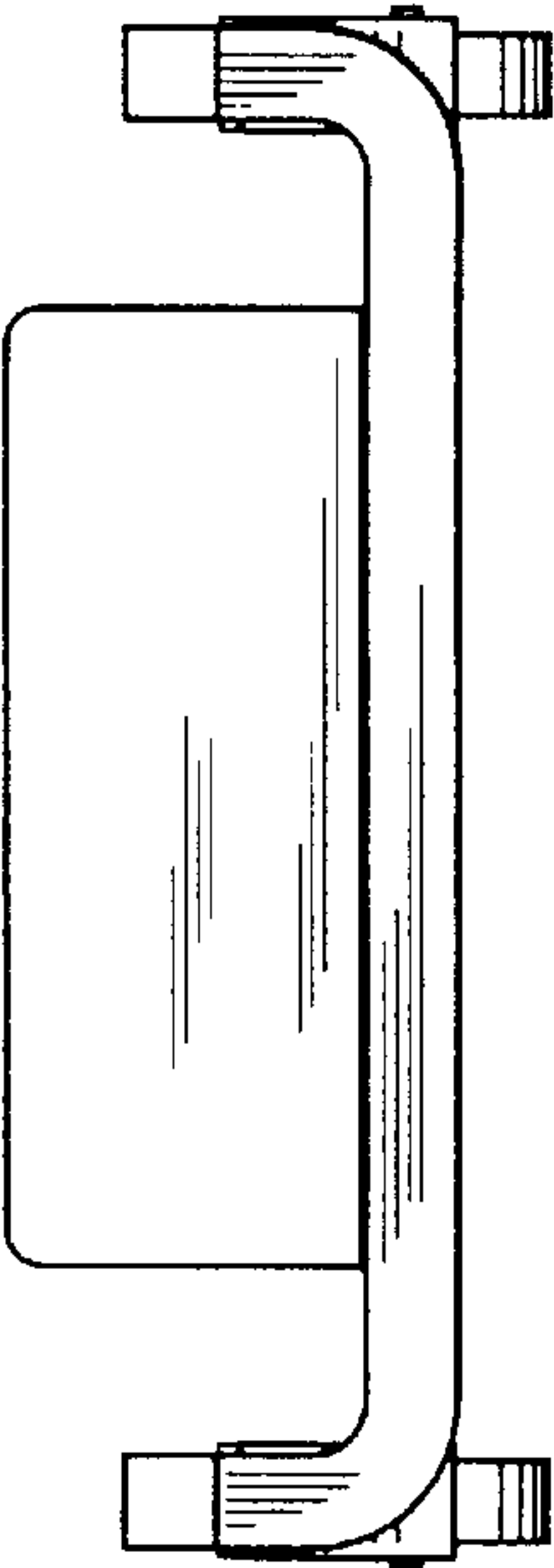

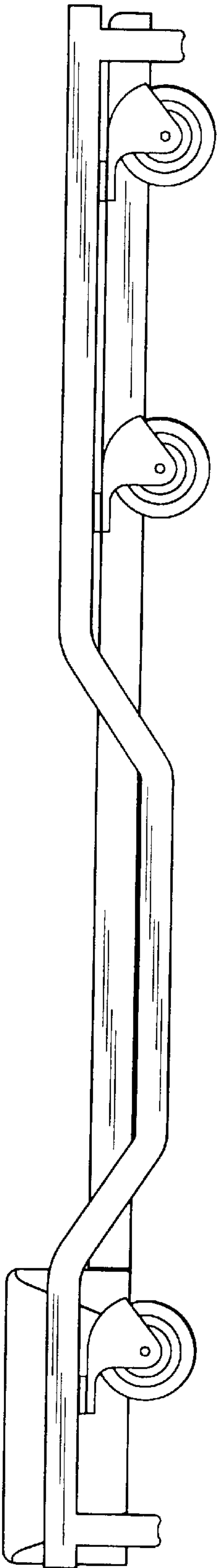

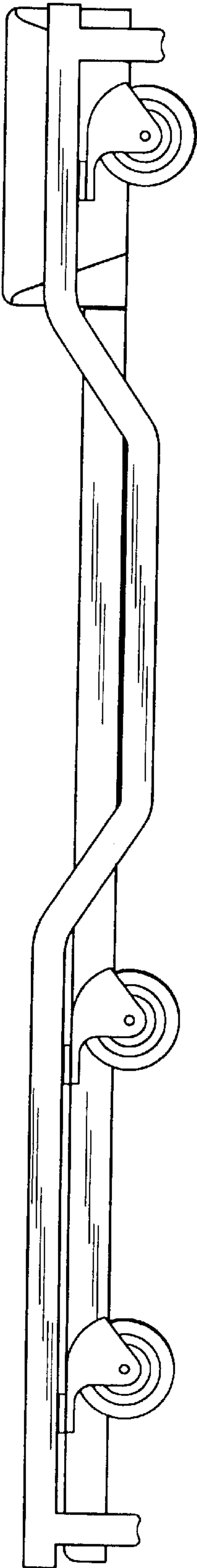

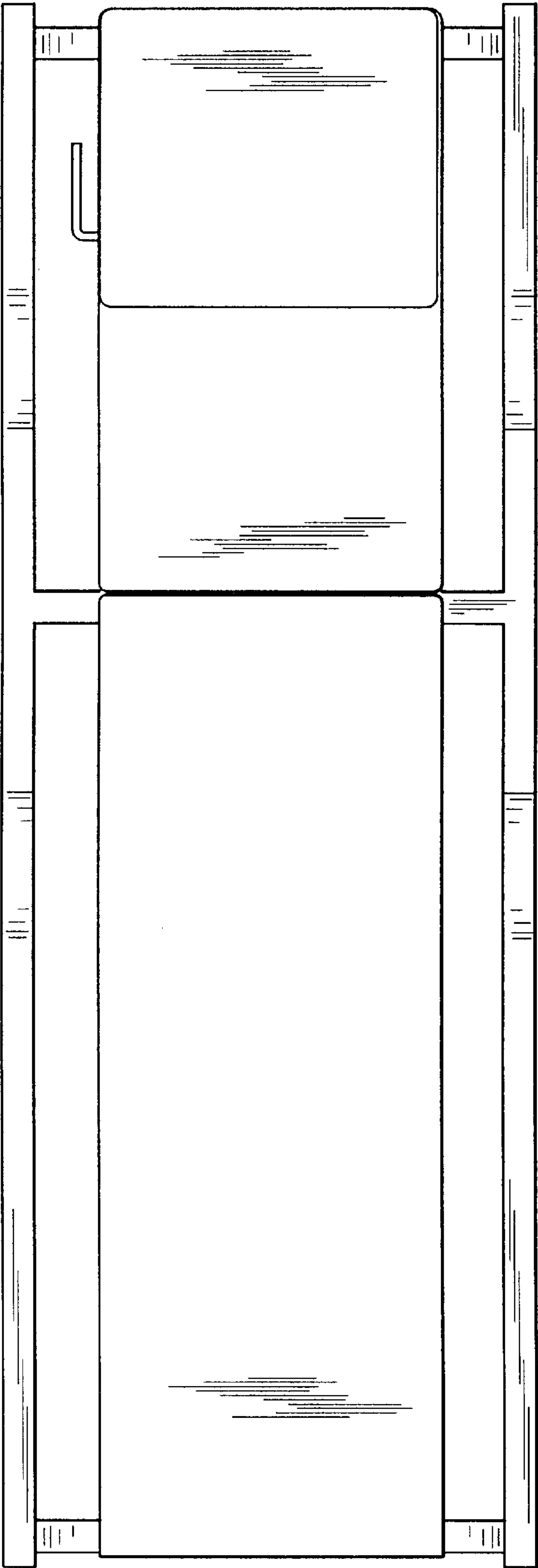

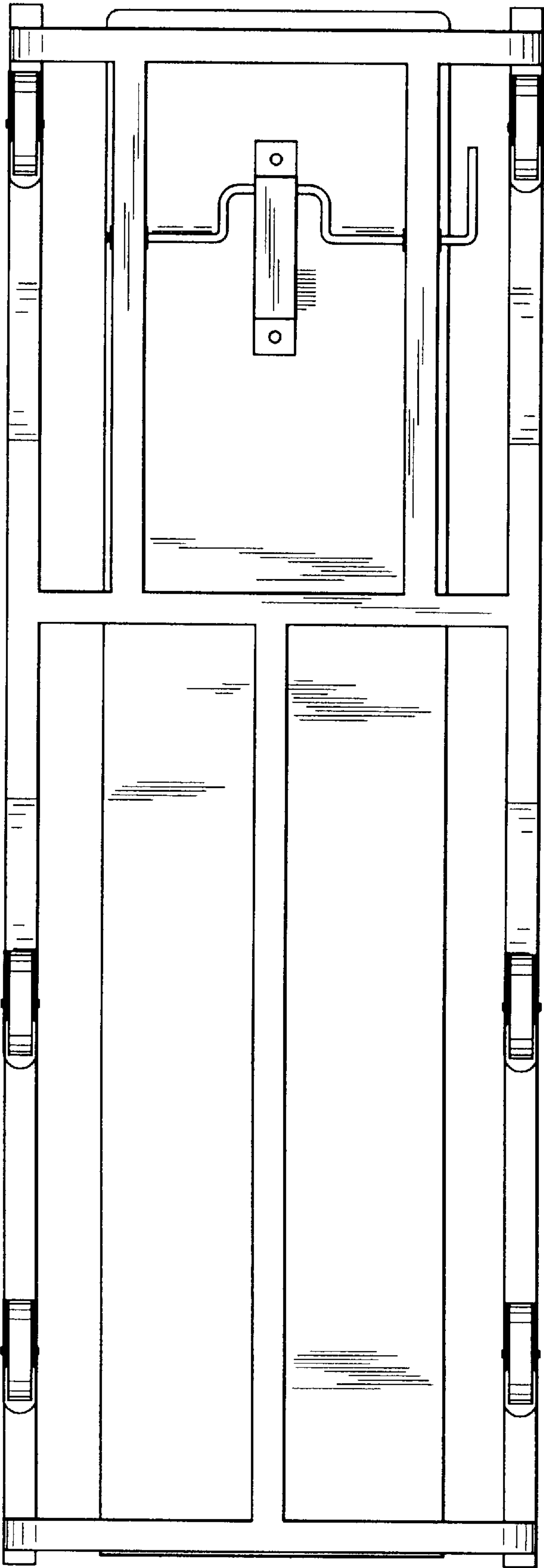

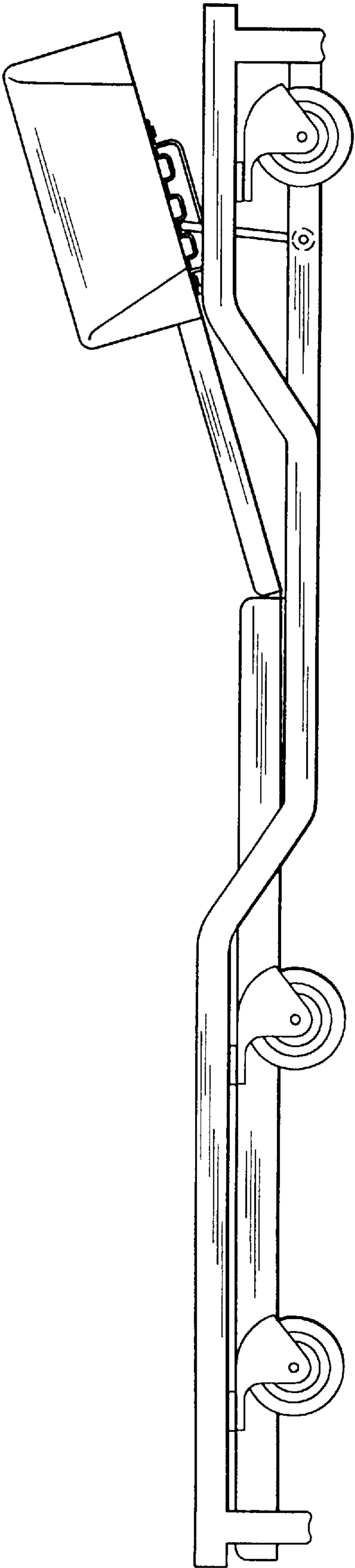
