FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the portion of a shoe upper of FIG. 1;

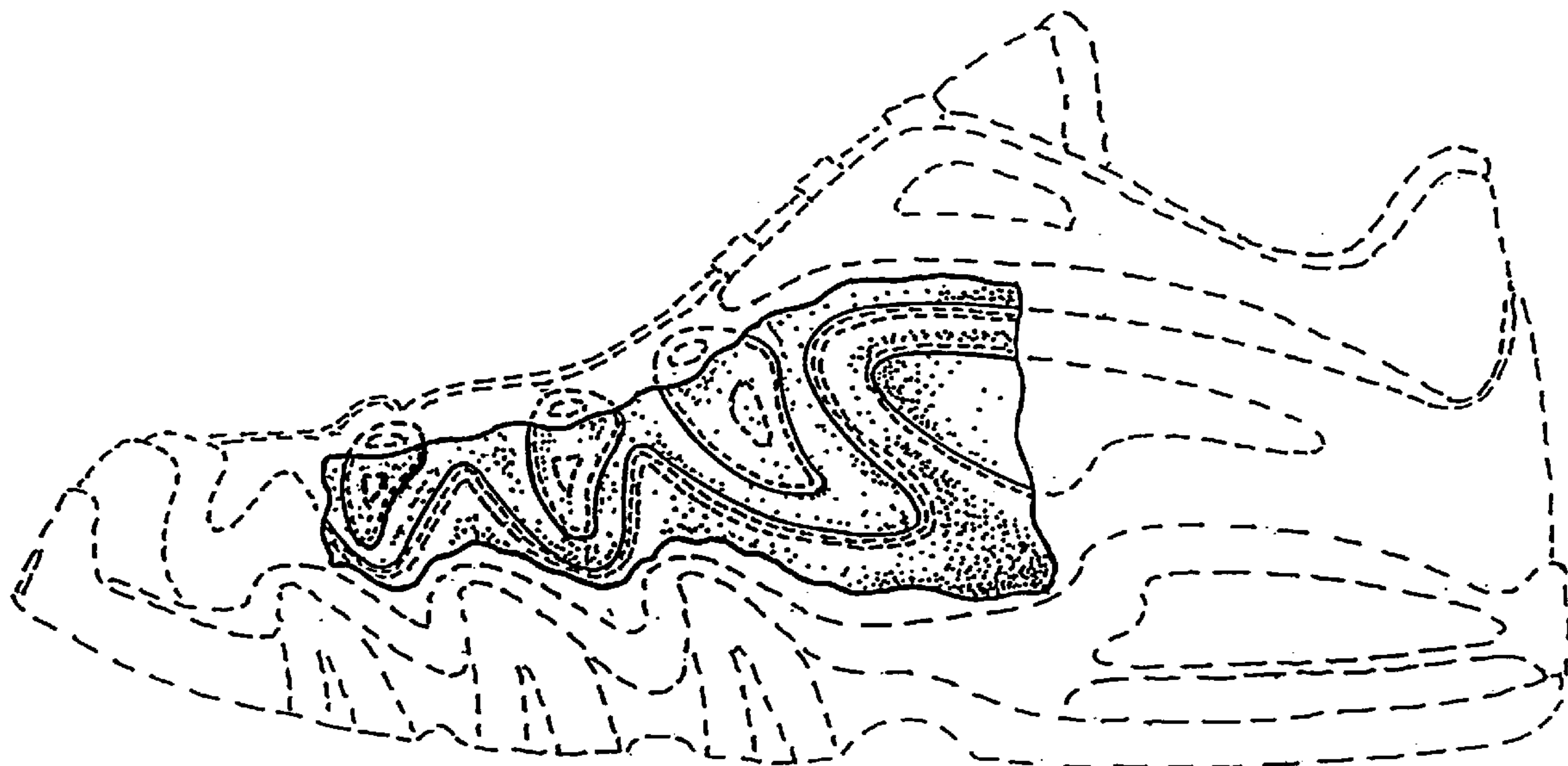
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view of the portion of a shoe upper of FIG. 1;

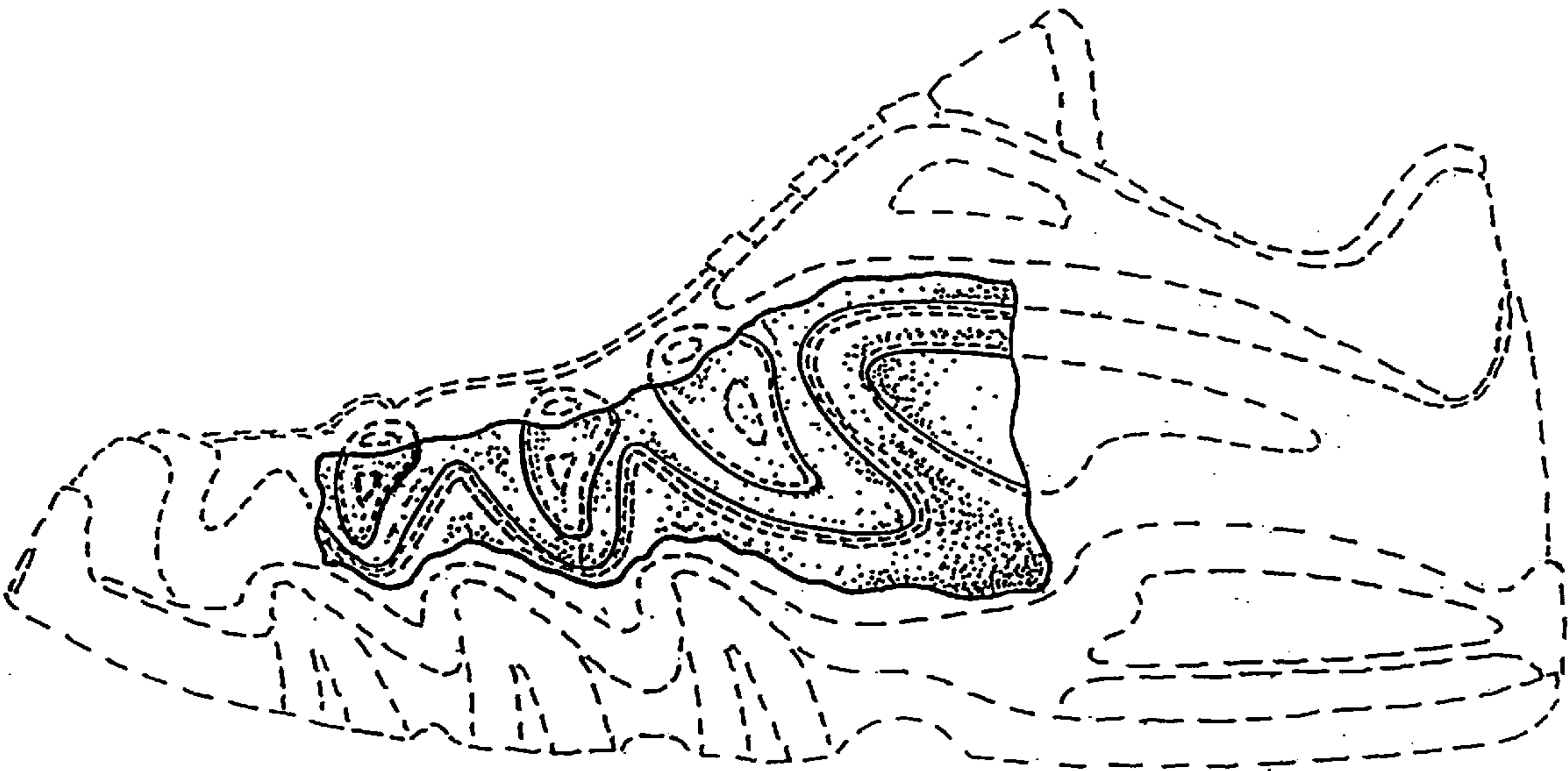
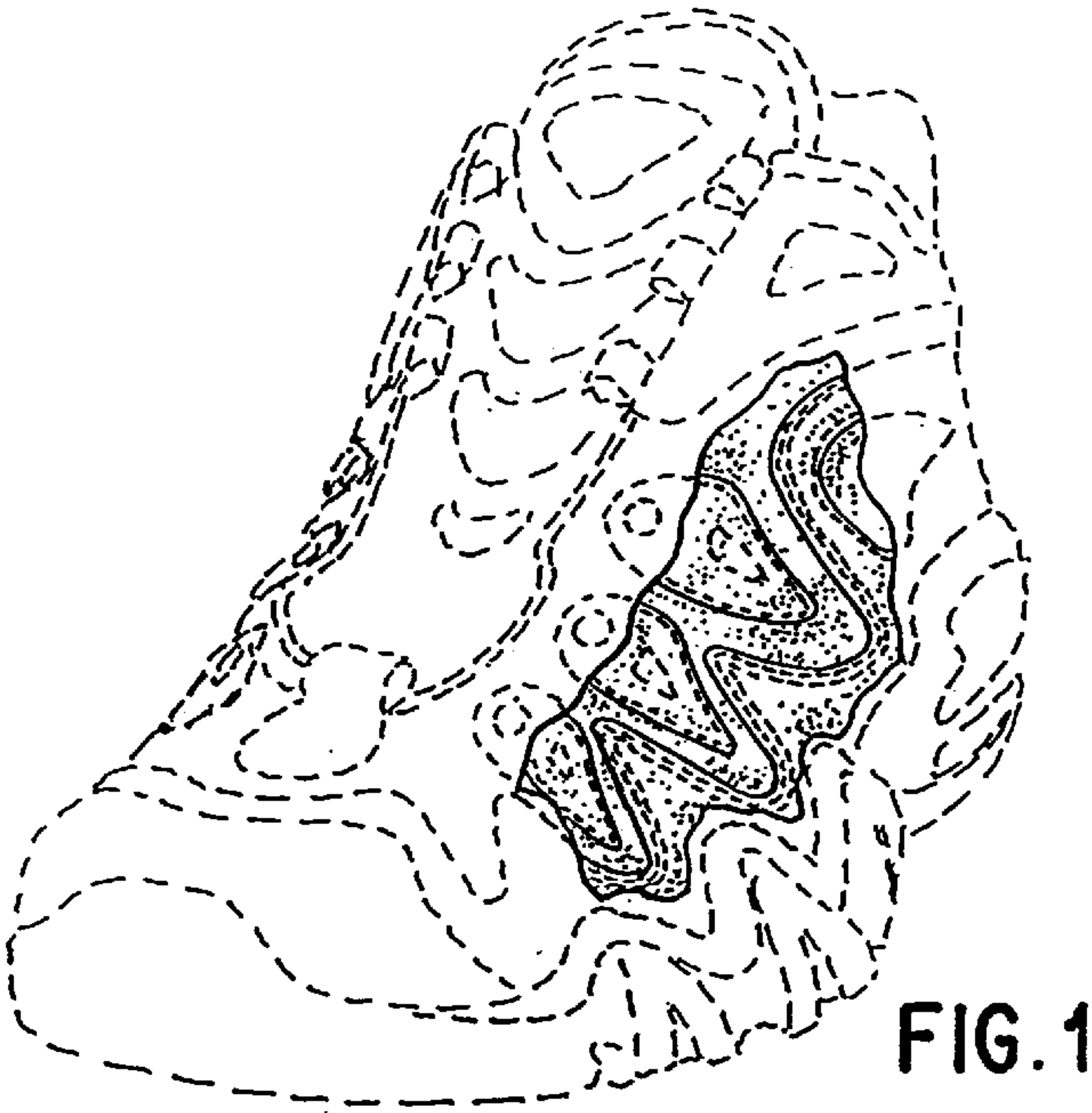

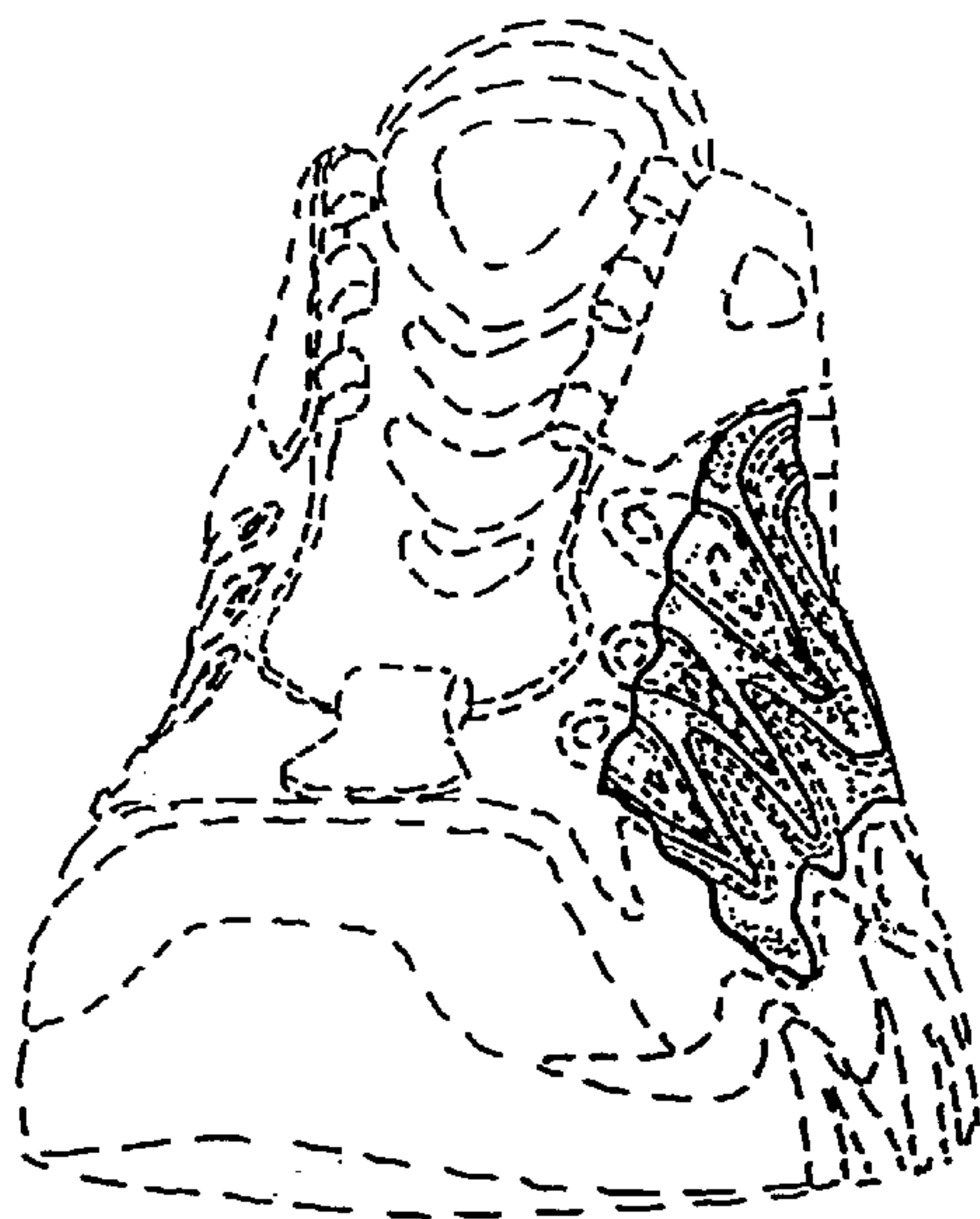

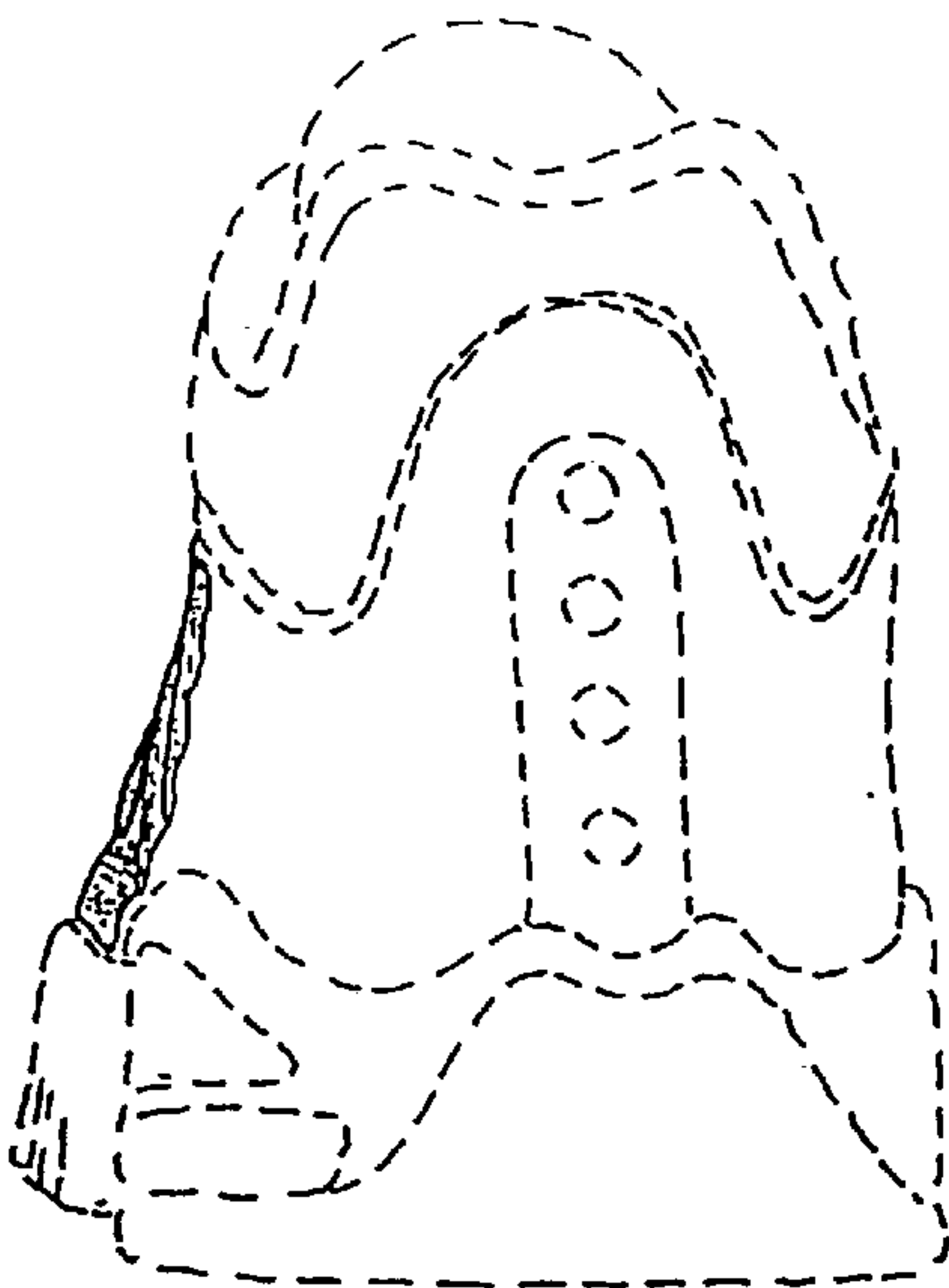

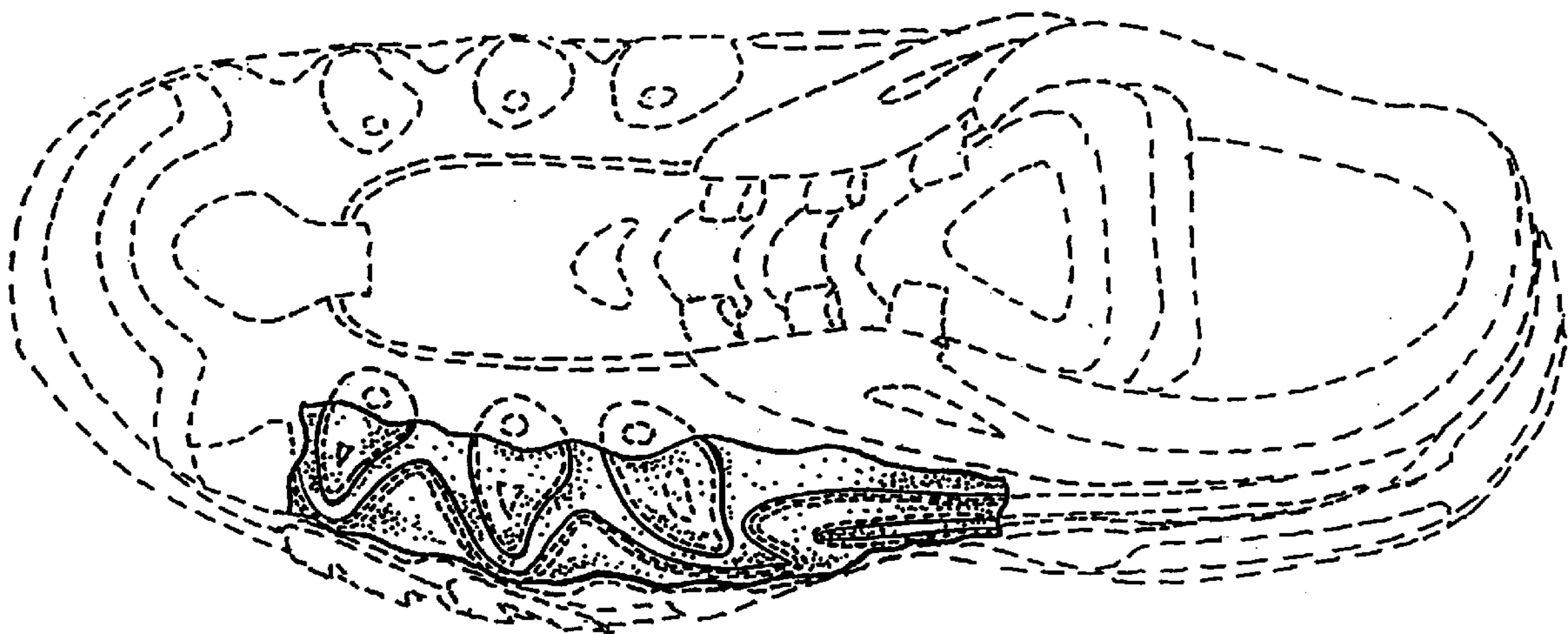
