FIG. 7 is a right side elevational view, with the left side elevational view being a mirror image thereof.

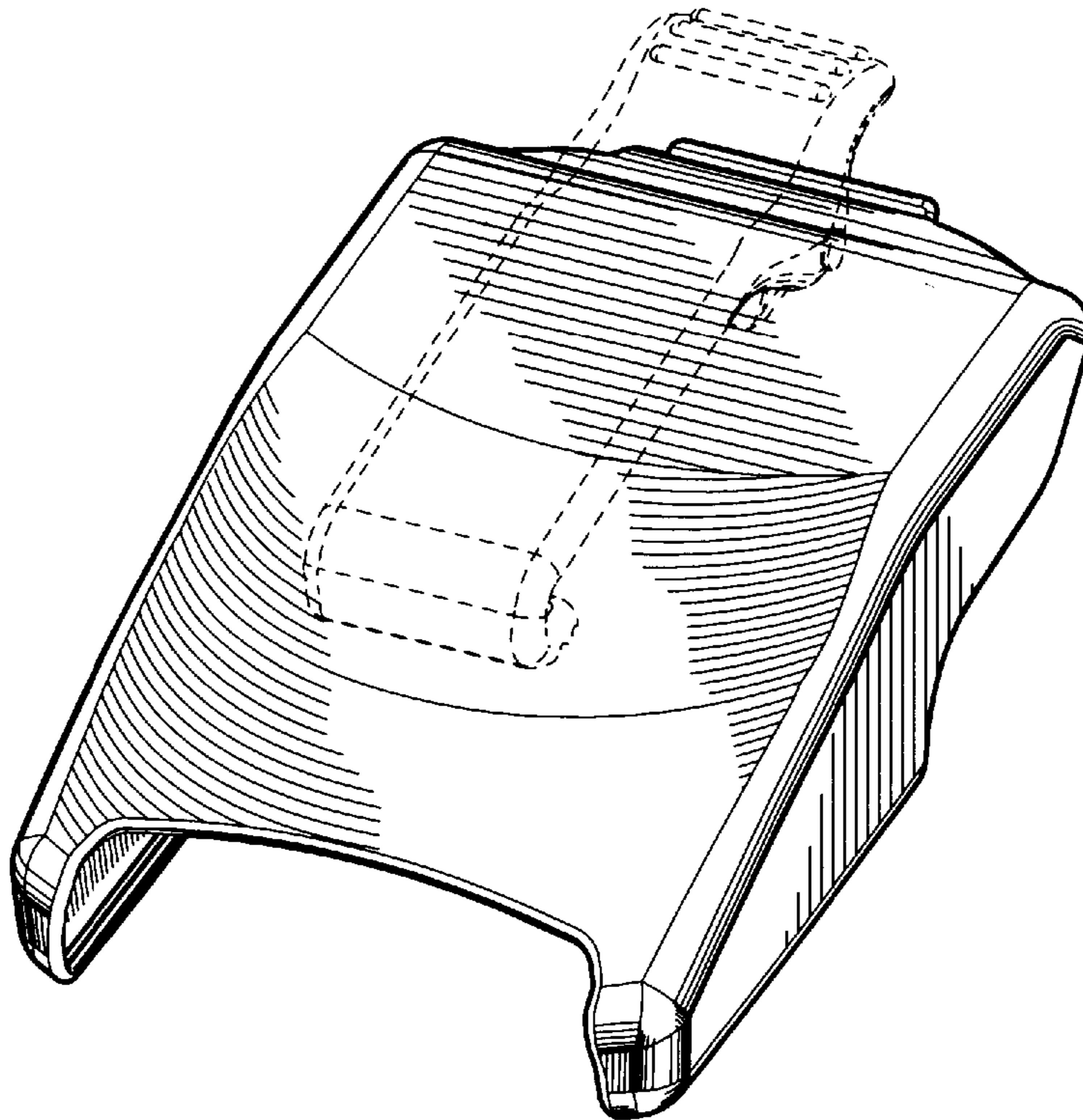
The broken line showing of environment in FIGS. 1-3 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

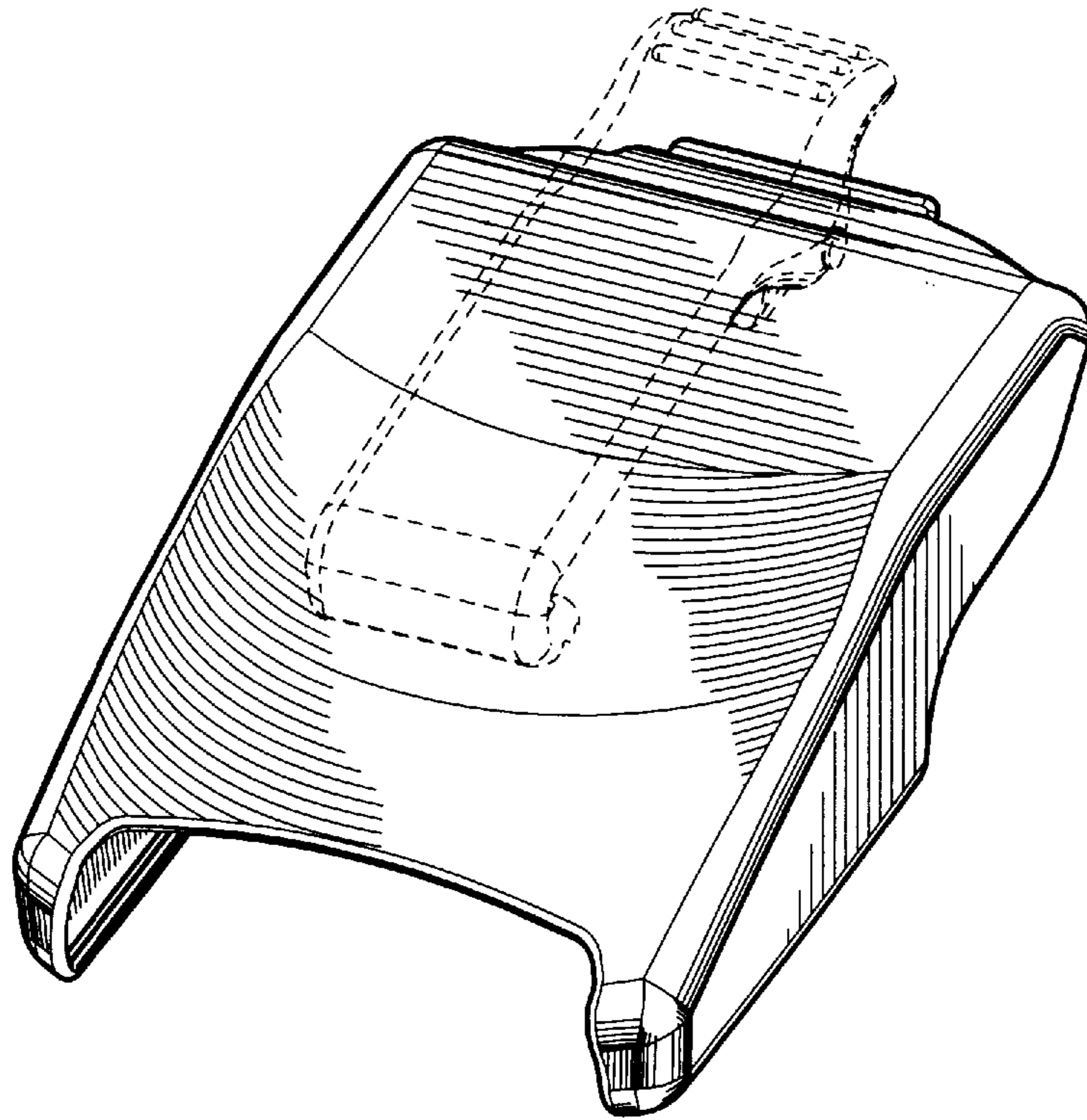

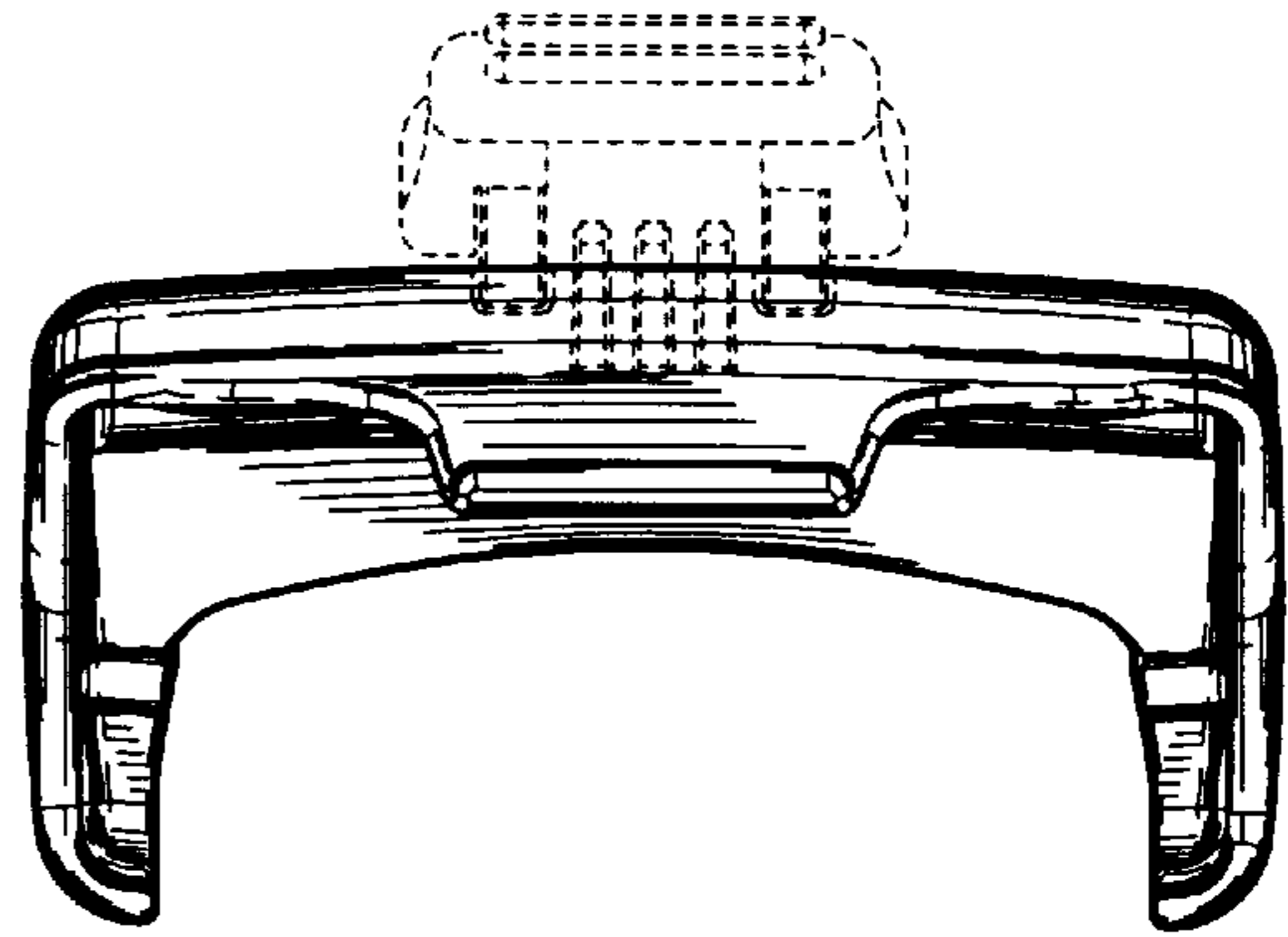

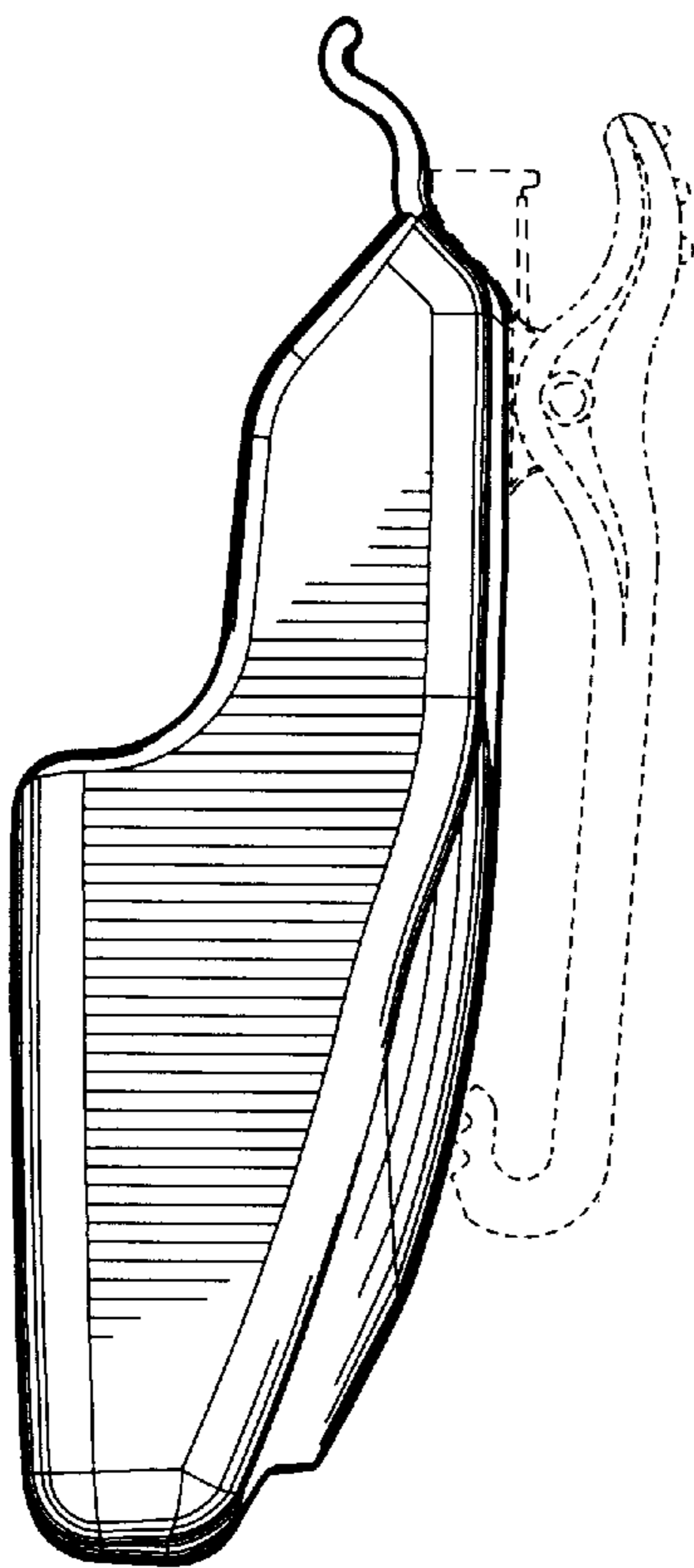




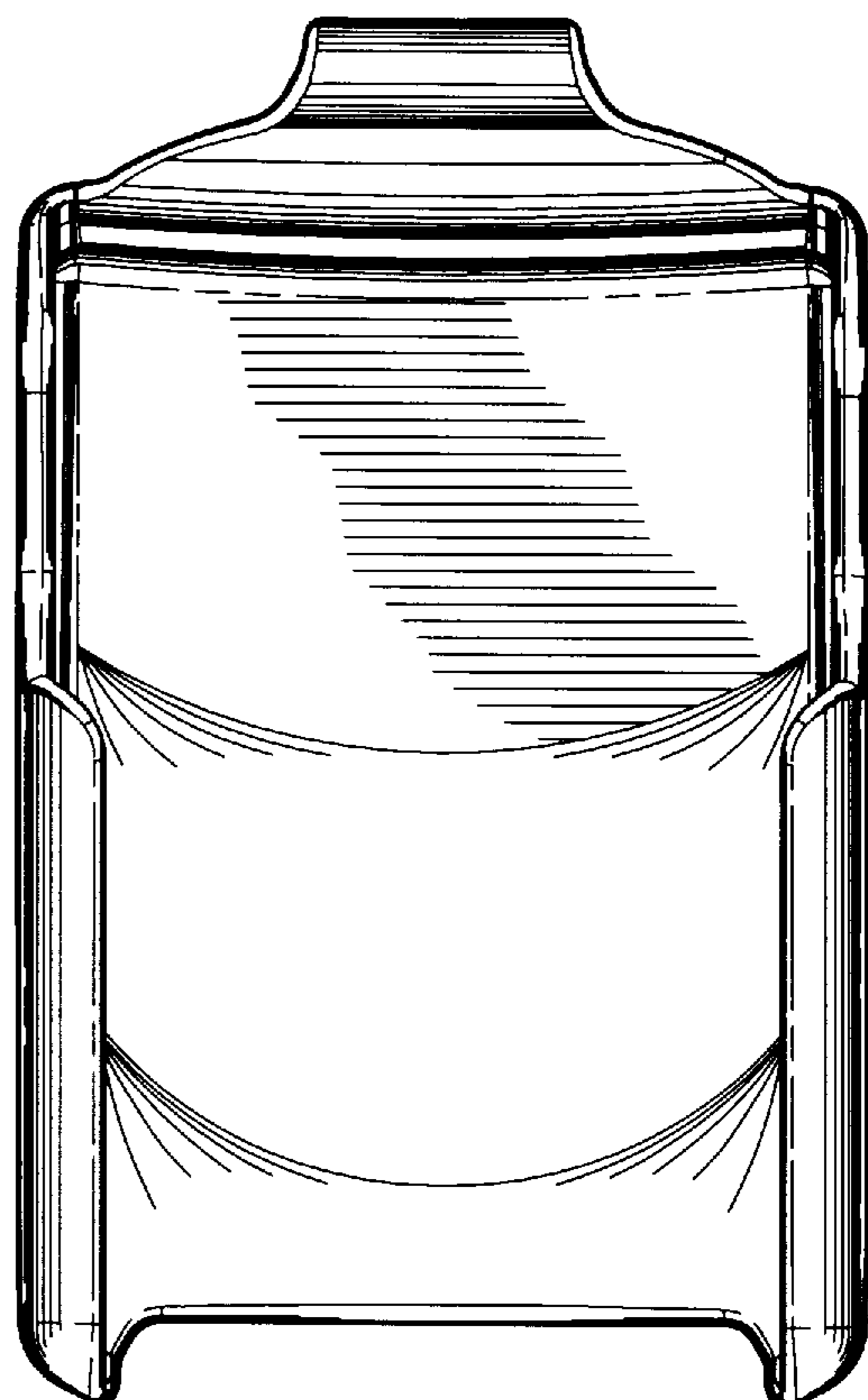

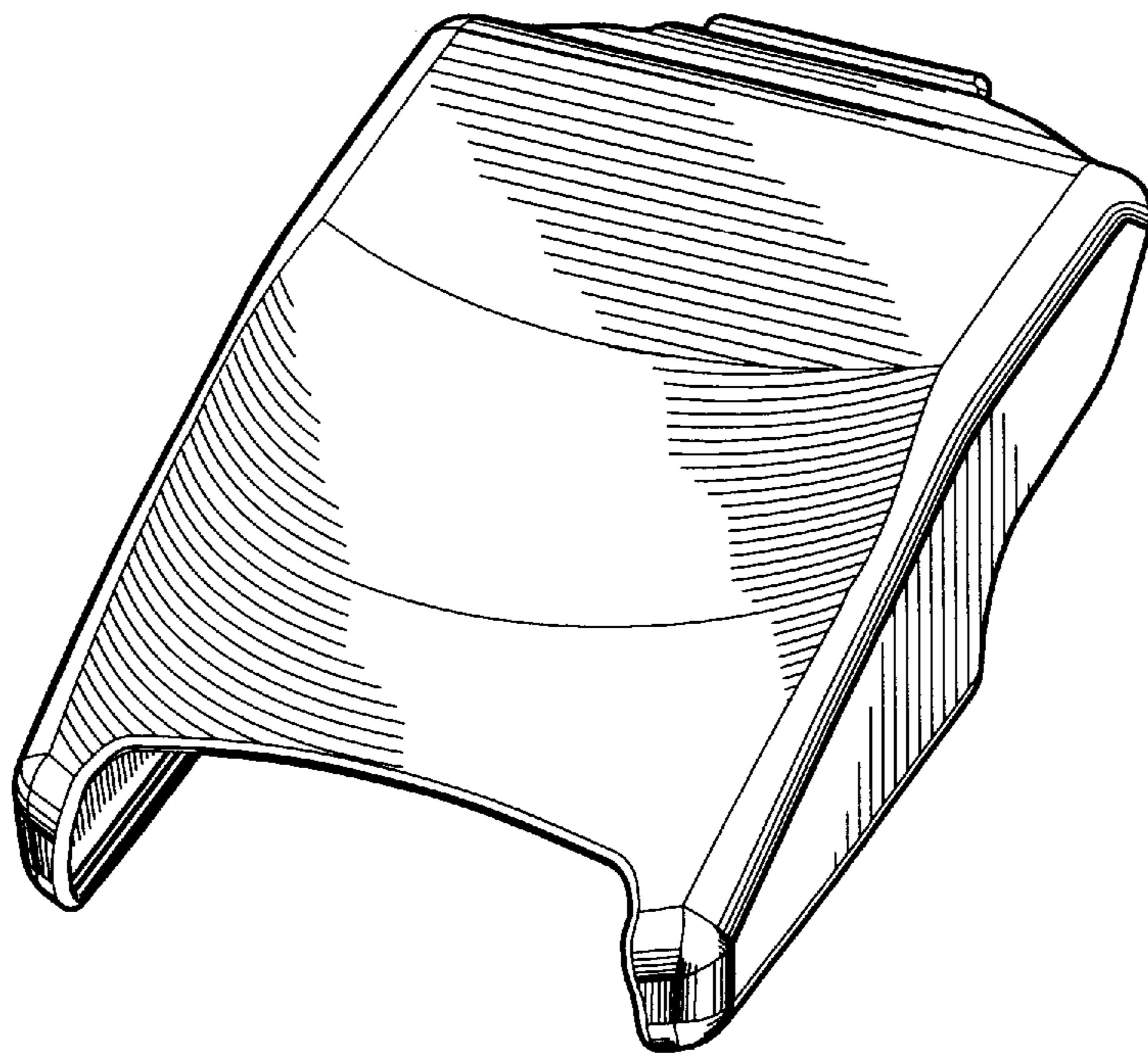

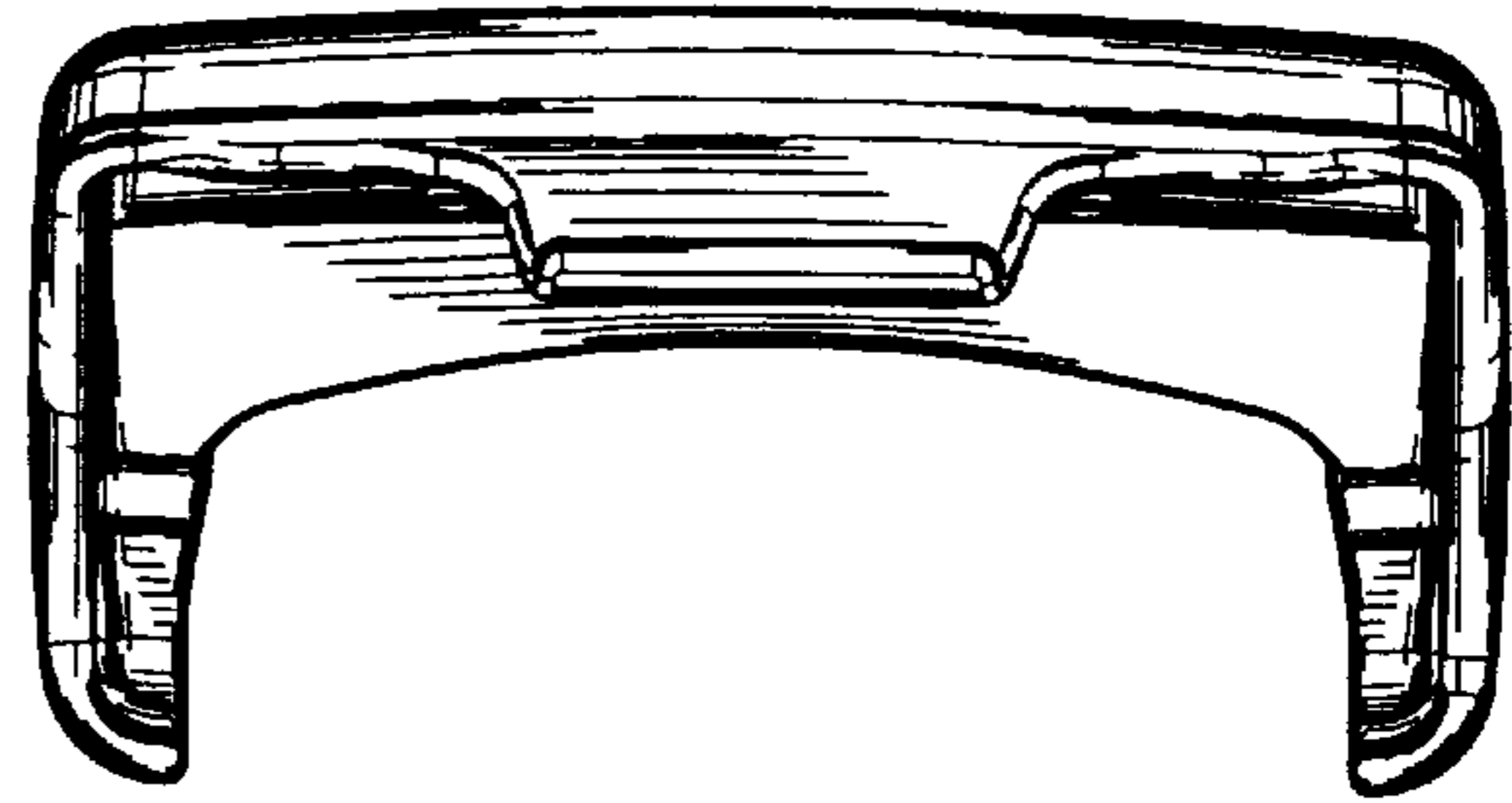

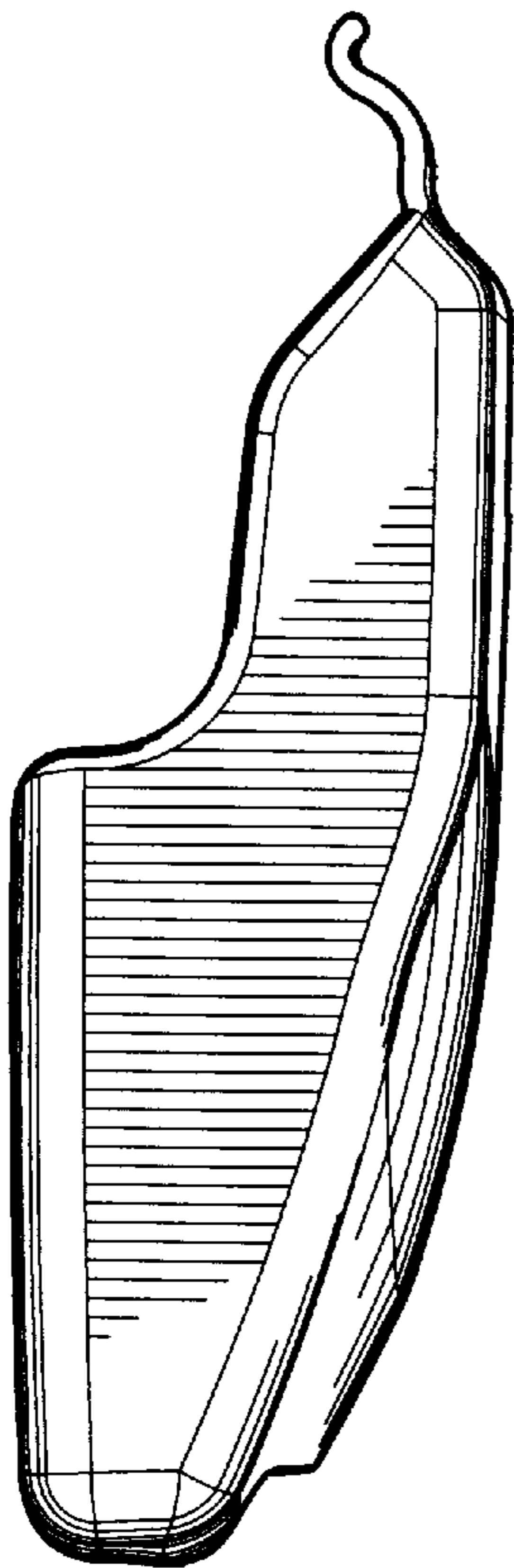
