FIG. 3 is a right side view of a motorcycle body according to our novel design;


FIG. 4 is a rear view of a motorcycle body according to our novel design;


FIG. 5 is a top view of a motorcycle body according to our novel design;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view from the front right side of a motorcycle body according to our novel design; and,


FIG. 7 is a perspective view from the rear left side of a motorcycle body according to our novel design.









