[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a battery housing for a cellular telephone, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front, bottom, and left side perspective view of a first embodiment of the battery housing for a cellular telephone;

FIG. 2 is a left side elevation view of the first embodiment;

FIG. 3 is a front elevation view of the first embodiment;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view of the first embodiment;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the first embodiment;

FIG. 6 is a right side elevation view of the first embodiment;

FIG. 7 is a rear elevation view of the first embodiment;

FIG. 8 is a front, bottom, and left side perspective view of a second embodiment of the battery housing for a cellular telephone;

FIG. 9 is a left side elevation view of the second embodiment;

FIG. 10 is a front elevation view of the second embodiment;

FIG. 11 is a bottom plan view of the second embodiment;

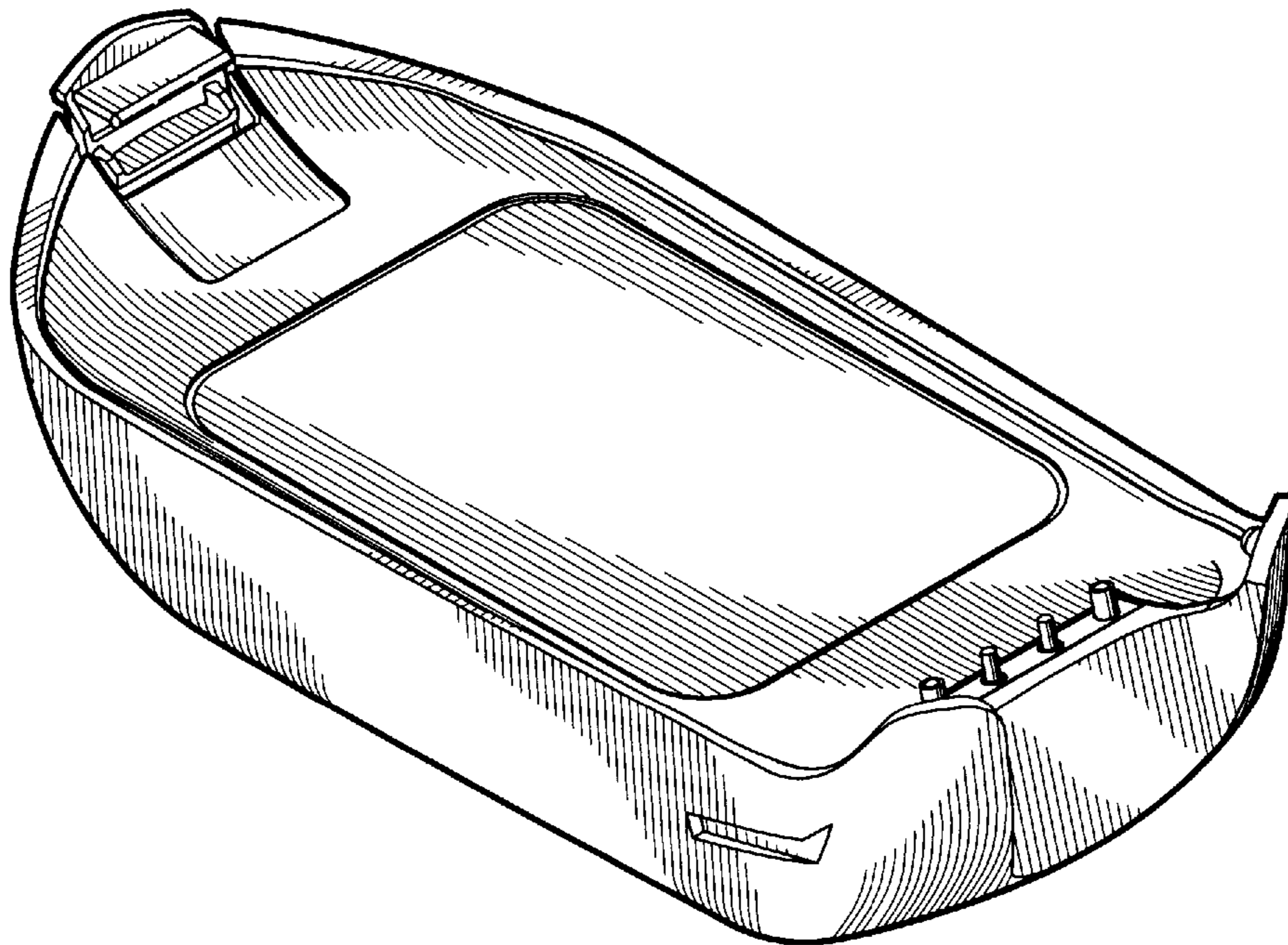
FIG. 12 is a top plan view of the second embodiment;

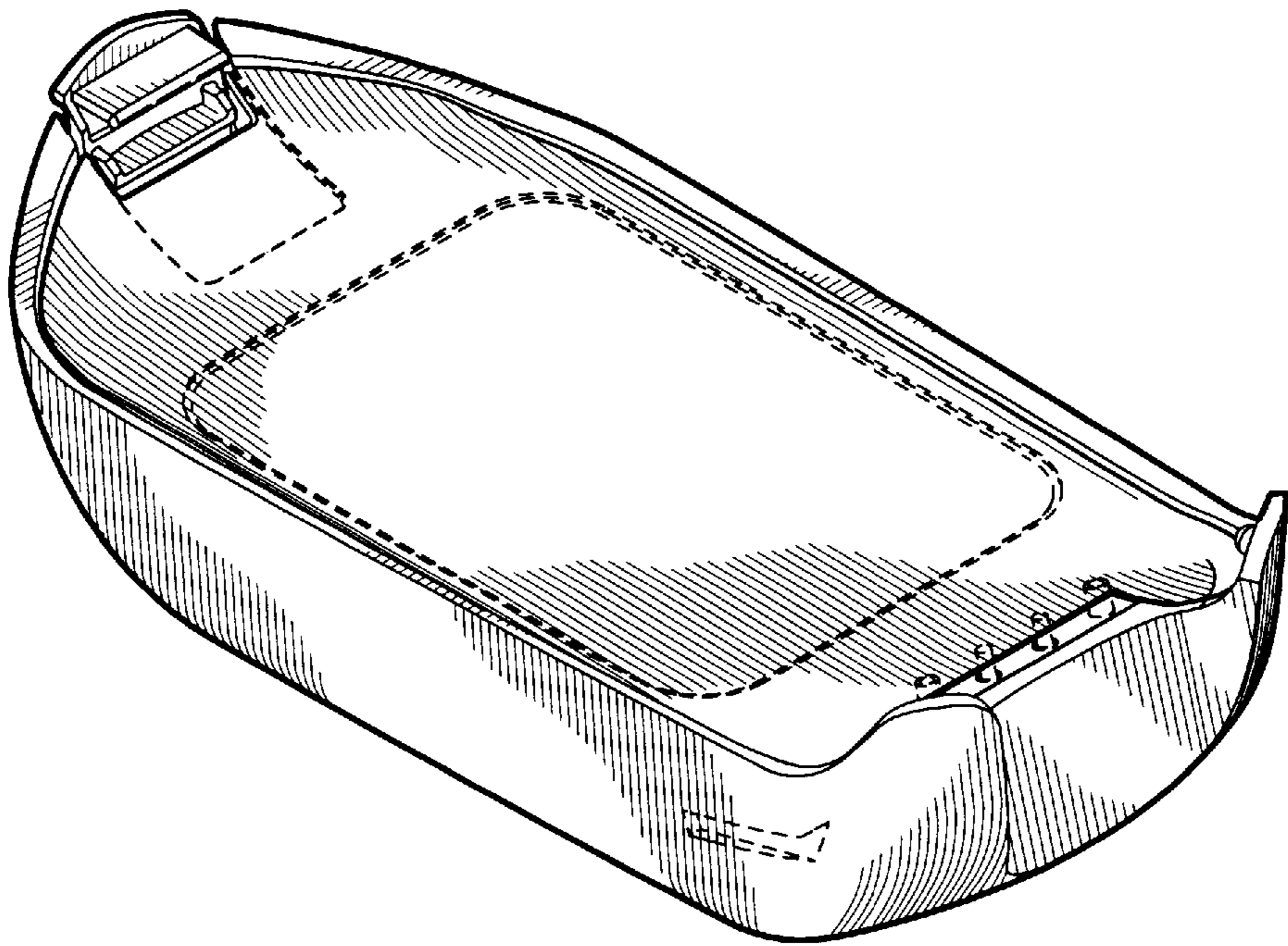

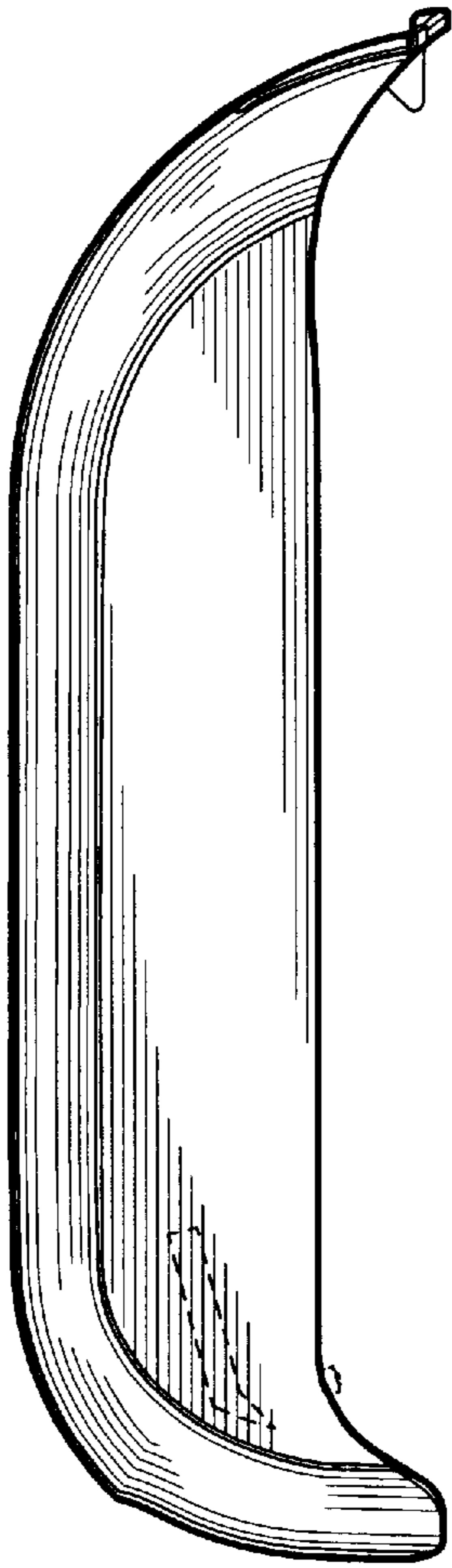

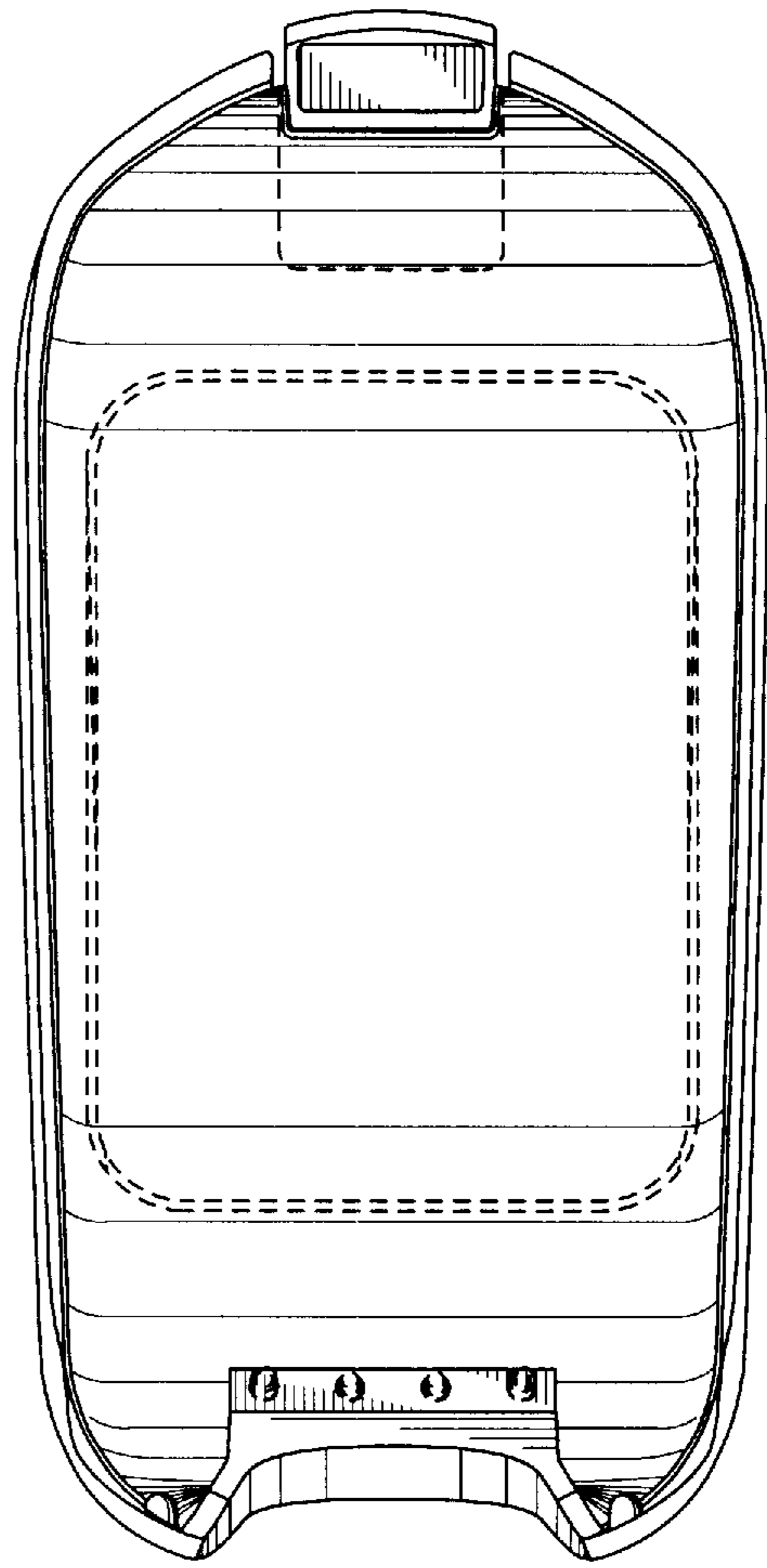

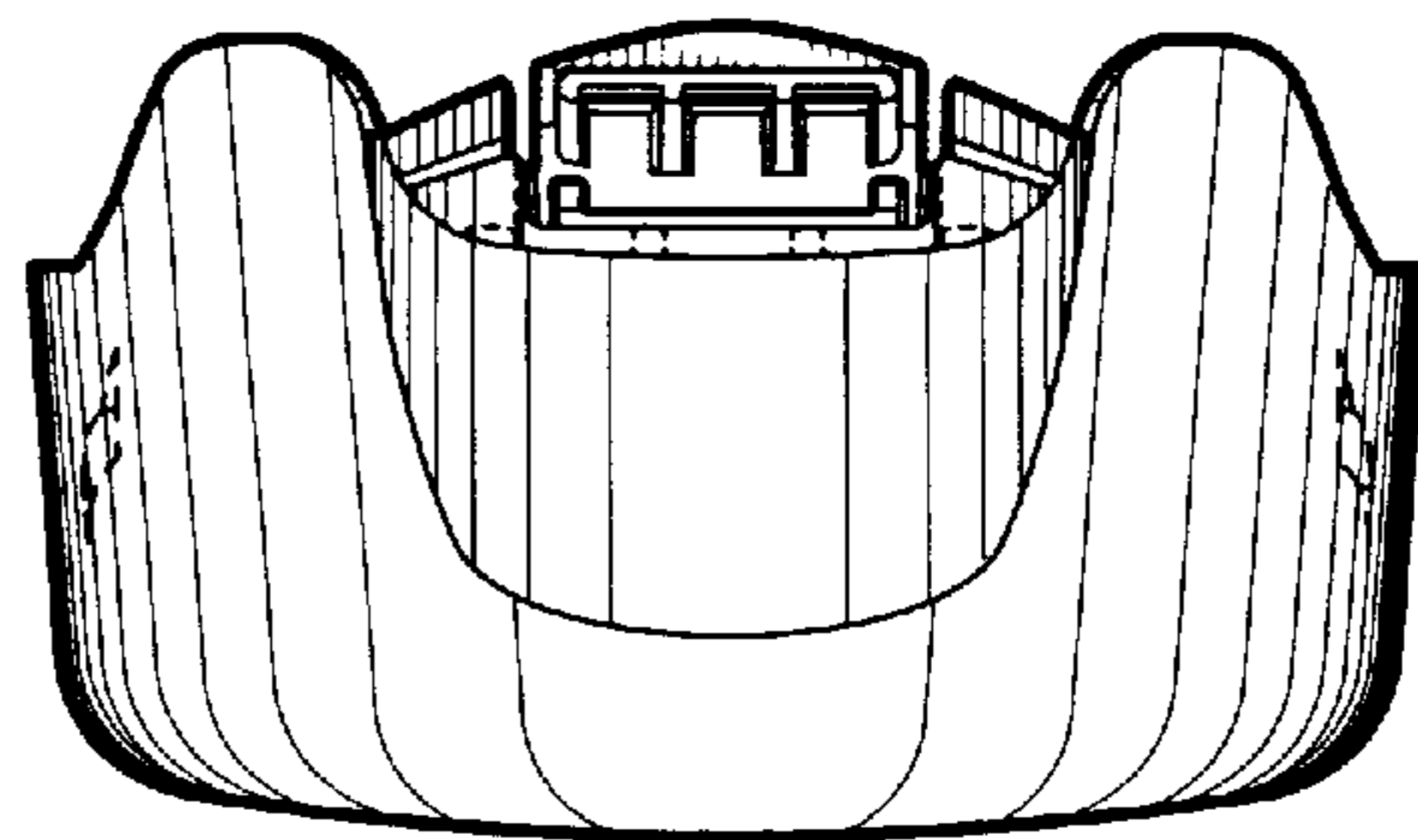

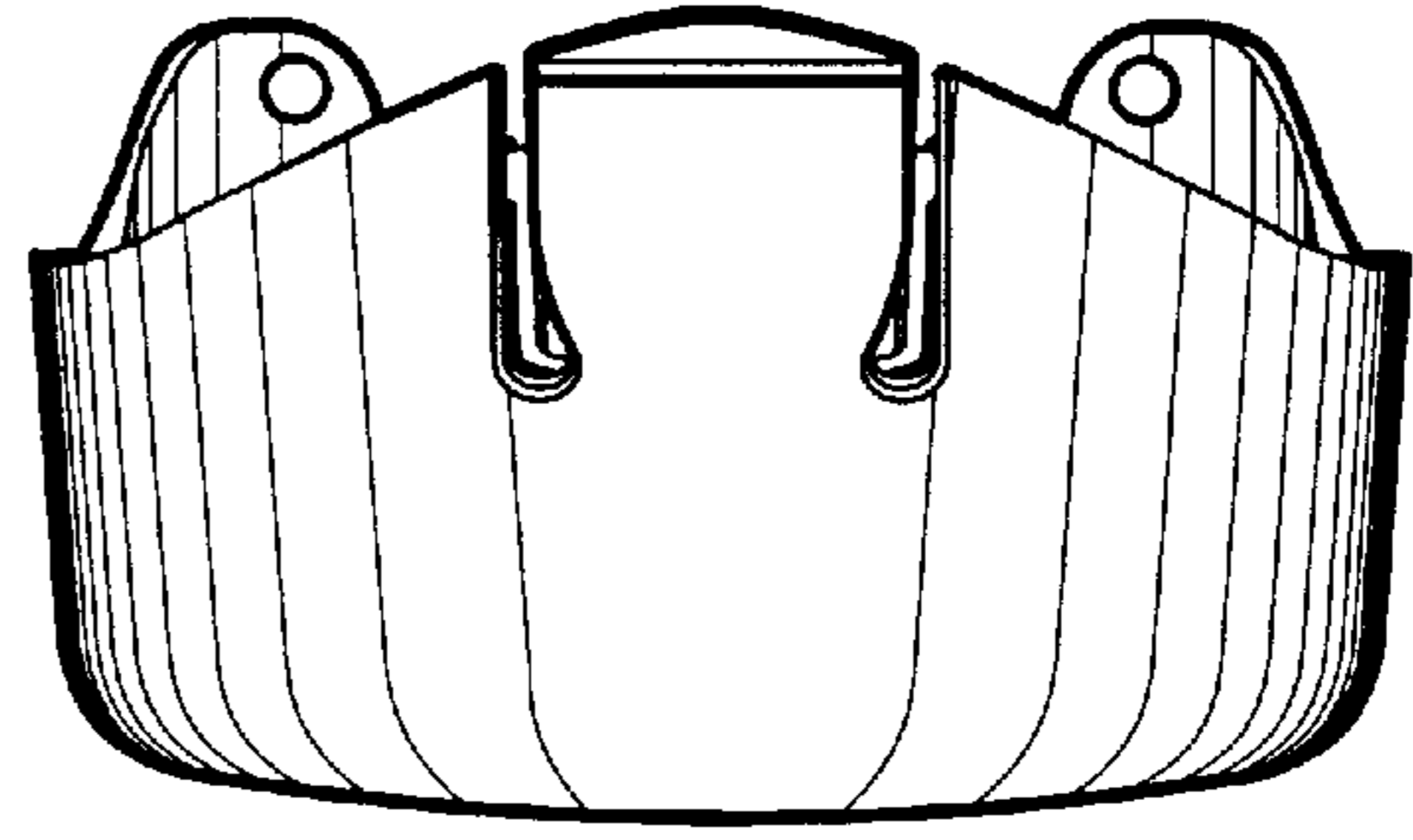

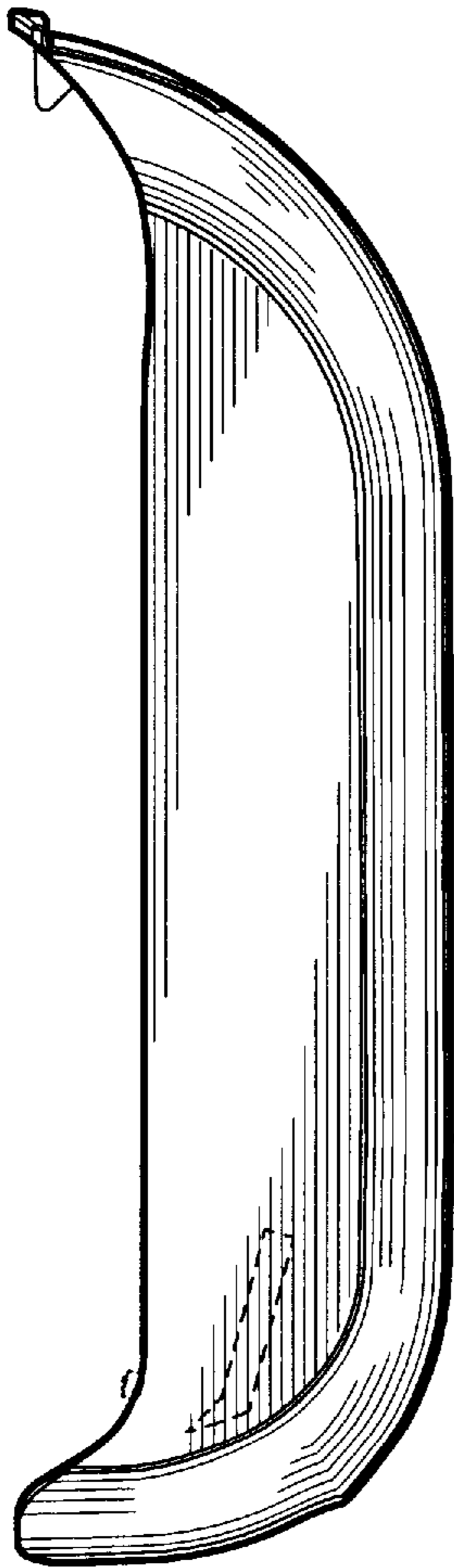

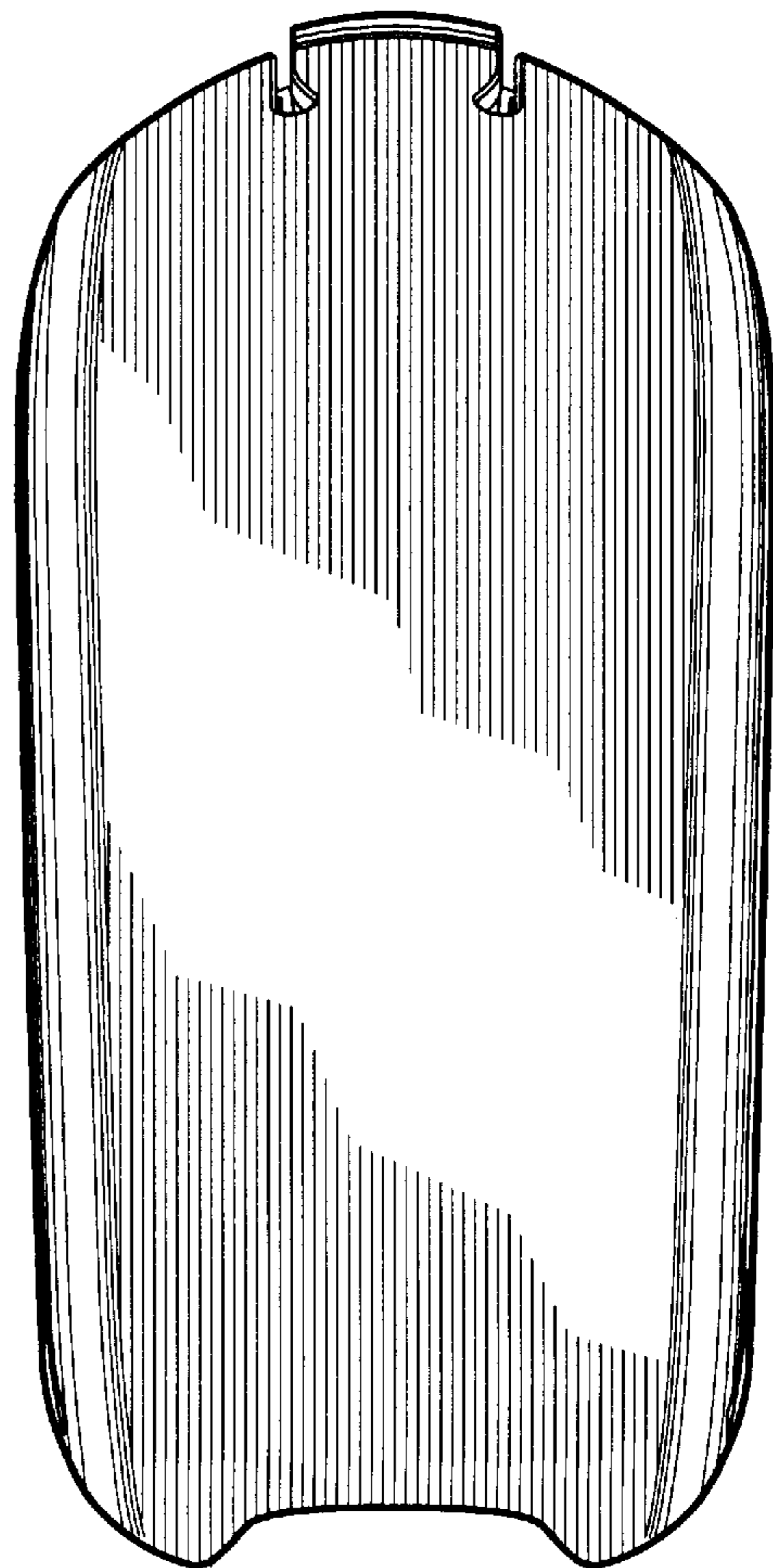

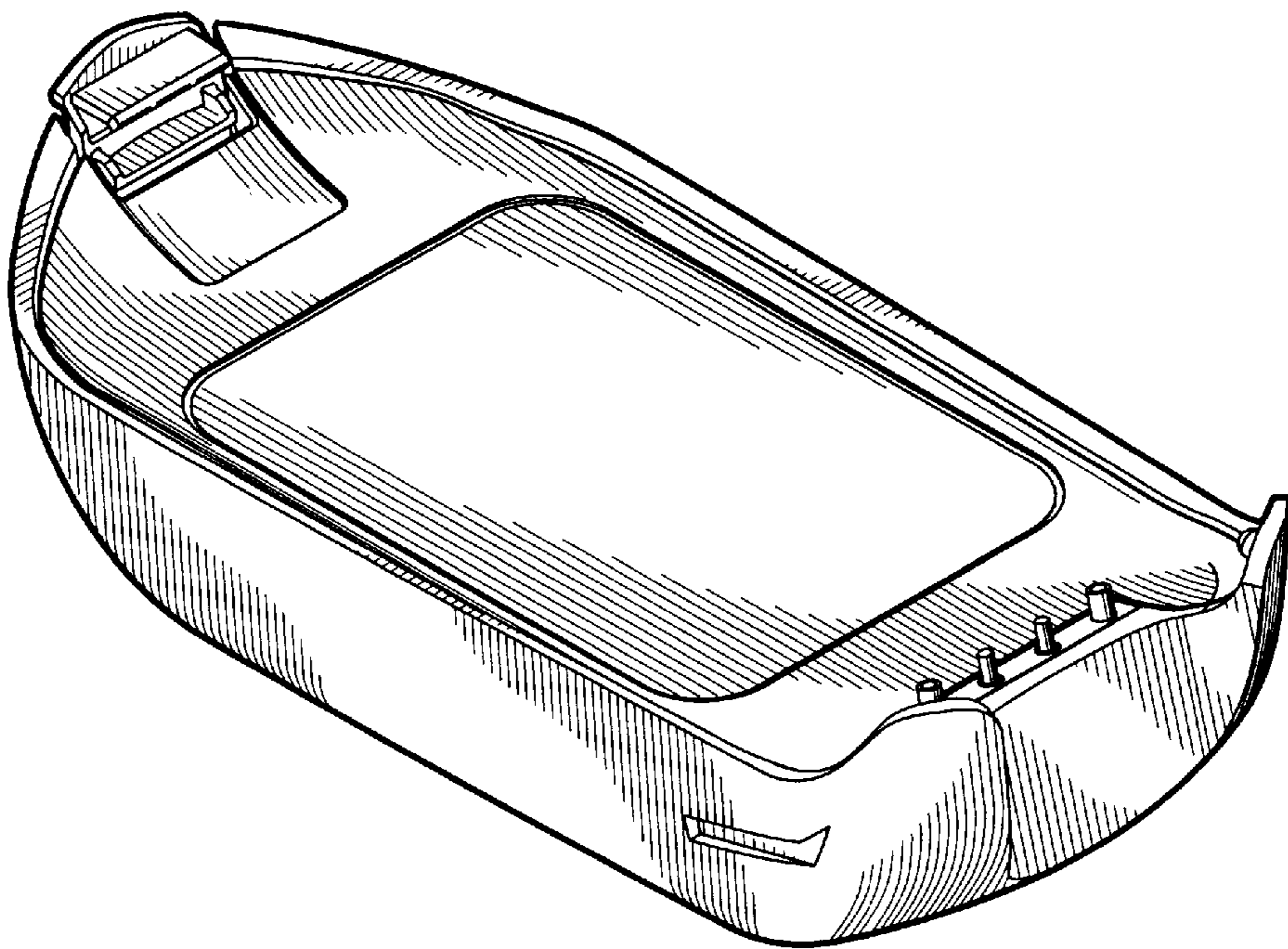

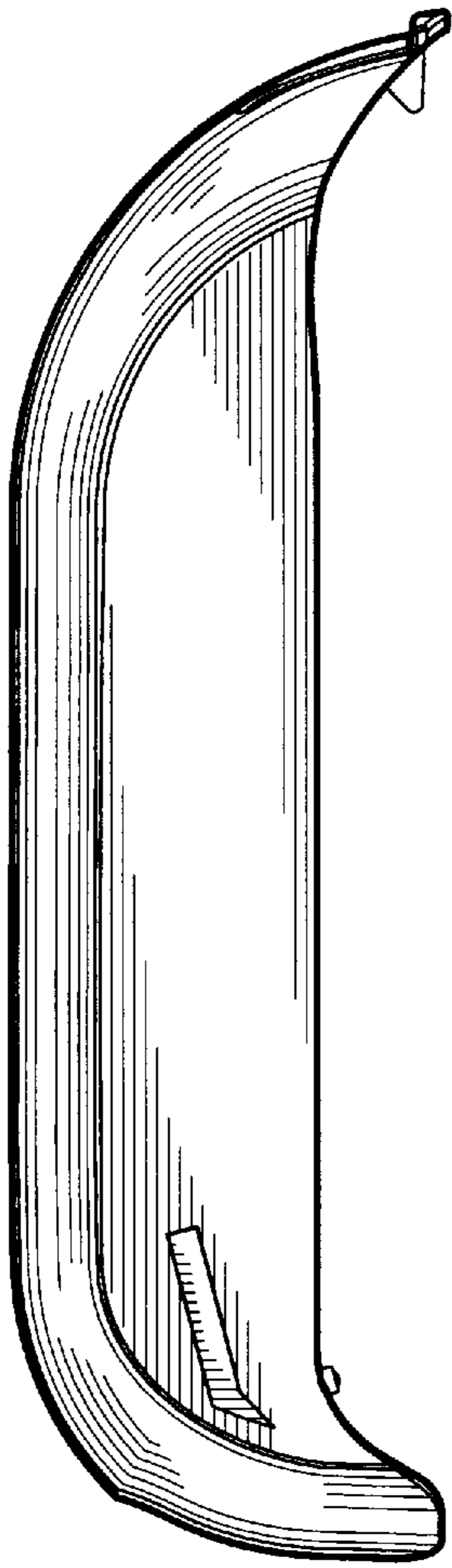

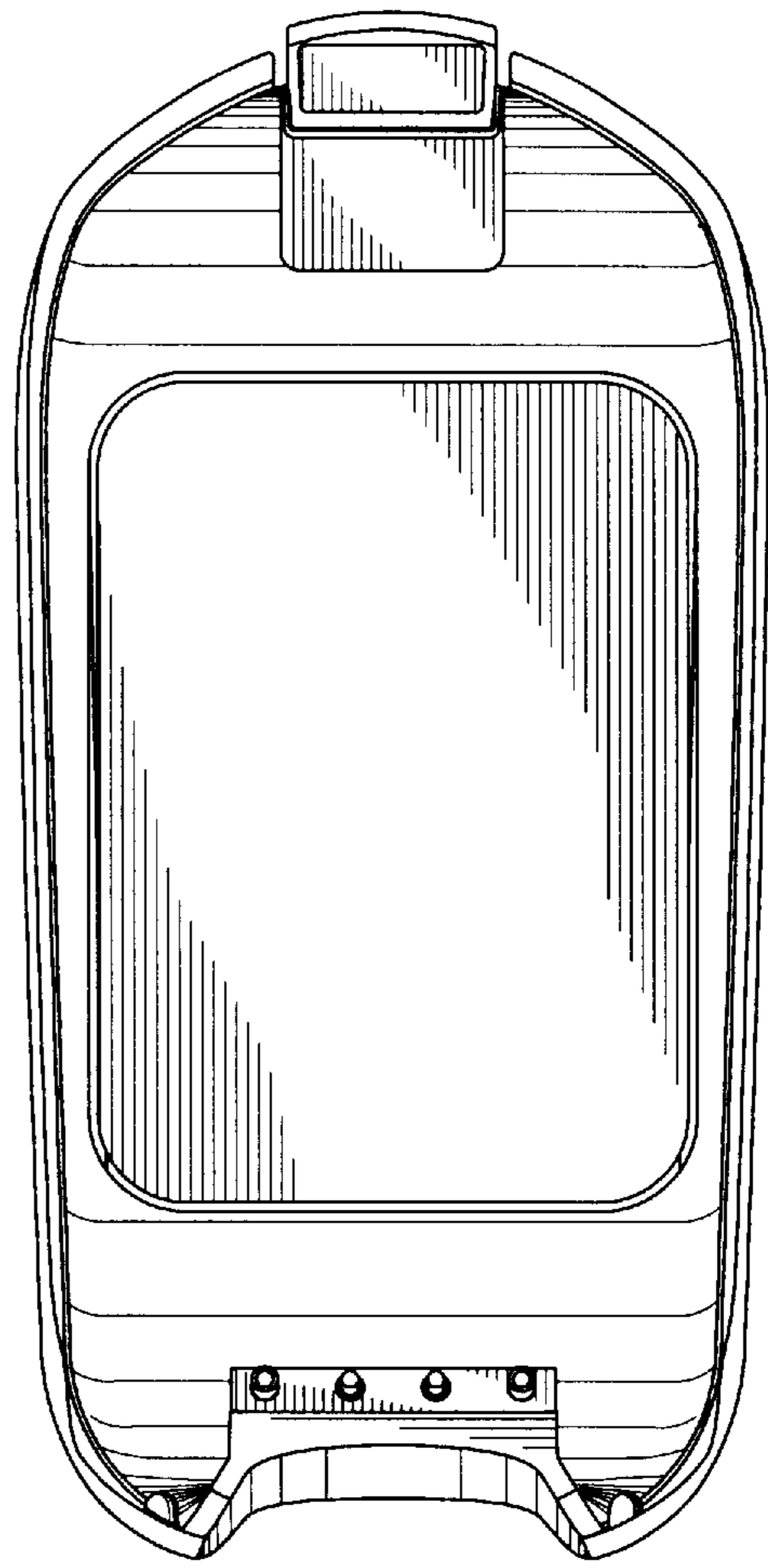

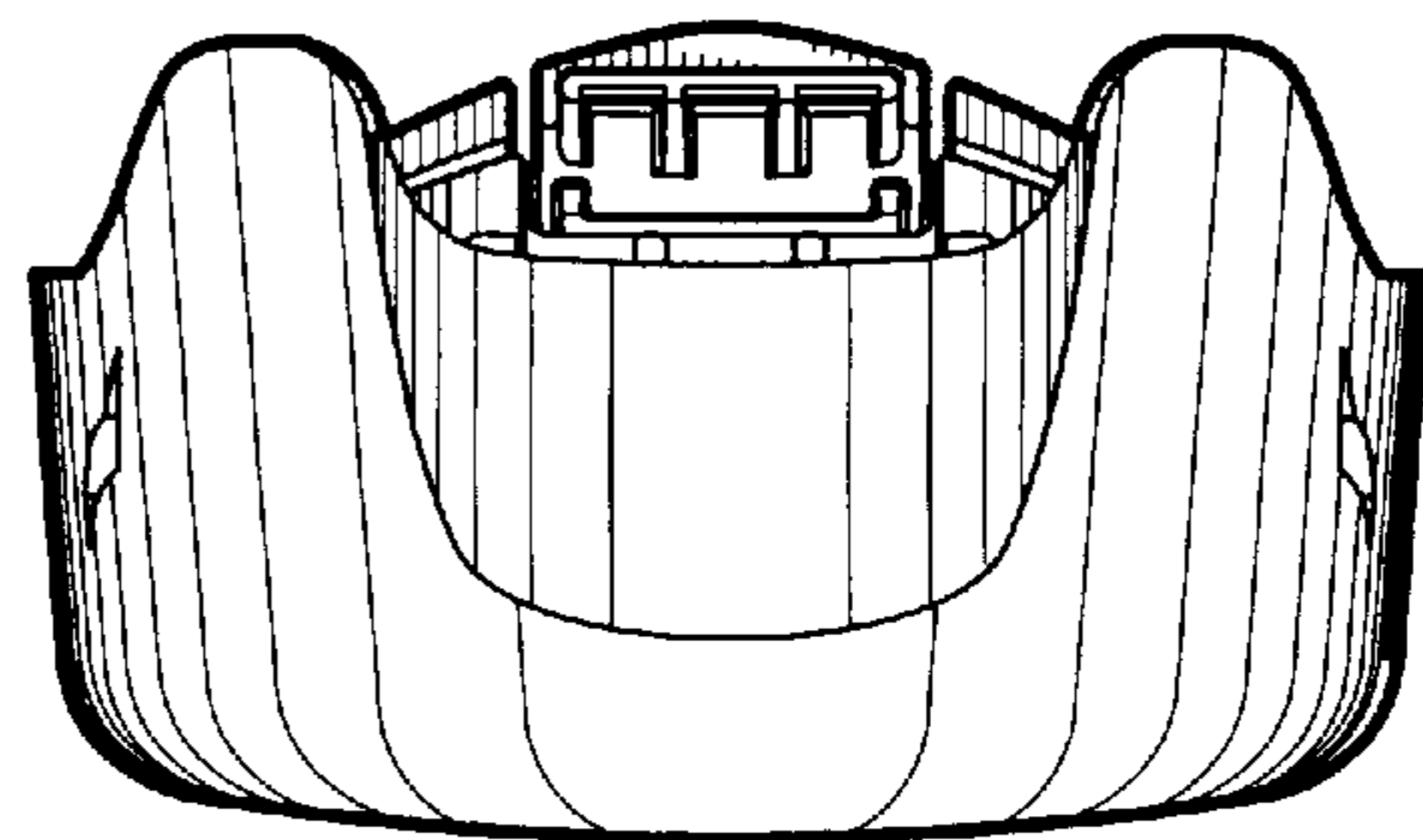

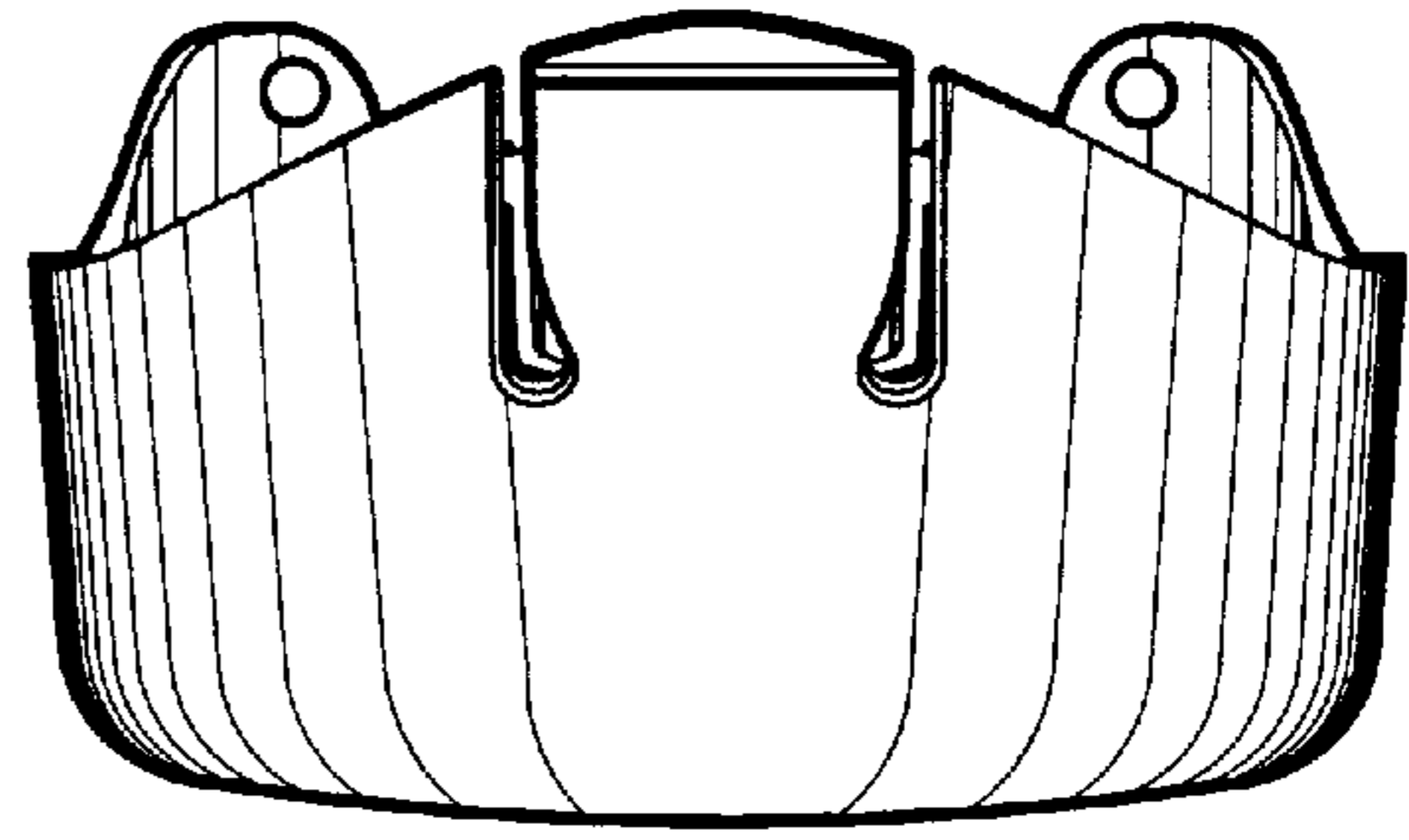

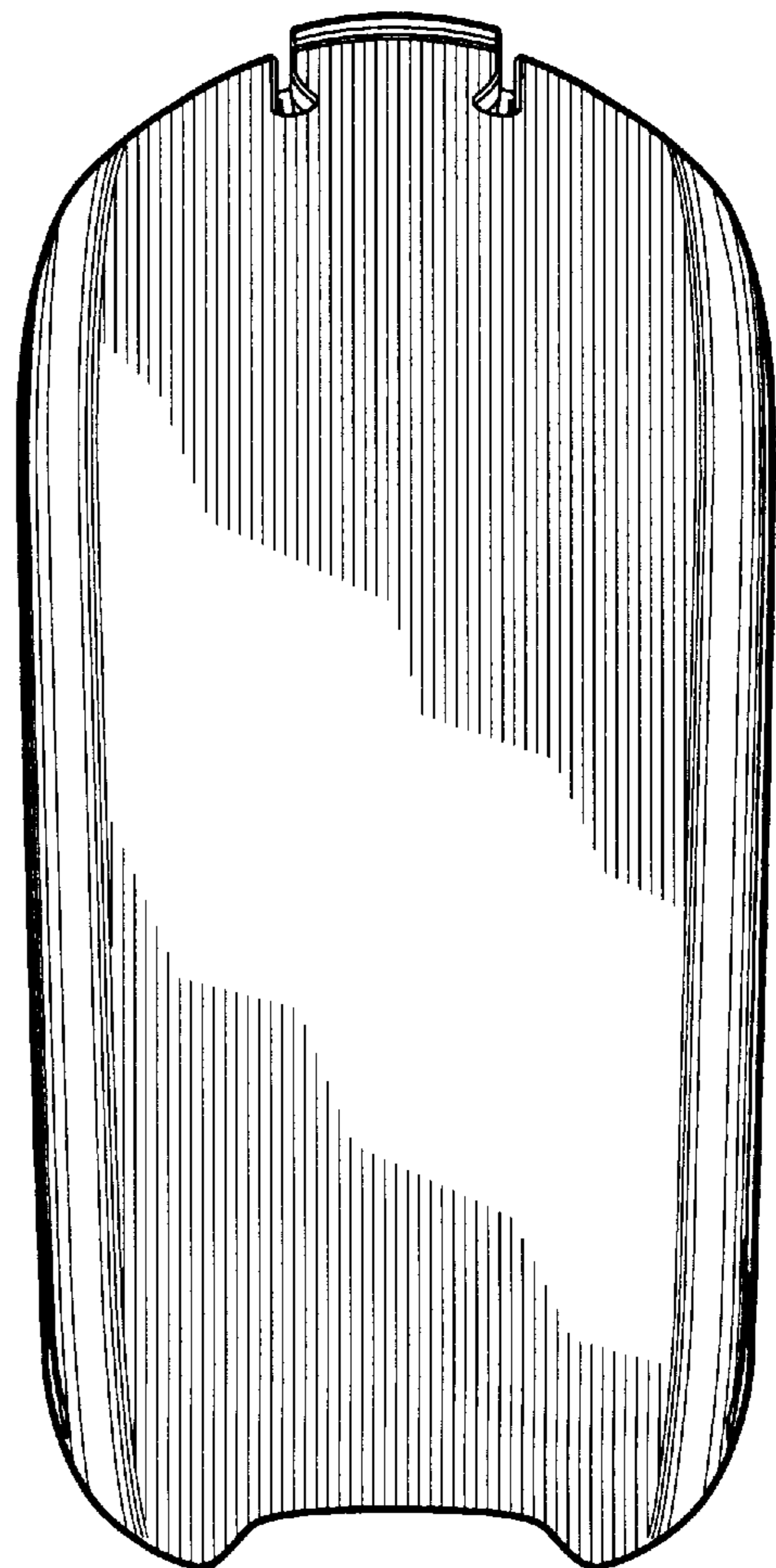
