The ornamental design for a slide top laptop computer workstation, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top left perspective view of a slide top laptop computer workstation showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a top left perspective view with the top tray in extended position for convenience of illustration;
FIG. 3 is a top right perspective view with the lower shelf in extended position for convenience of illustration;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side elevational view being a mirror image of FIG. 5;
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof; and,
FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view thereof.

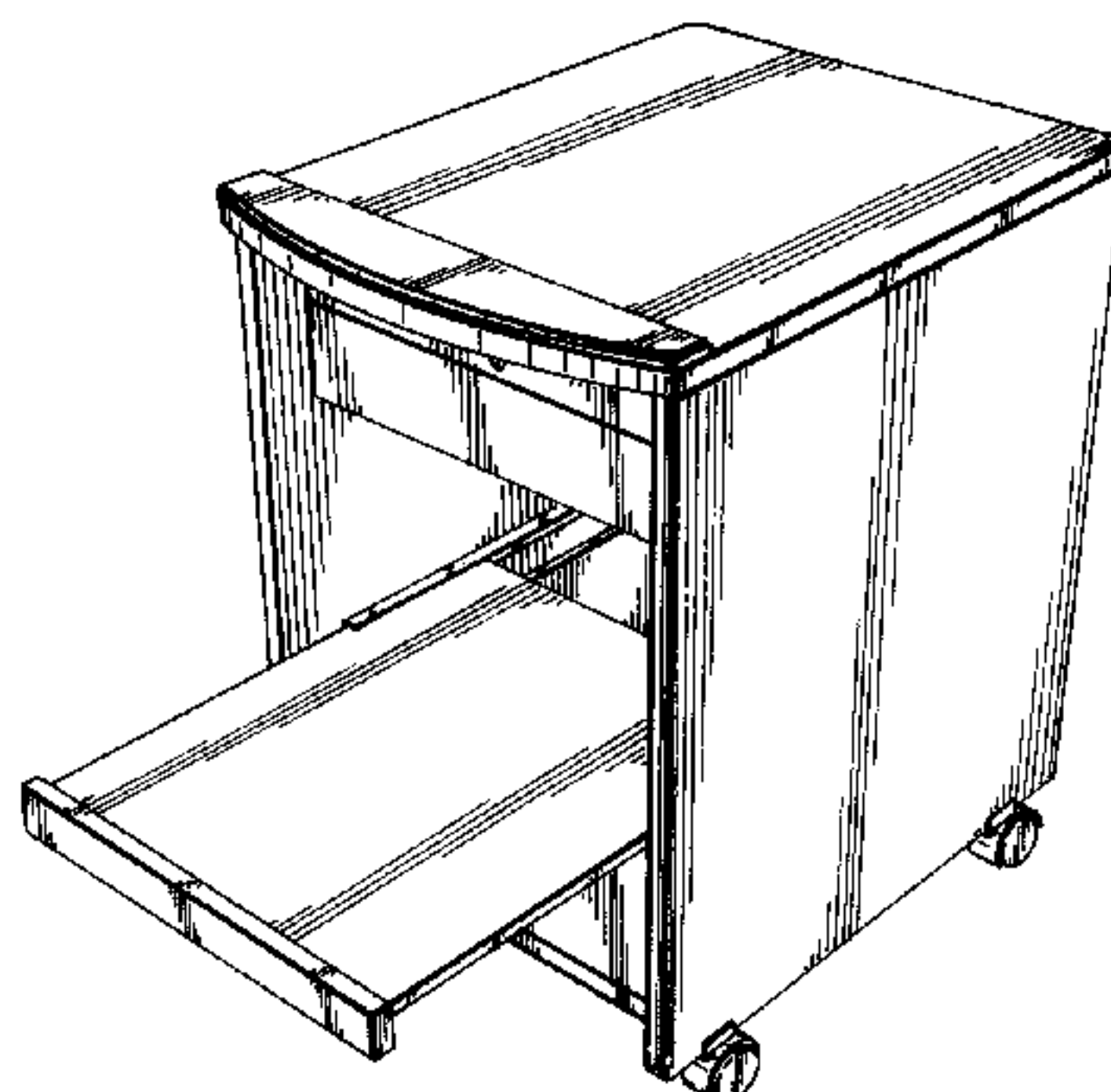
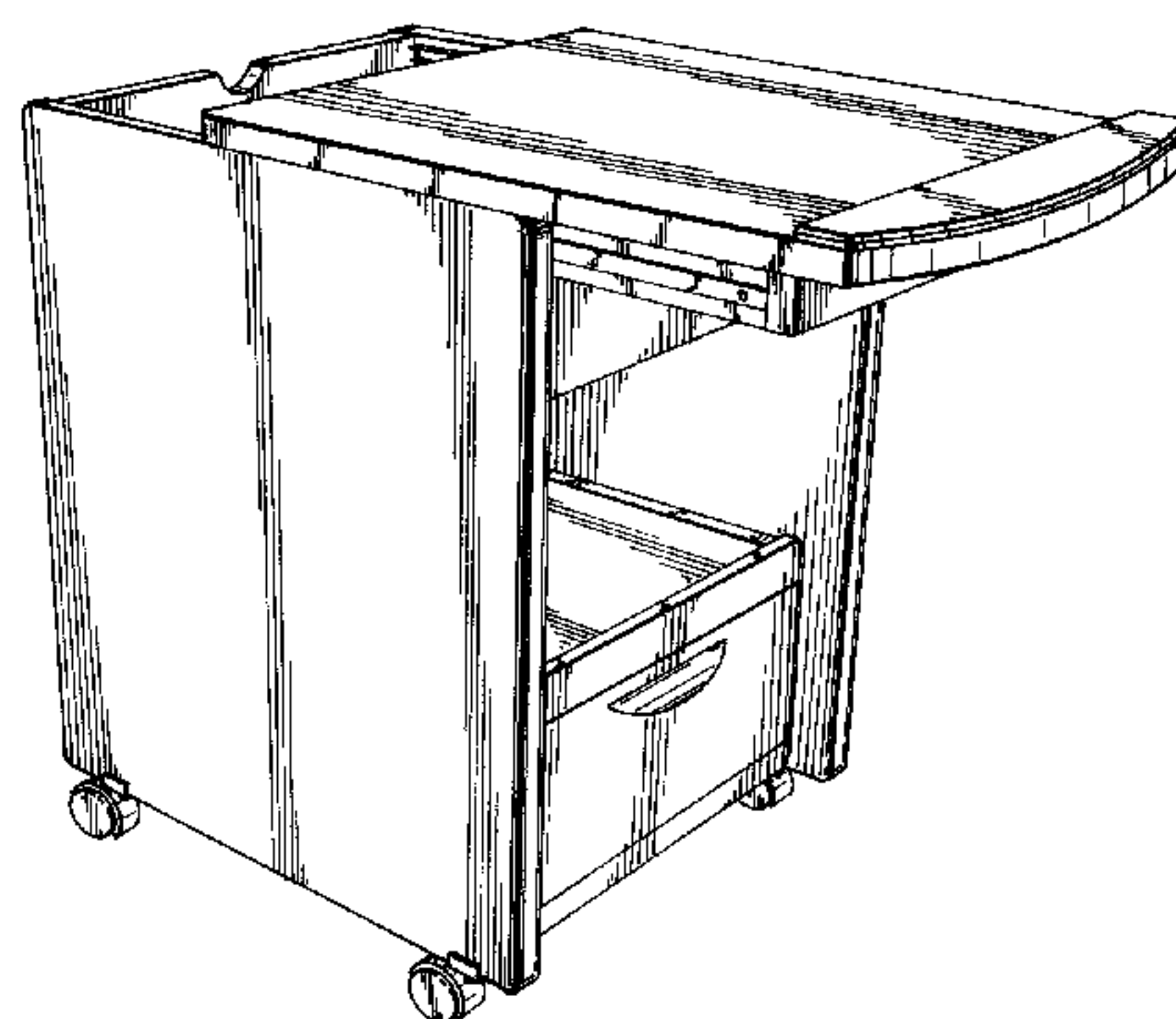
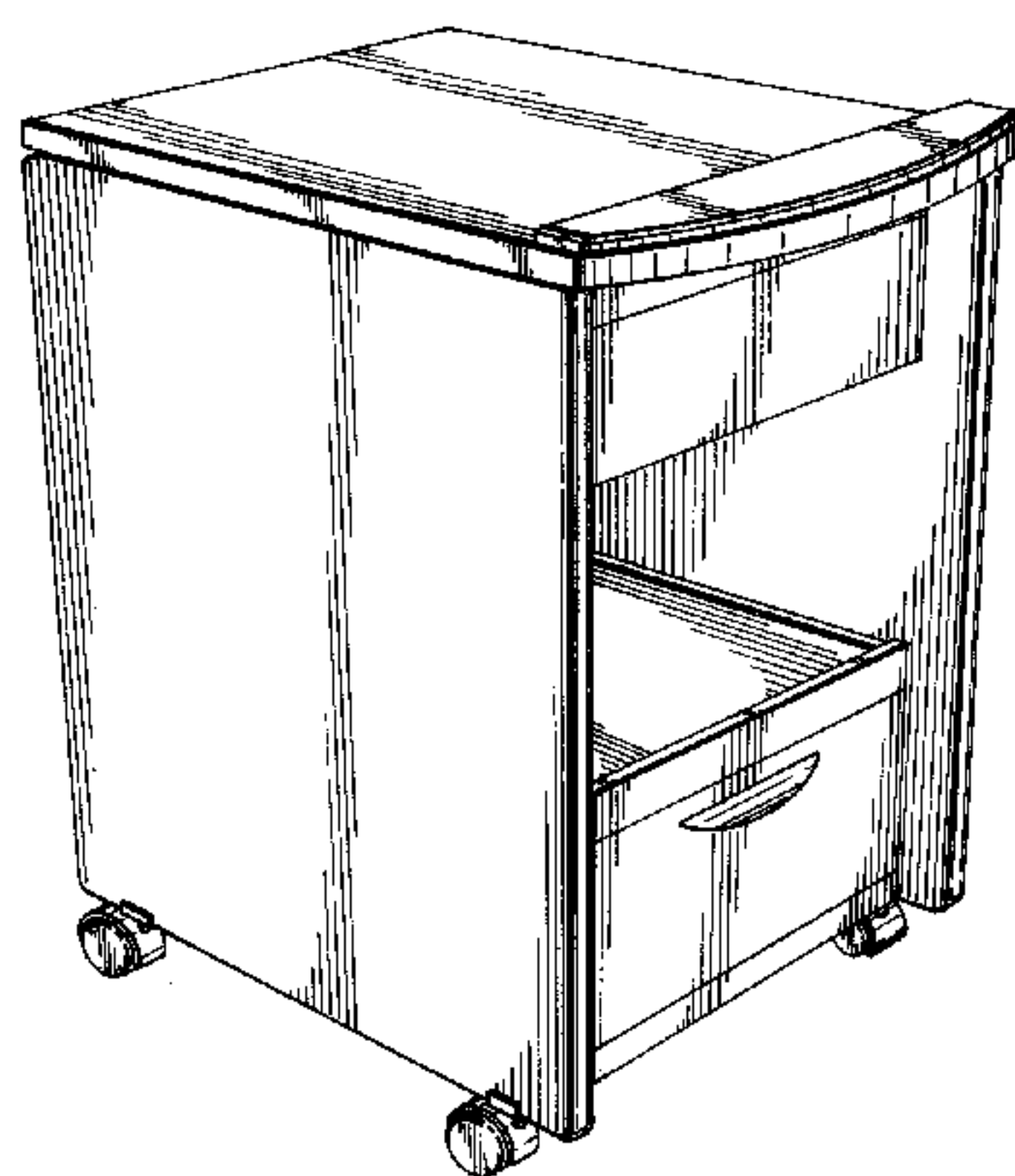

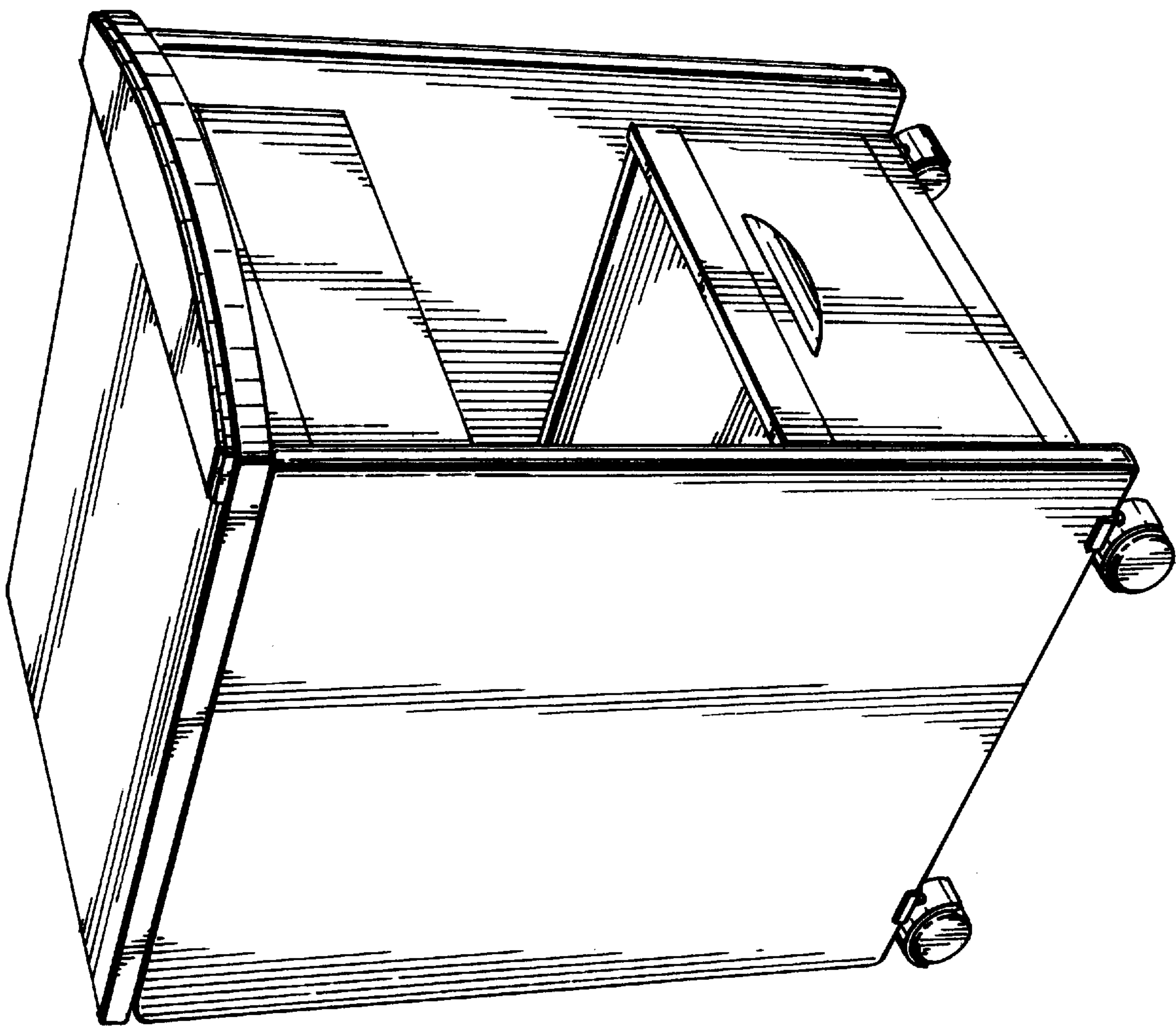

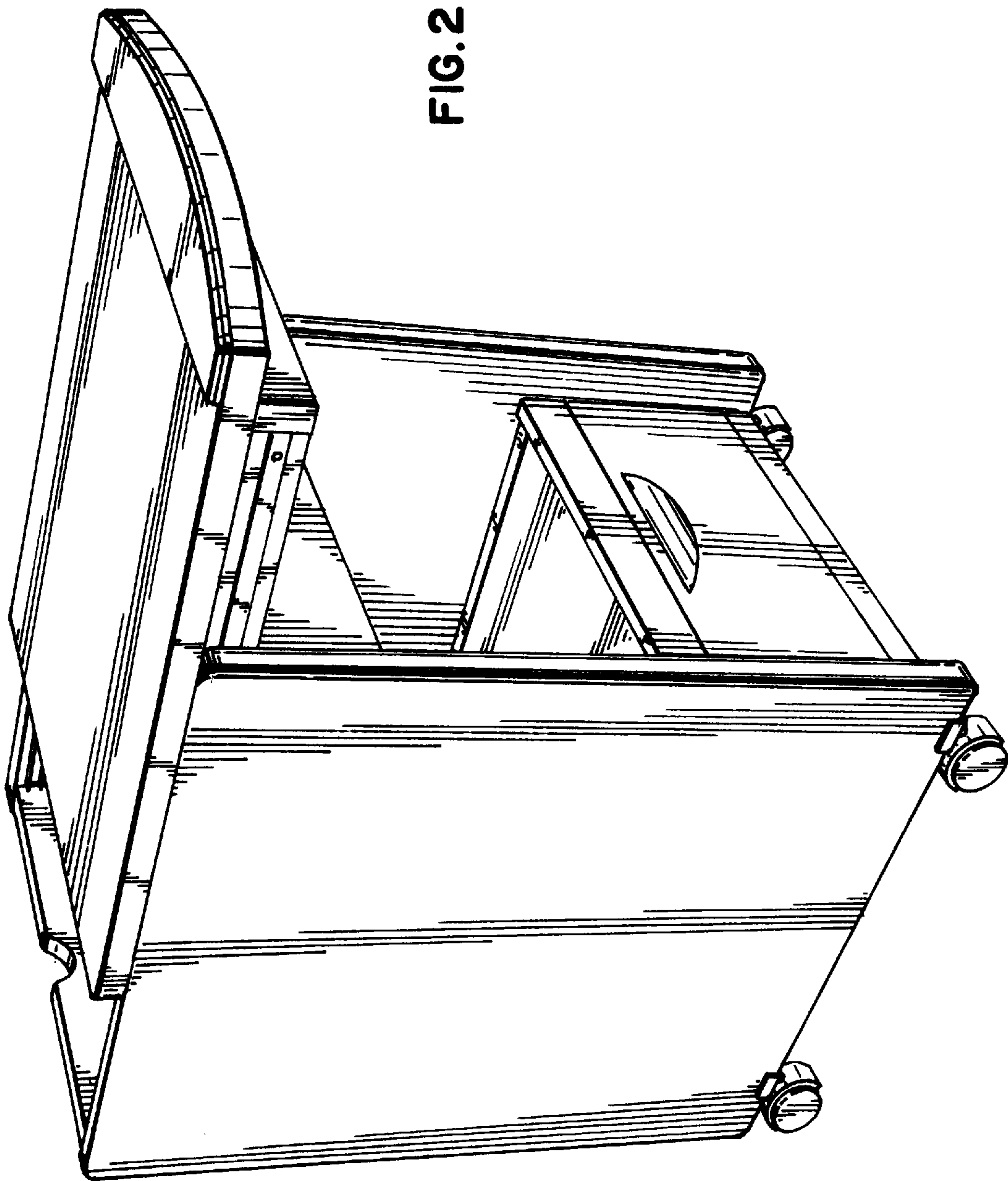
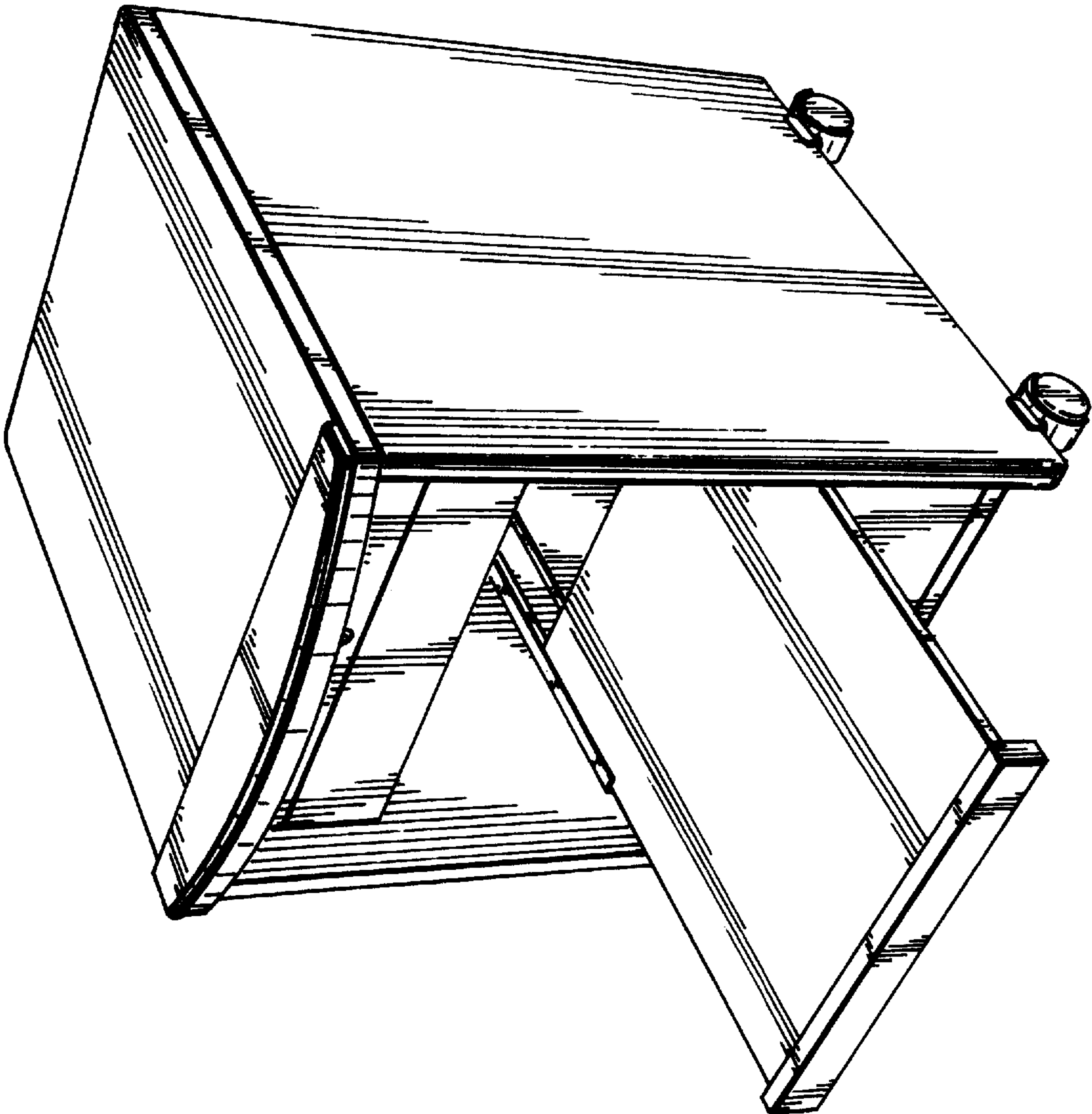

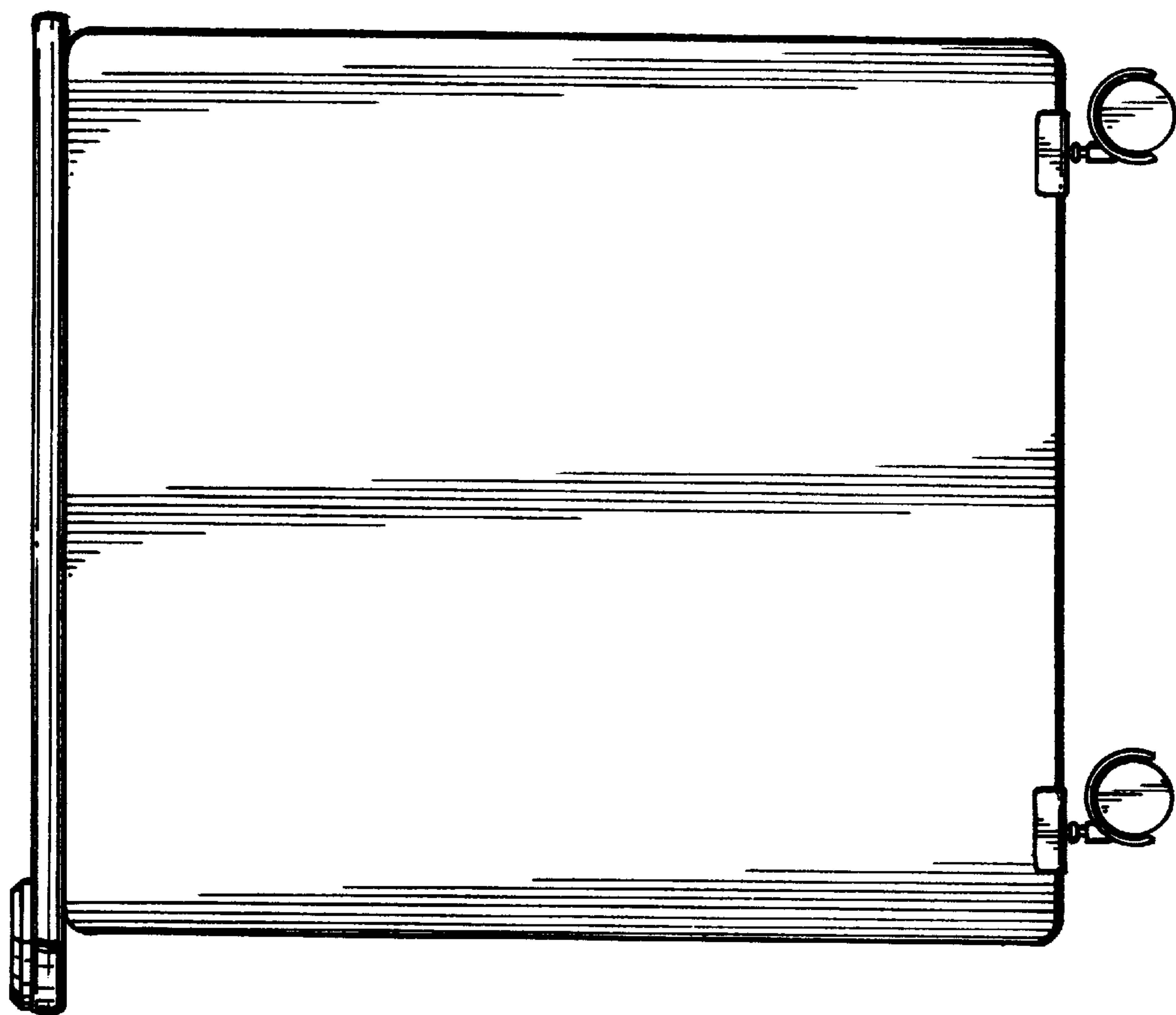

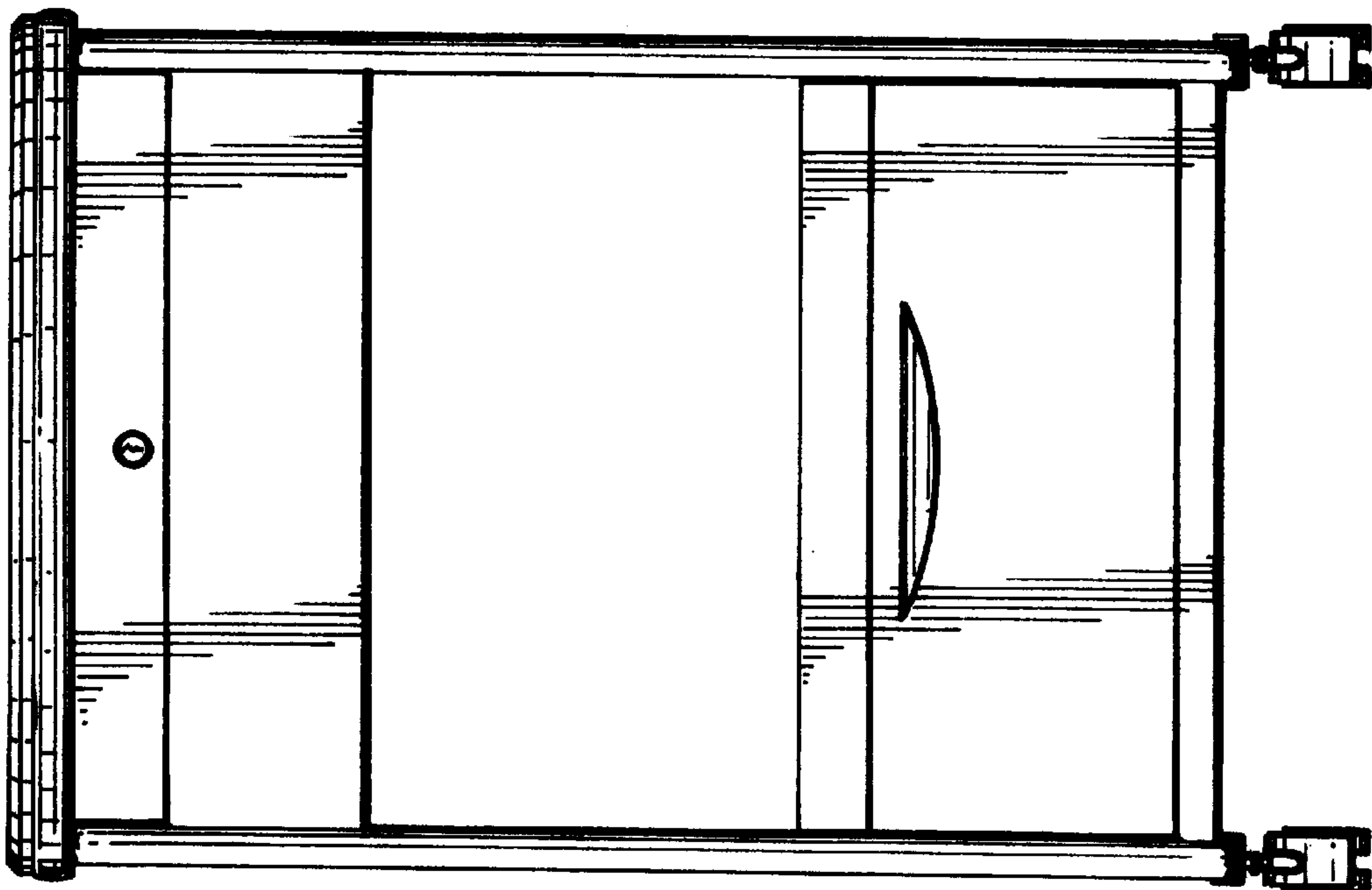

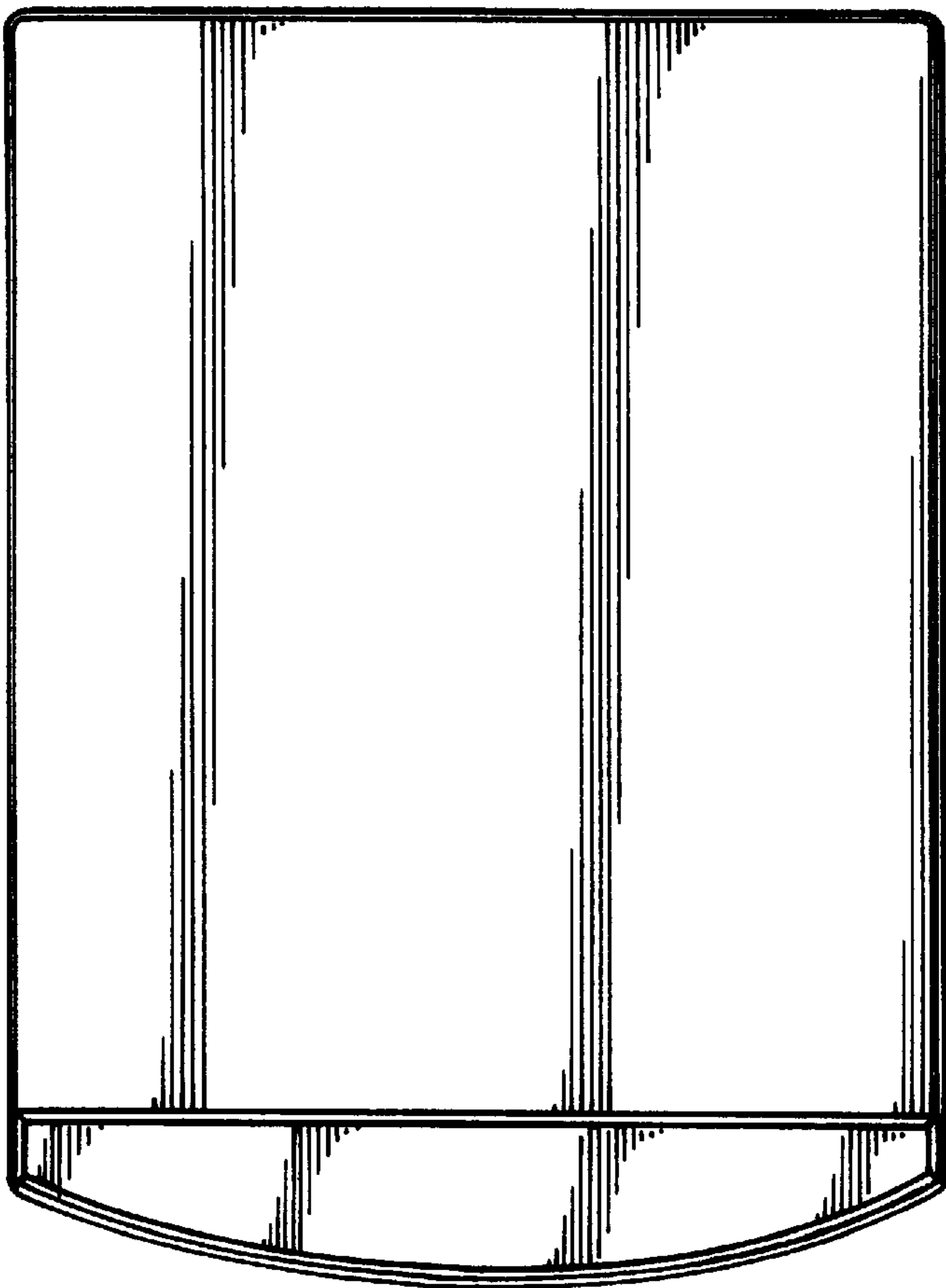

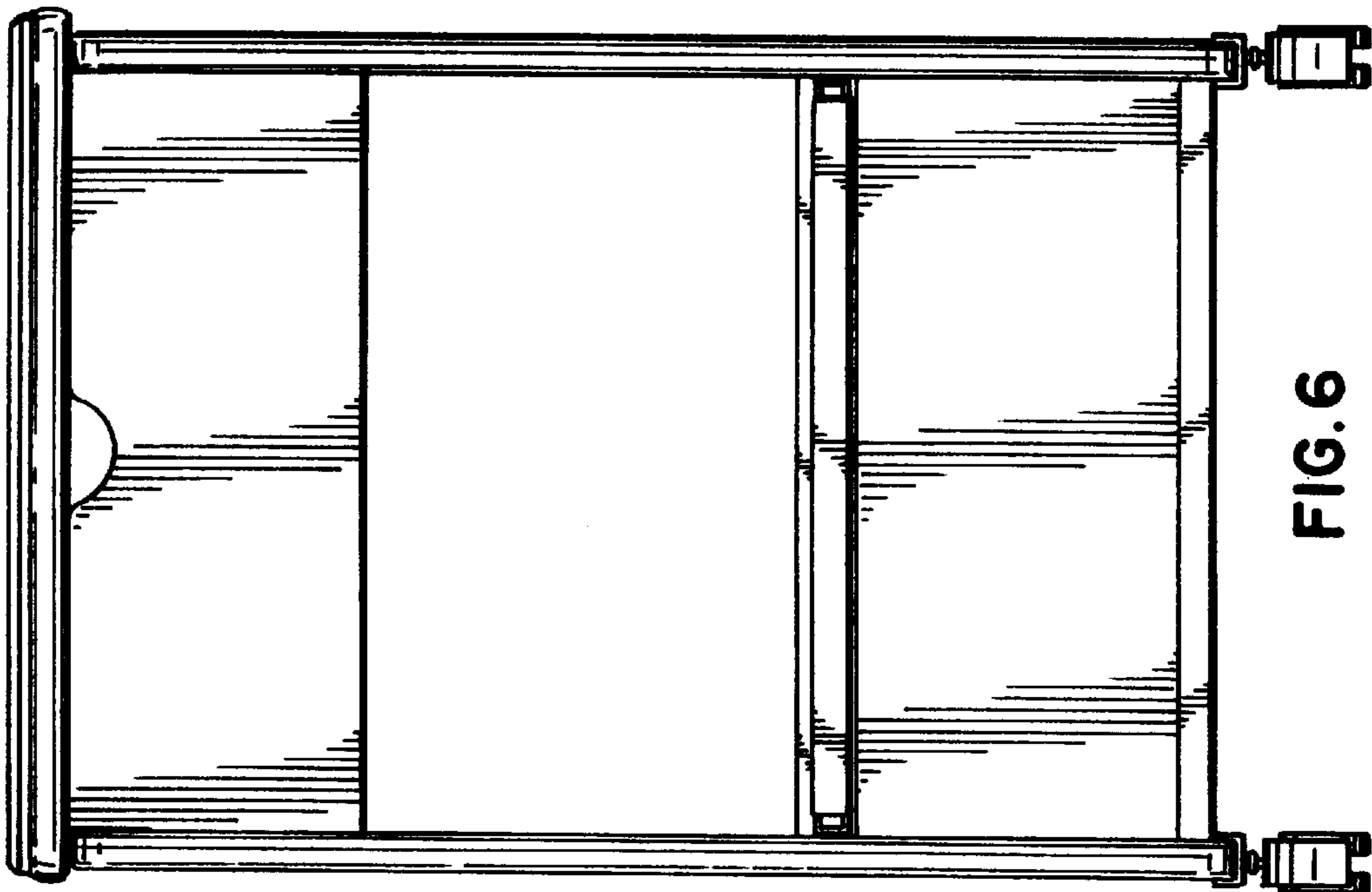

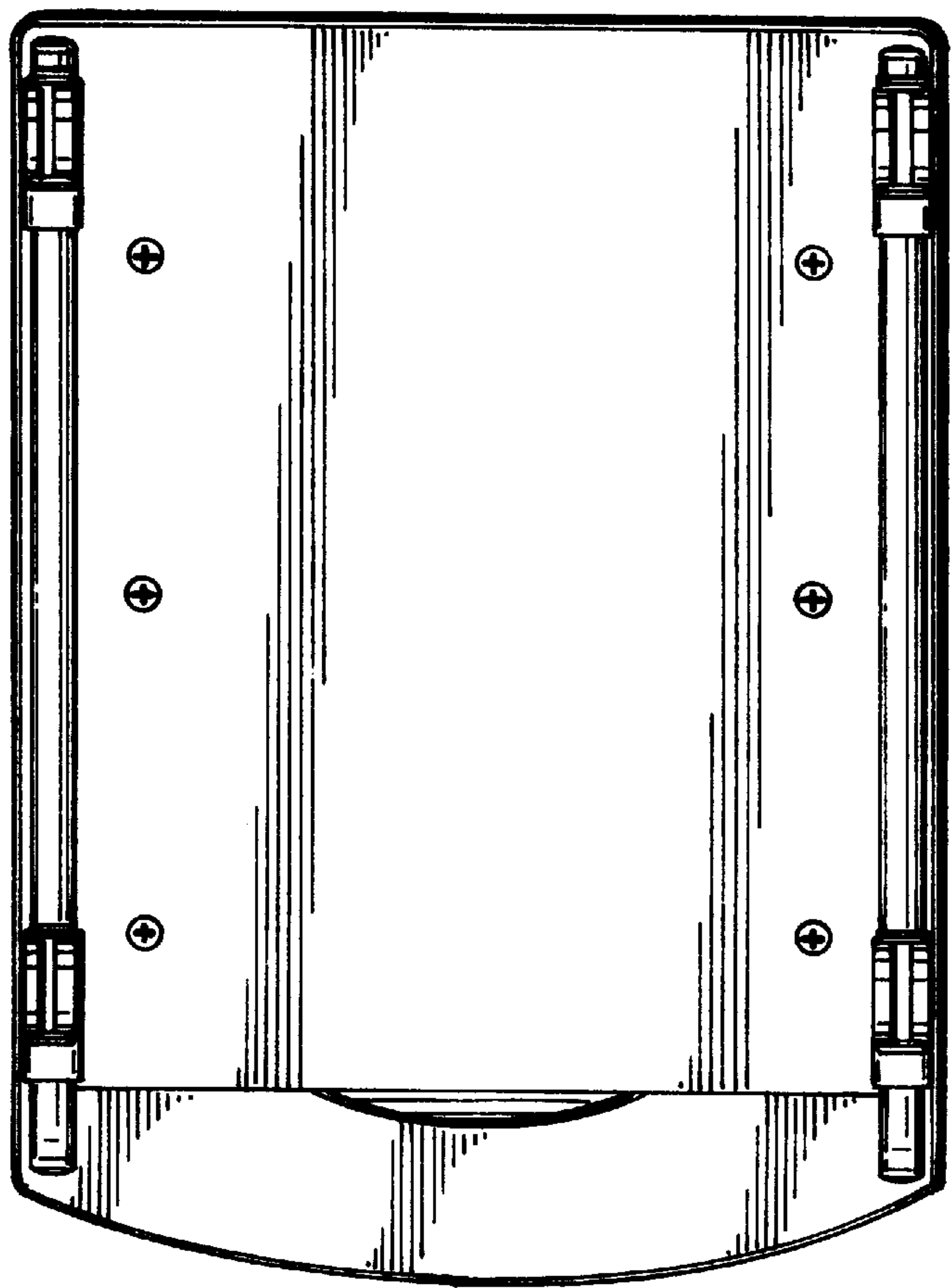
