raised Kokopelli design;

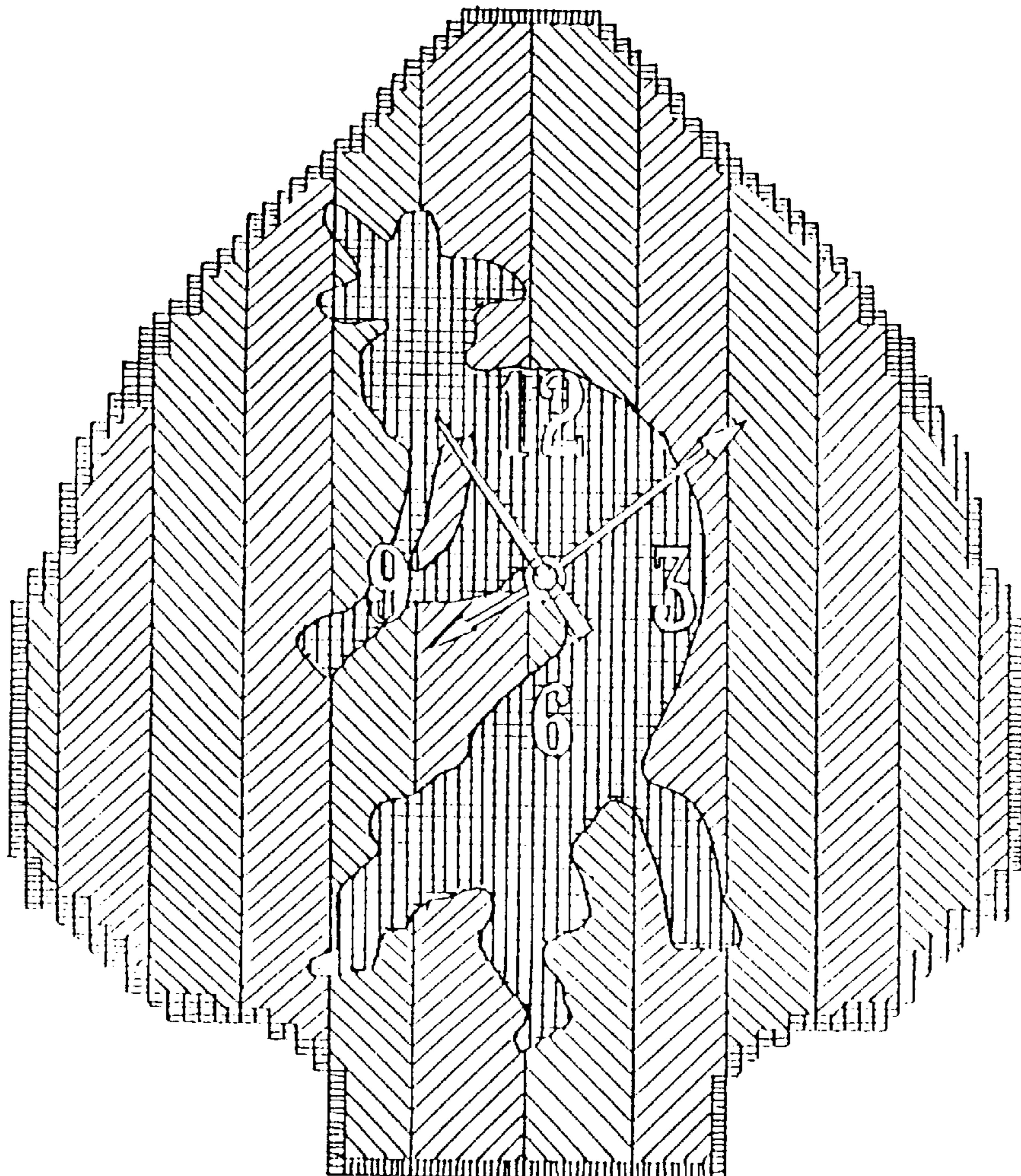

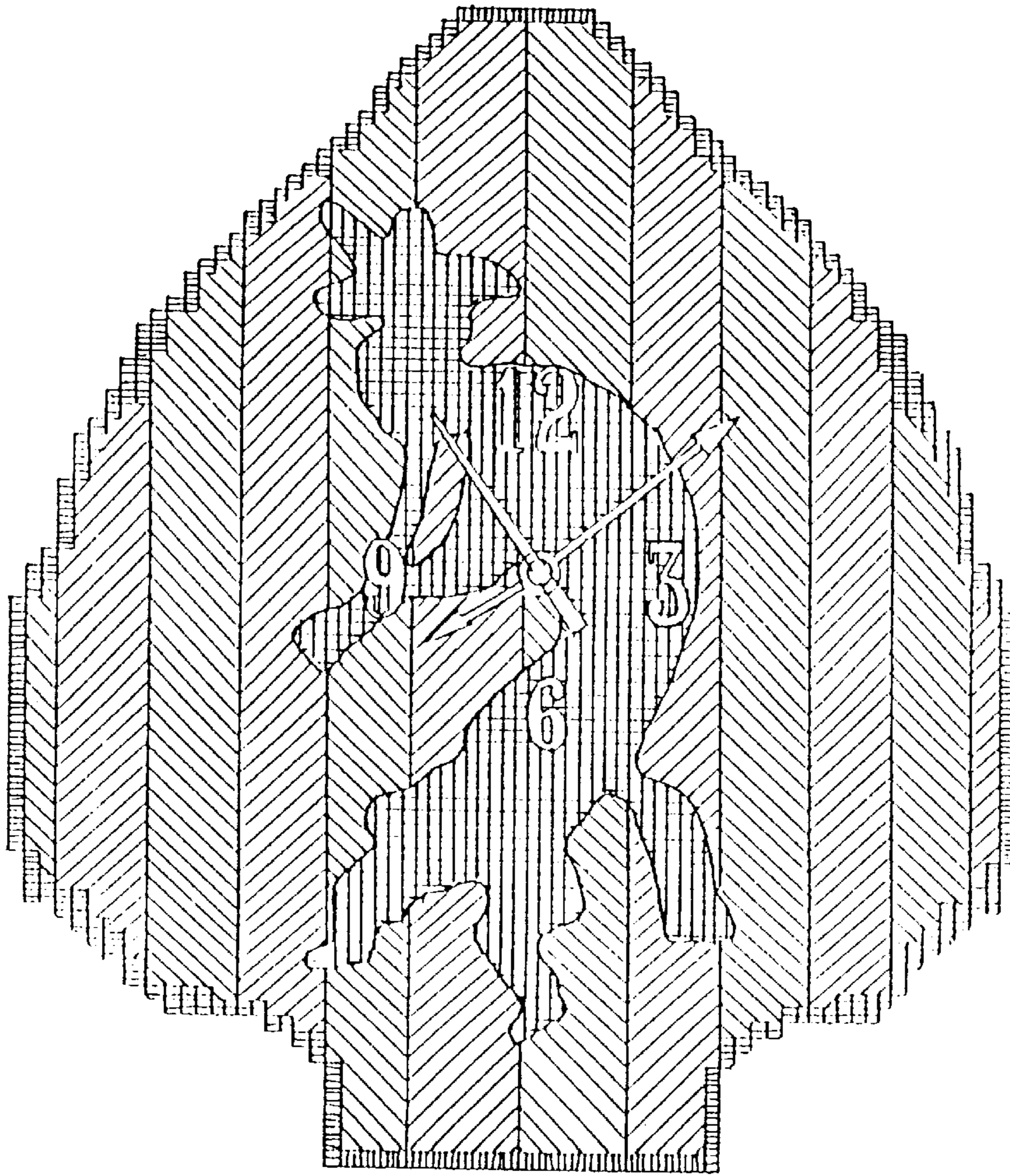

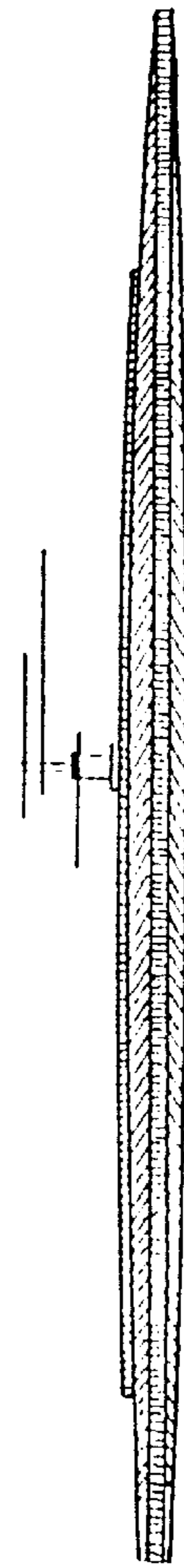

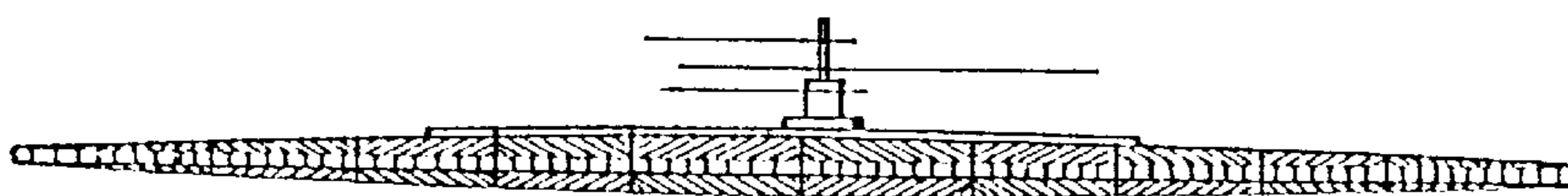

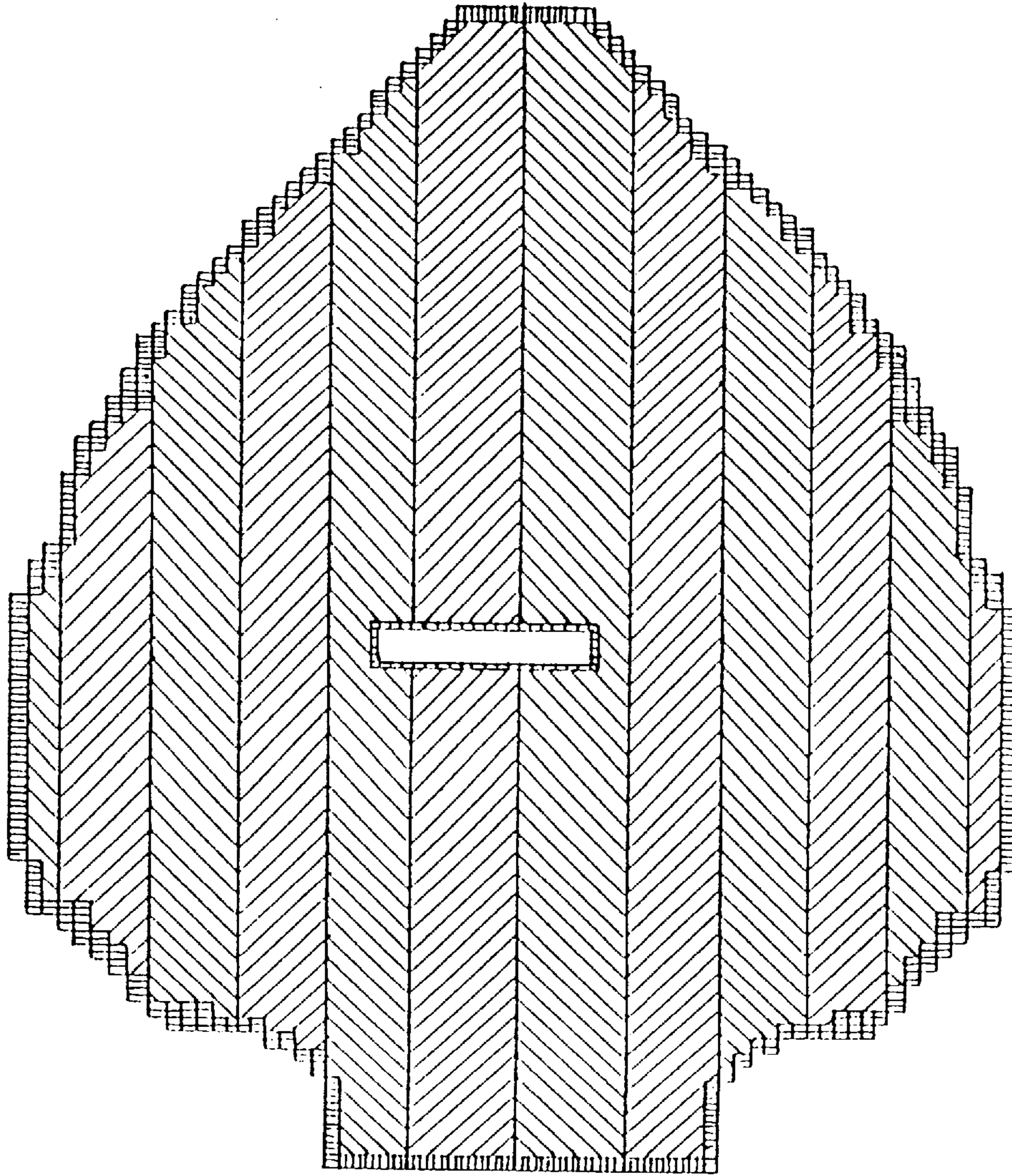
