The ornamental design for a shoe element, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a shoe element showing my new design, the shoe shown in broken lines for environmental purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being a mirror image;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of FIG. 1;

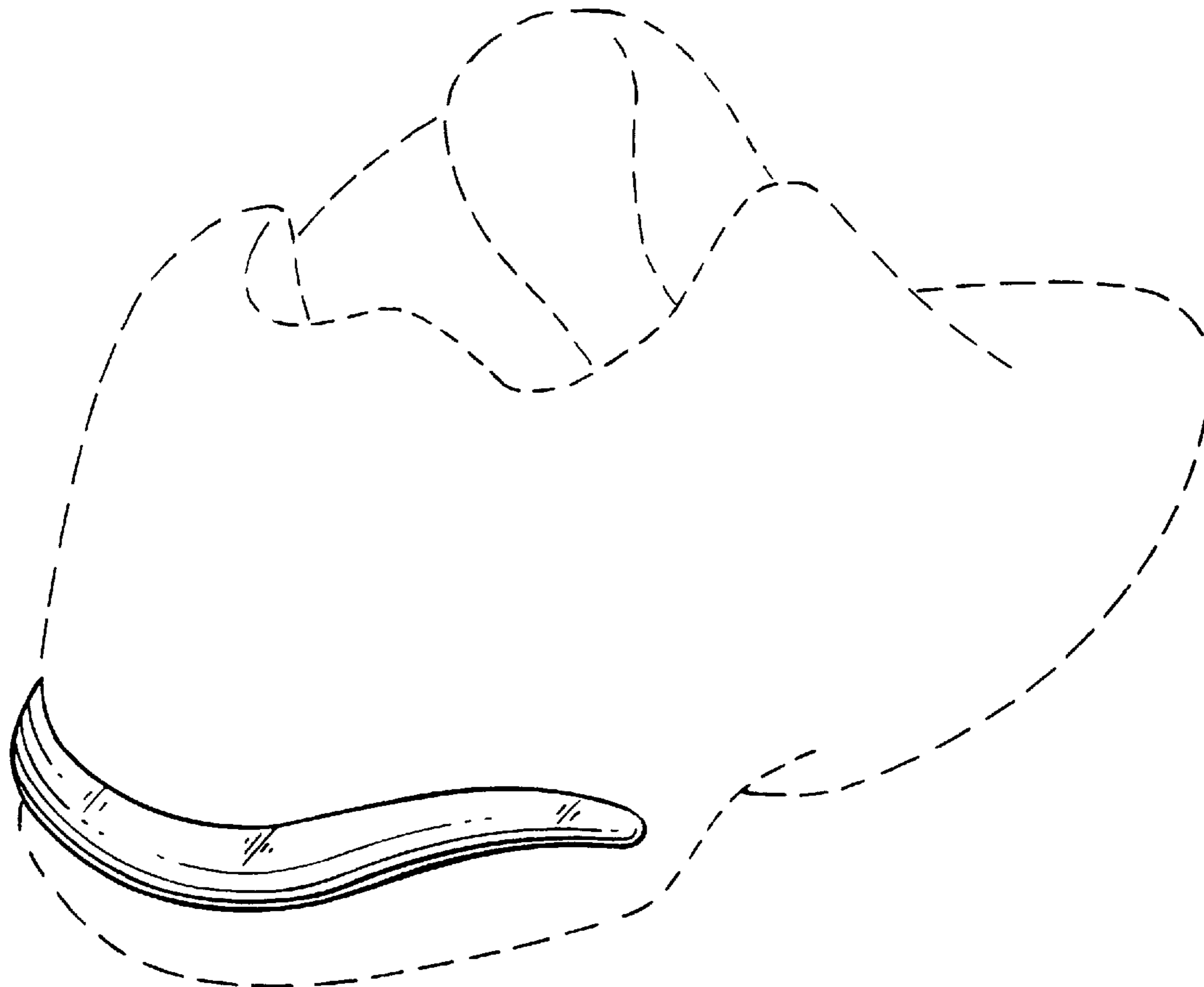
FIG. 7 is a top plan view of FIG. 6;

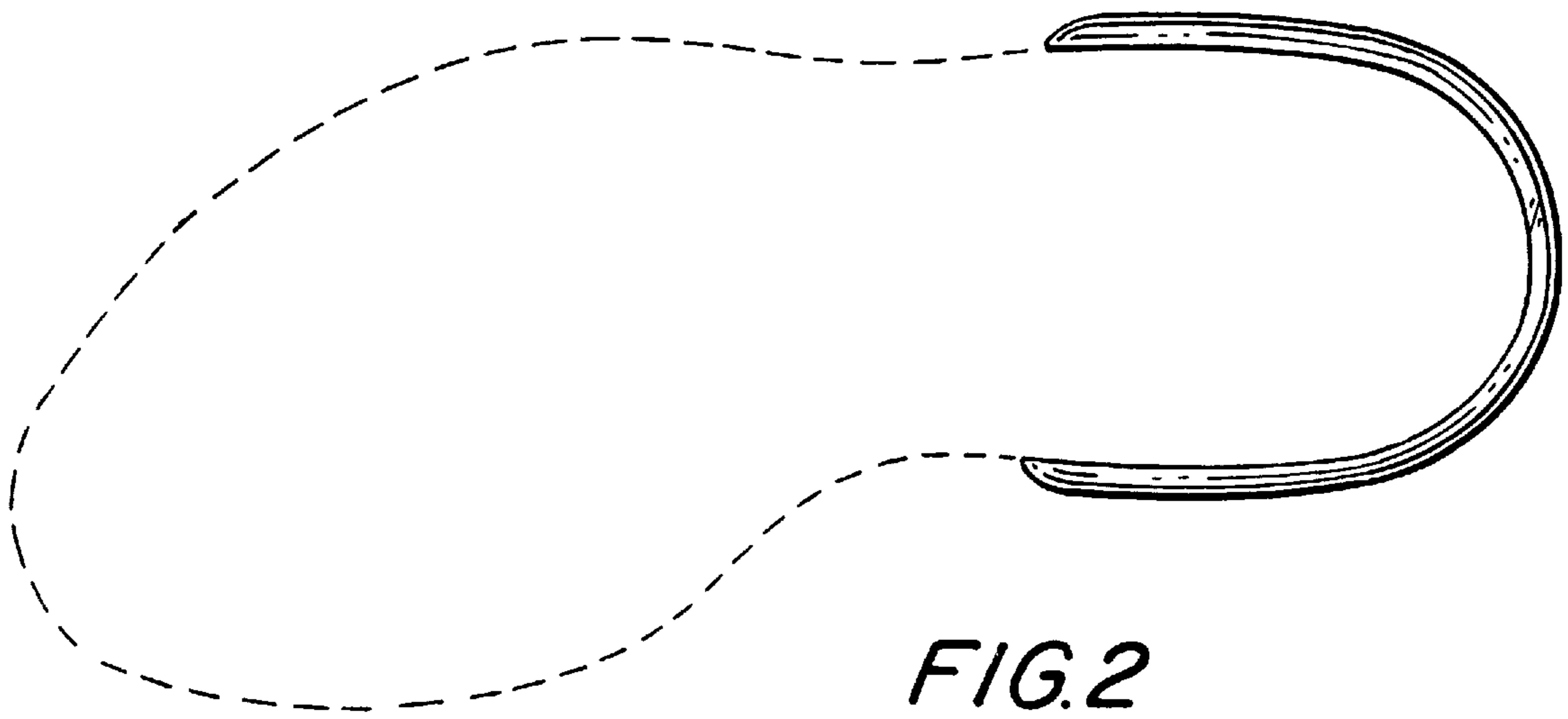
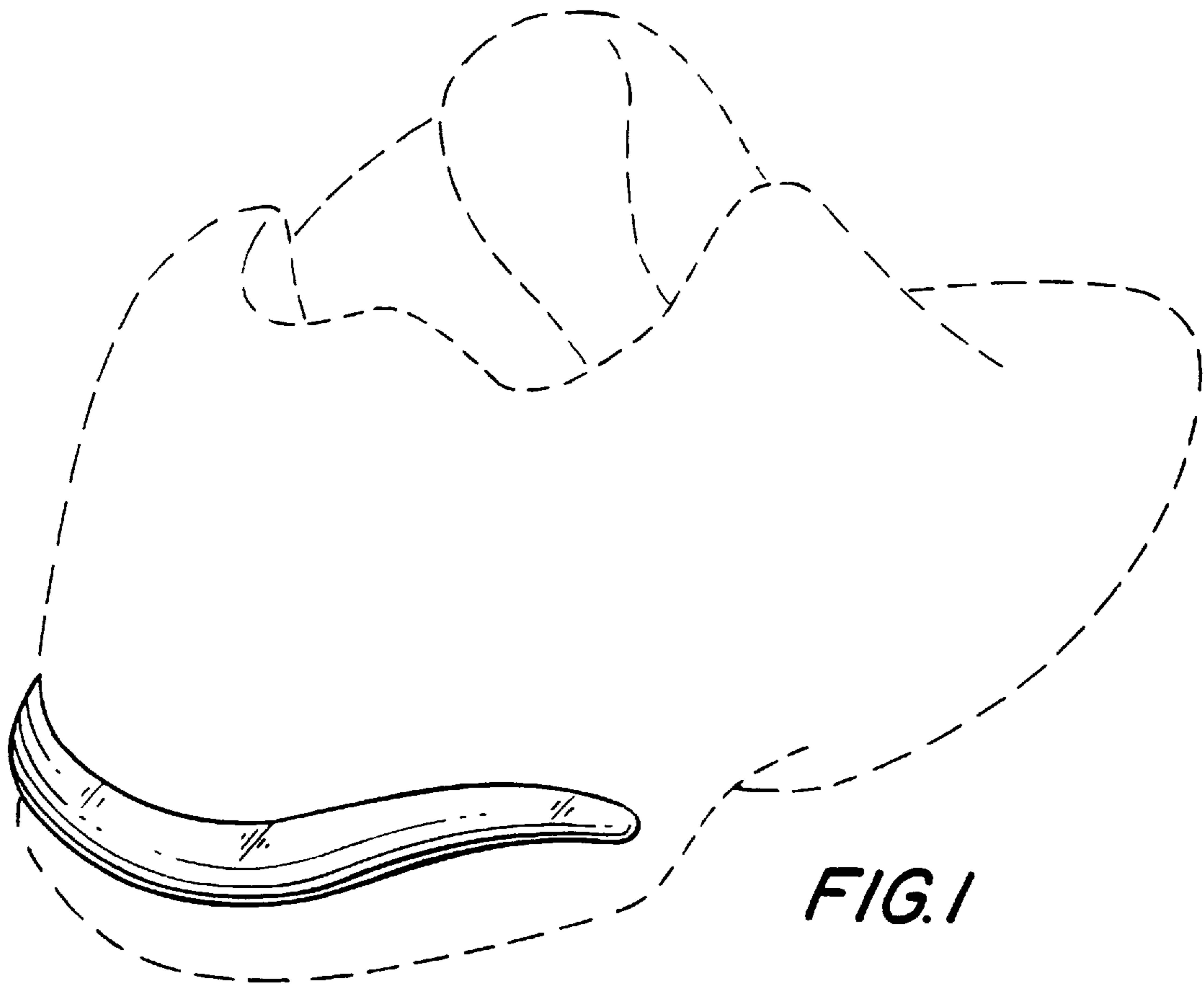

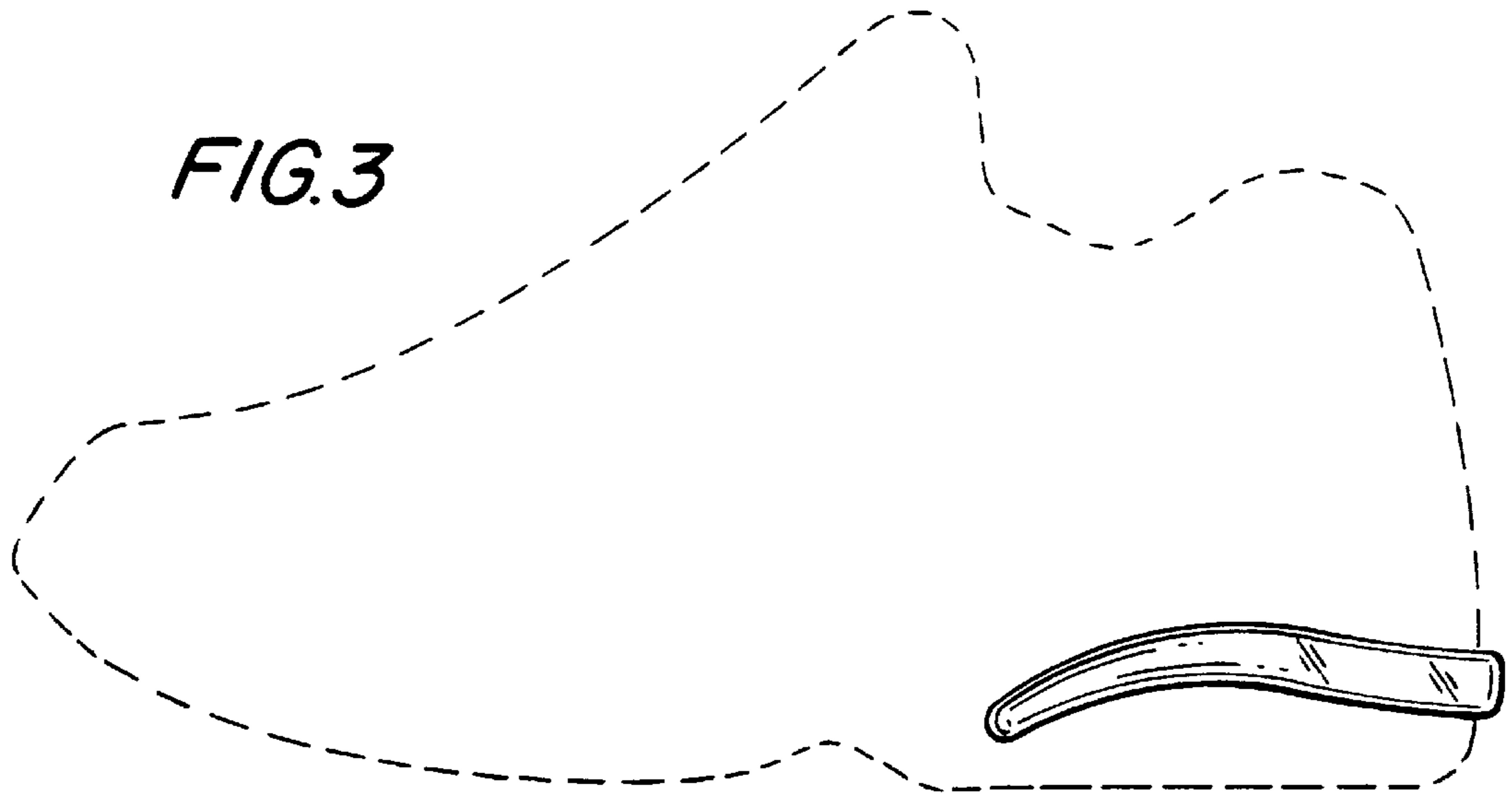

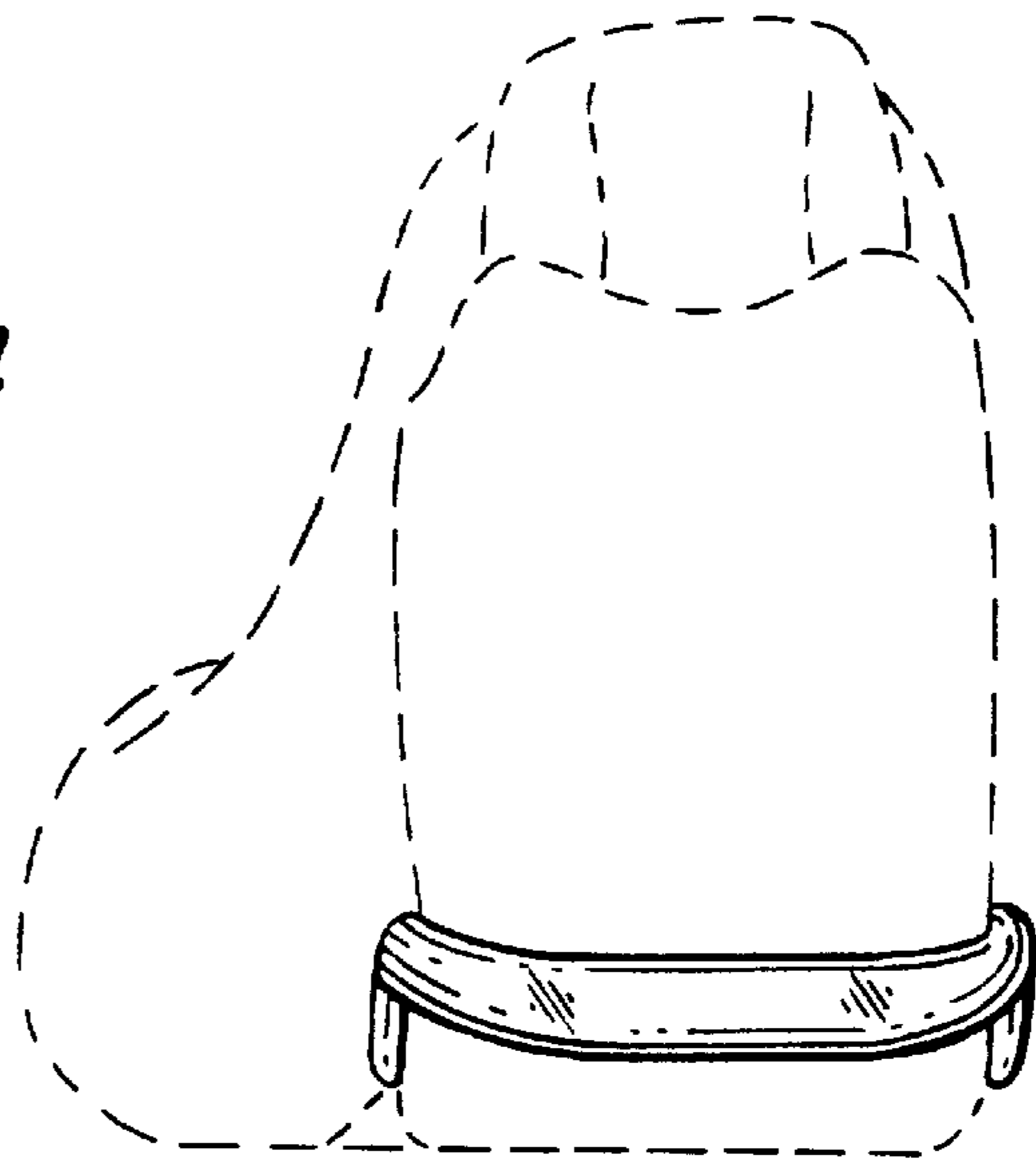
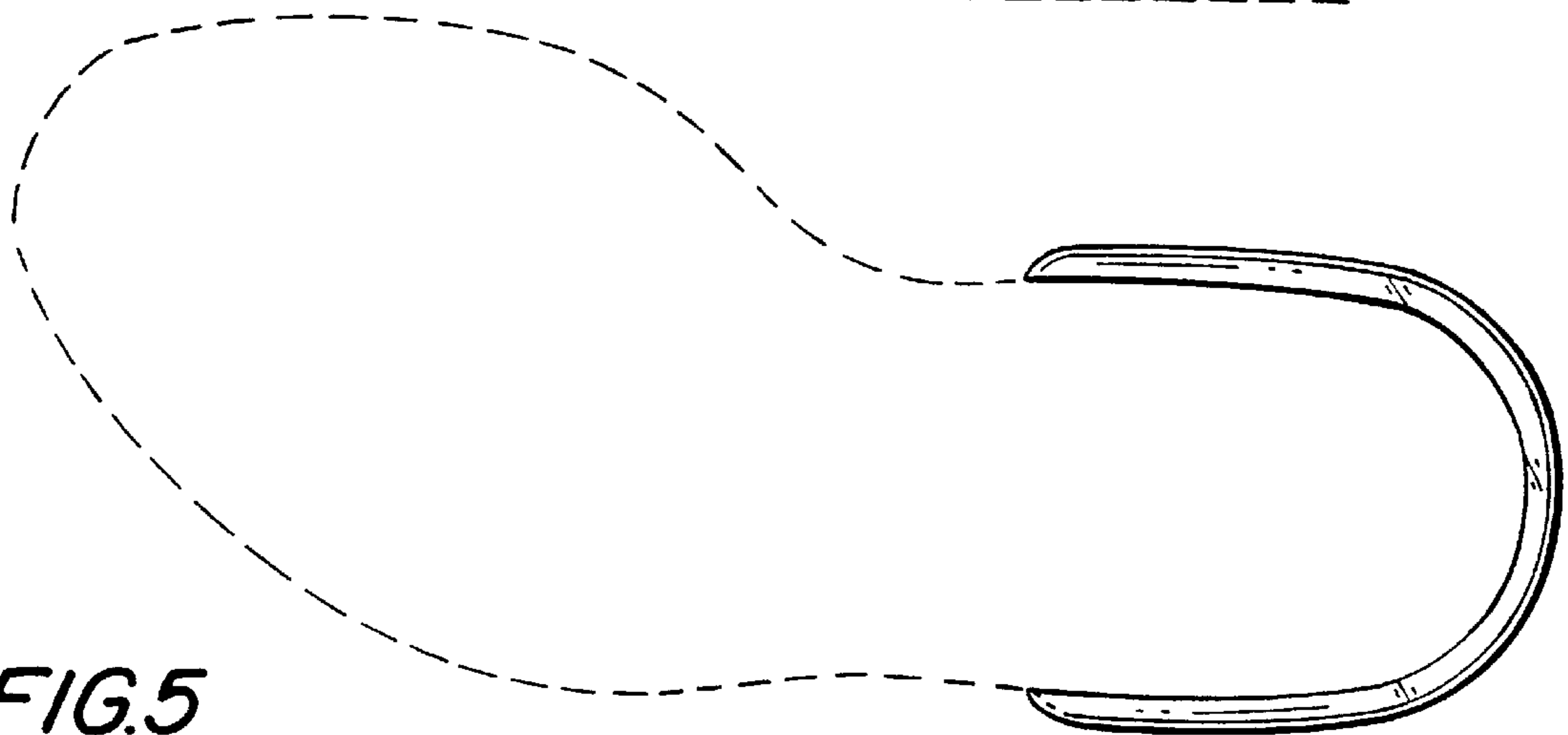

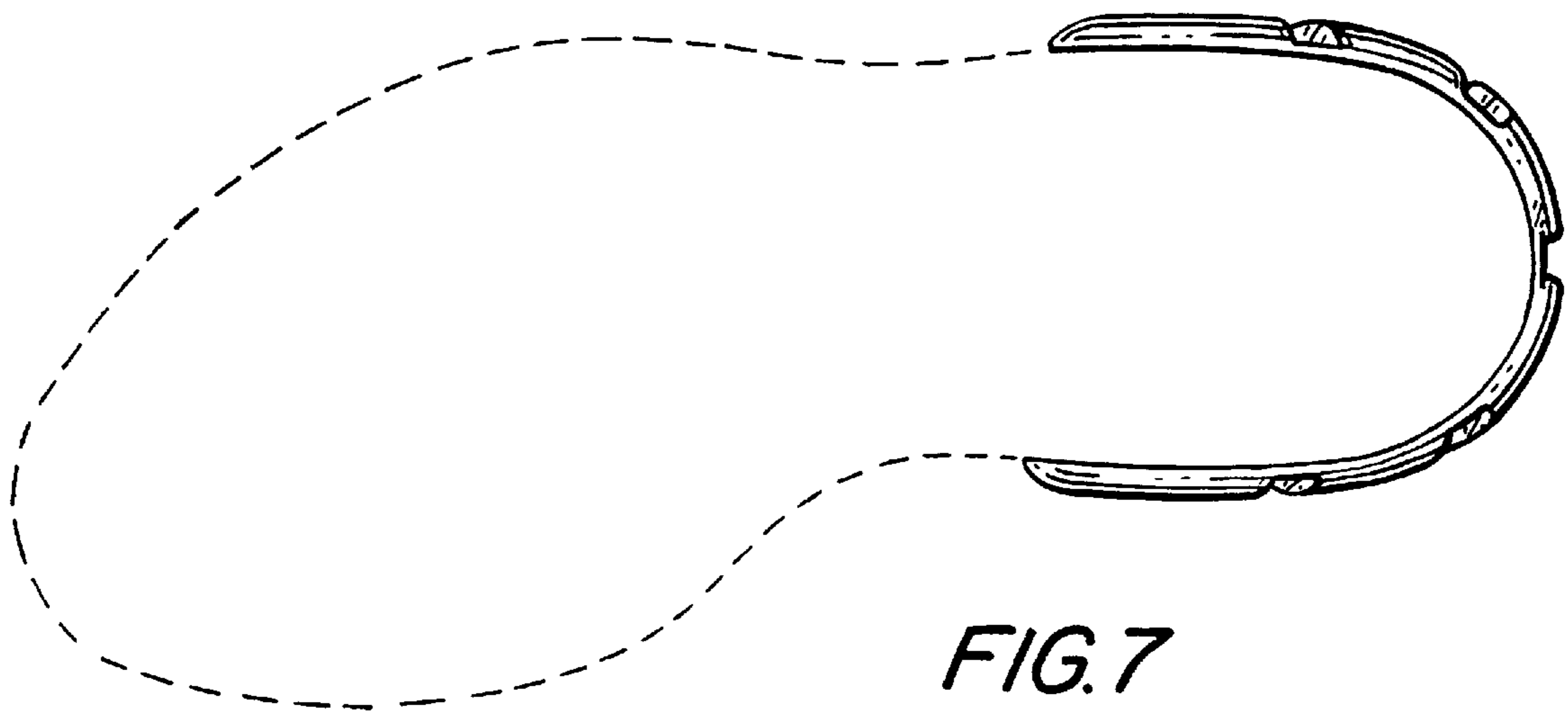
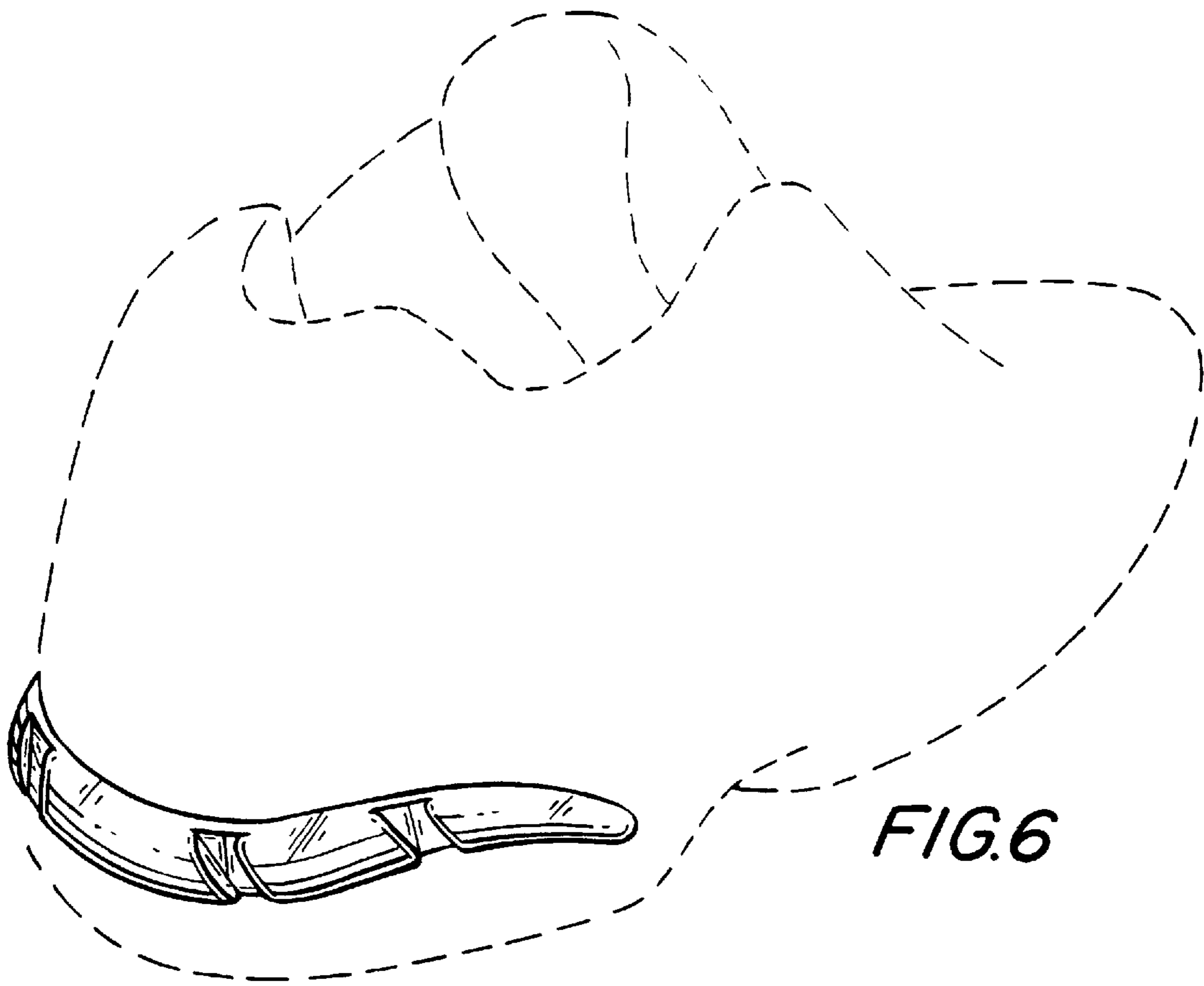

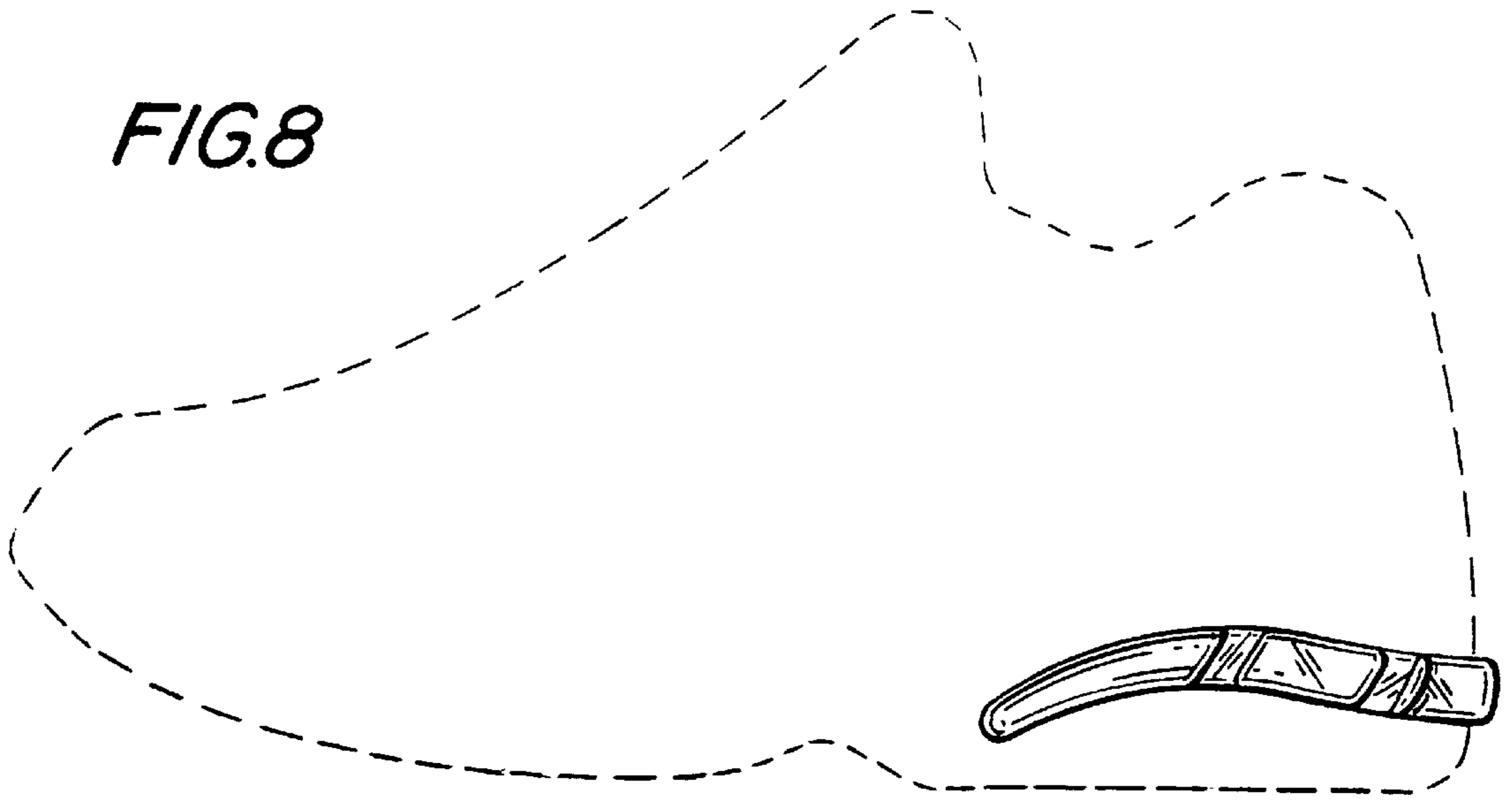

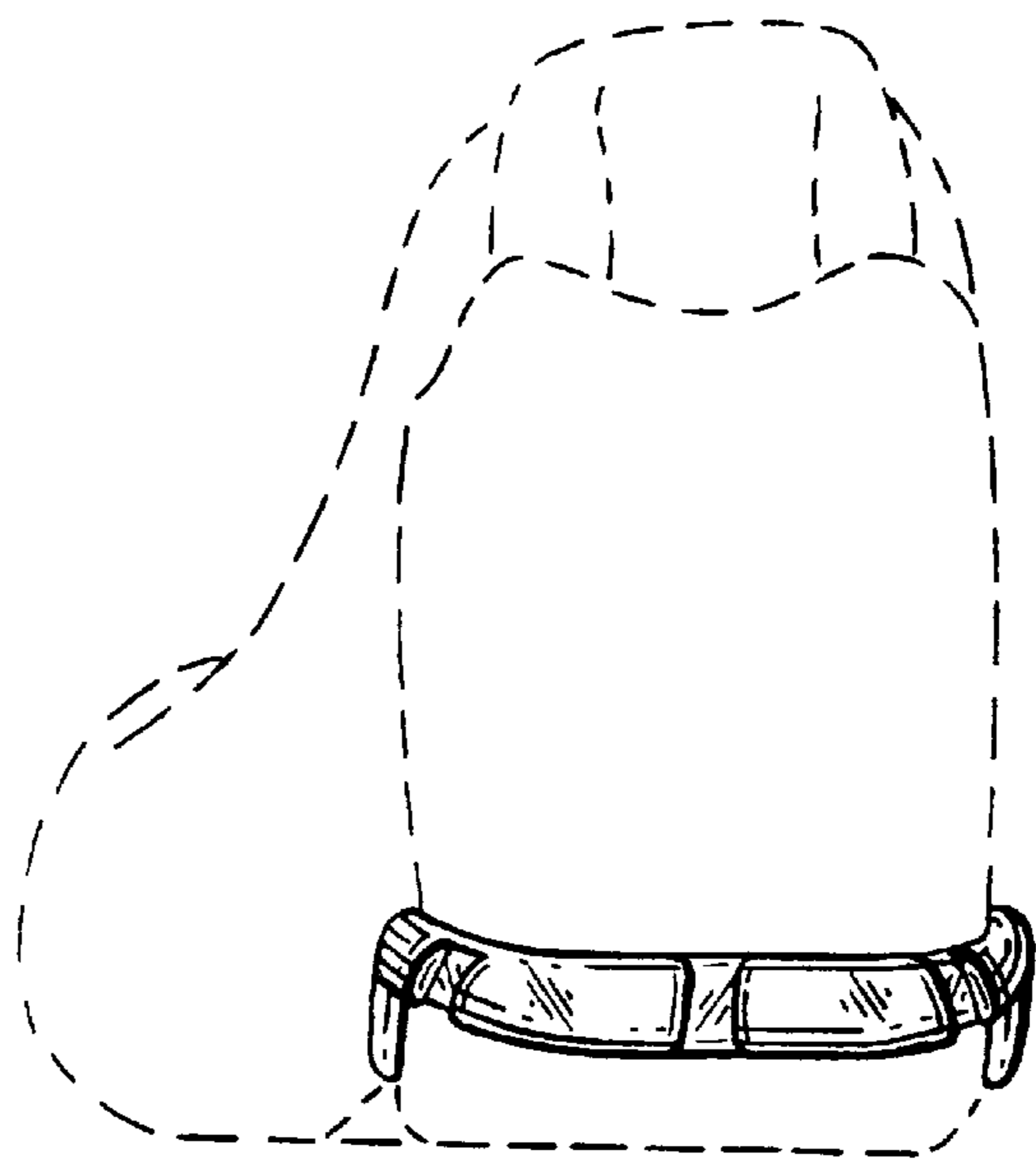
