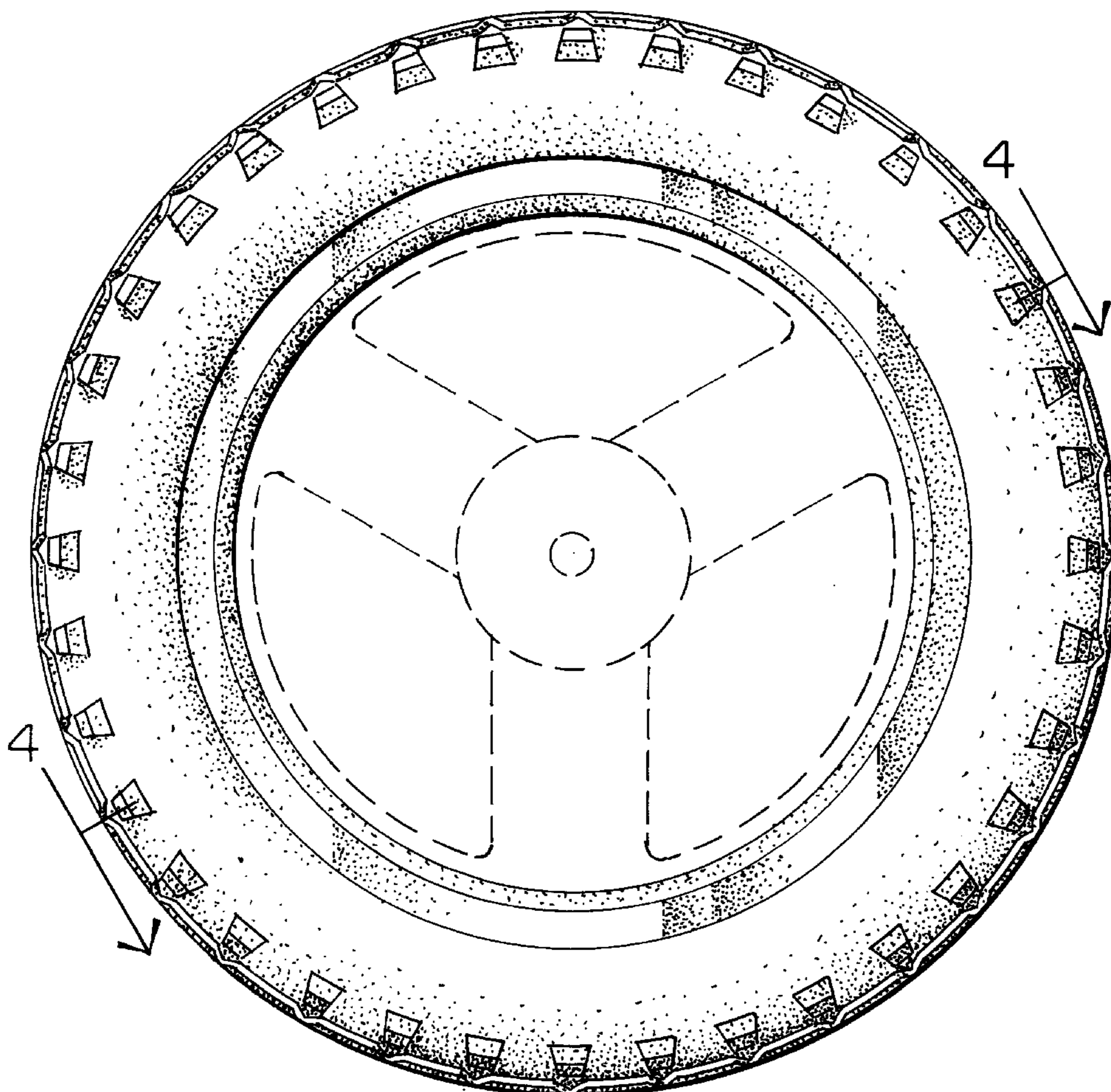
FIG. 4 is a cross sectional view thereof, taken in the direction of line 4-4 of FIG. 1.

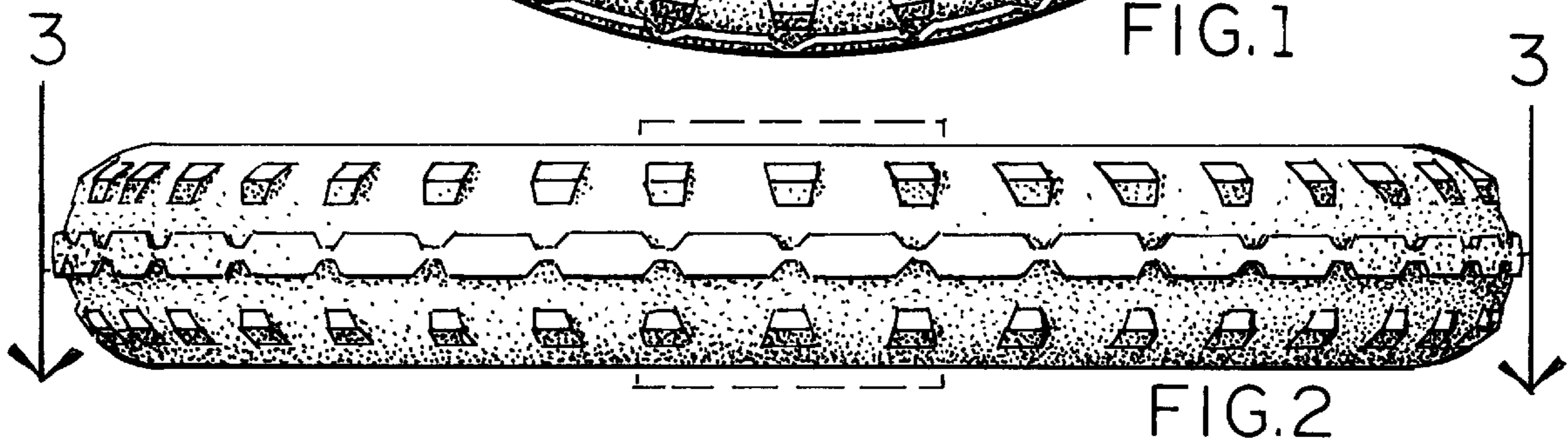
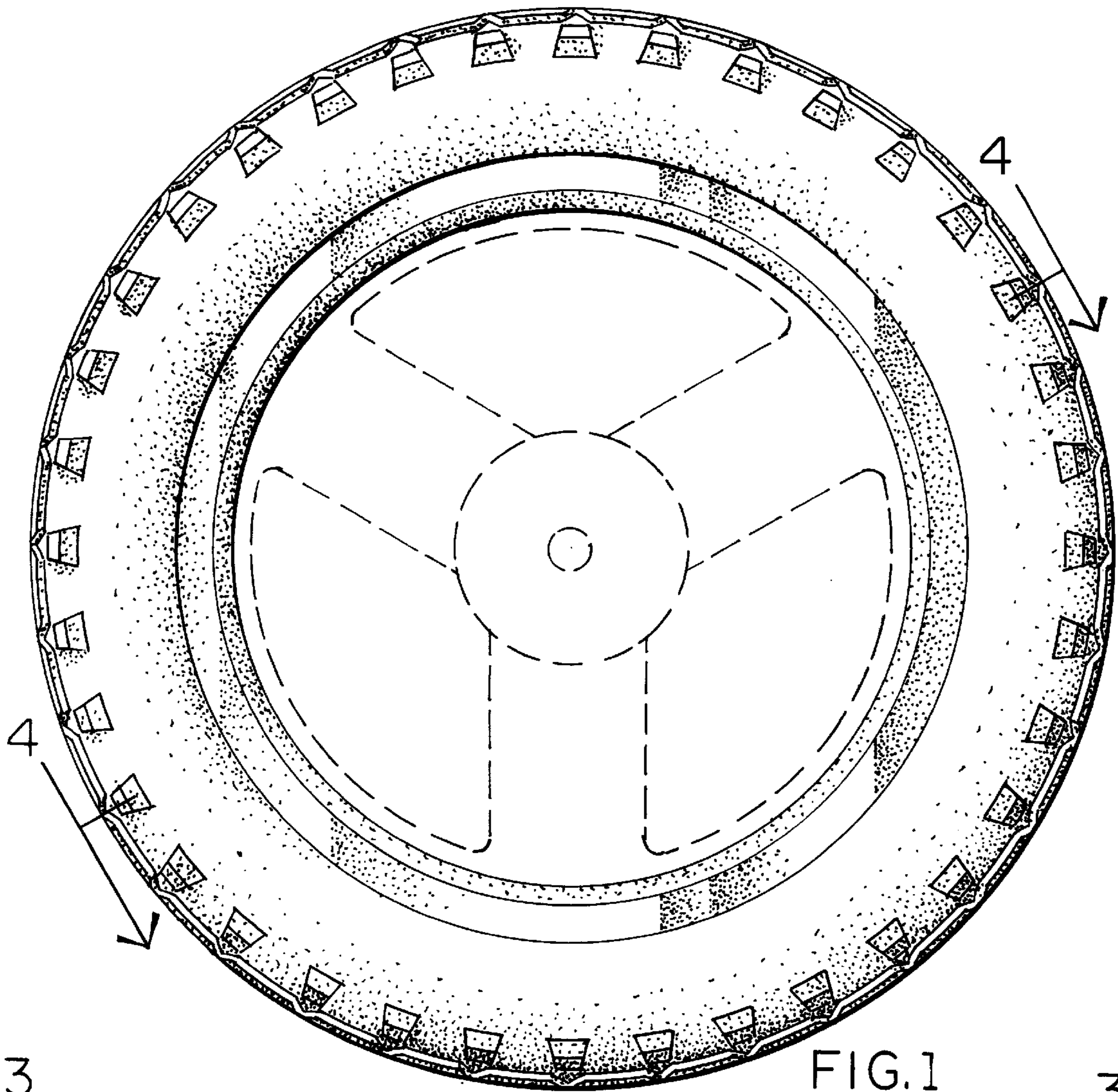

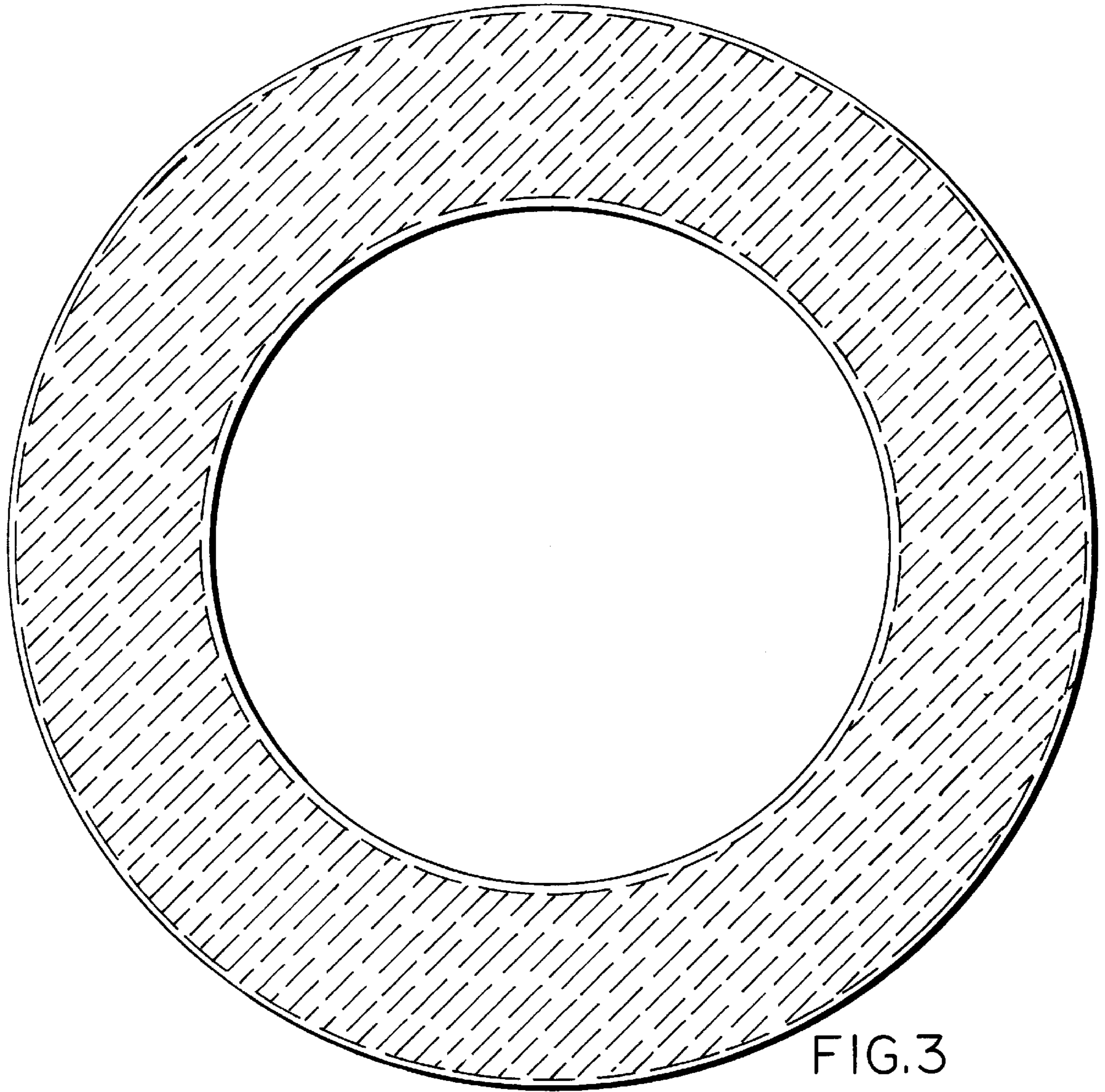

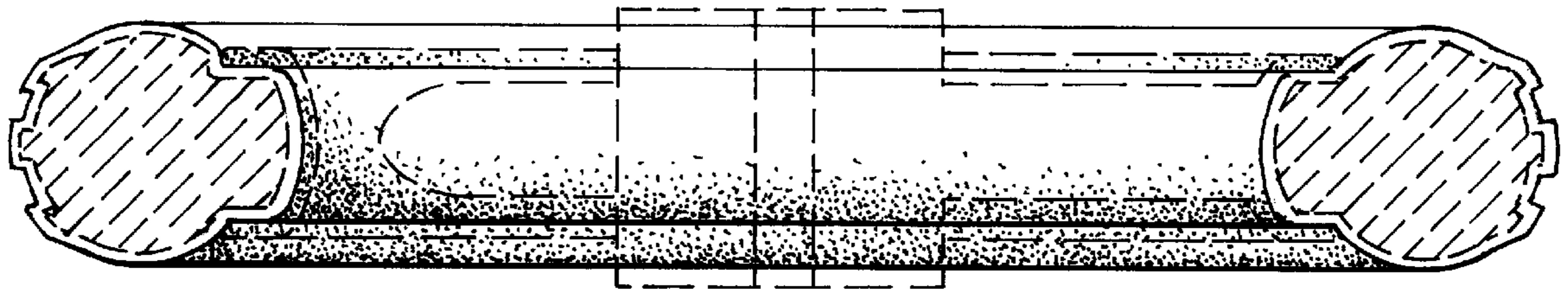
