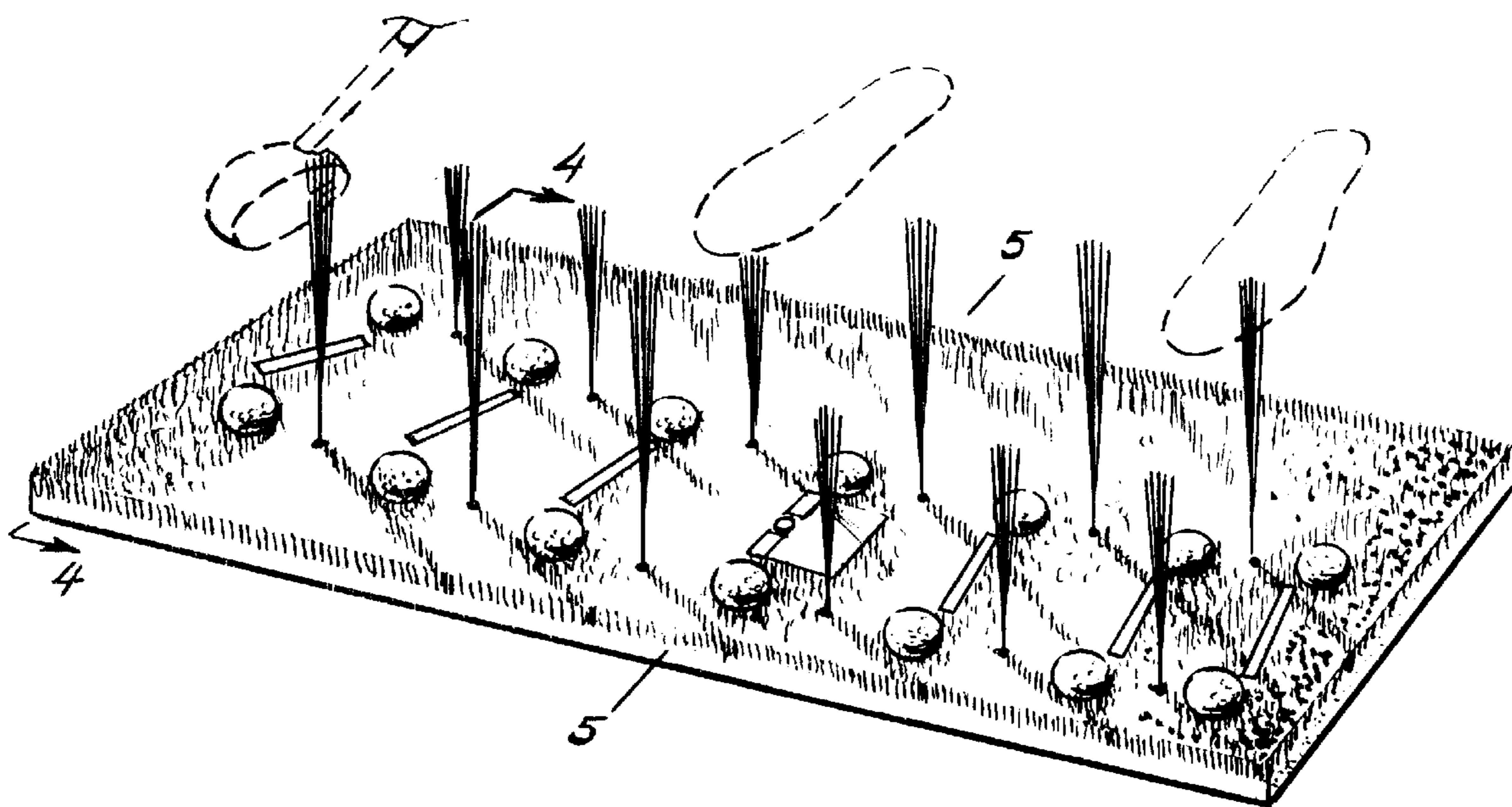

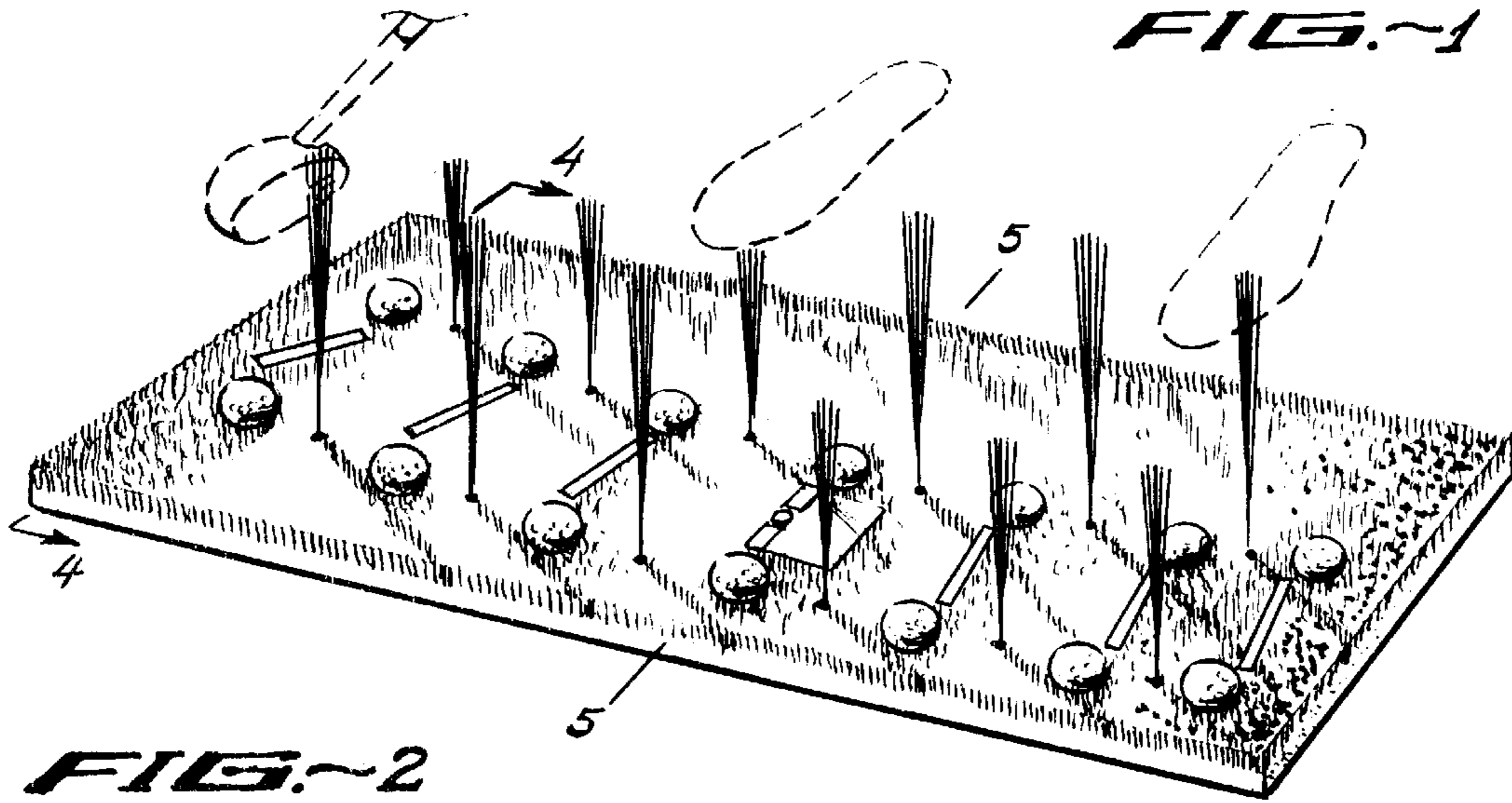
The ornamental design for a golfclub swing-path and face-angle training-mat, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

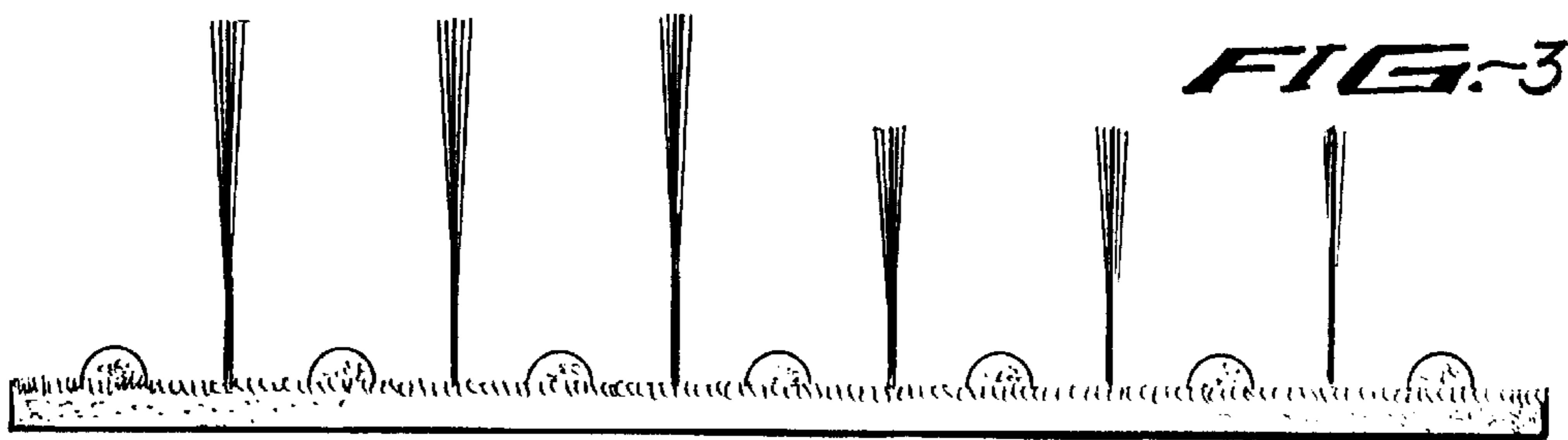
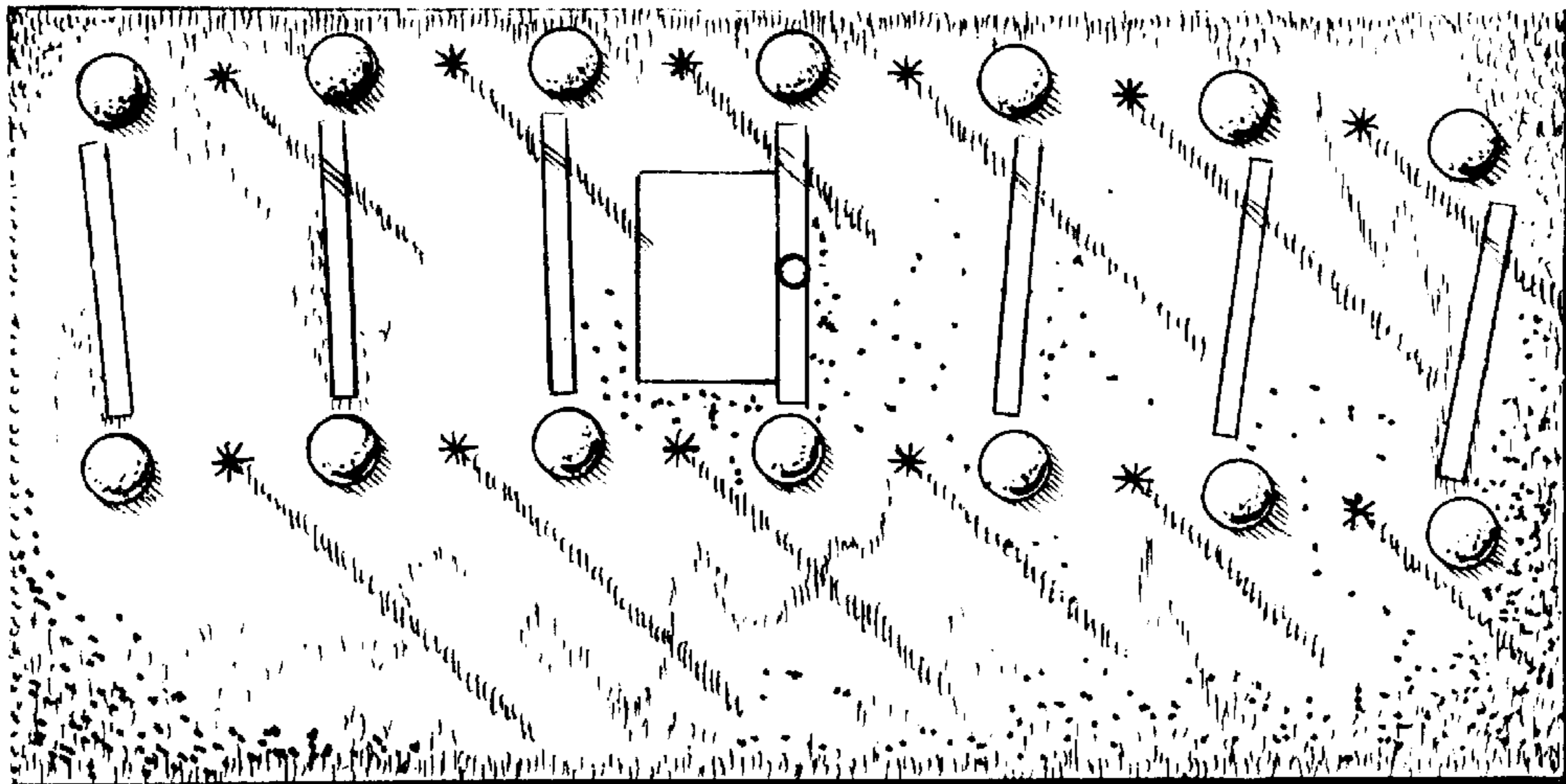
FIG. 1 is an upper frontal perspective view of an golf club swing path and face-angle training-mat; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof; FIG. 5 is a cross section taken on line 5—5 of FIG. 1; FIG. 6 is a top front perspective view of a second embodiment of the golf club swing path and face angle training mat as disclosed in FIG. 1; FIG. 7 is a top plan view of FIG. 6; FIG. 8 is a rear elevational view of FIG. 6; FIG. 9 is a right side view of FIG. 6; and, FIG. 10 is a cross section taken on line 5—5 of FIG. 6. The broken line showing of a golf club and foot prints is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

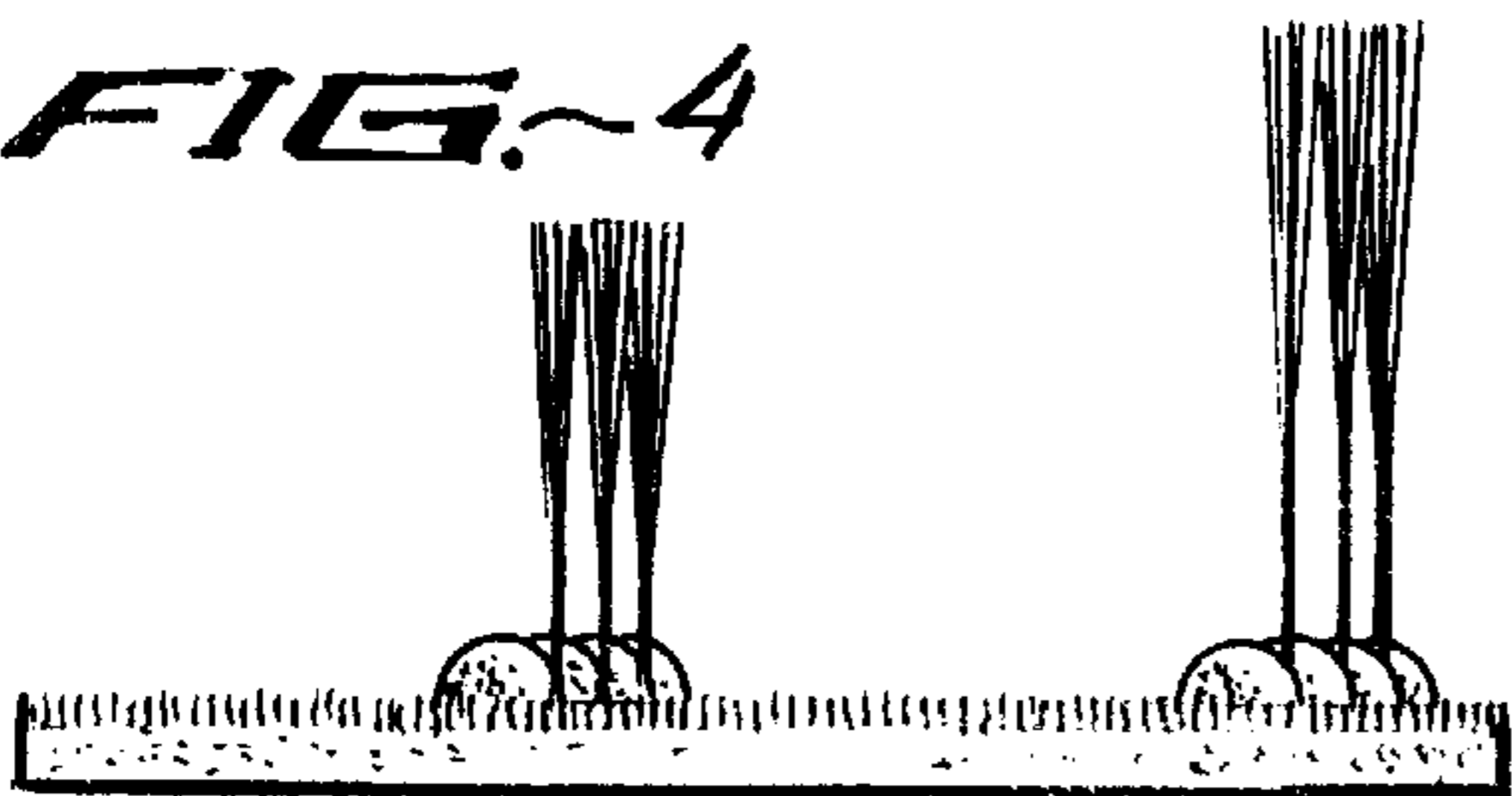

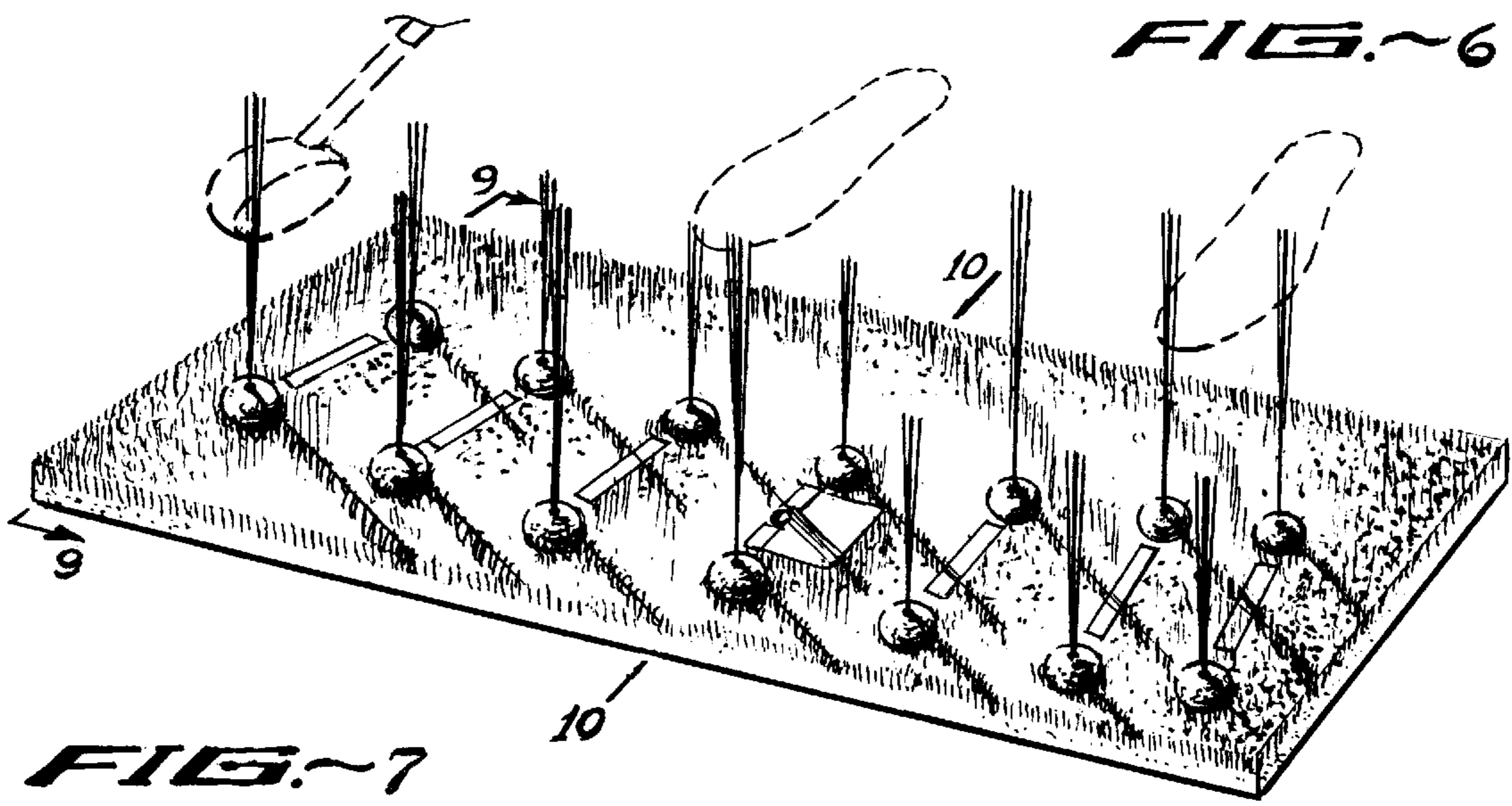

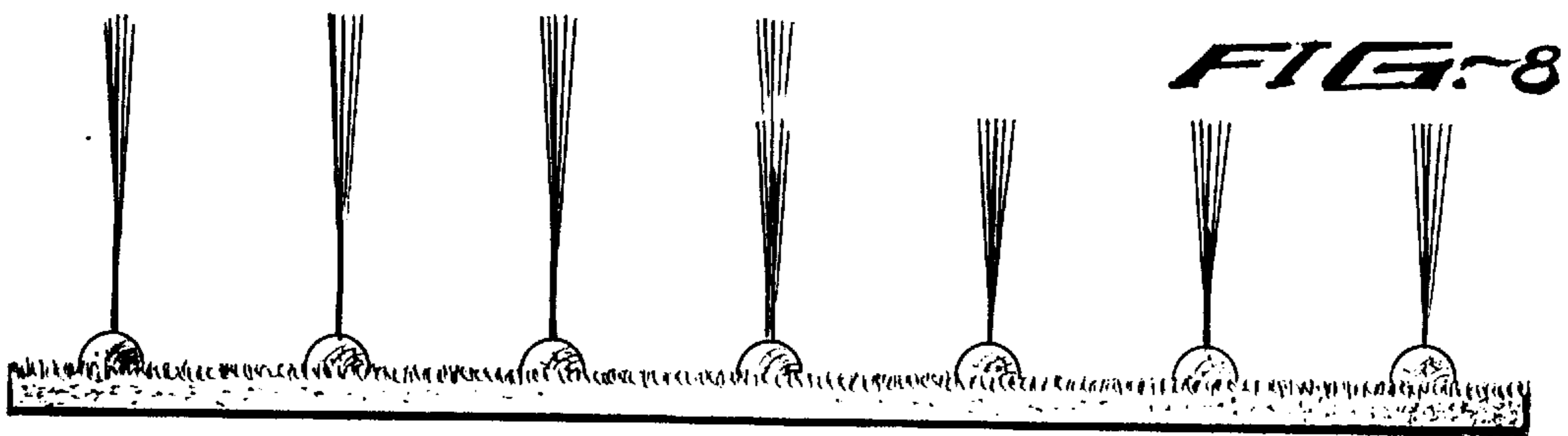
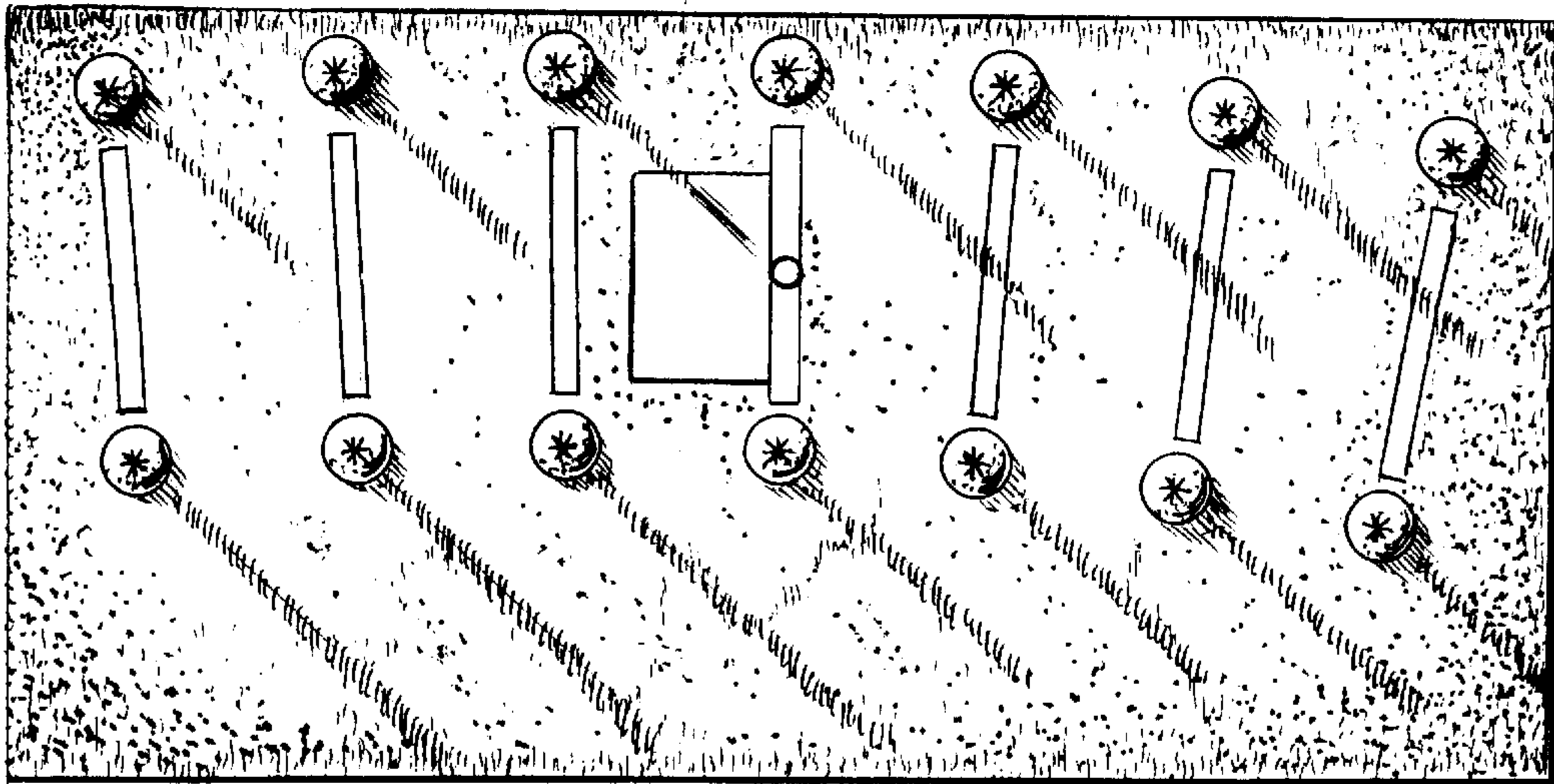

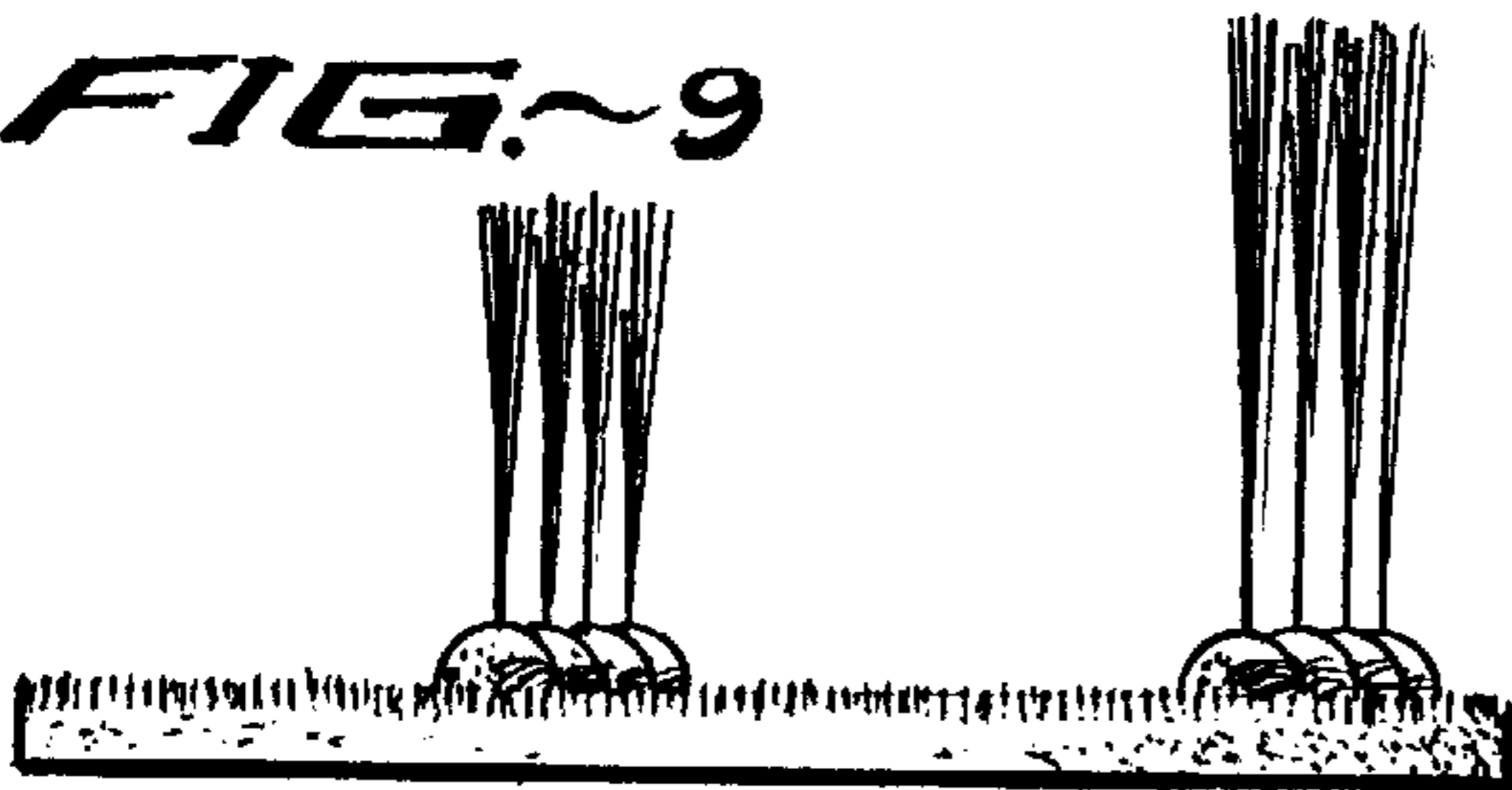
