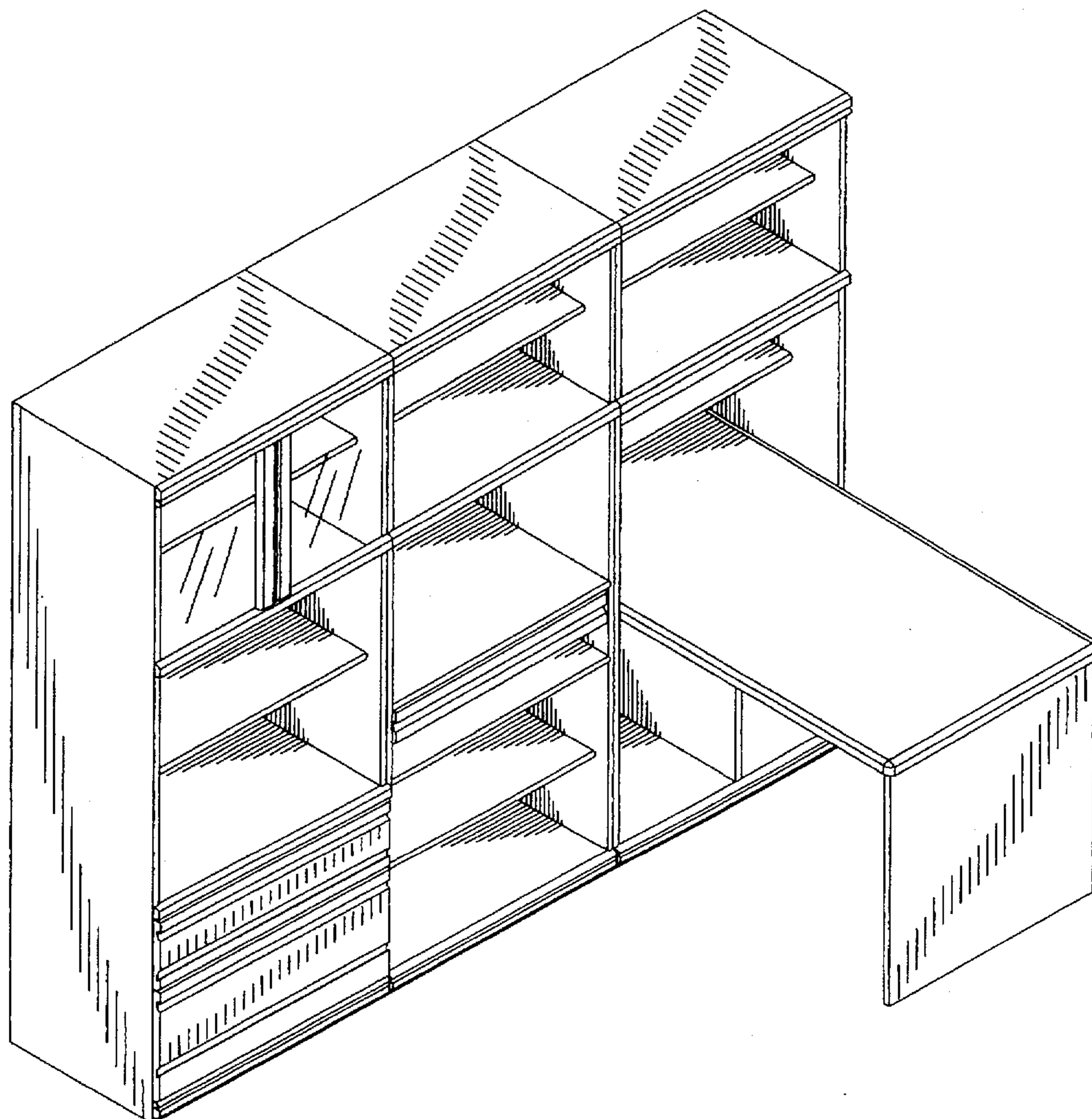
FIG. 1 is a top view of a combined modular shelf and desk unit showing our new design;

The rear of the unit forms no part of the claimed design.

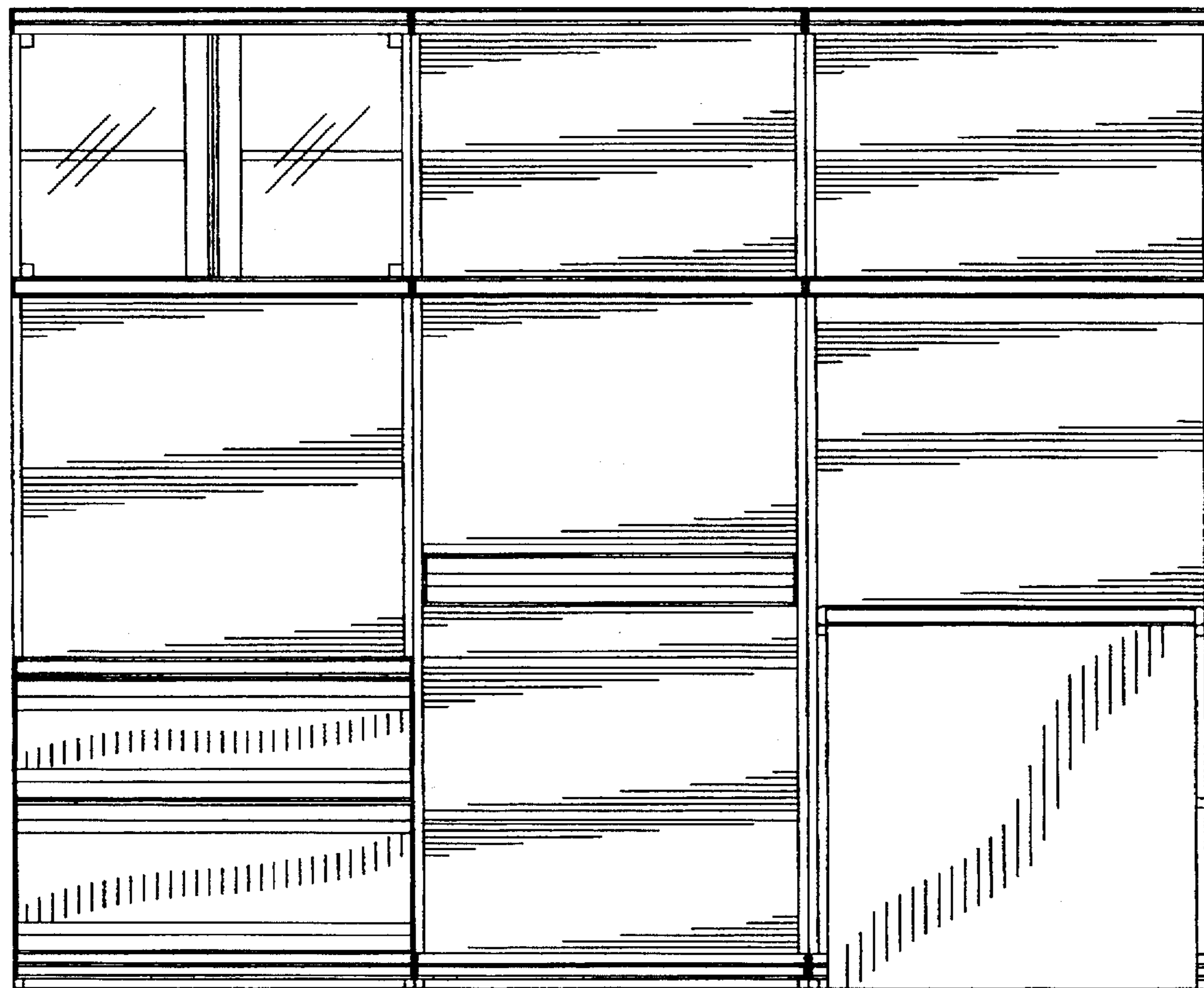
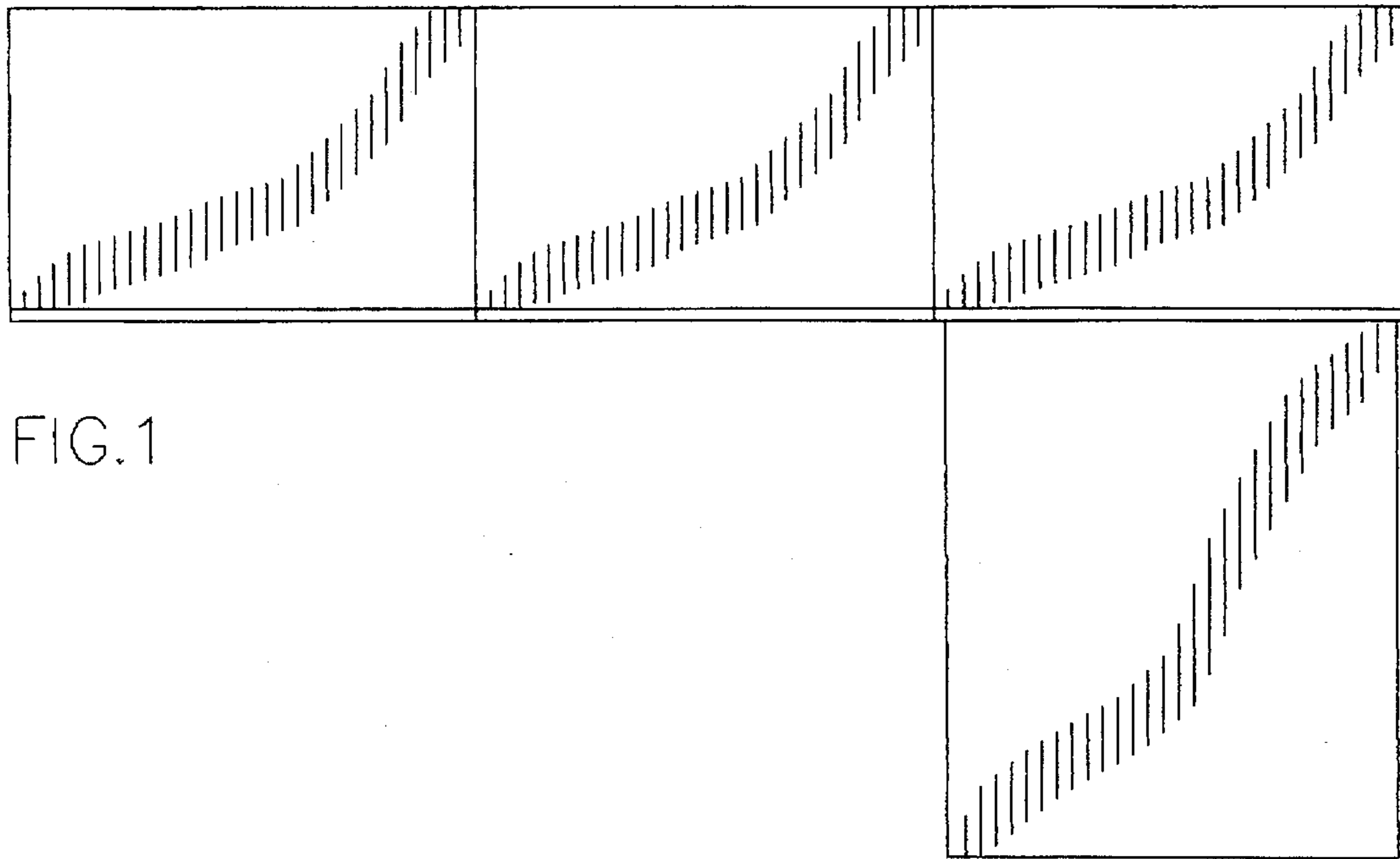

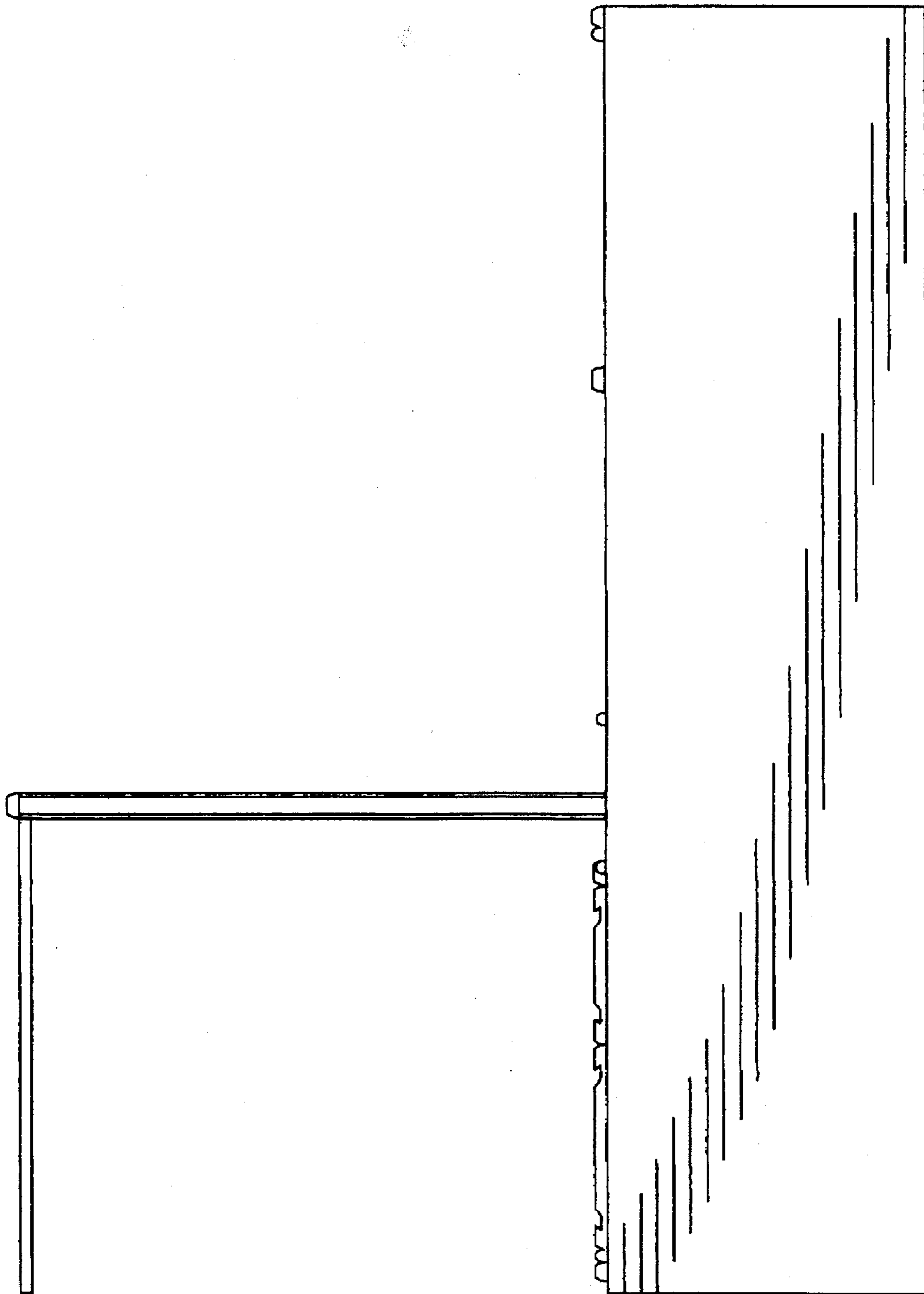

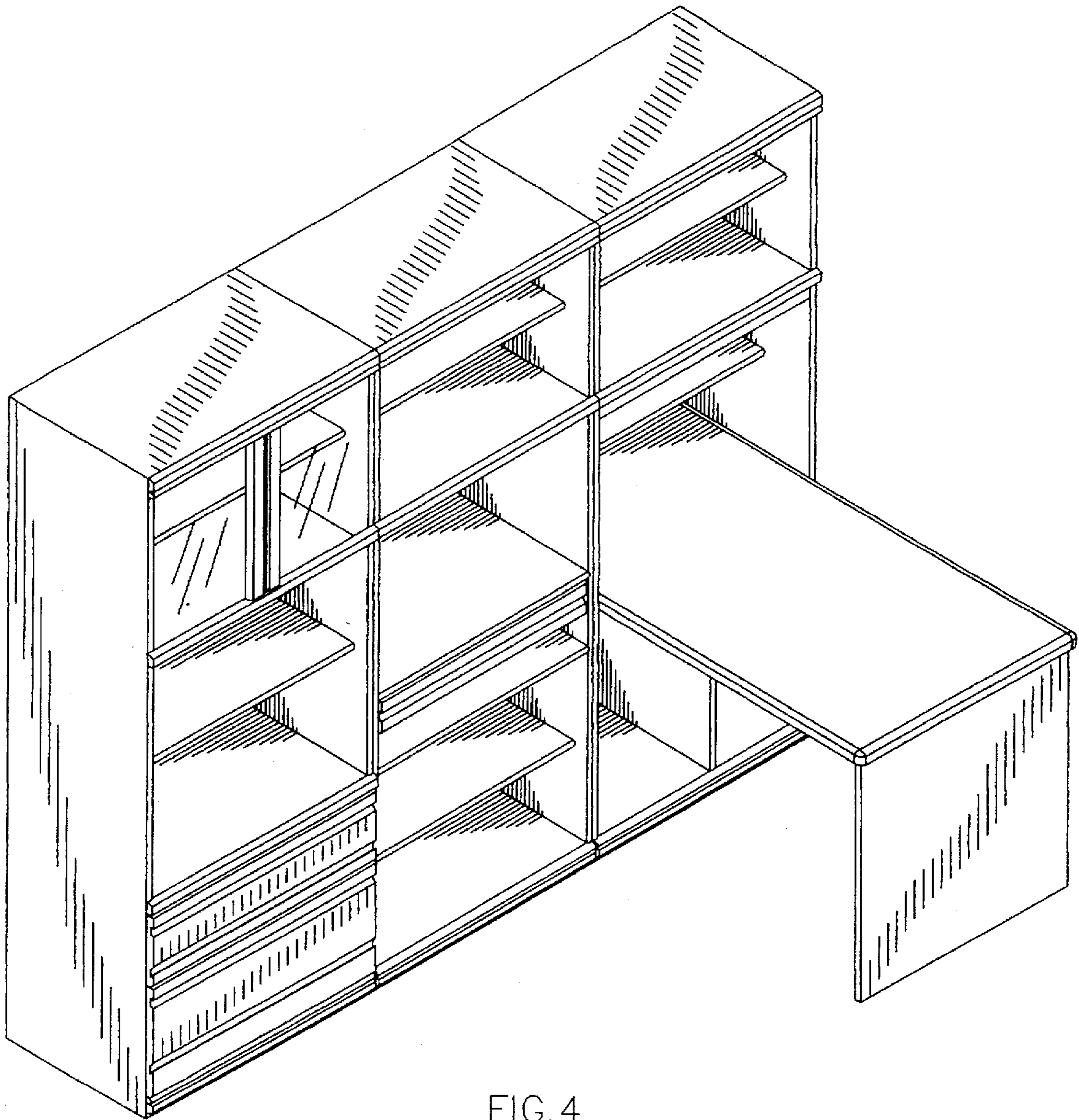
