[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a bicycle seat post, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of a bicycle seat post showing my new design with broken lines being for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the first embodiment;

FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view of the first embodiment;

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of the first embodiment;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view of the first embodiment;

FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the second embodiment of a bicycle seat post with broken lines being for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 8 is a top plan view of the second embodiment ;

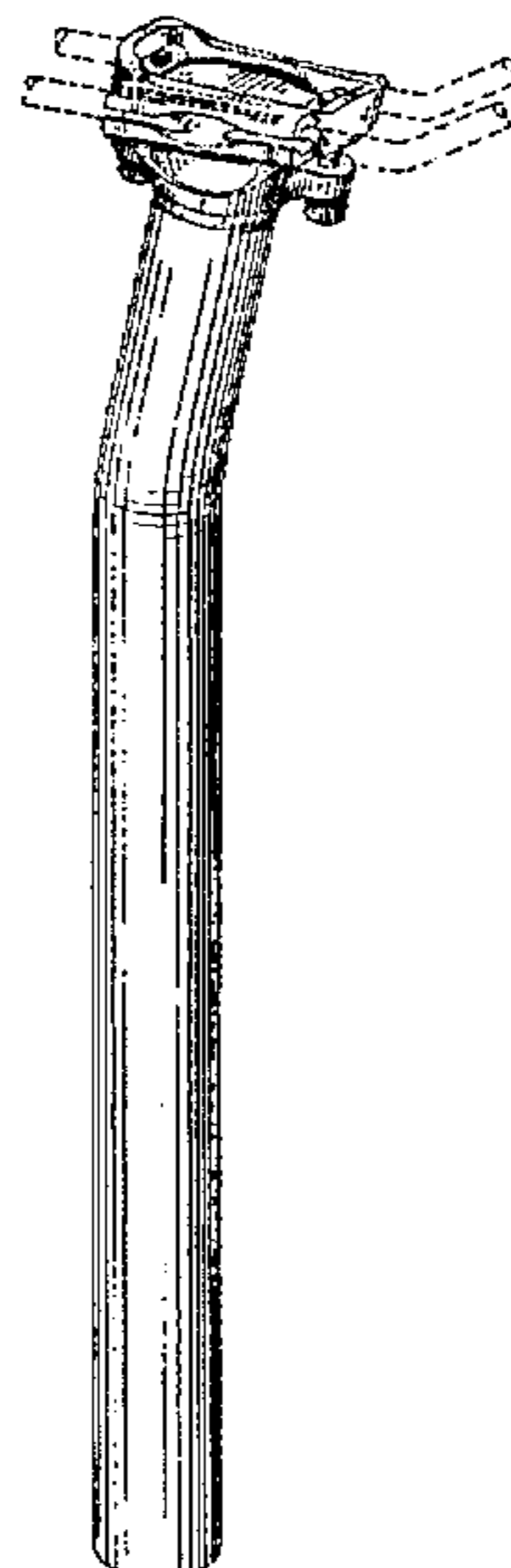
FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view of the second embodiment;

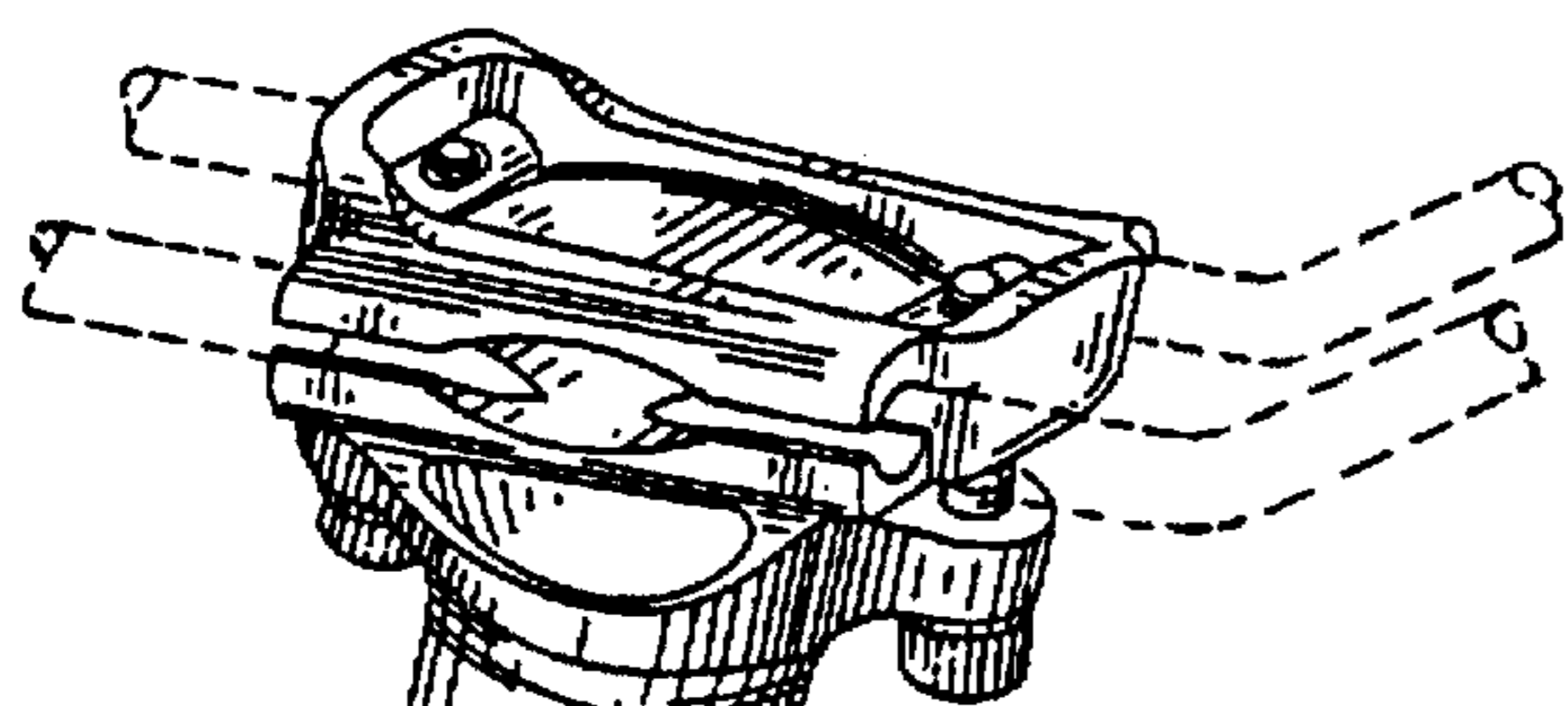

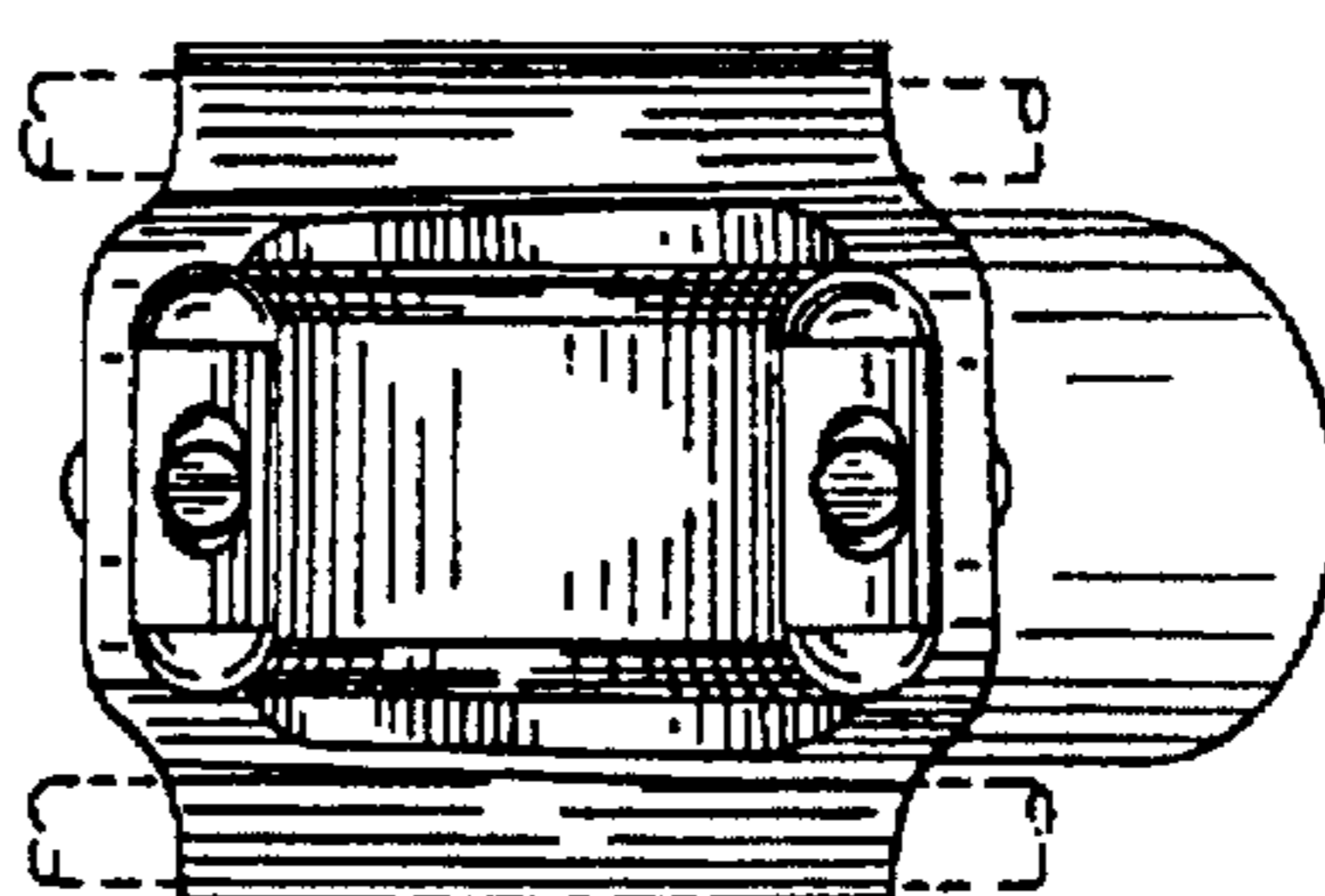

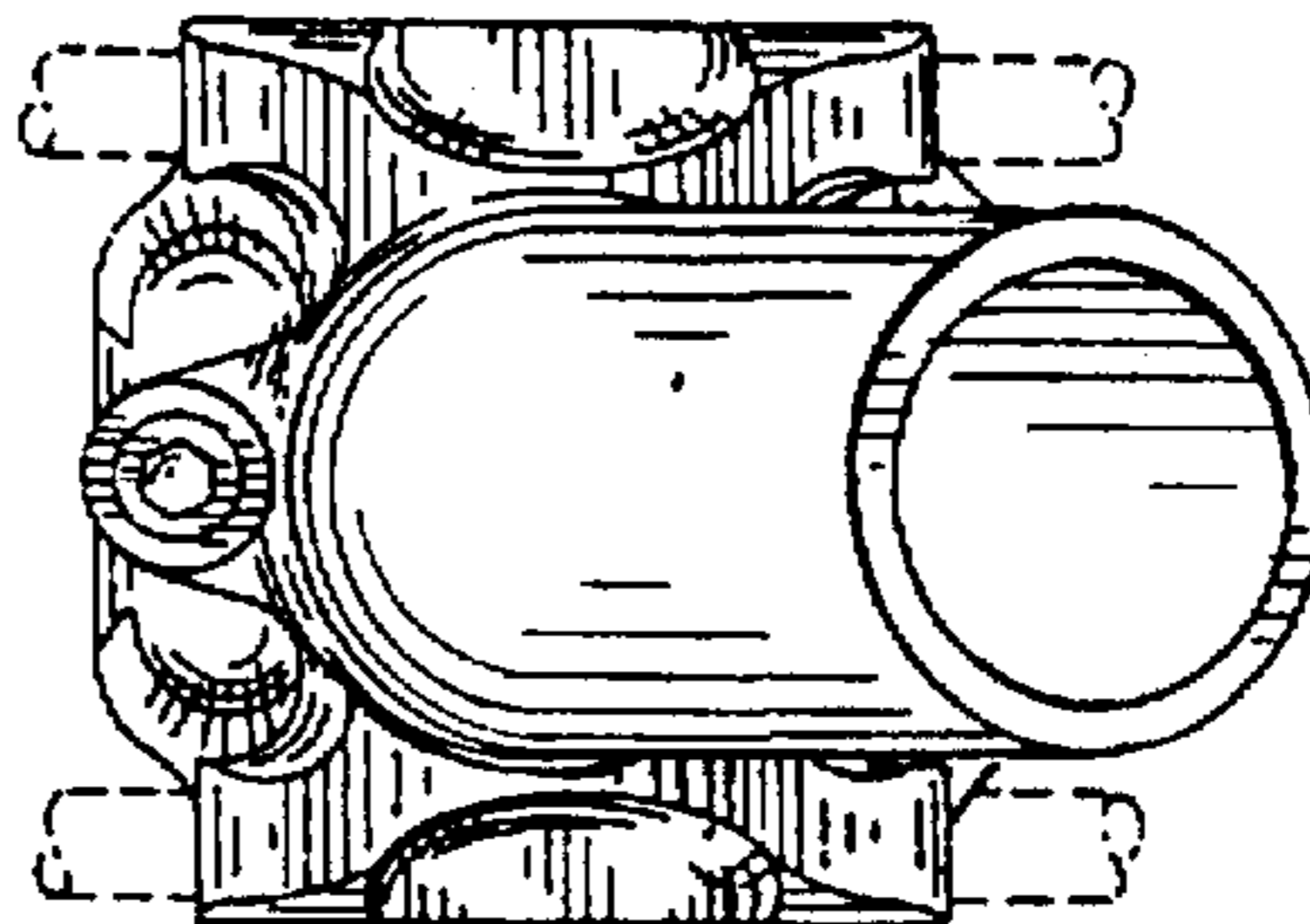

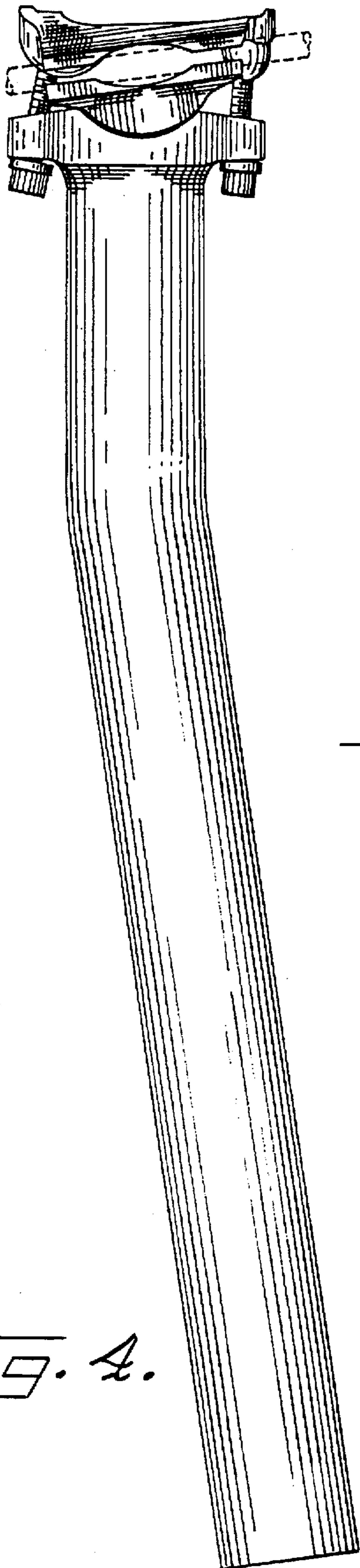

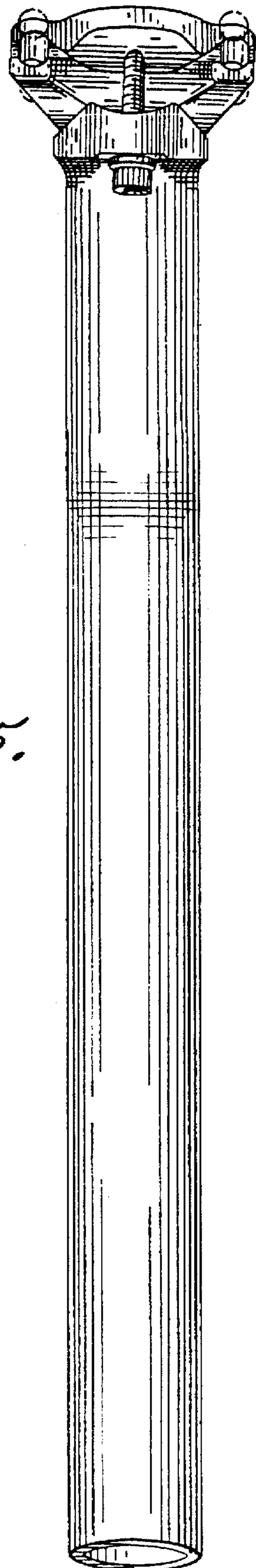

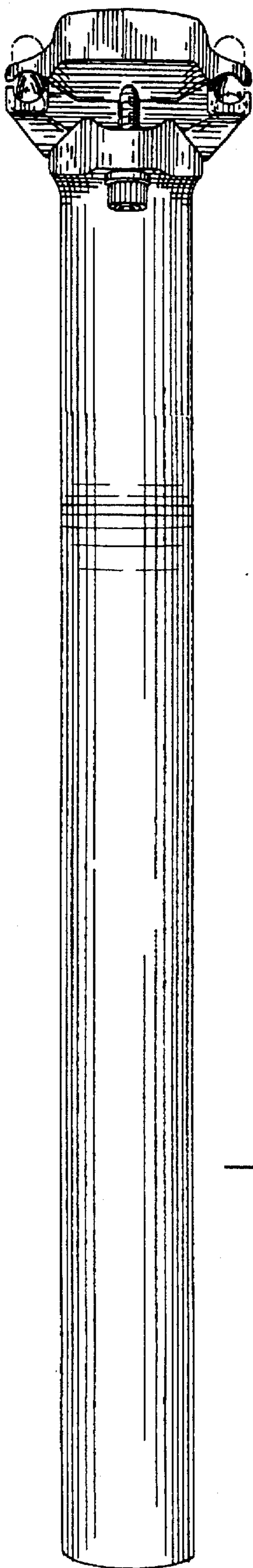

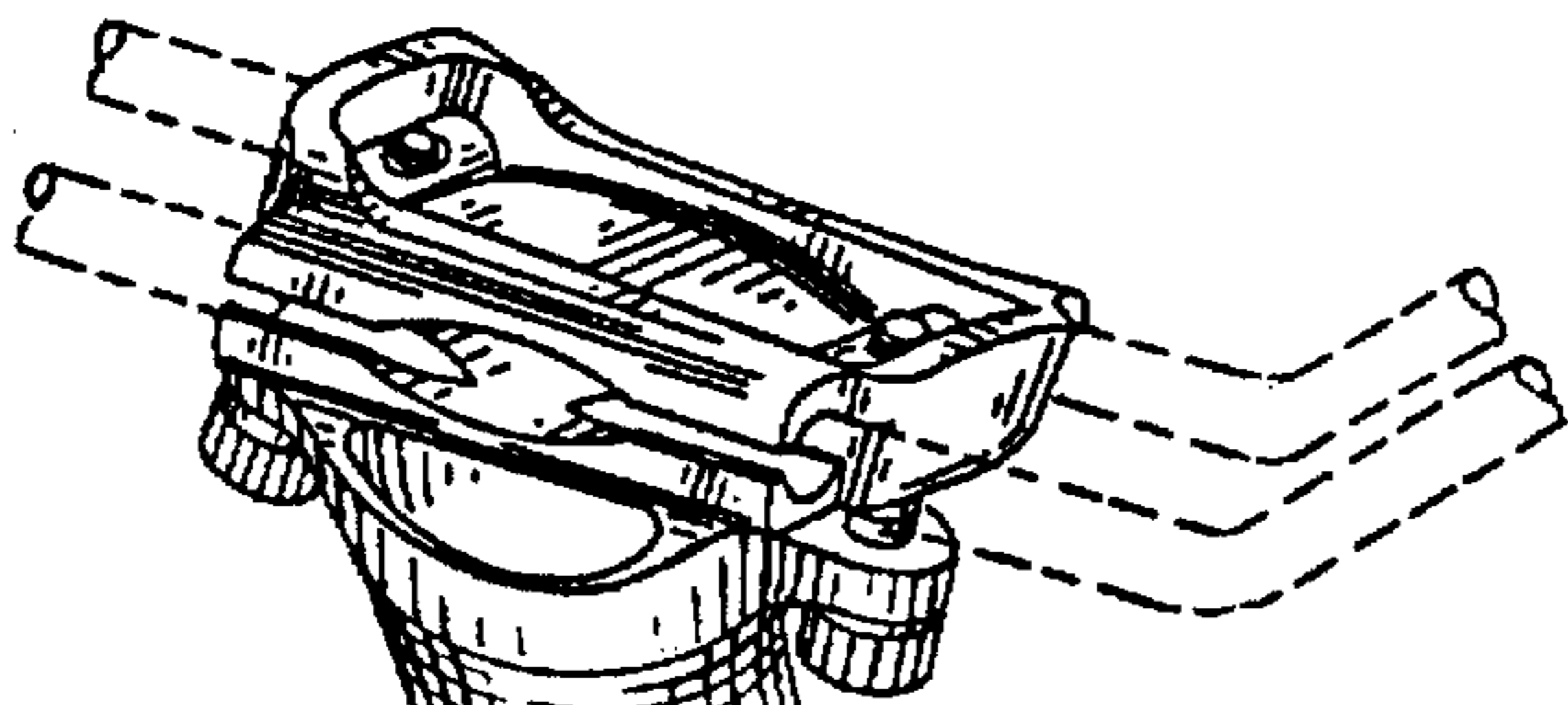

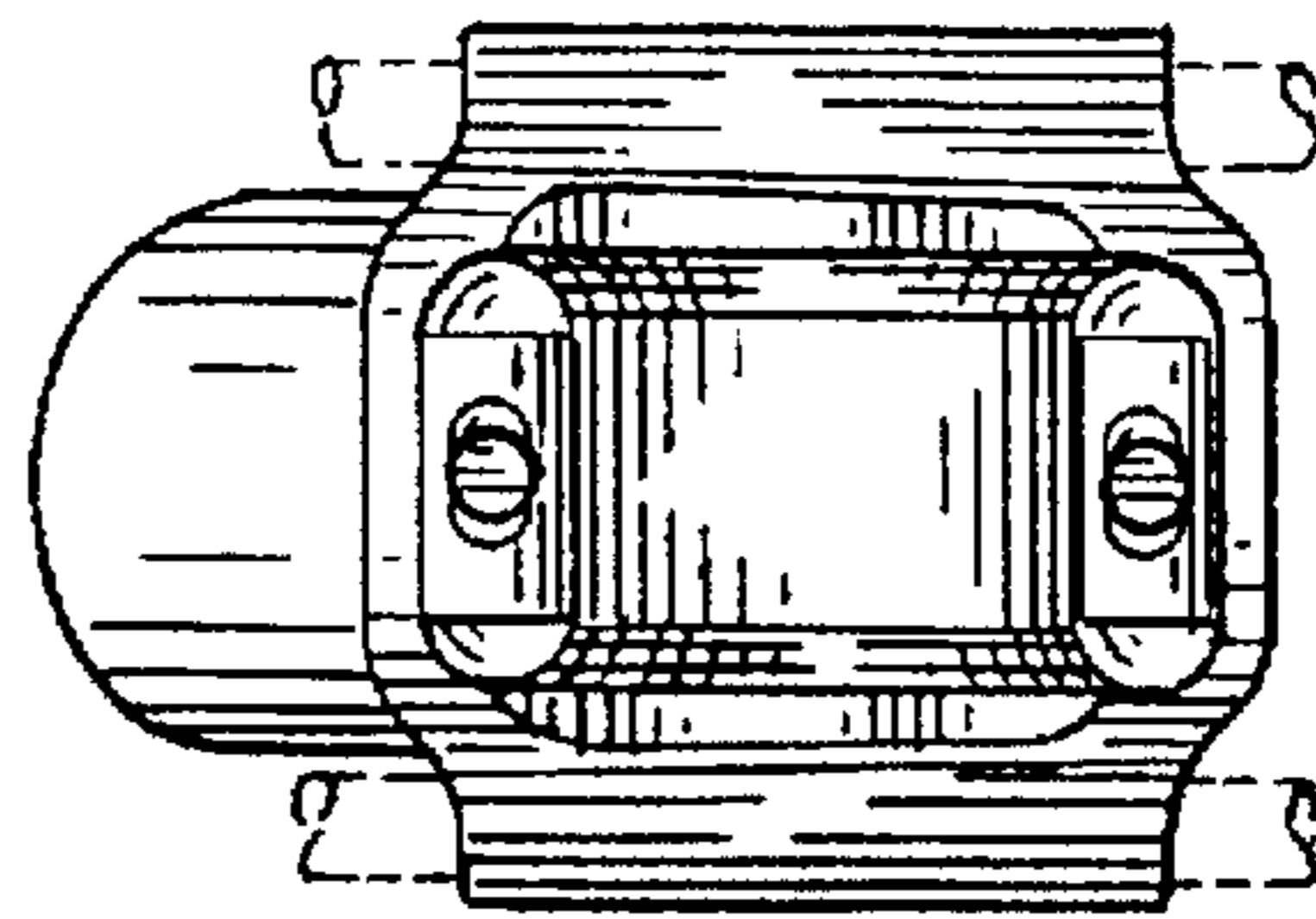

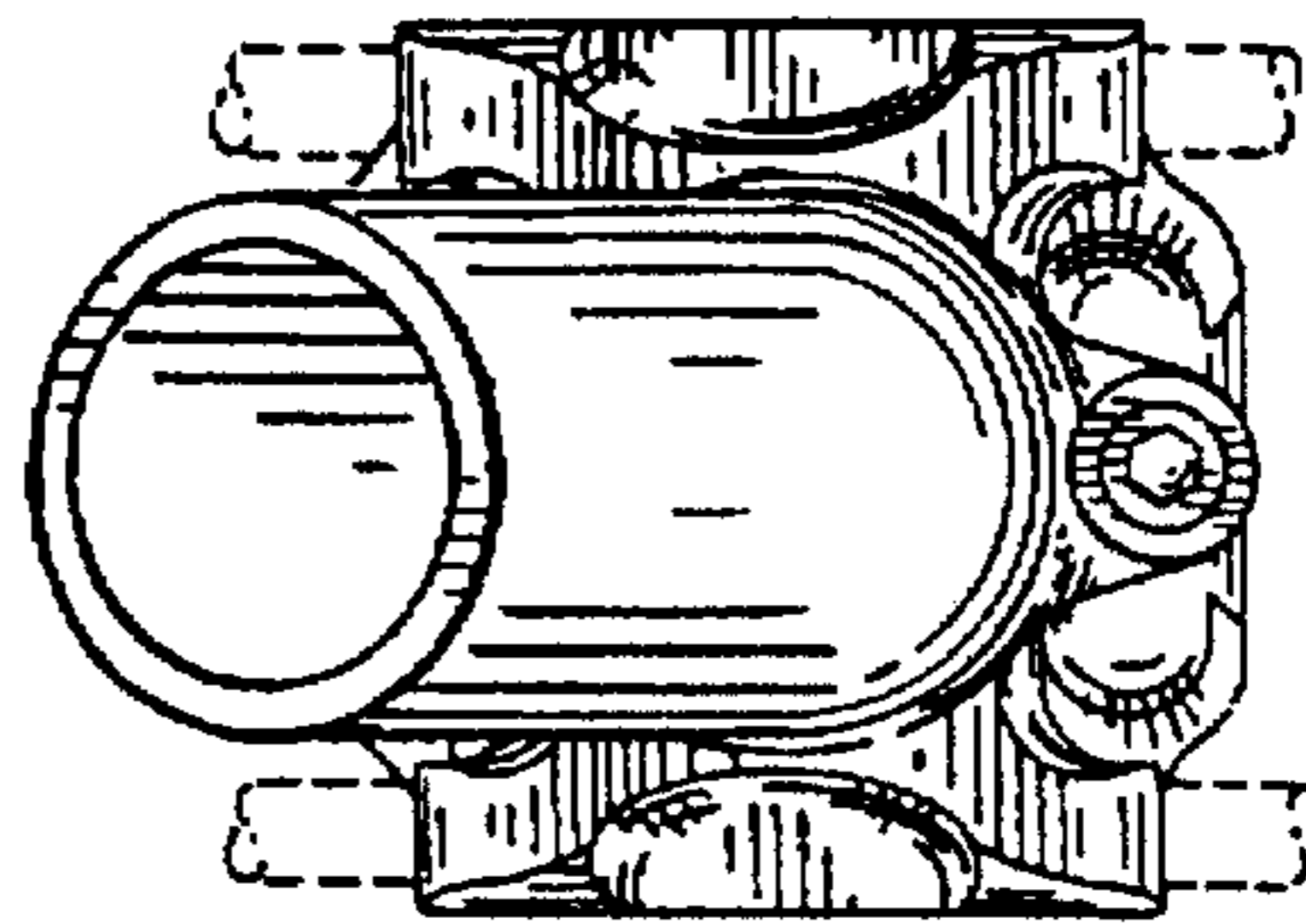
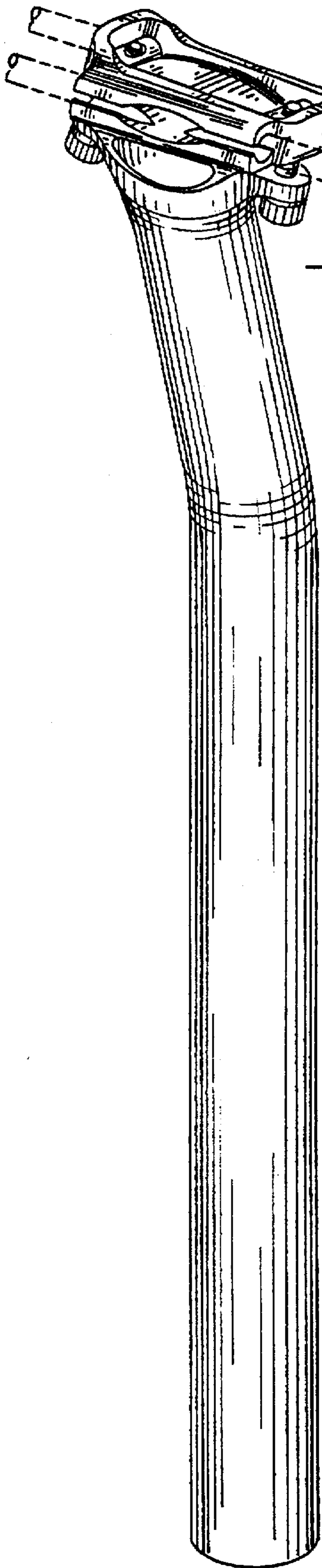

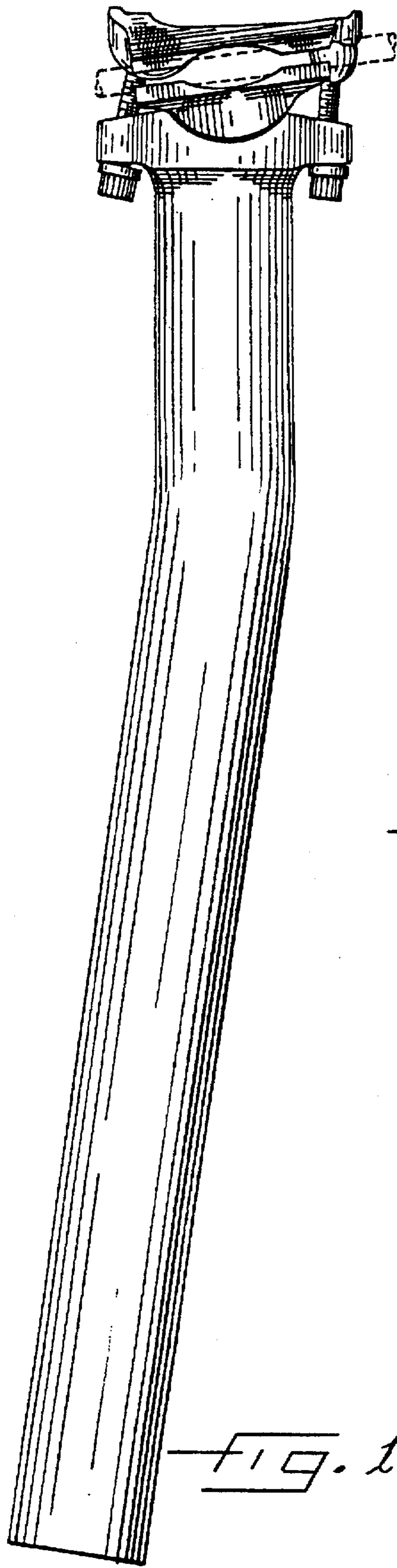

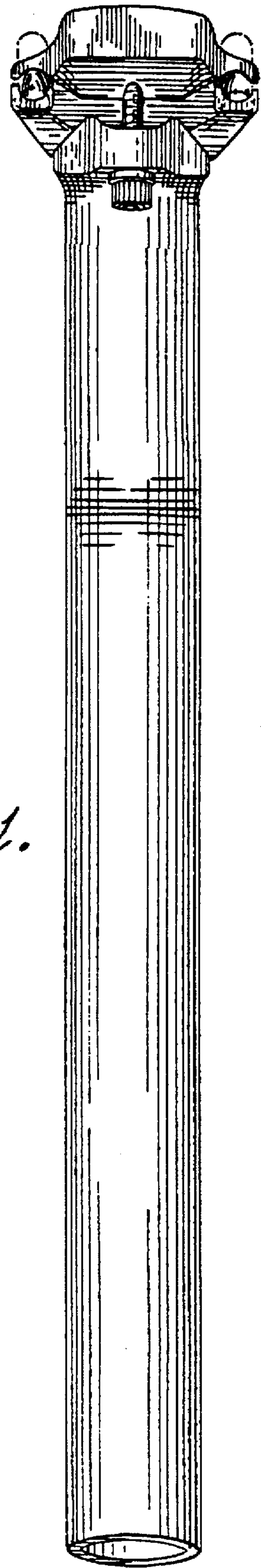

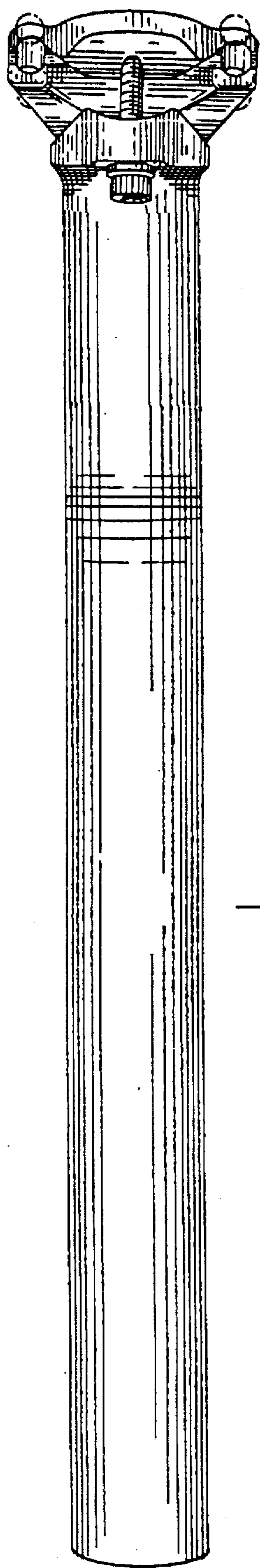
