[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a table top rim, as shown and
described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a table top rim showing my new
design;
FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view, the rear, left side and right
side elevational views being identical thereto;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view of a second embodiment of a table
top rim showing my new design;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view of a third embodiment of a table
top rim showing my new design;
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view;
FIG. 8 is a top plan view of a fourth embodiment of a table
top rim showing my new design;
FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view;
FIG. 10 is a cross sectional view showing one embodiment
of my design taken transversely through the design element
shown in FIGS. 1, 4, 6 and 8; and,
FIG. 11 is a cross sectional view showing another embodi-
ment of my design taken transversely through the design
element shown in FIGS. 1, 4, 6 and 8.
The front, rear, left side and right side elevational views of
FIGS. 4, 6 and 8 are similar to FIG. 3.
The broken lines in the drawings form no part of the claimed
design.

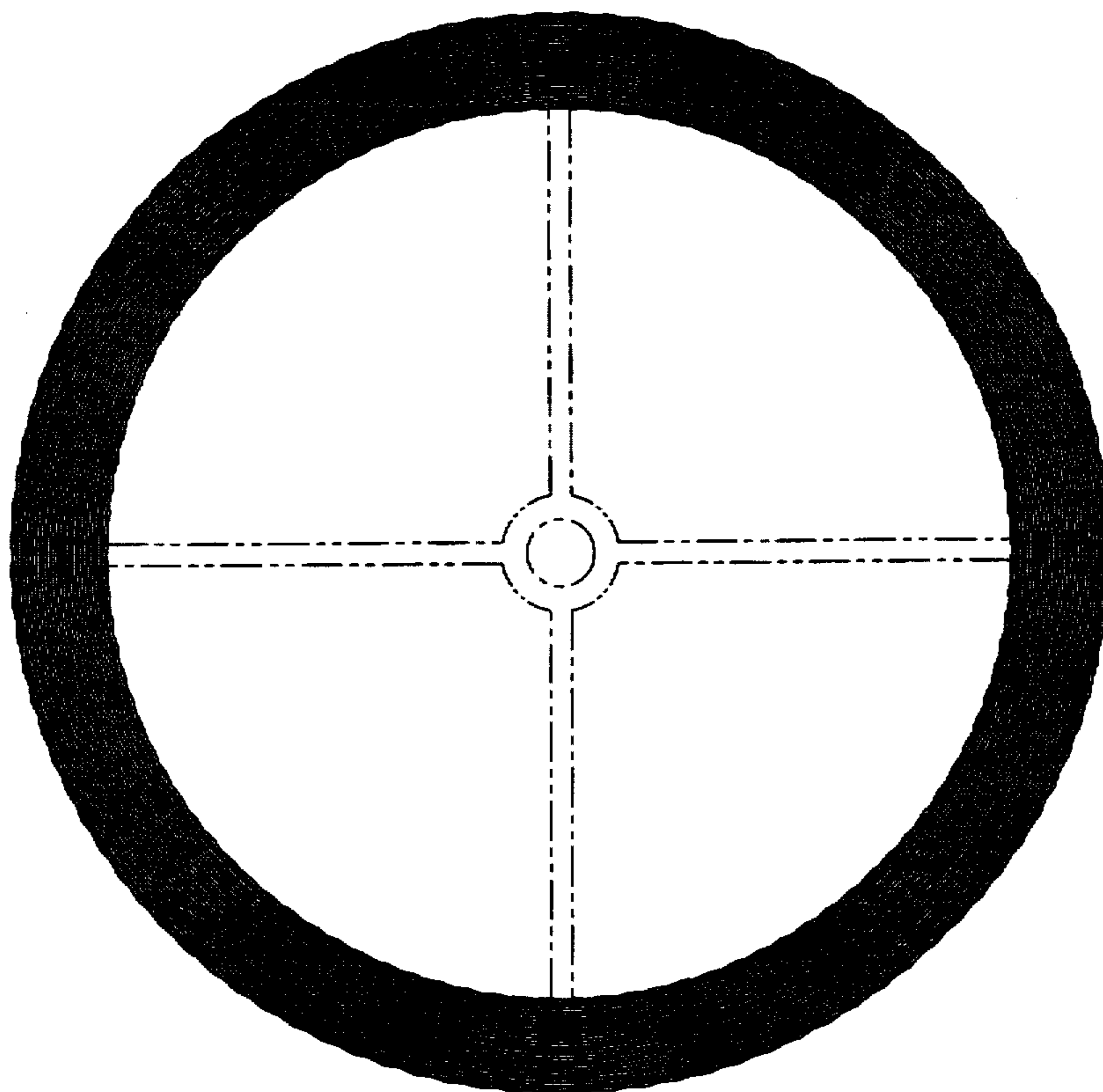

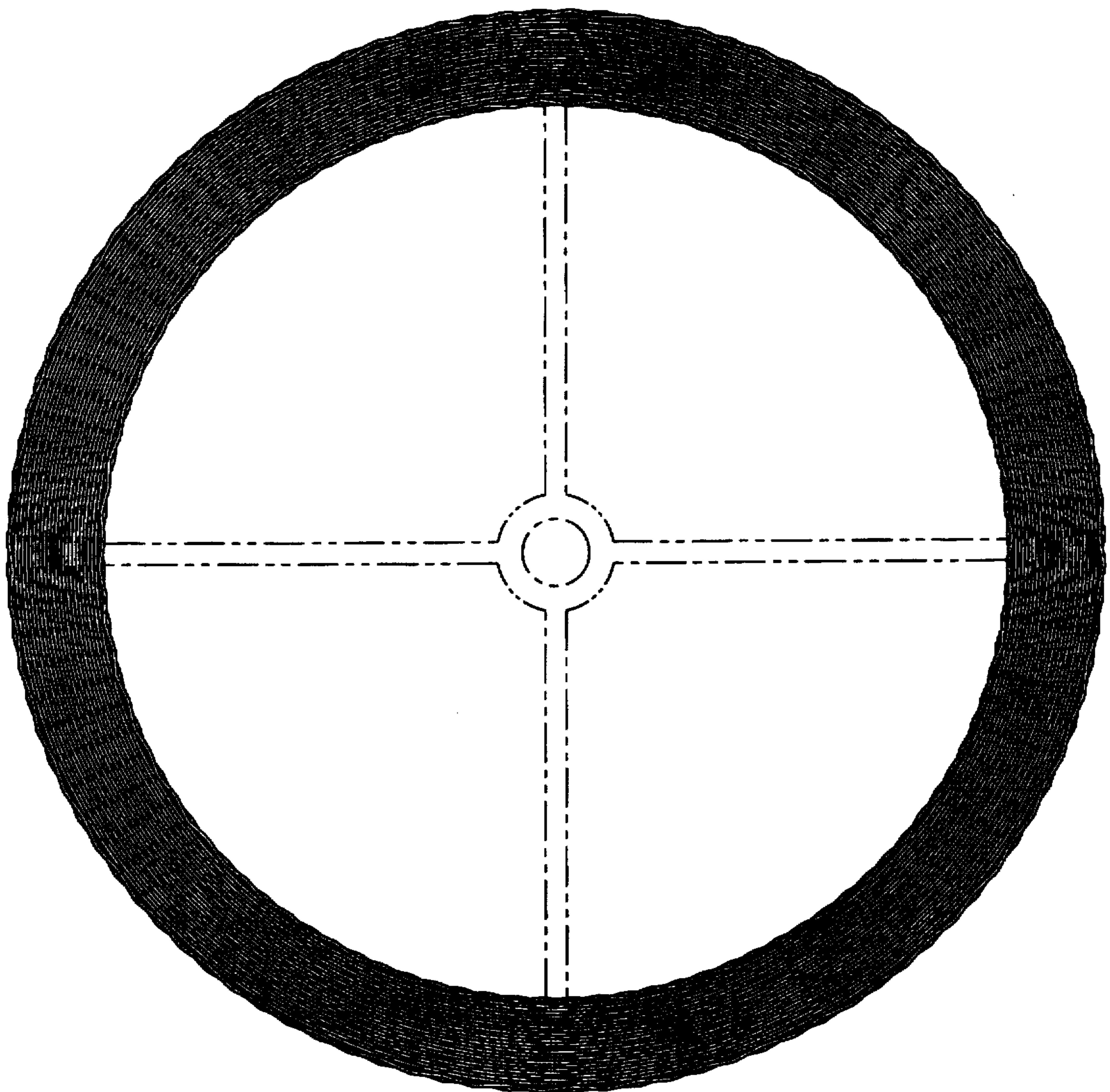

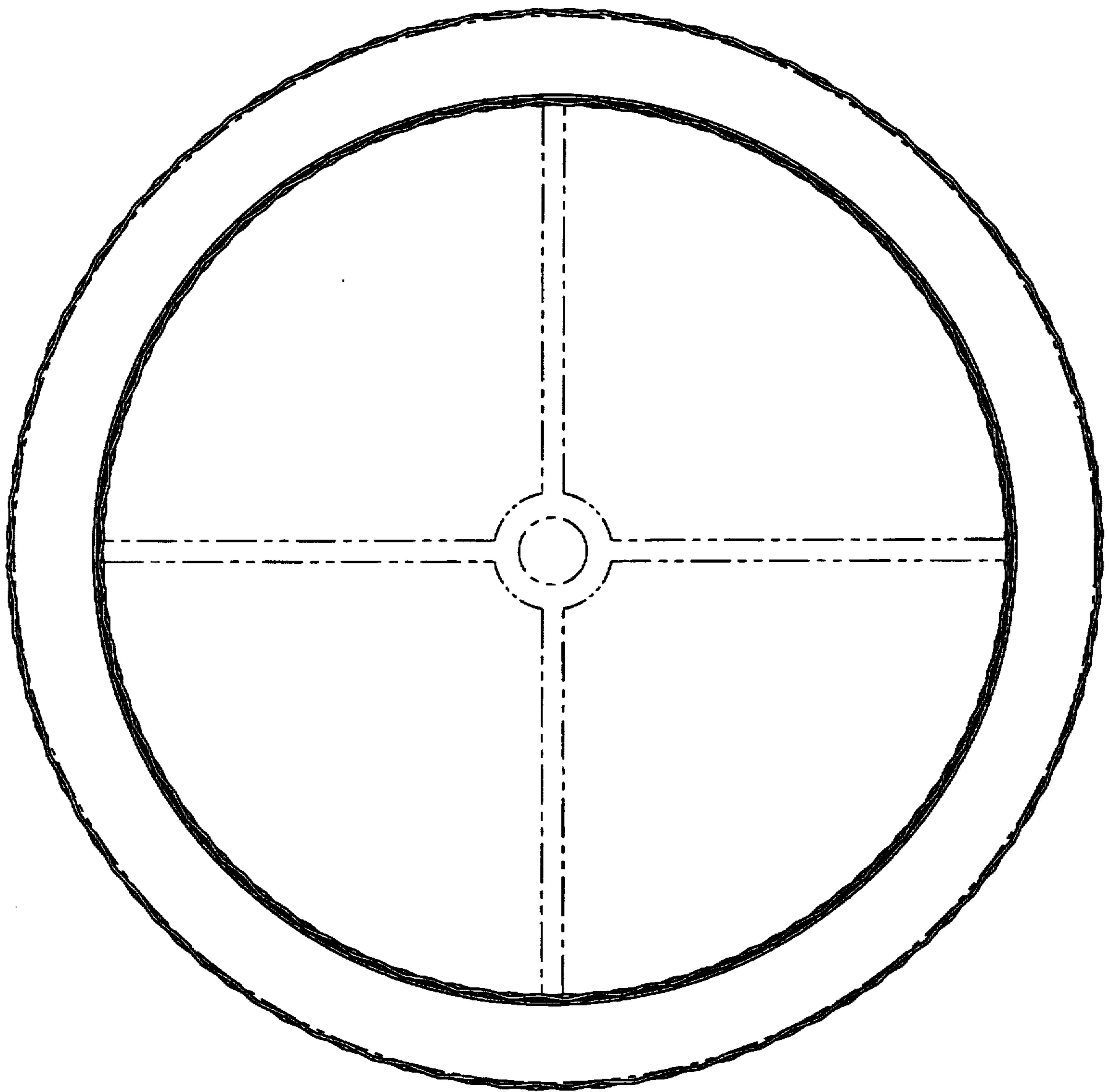

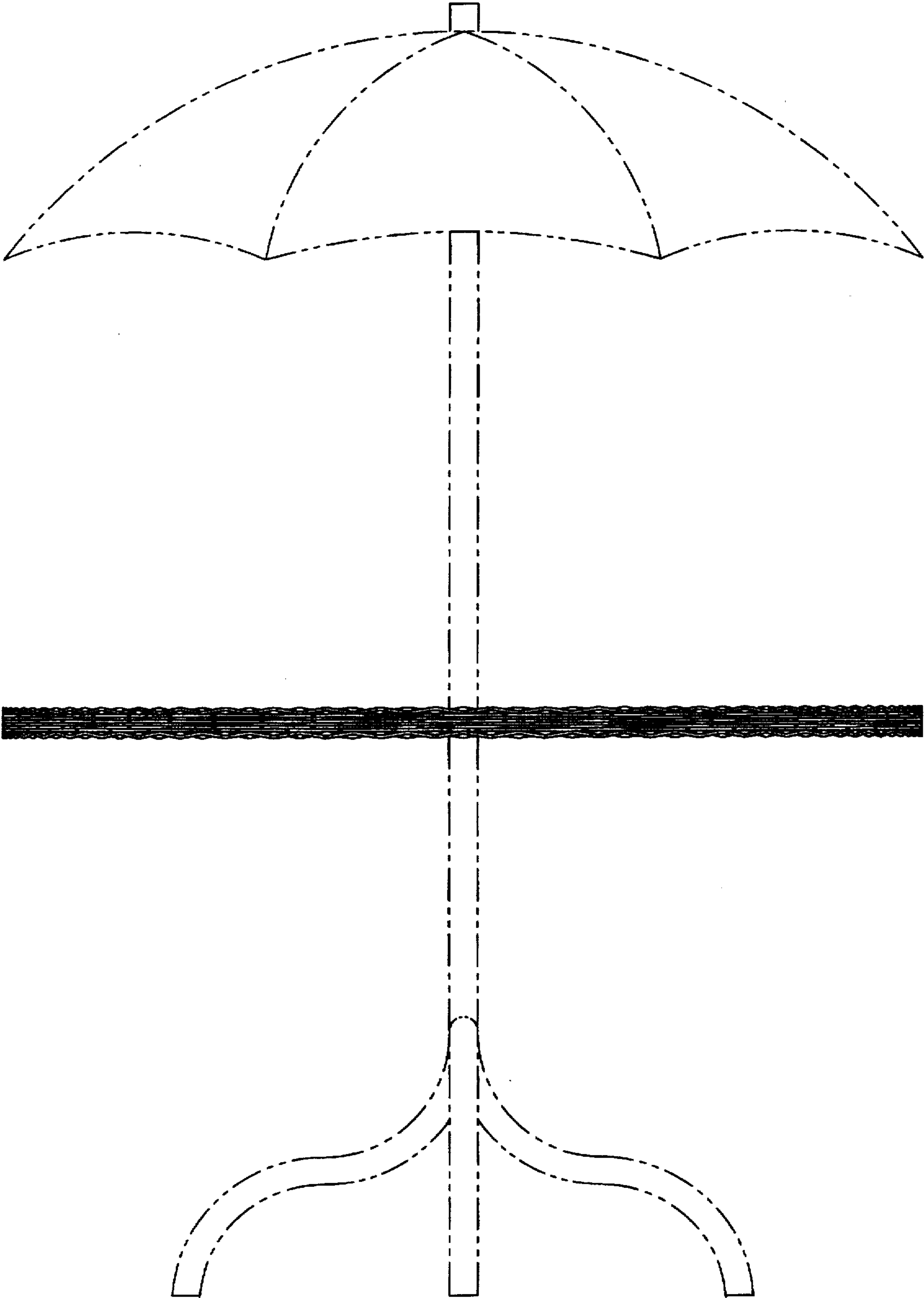

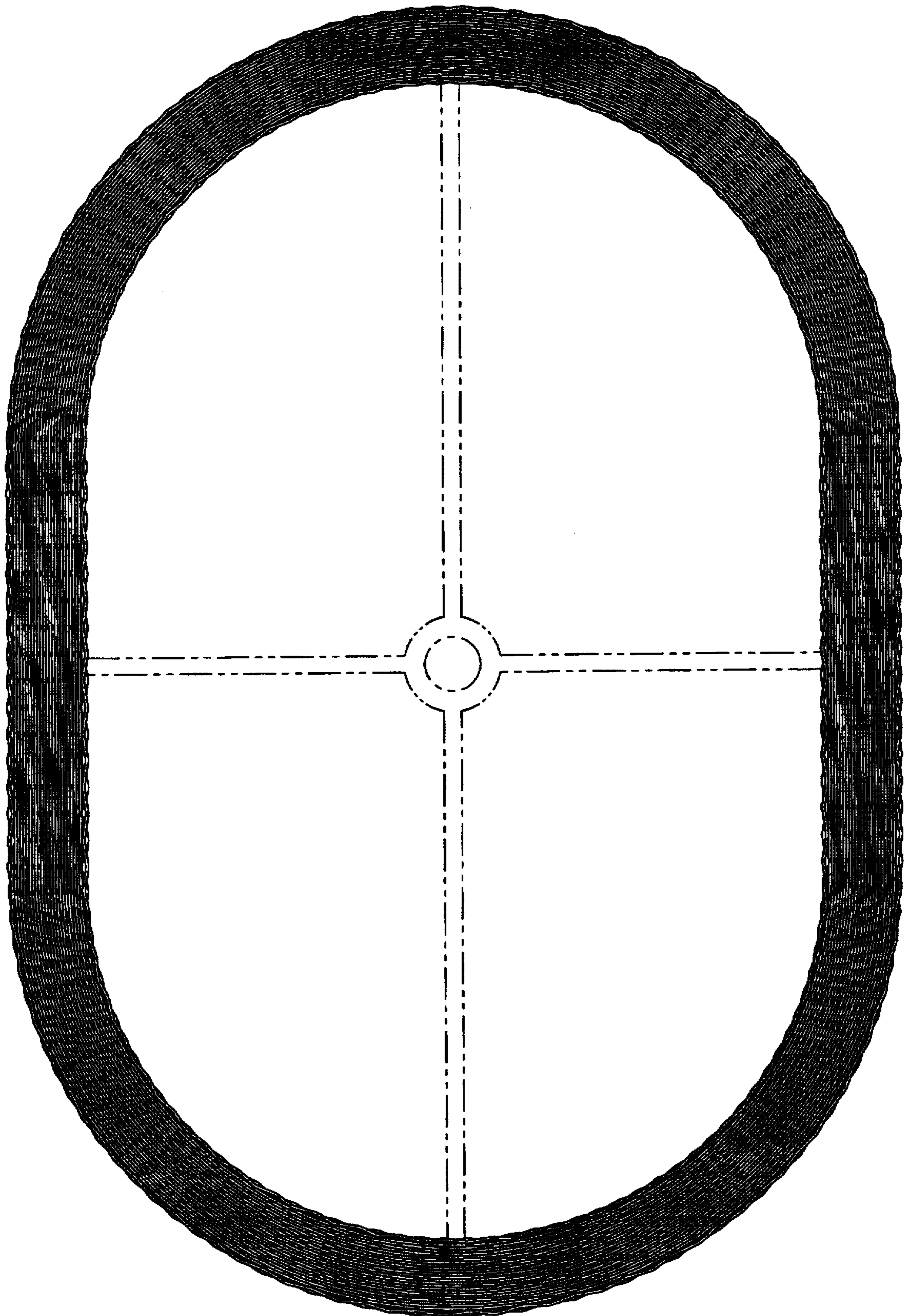

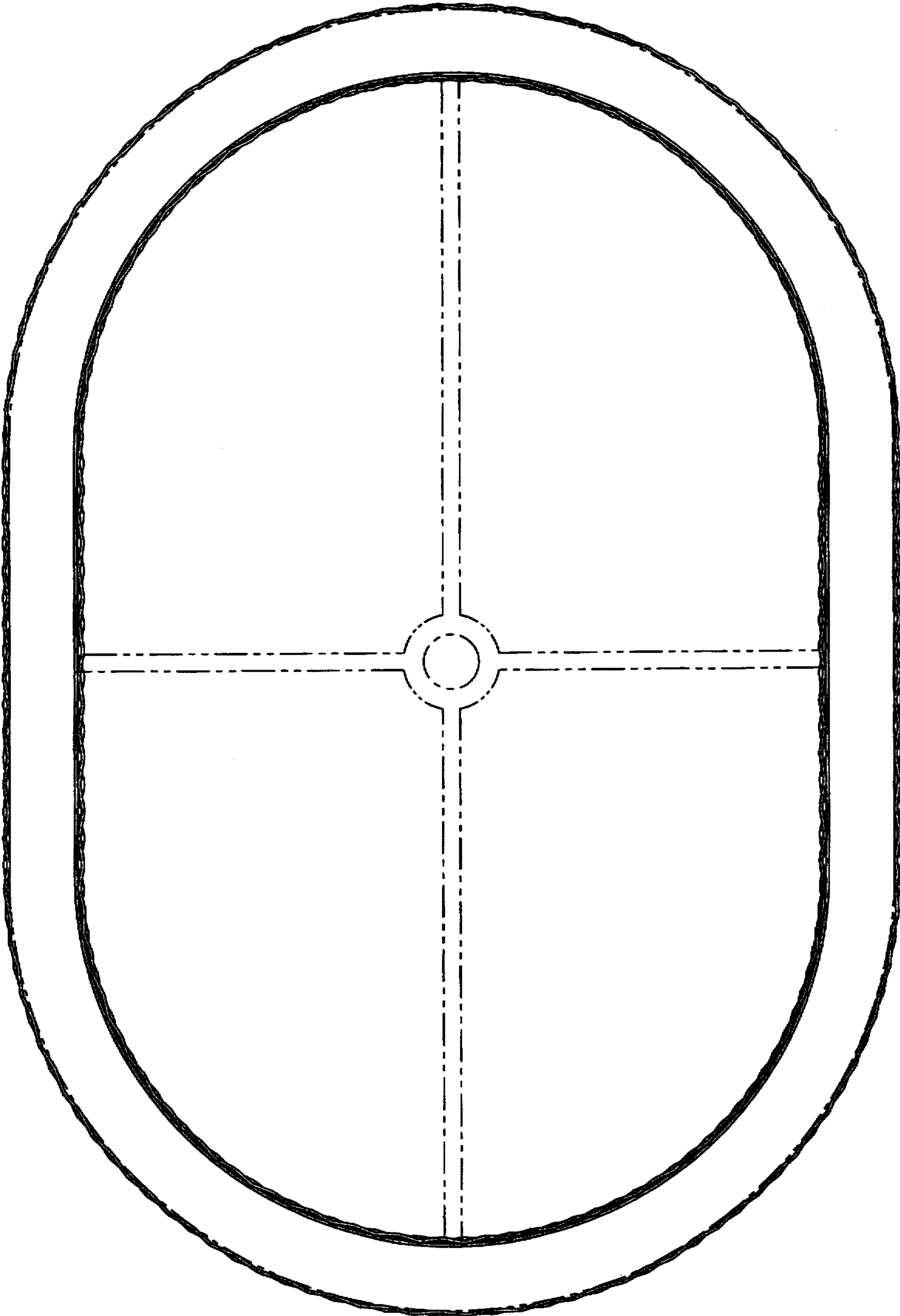

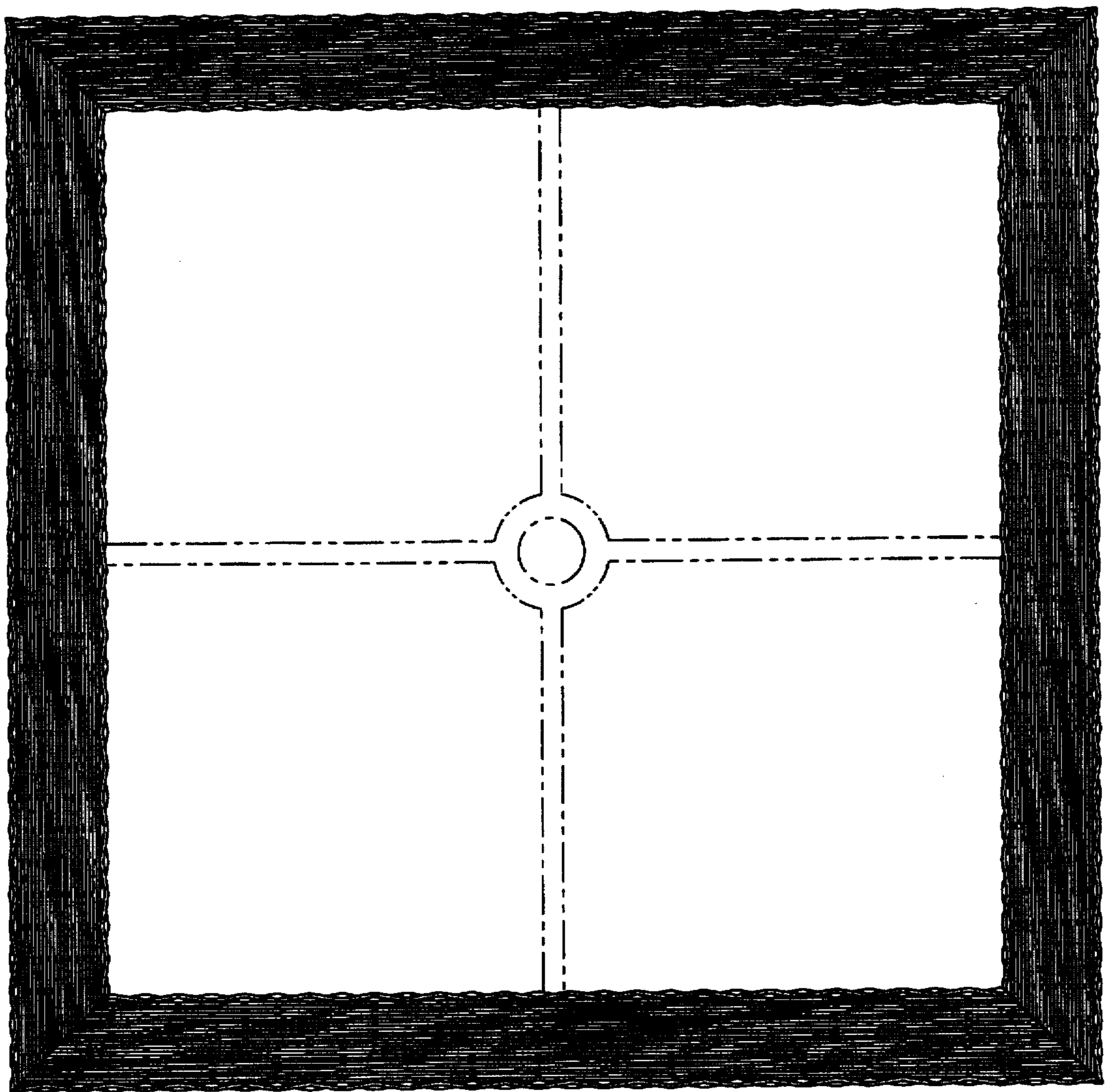

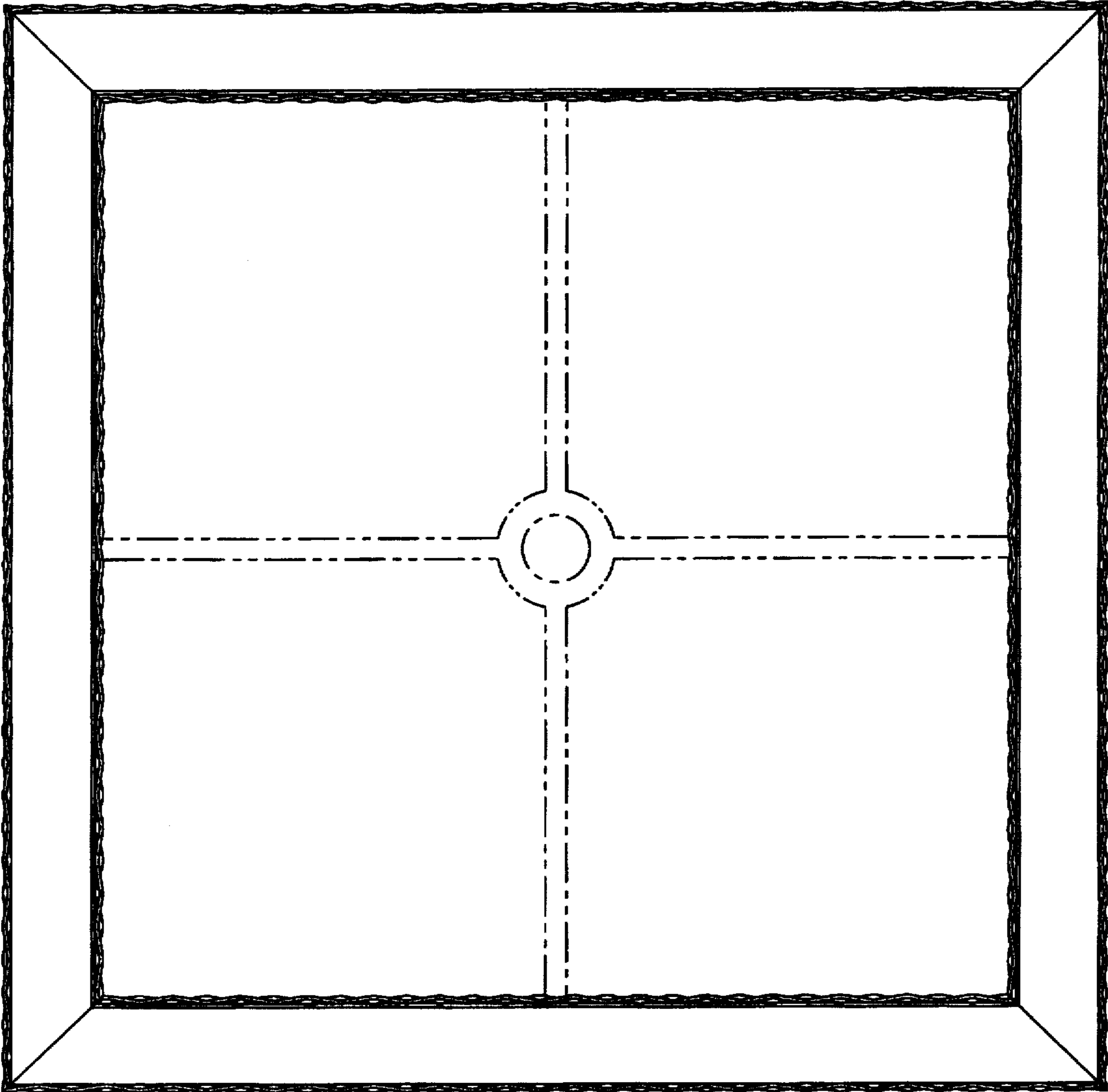

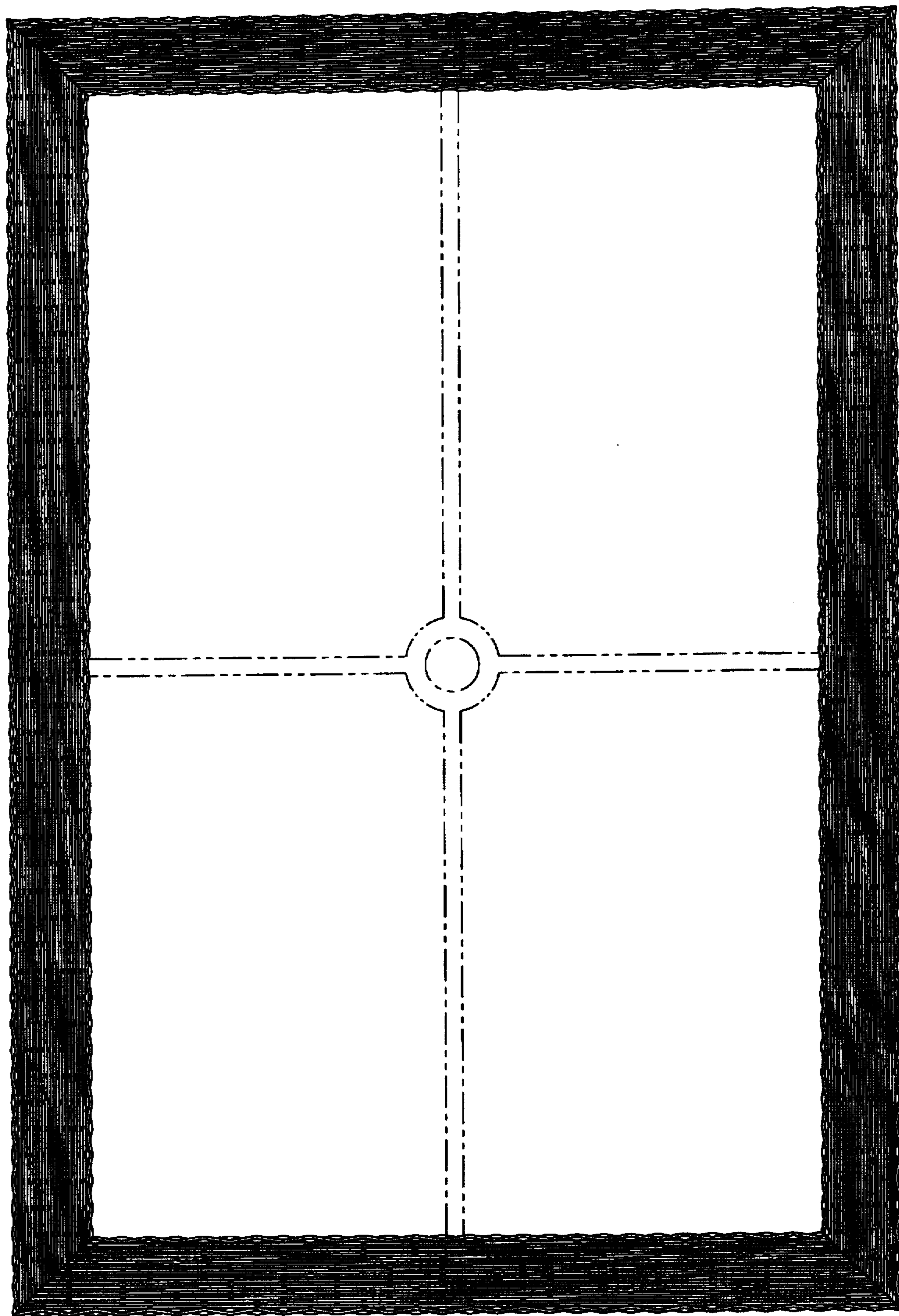

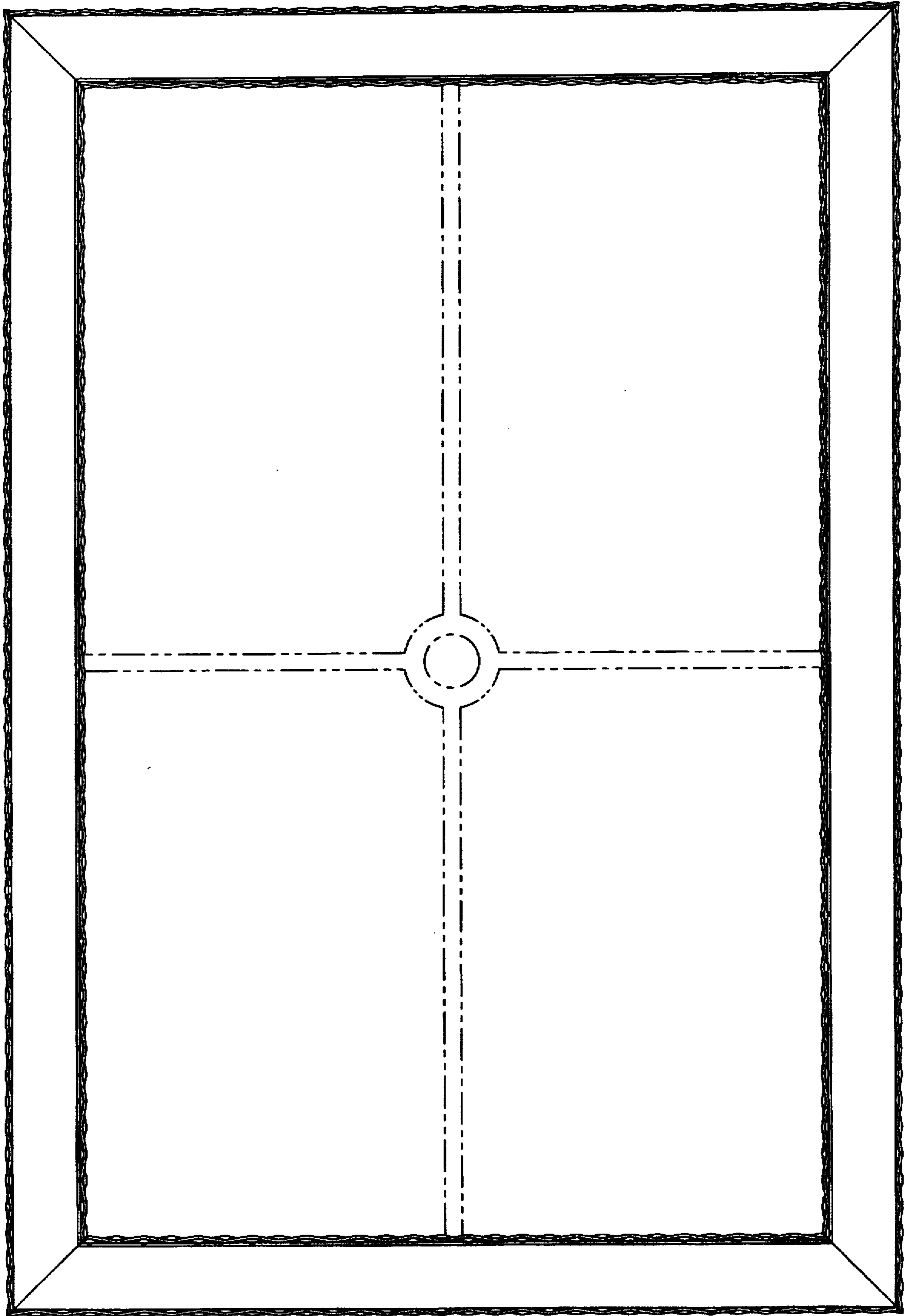

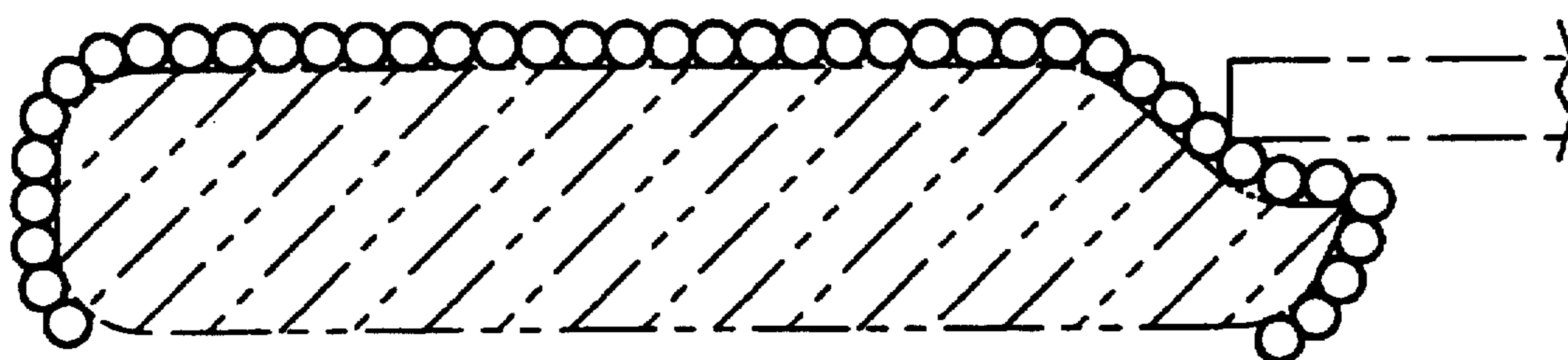
