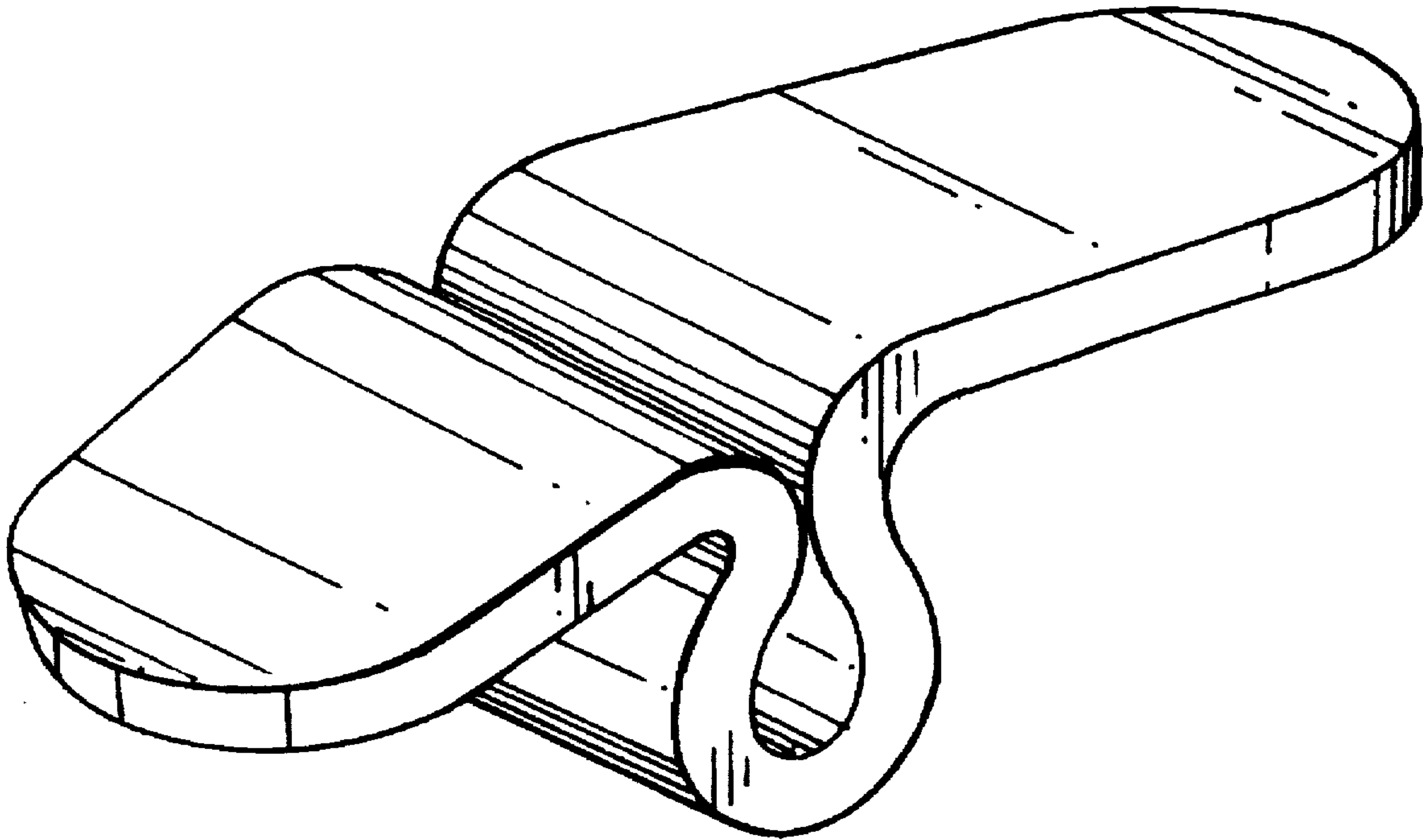
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[57] **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a front, left, top perspective view of a spring for a clip-on earring showing my design therefor;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, the opposite side being an identical mirror image;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; and,
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.

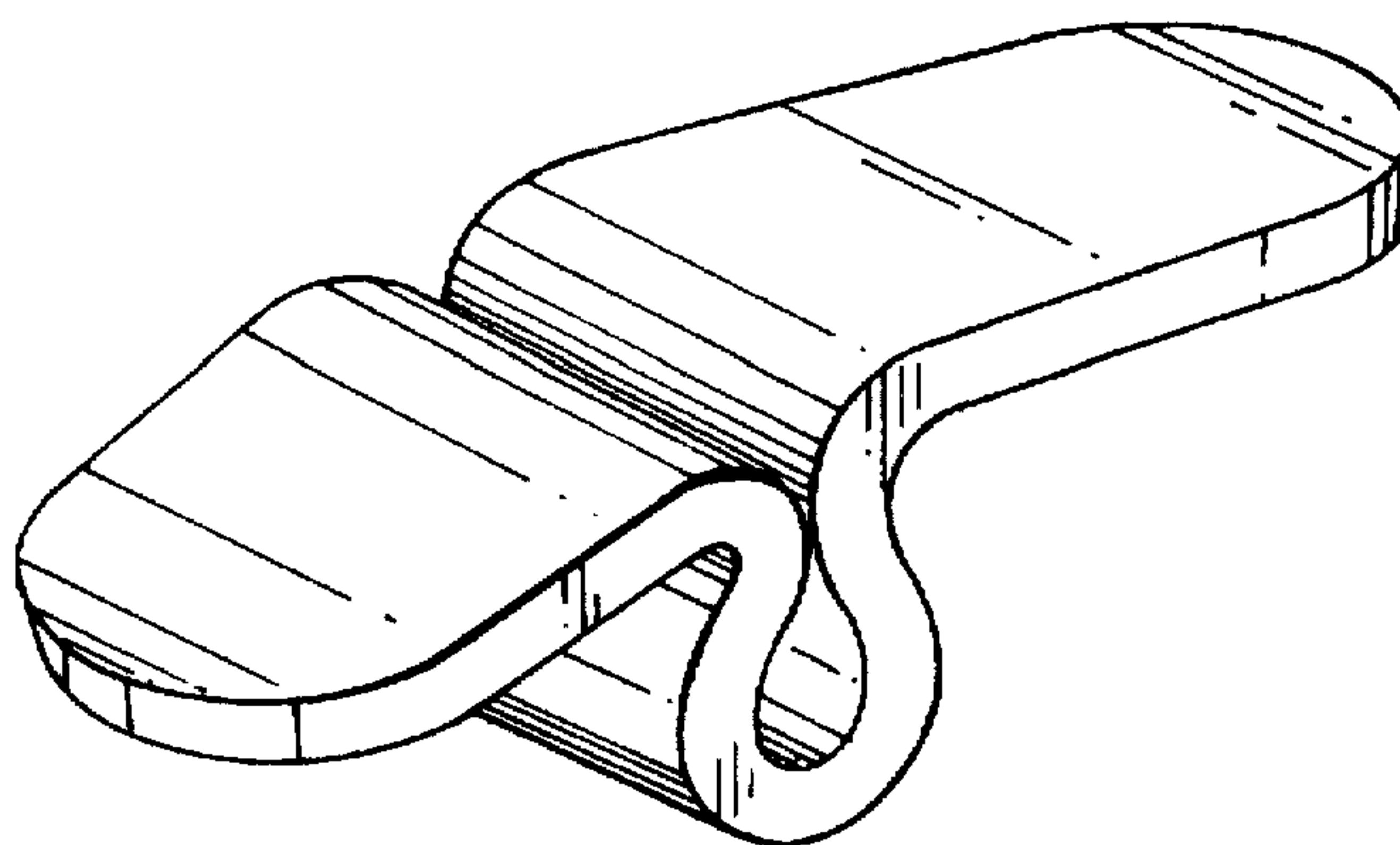

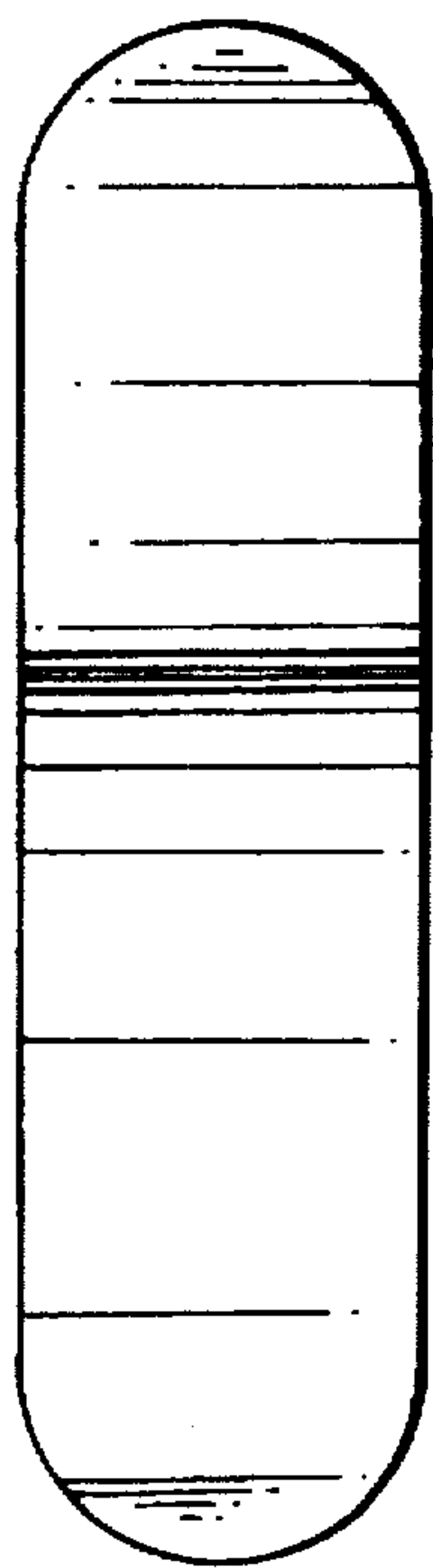

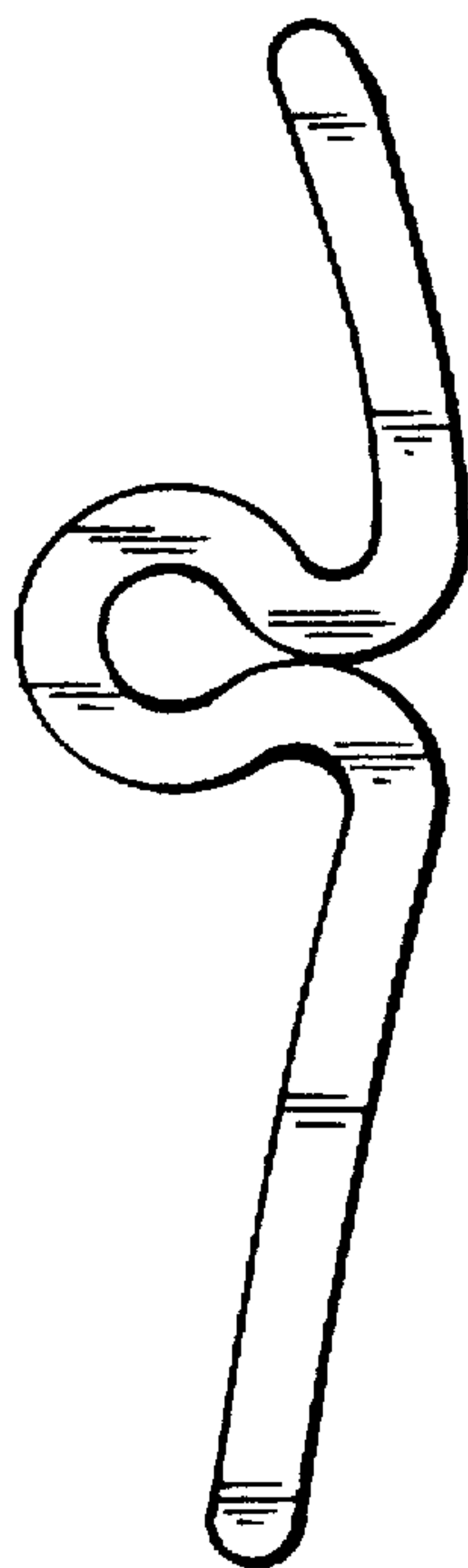

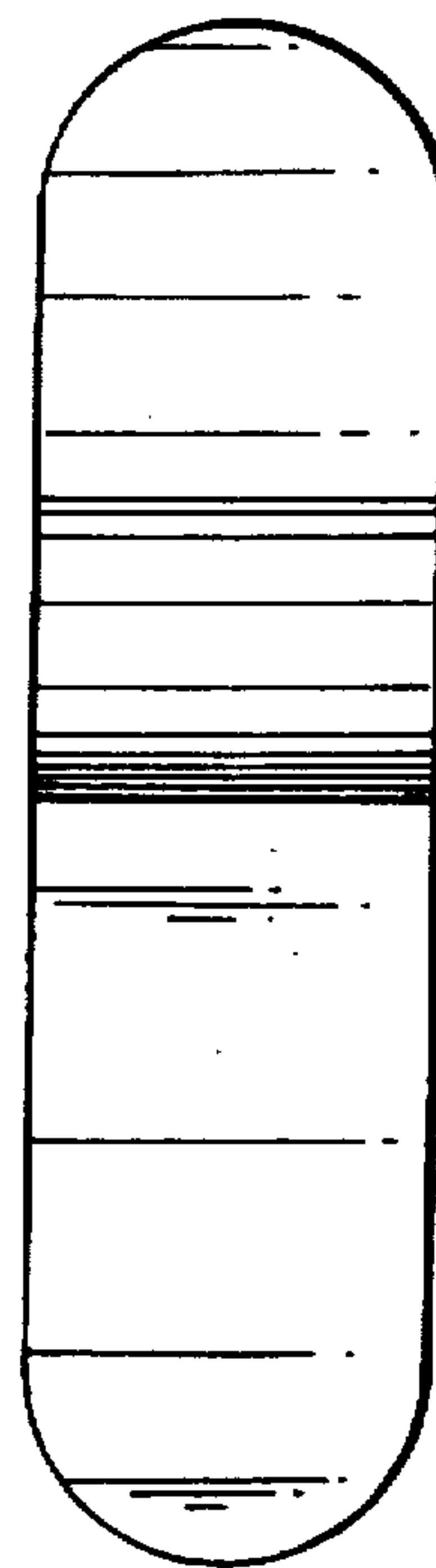

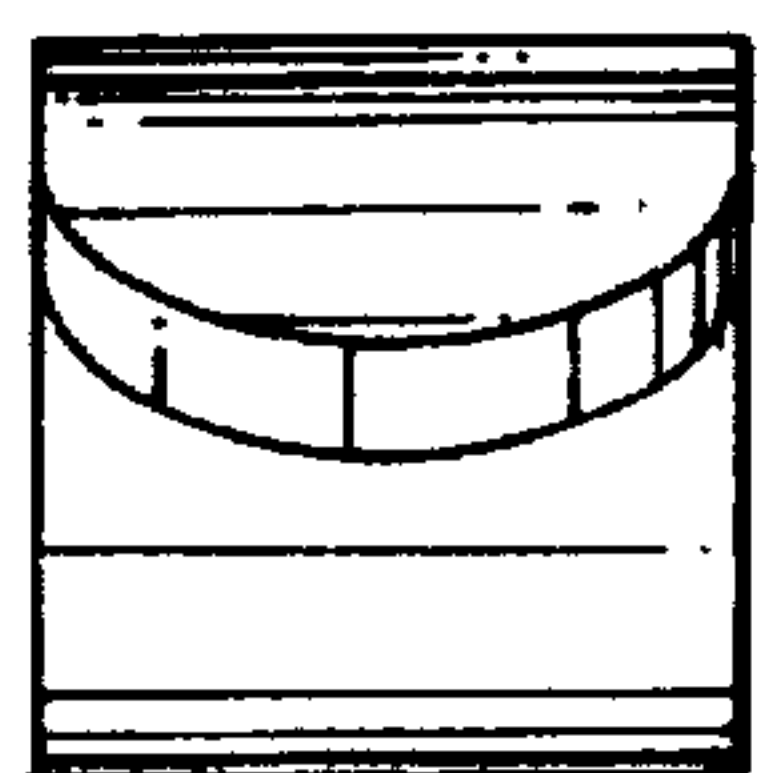

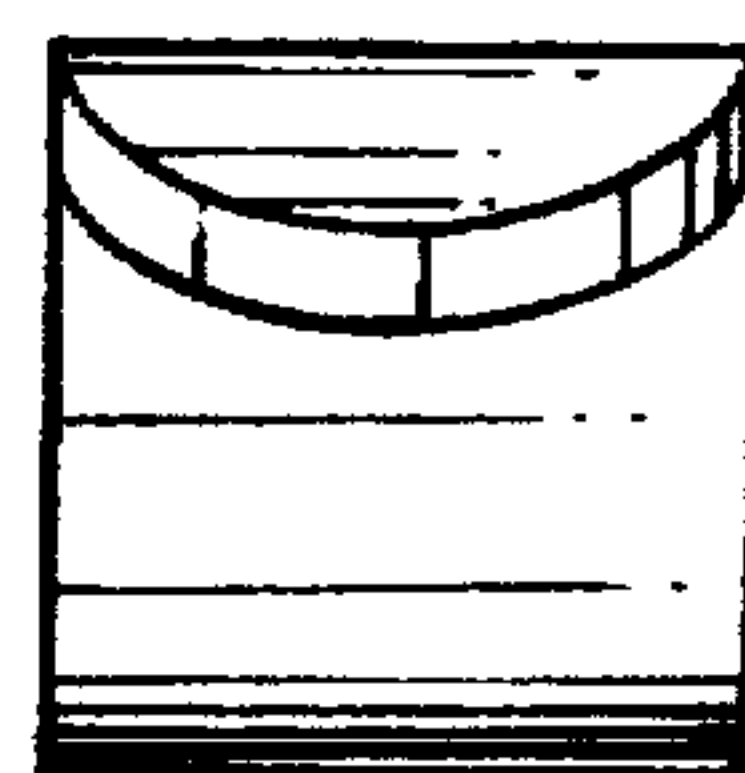
