FIG. 1 is a plan view of a portion of a shoe outsole showing my new design;

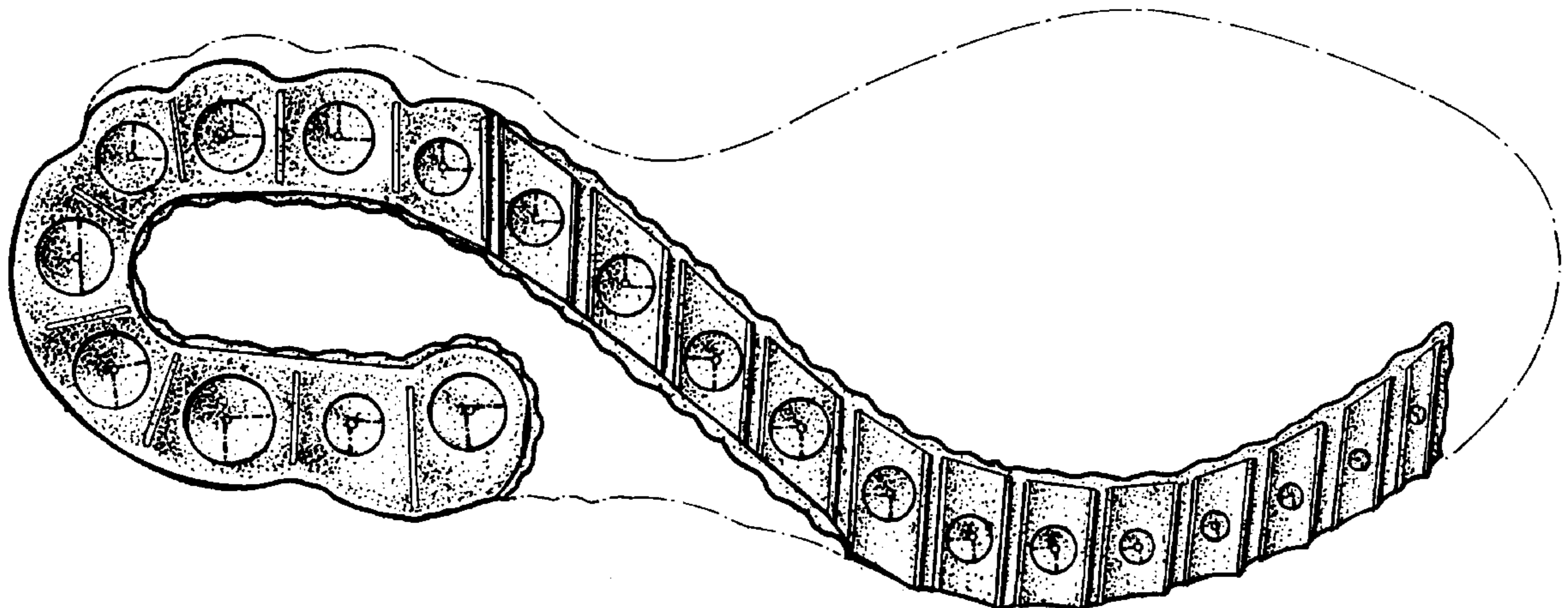
FIG. 2 is a lateral front perspective view thereof;

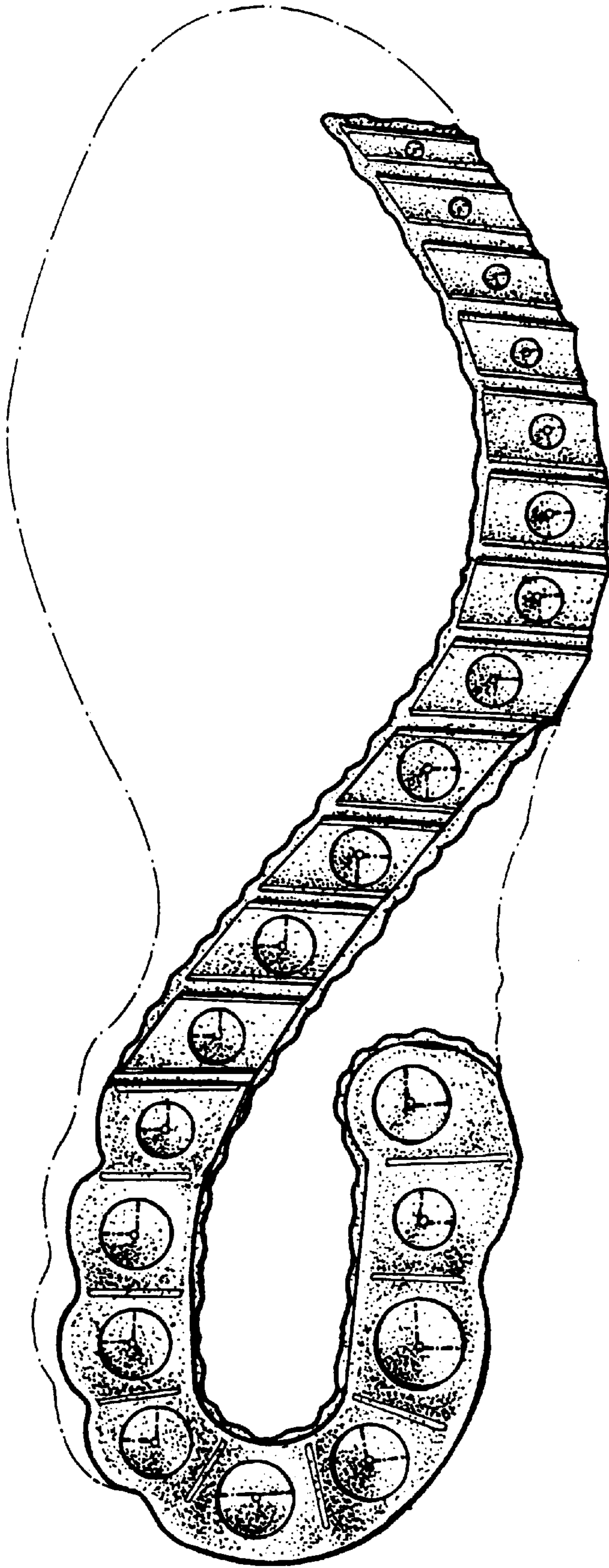

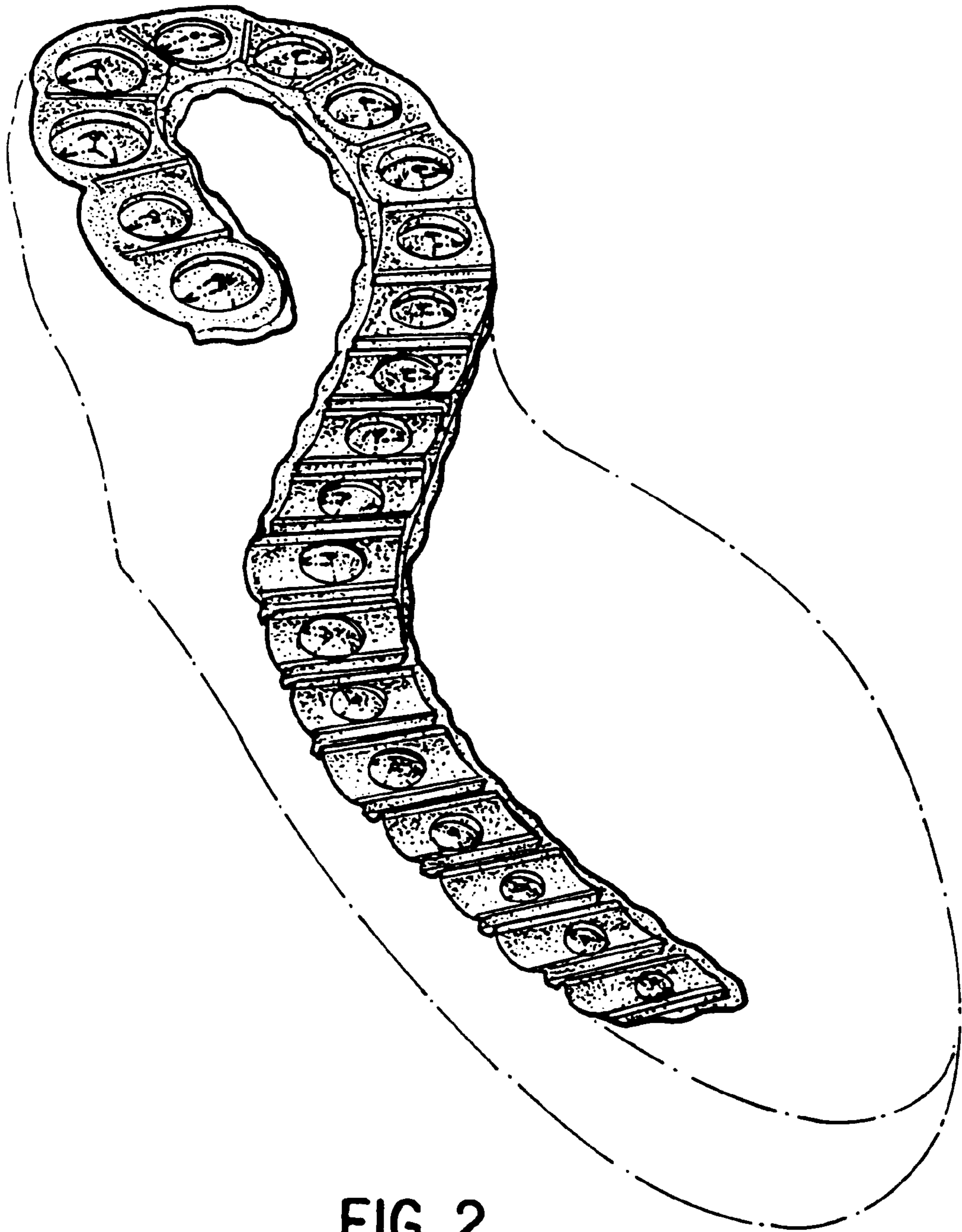

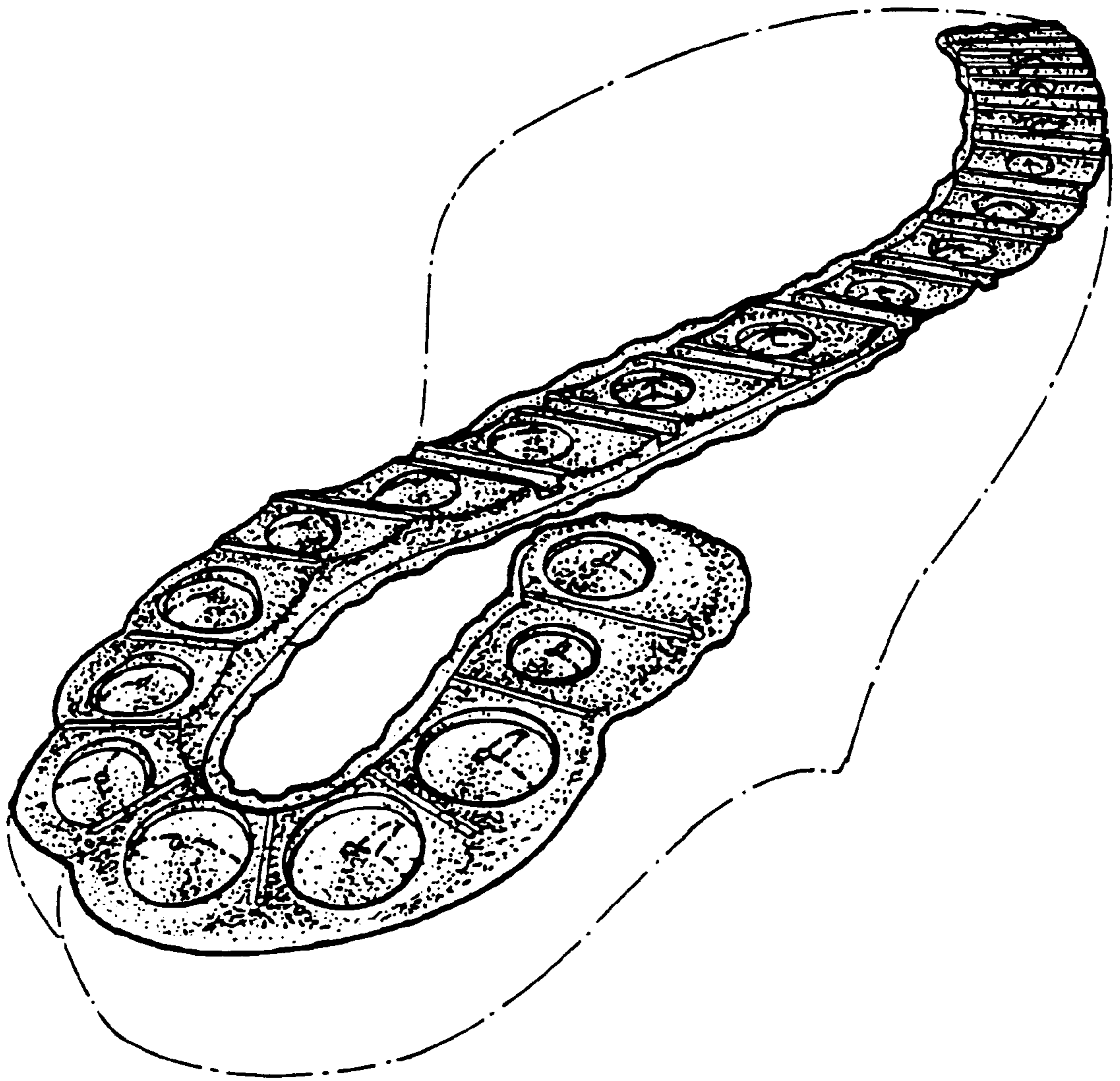

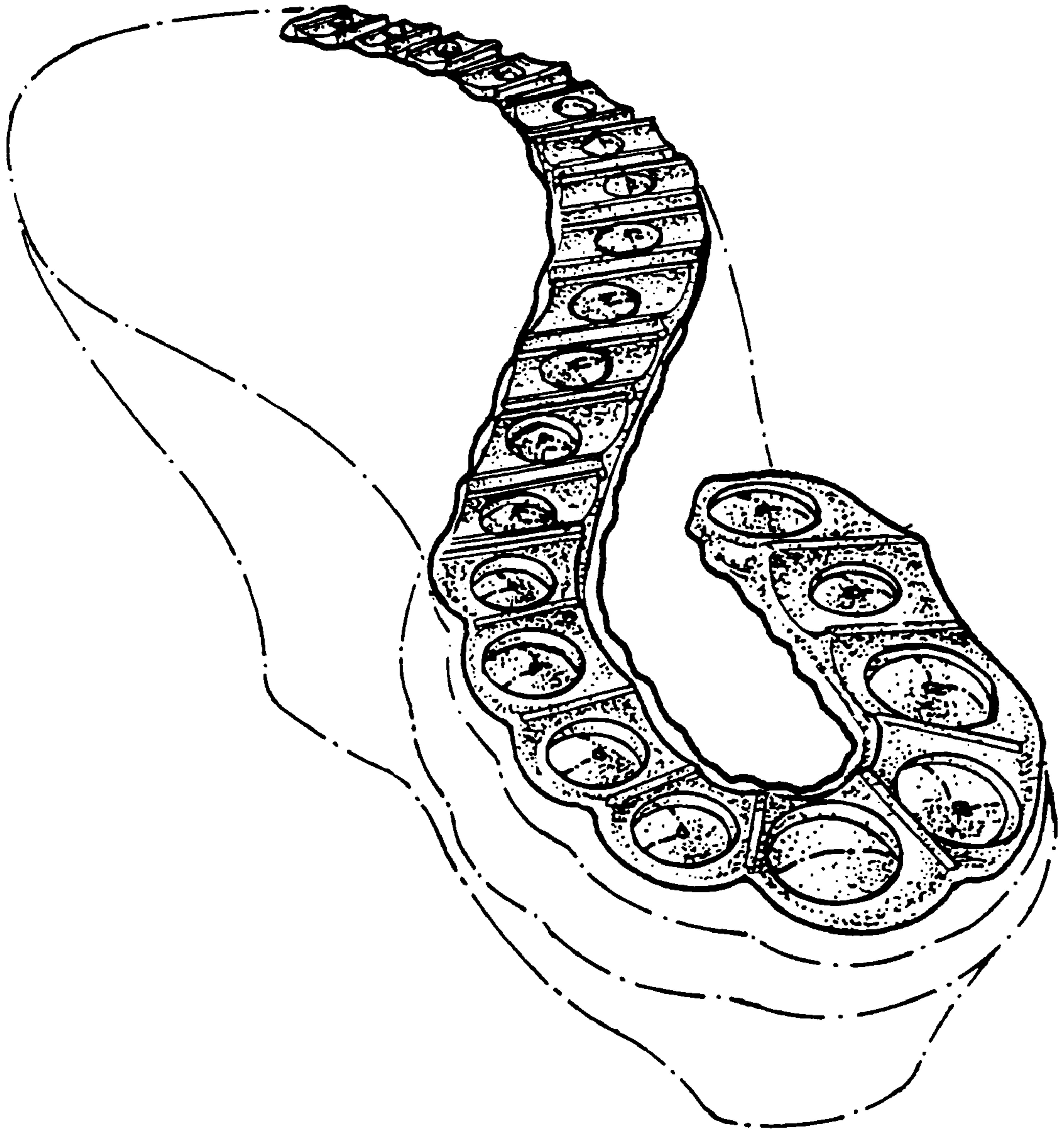
