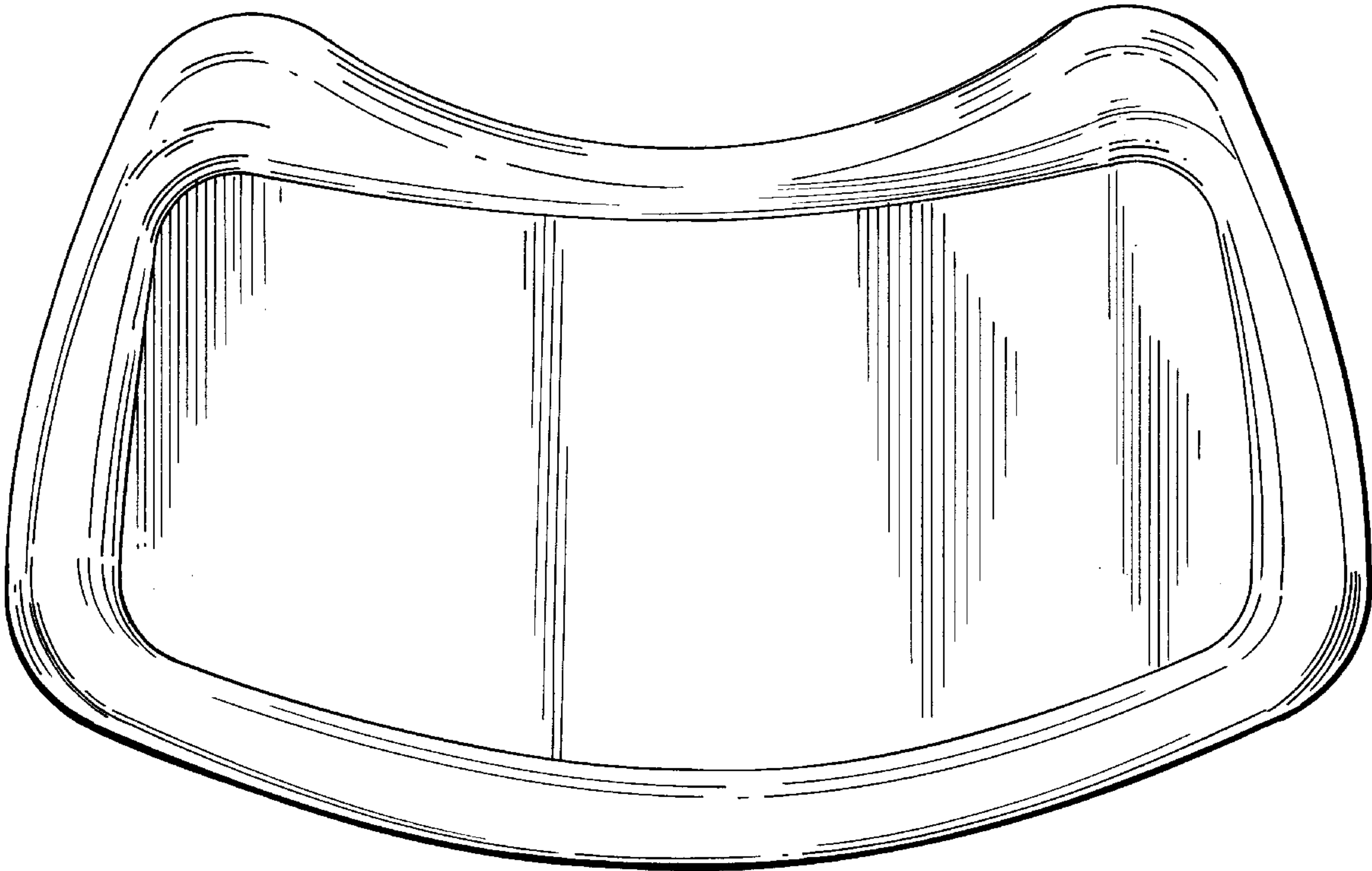

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a high chair tray showing a first embodiment of our new design;
FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right-side elevational view thereof, with the left-side elevational view thereof being a mirror image;
FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom view thereof;

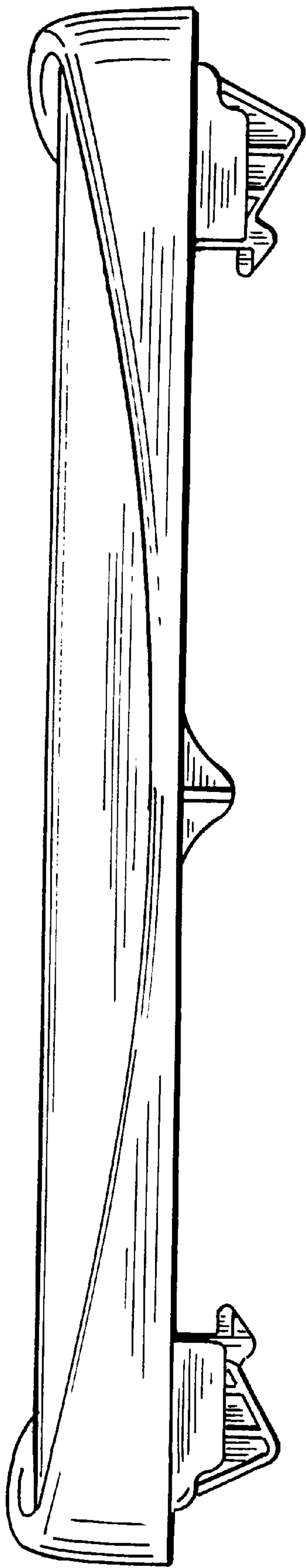

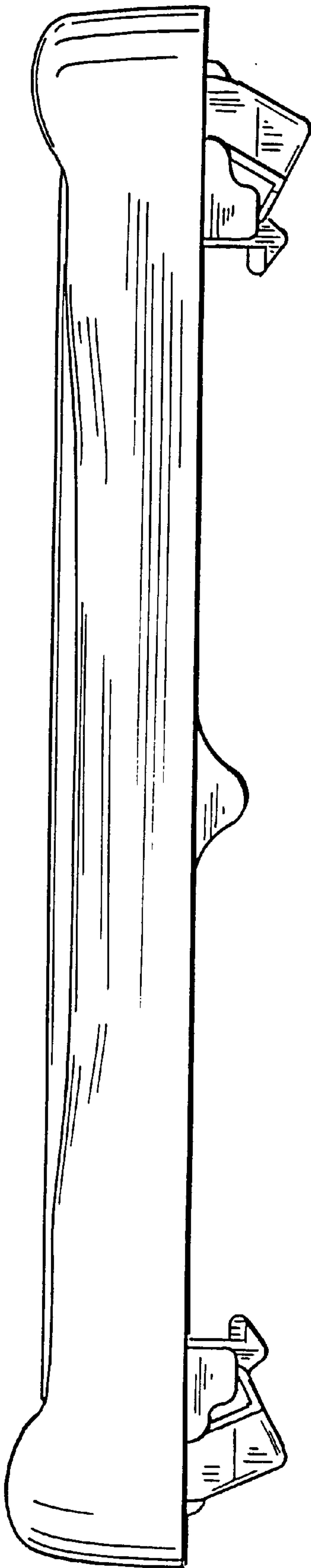

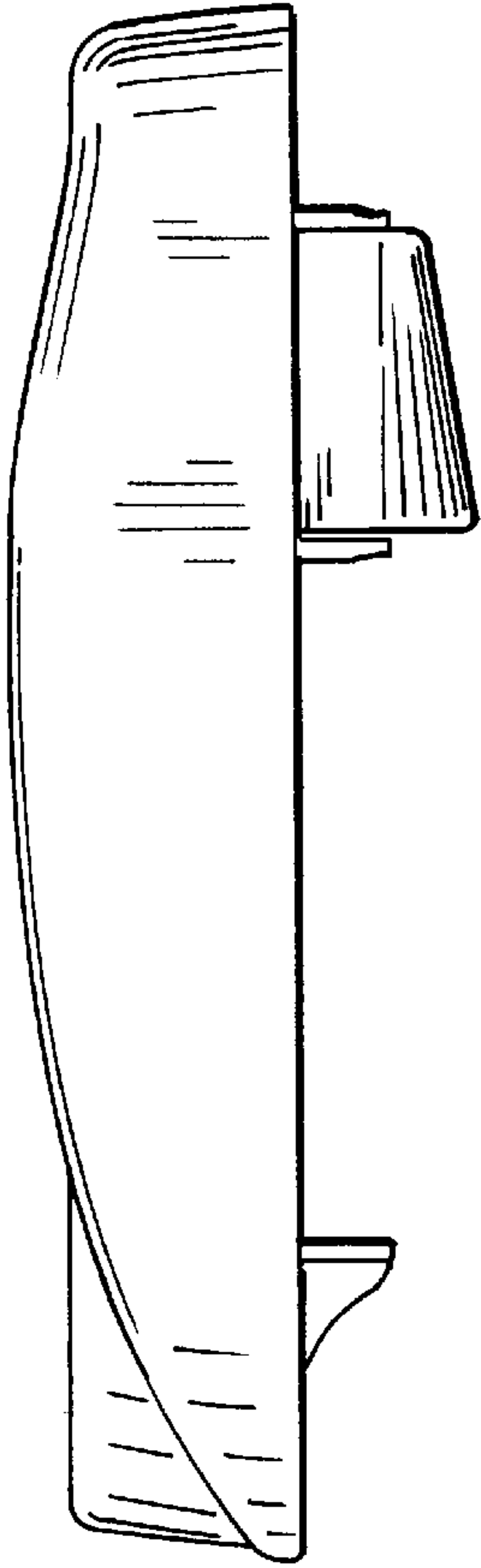

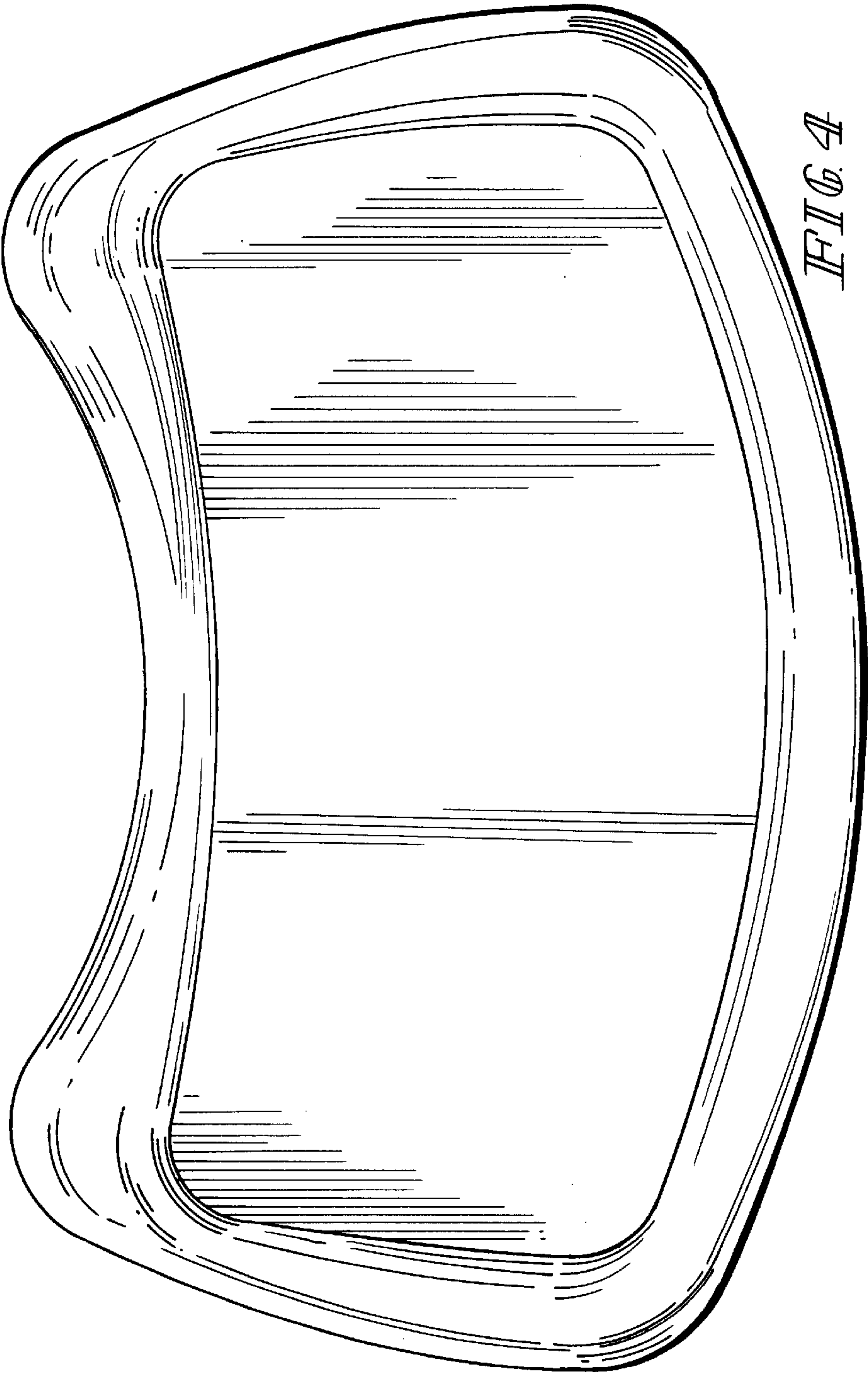

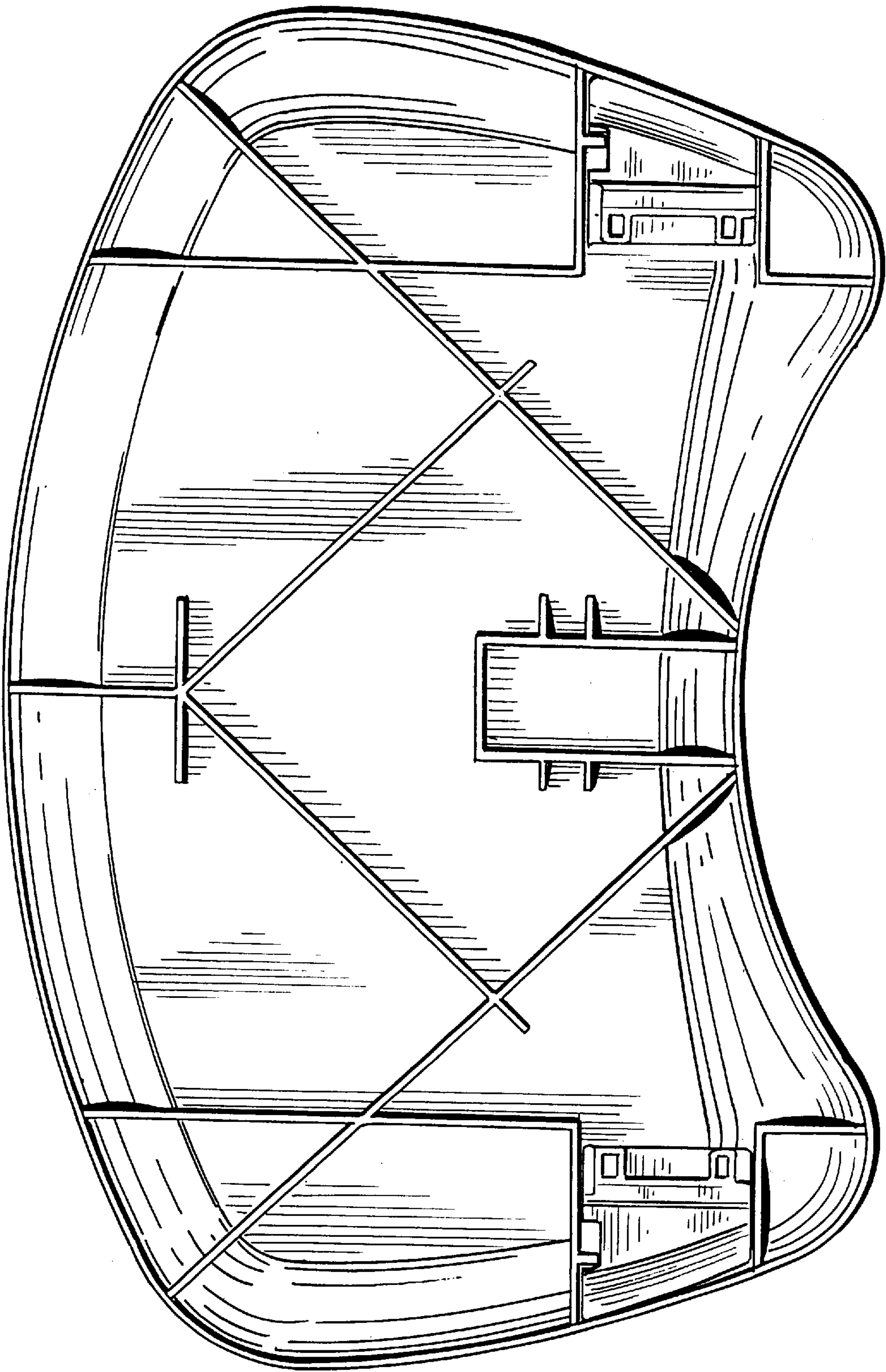

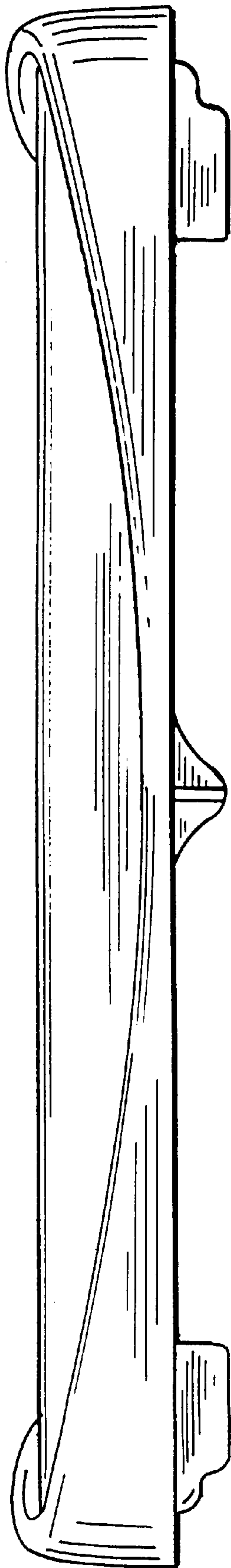

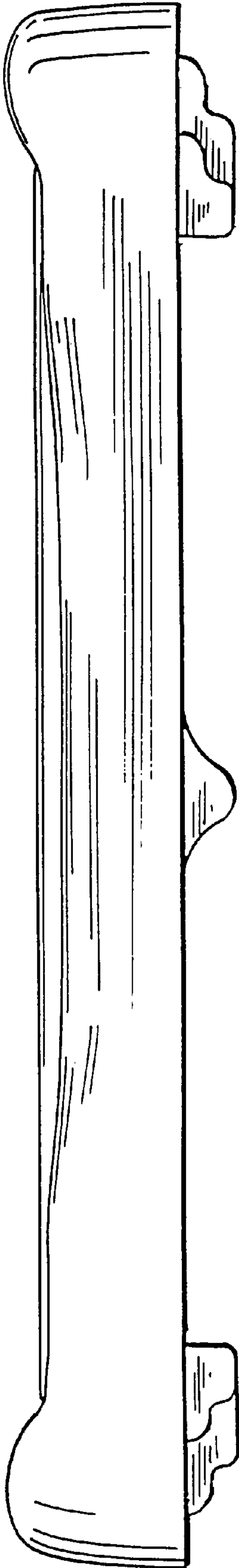
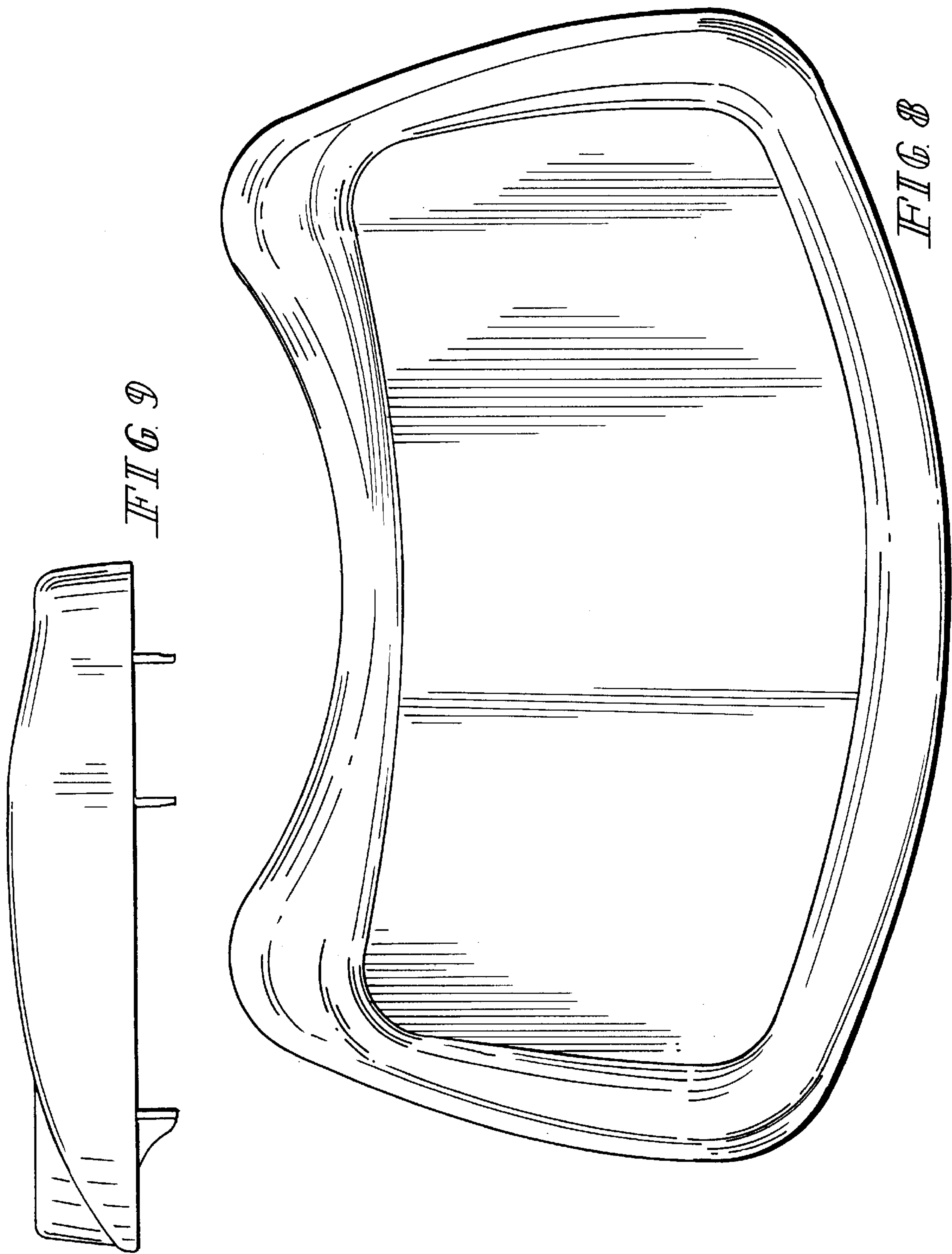

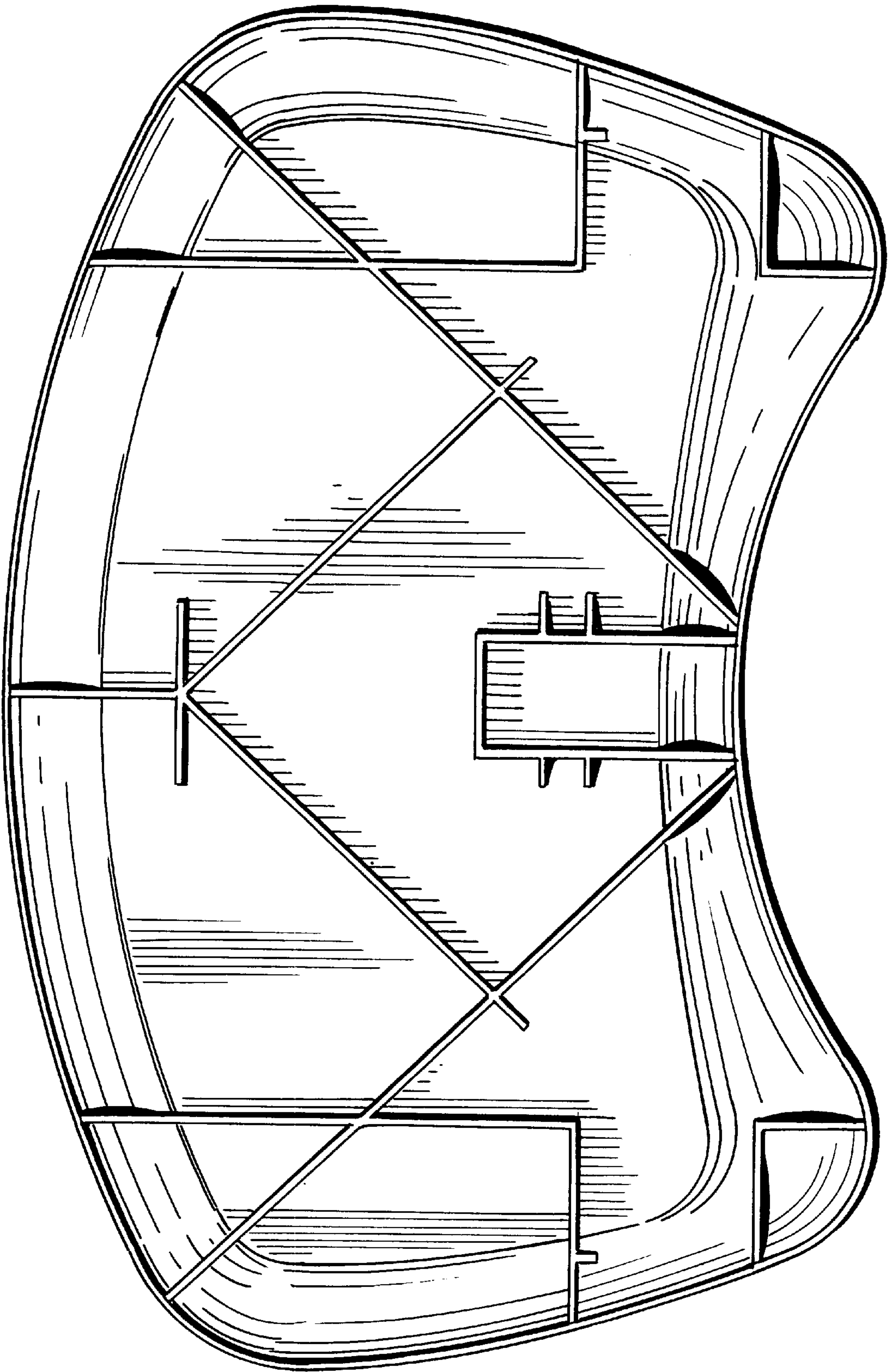
