and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front-right-top perspective view of a handle for
a suitcase, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;

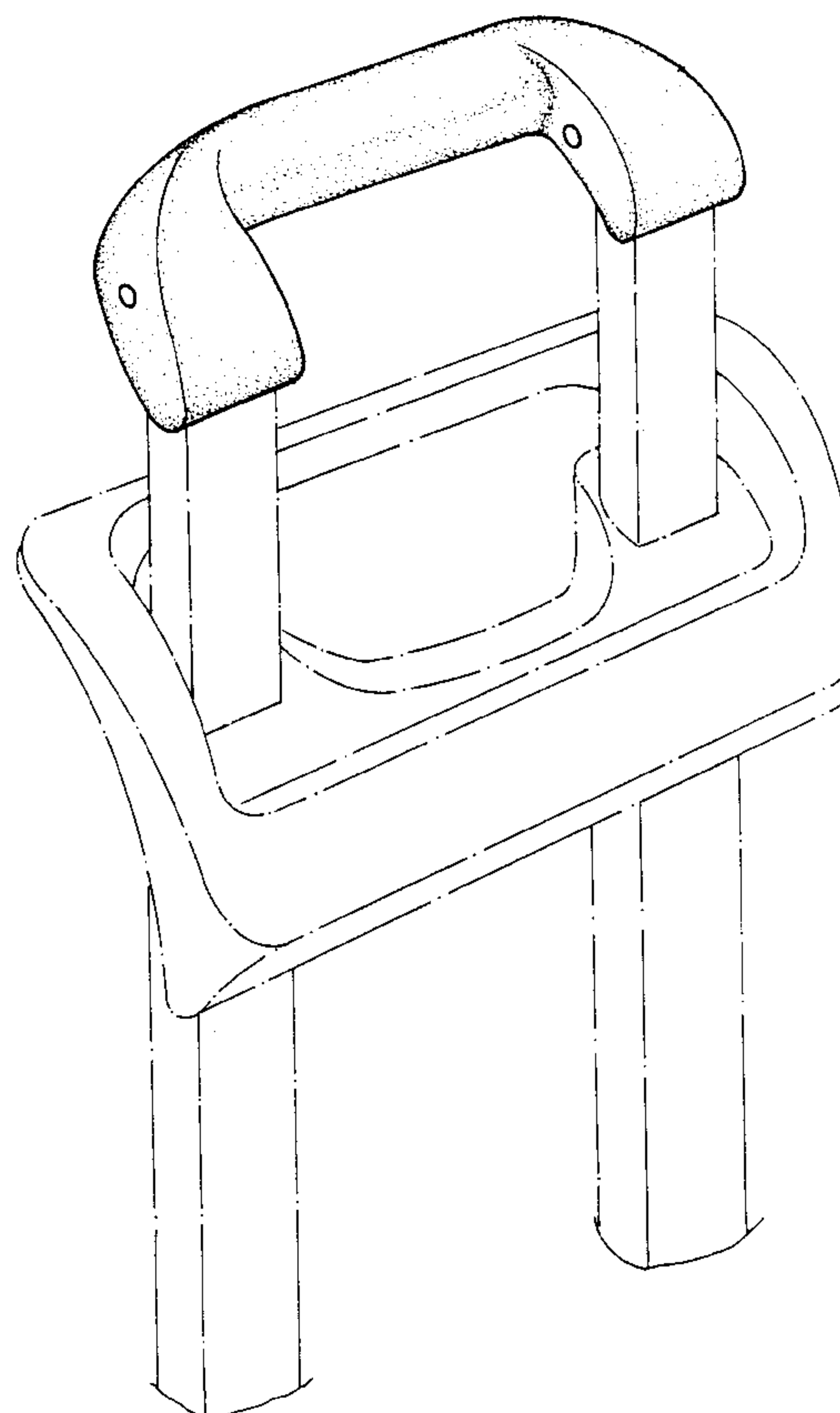
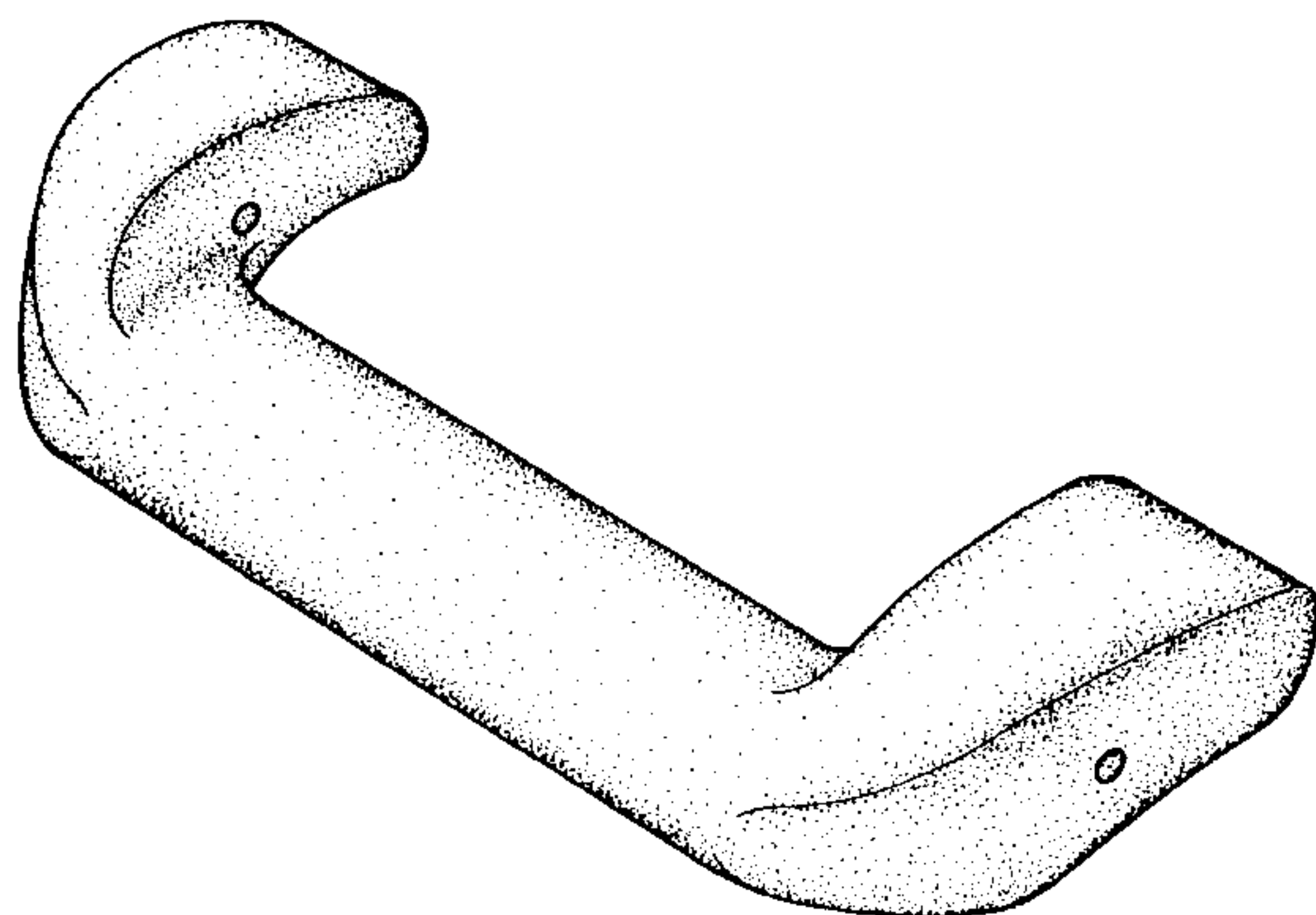
FIG. 4 is a right elevational view thereof (the left side being

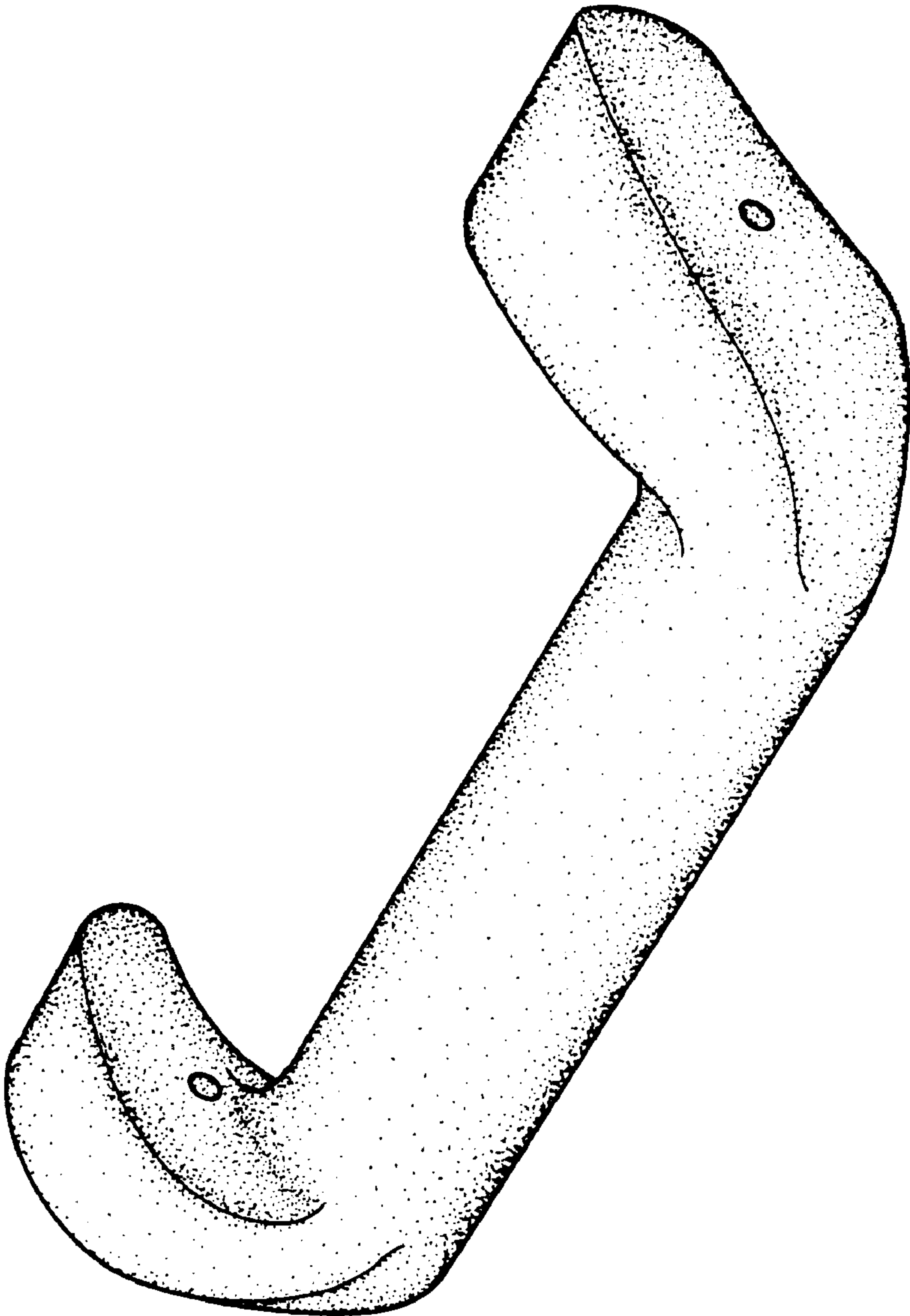

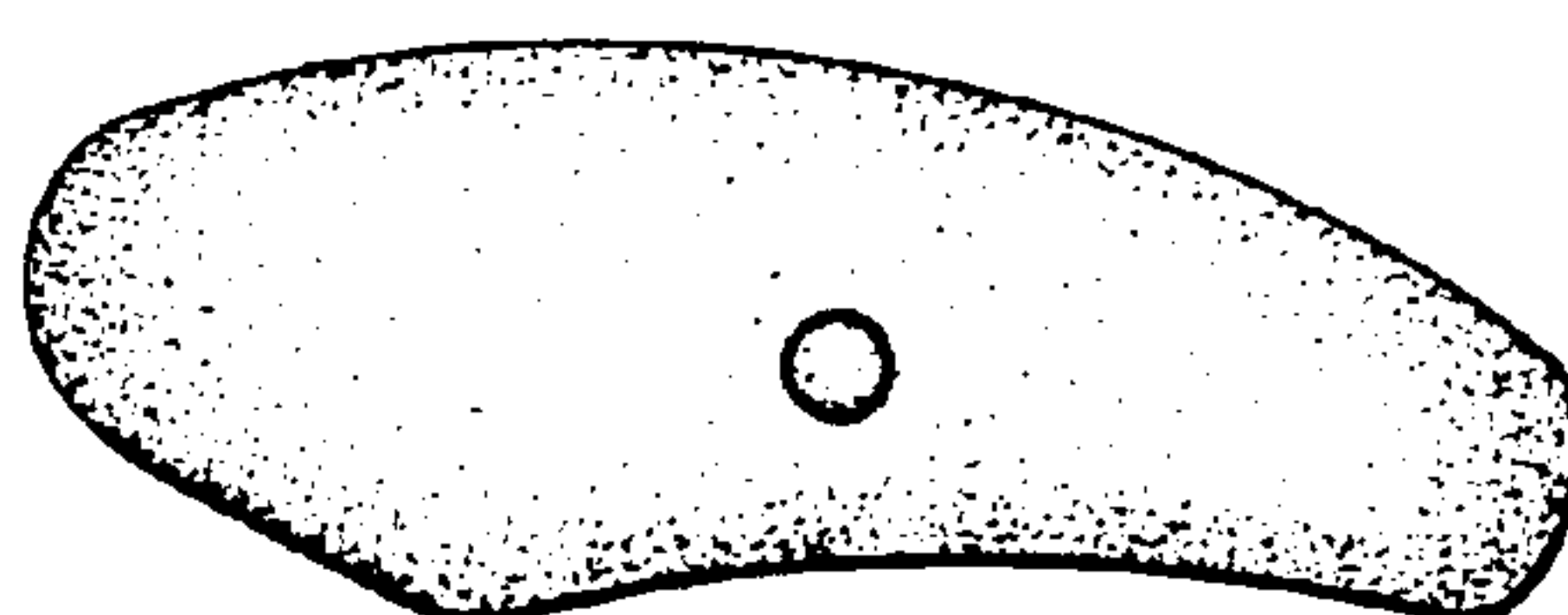

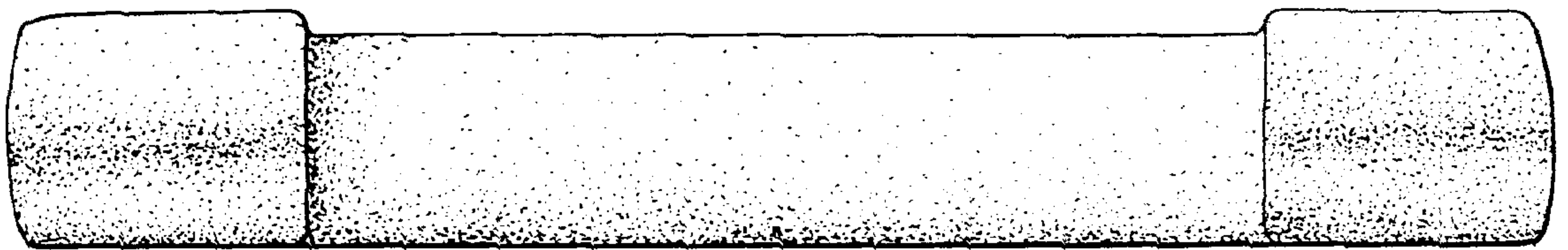

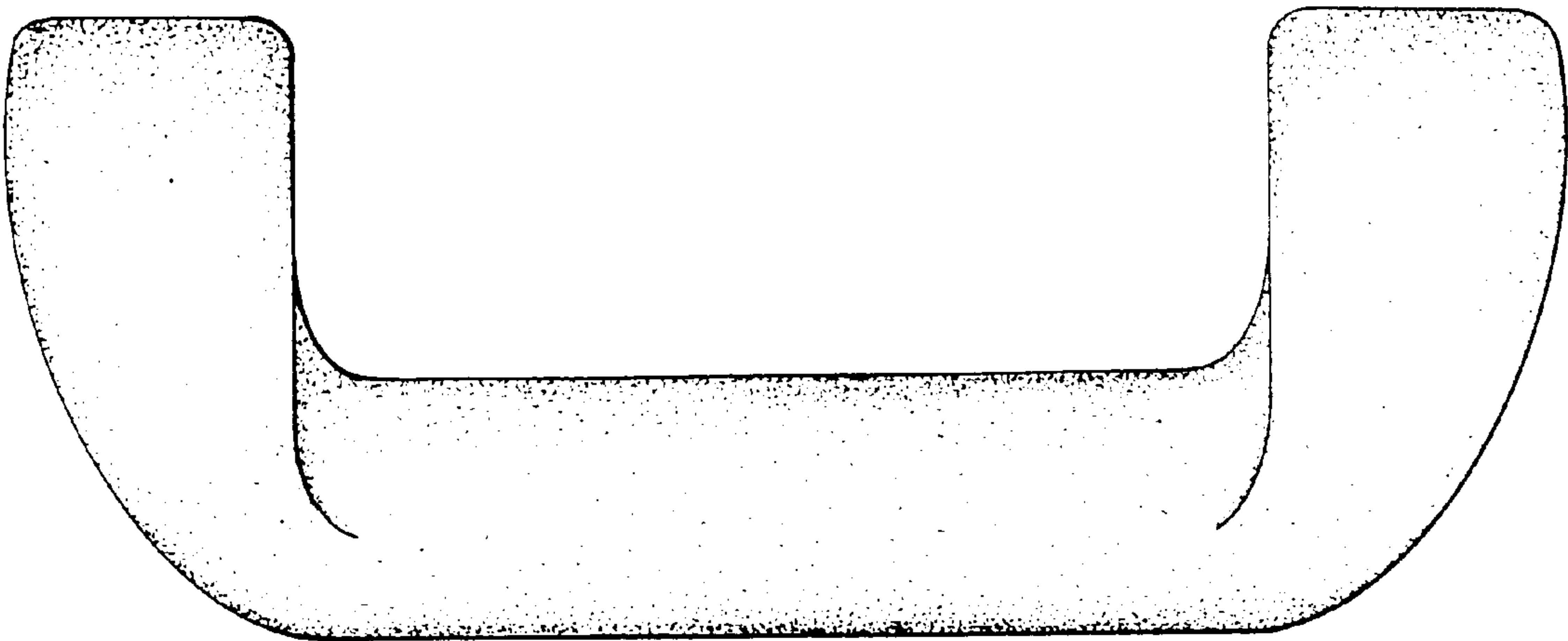

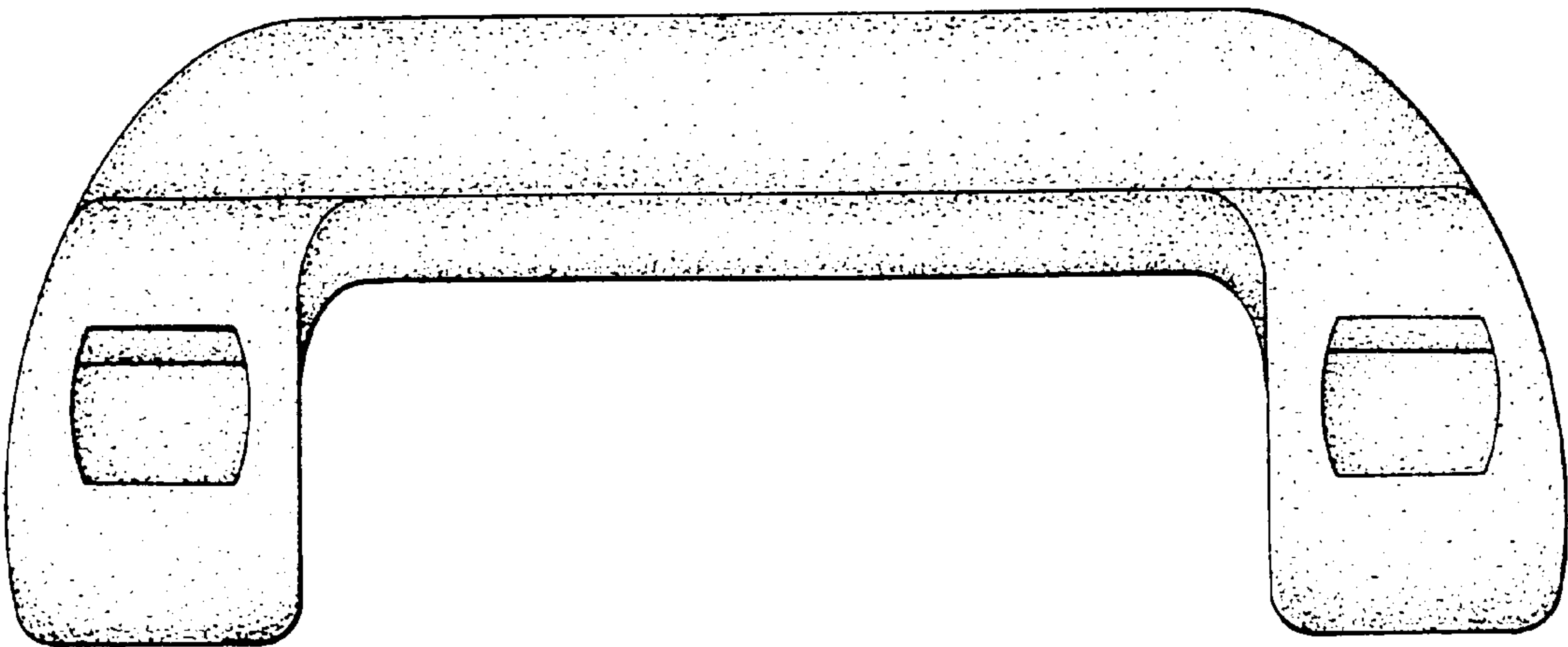

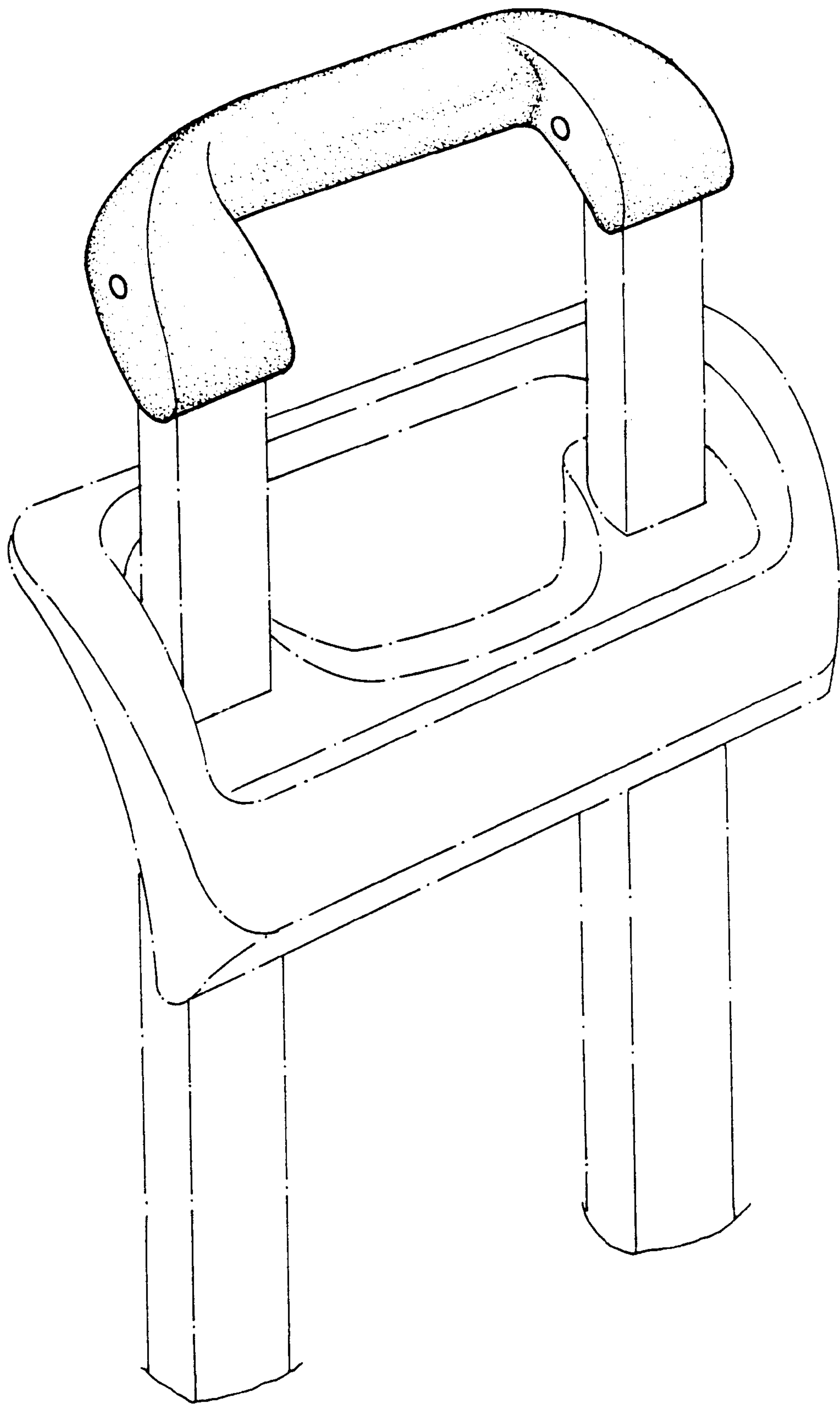
