**DESCRIPTION**

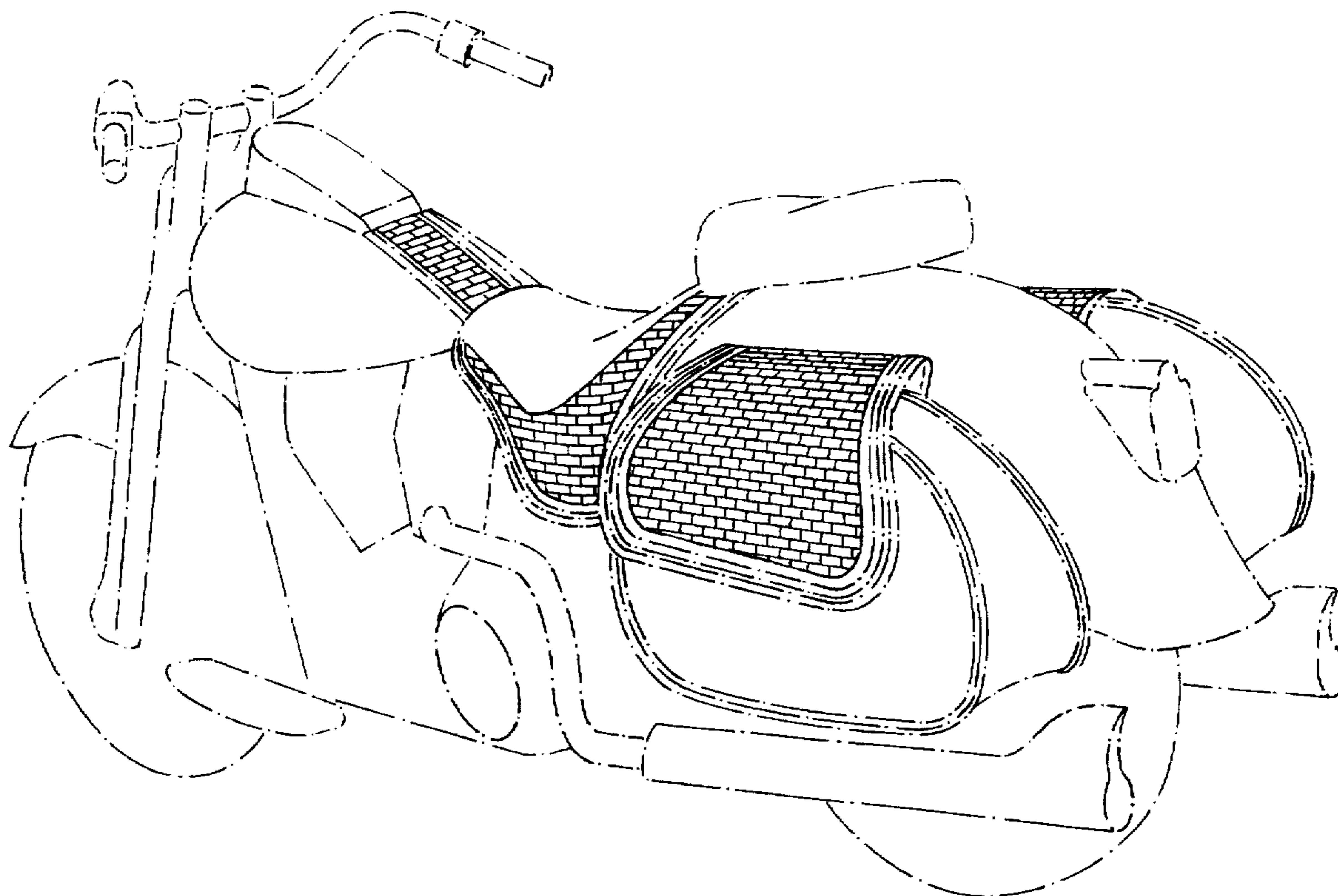
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a portion of a motorcycle

design;

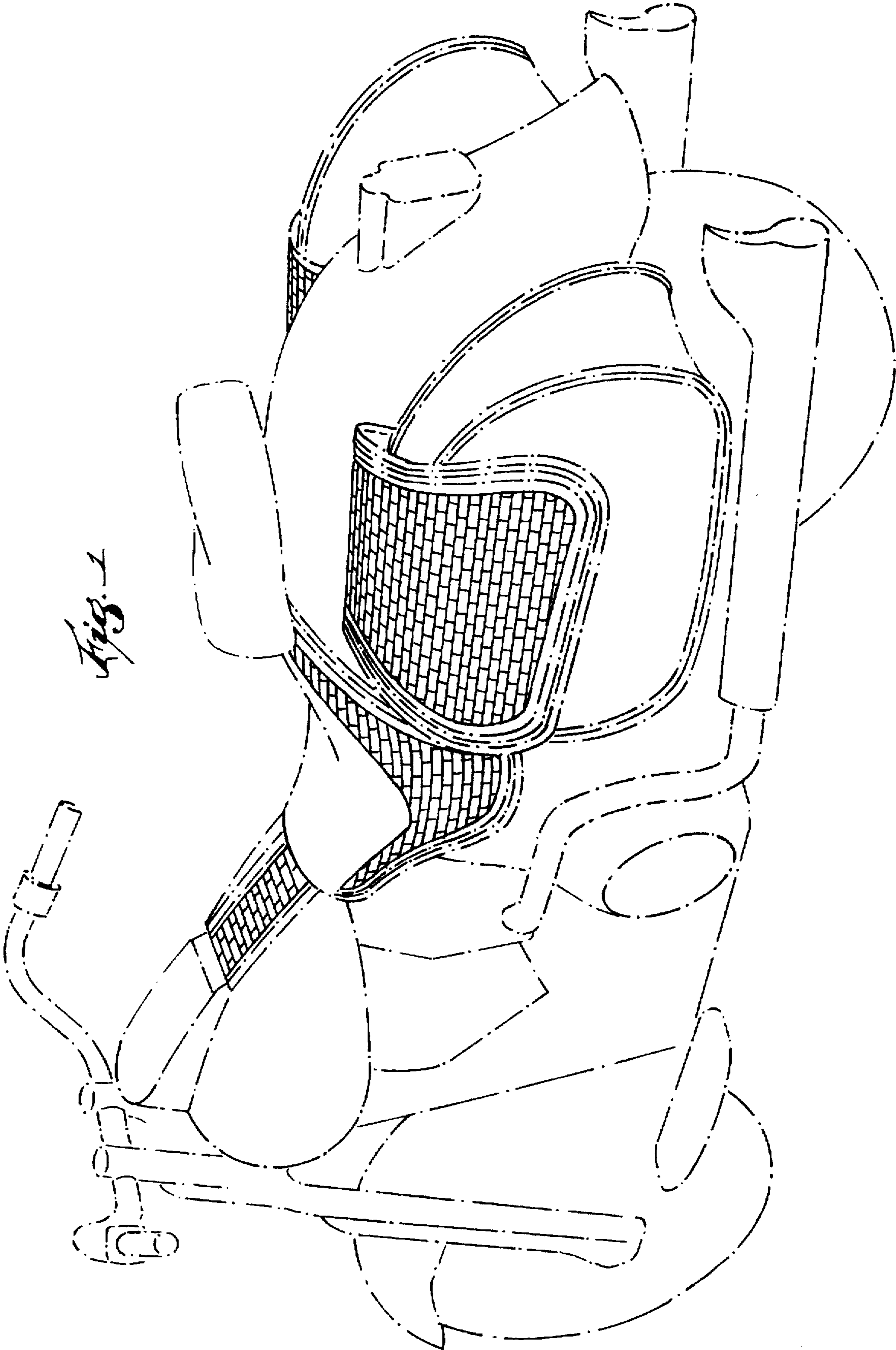
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; and,

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof.

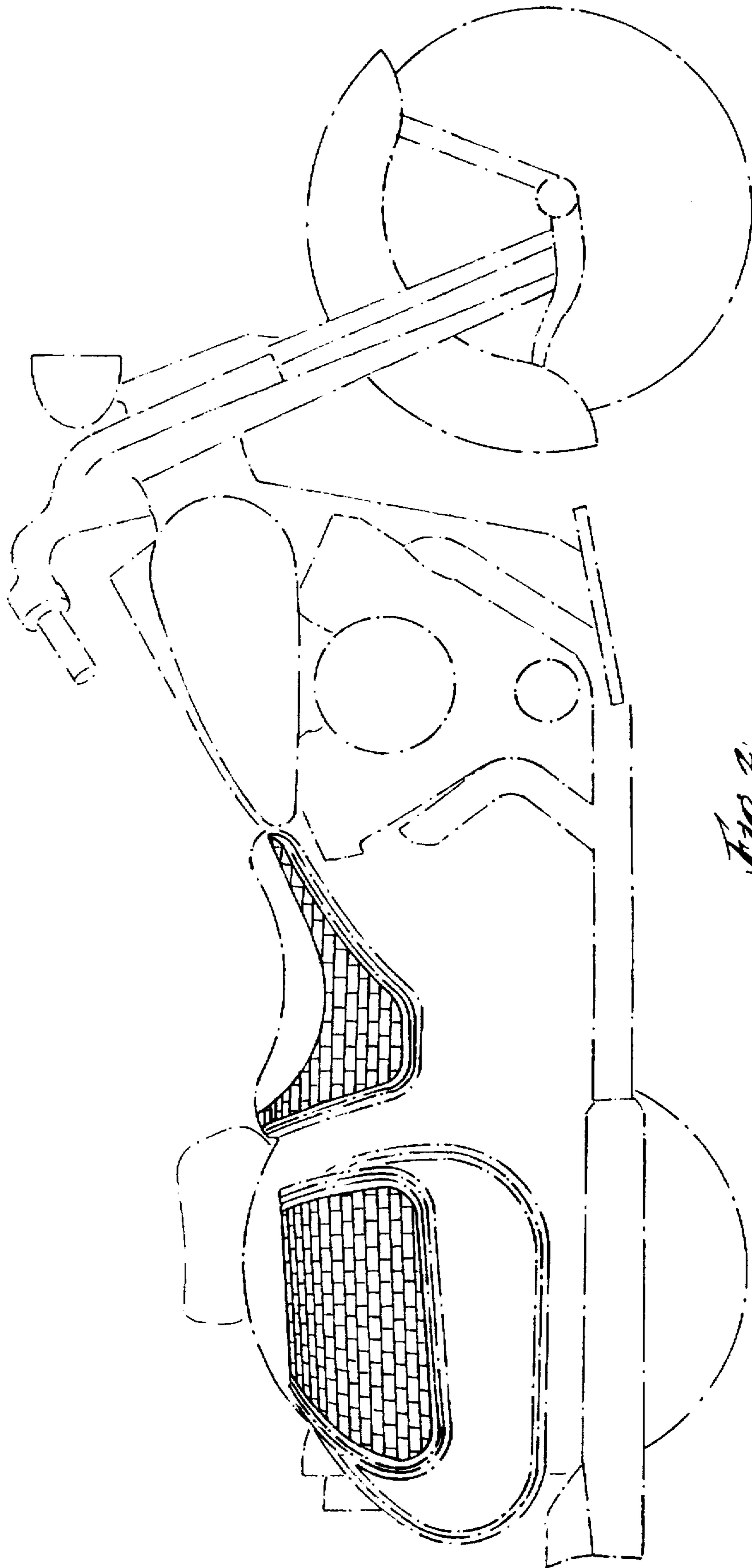
The front, bottom, rear and left side views of the design are

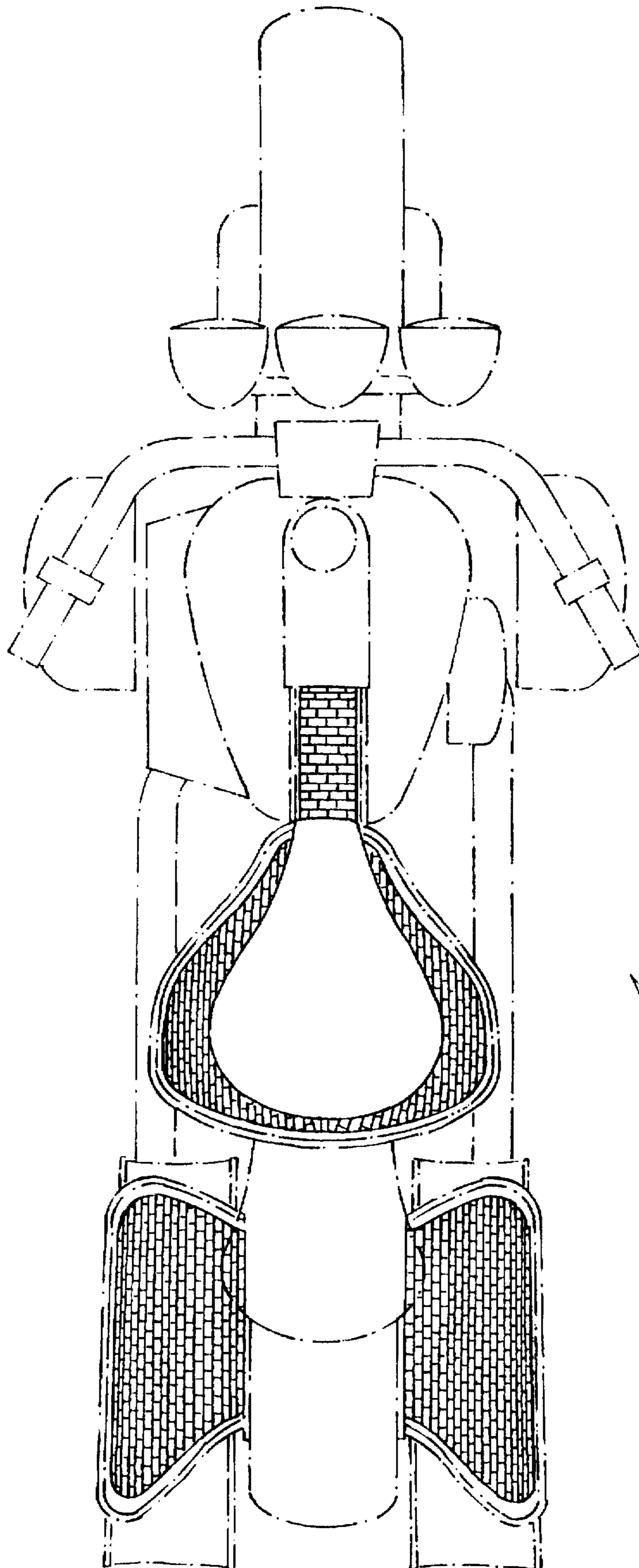
