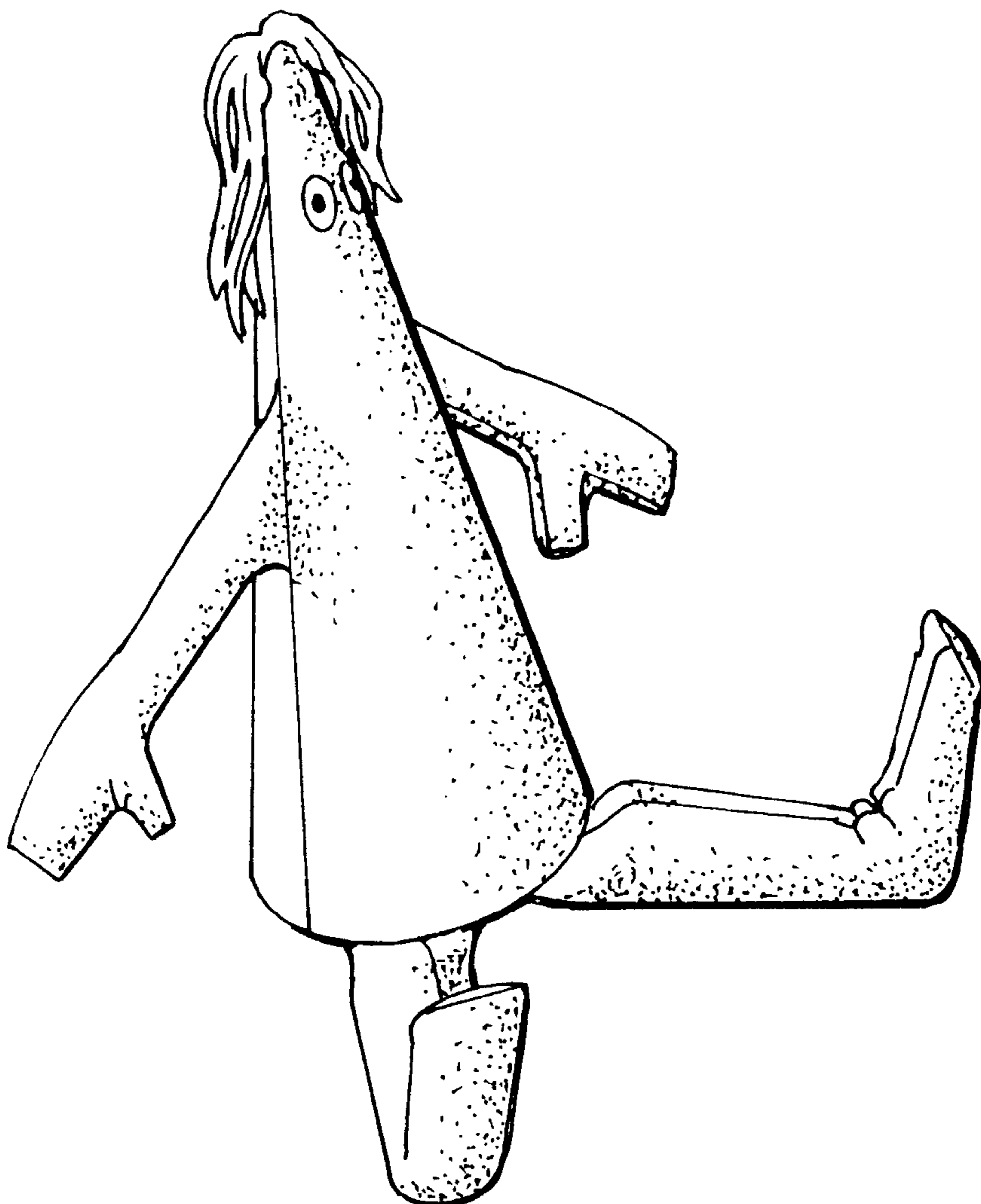
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the present invention;

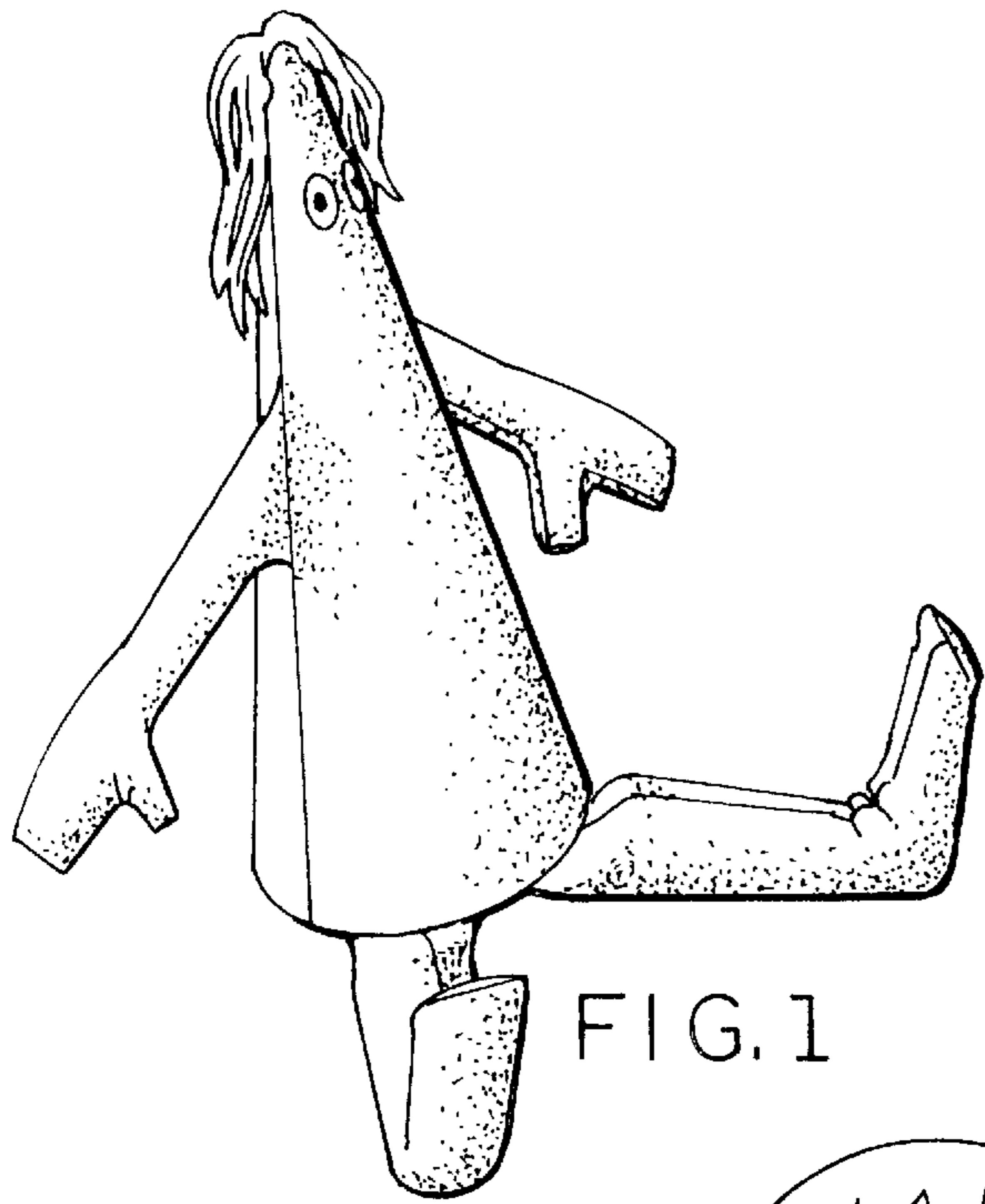

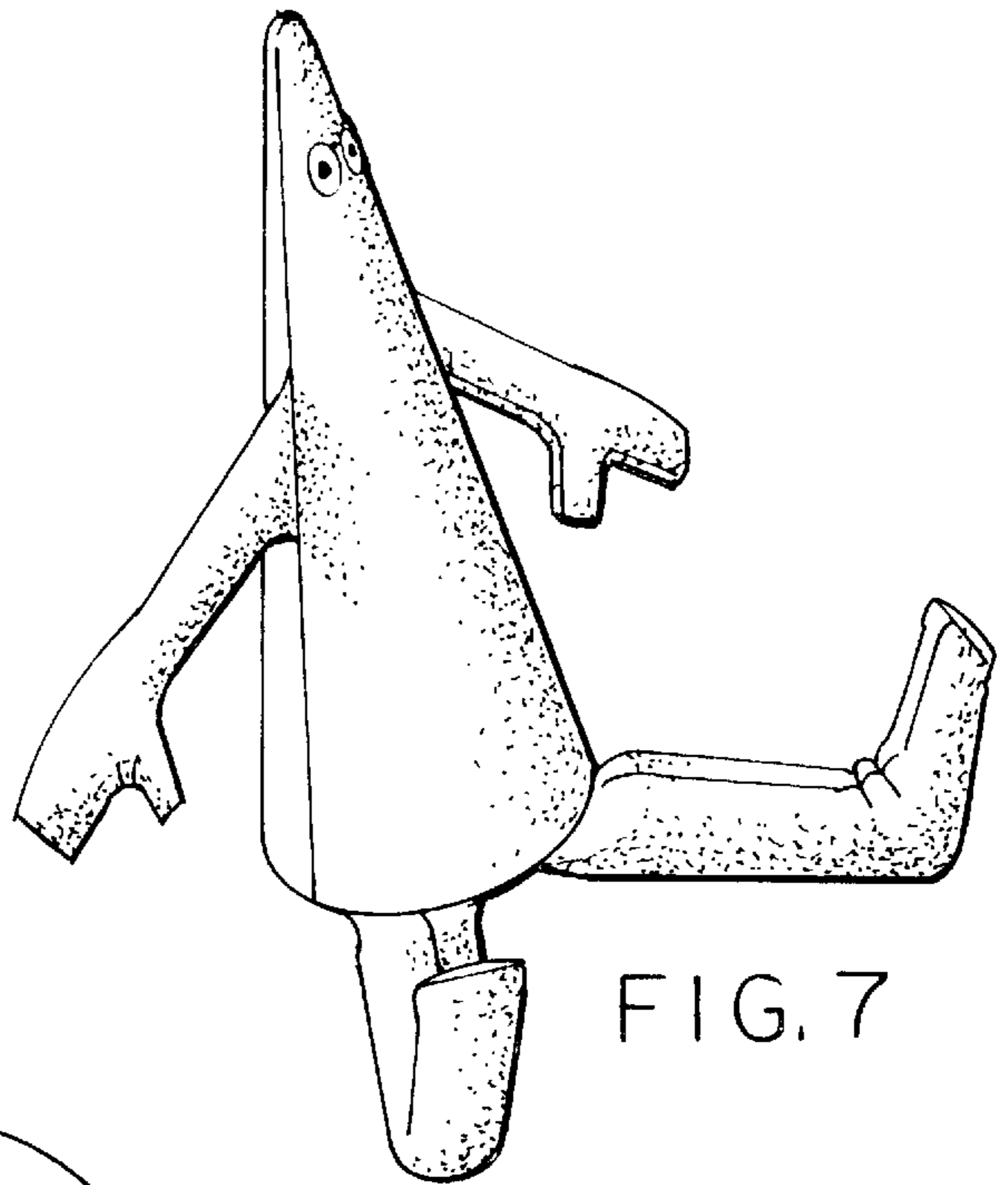

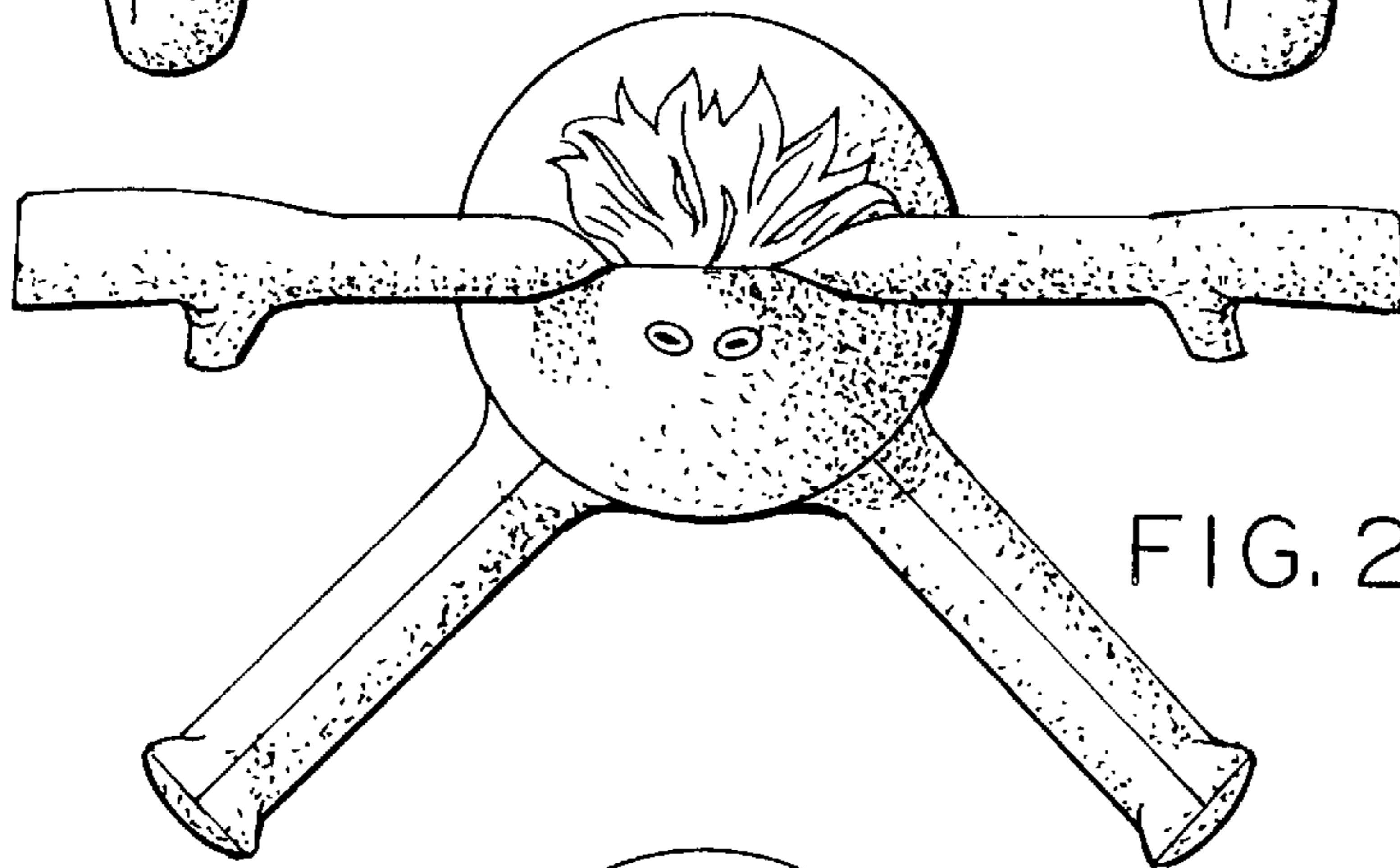

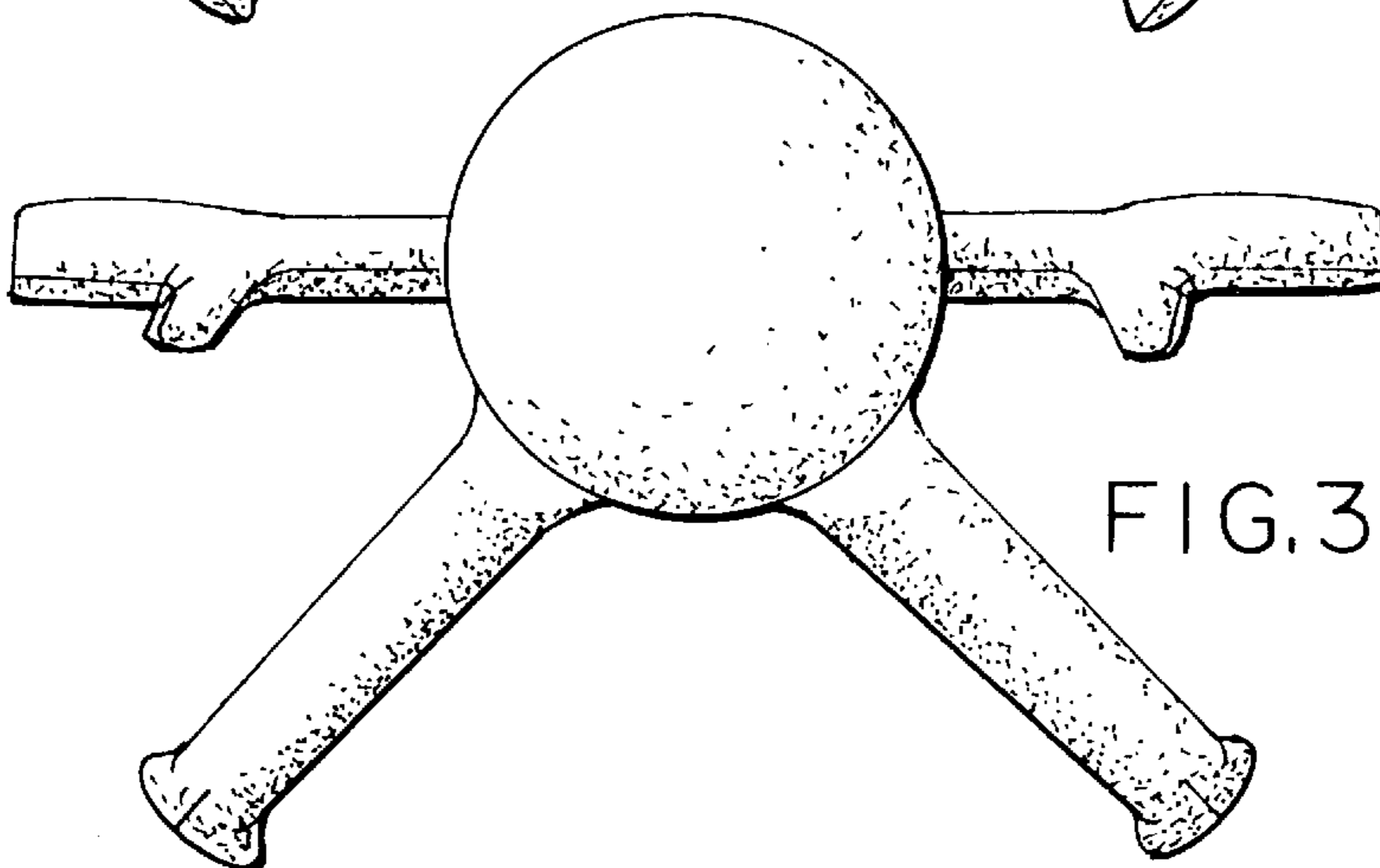

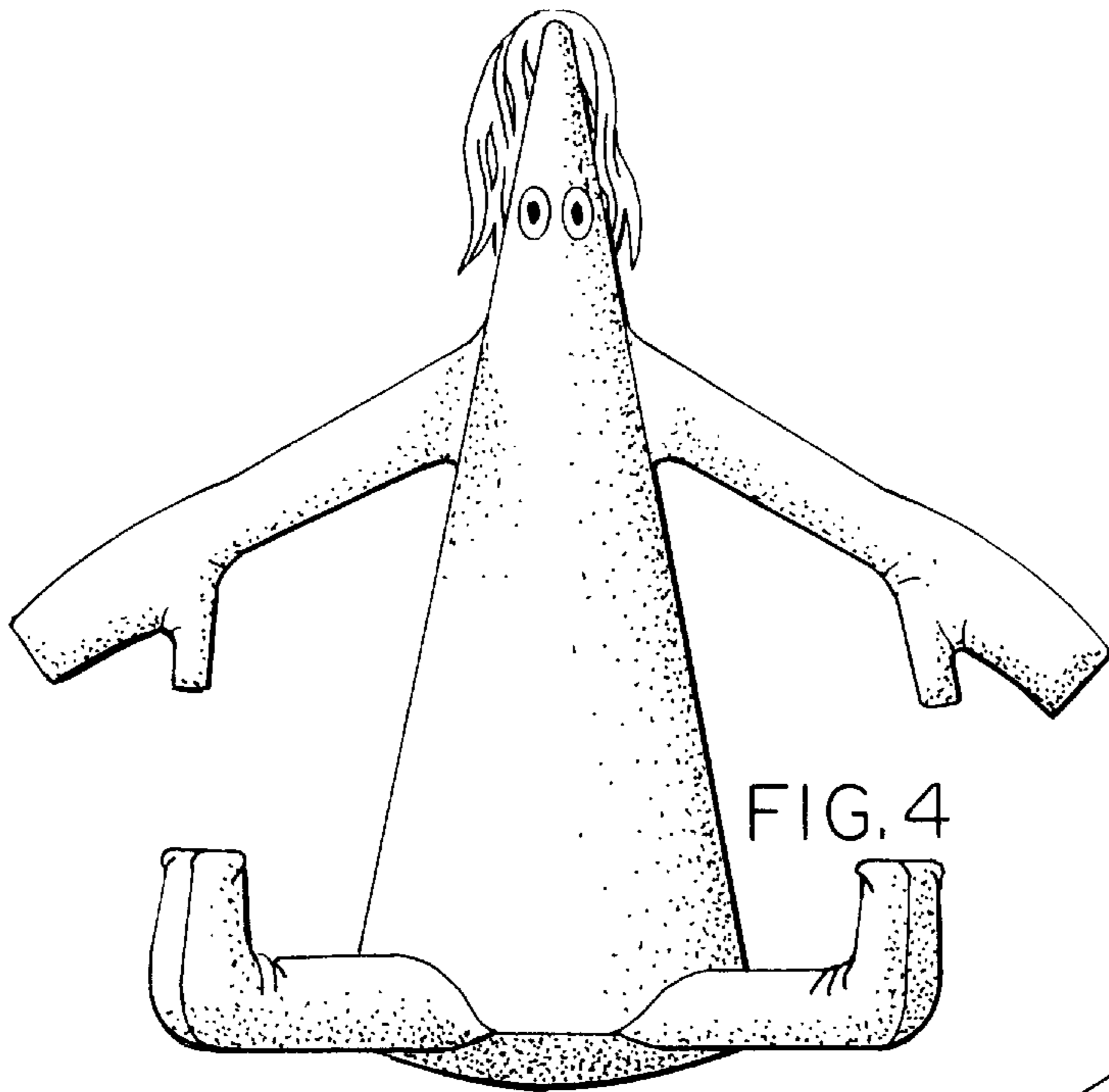

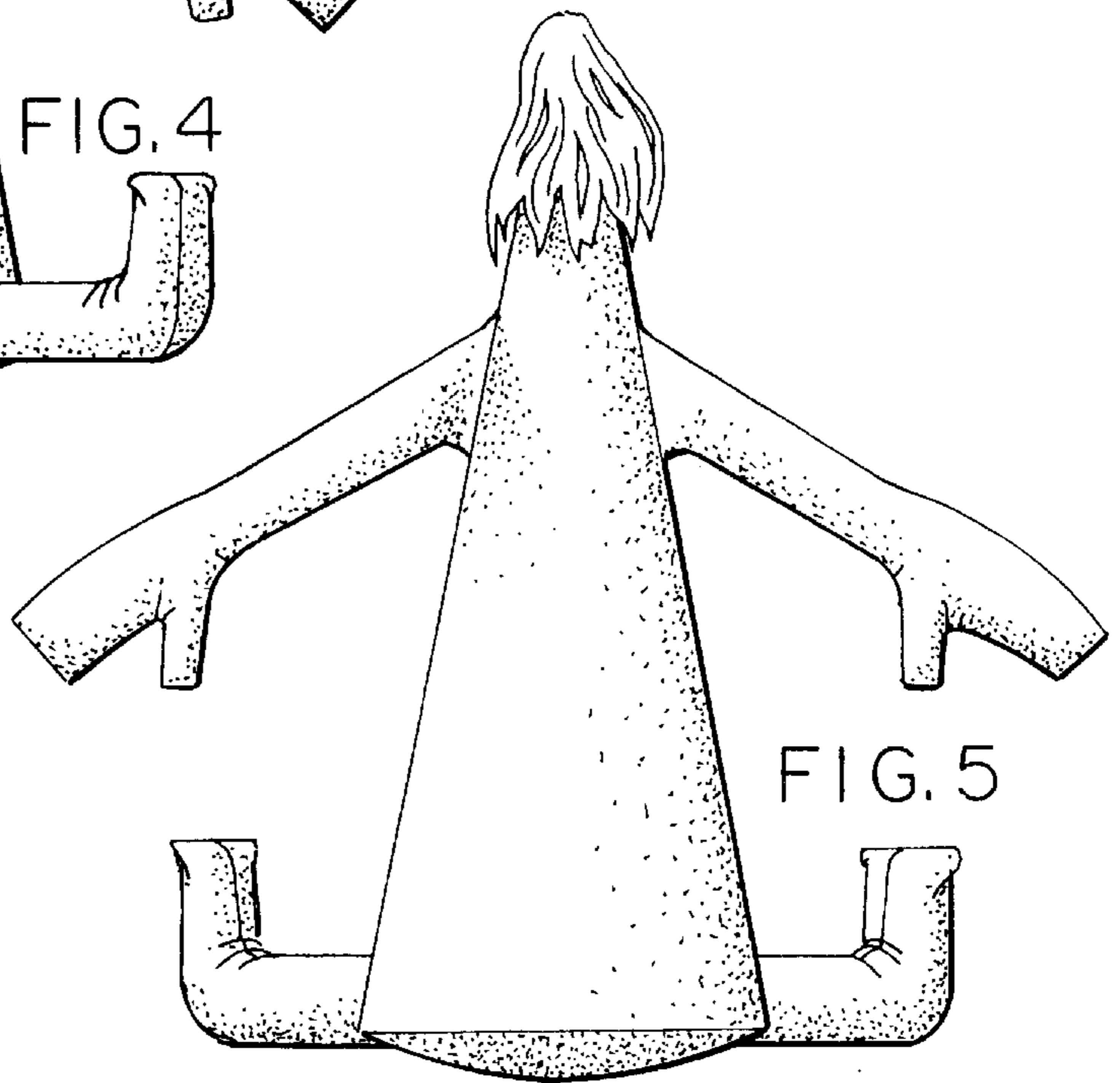

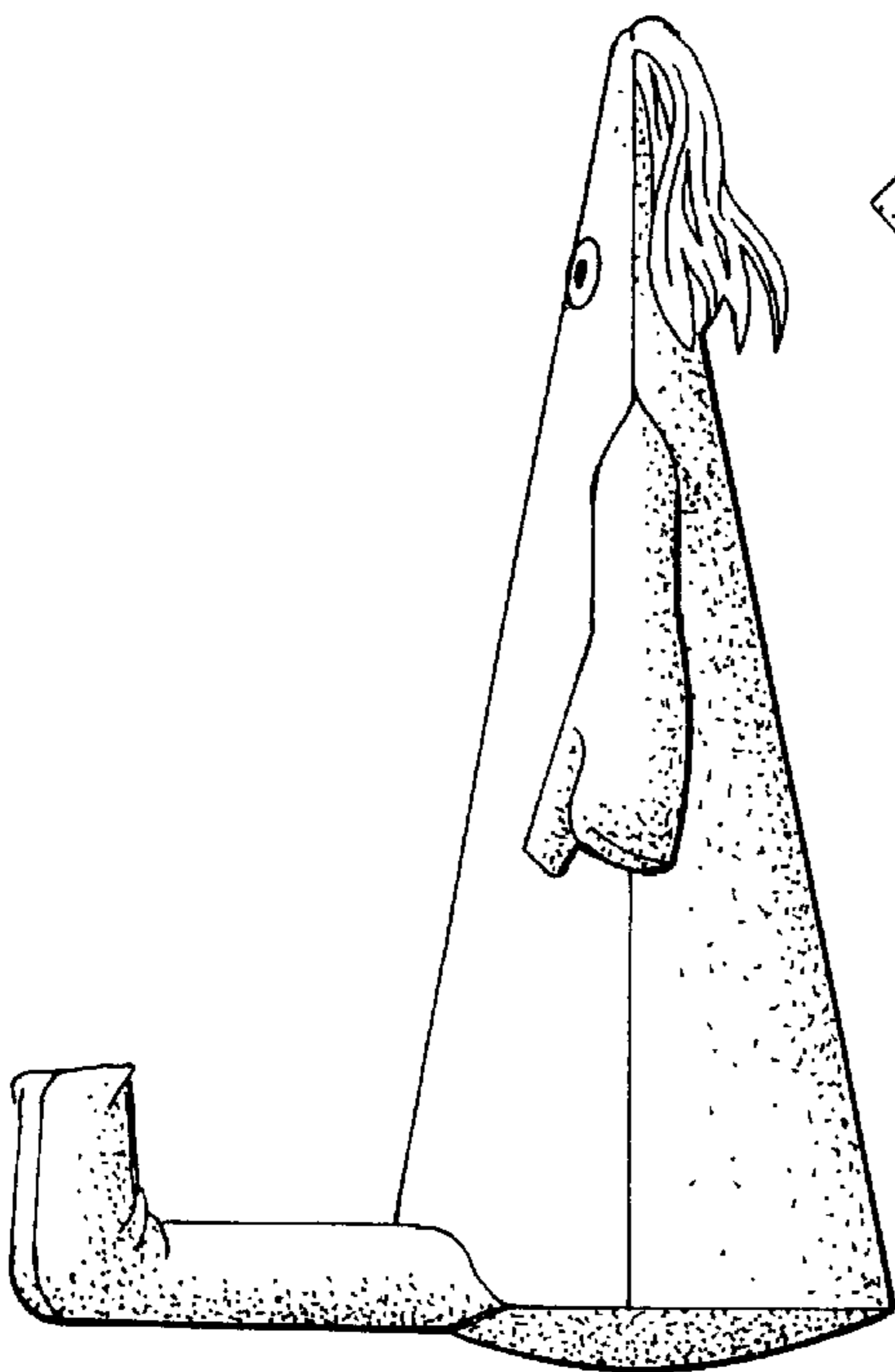
