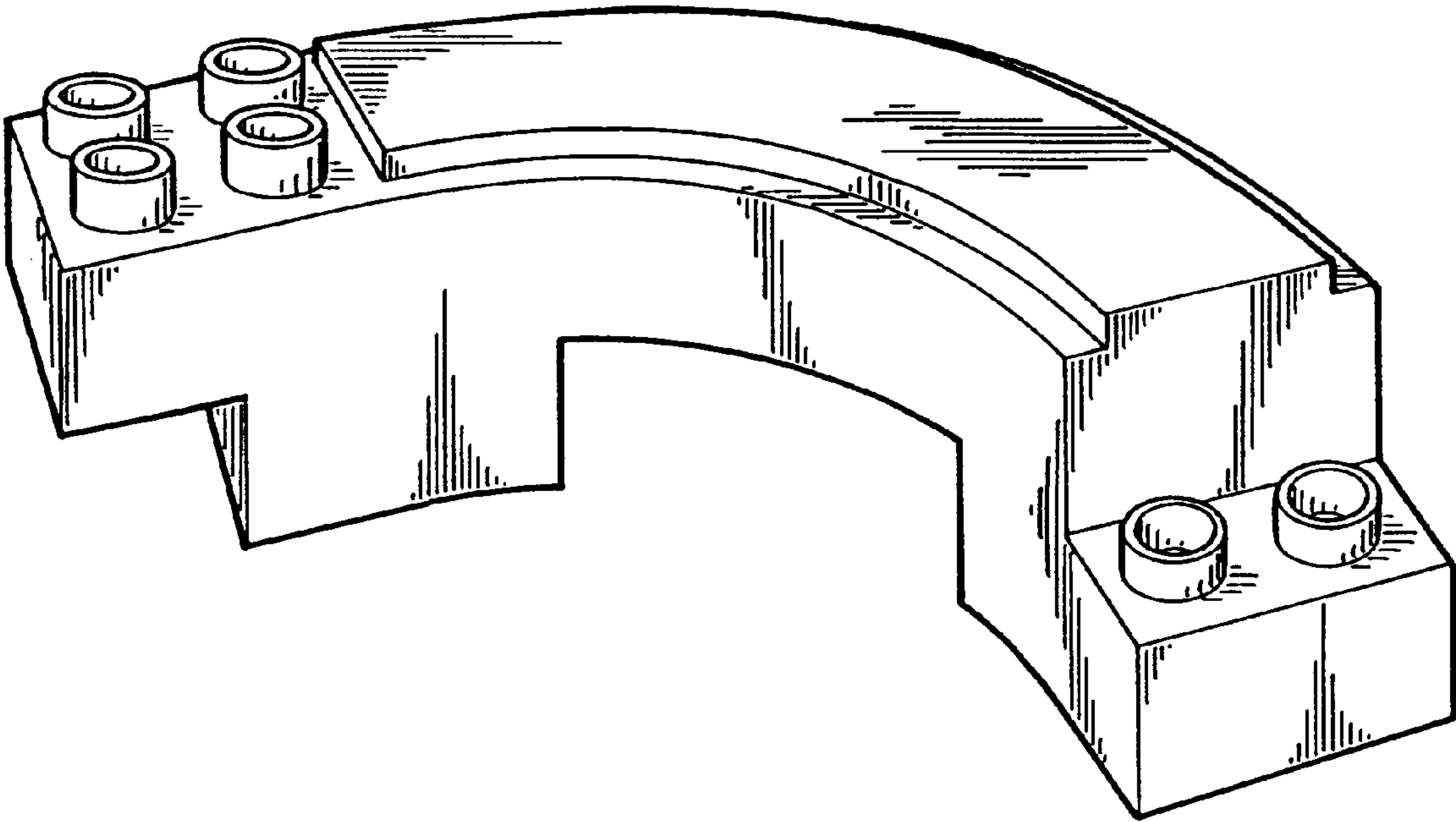

The ornamental design for a rail element for a toy train, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

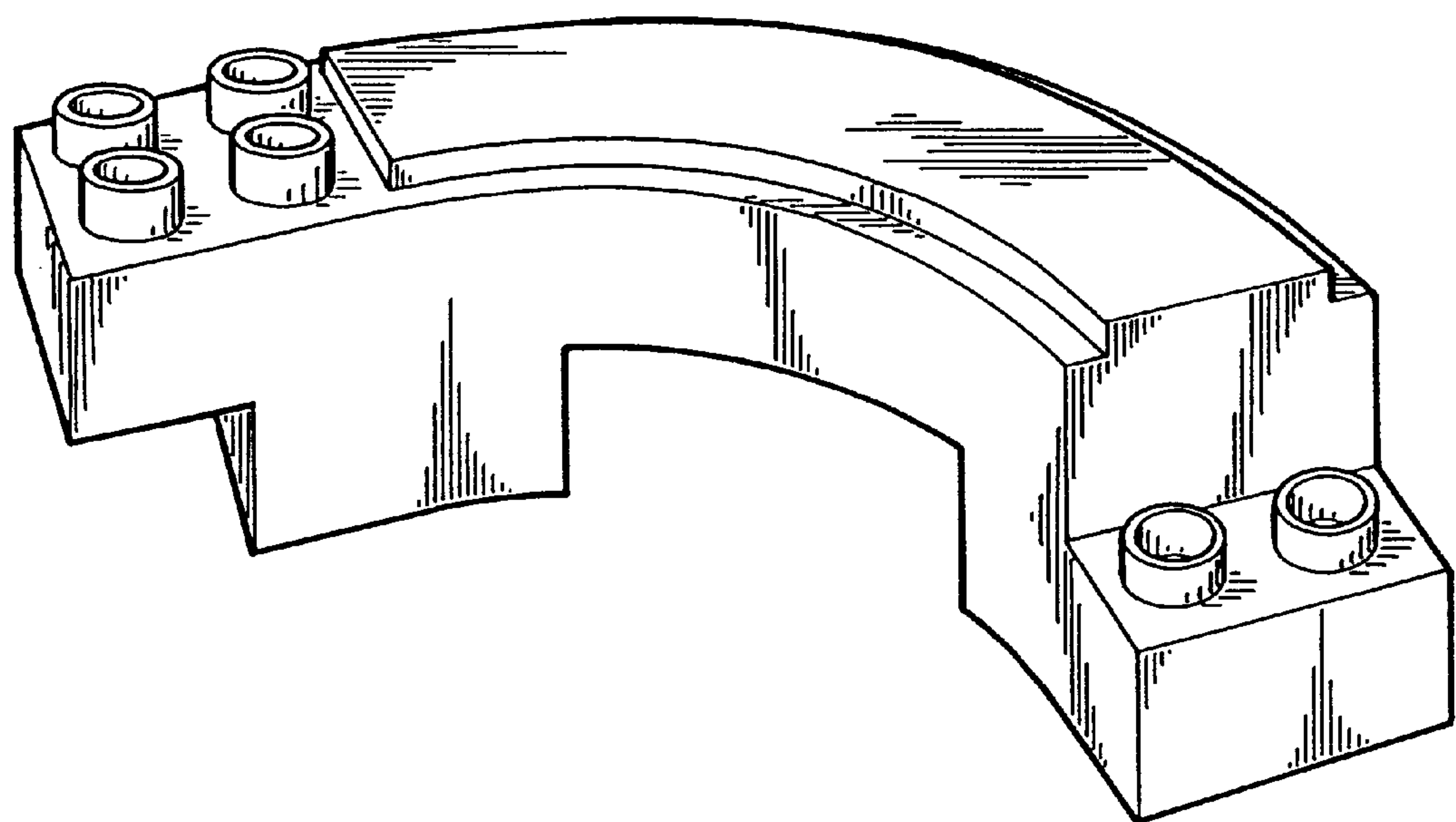

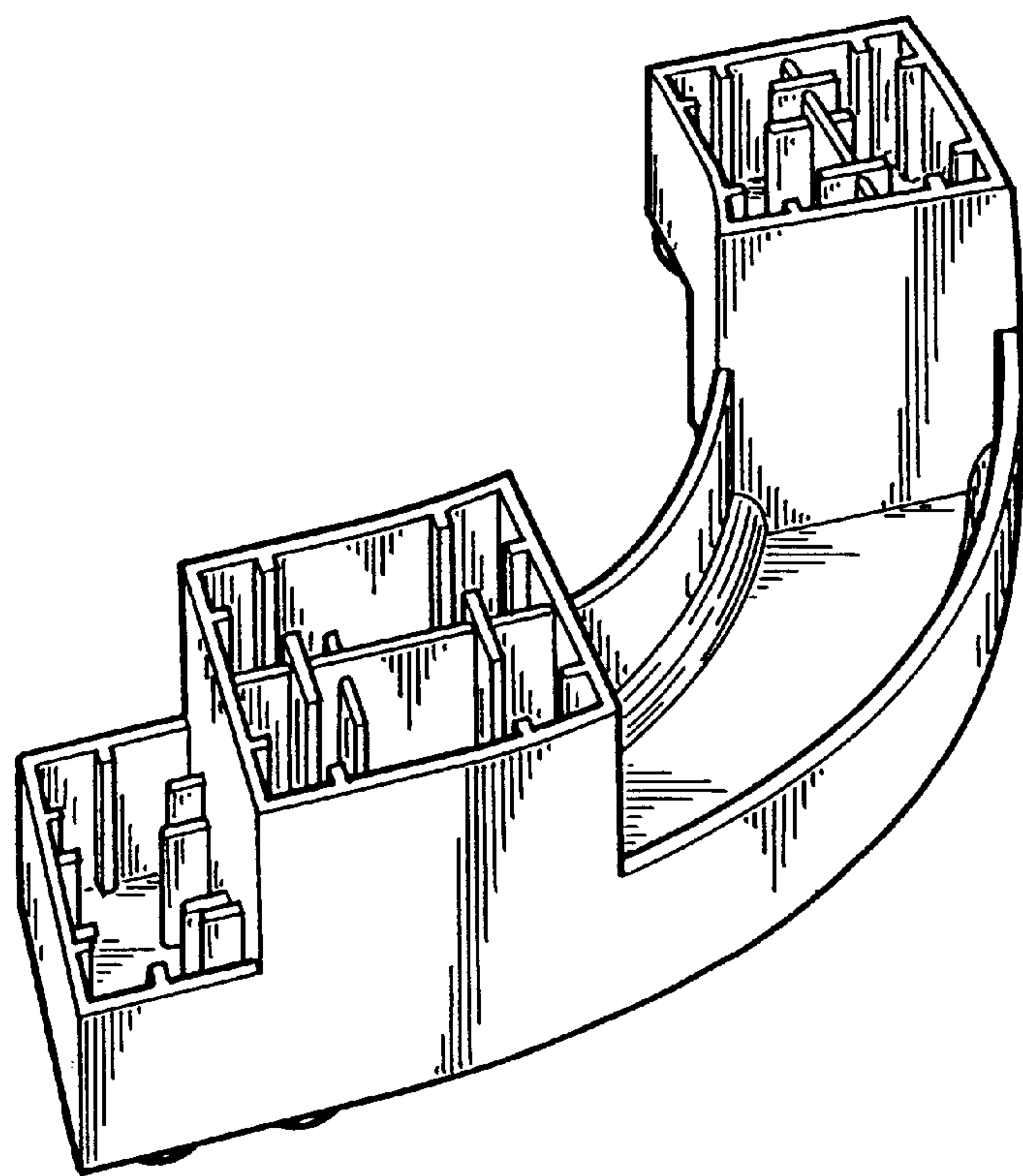
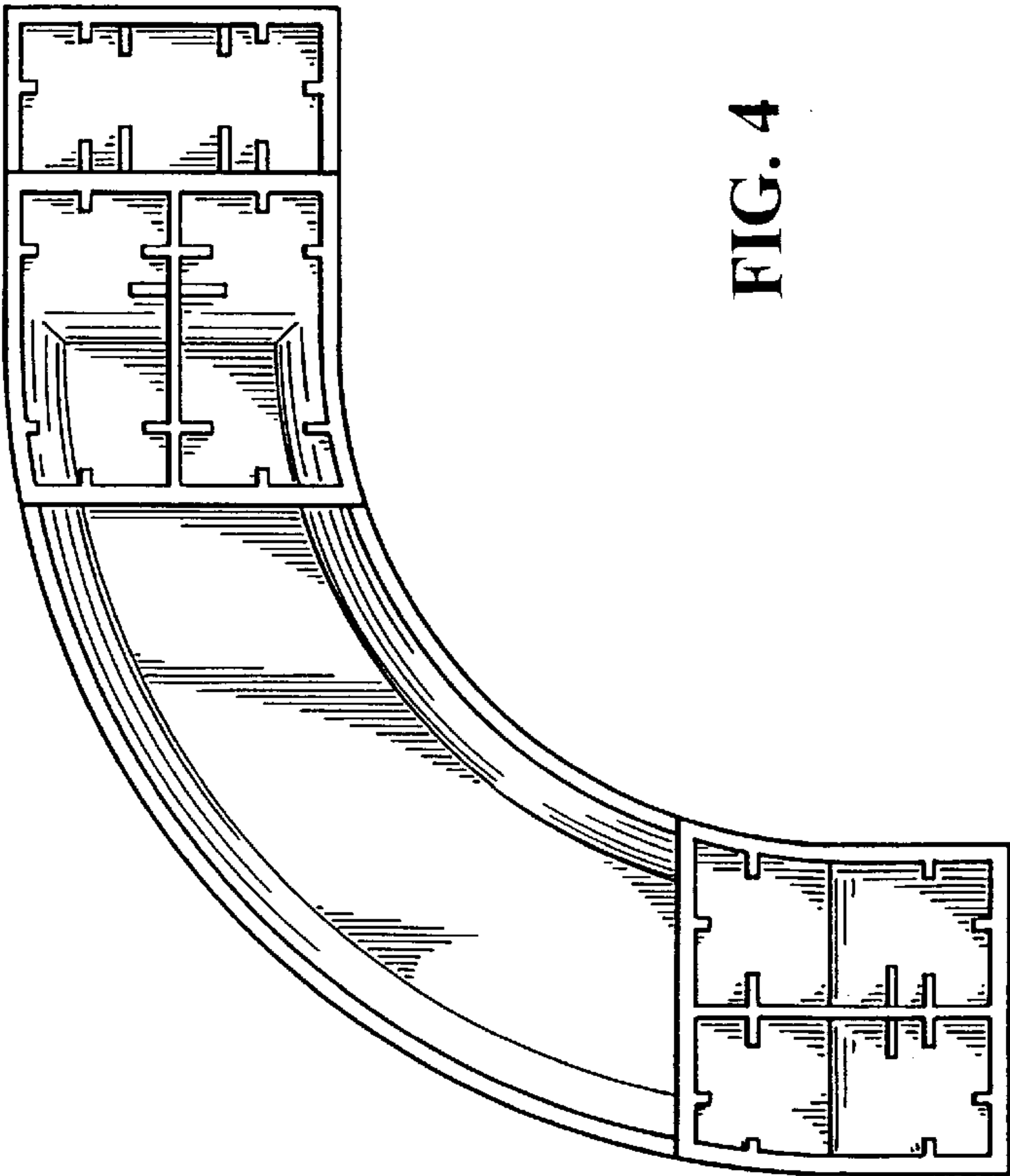
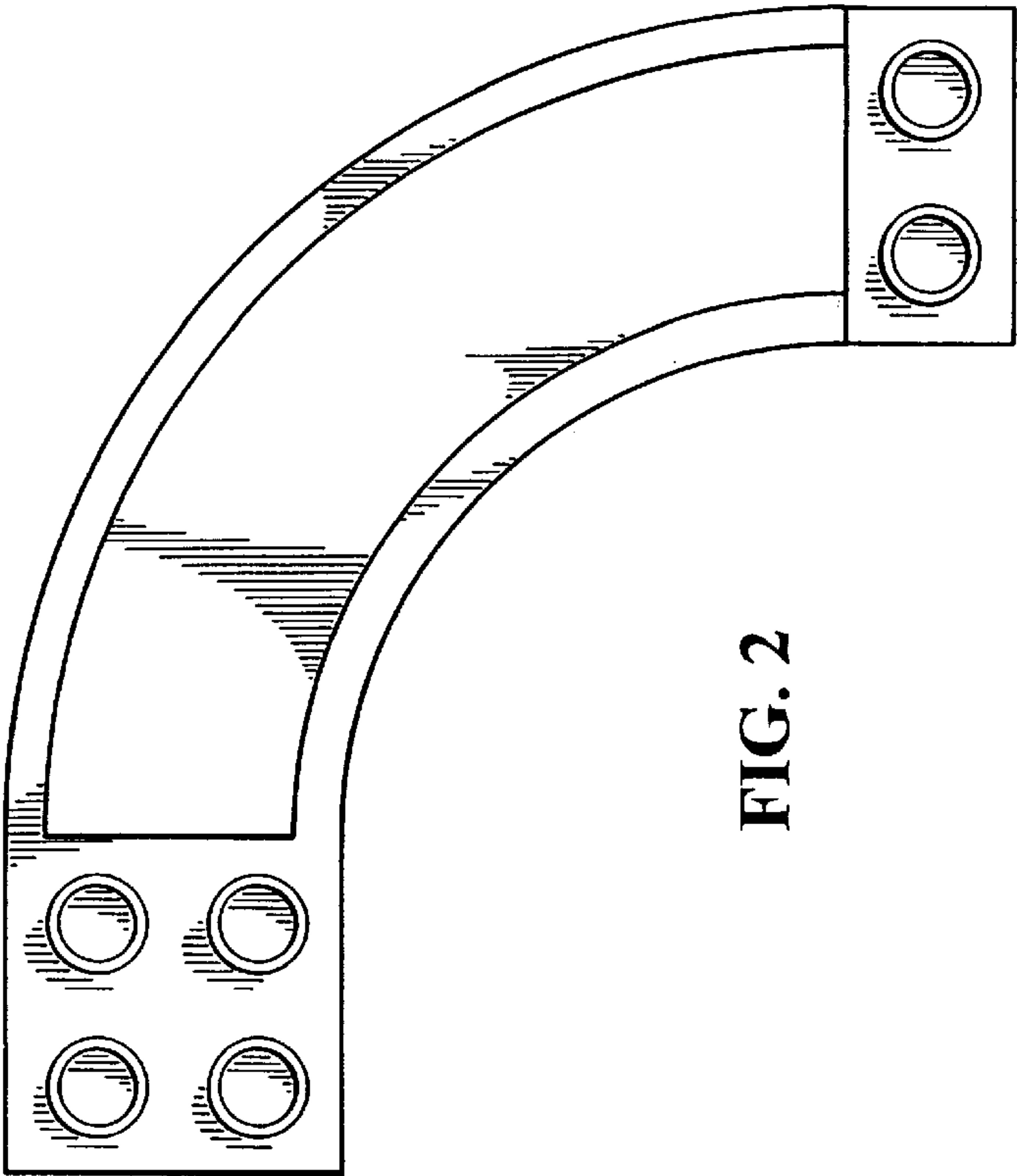

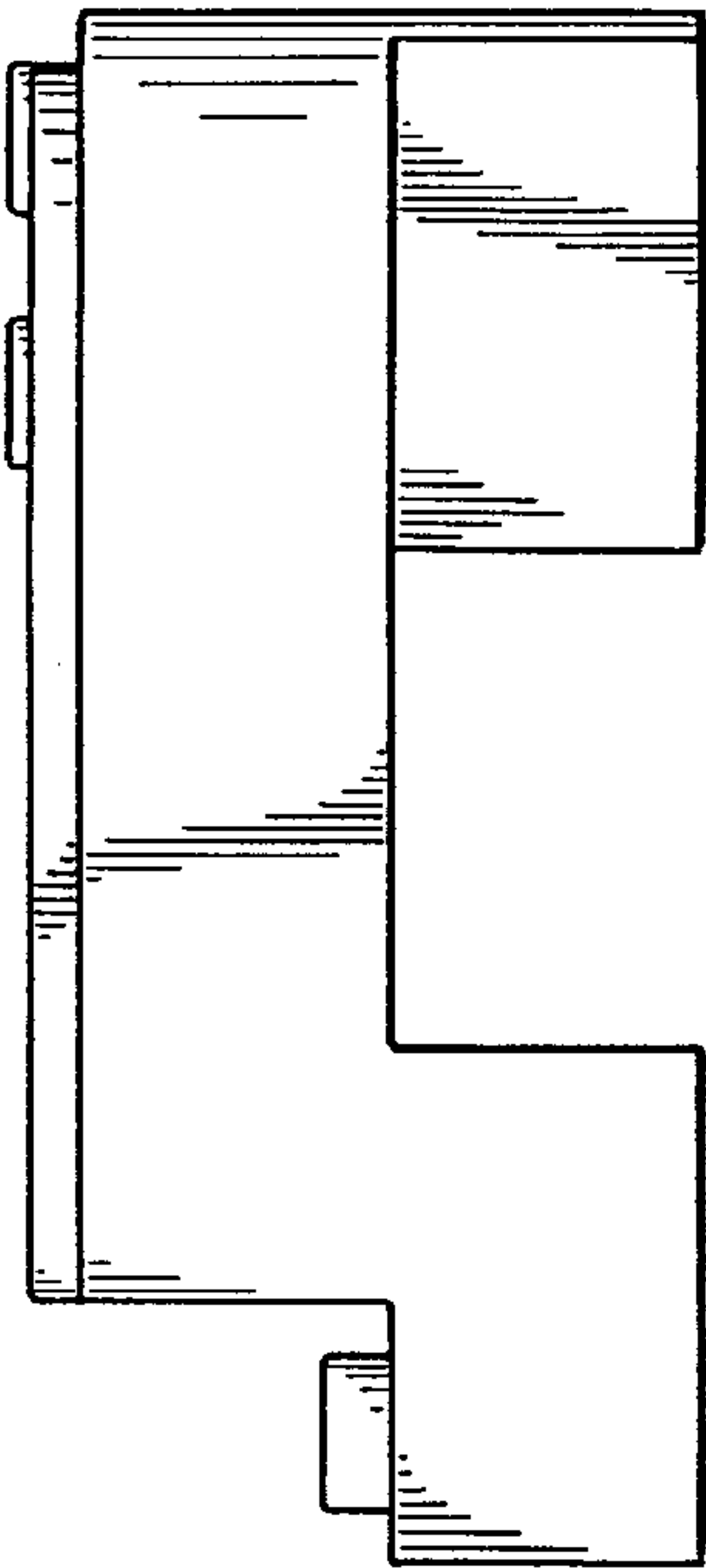

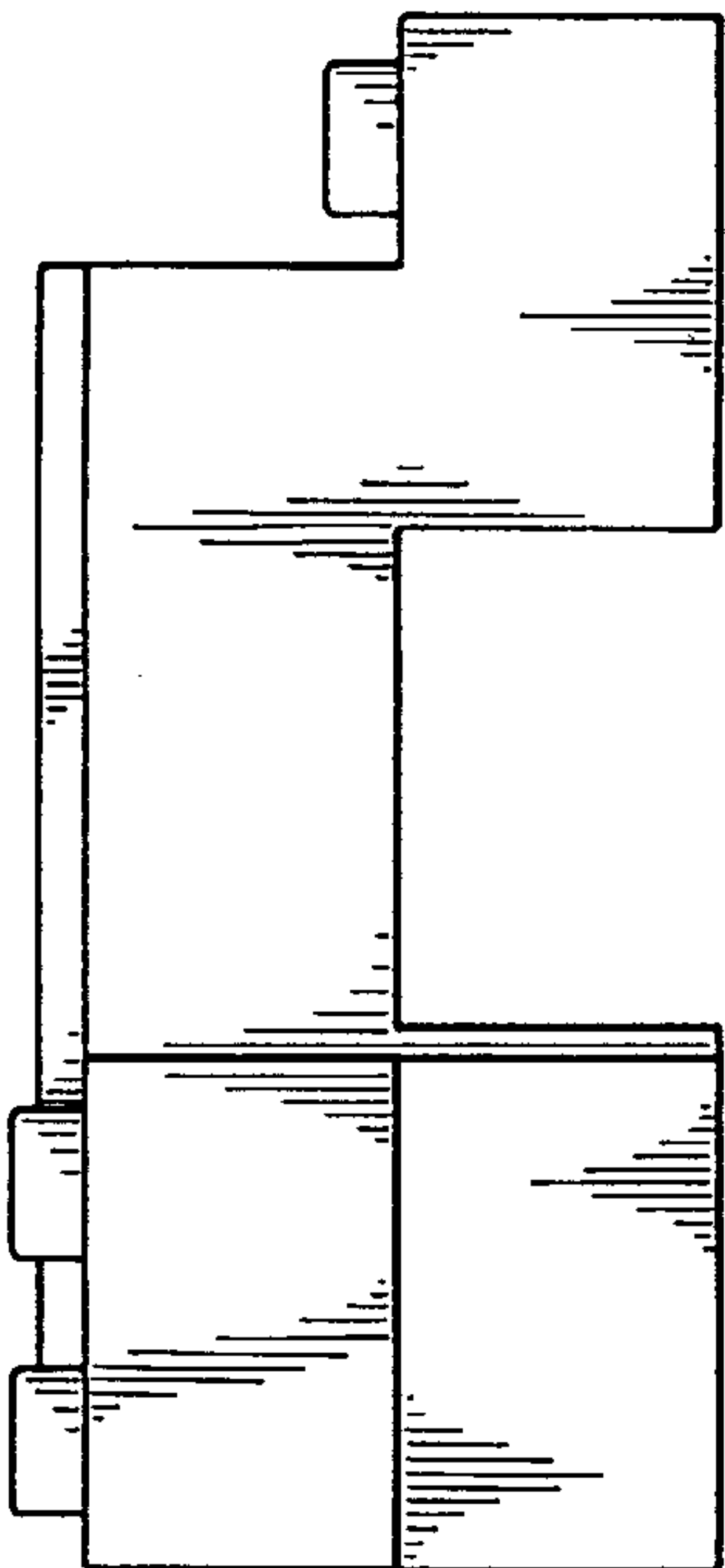

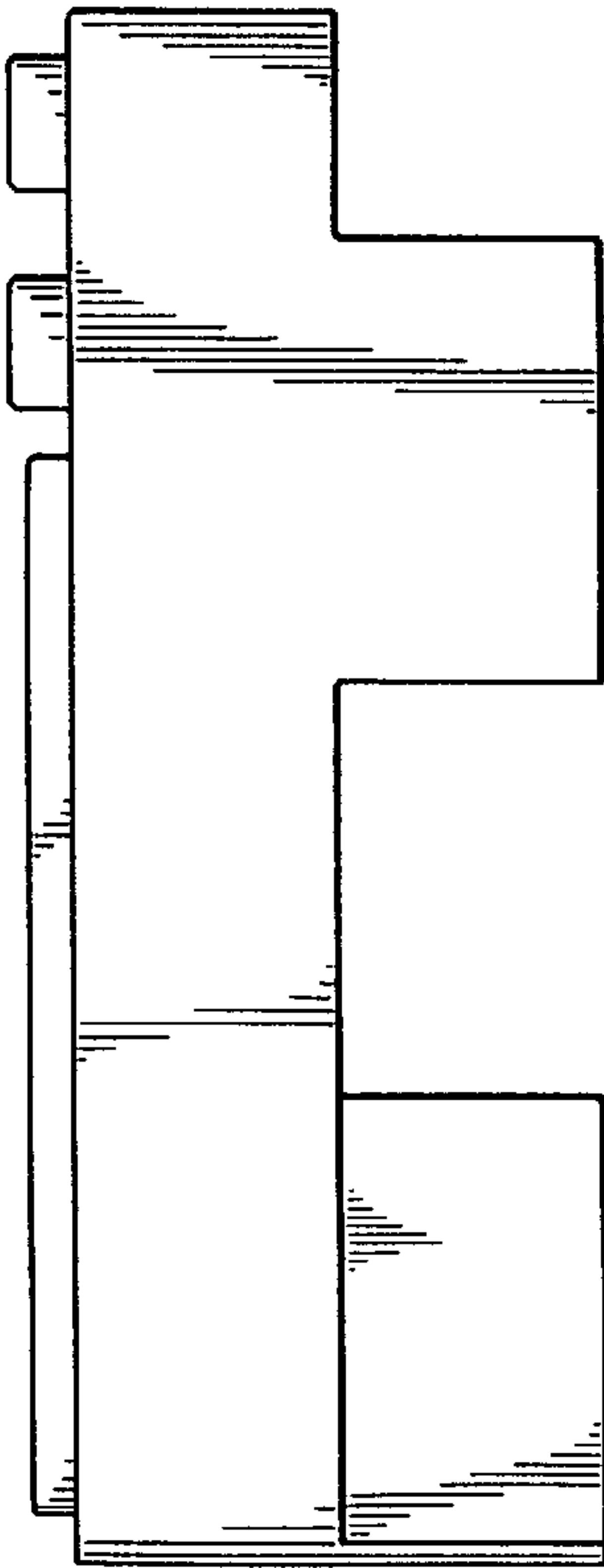

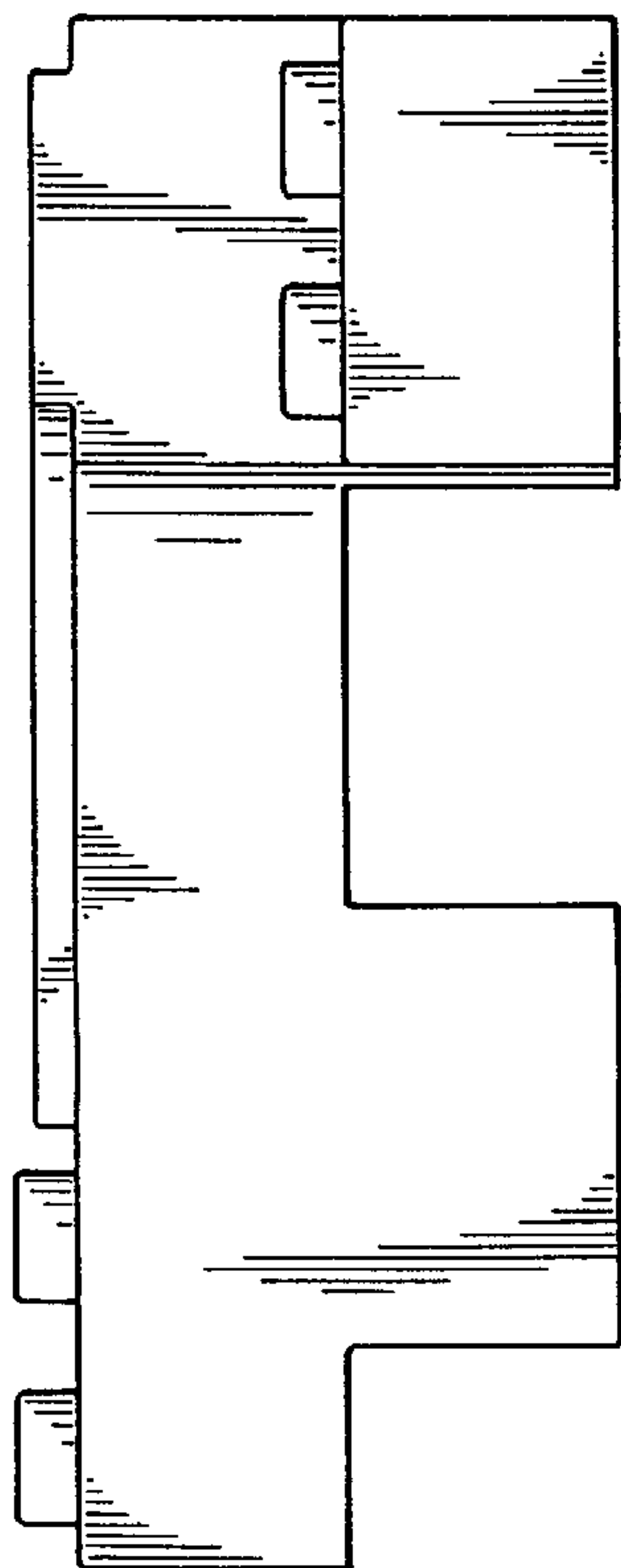
