[57] CLAIM

I claim the ornamental design for a swimsuit, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

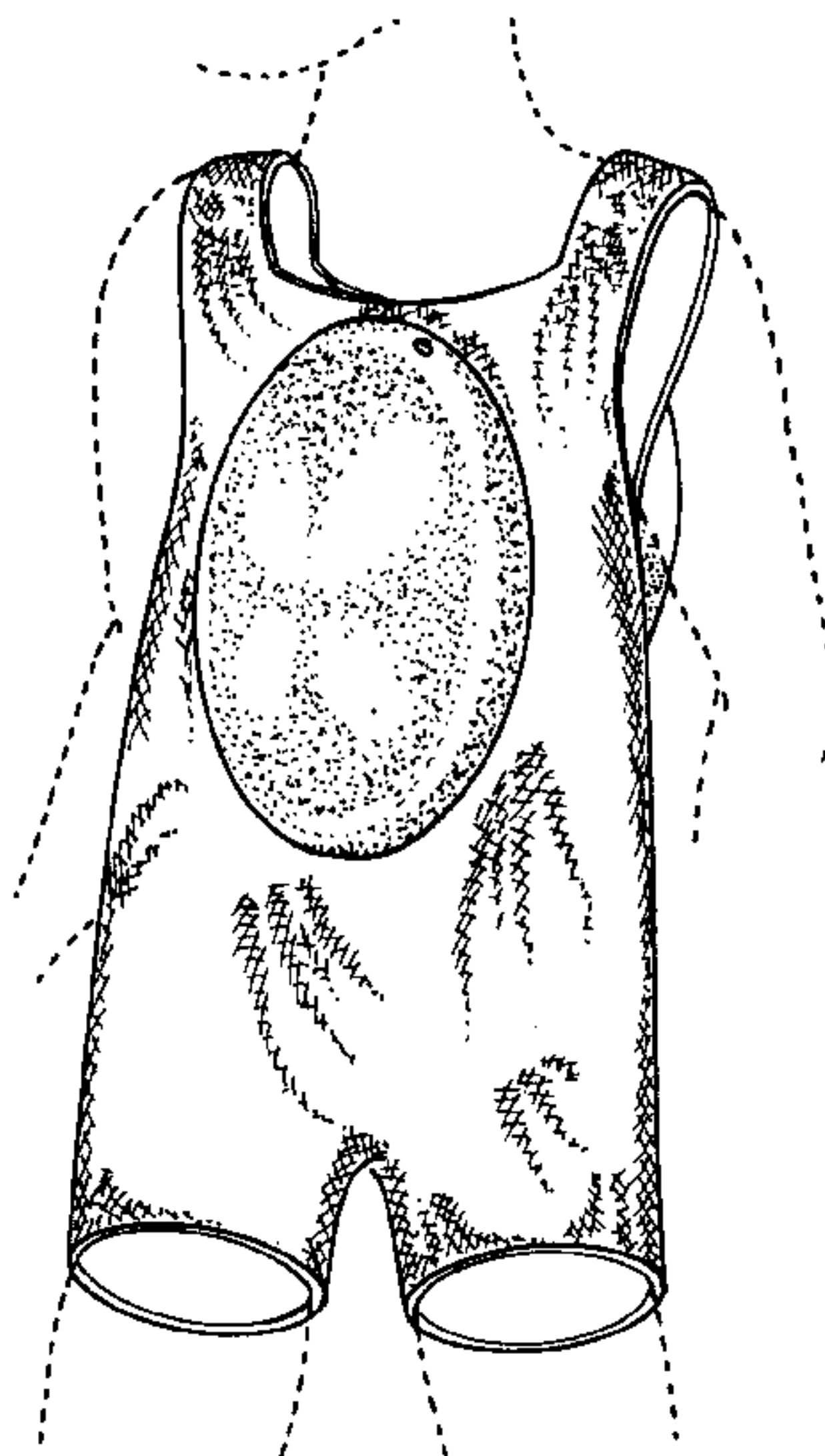
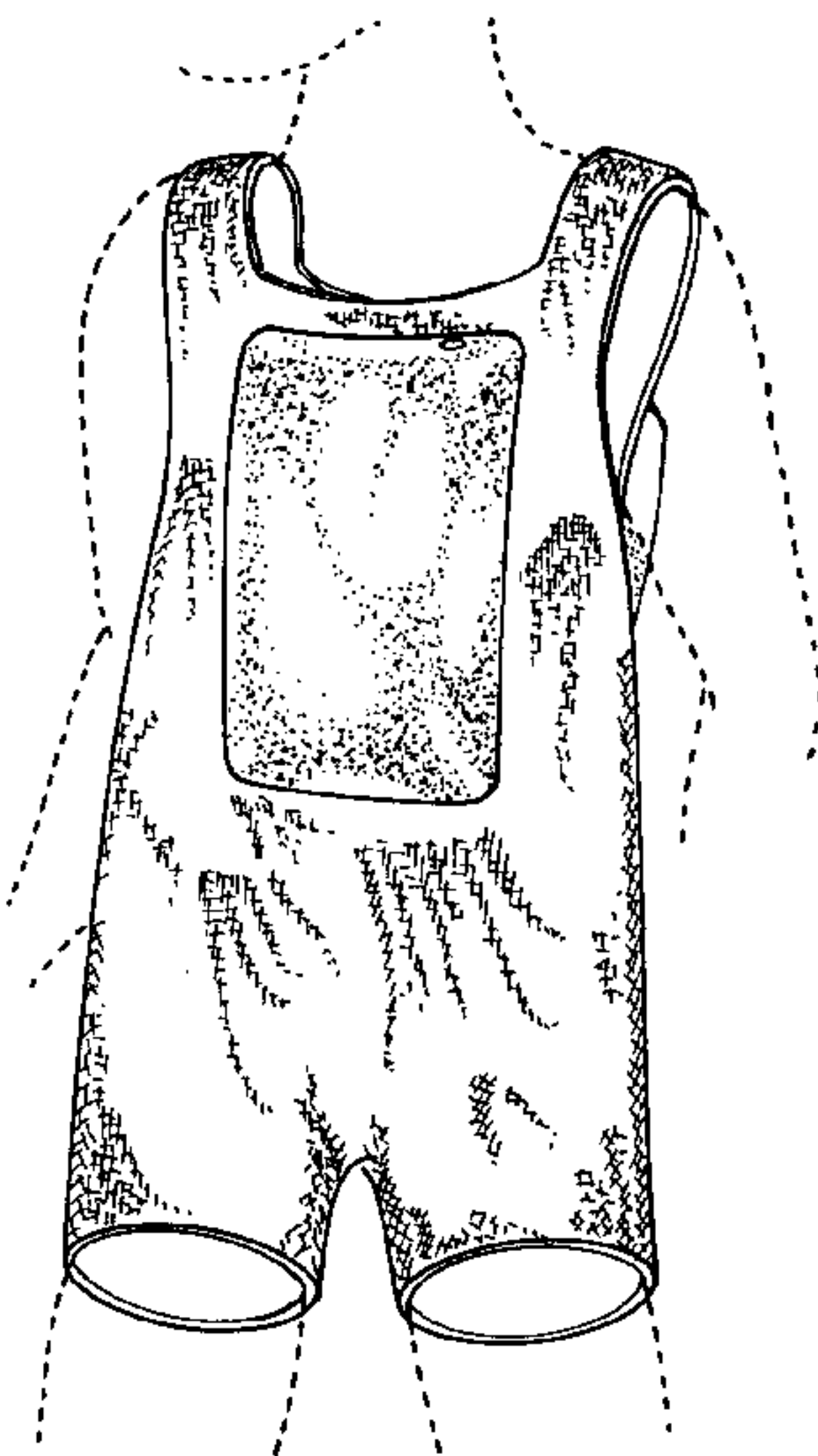
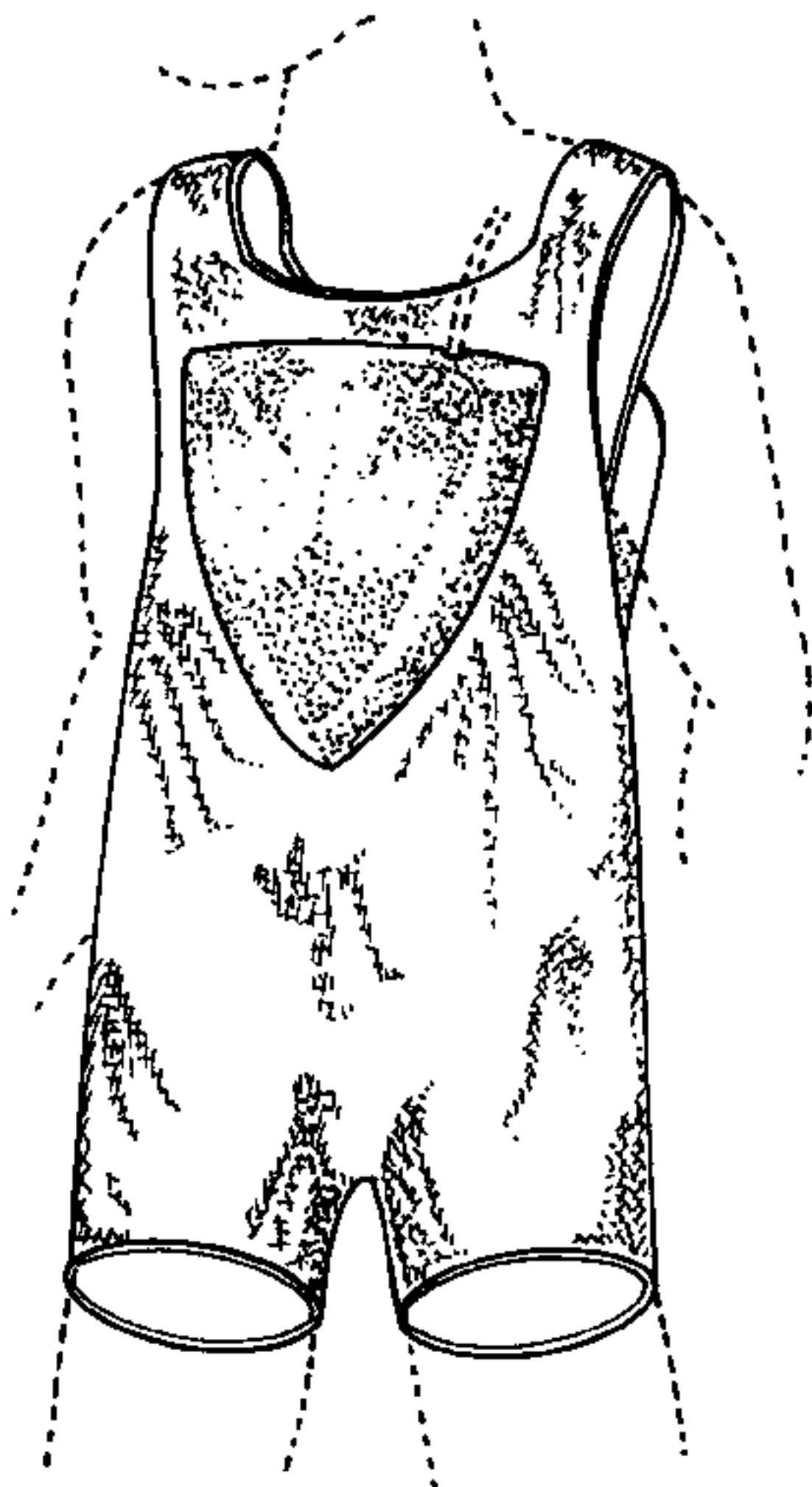
FIG. 7 is a perspective view of a of an alternate embodiment of the design shown in FIG. 1, the opposite side being a mirror image;

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a swimsuit embodying my new design; the broken lines partially showing a human torso in FIGS. 1 and 7—10 being for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a front elevational view of the swimsuit shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the swimsuit shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of the swimsuit shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the swimsuit shown in FIG. 1.

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the swimsuit shown in FIG. 1.

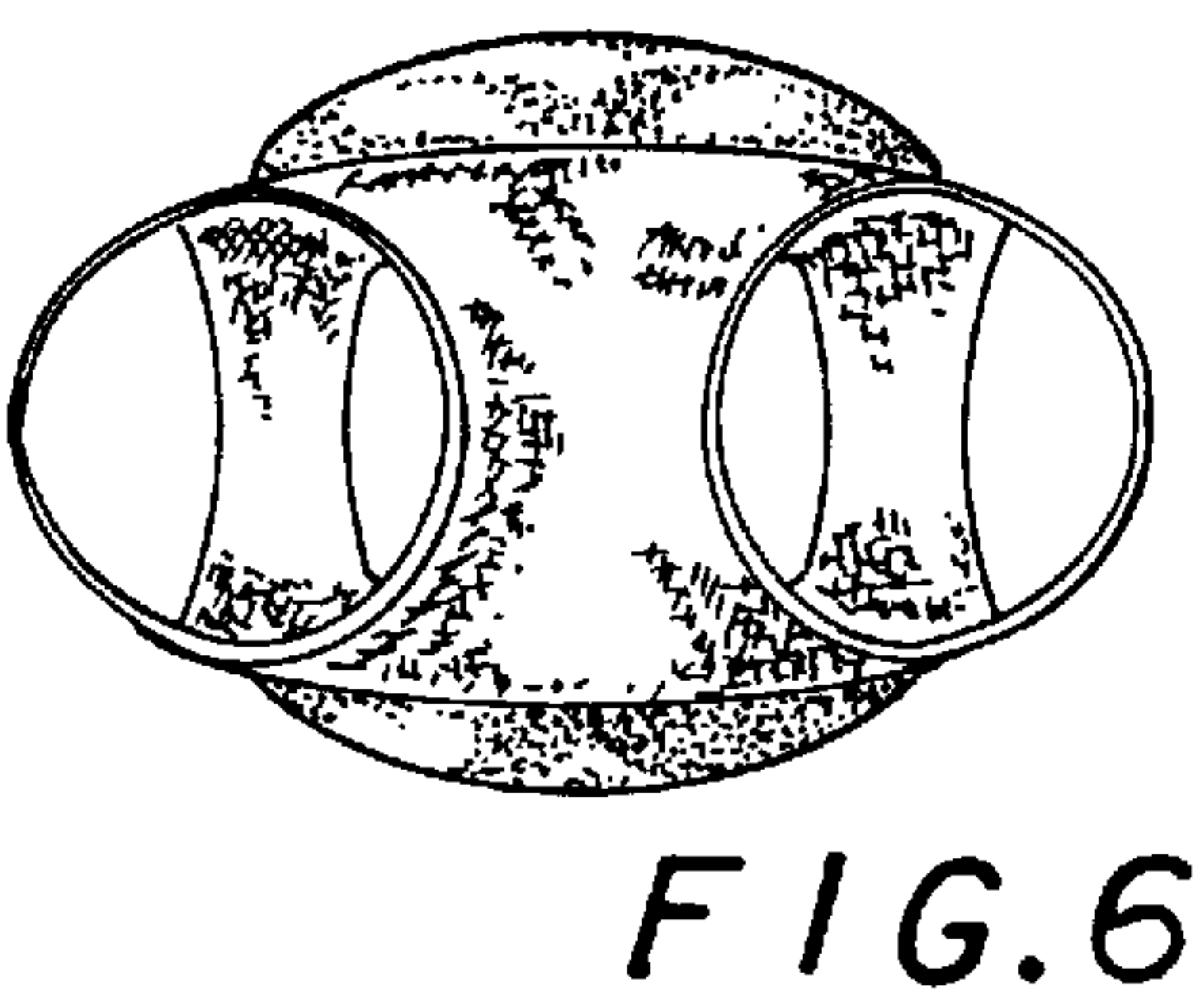
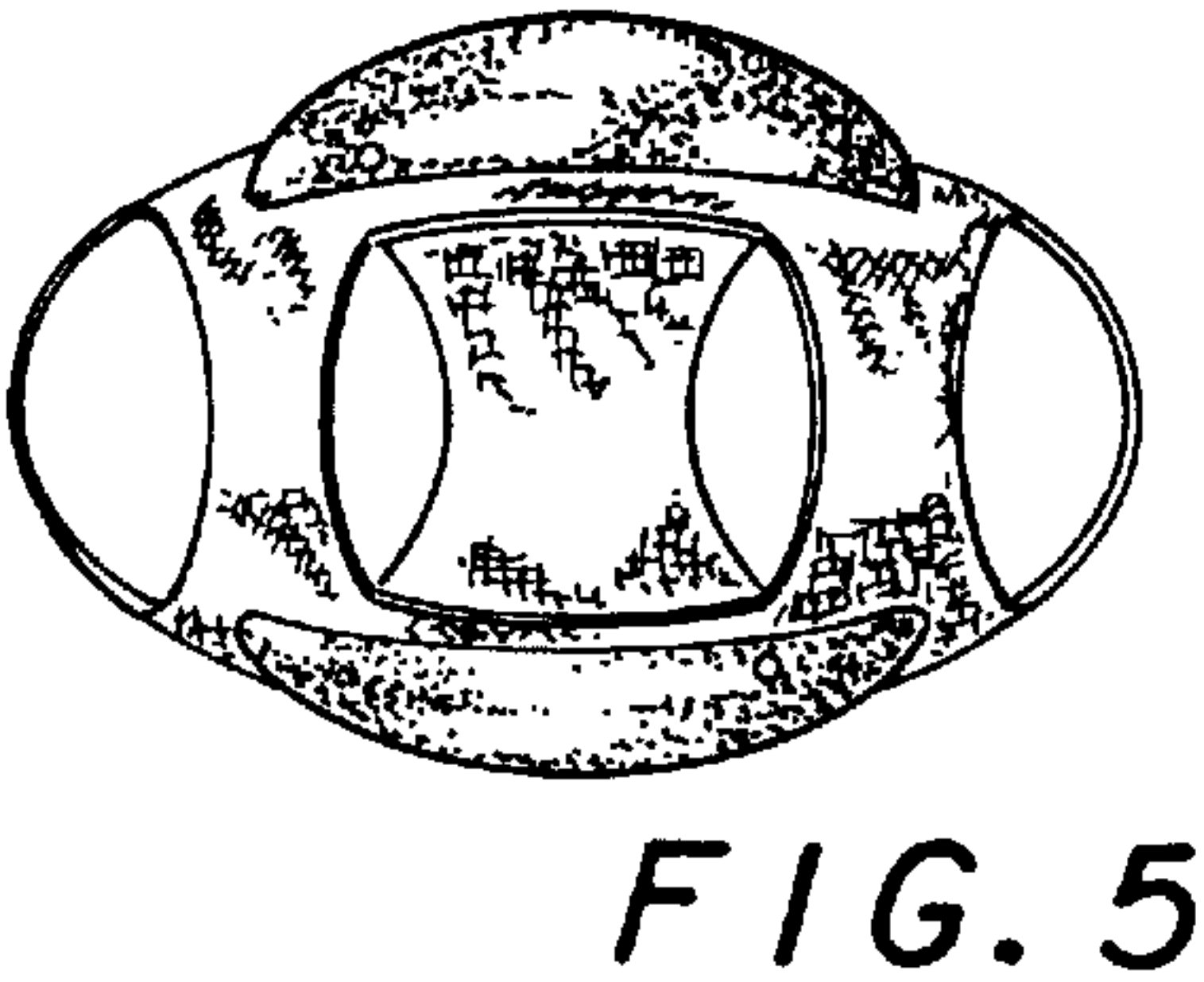
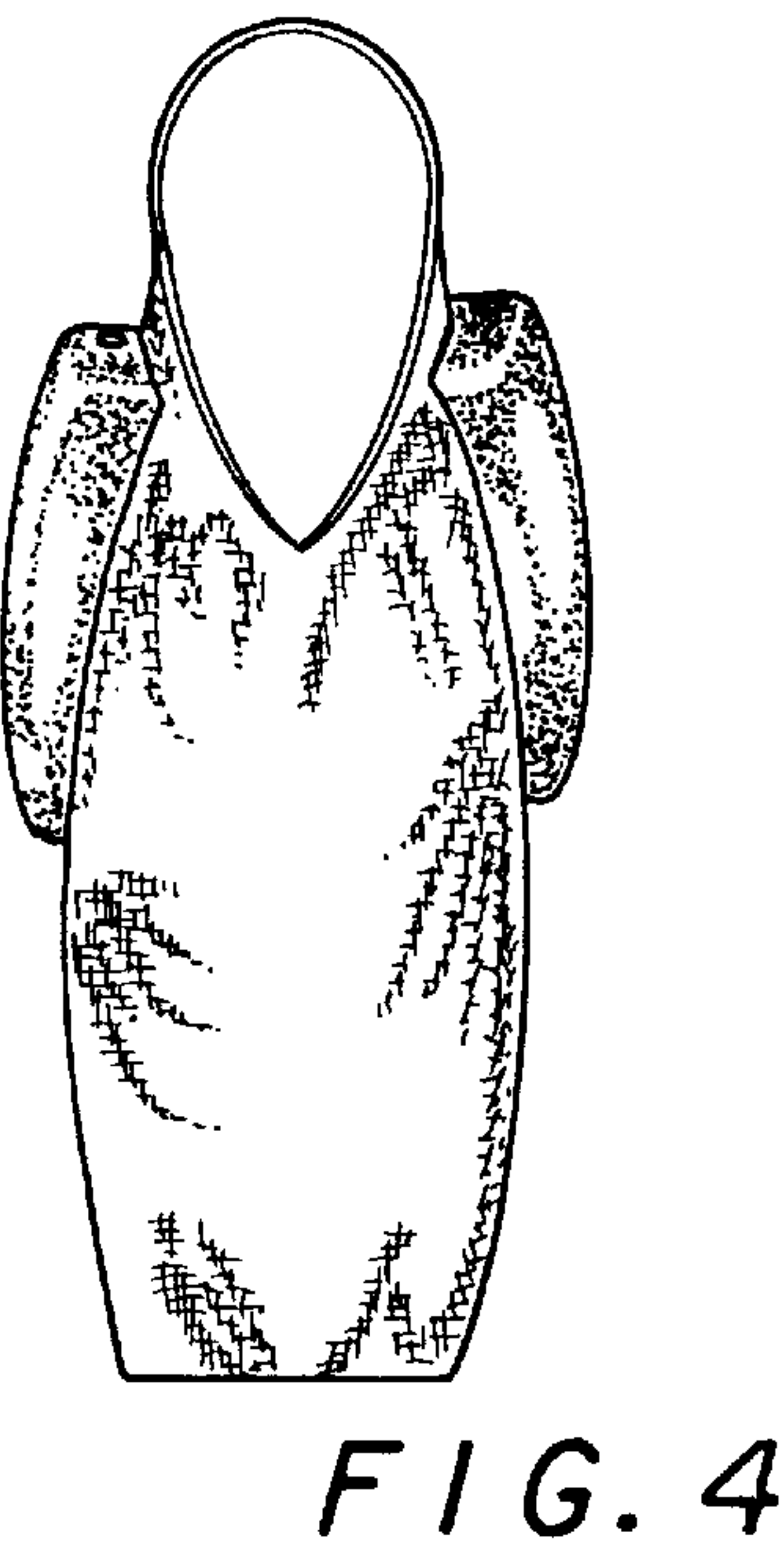
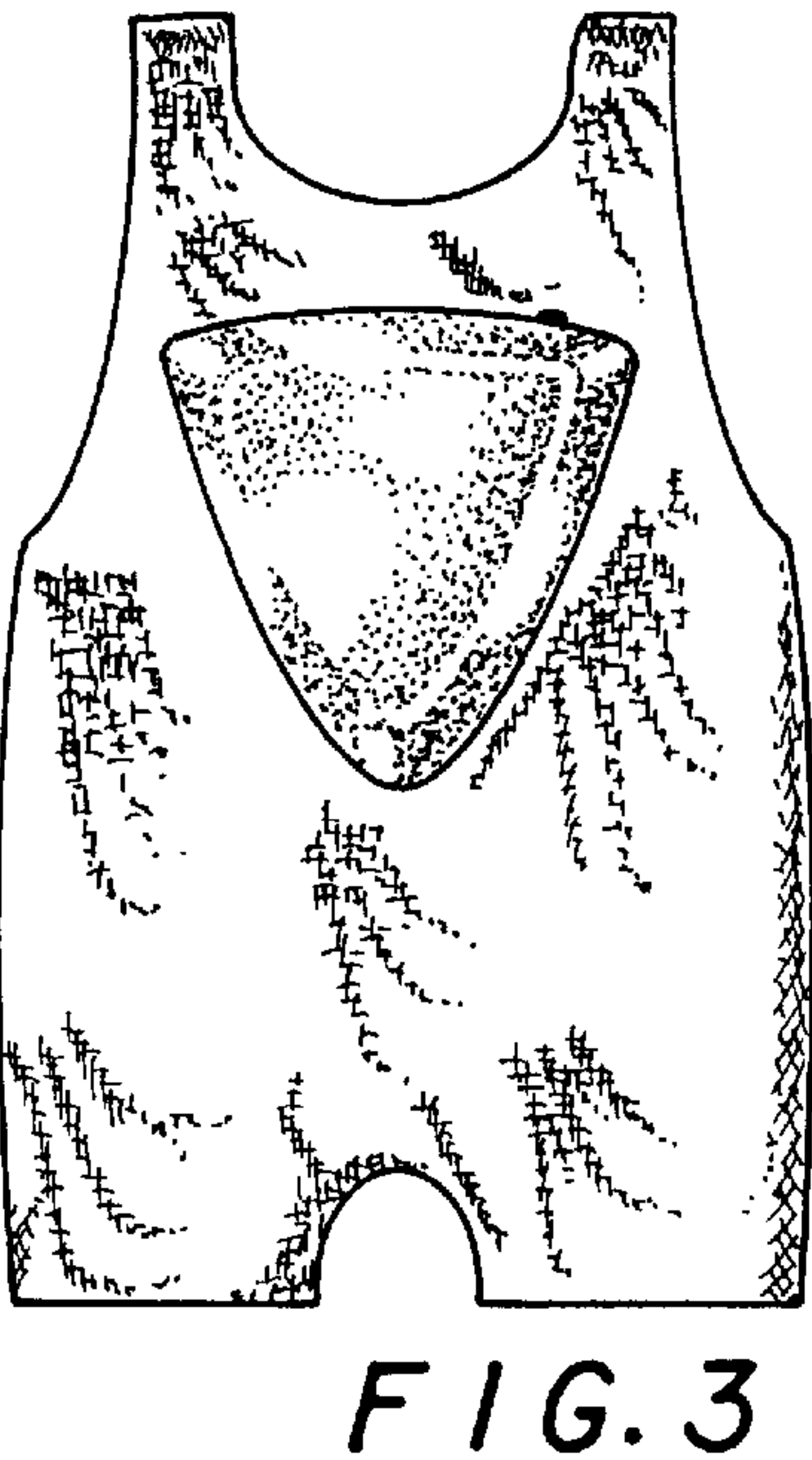
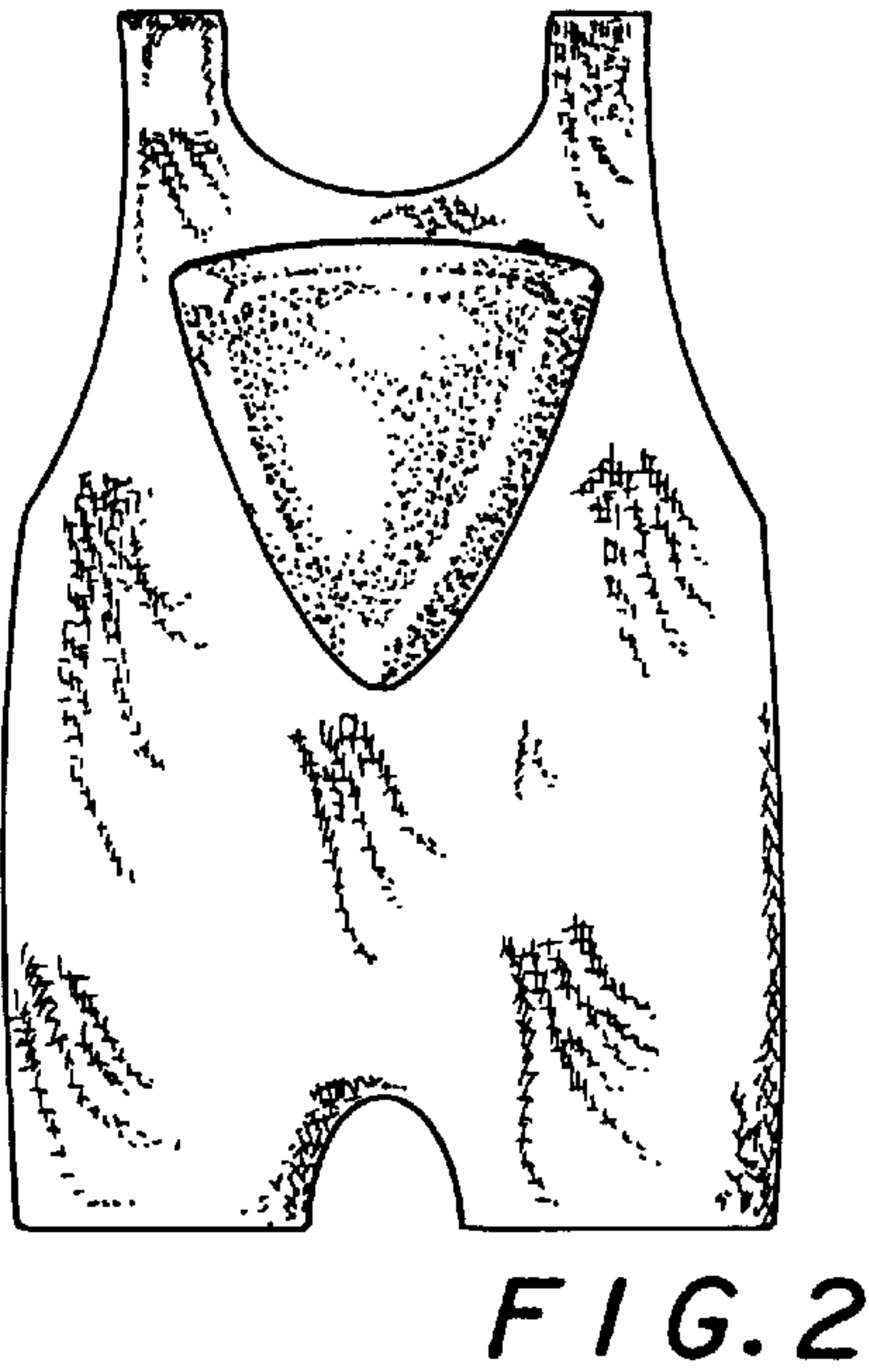
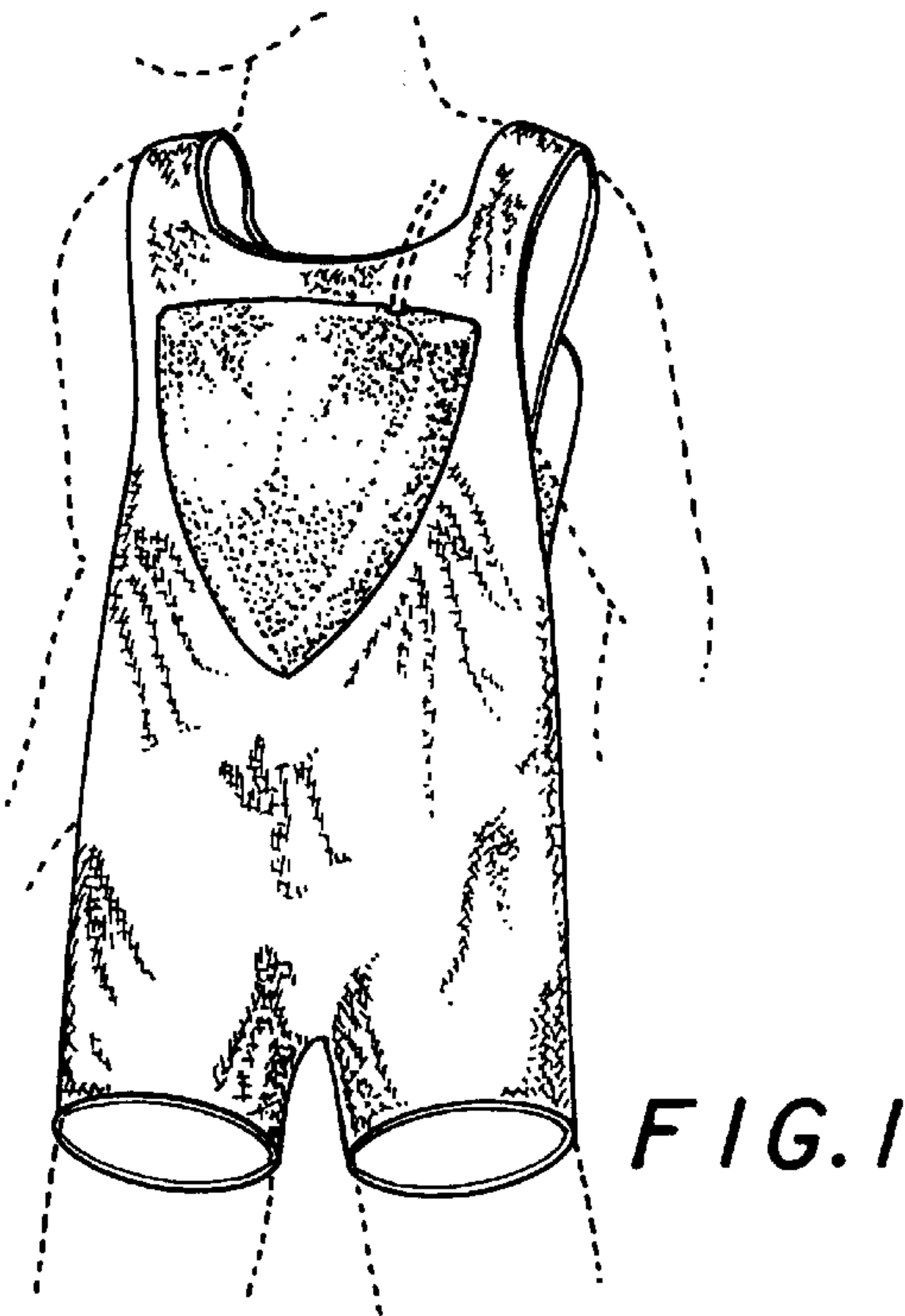
FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of the design shown in FIG. 1, the opposite side being a mirror image;

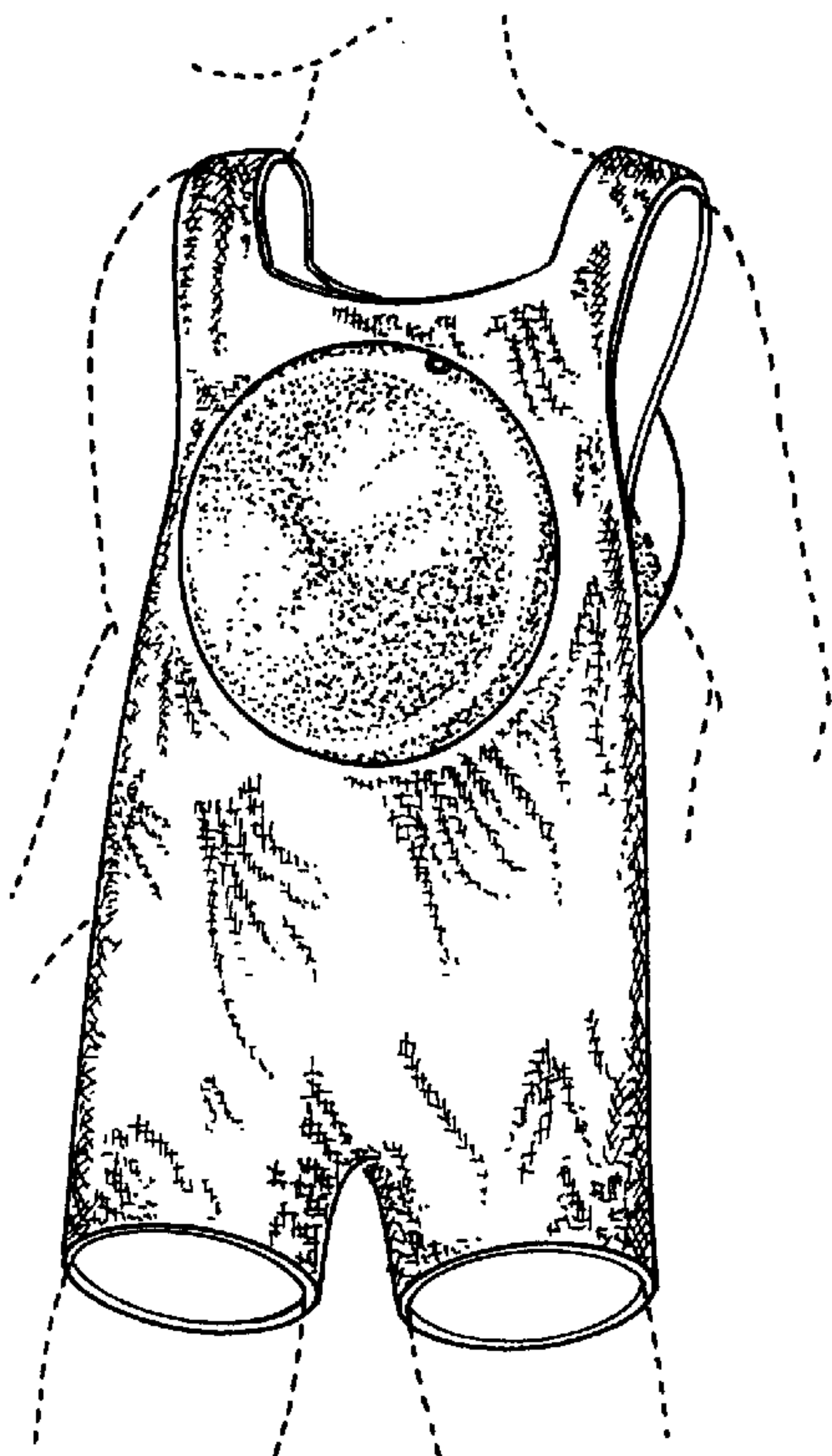

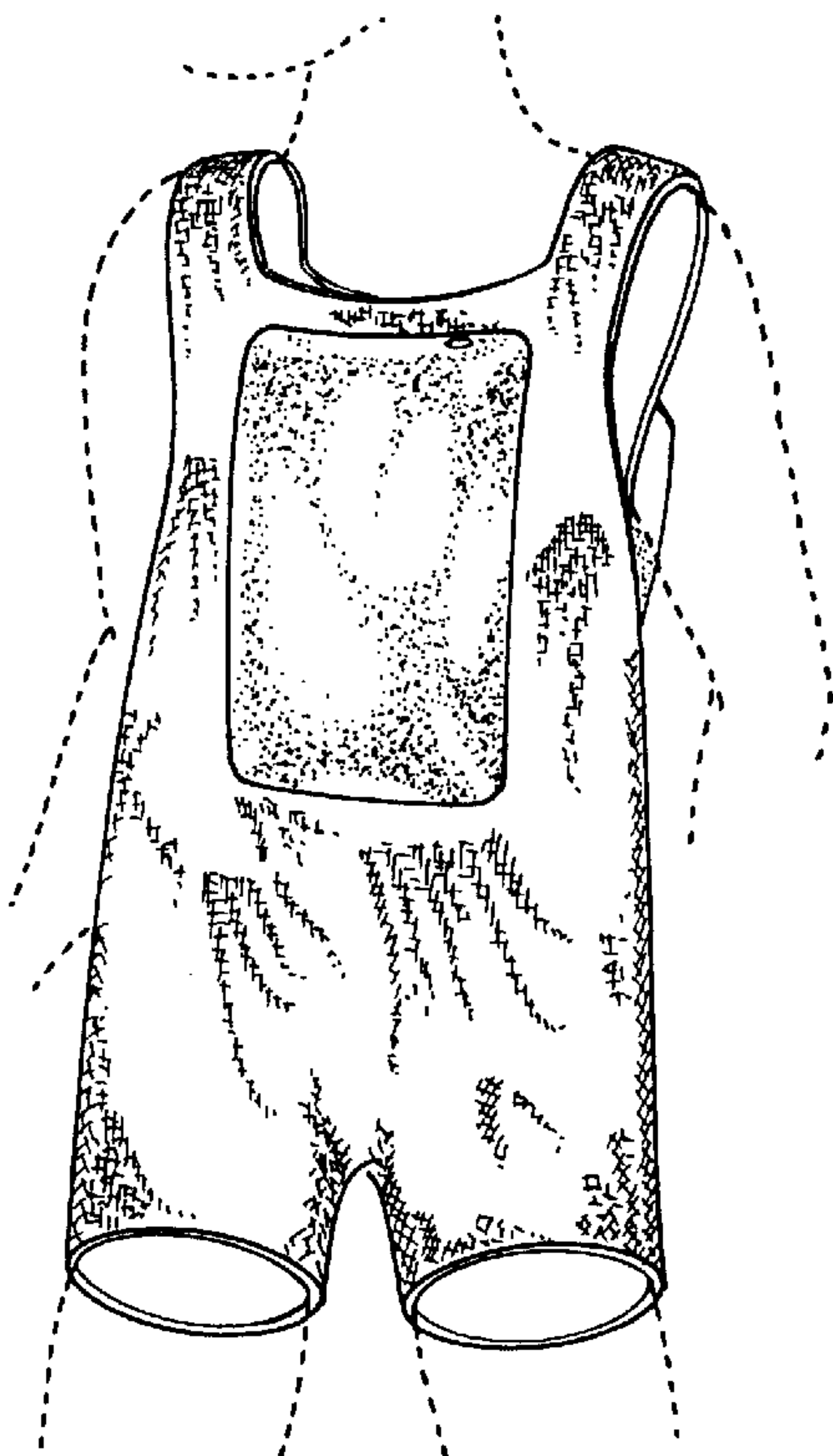

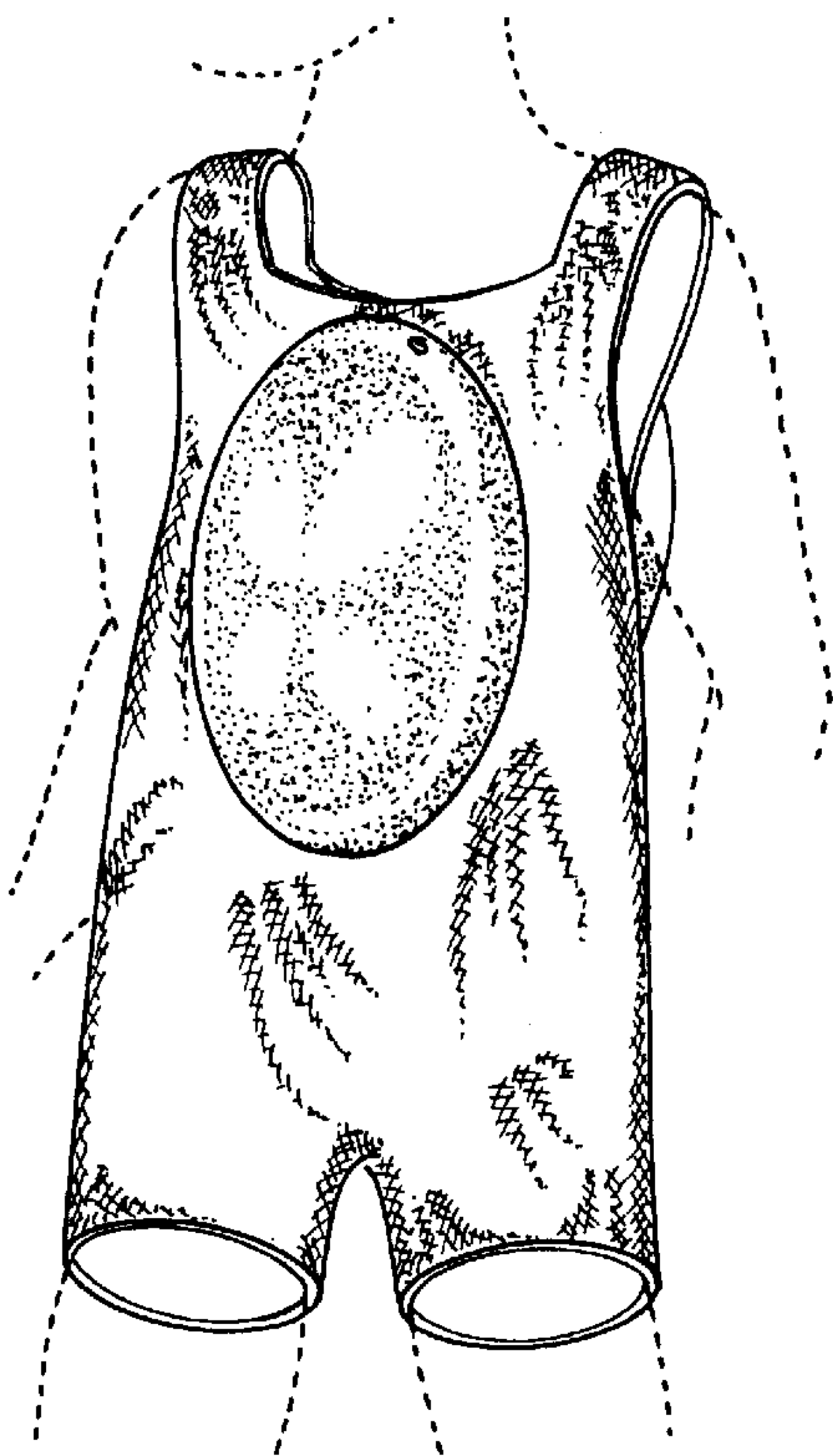

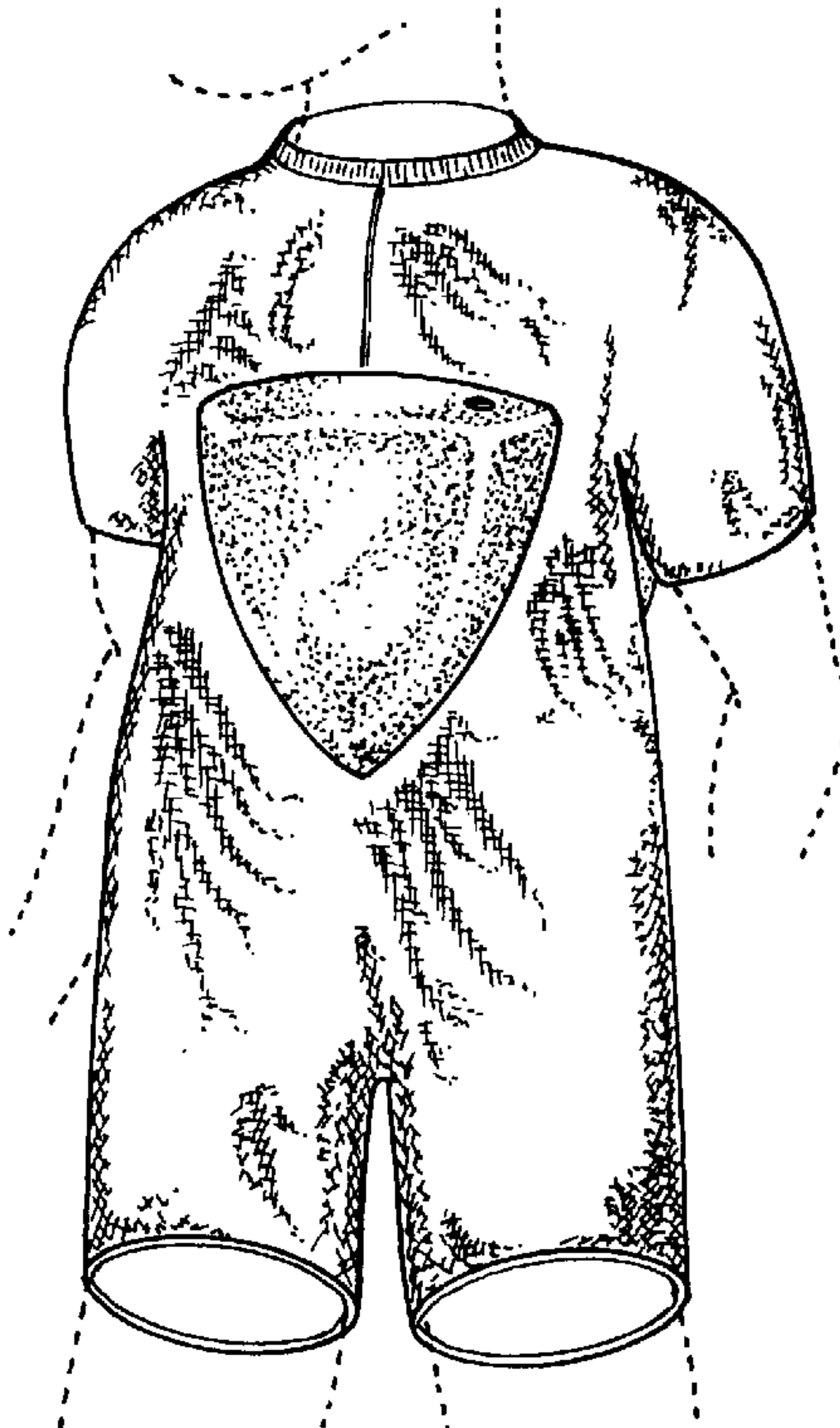
