FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of the pedicure slipper of FIG. 1; and,

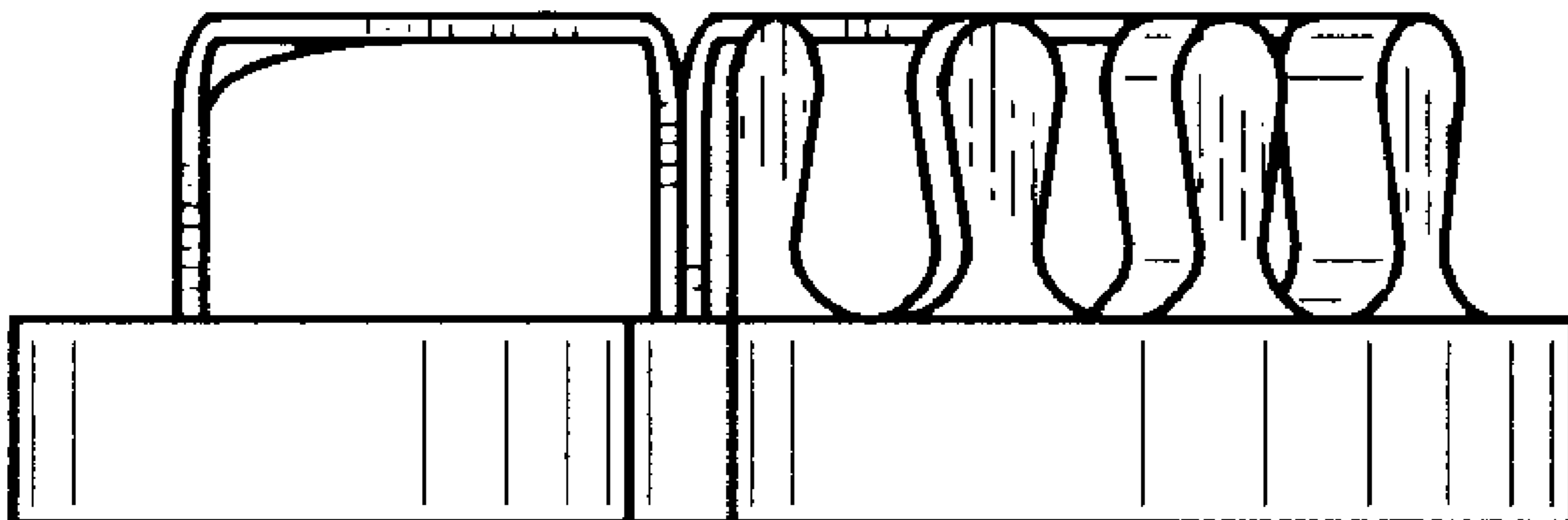
FIG. 6 is a back elevational view of the pedicure slipper of FIG. 1.

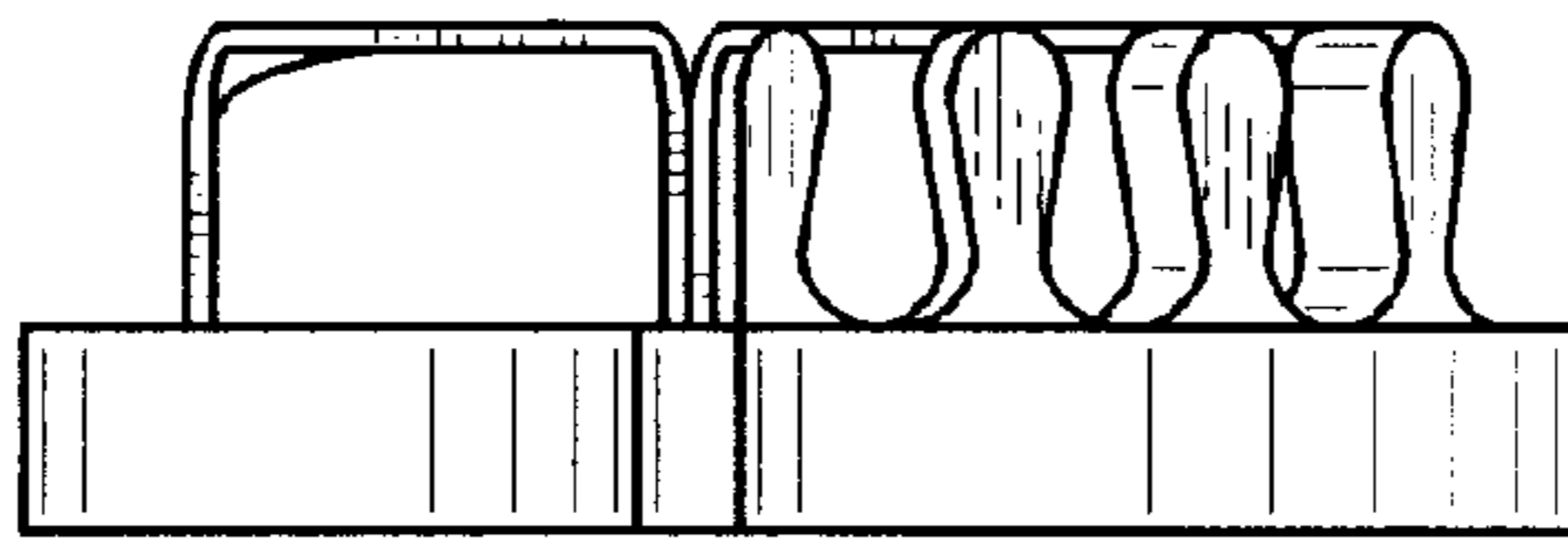

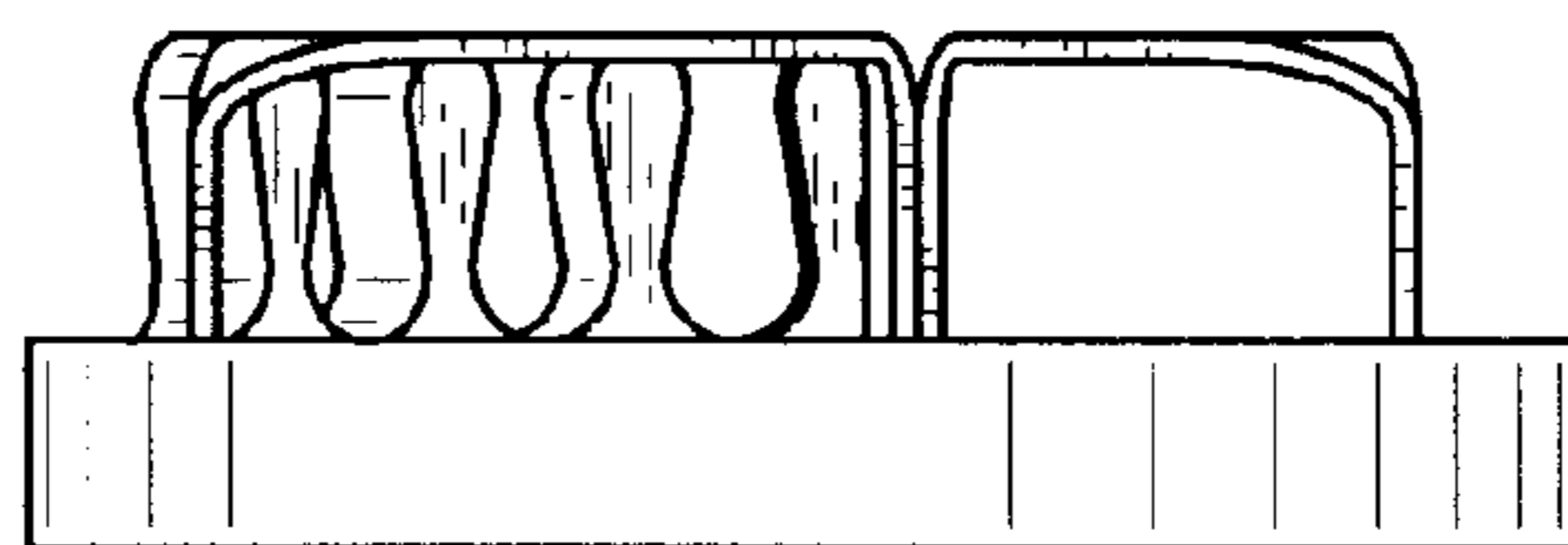

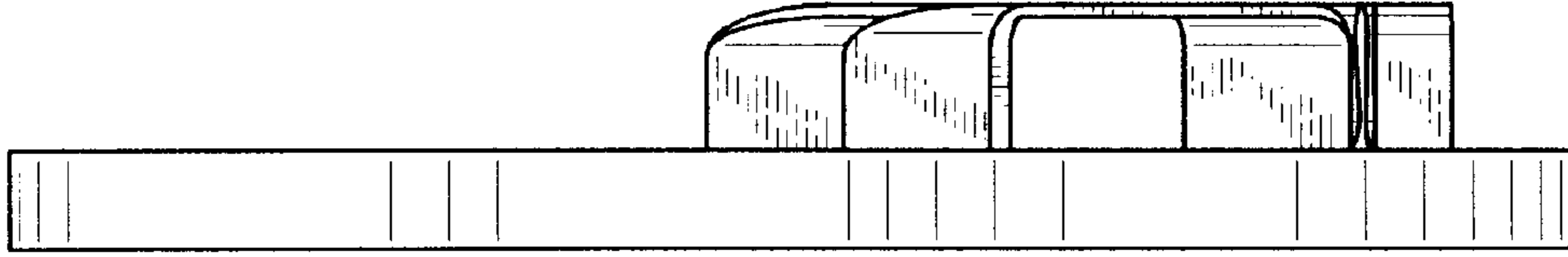

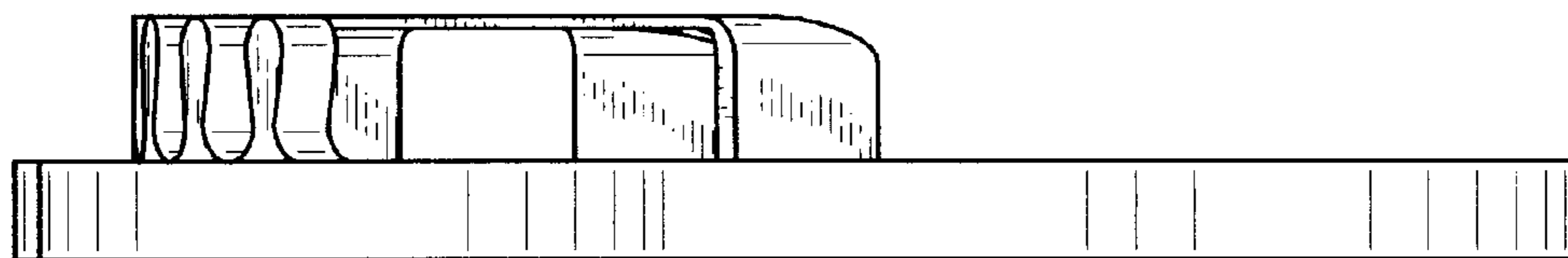

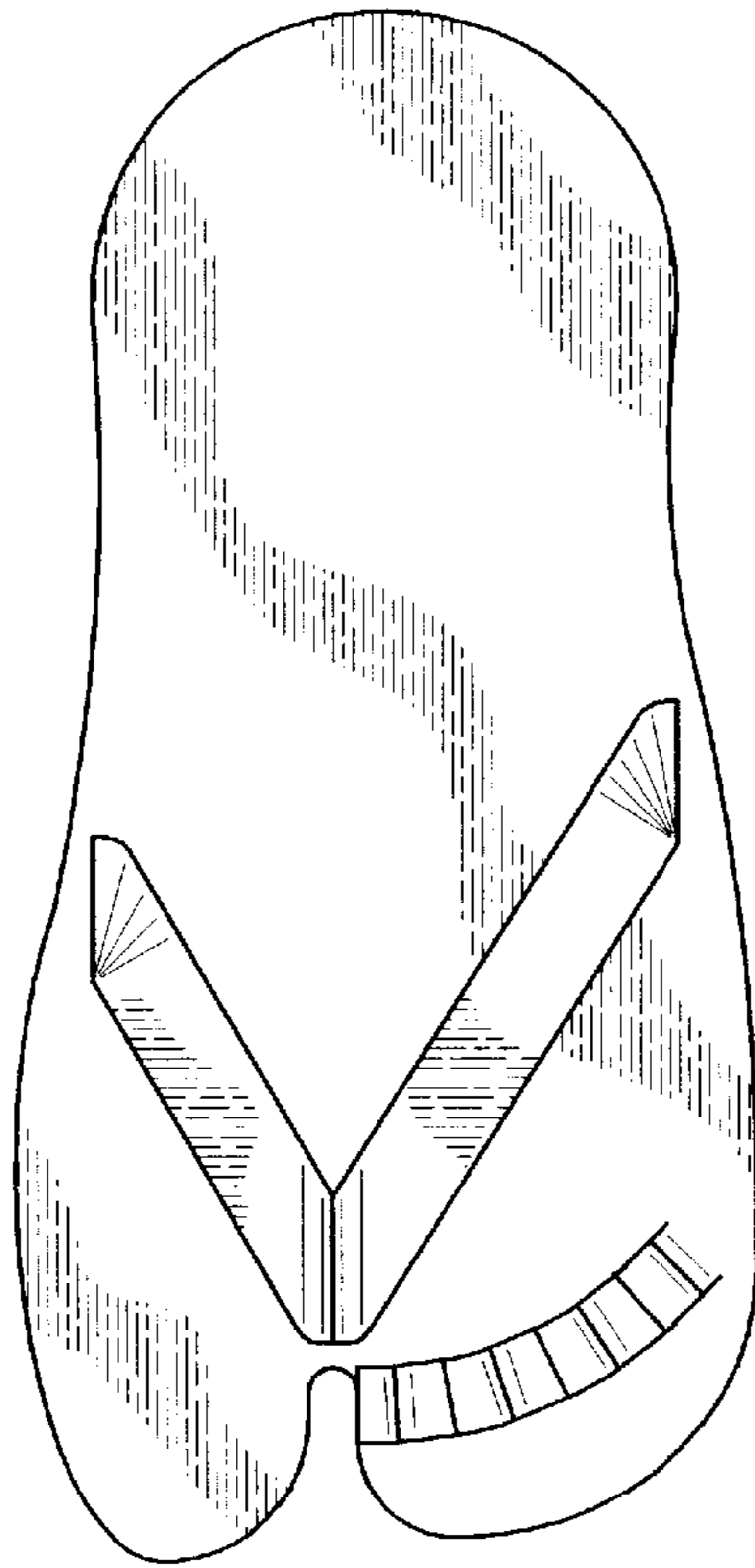

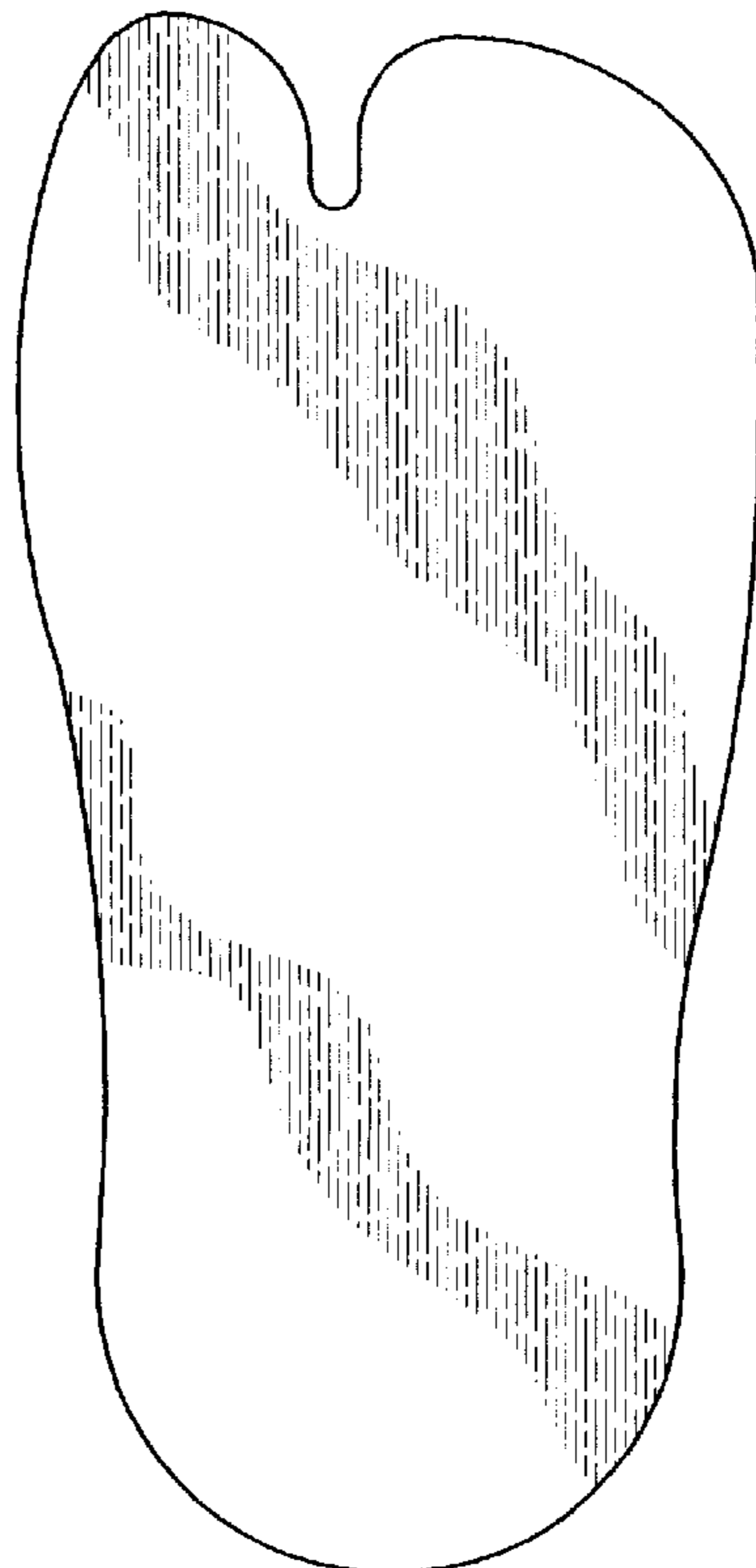
