[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for ornamental child's pillow in the fanciful form of a frog, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the ornamental child's pillow in the fanciful form of a frog, taken from above the right front corner,

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

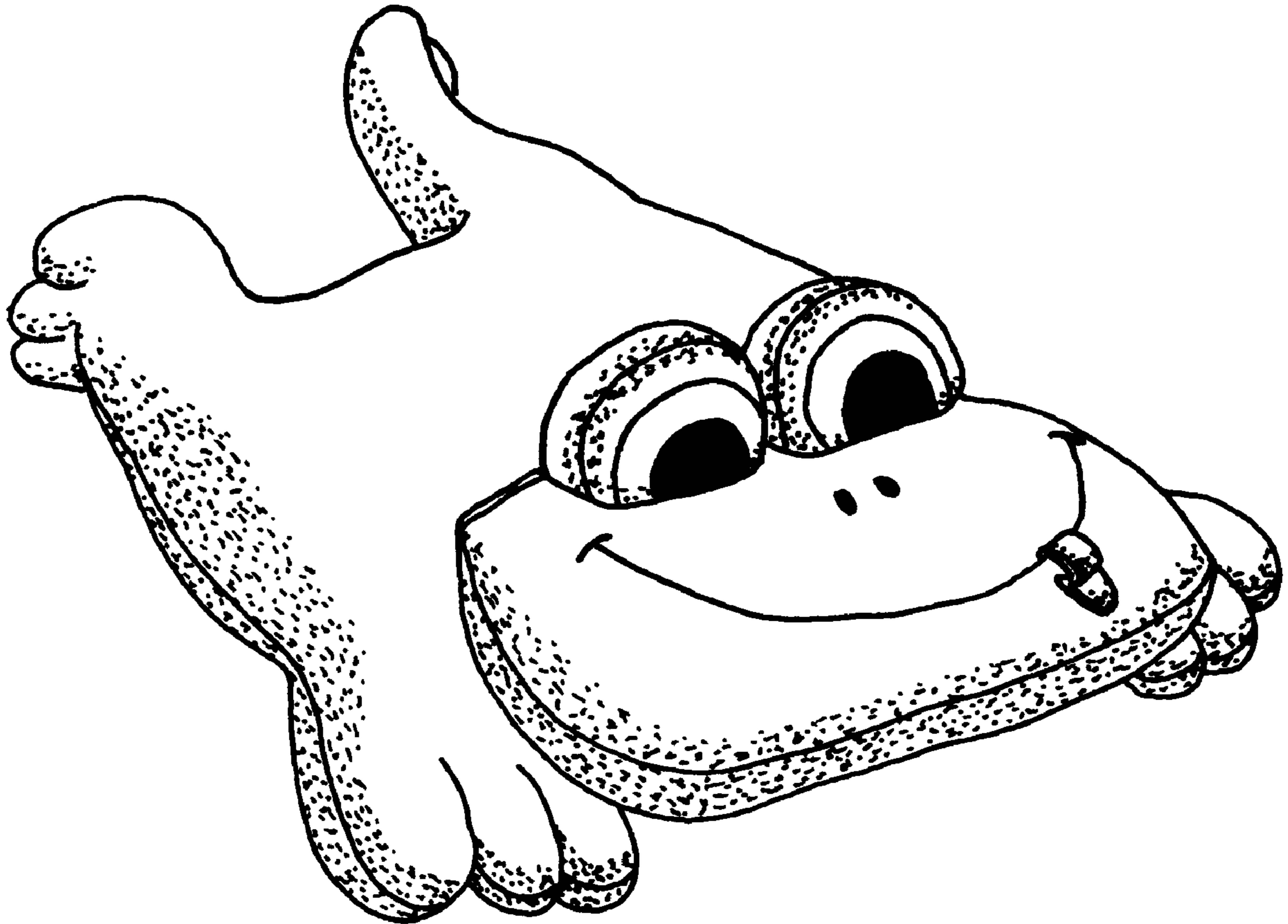
FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view the right side being a mirror image thereof;

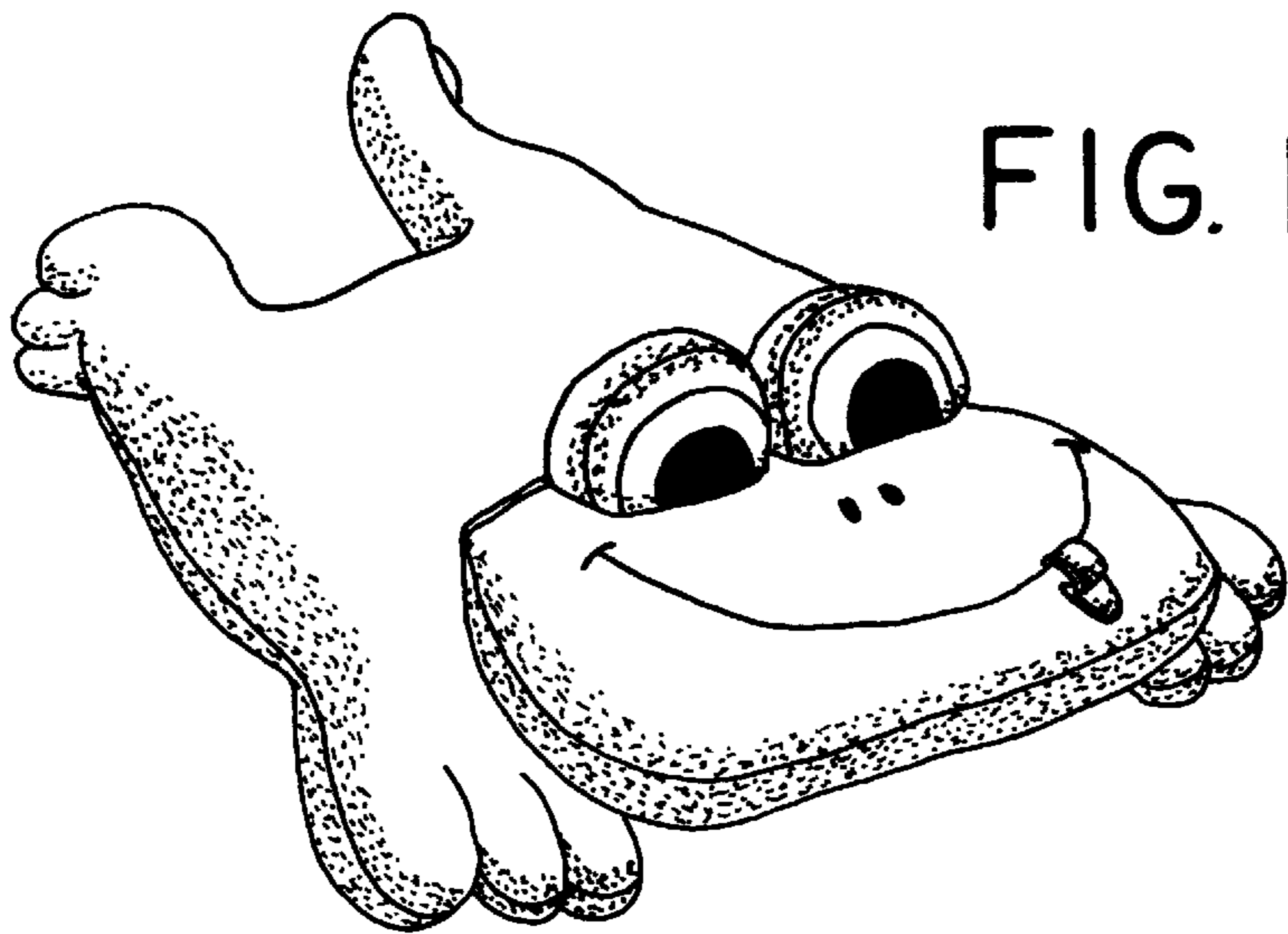

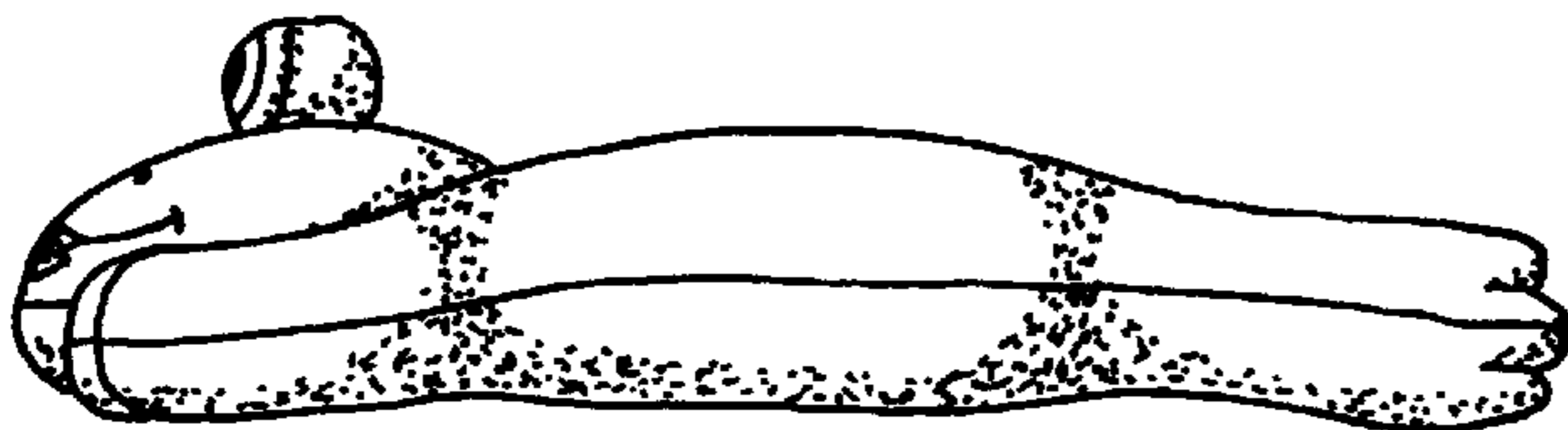

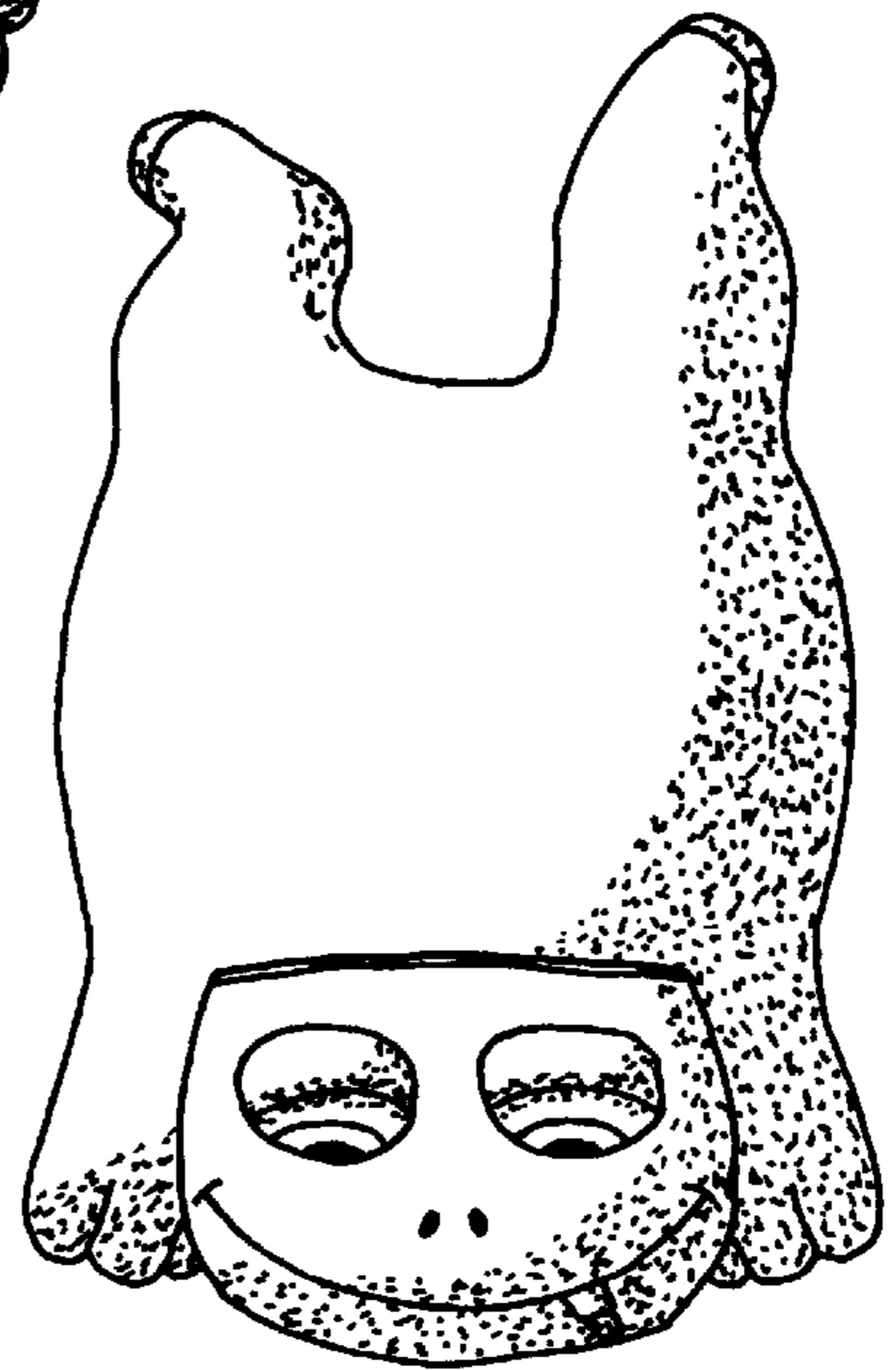

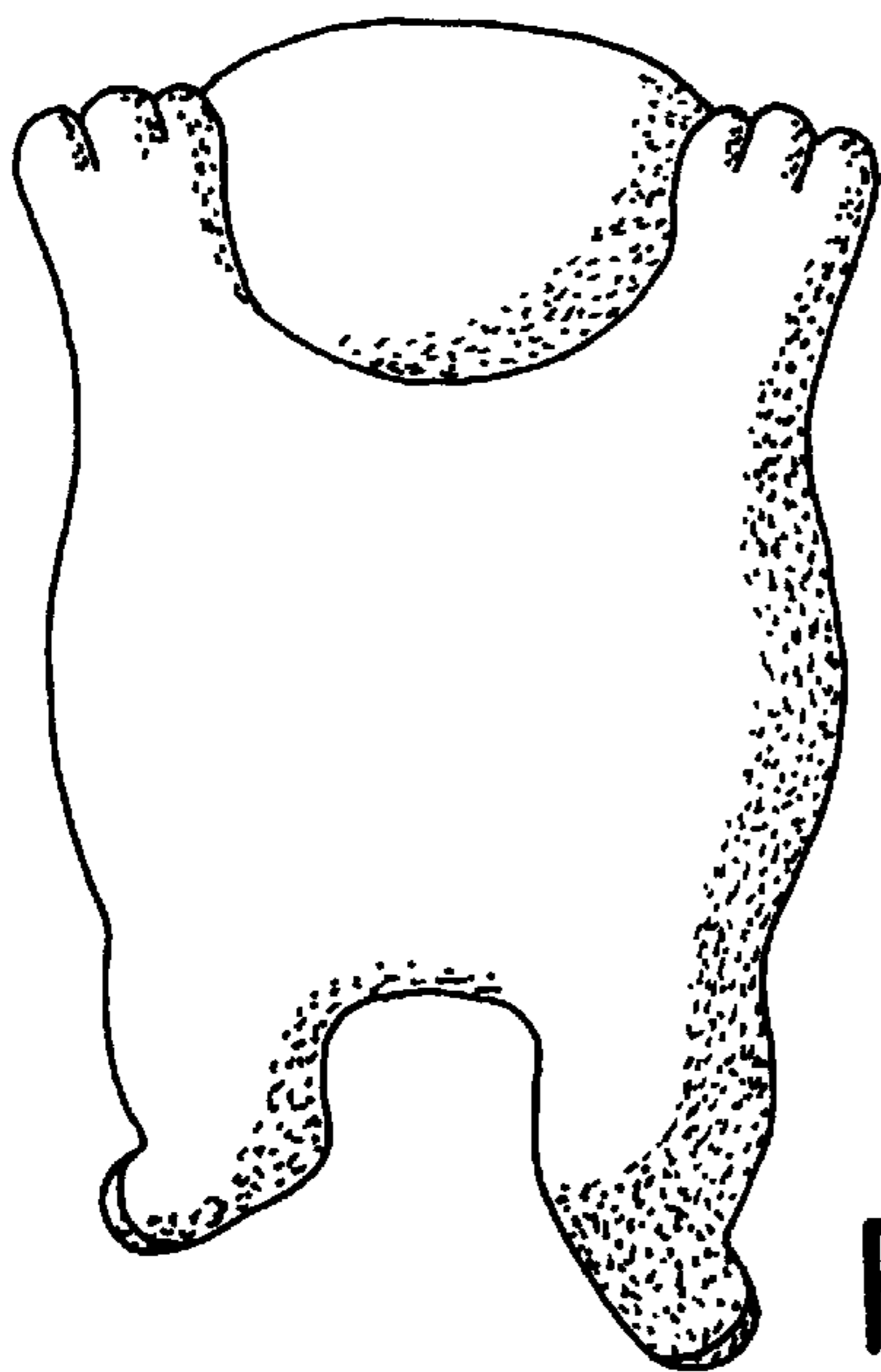

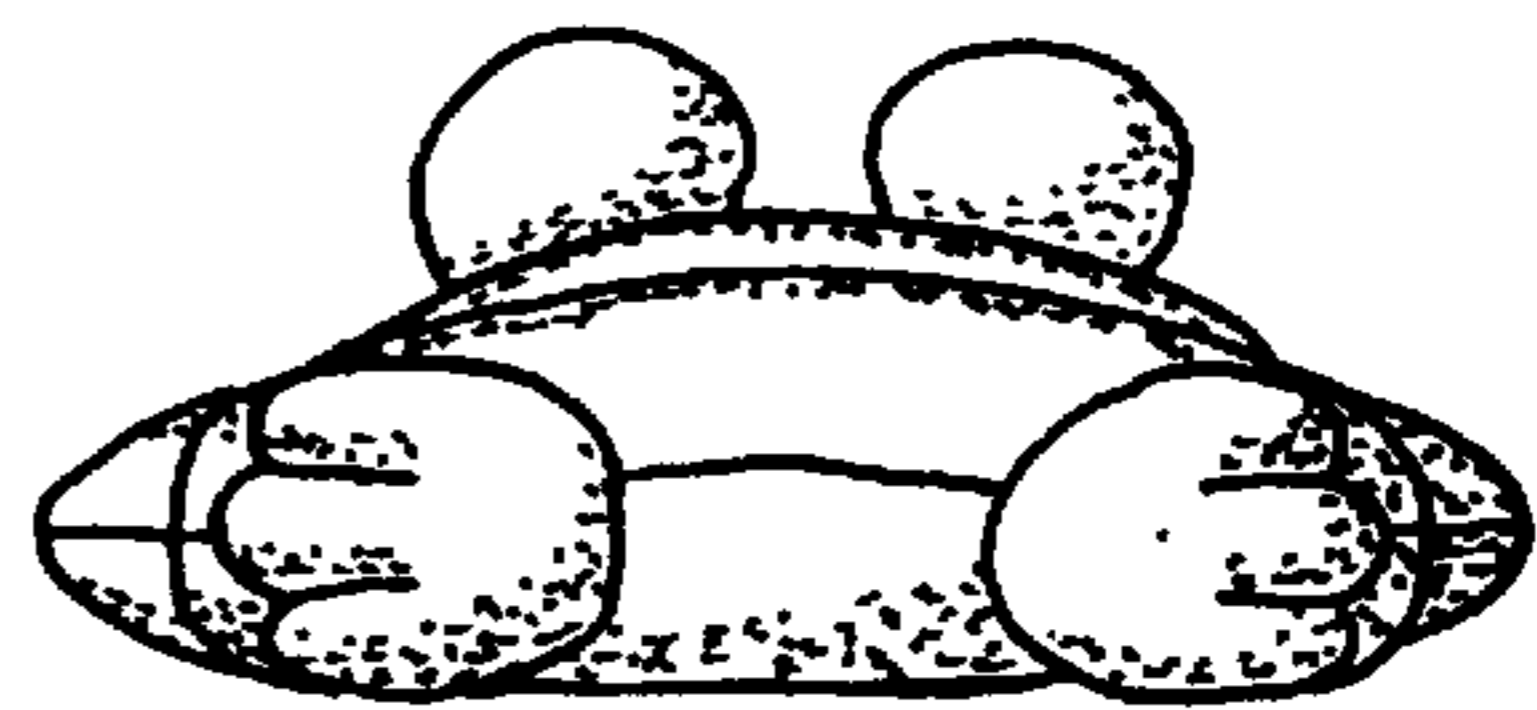
