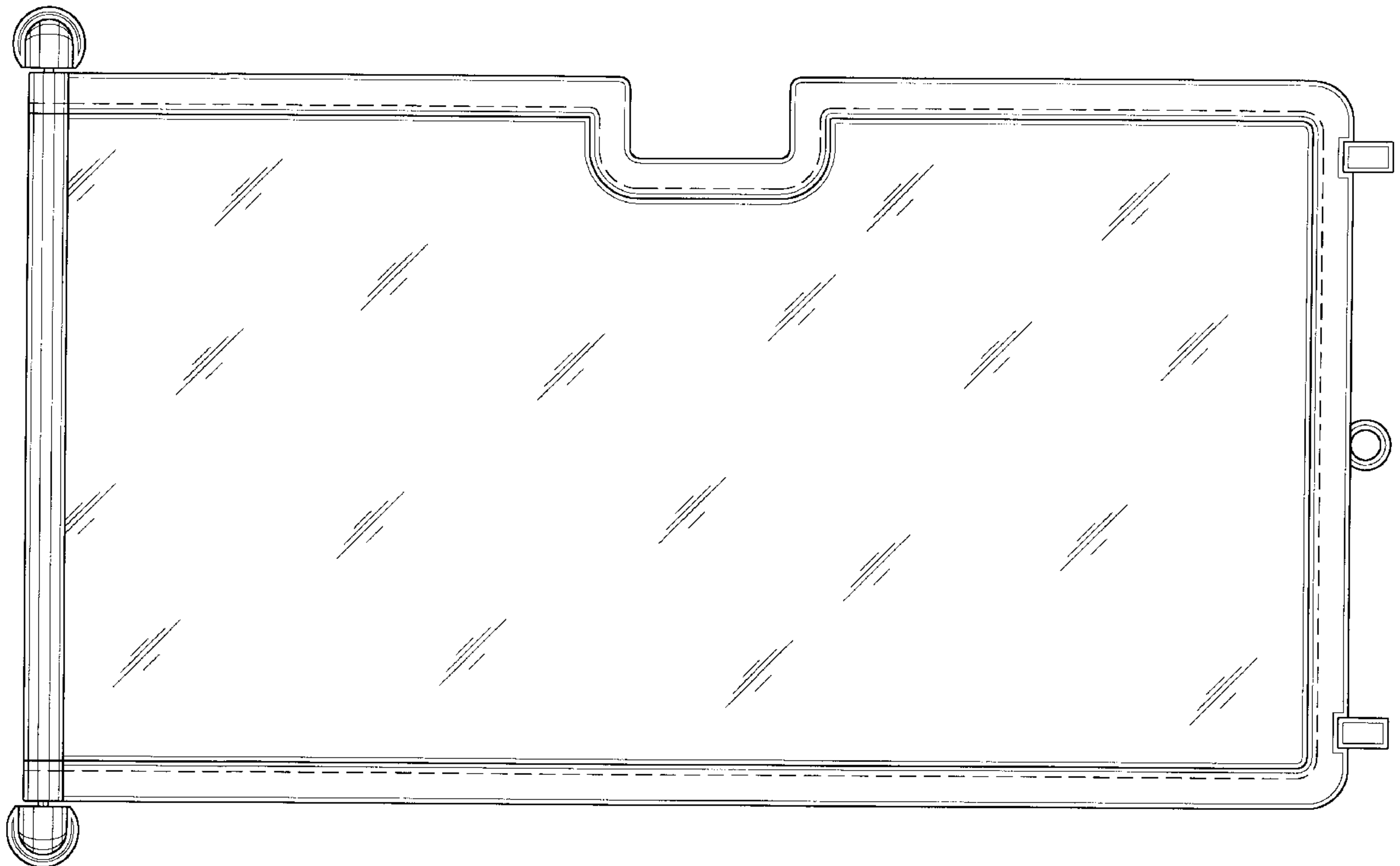
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the retractable windshield shade of the present invention;

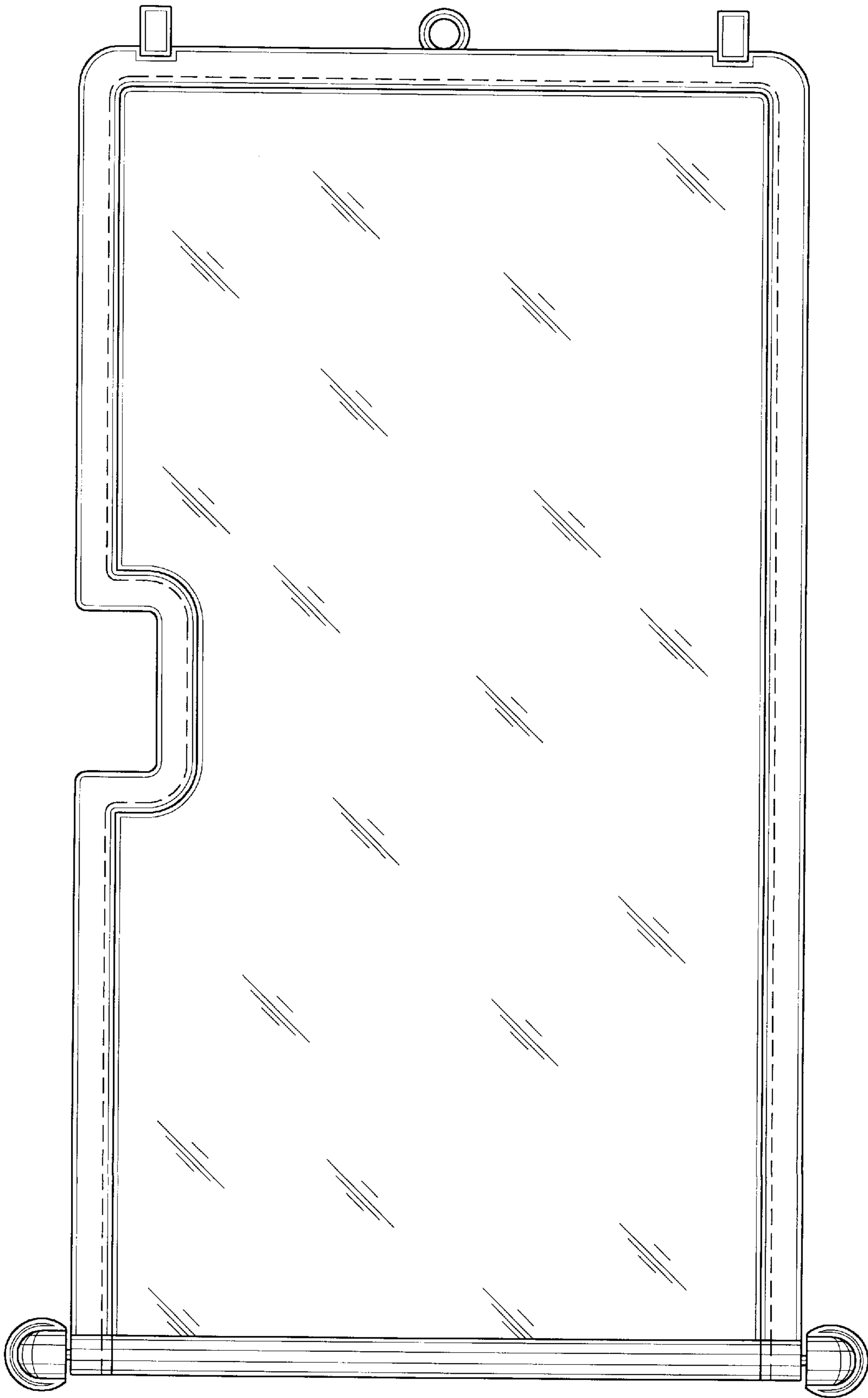

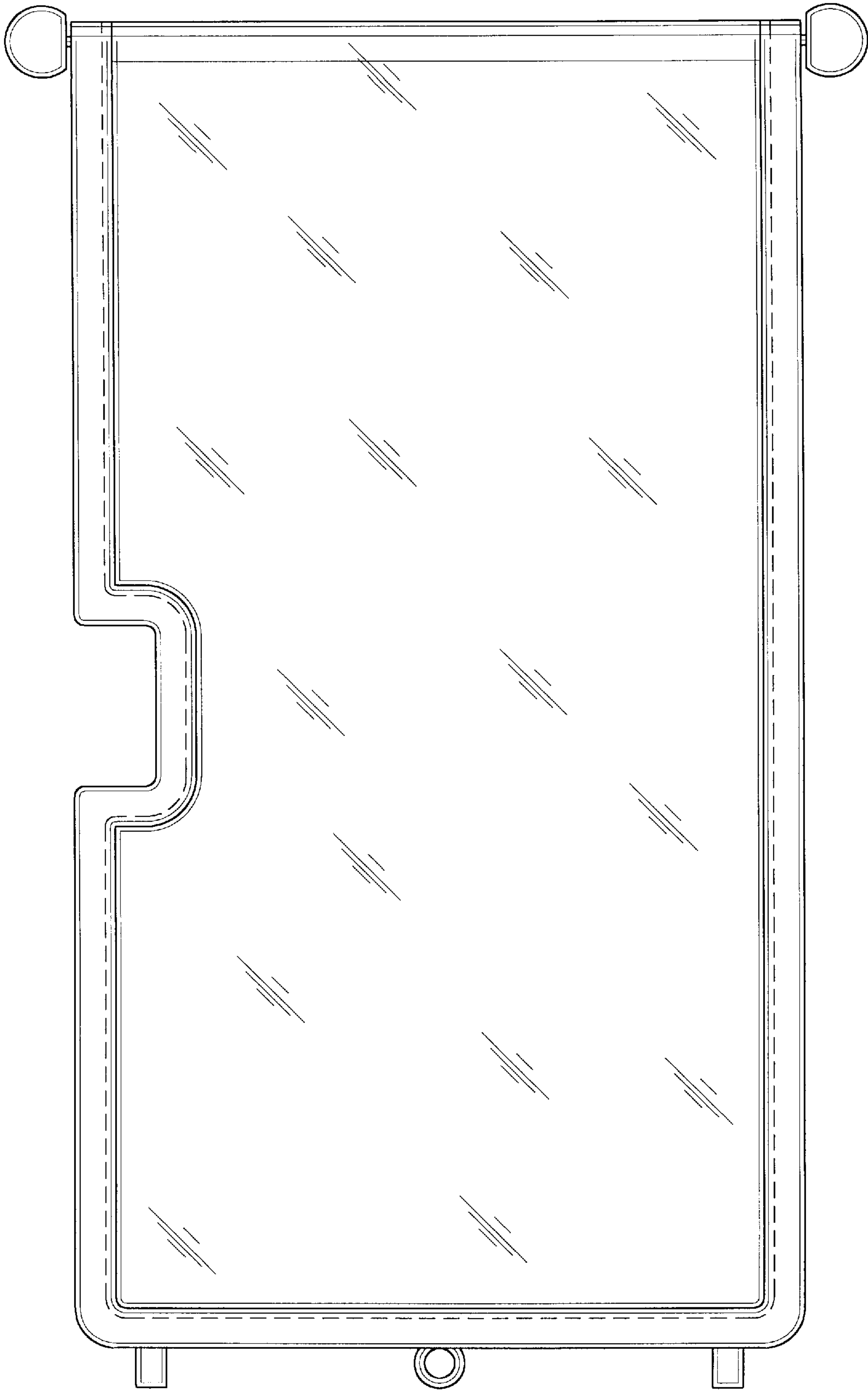

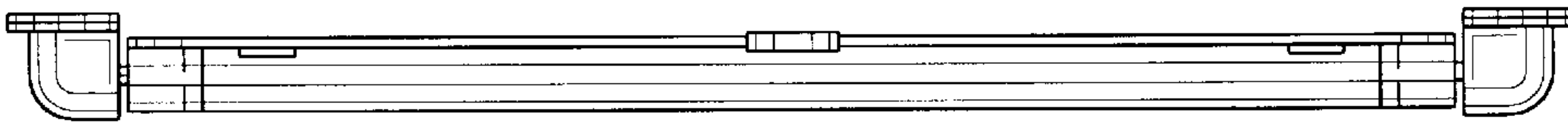
