**DESCRIPTION**

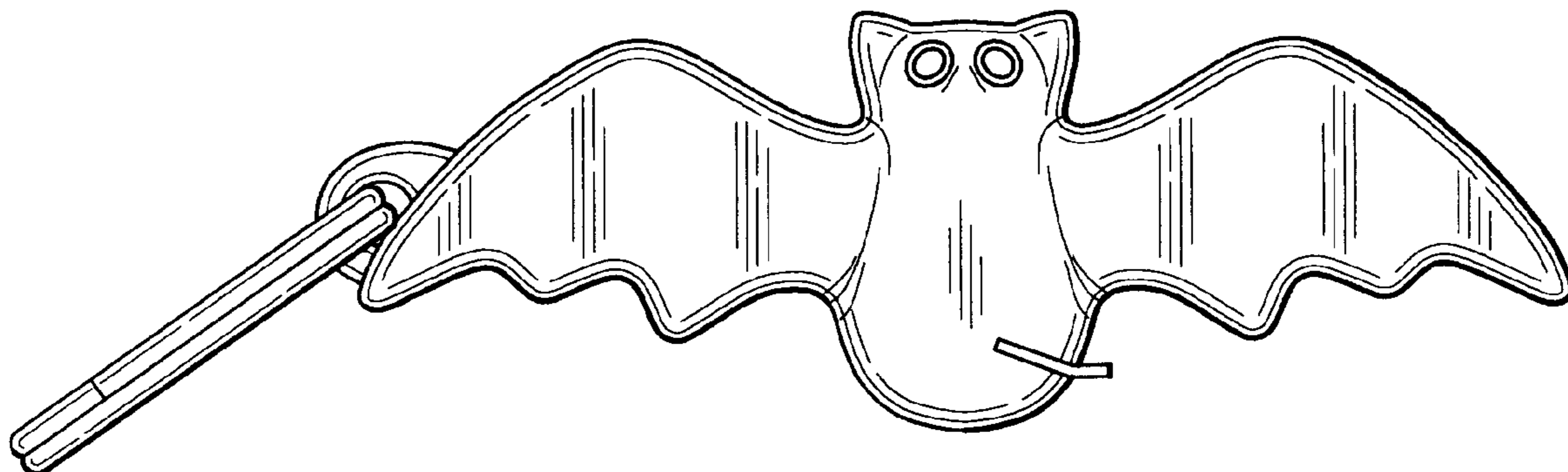
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a bat shaped bottle opener, showing my new design;

FIG. 7 is a right side elevation view thereof.

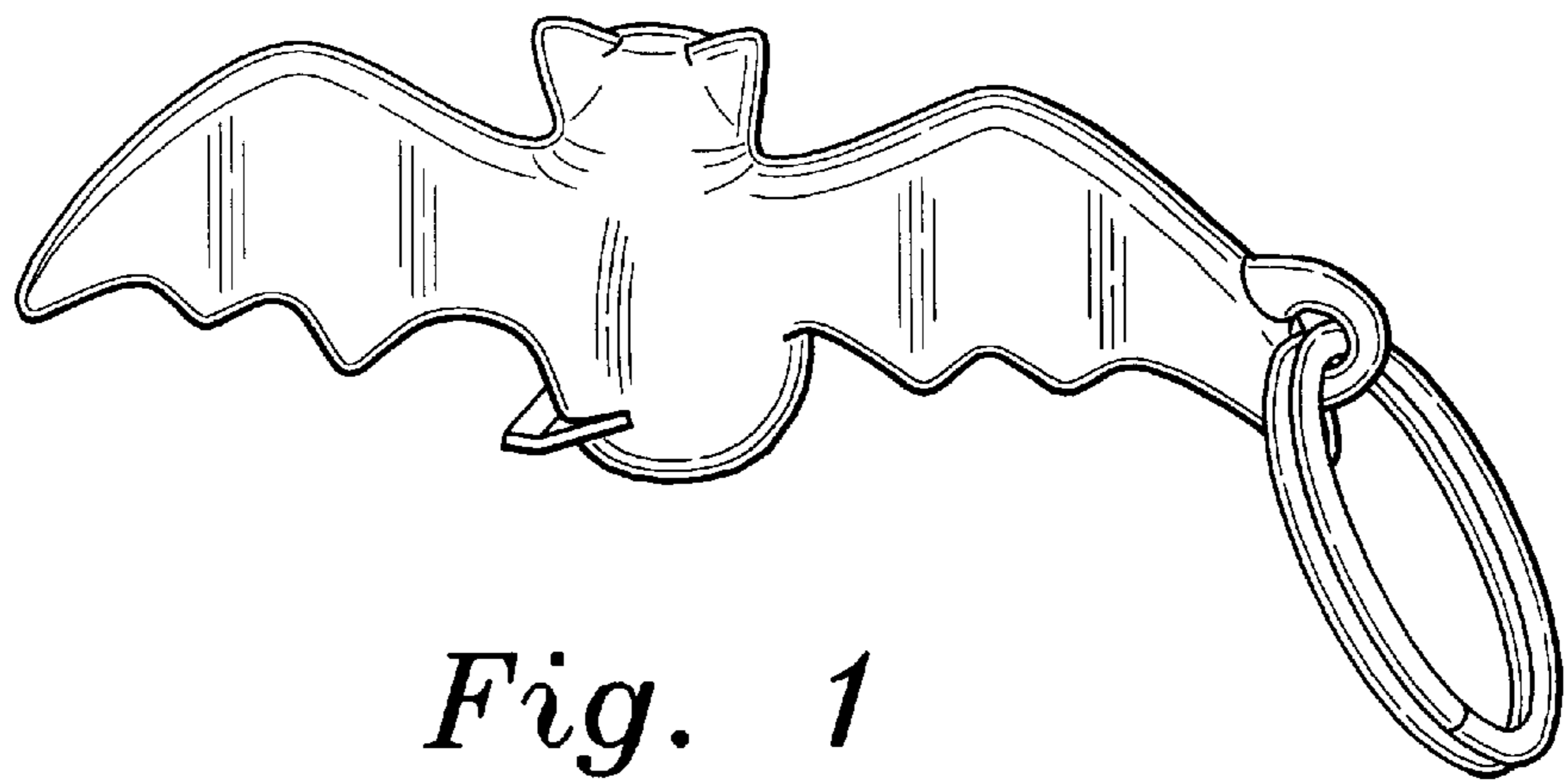

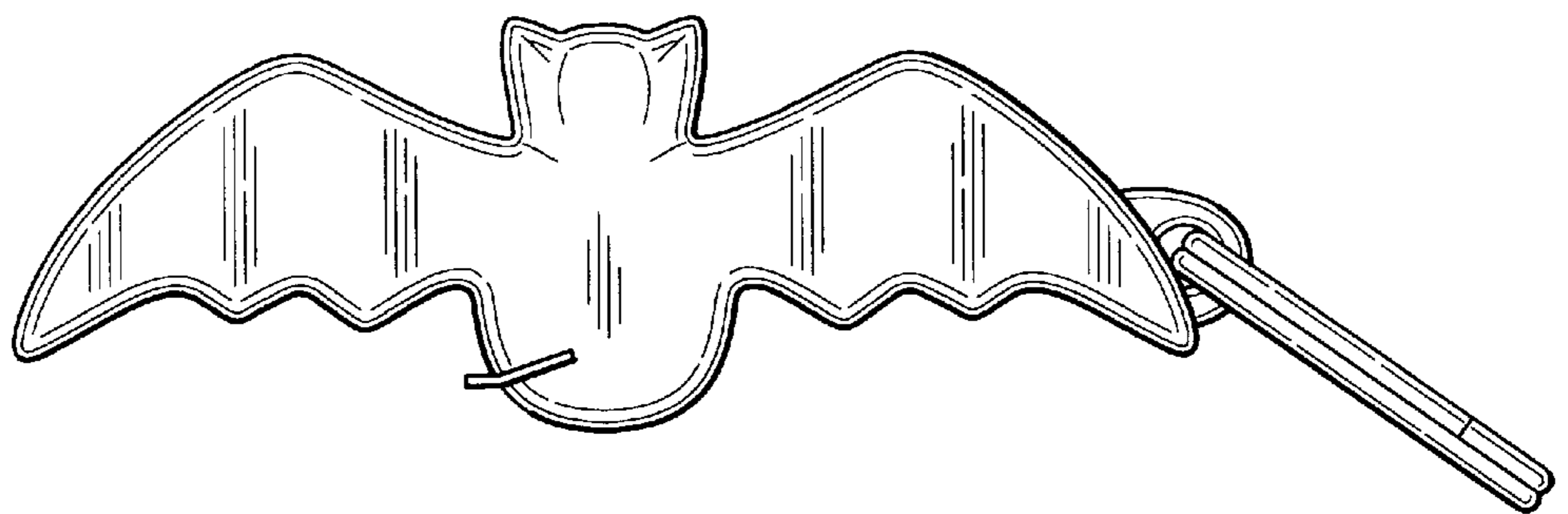

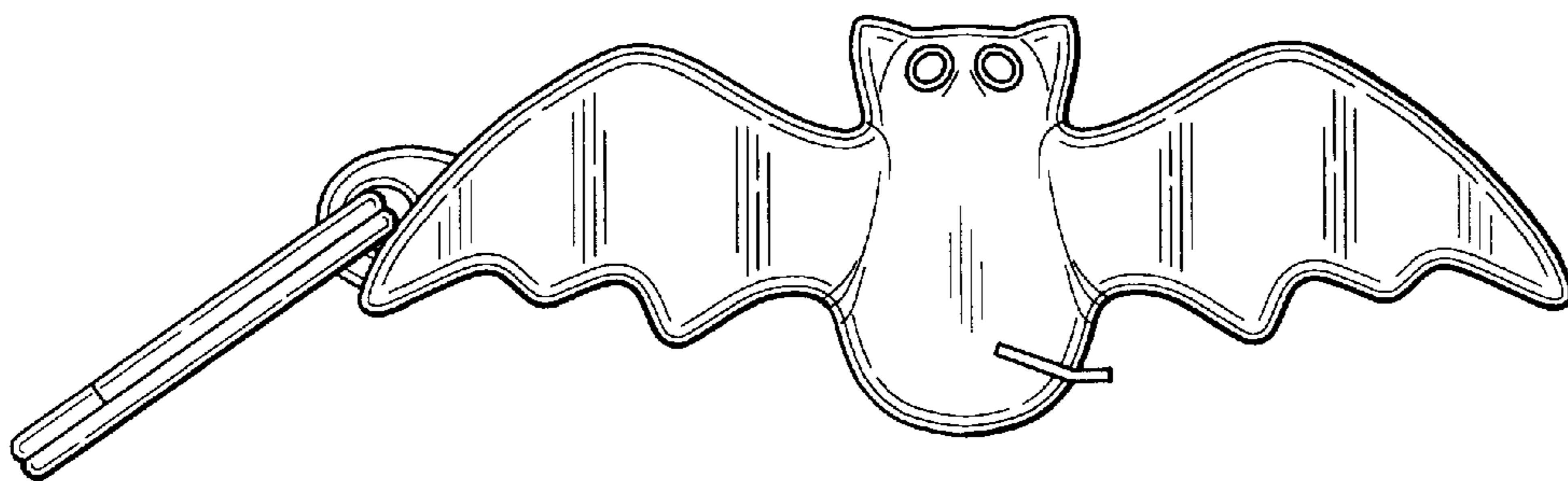




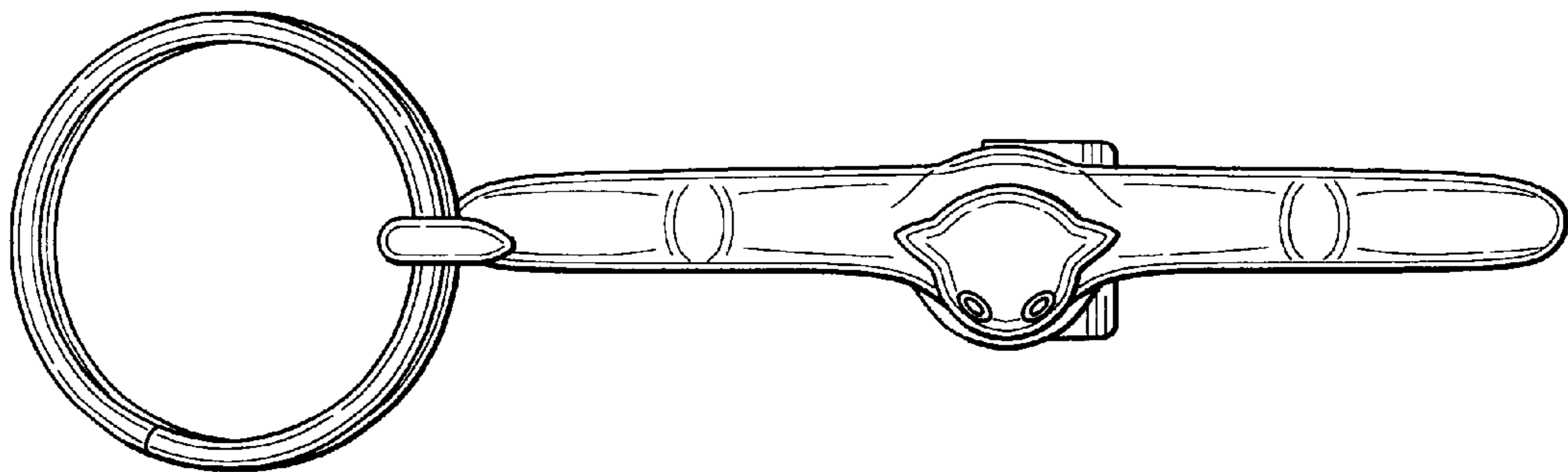

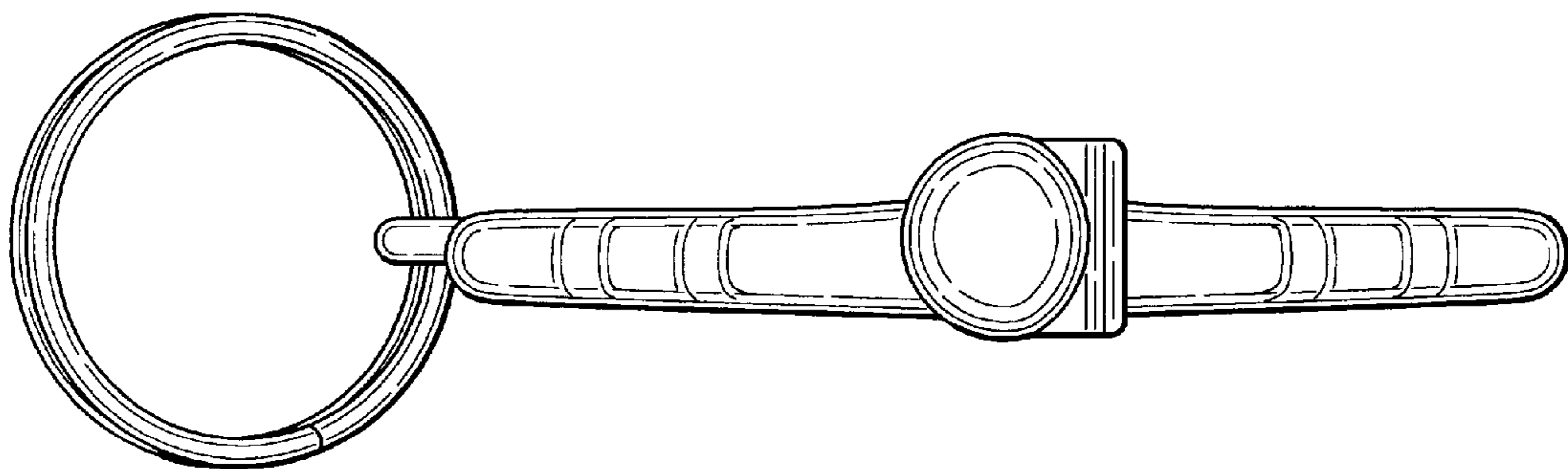

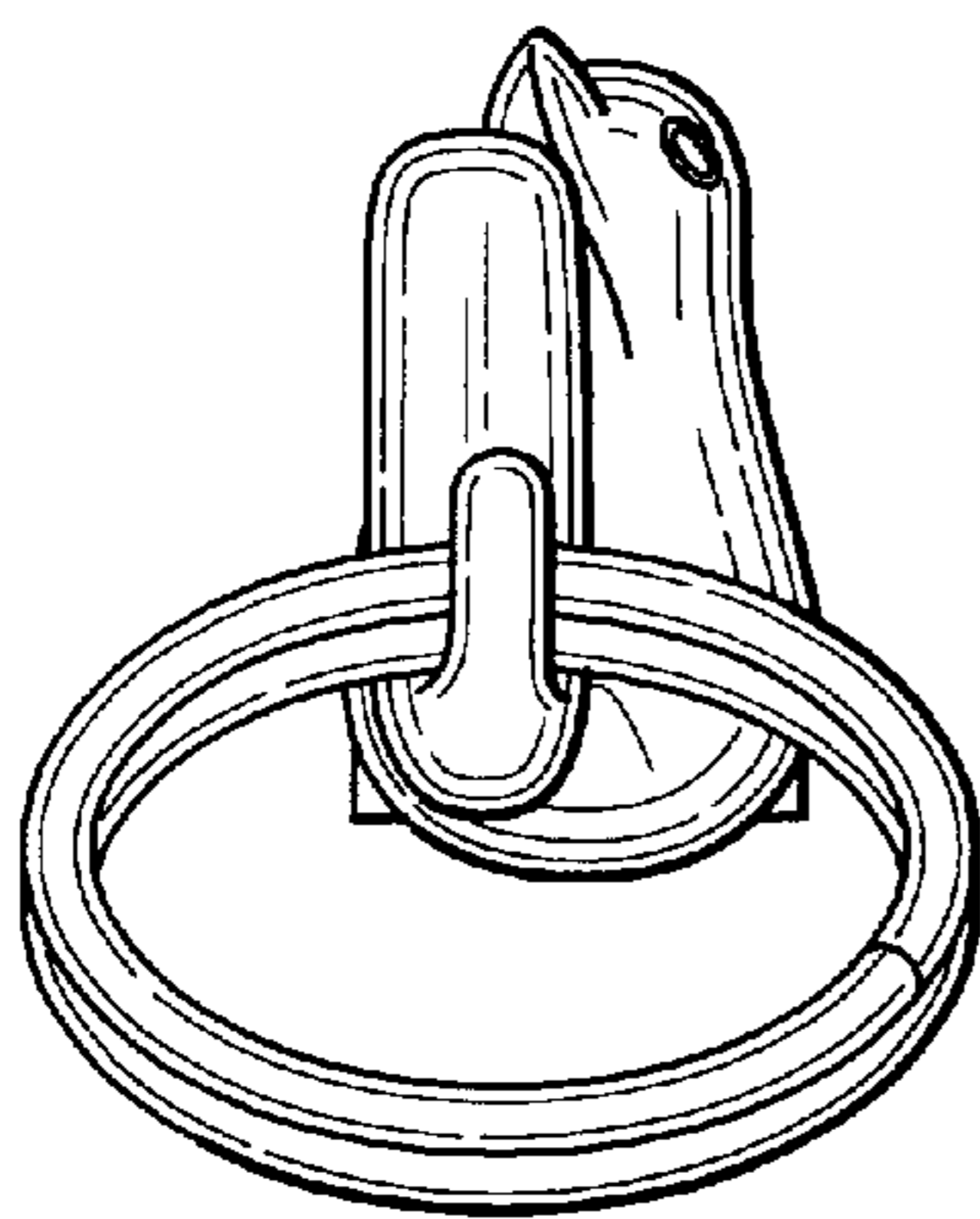

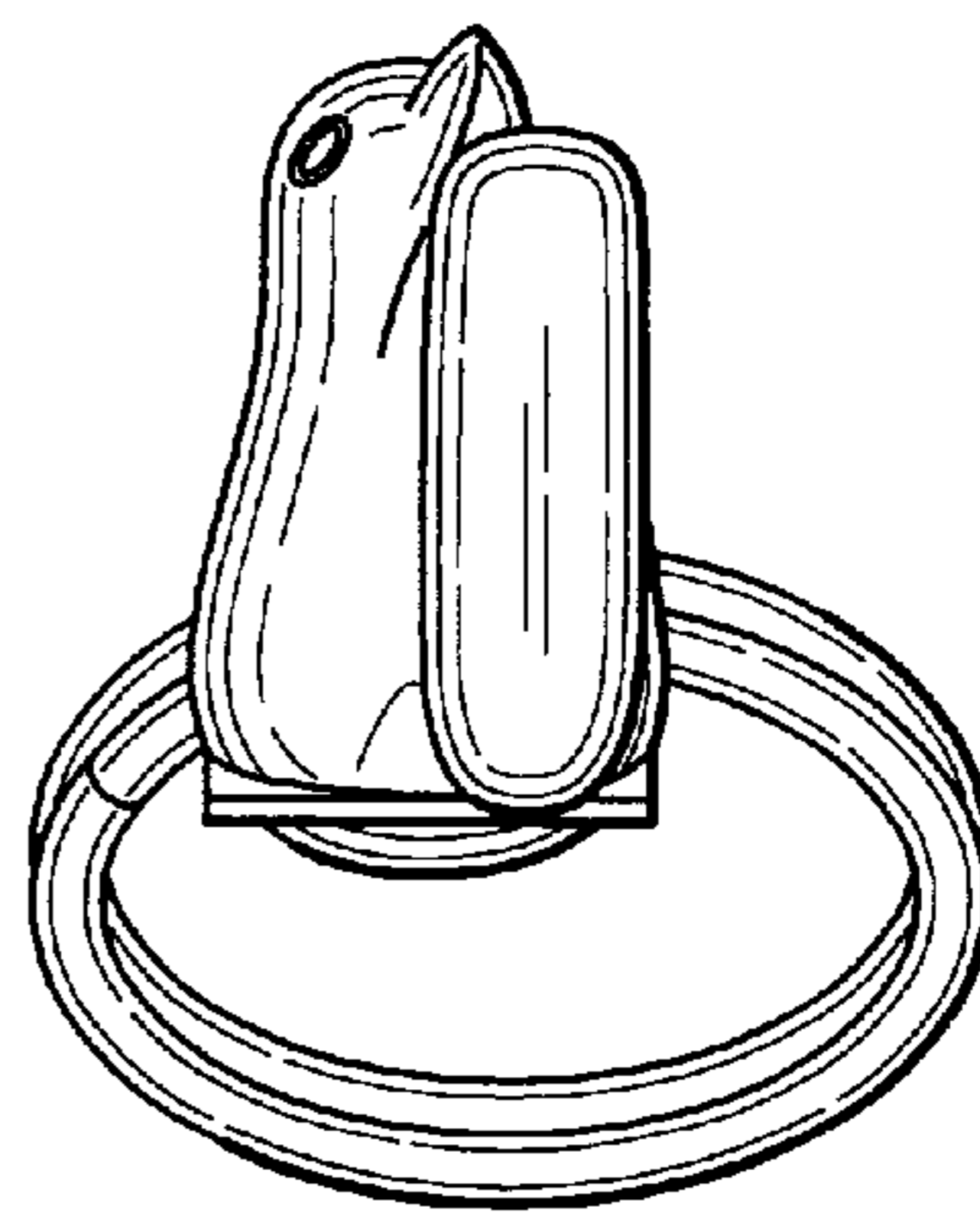
