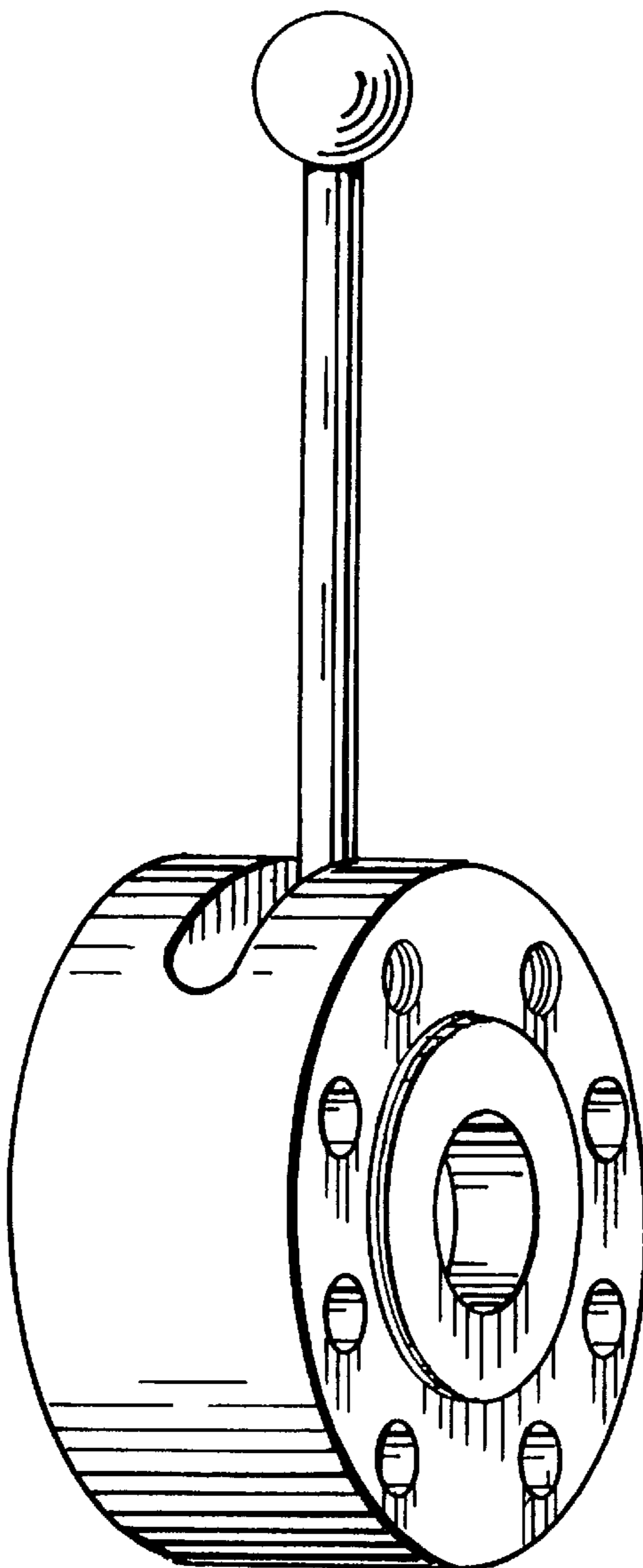
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an in-line fluid flow control valve showing my new design;

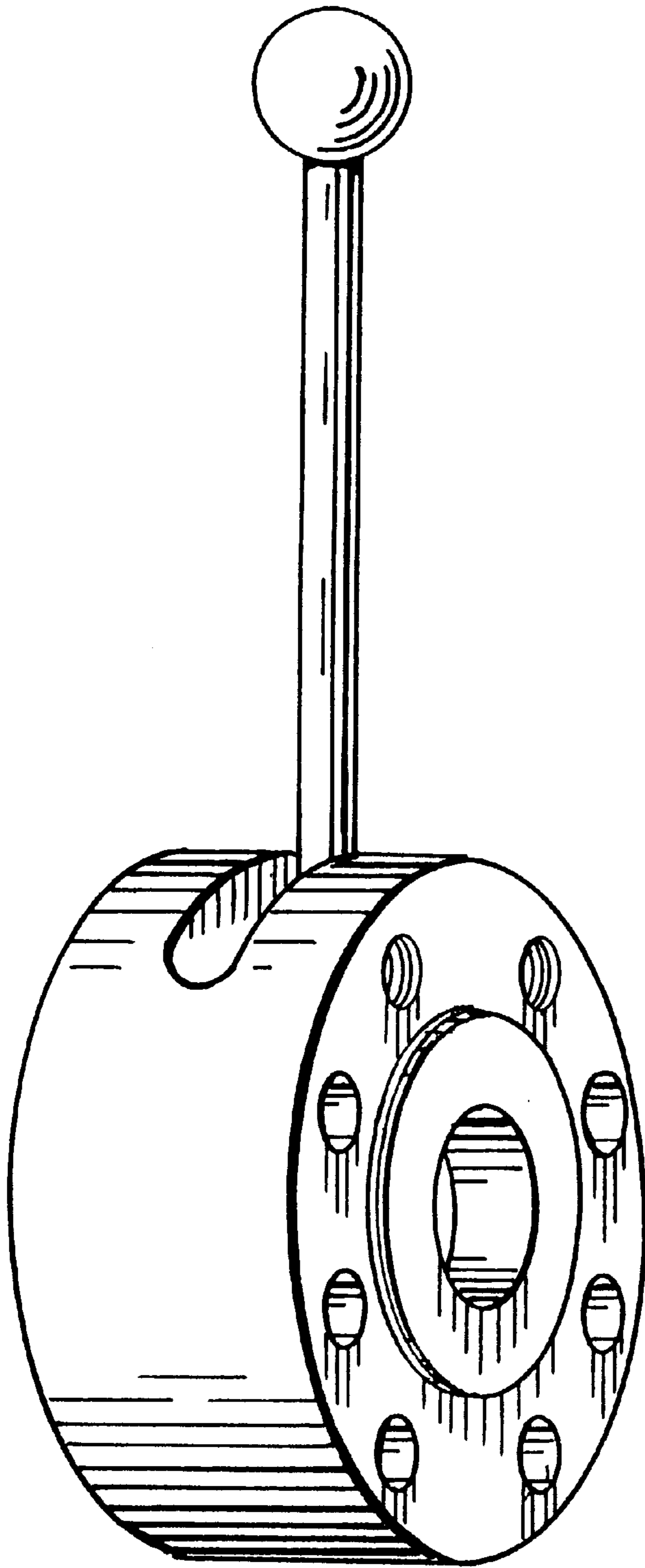

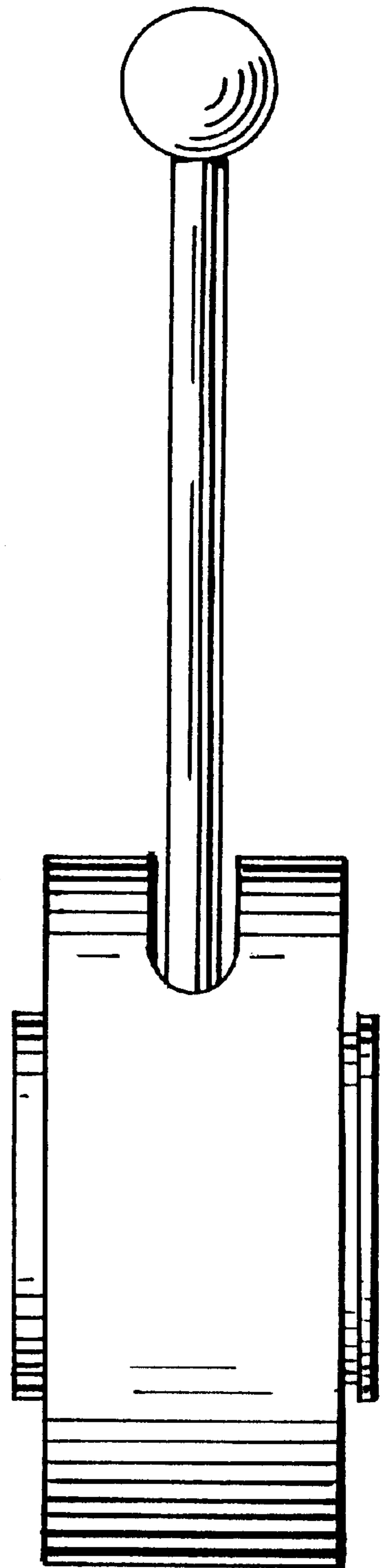

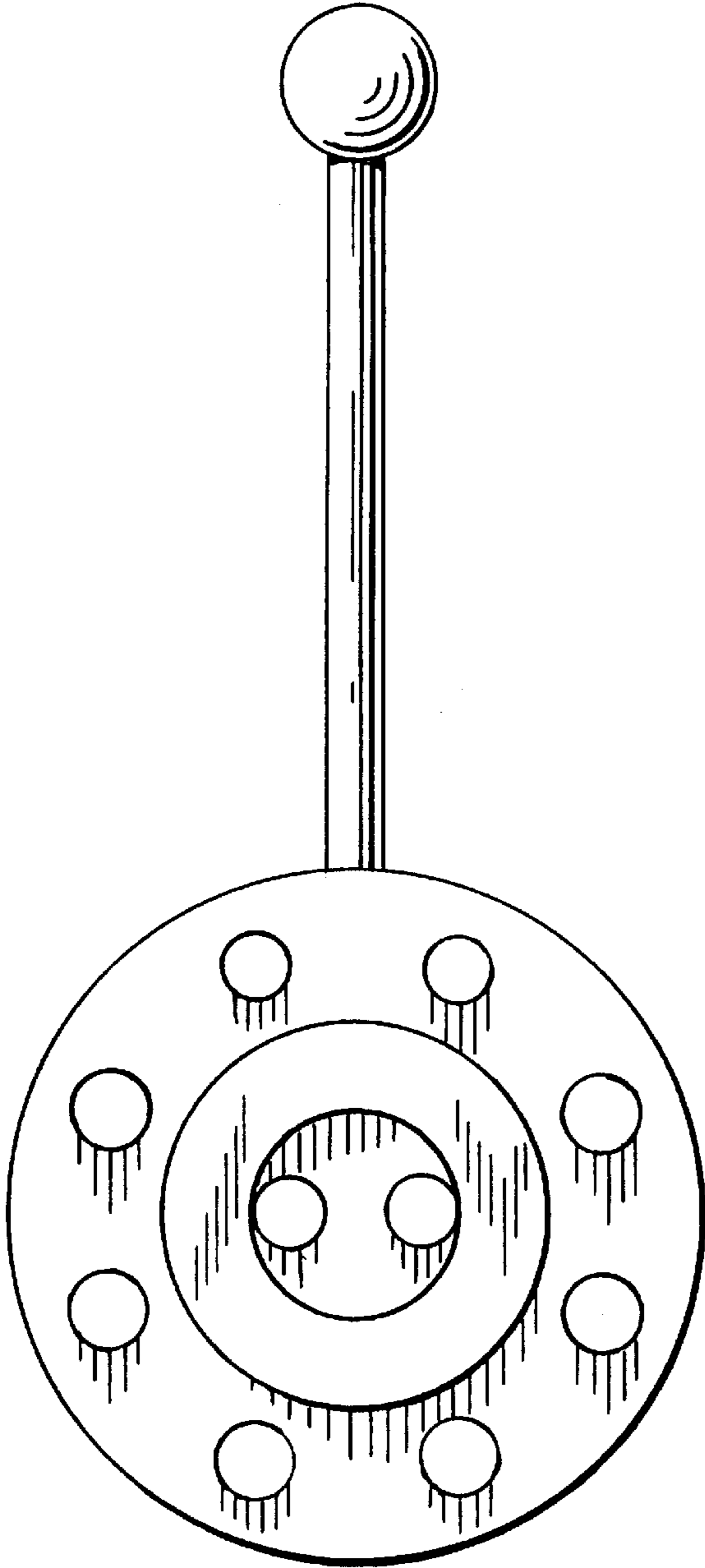

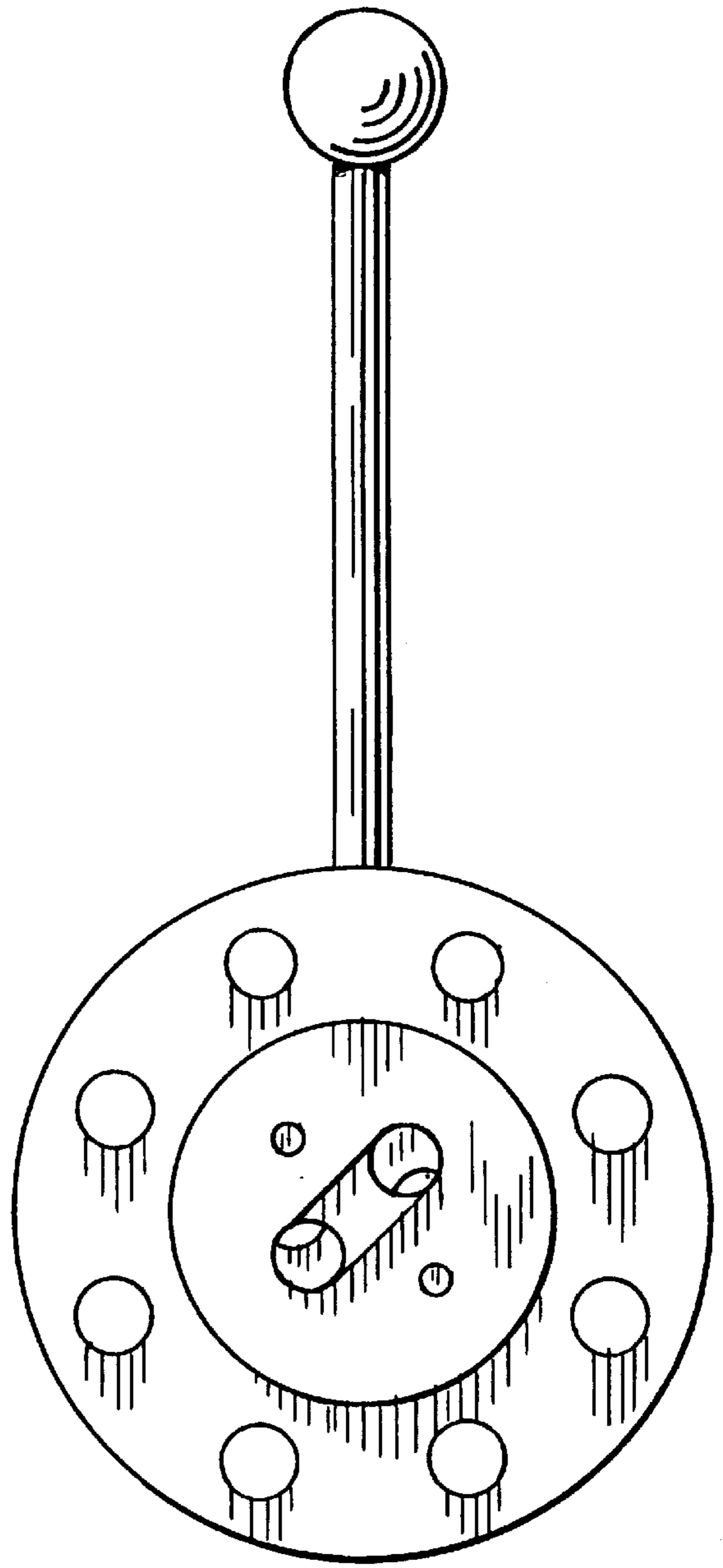

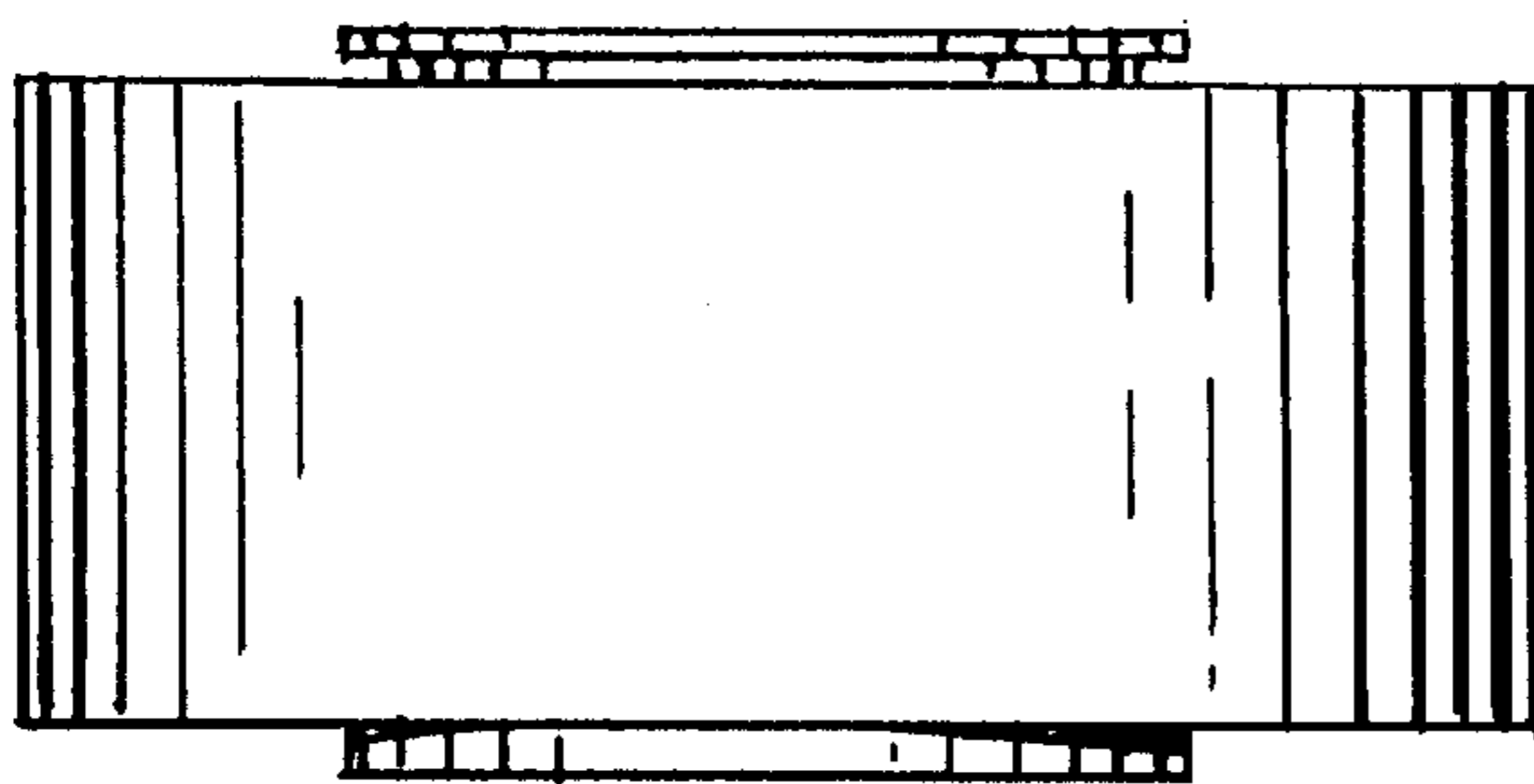

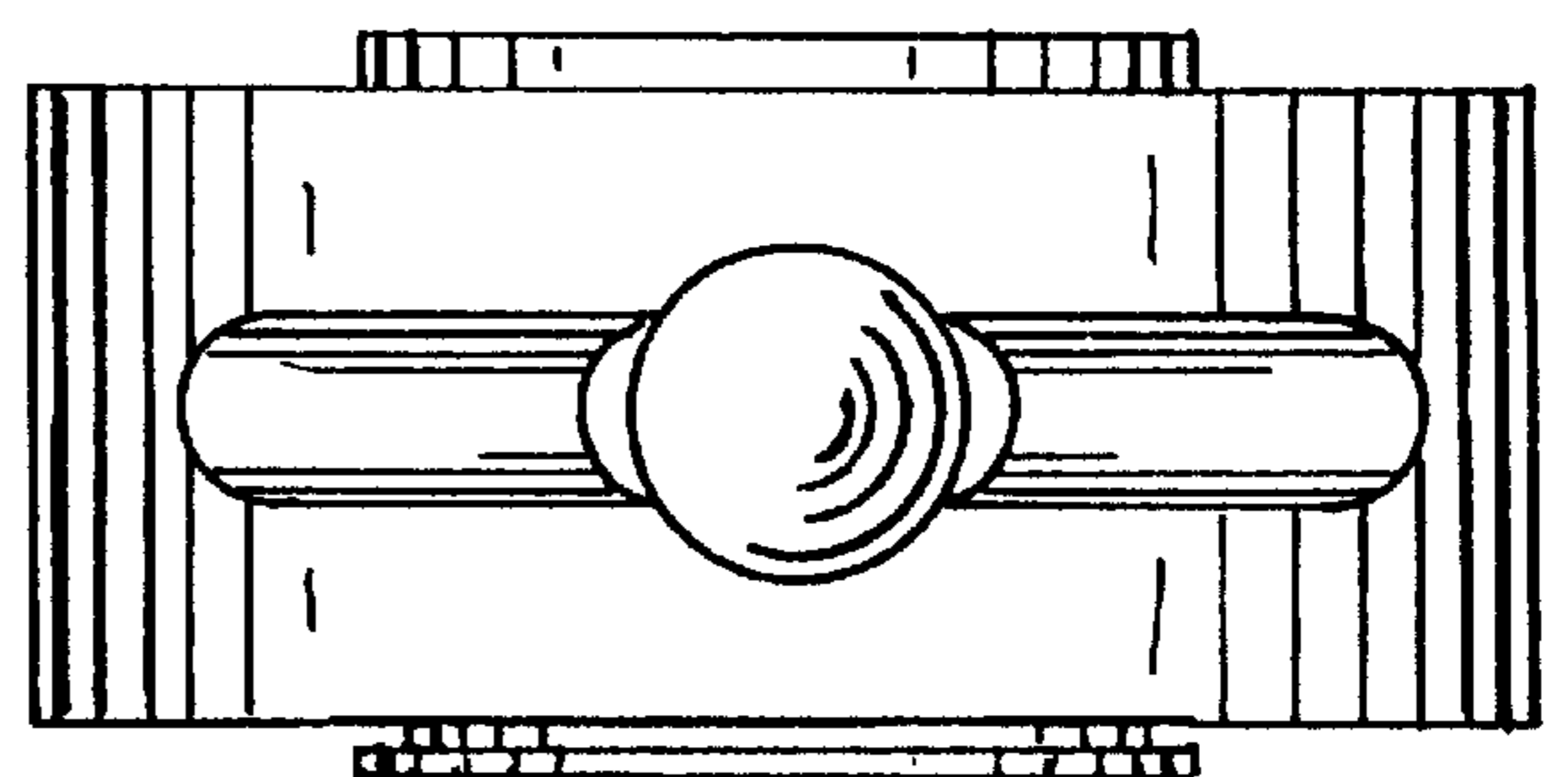
