FIG. 5 is a top plan view of a lighted safety unit of FIG. 1; and,

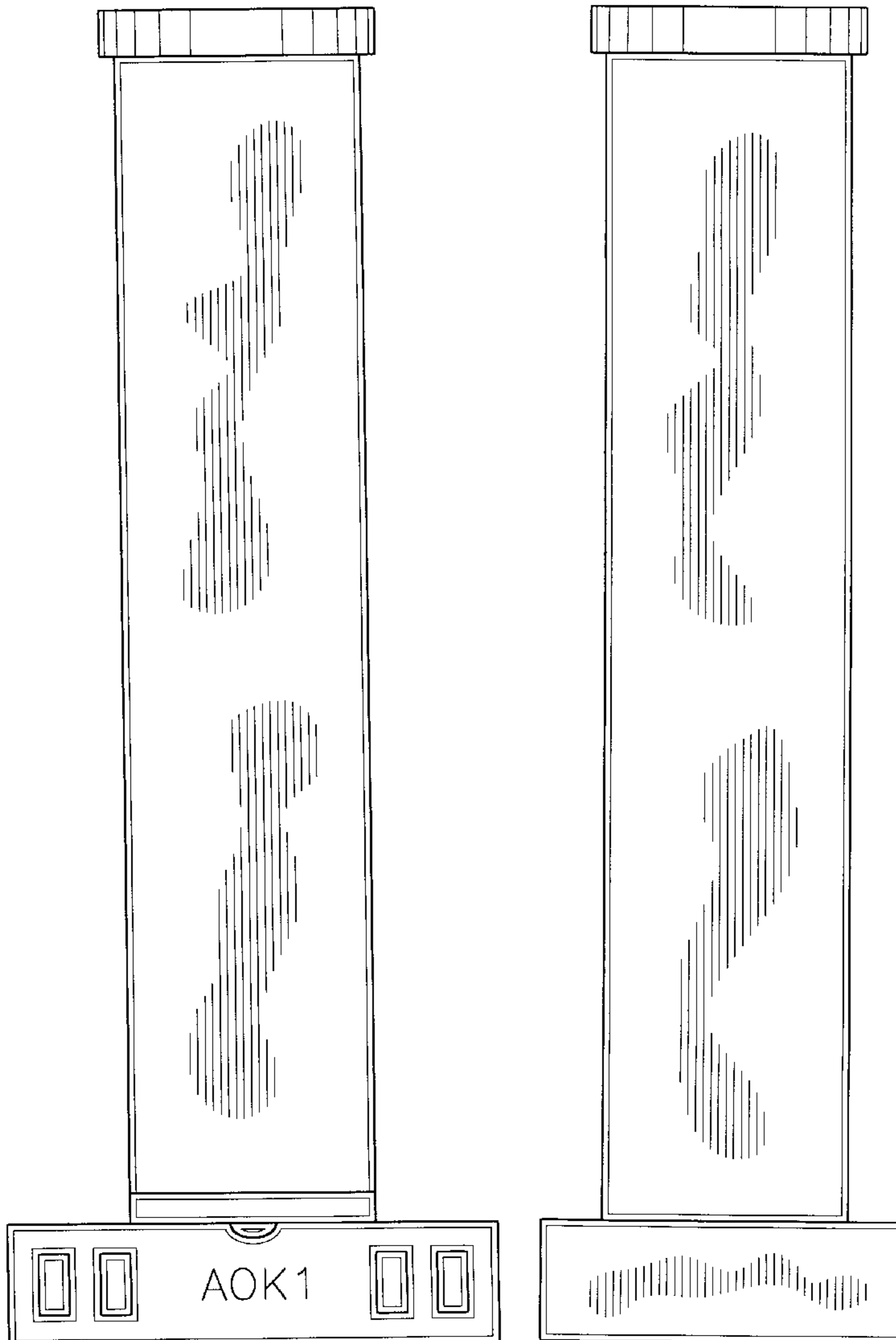
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of a lighted safety unit of FIG. 1.

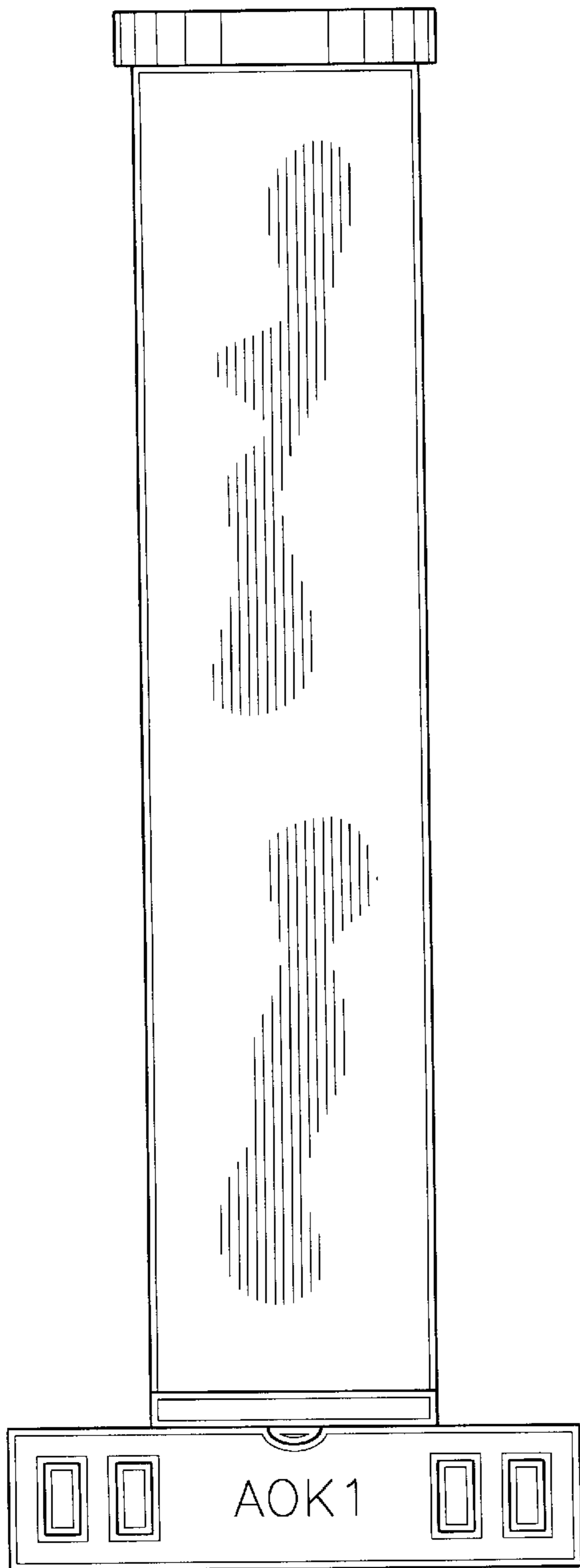

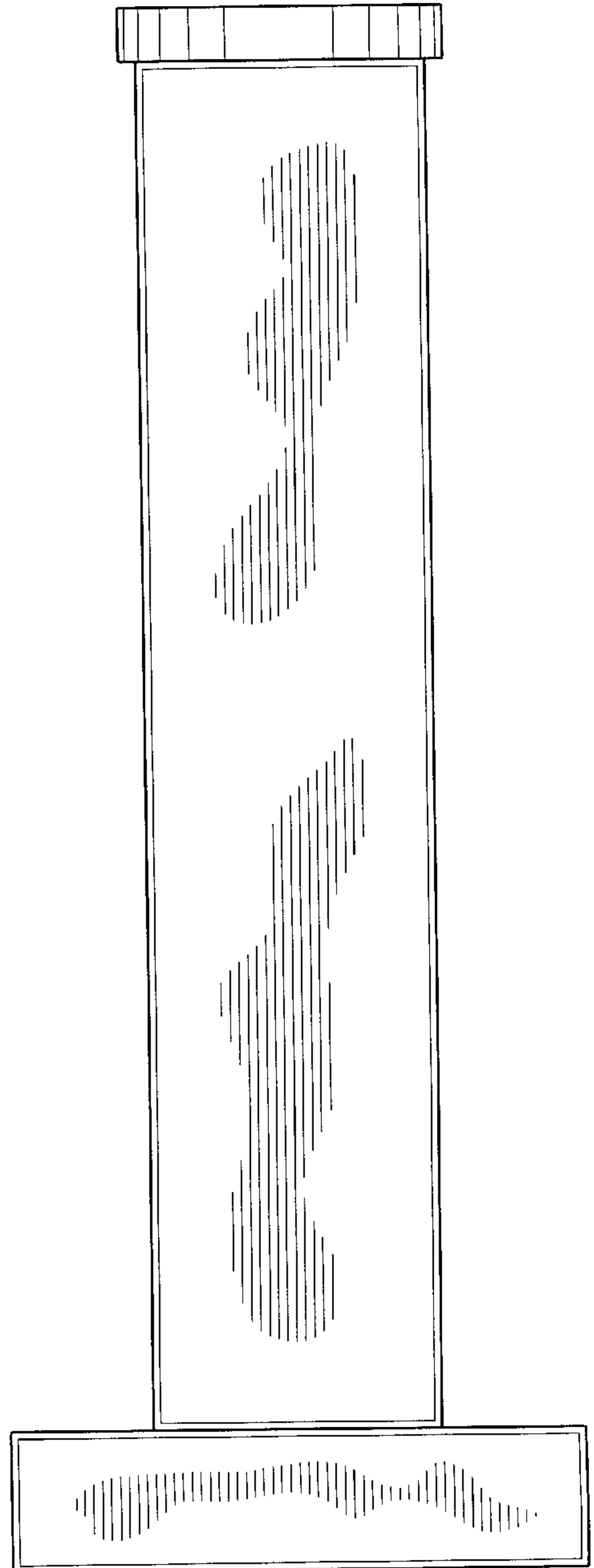

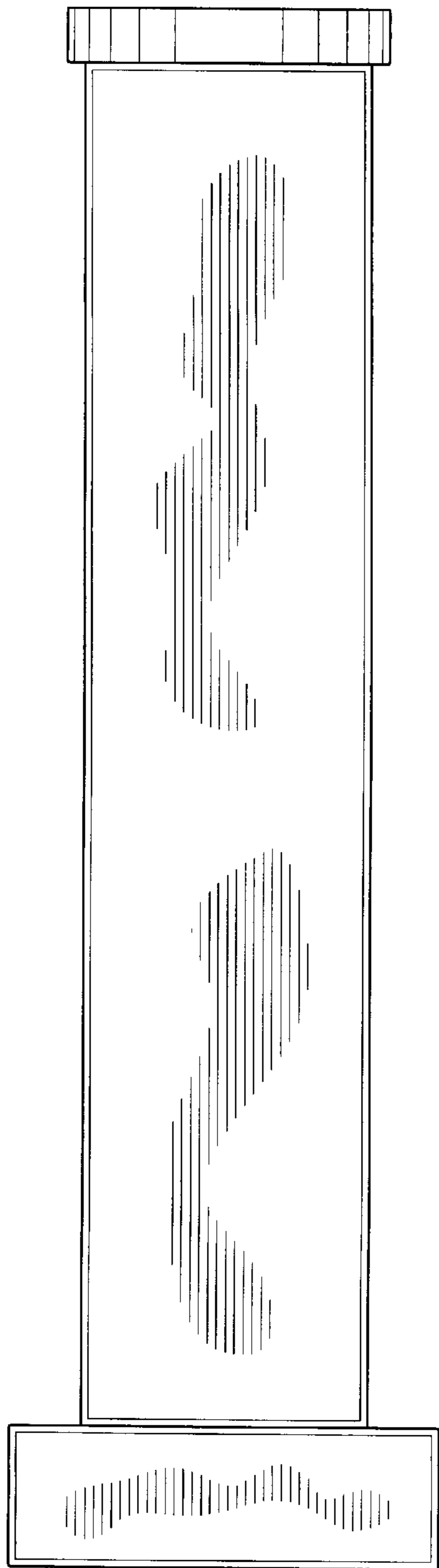

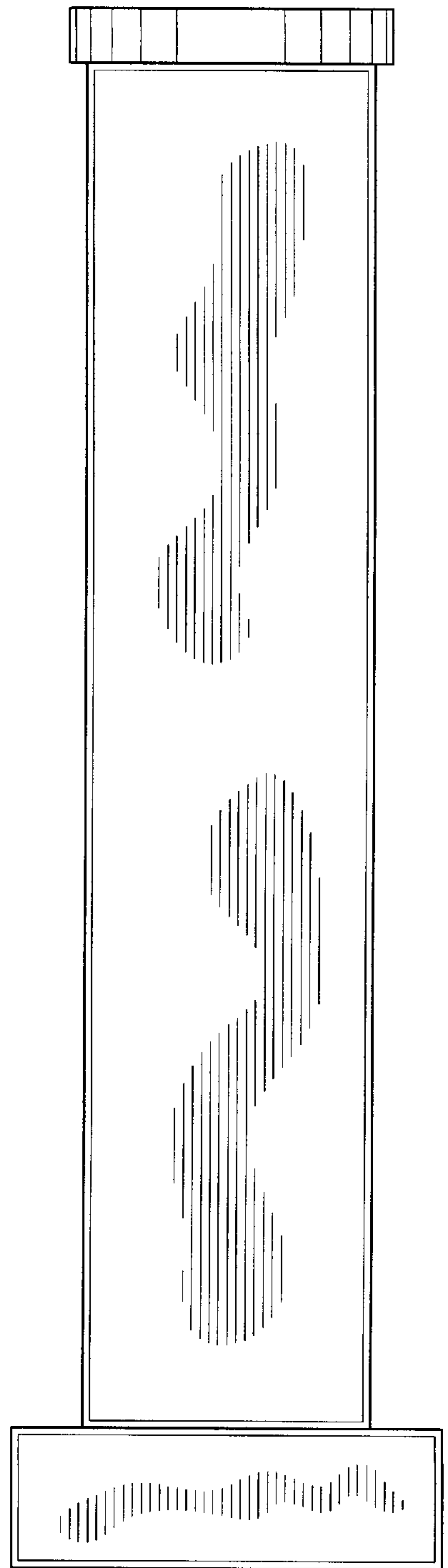

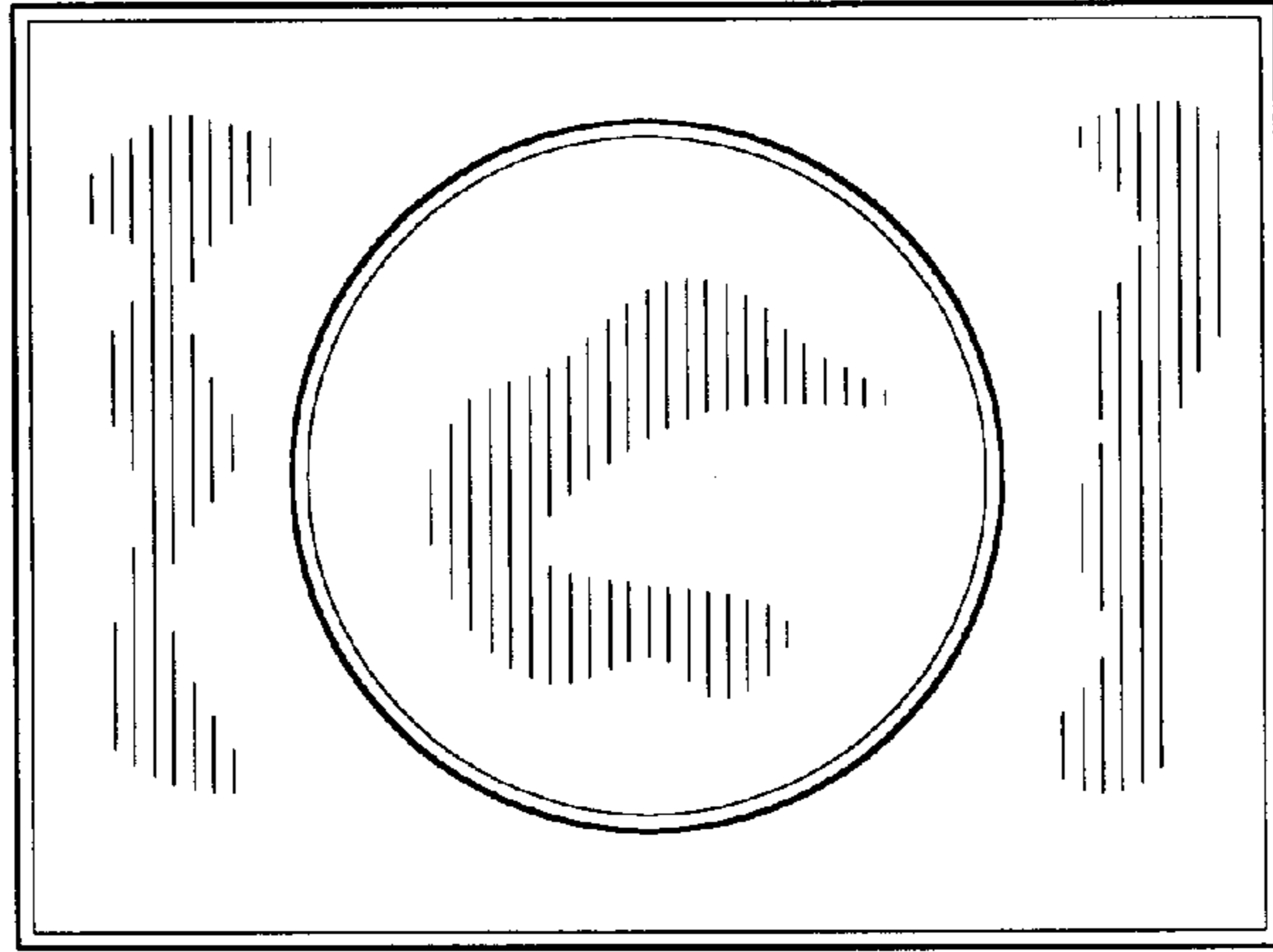

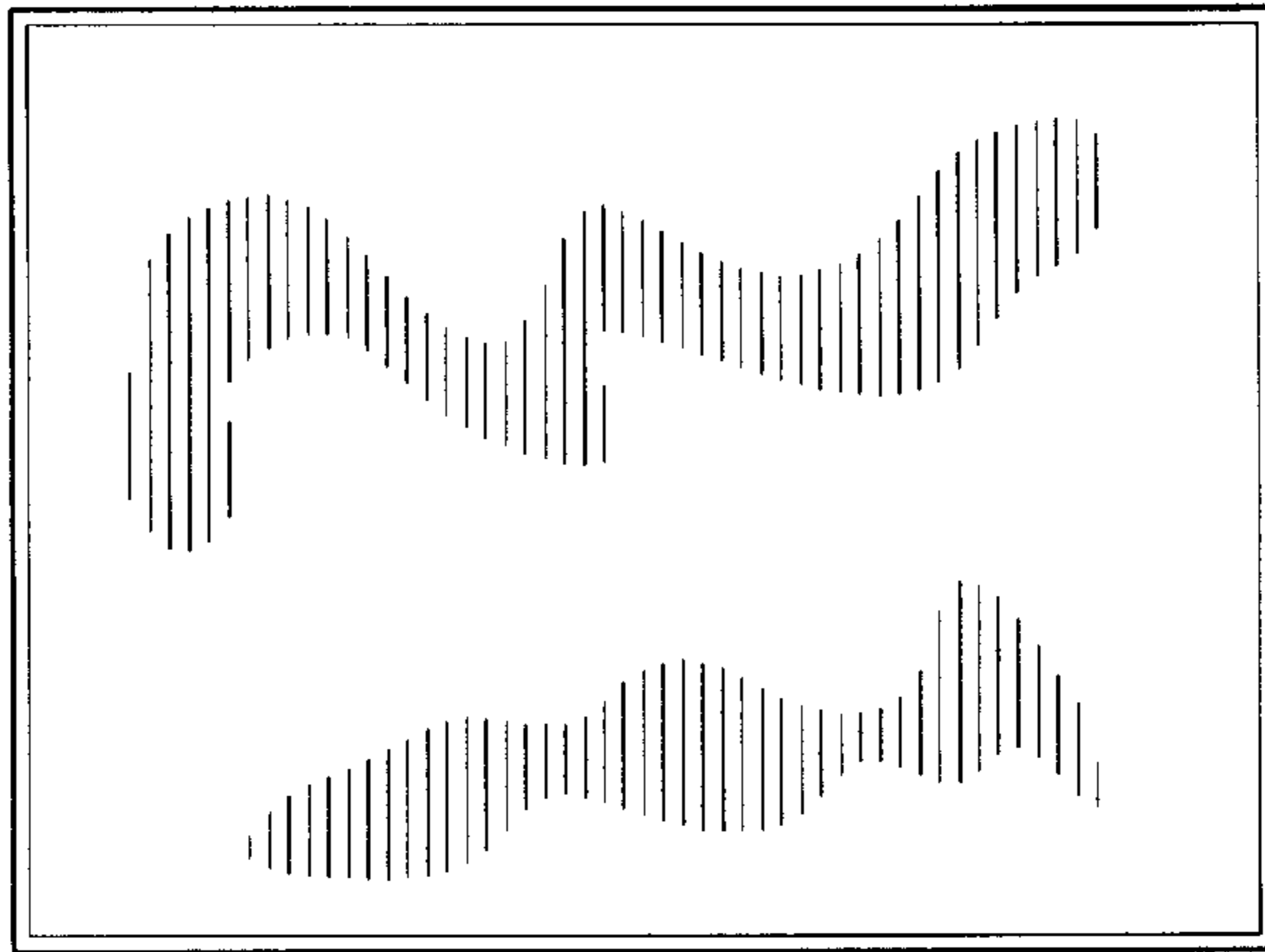
