[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an urn and hanging planter with floral-adorned lip, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a first embodiment of my new design for an urn and hanging planter with floral-adorned lip;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a front view of FIG. 1, the rear view being a mirror image;

FIG. 4 is a side view of FIG. 3, rotated 180°, the opposite side being a mirror image;

FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view taken along line 5—5-in FIG. 4;

FIG. 6 is a perspective view showing a second embodiment of the urn and hanging planter with floral-adorned lip;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view of the hanging planter shown in FIG. 6;

FIG. 8 is a front view of FIG. 6, the rear view being a mirror image;

FIG. 9 is a side view of FIG. 6, rotated 180°, the opposite side being a mirror image; and,

FIG. 10 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 6.

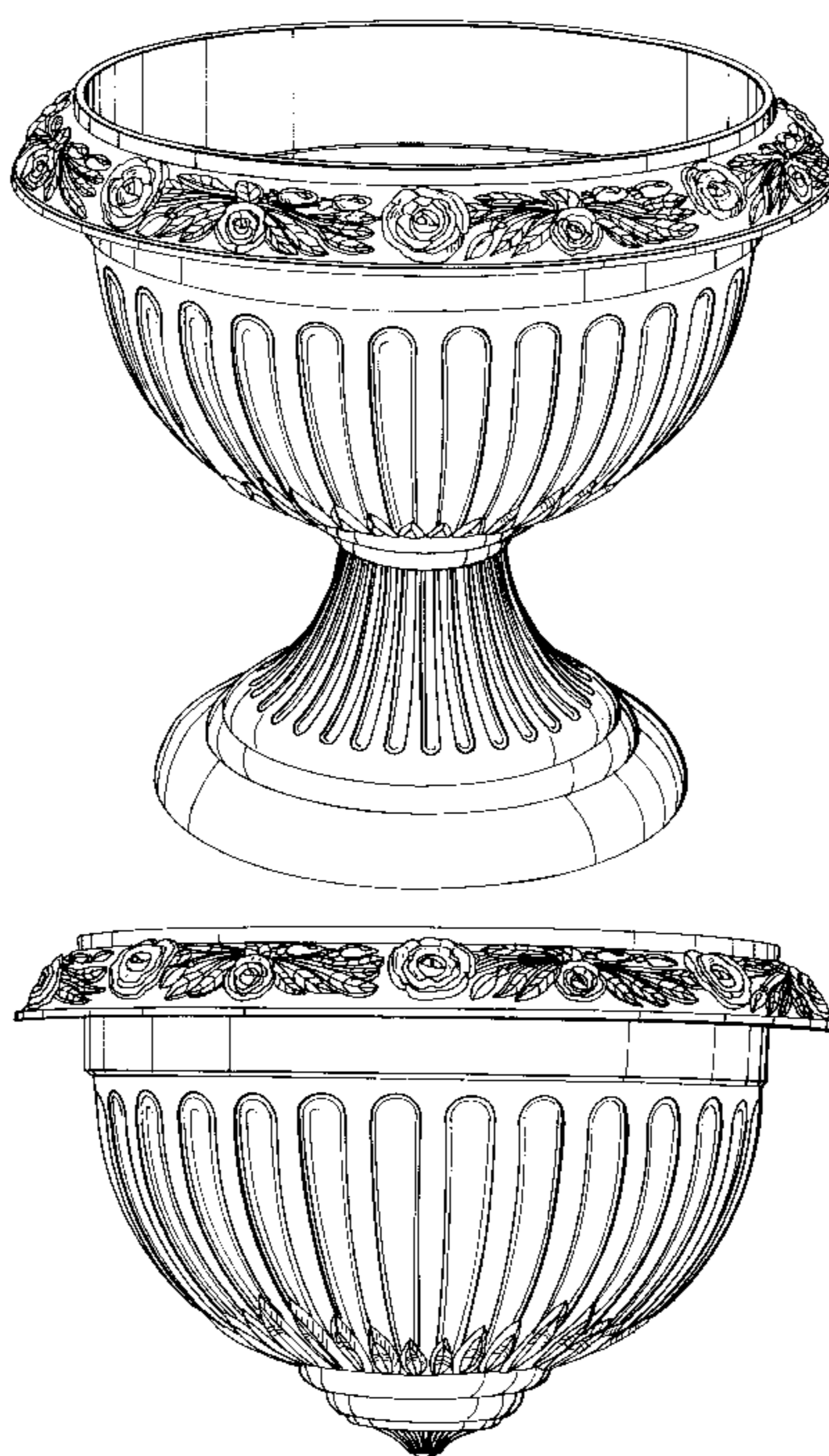

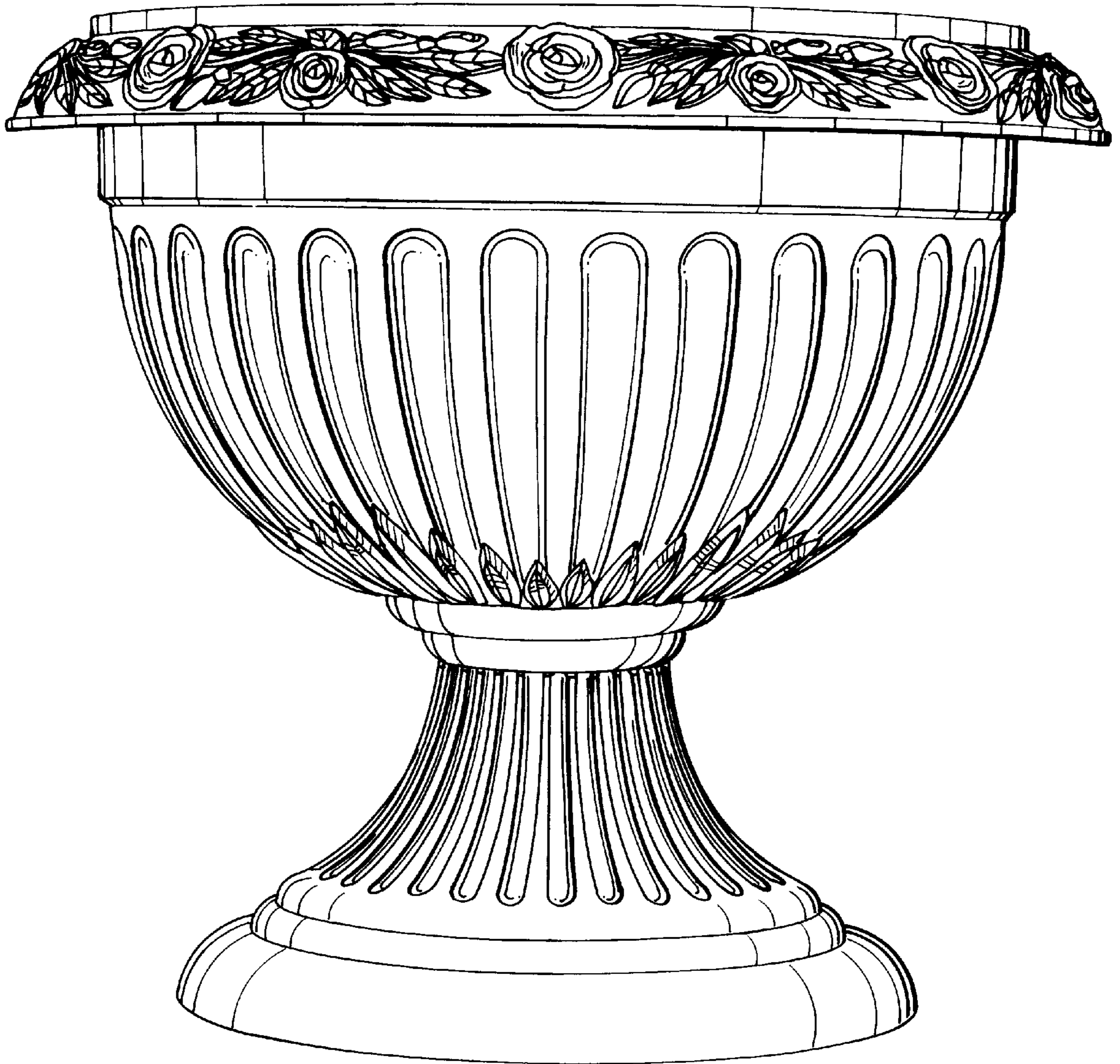

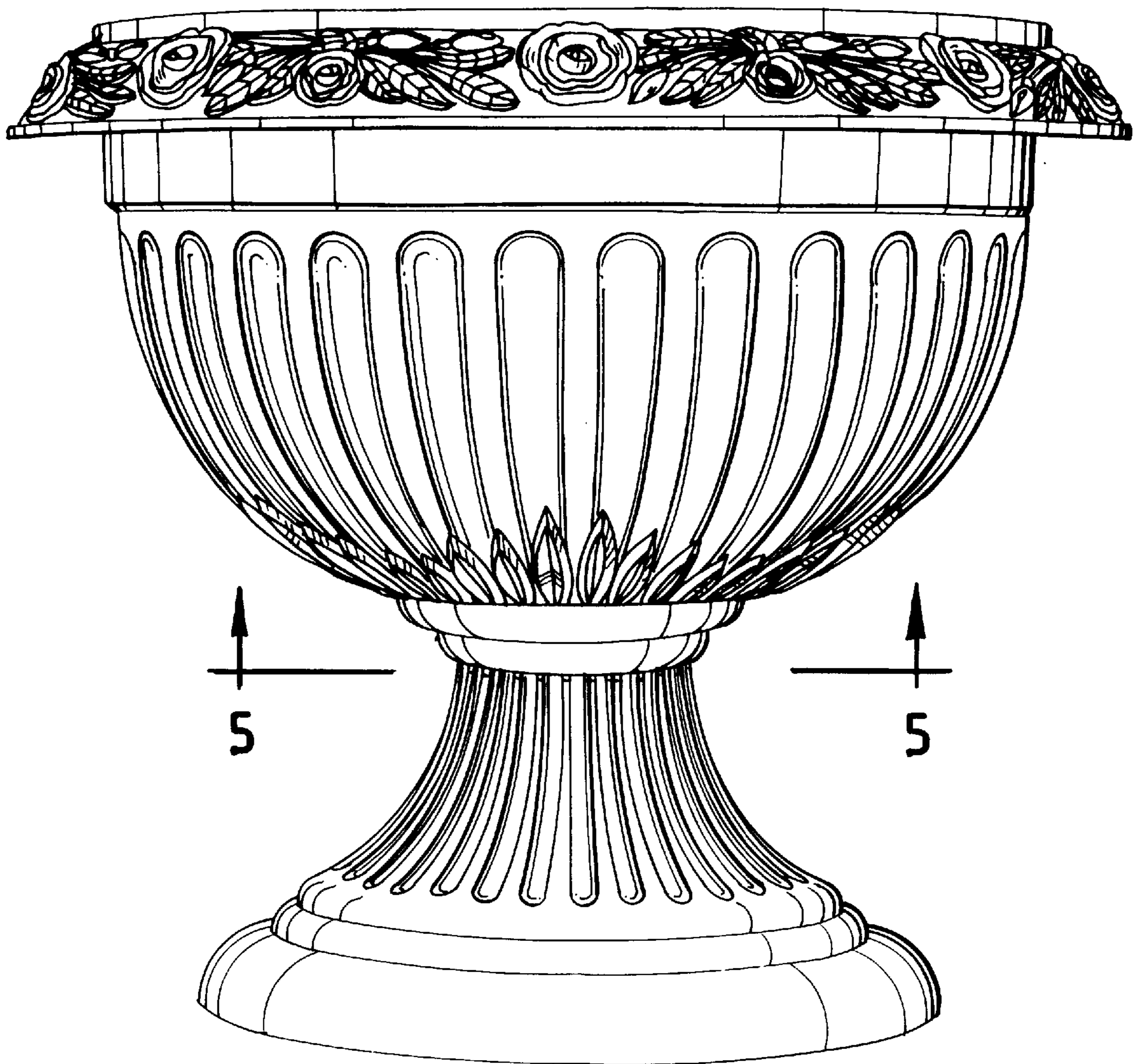

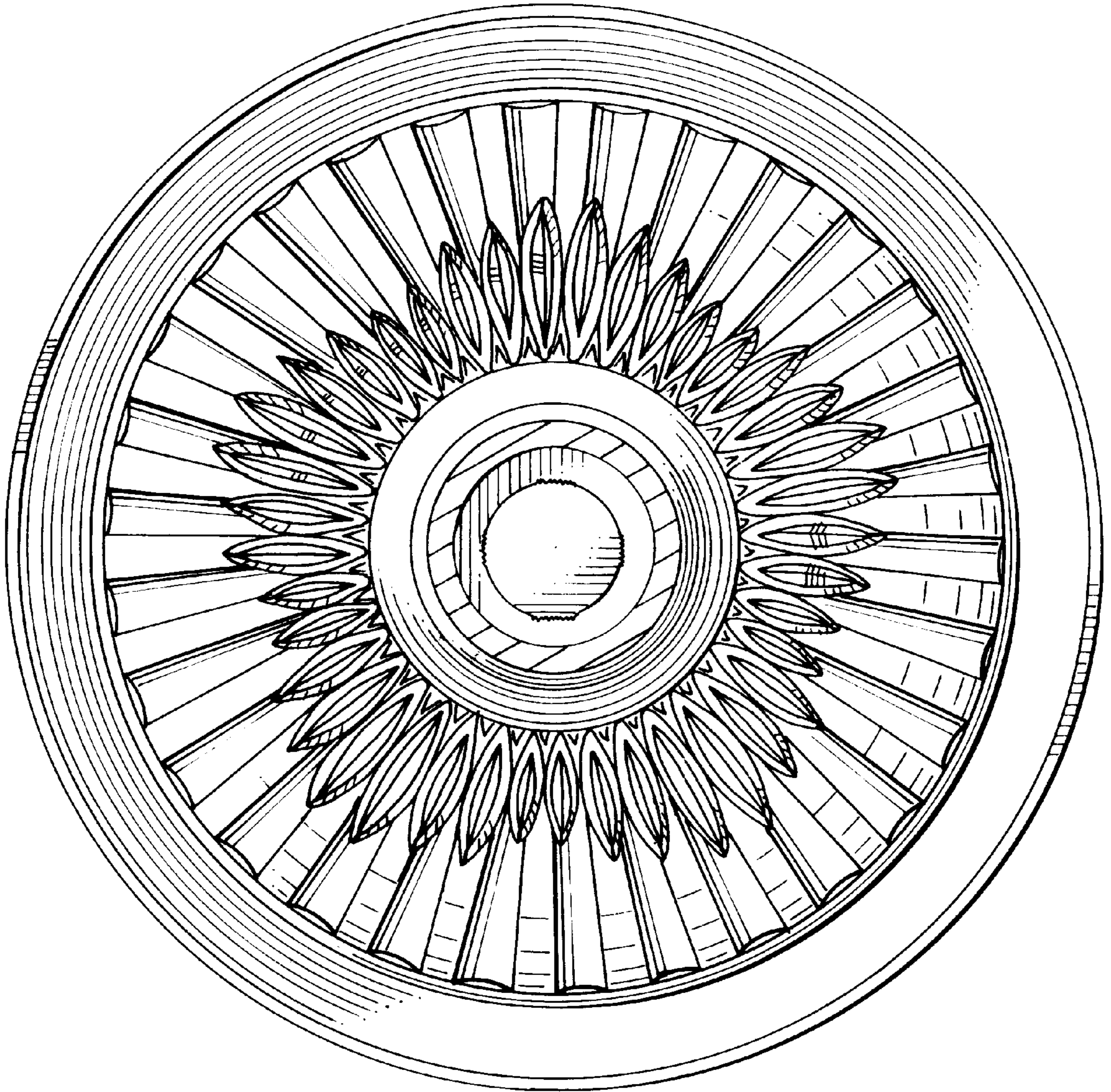

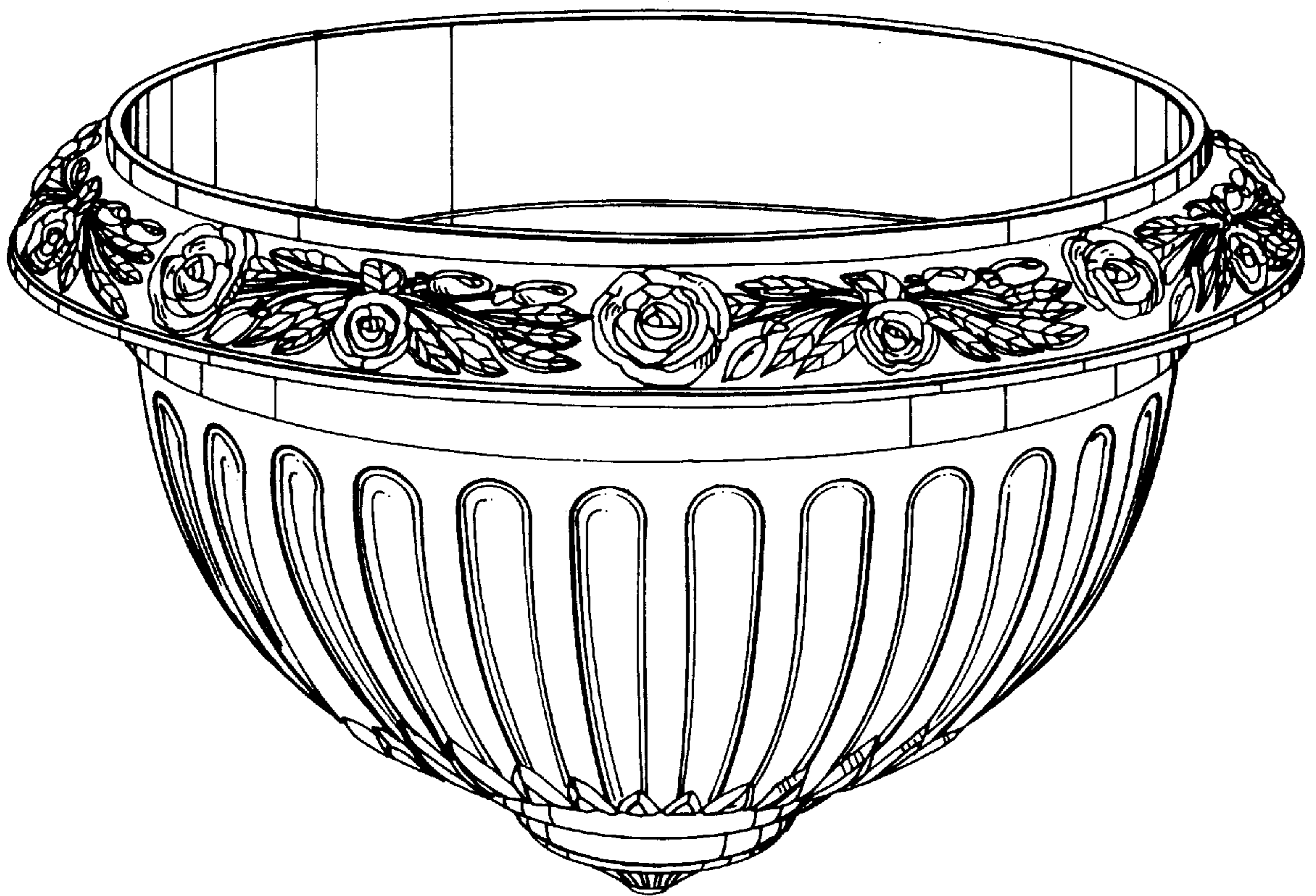

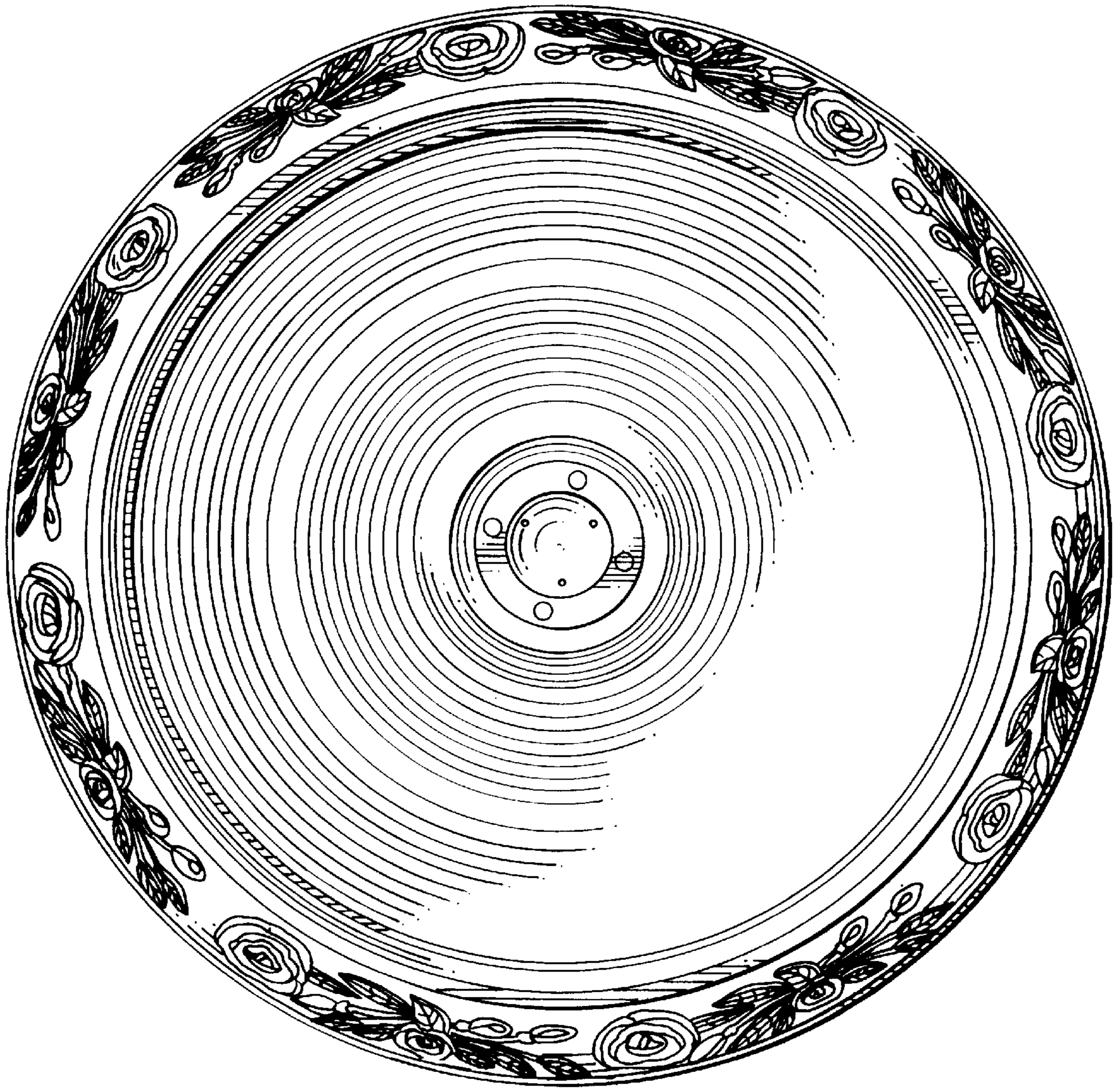

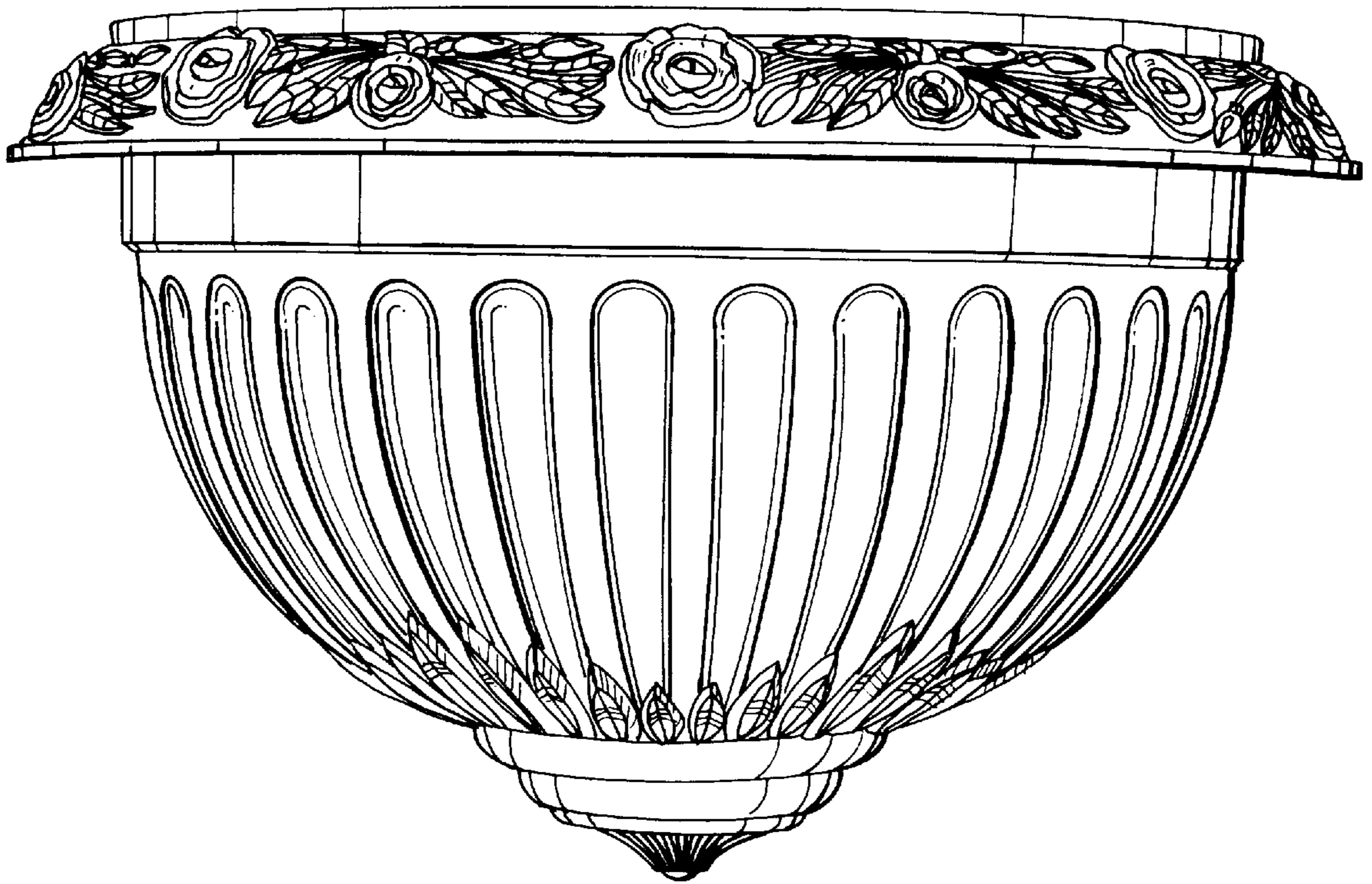

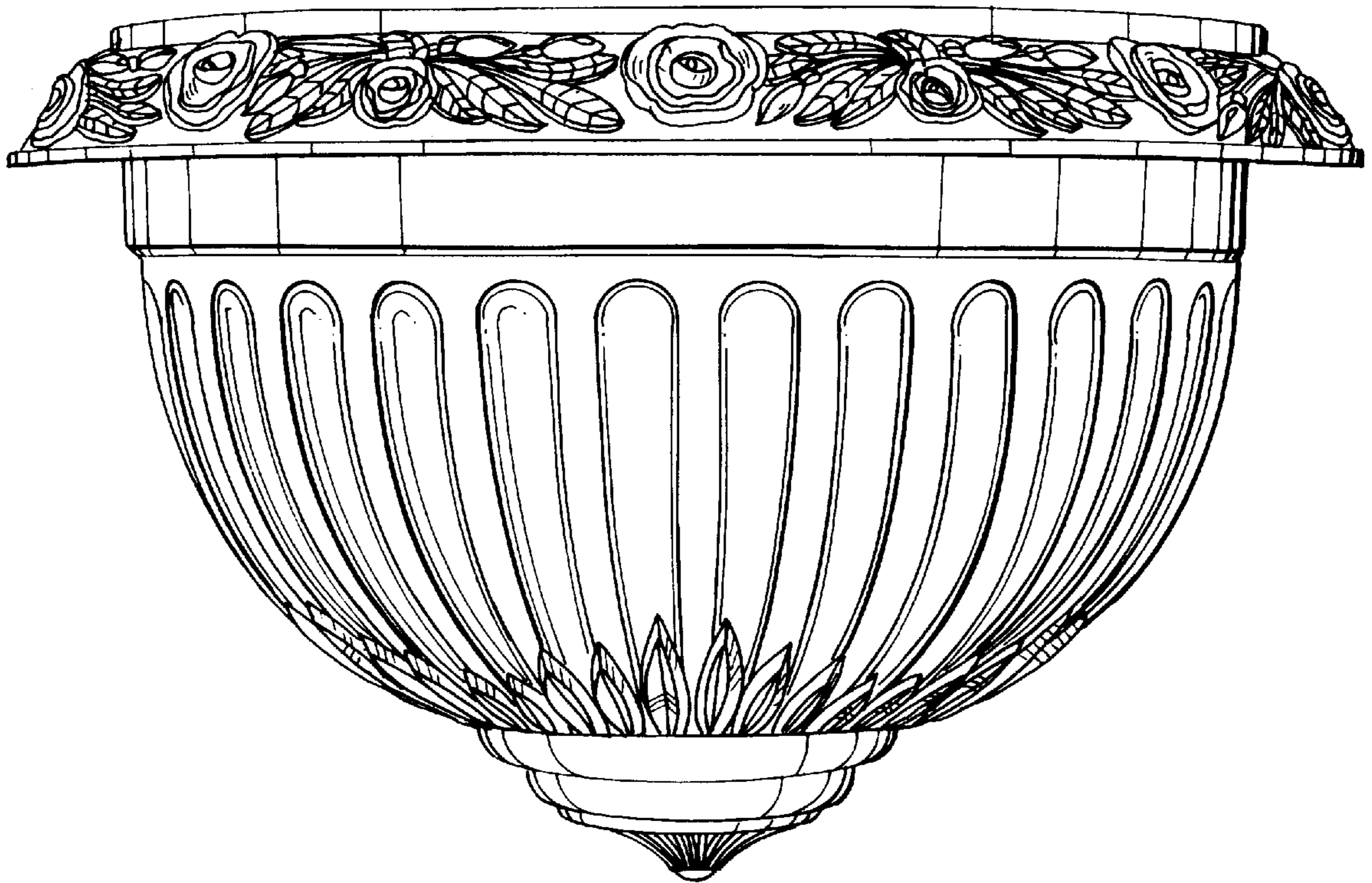
