FIG. 6 is a perspective view of the rear left of an exterior surface configuration of a vehicle according to our novel design;


FIG. 7 is a perspective view of the rear right of an exterior surface configuration of a vehicle according to our novel design;


FIG. 8 is a rear view of an exterior surface configuration of a vehicle according to our novel design; and,

FIG. 9 is a top view of an exterior surface configuration of a vehicle according to our novel design.














