FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof;

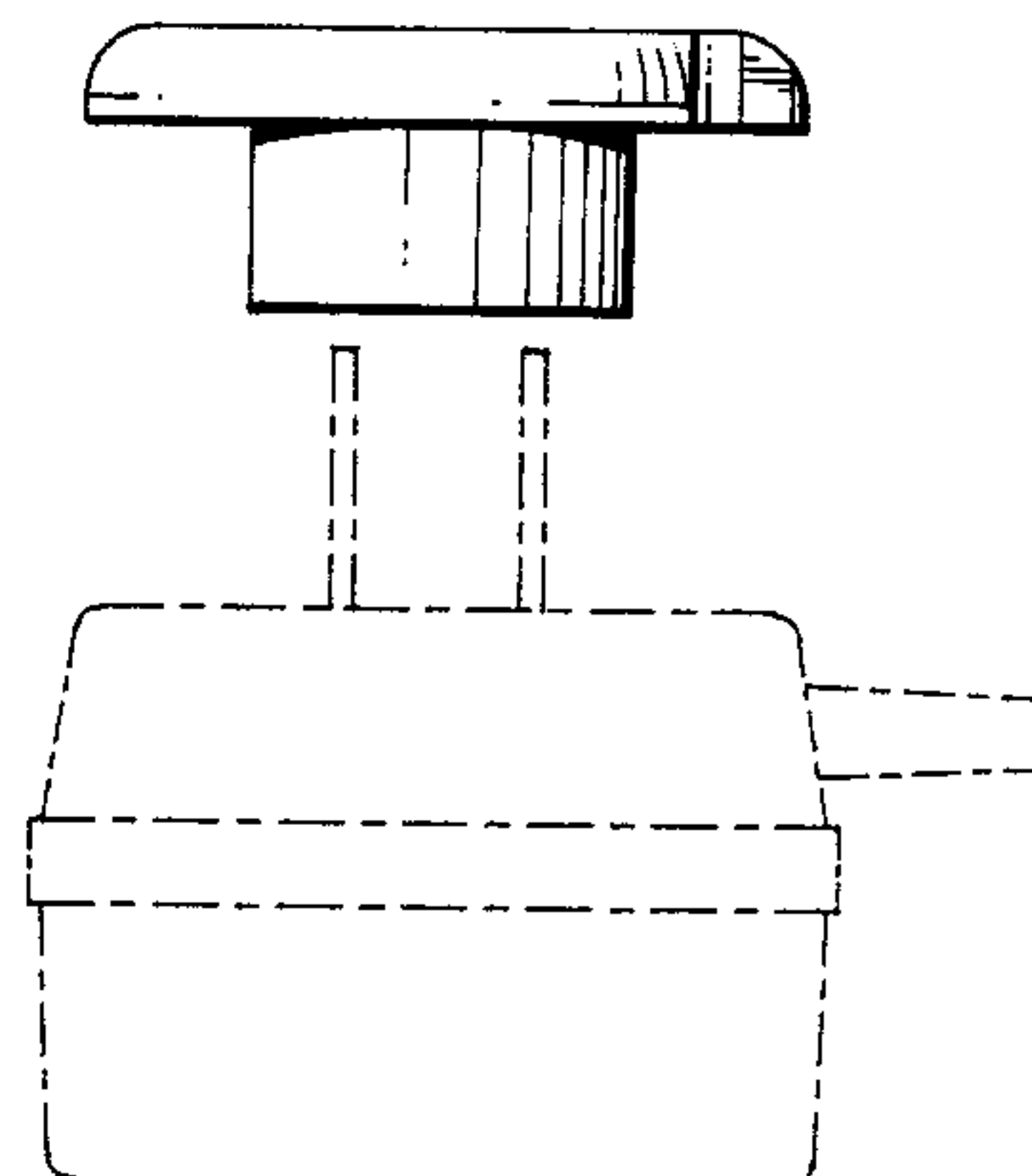
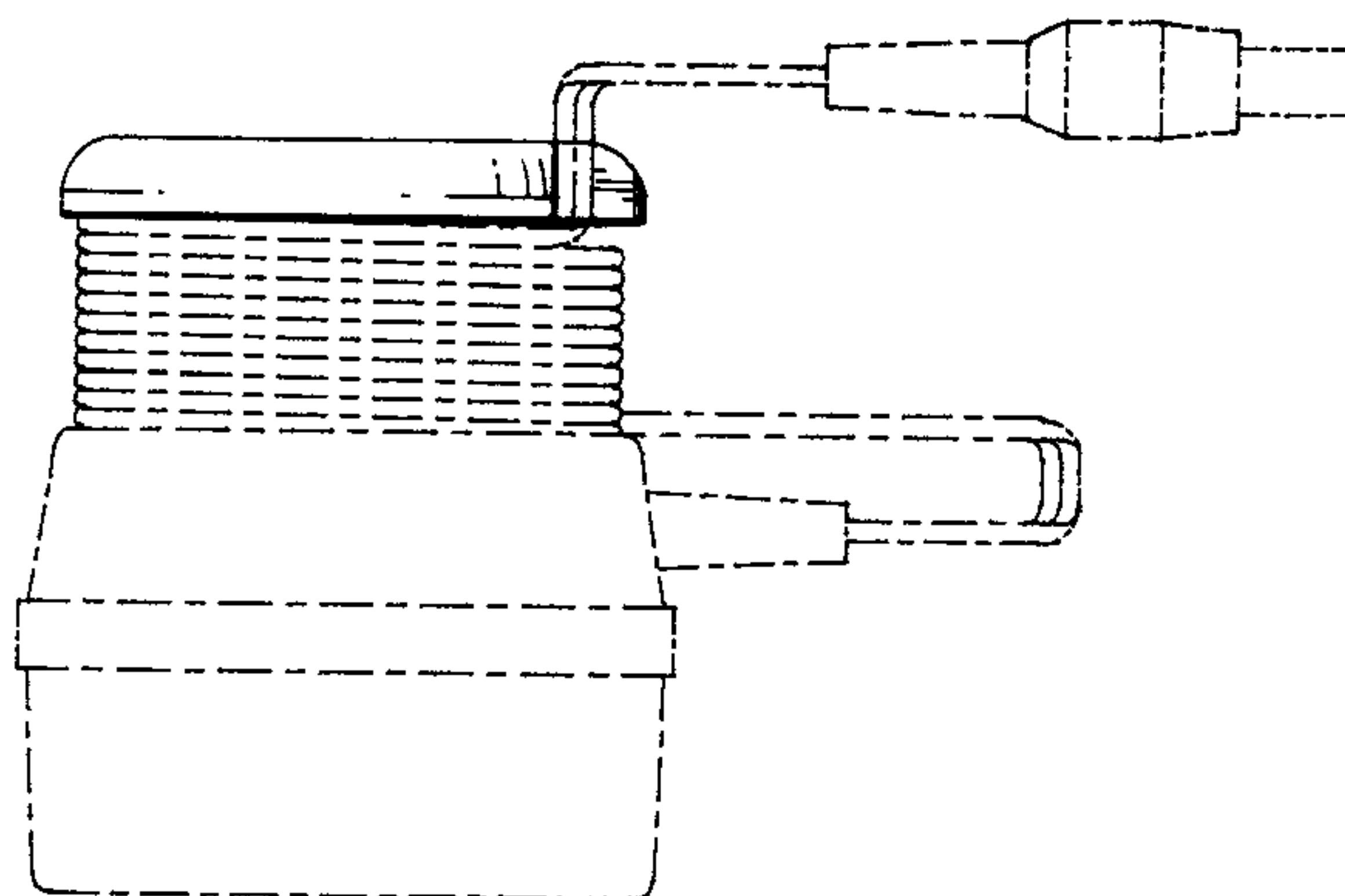
FIG. 5 is a front view thereof, the left side view being

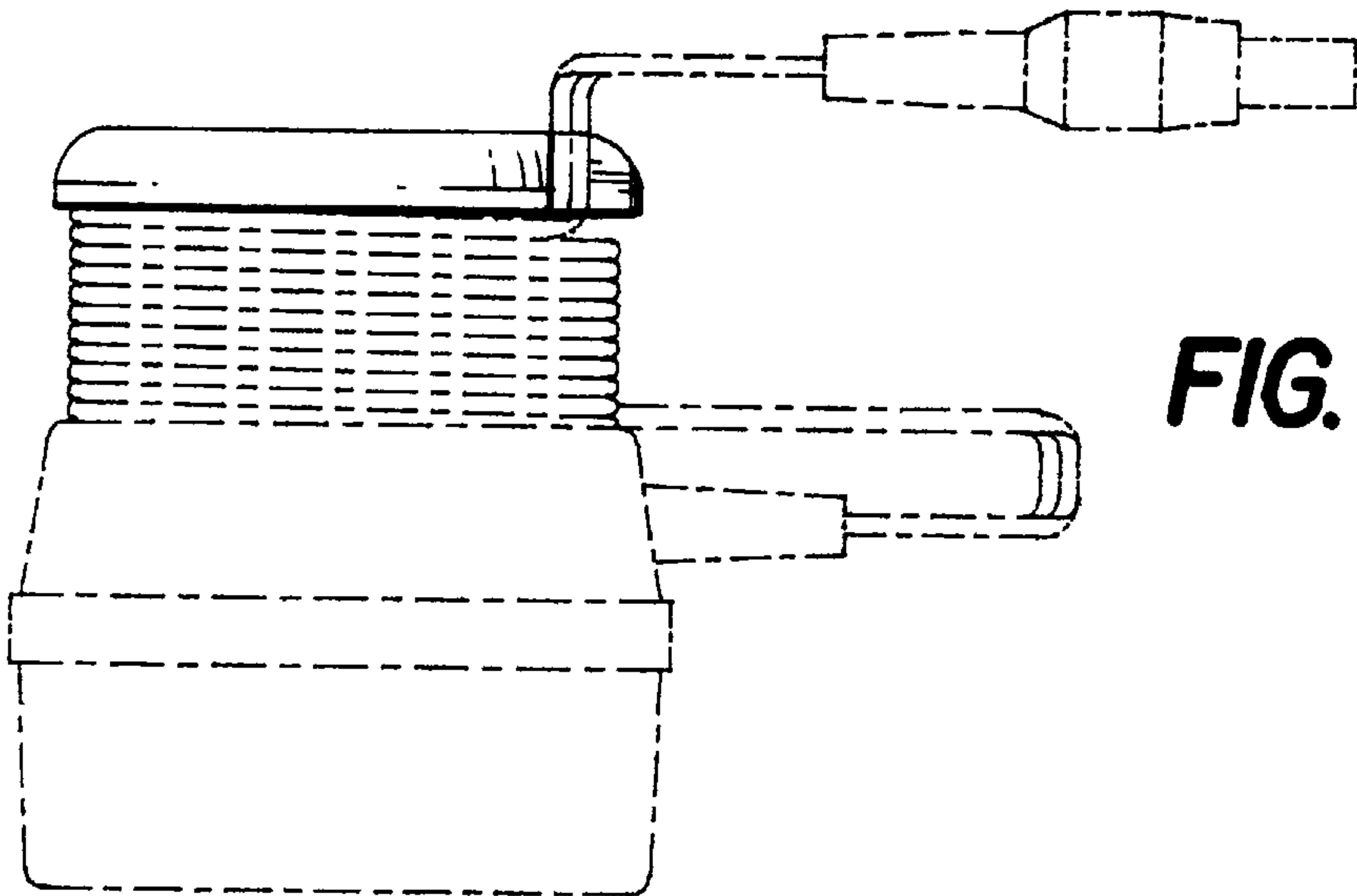

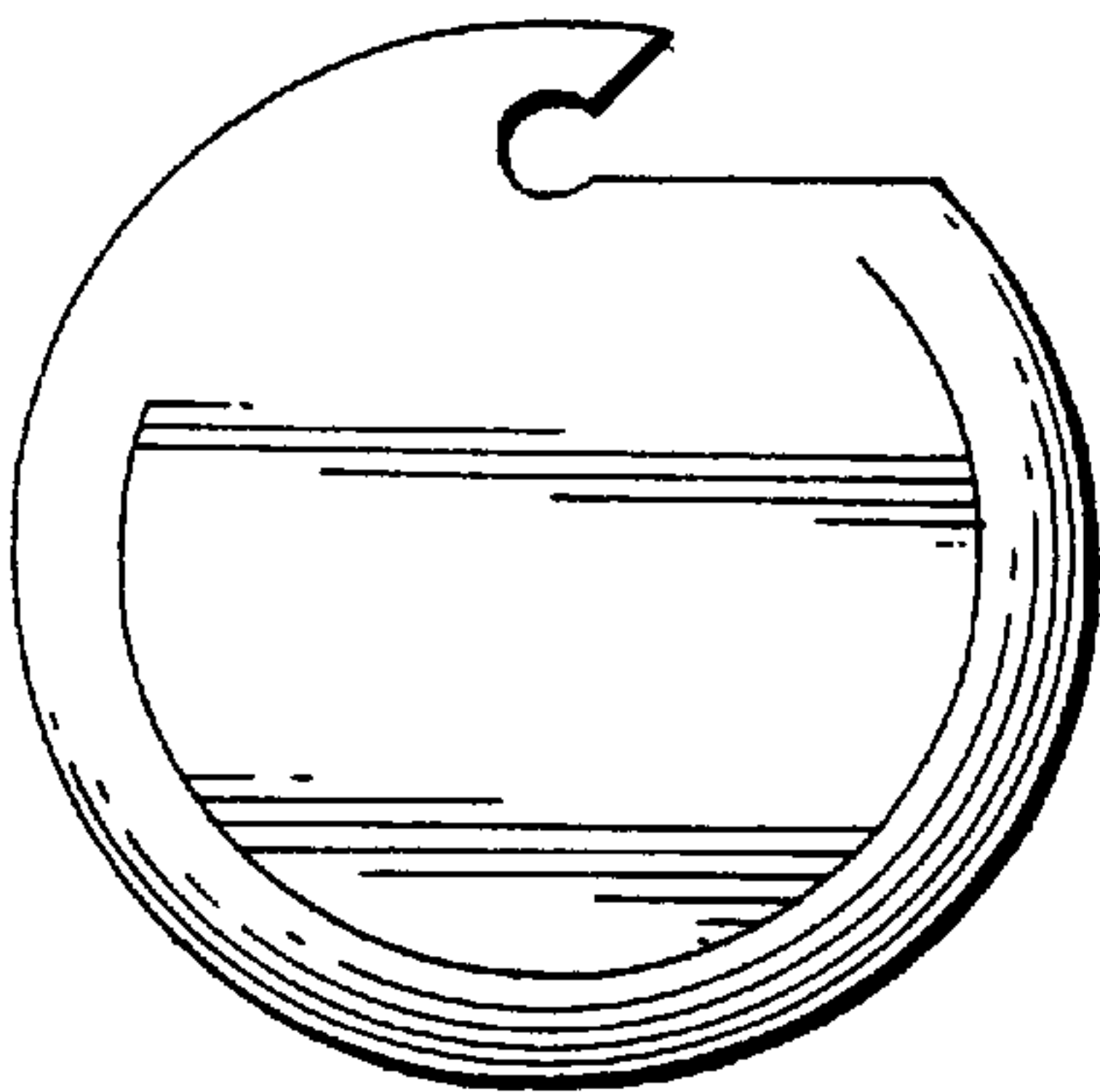
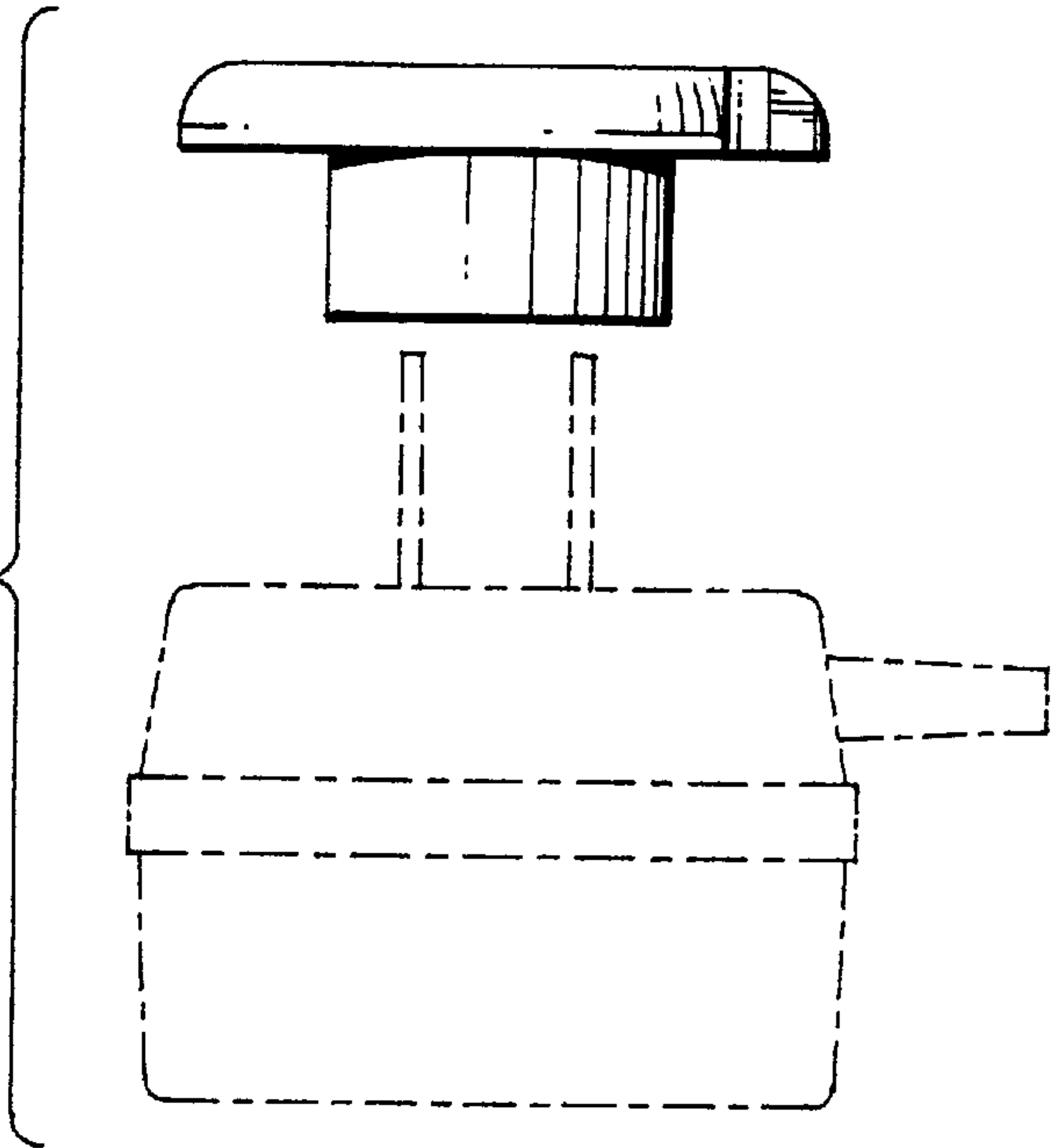

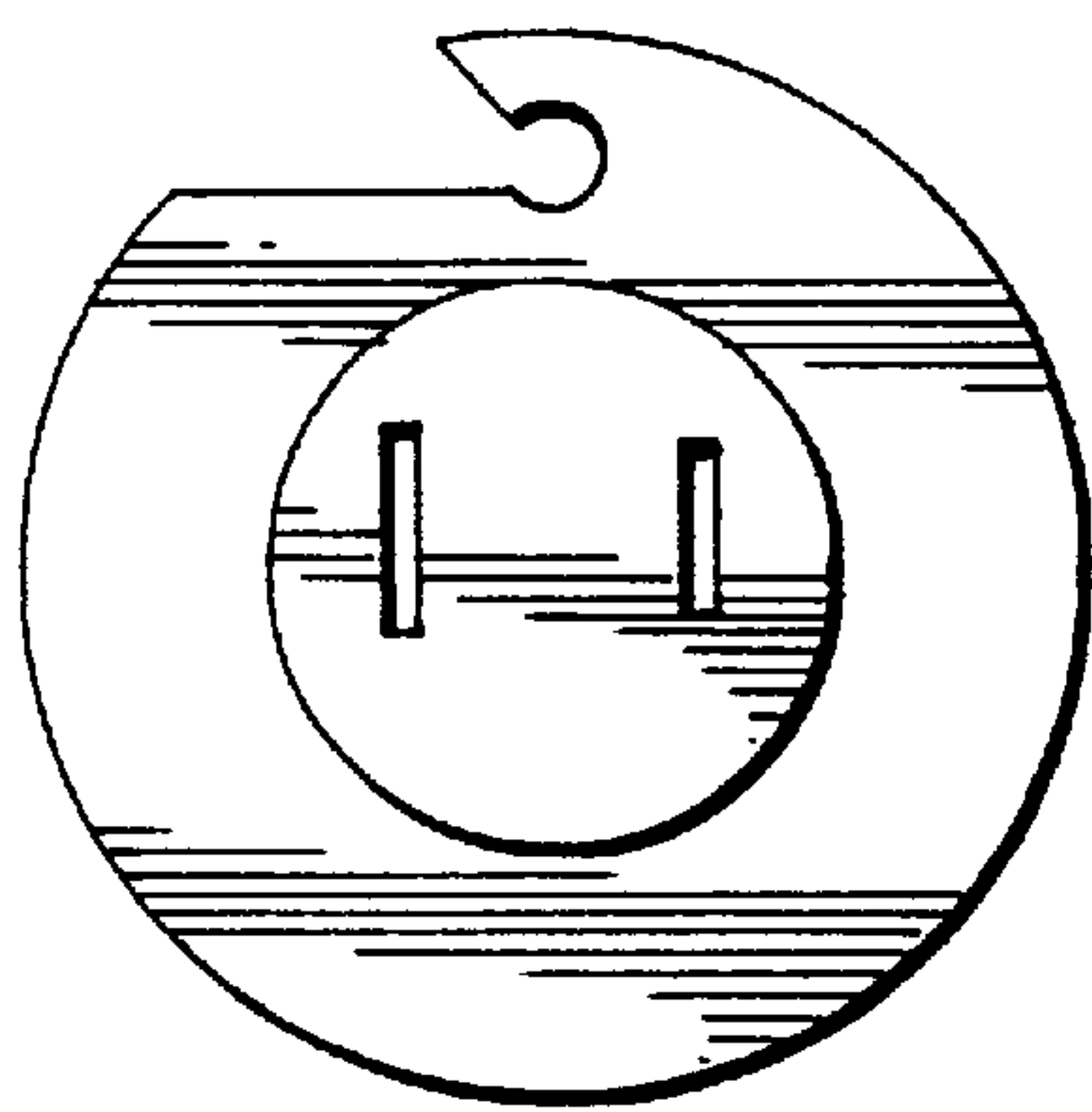

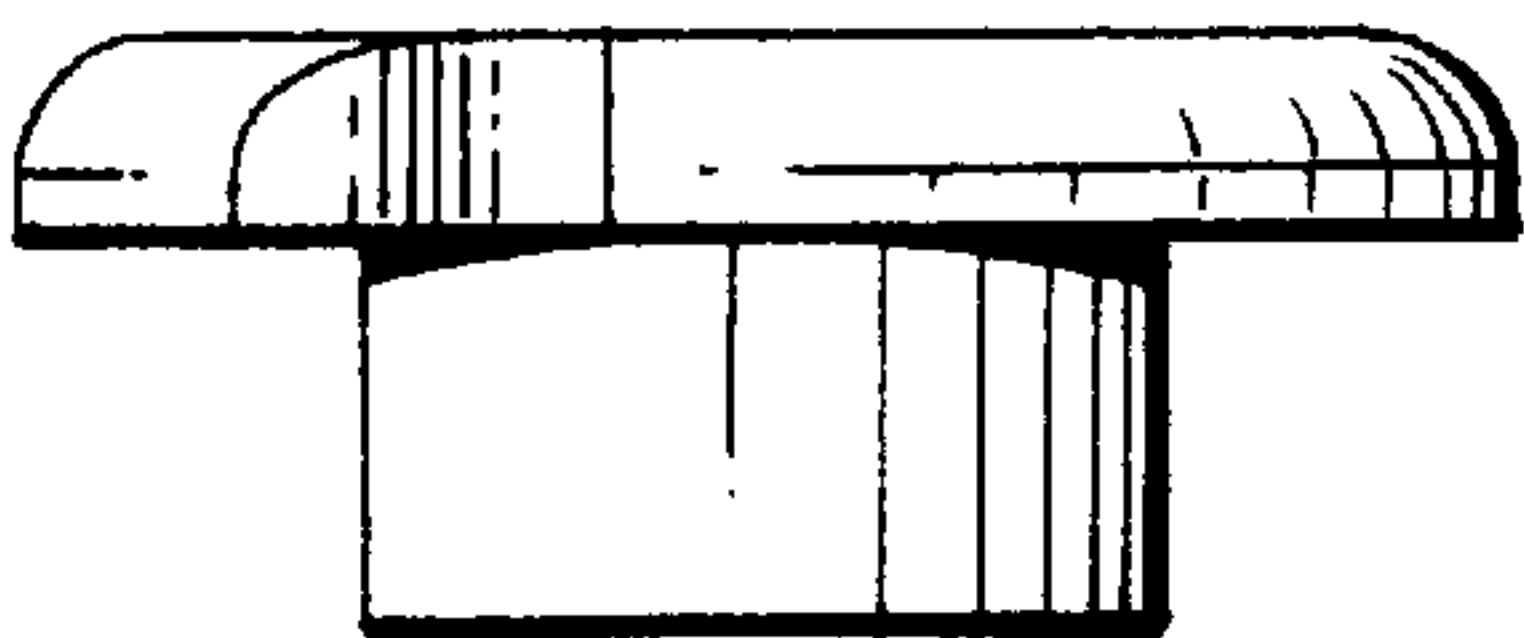
