[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an audio disc player combined with a radio receiver and a tape recorder, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of an audio disc player combined with a radio receiver and a tape recorder showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof; and

FIG. 7 is a perspective view thereof, wherein the lid portion of the first embodiment is in the open position. The portion in broken line is for illustrative purpose only and forms no part of claimed design.

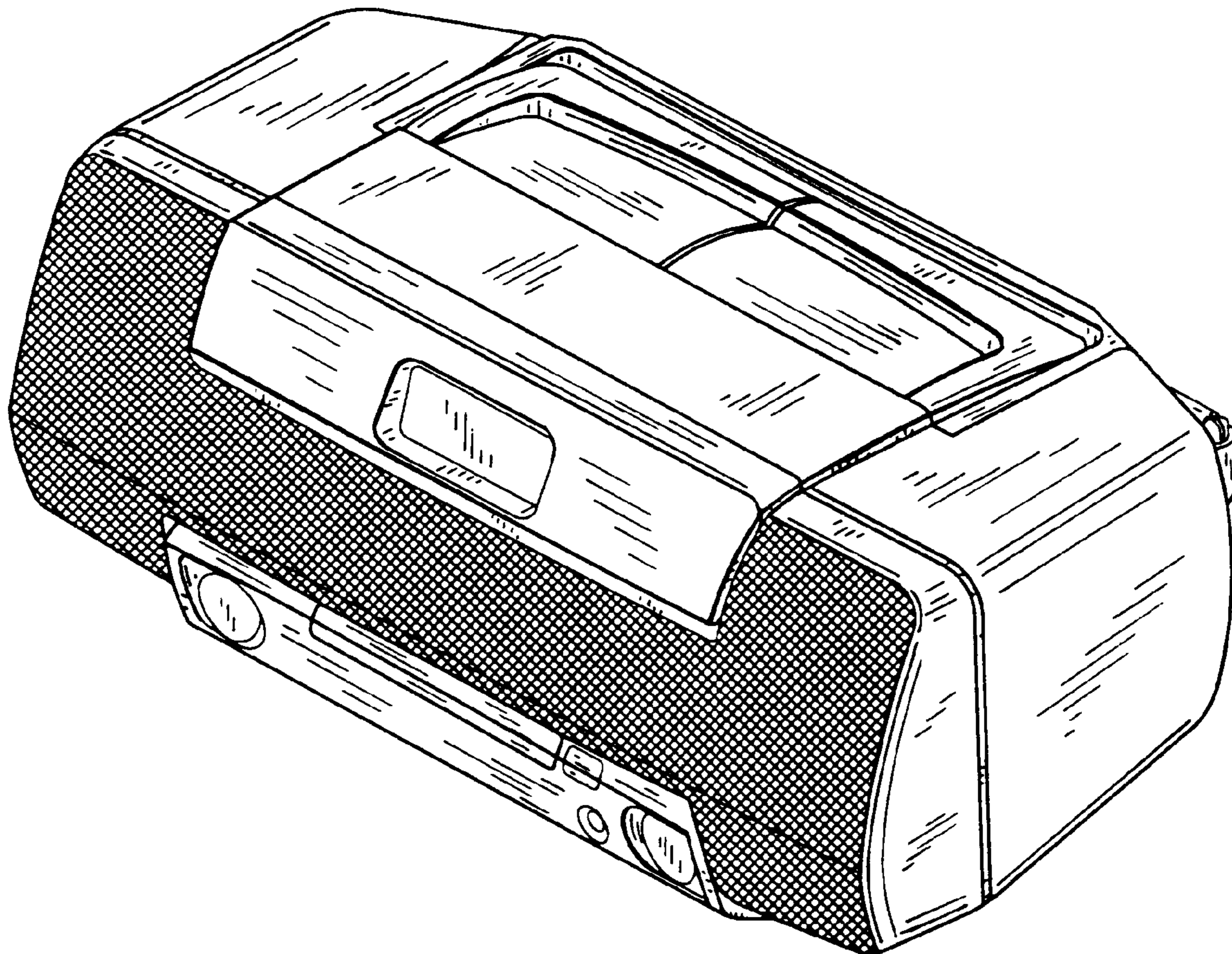

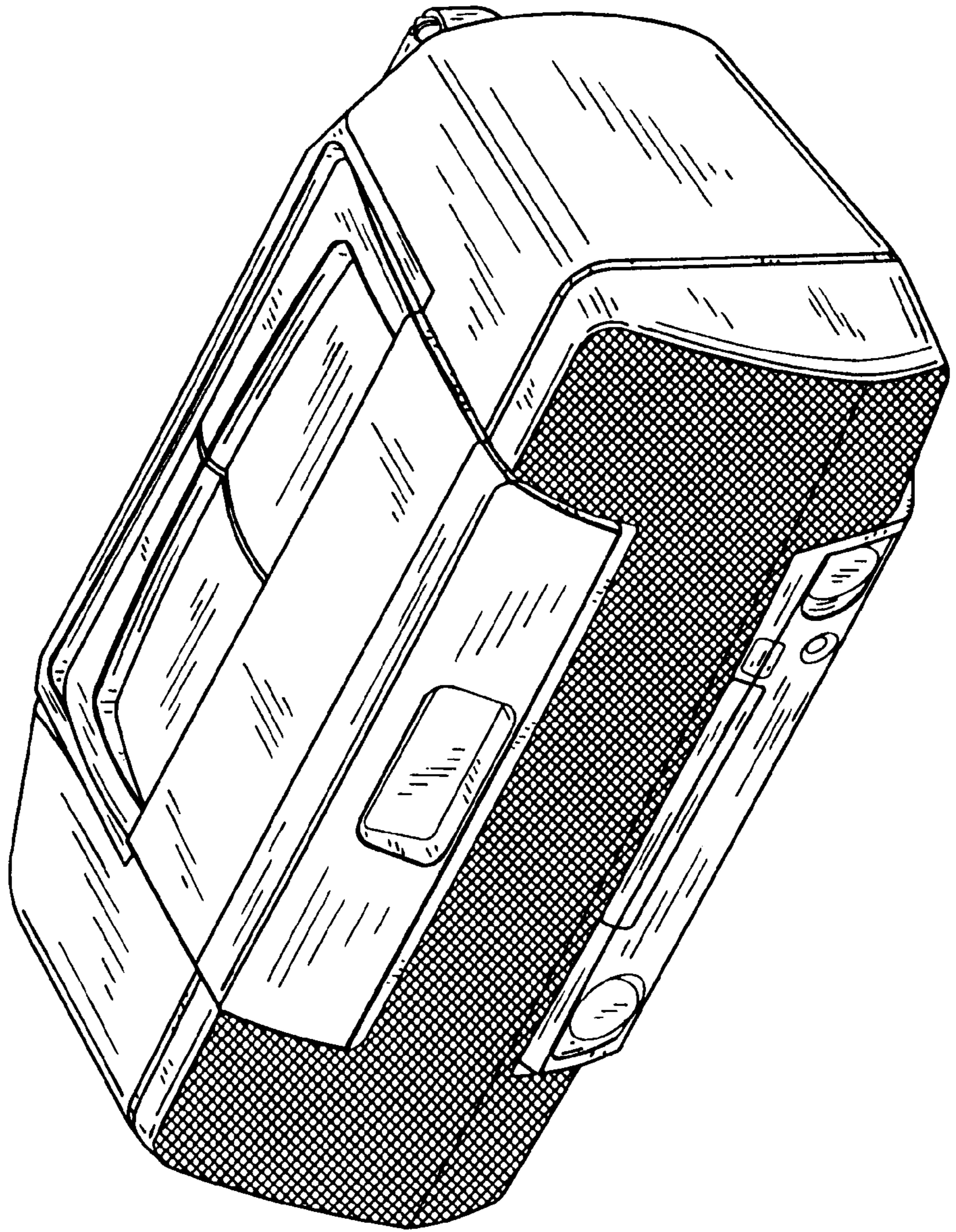

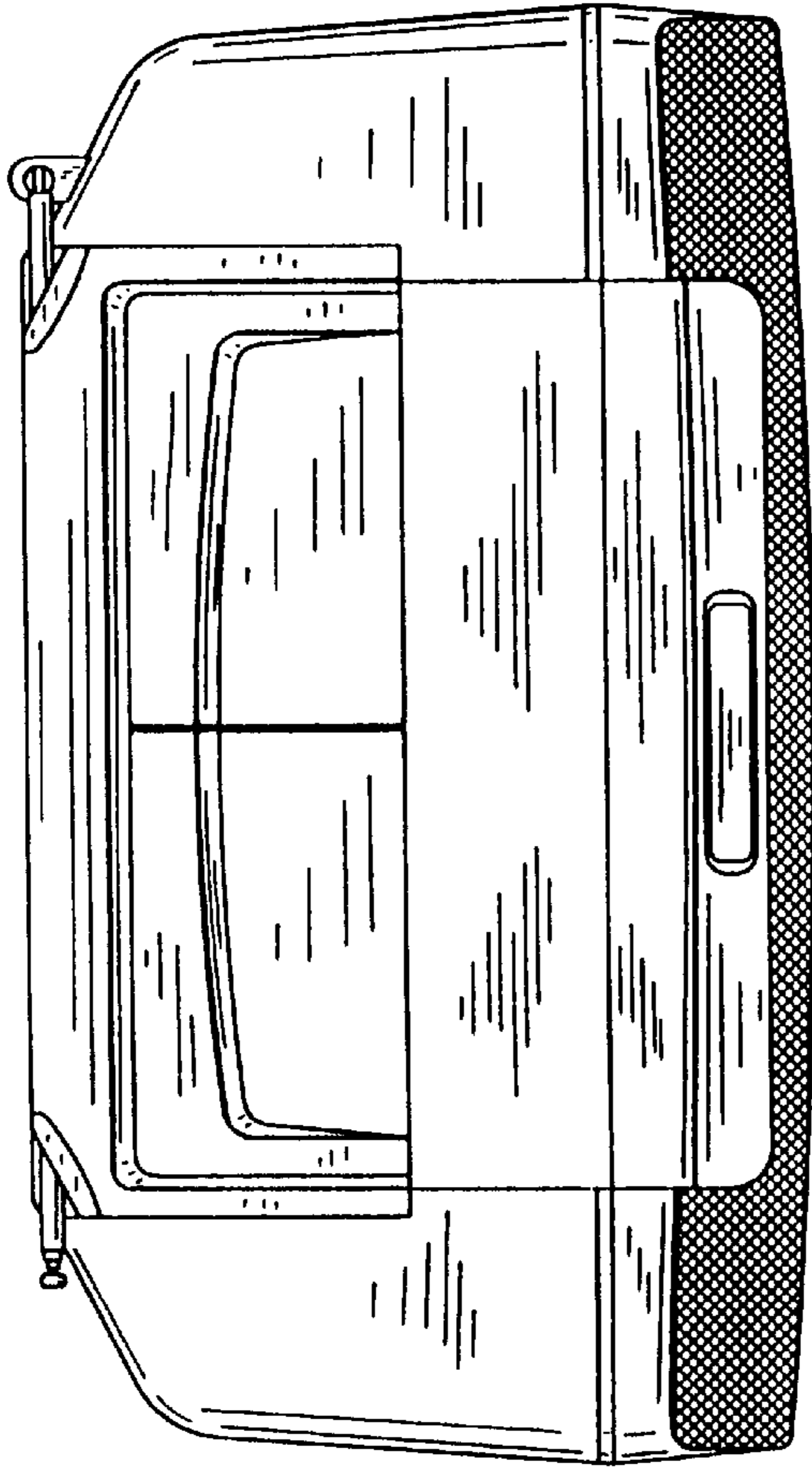

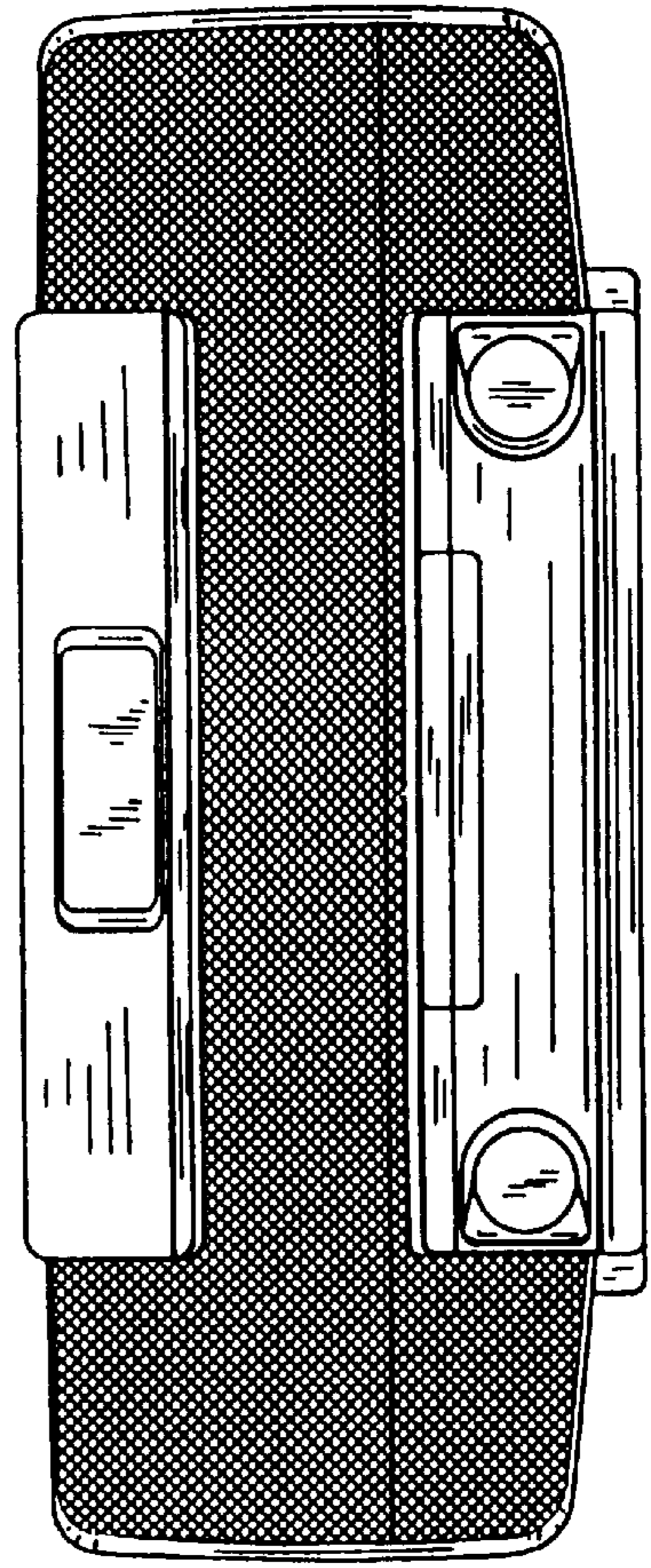

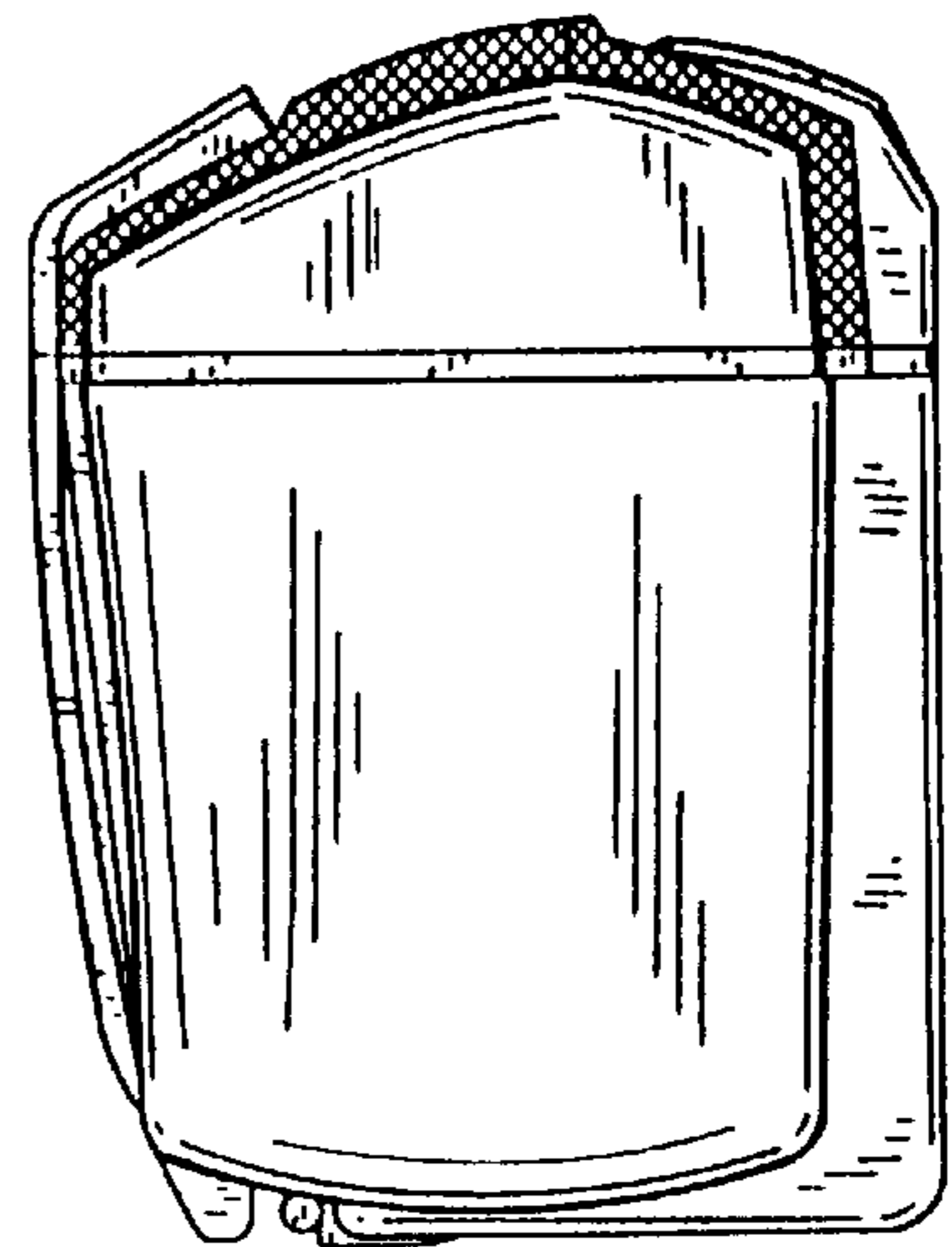

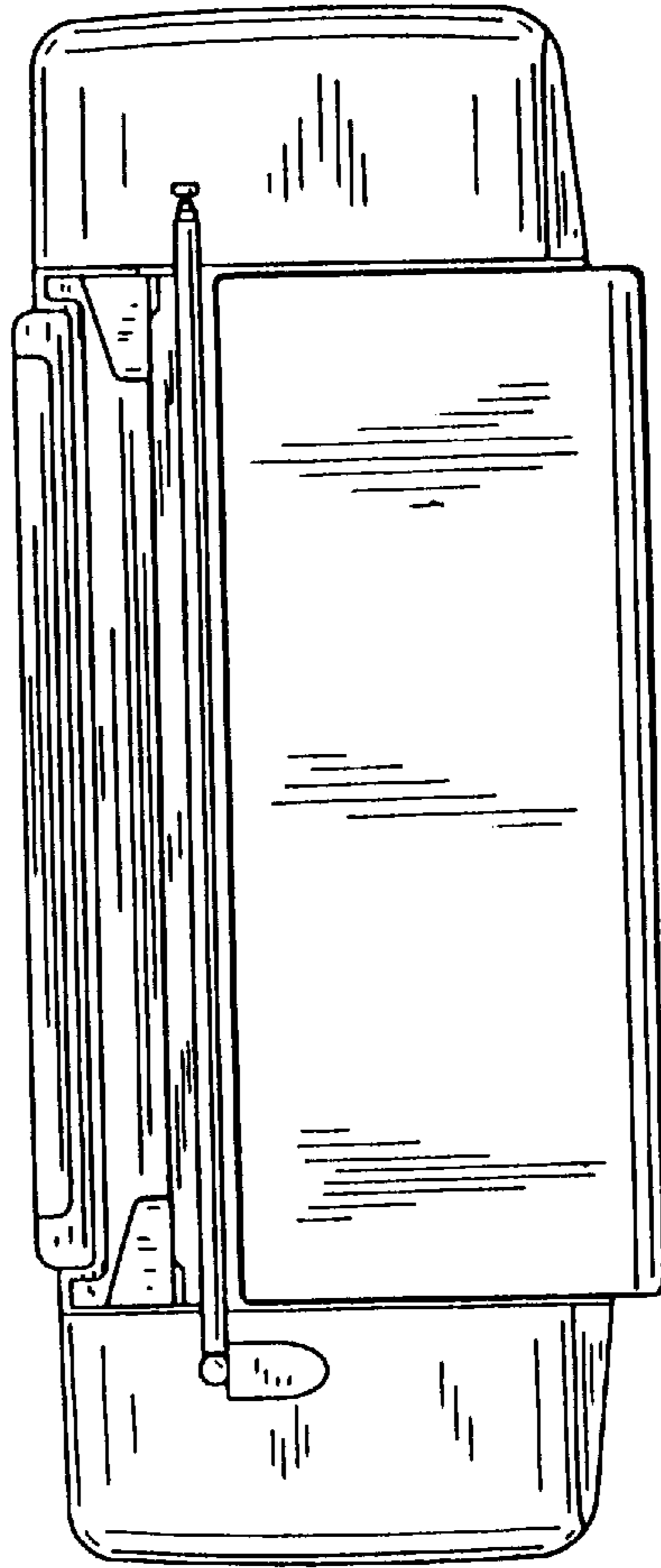

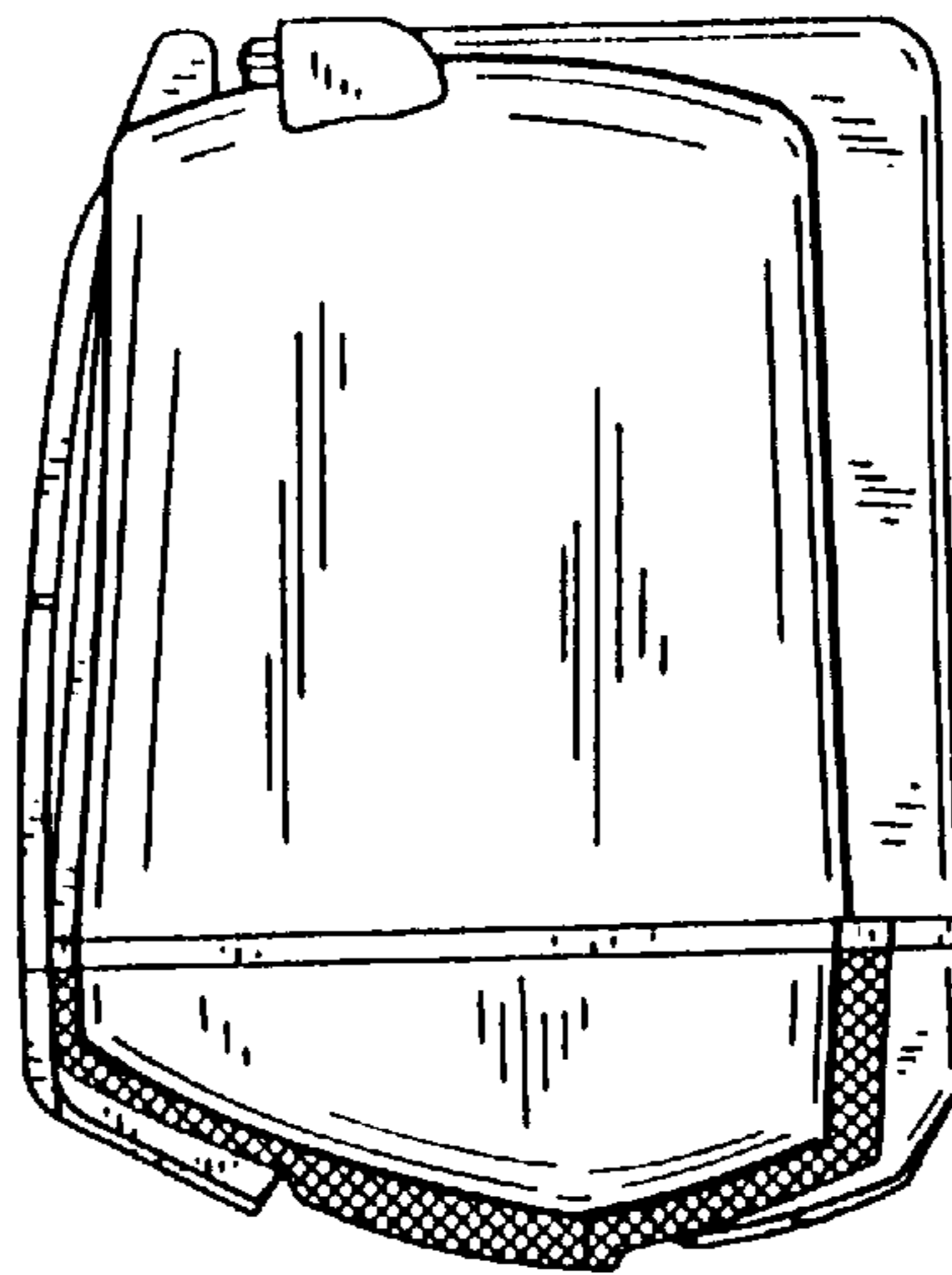
