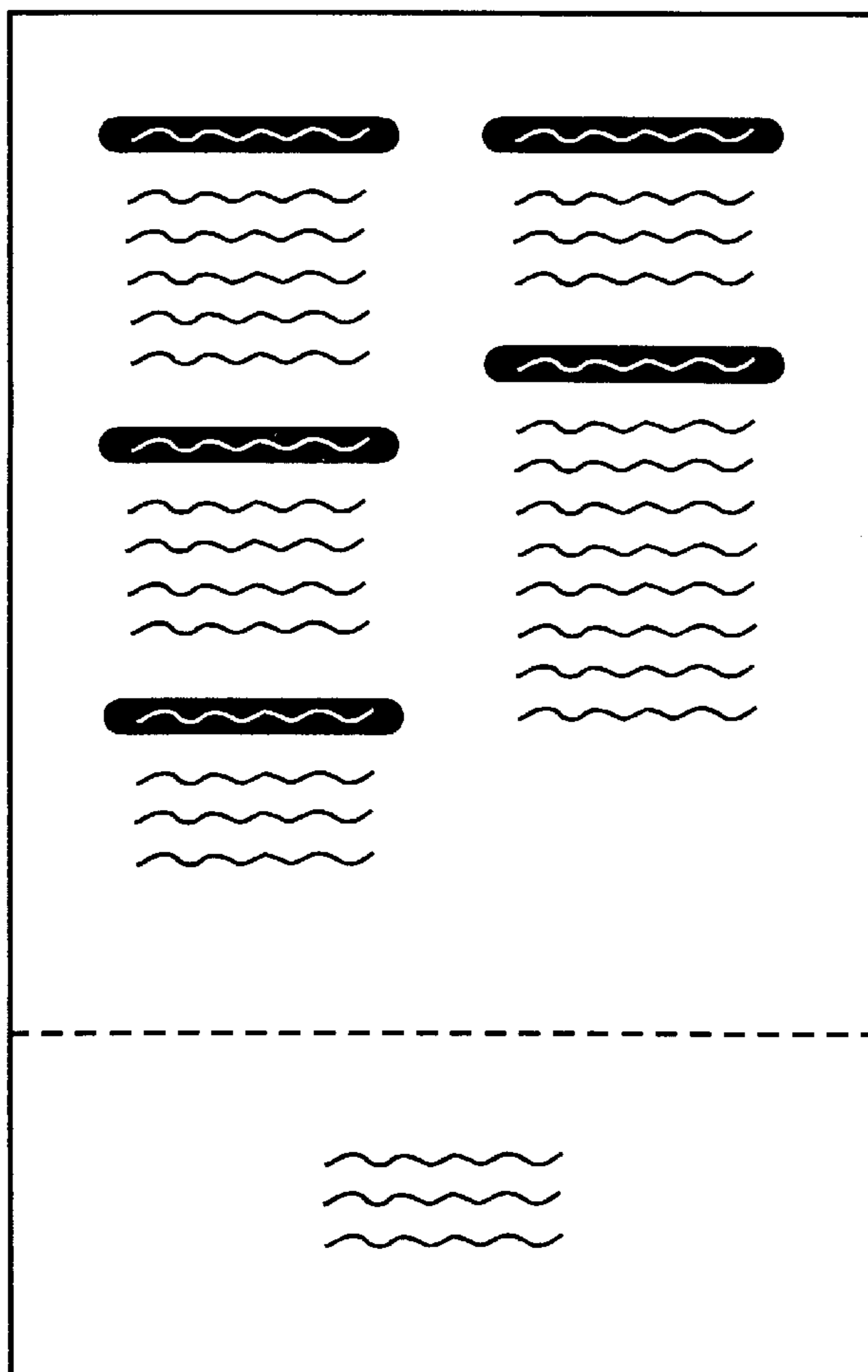
[57] **CLAIM**

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of business paper showing our new design. The broken lines shown in the drawing represent perforation lines; and, FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view thereof. The broken lines shown in the drawing represent perforation lines. It is understood that the claimed article is of no substantial thickness.

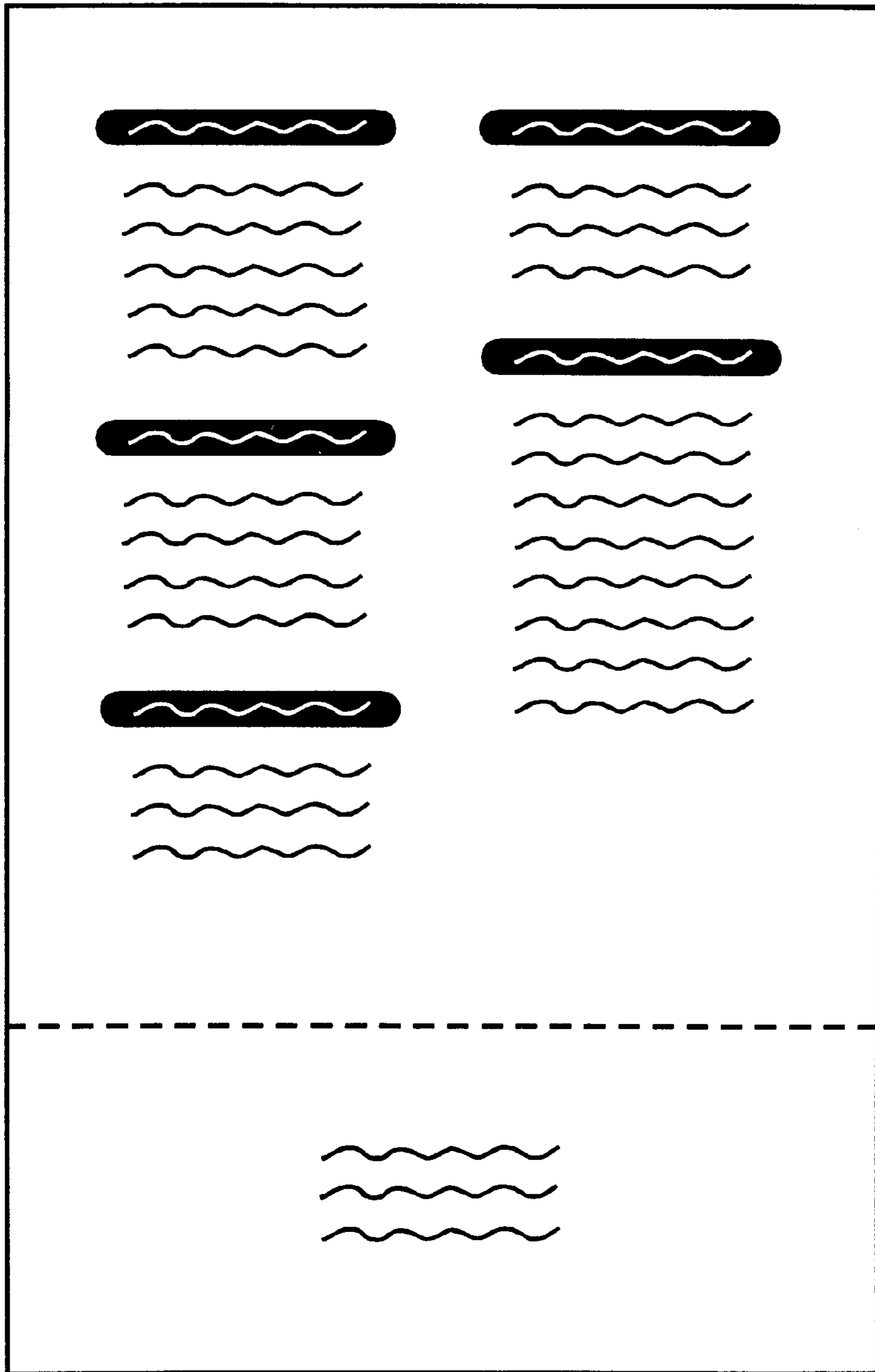

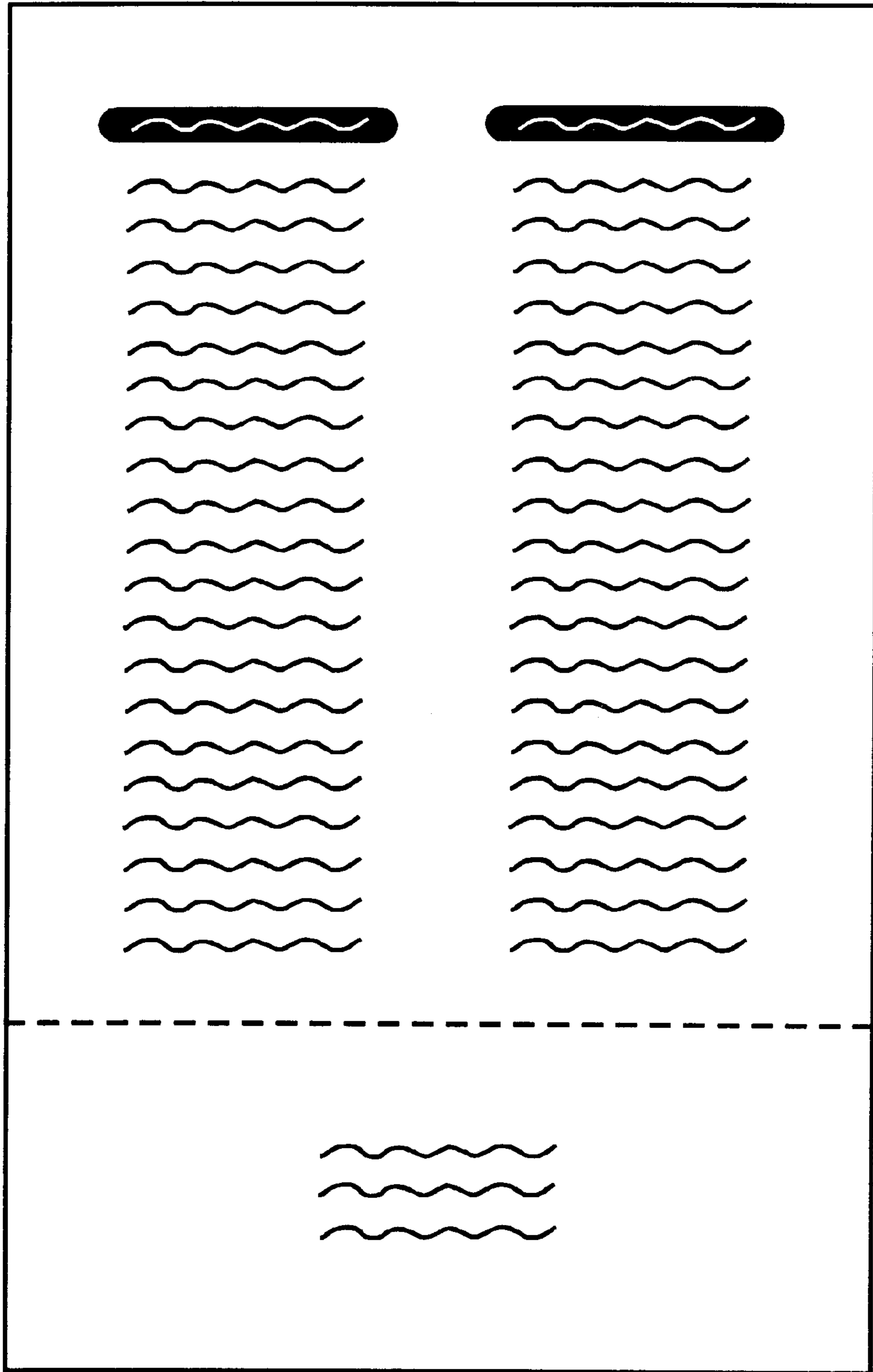
