[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a portion of a shoe sole, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a portion of a shoe sole according to the present invention; FIG. 2 is a top view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left side view thereof; FIG. 4 is a right side view thereof; FIG. 5 is a front view thereof; FIG. 6 is a rear view thereof; and, FIG. 7 is a bottom view thereof.

The broken line showing of a shoe sole is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

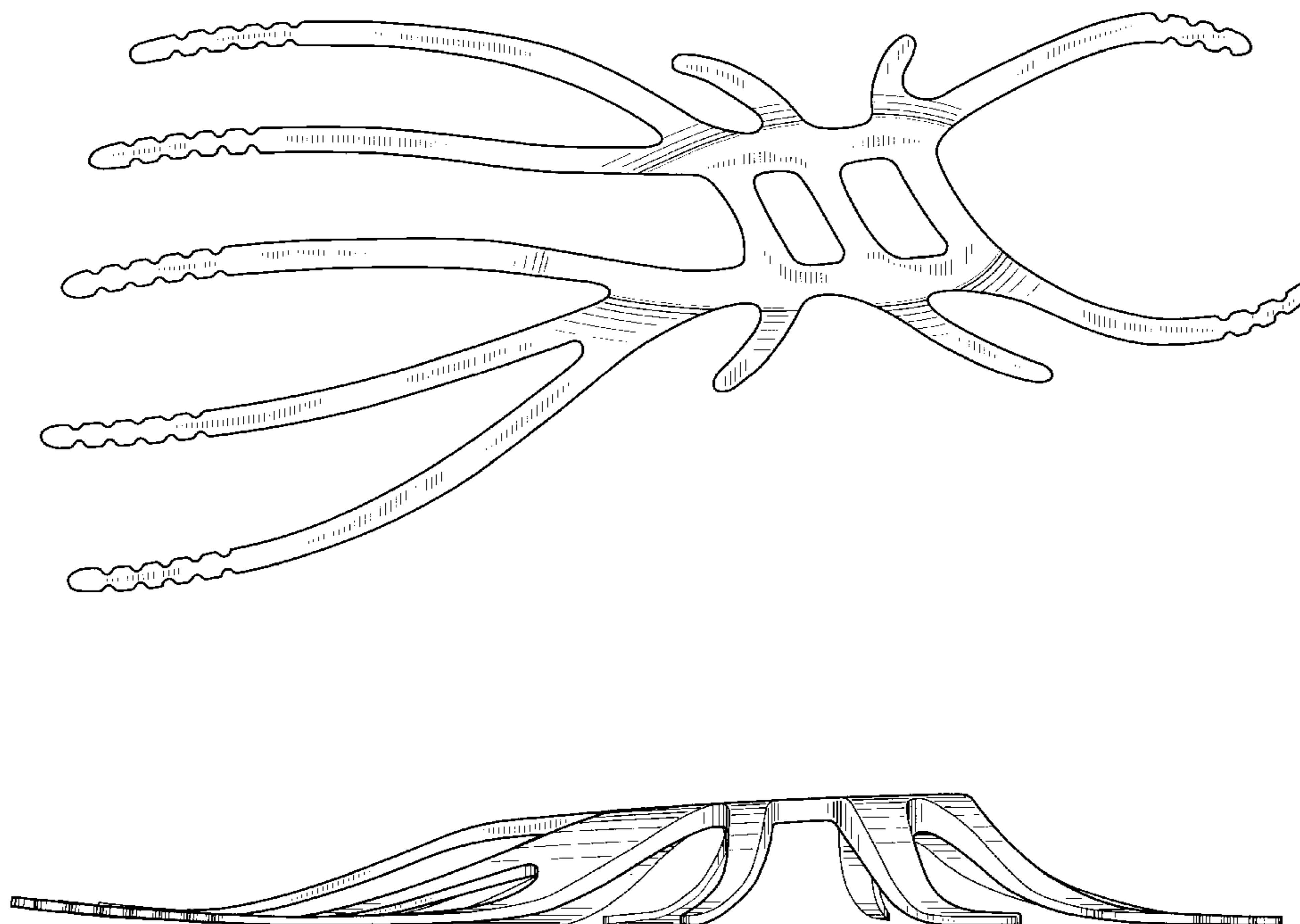

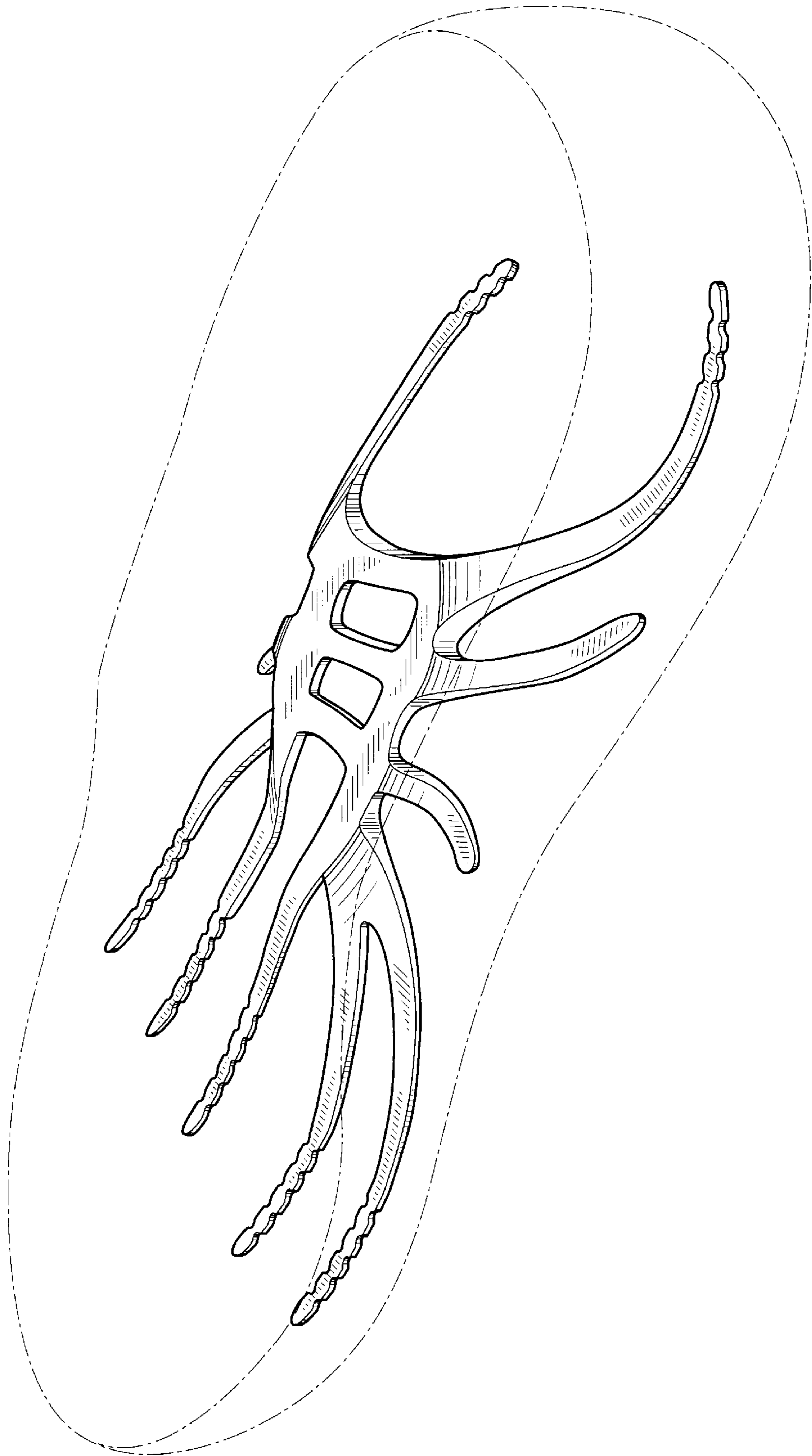

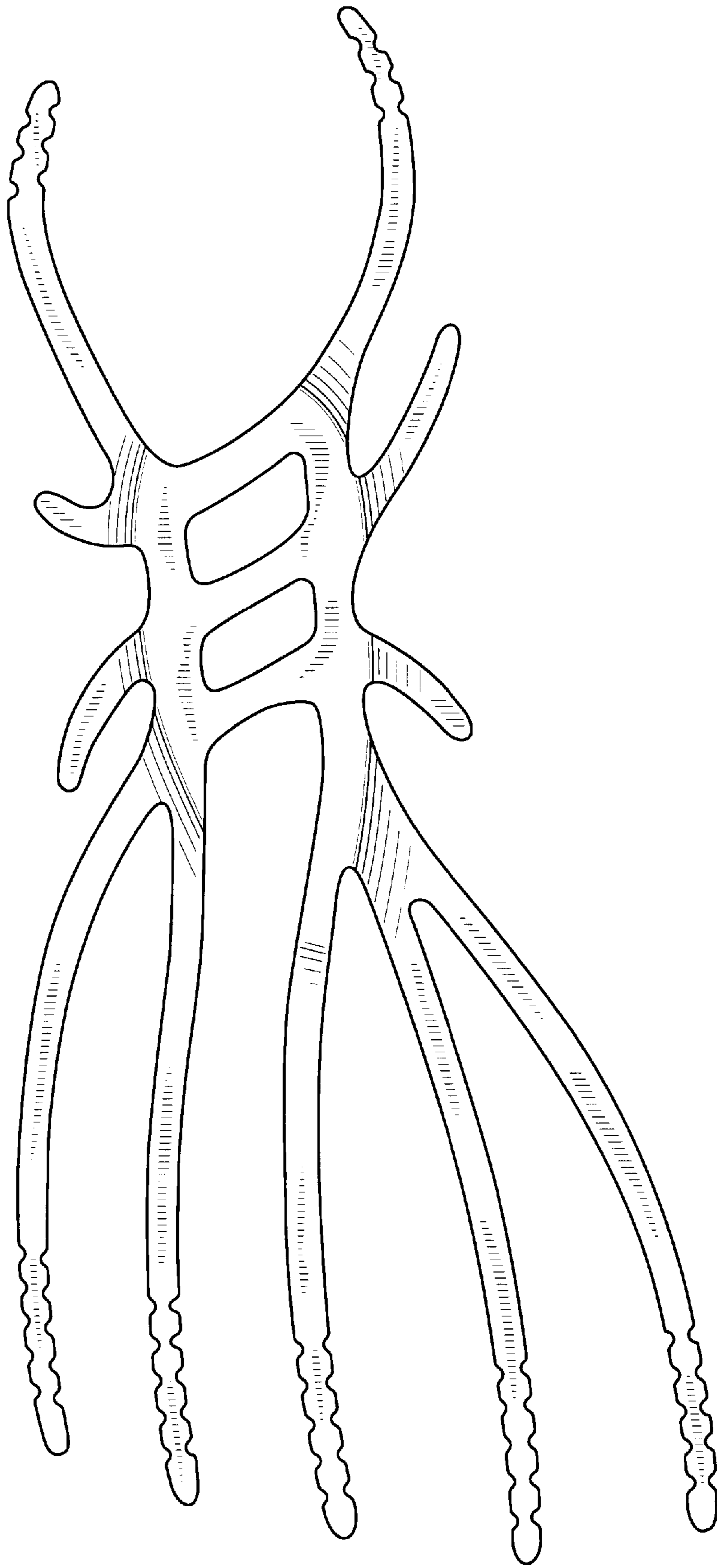

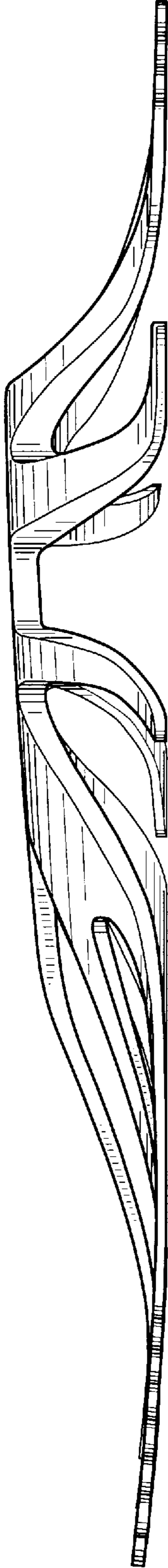

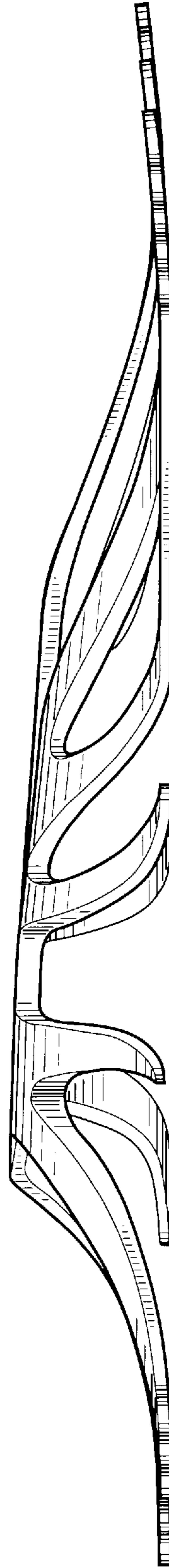

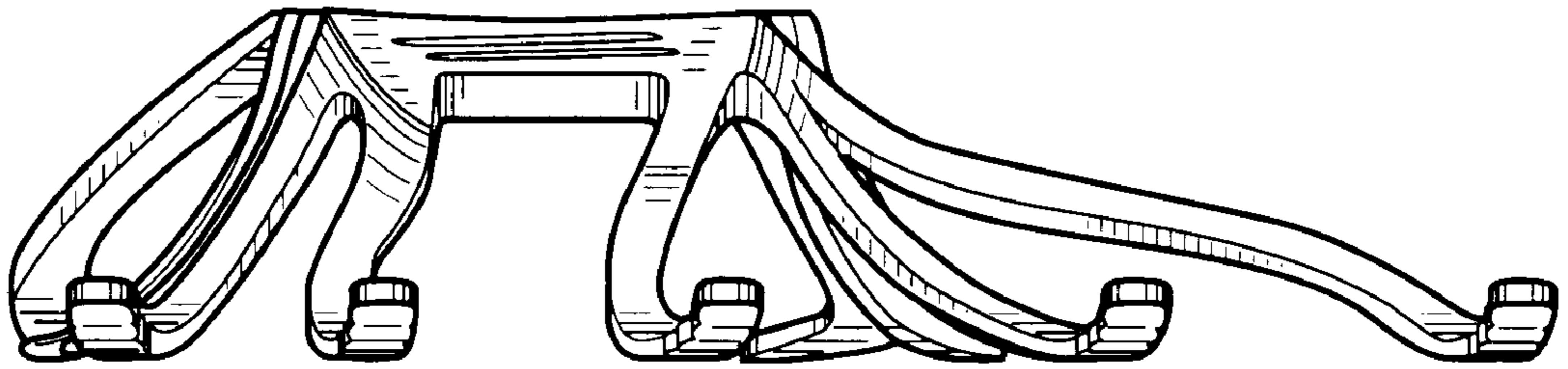

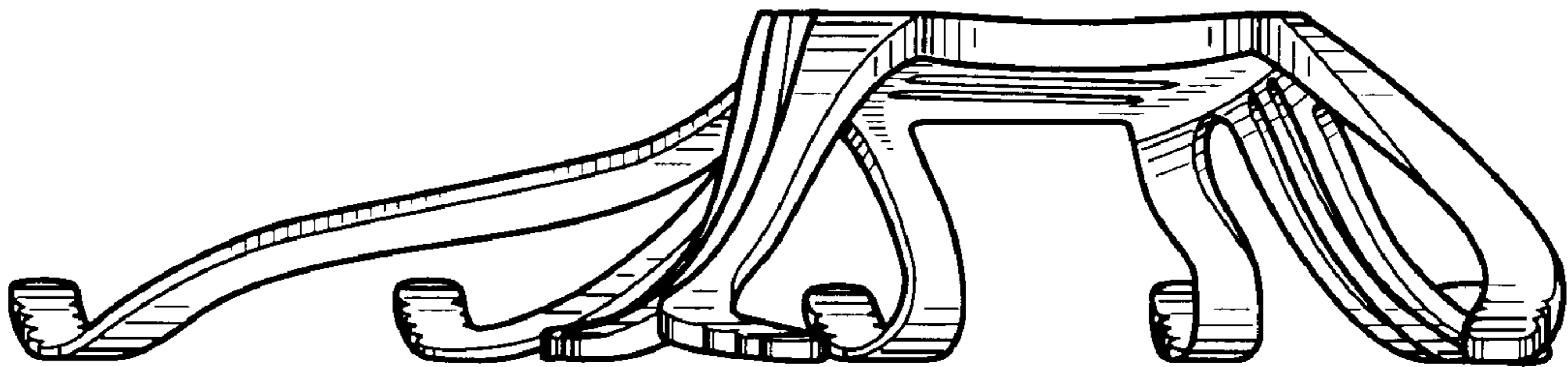
