FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the bathing chair of the present invention;

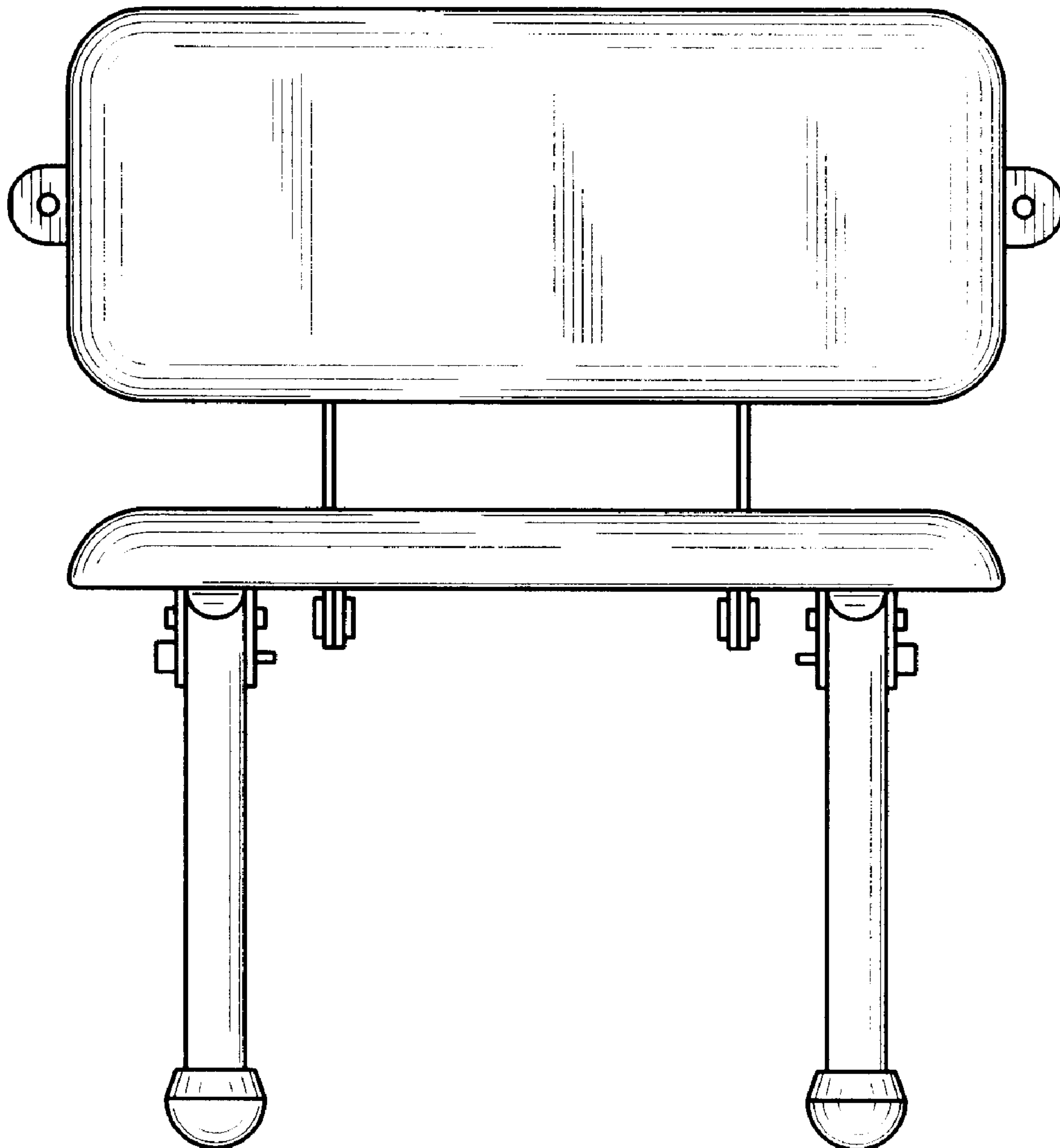
FIG. 2 is a back elevational view of the bathing chair of FIG. 1;

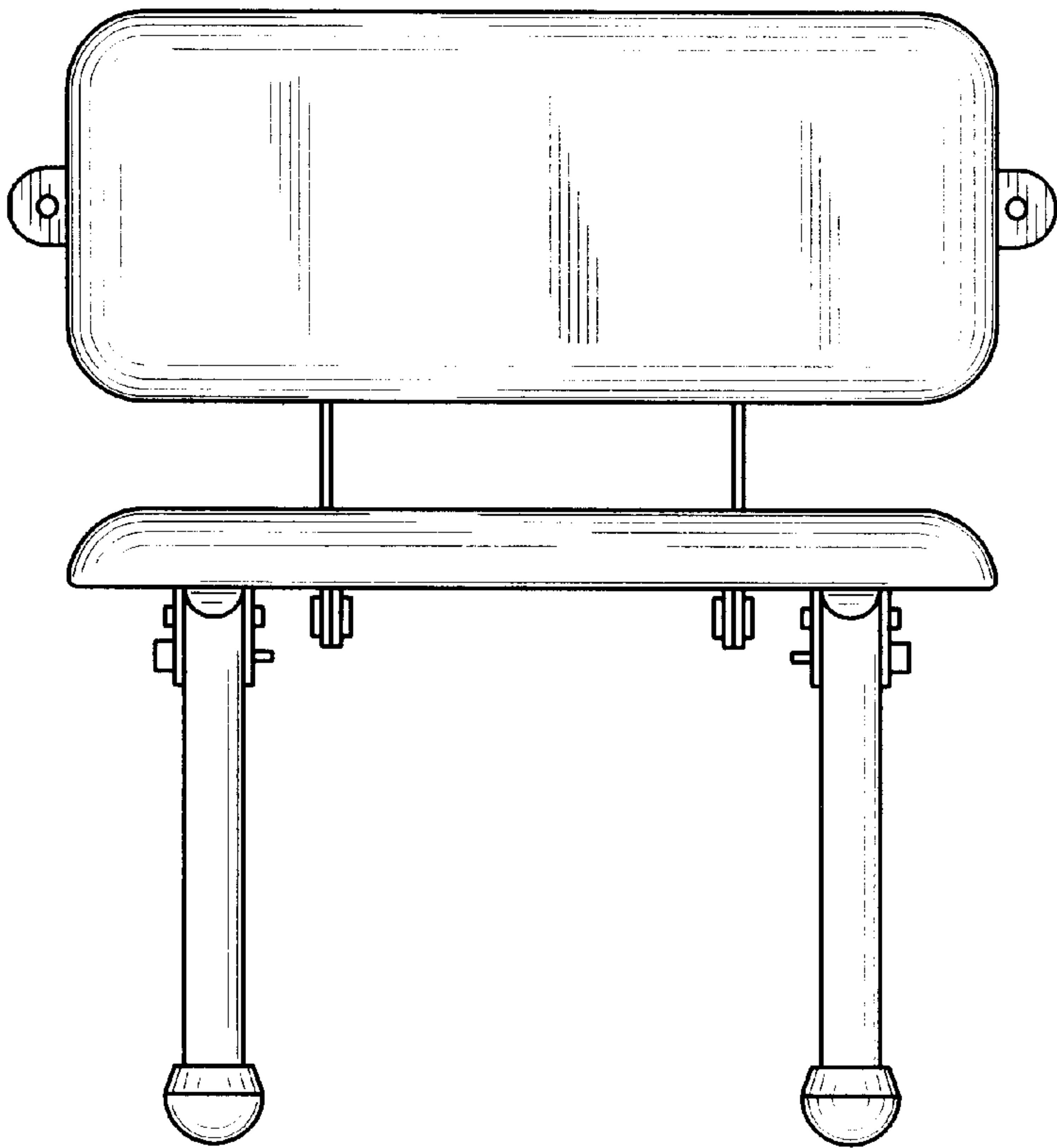

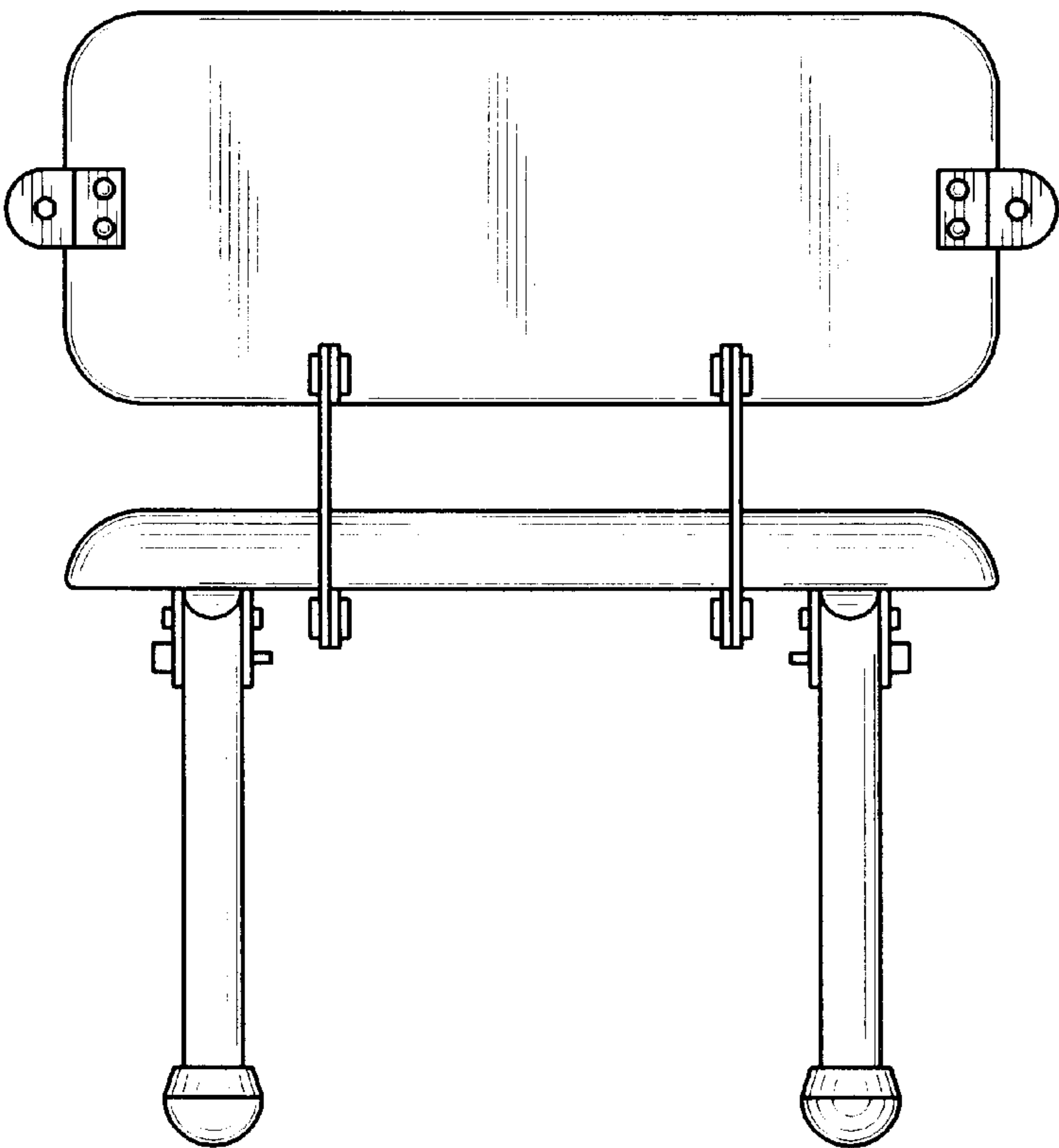

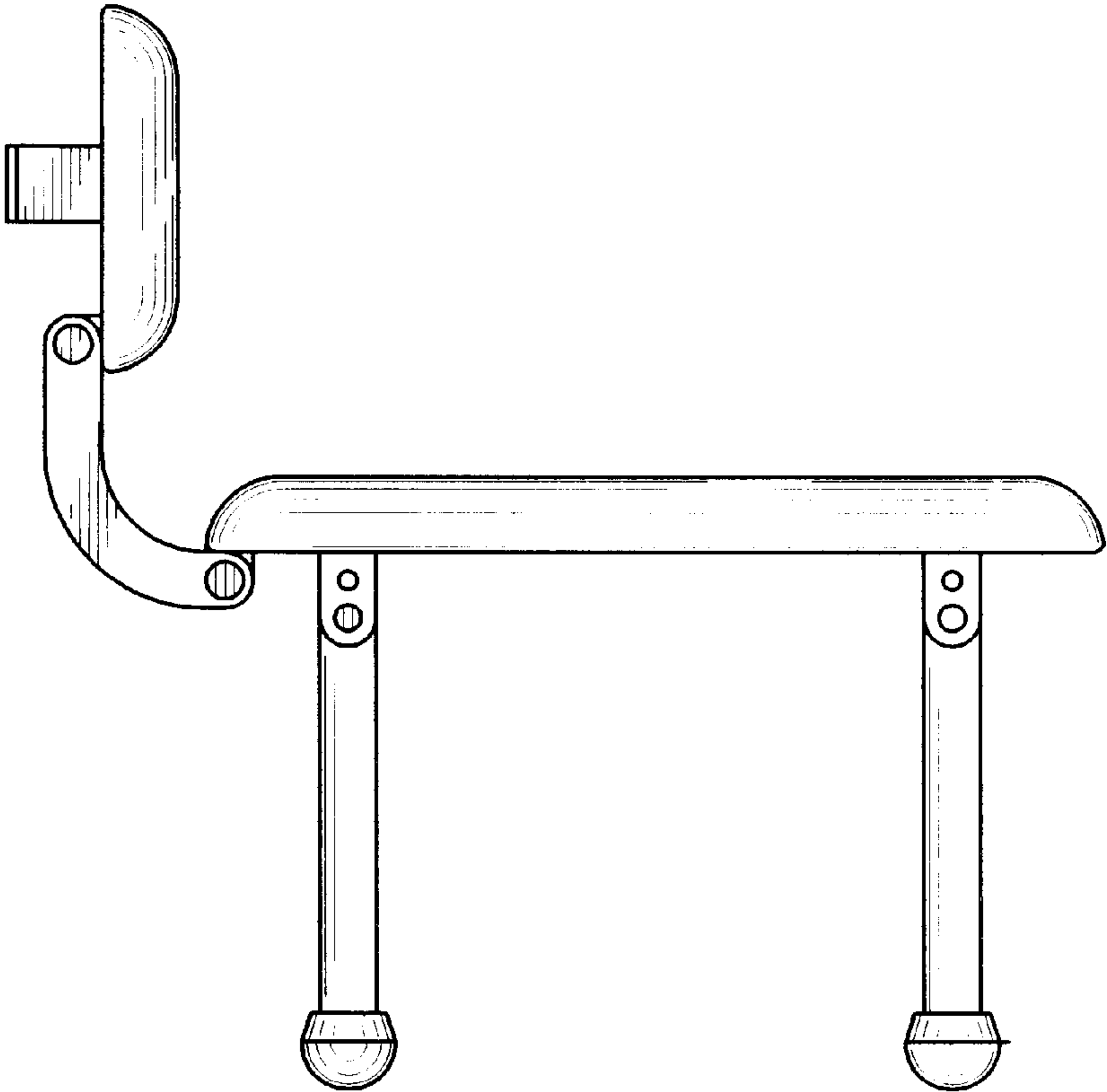

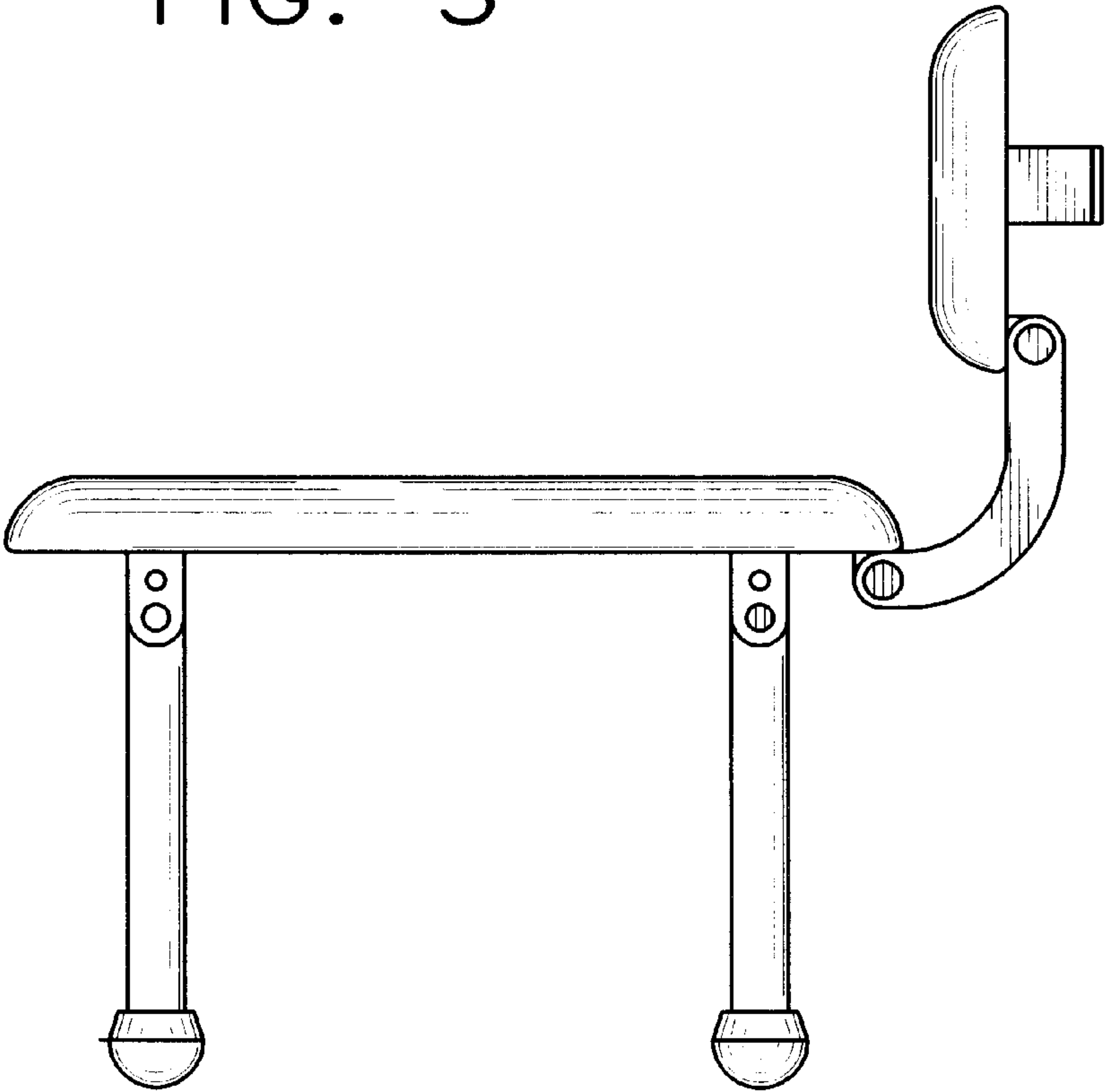

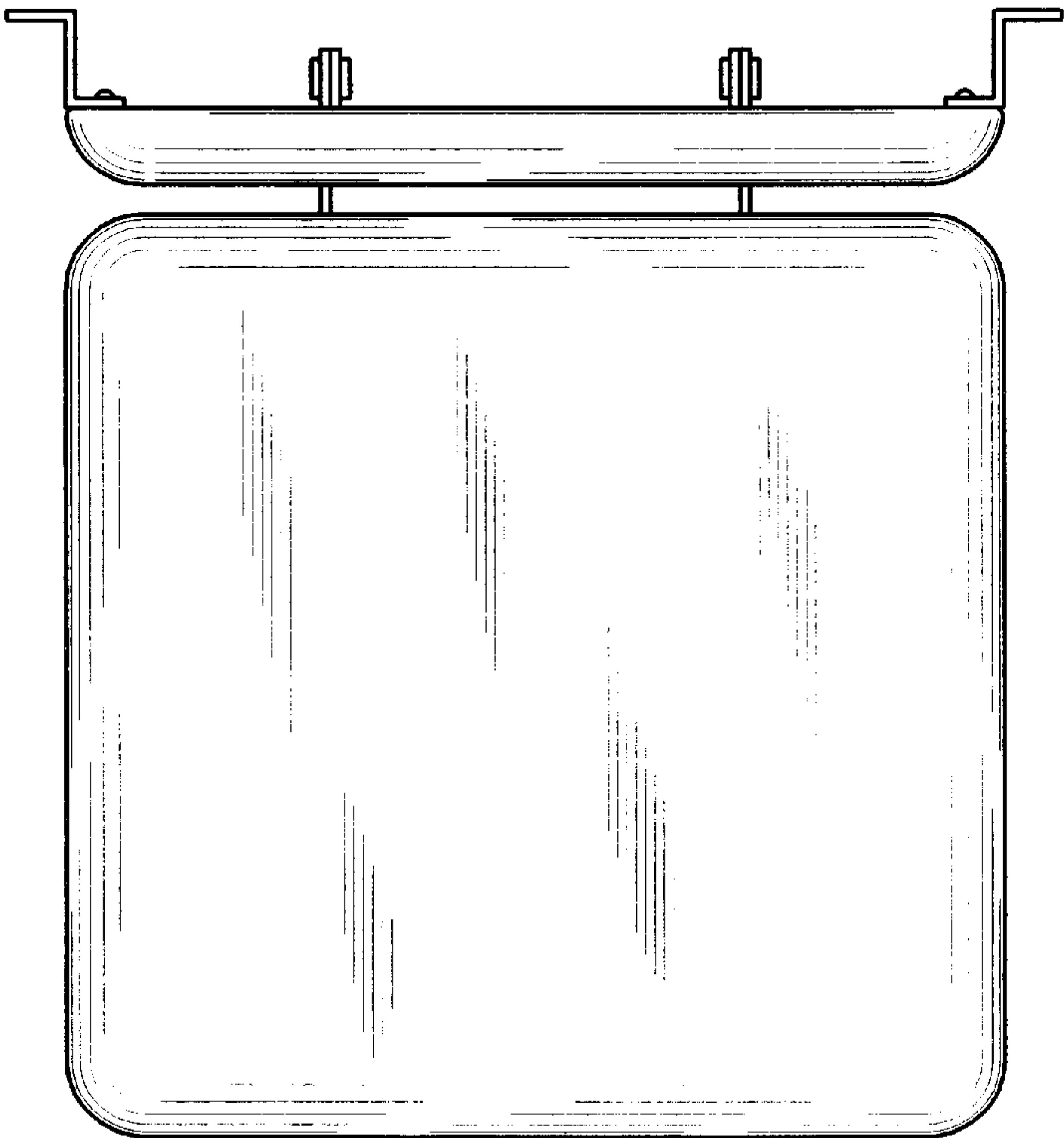

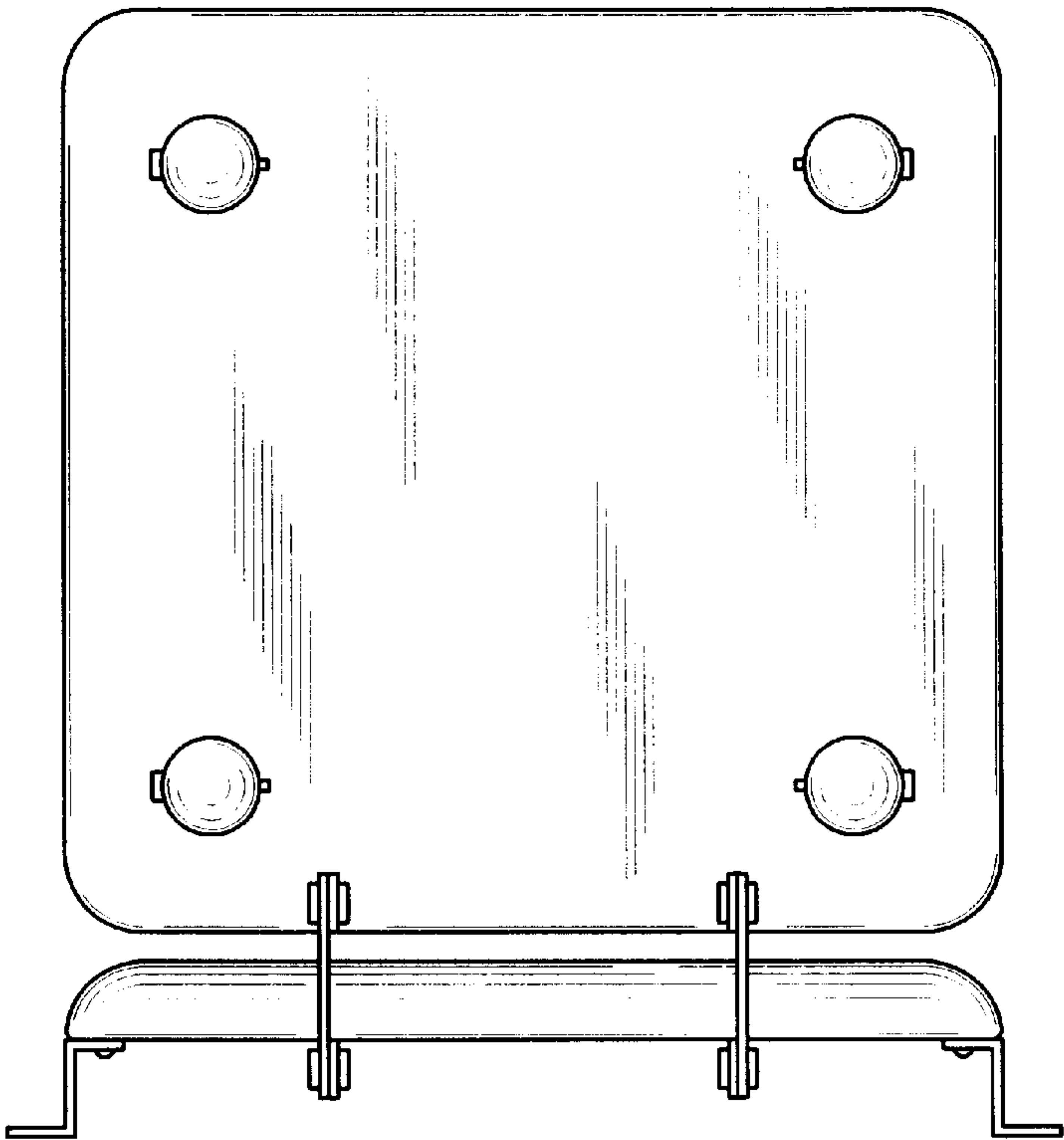
