[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a bottom housing for a foldable portable telephone, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top, front and left side perspective view of a bottom housing for a foldable portable telephone showing our new design in an open position;

FIG. 2 is a top, front and left side perspective view thereof showing our new design in a closed position;

FIG. 3 is a rear side elevation view thereof showing our new design in the closed position;

FIG. 4 is a rear side elevation view thereof showing our new design in the open position;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevation view thereof showing our new design in the closed position, the left side elevation view thereof showing our new design in the closed position being a mirror image of the right side elevation view thereof showing our new design in the closed position;

FIG. 6 is a right side elevation view thereof showing our new design in the open position, the left side elevation view thereof showing our new design in the open position being a mirror image of the right side elevation view thereof showing our new design in the open position;

FIG. 7 is a bottom side plan view thereof showing our new design in the closed position;

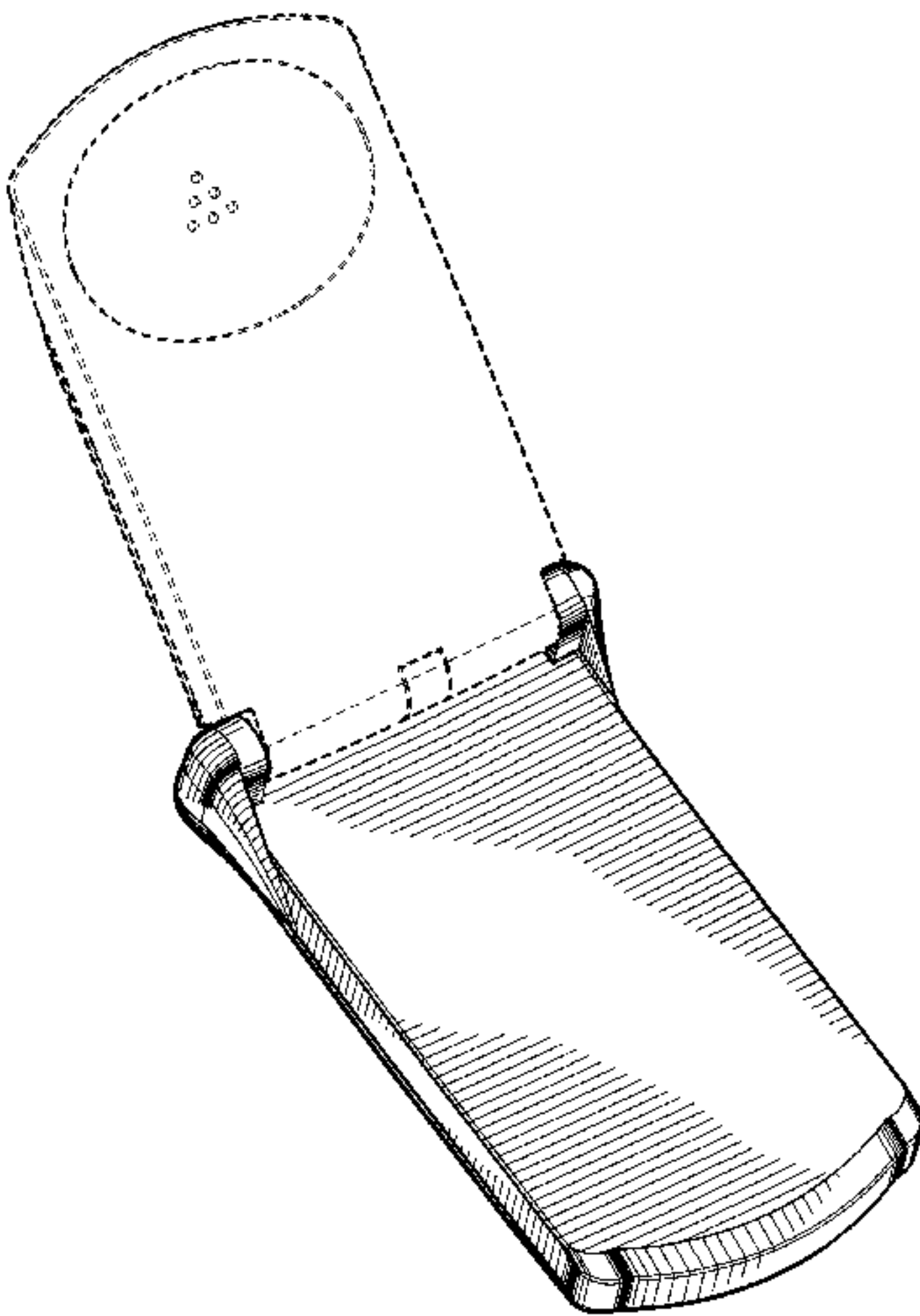
FIG. 8 is a bottom side plan view thereof showing our new design in the open position;

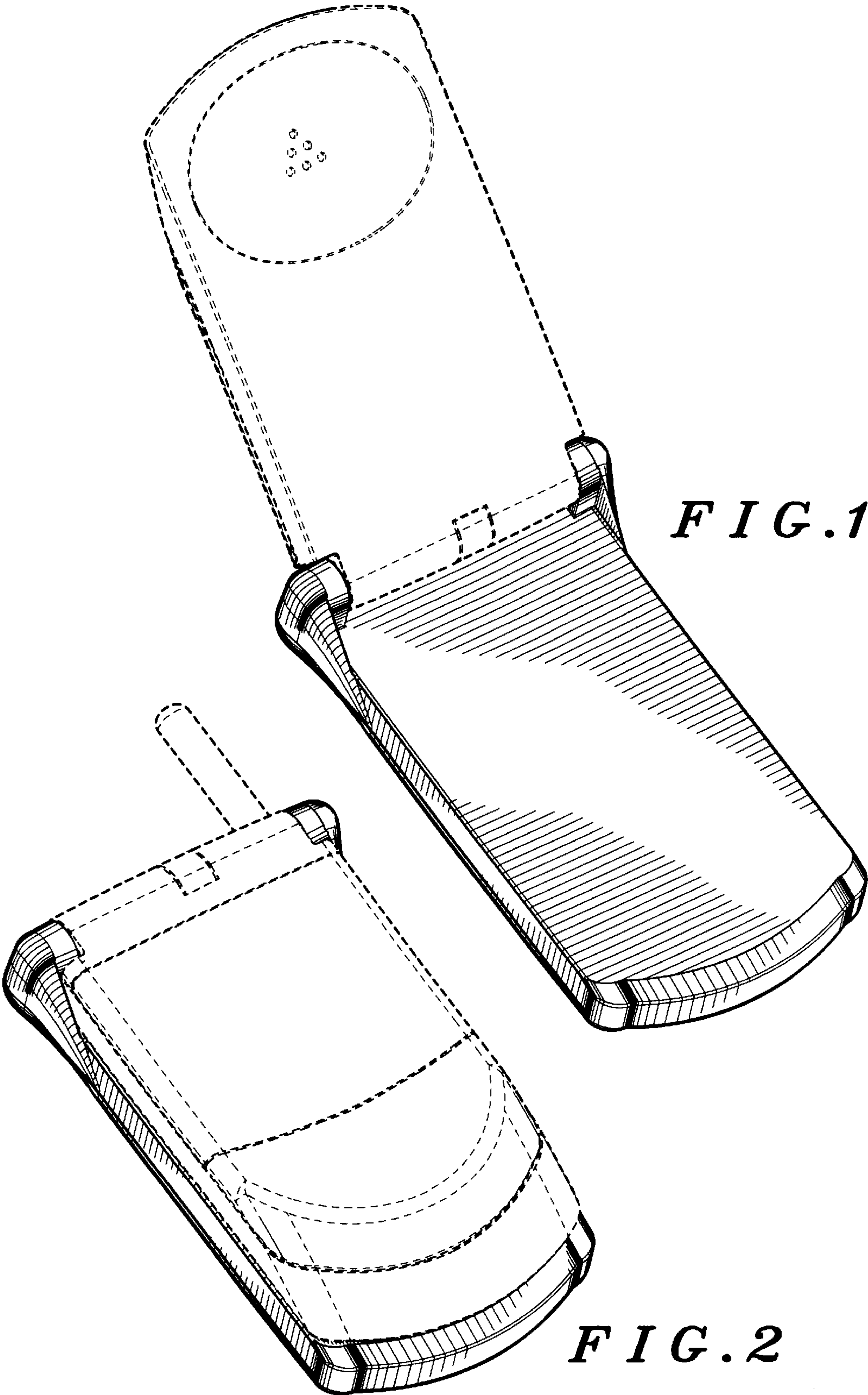
FIG. 9 is a front side elevation view thereof showing our new design in the closed position; and,

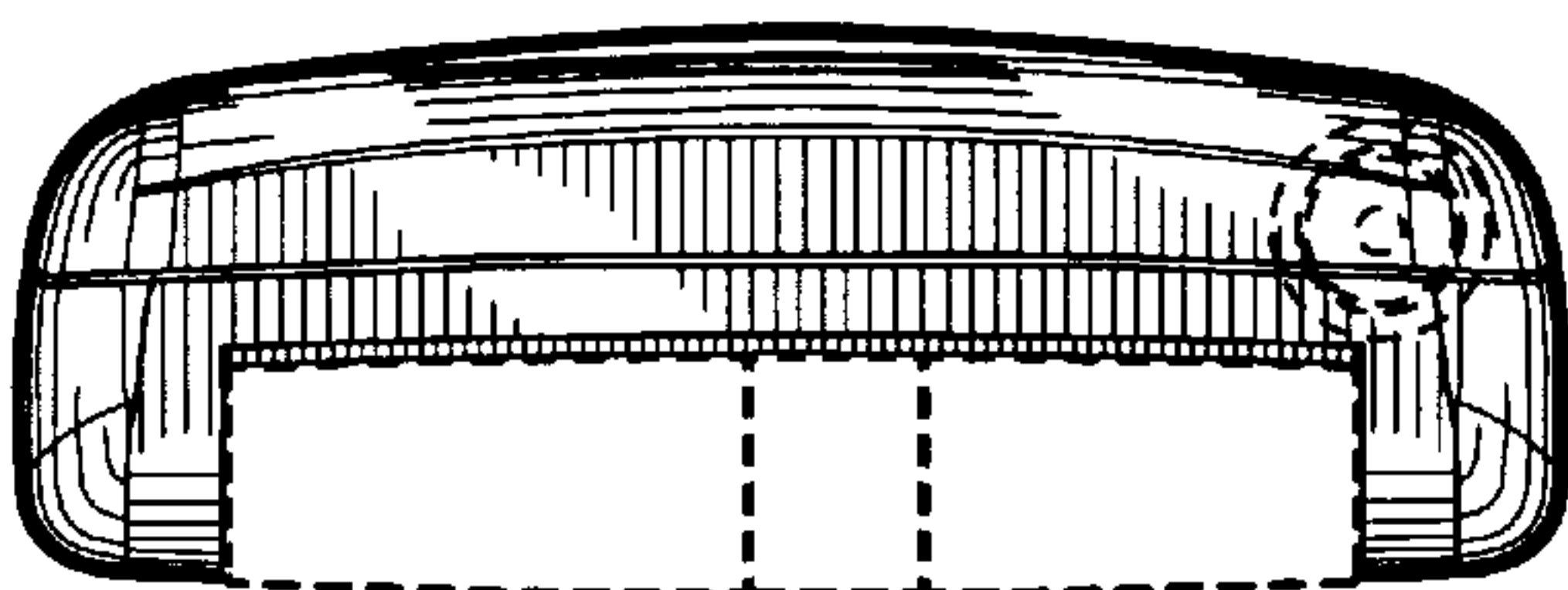

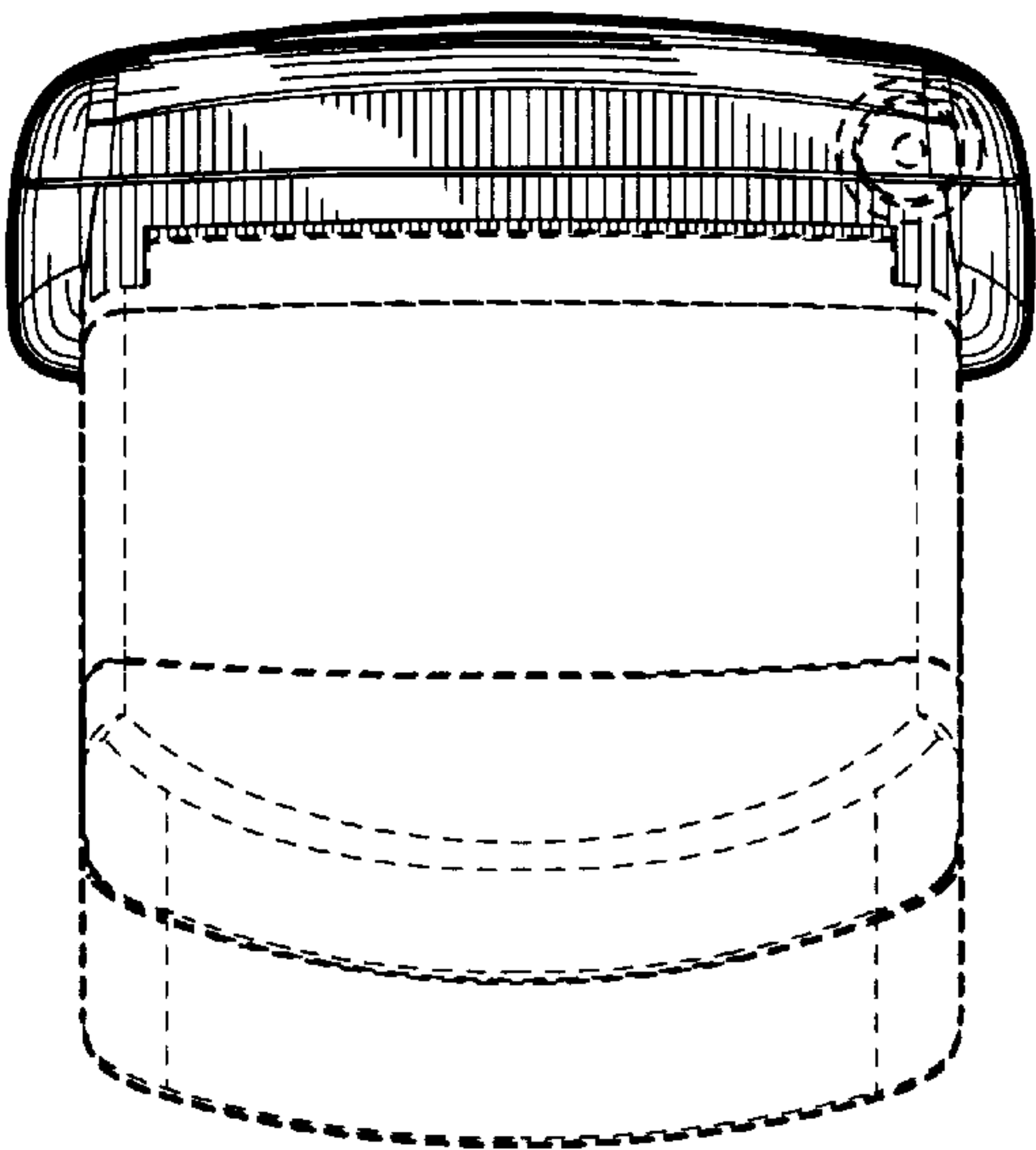

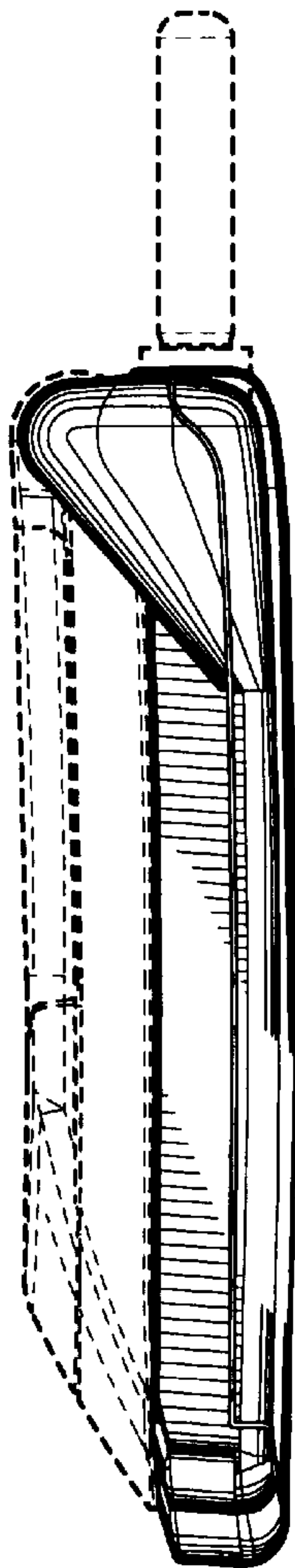
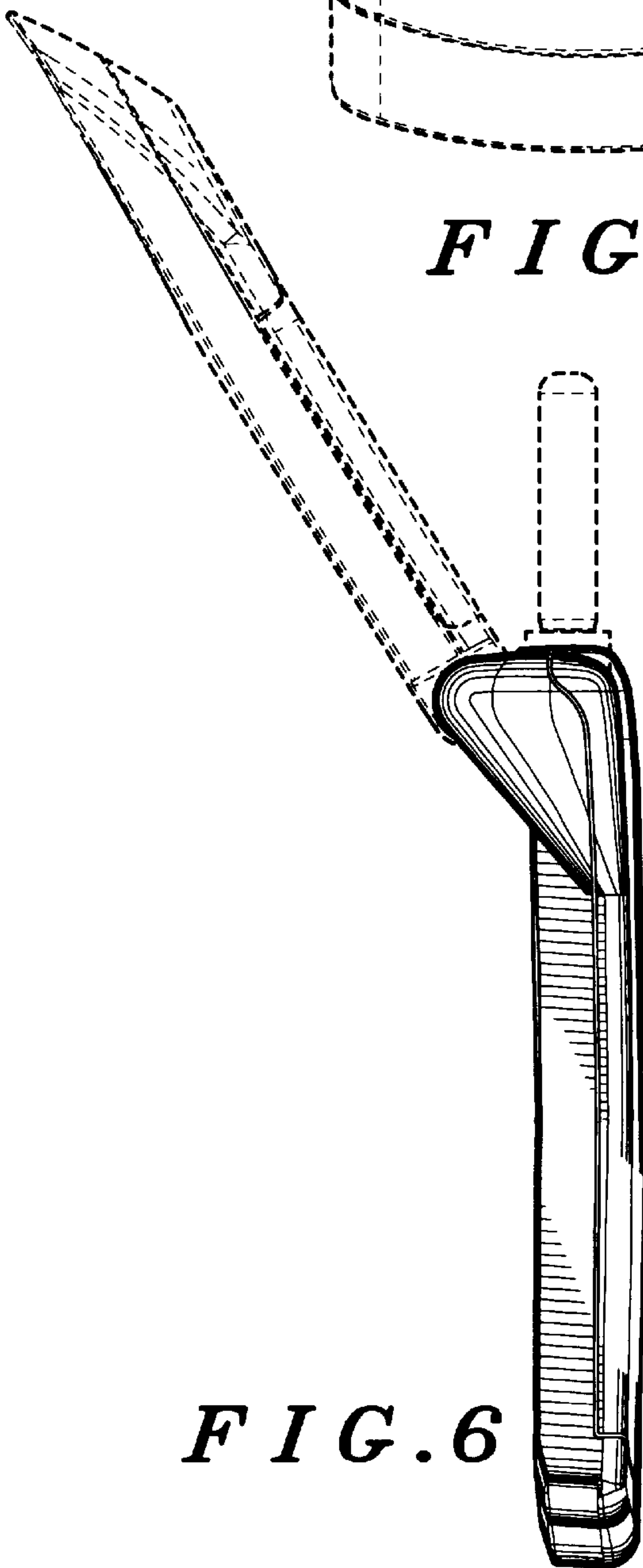

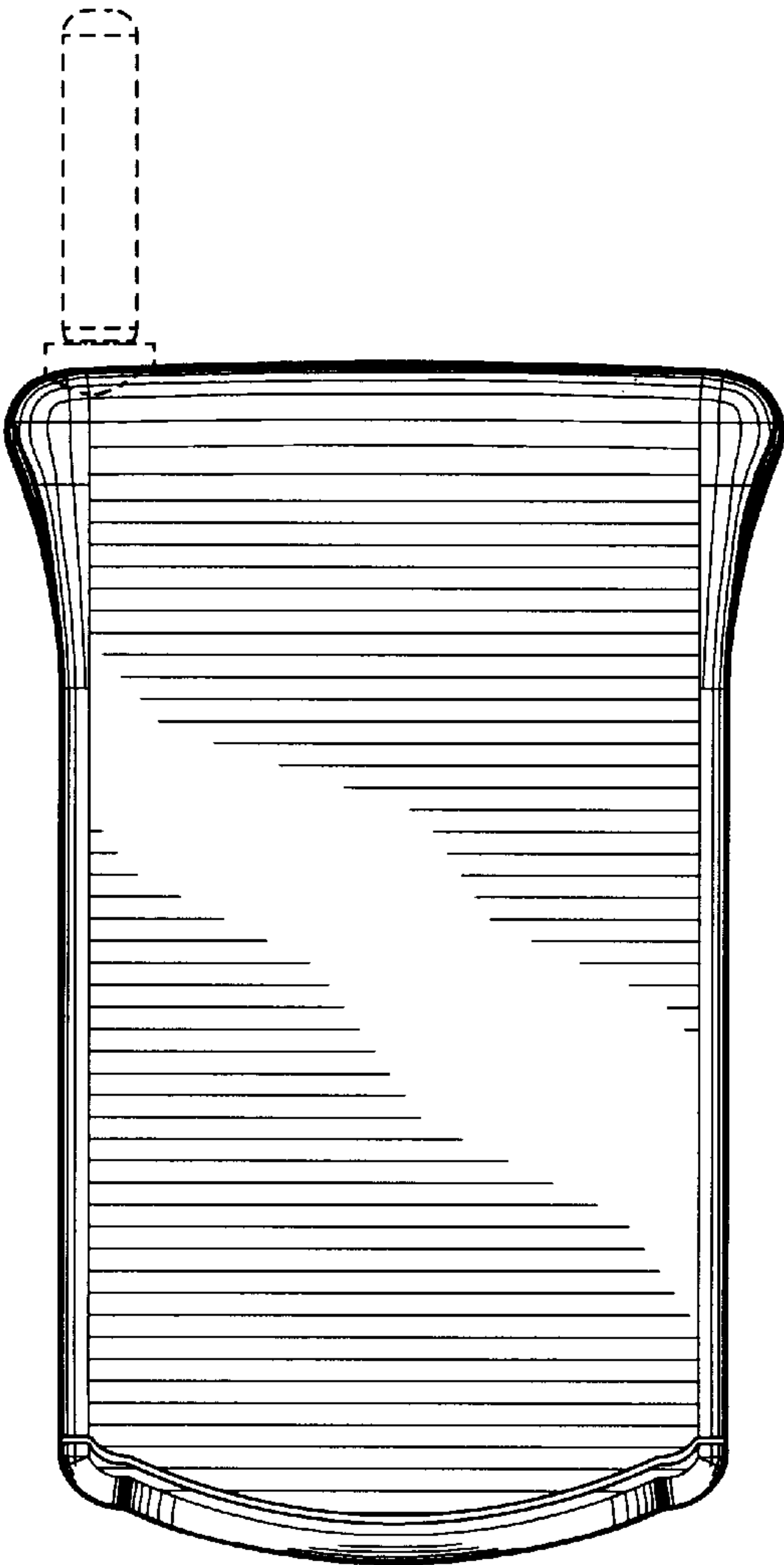

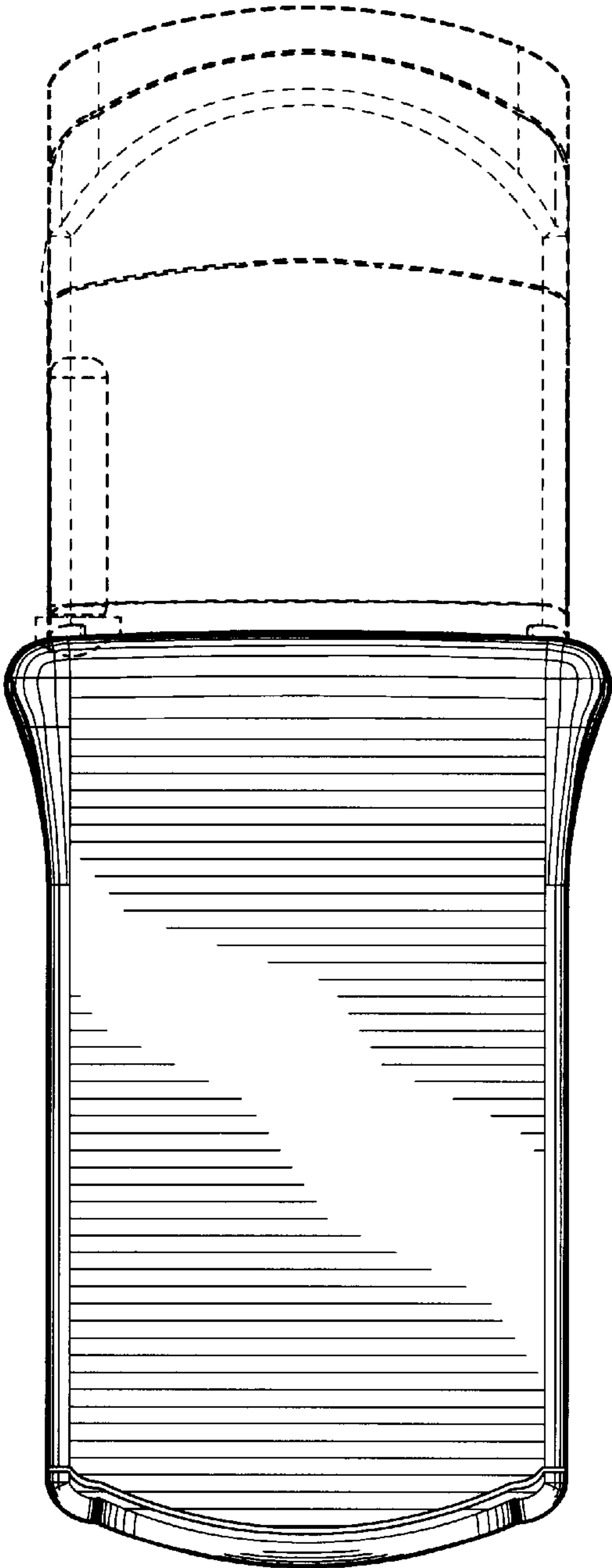

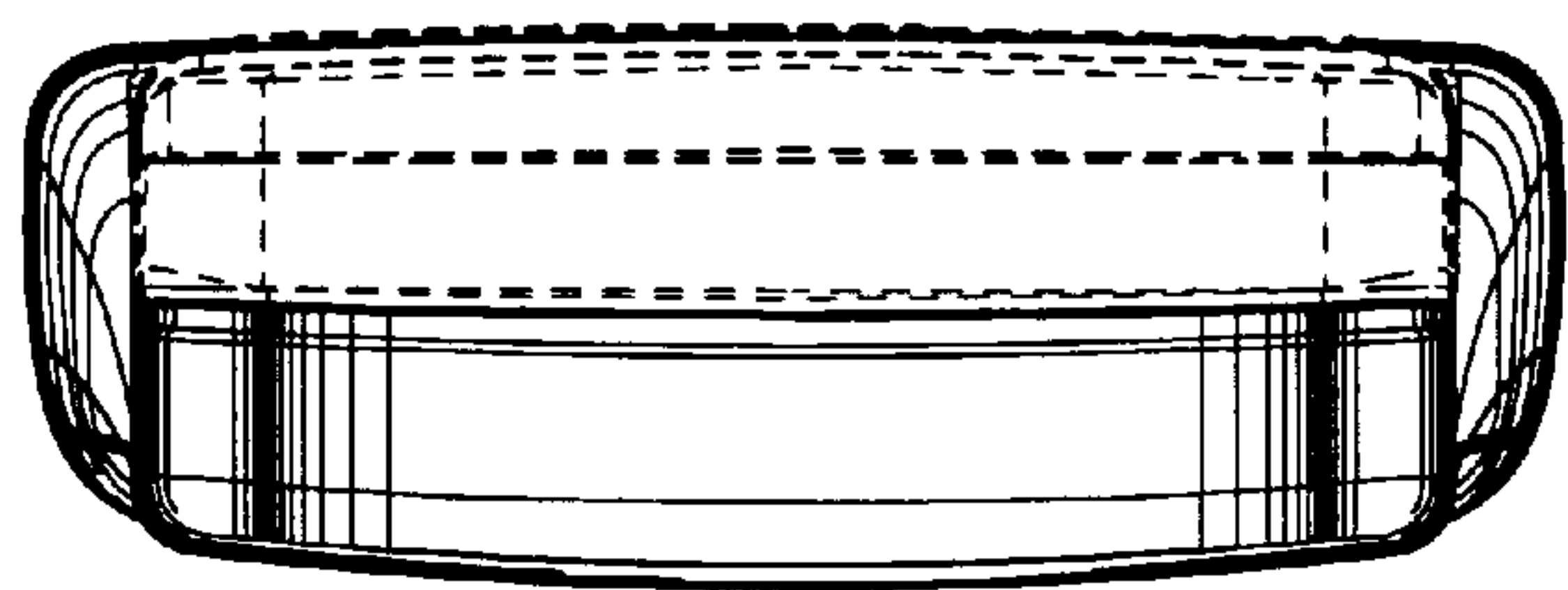

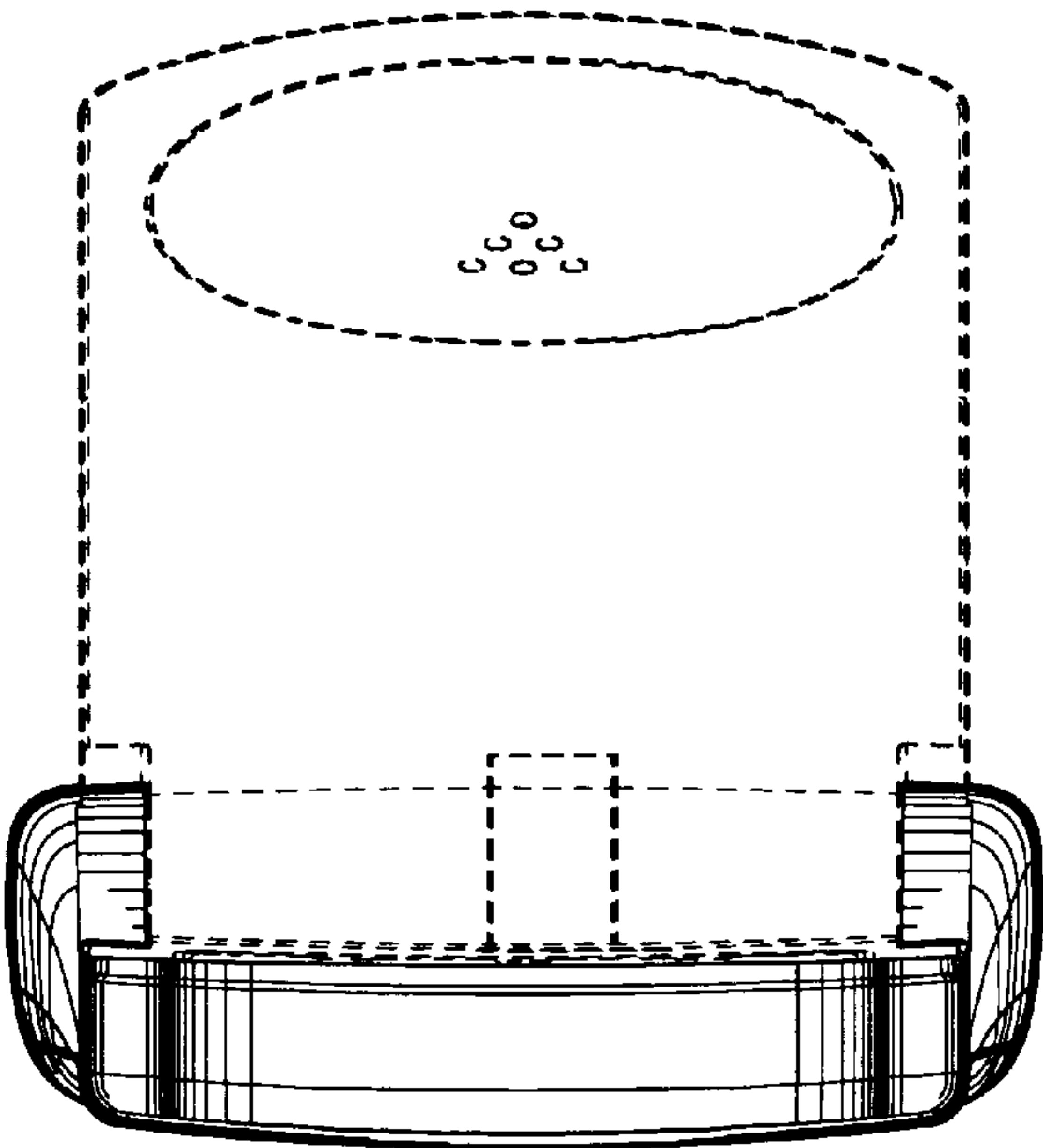
