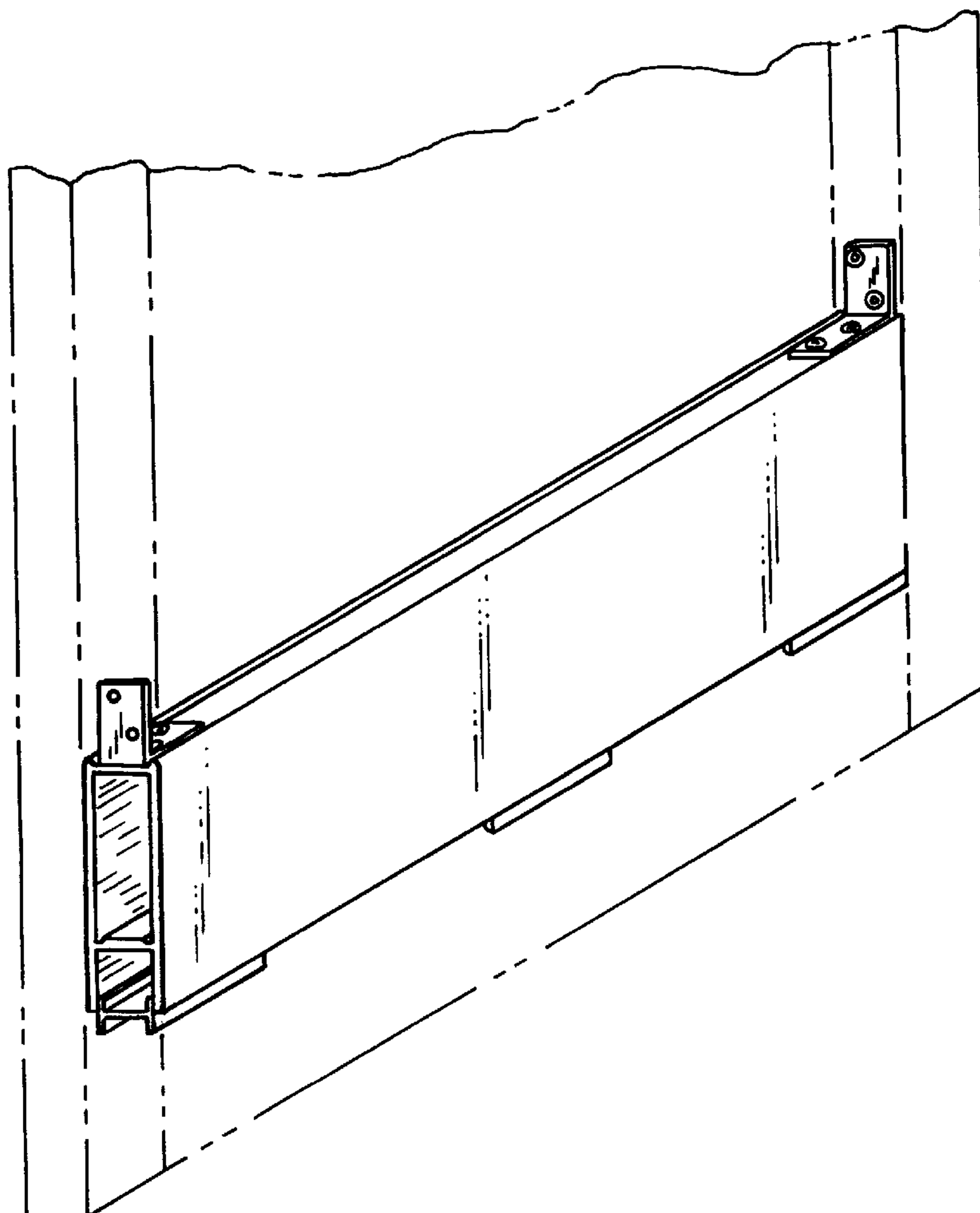

The ornamental design for a stacked rail for door, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the stacked rail for door; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear elevational view being identical thereto; and, FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof; the left side elevational view being identical thereto.

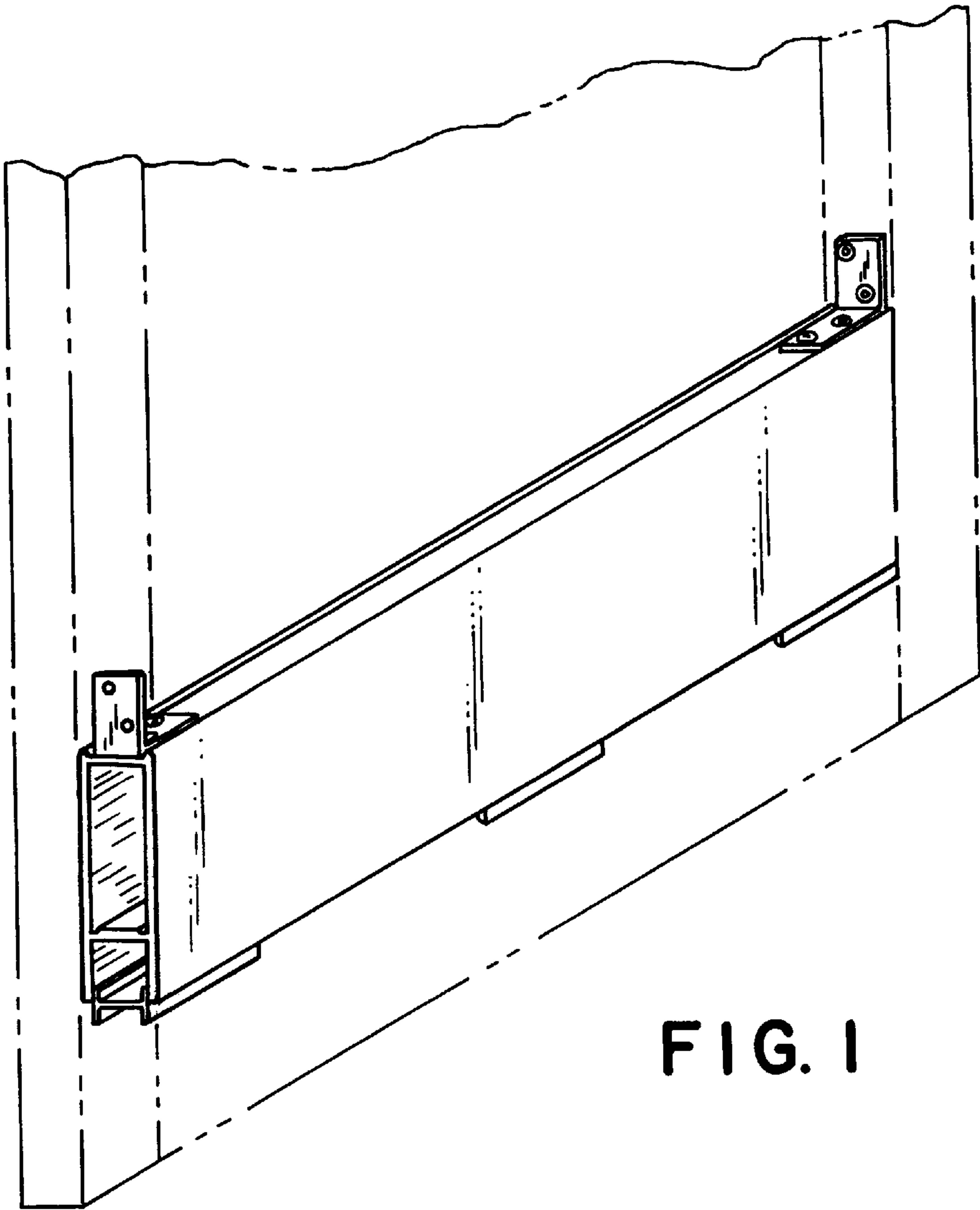

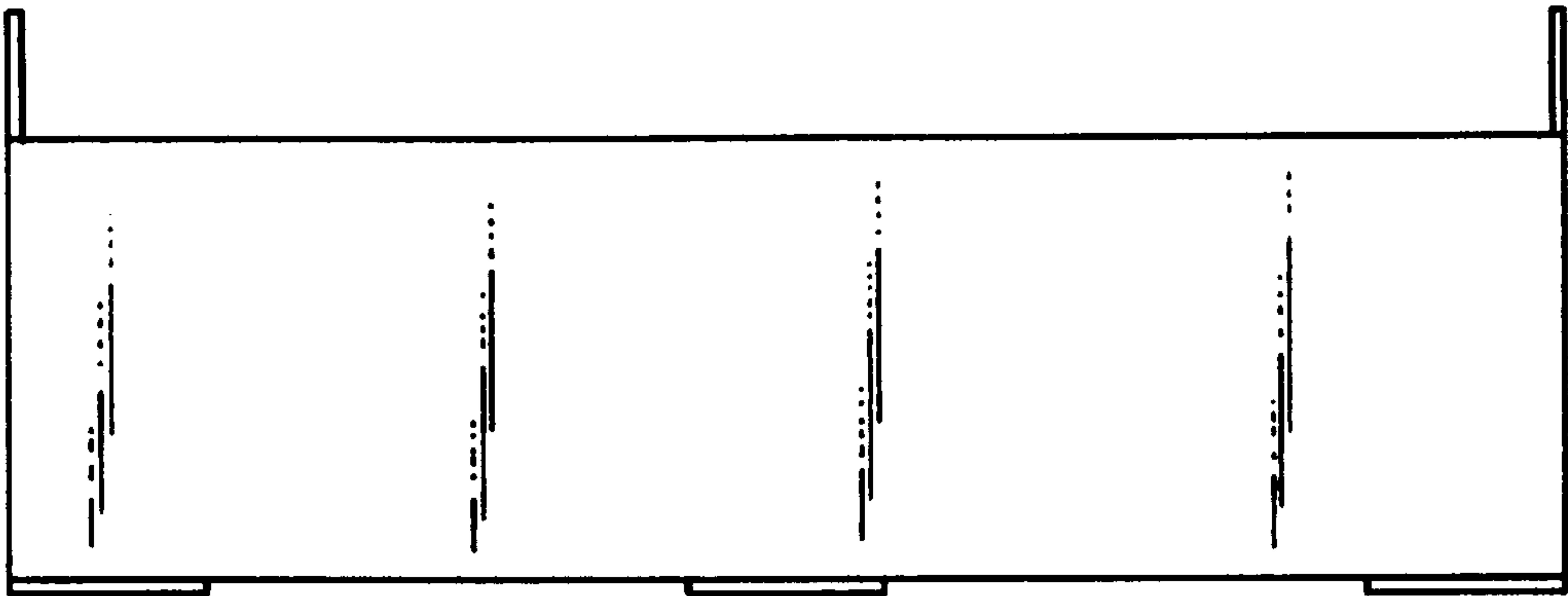

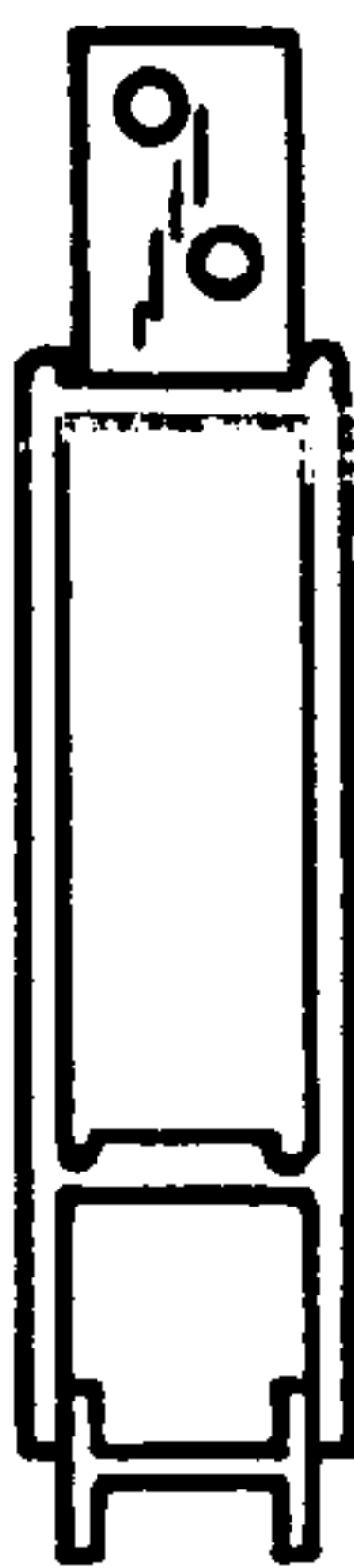
