[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a cologne bottle, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the design for a cologne bottle according to the invention;

FIG. 2 is a side view of the design for a cologne bottle according to the invention, the opposite side view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 3 is a rear view of the design for a cologne bottle according to the invention;

FIG. 4 is a front view of the design for a cologne bottle according to the invention;

FIG. 5 is an overhead view of the design for a cologne bottle according to the invention;

FIG. 6 is an underside view of a cologne bottle according to the invention;

FIG. 7 is an exploded view of a cologne bottle according to the invention;

FIG. 8 is a perspective view of a second embodiment of a cologne bottle according to the invention;

FIG. 9 is a side view of a second embodiment of a cologne bottle according to the invention, the opposite side view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 10 is a rear view of a second embodiment of a cologne bottle according to the invention;

FIG. 11 is a front view of a second embodiment of a cologne bottle according to the invention;

FIG. 12 is an overhead view of a second embodiment of a cologne bottle according to the invention;

FIG. 13 is an underside view of a second embodiment of a cologne bottle according to the invention;

FIG. 14 is a perspective view of a third embodiment of a cologne bottle according to the invention;

FIG. 15 is a side view of a third embodiment of a cologne bottle according to the invention, the opposite side view being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 16 is a rear view of a third embodiment of a cologne bottle according to the invention;

FIG. 17 is a front view of third embodiment of a cologne bottle according to the invention;

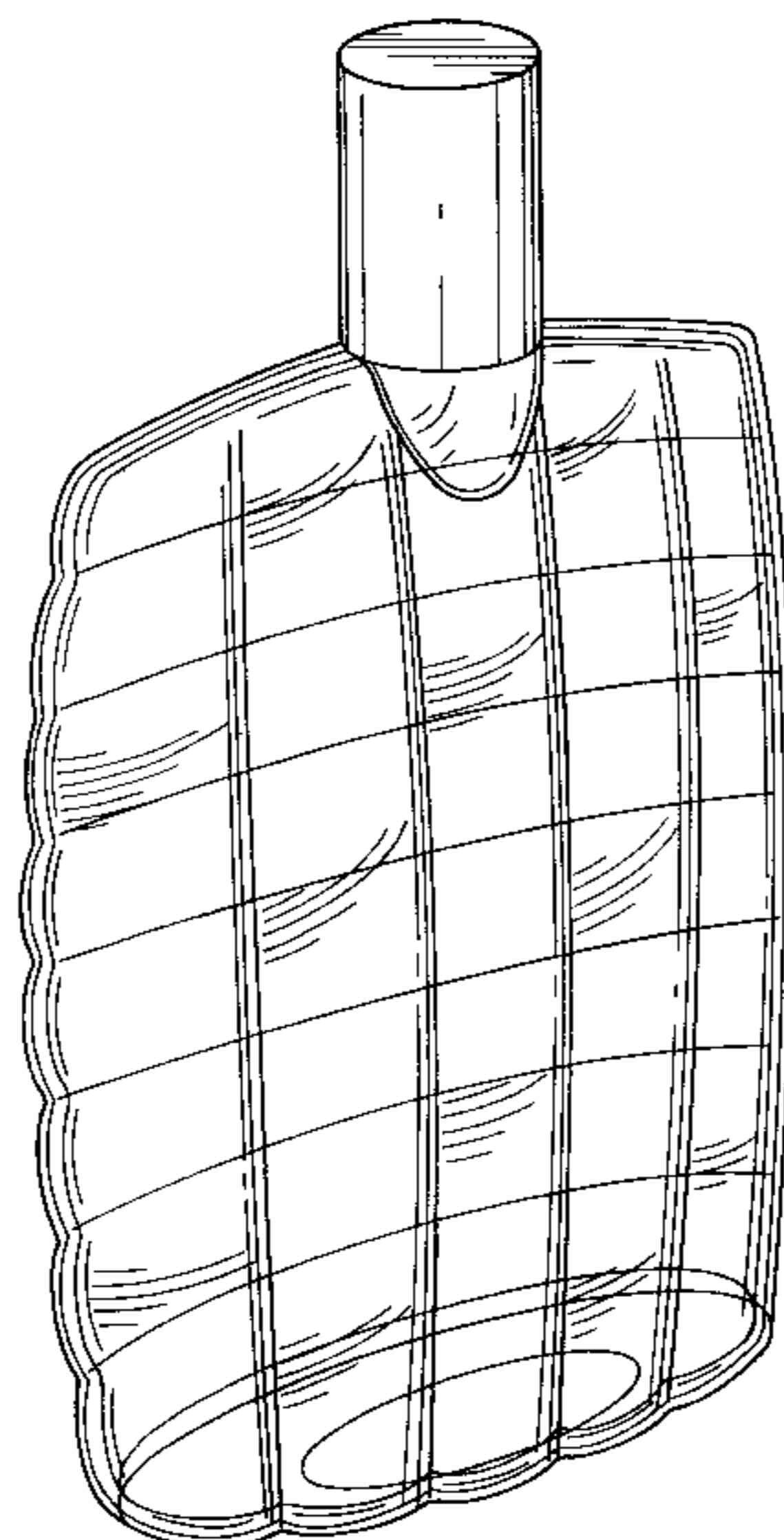
FIG. 18 is an overhead view of third embodiment of a cologne bottle according to the invention; and,

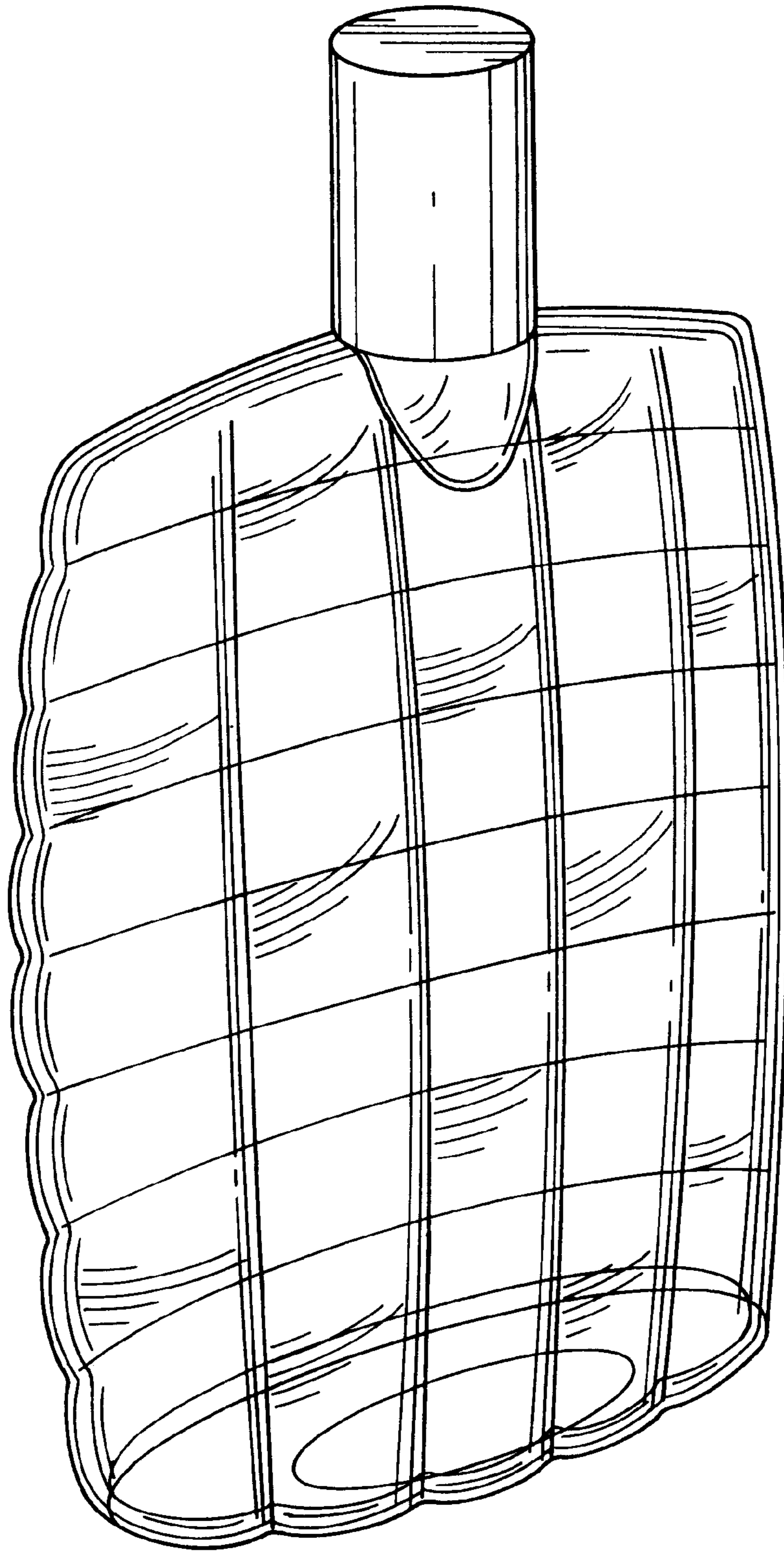

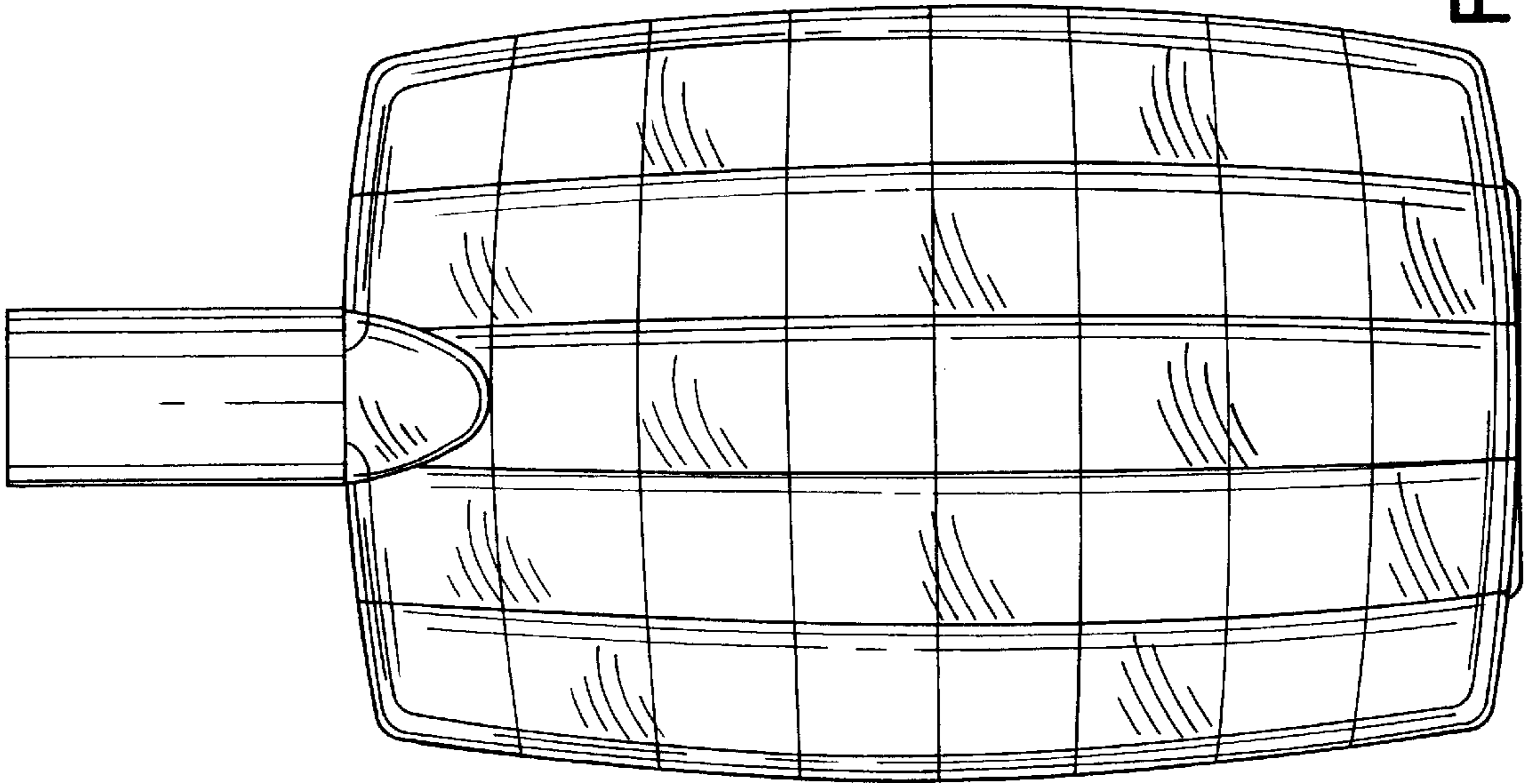

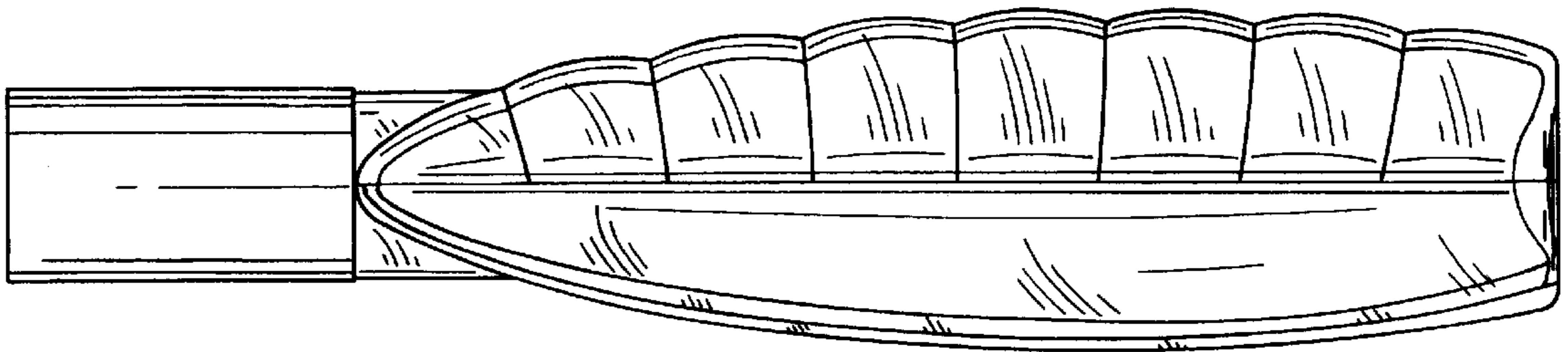

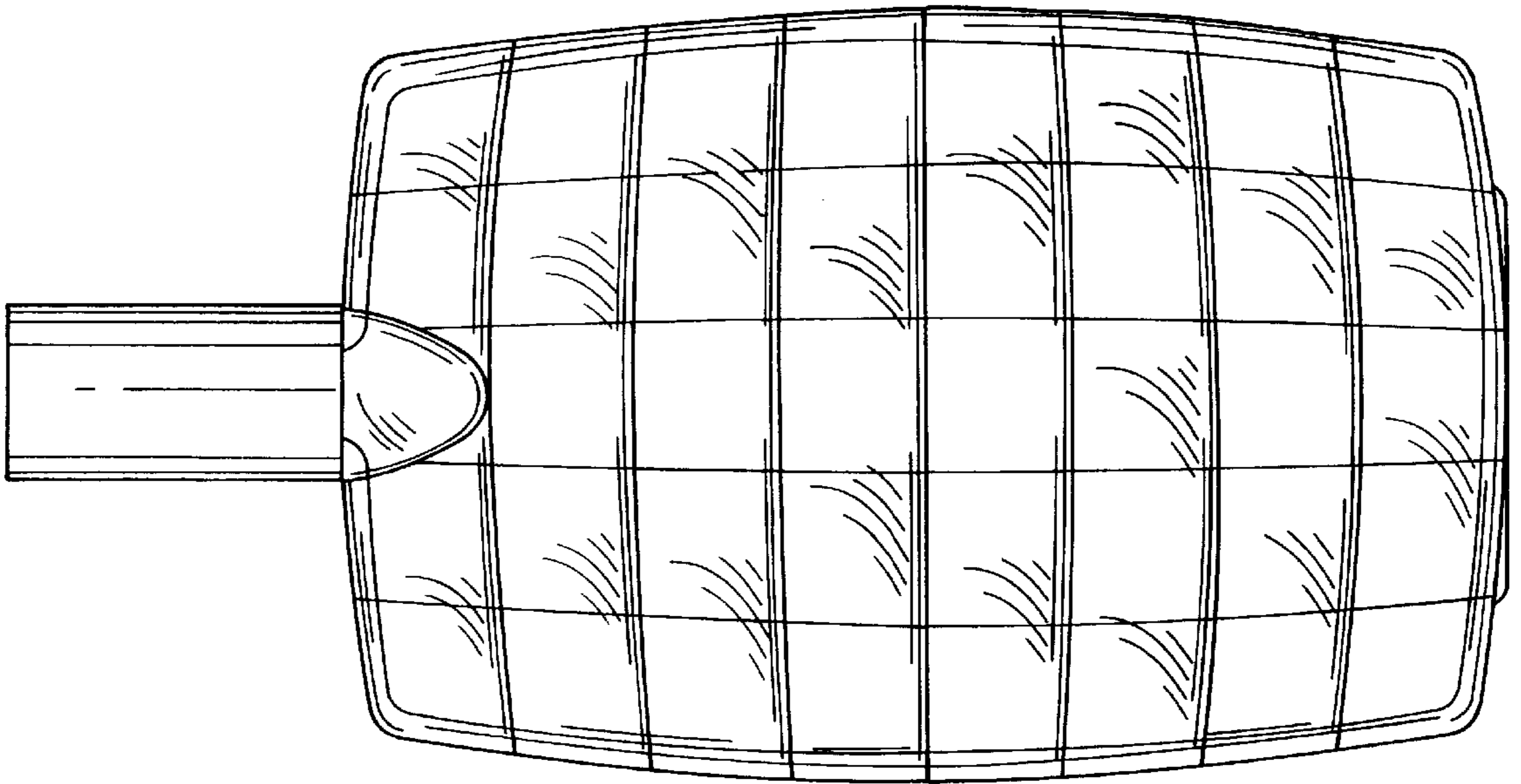

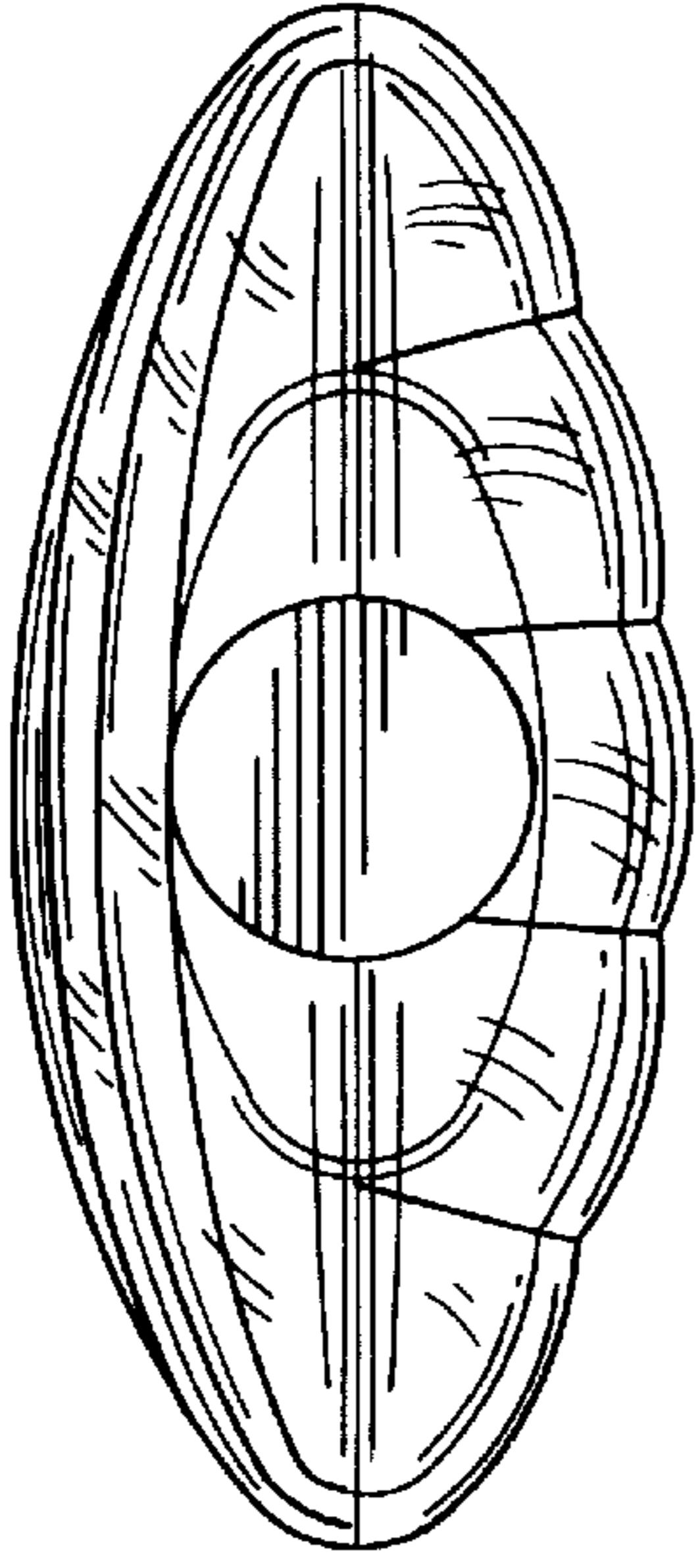

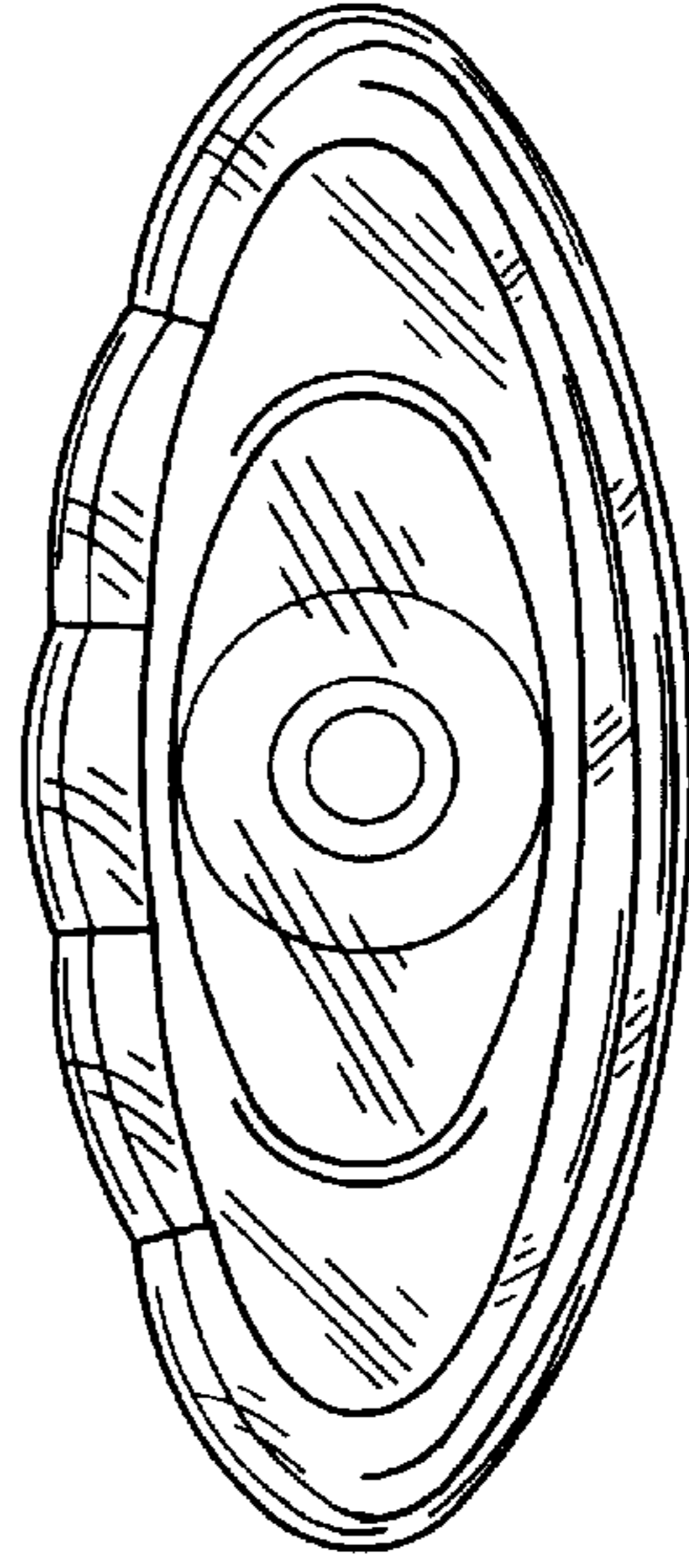

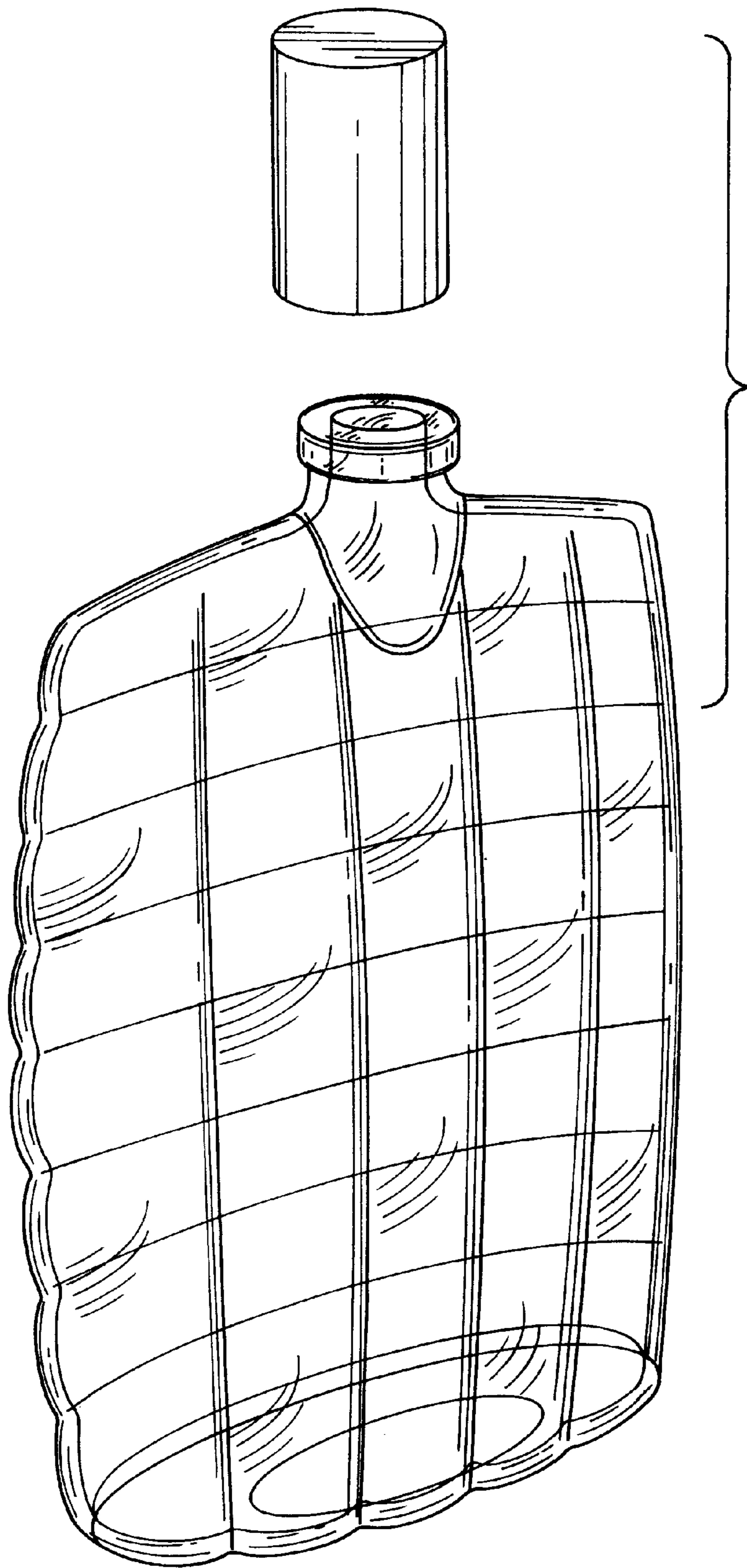

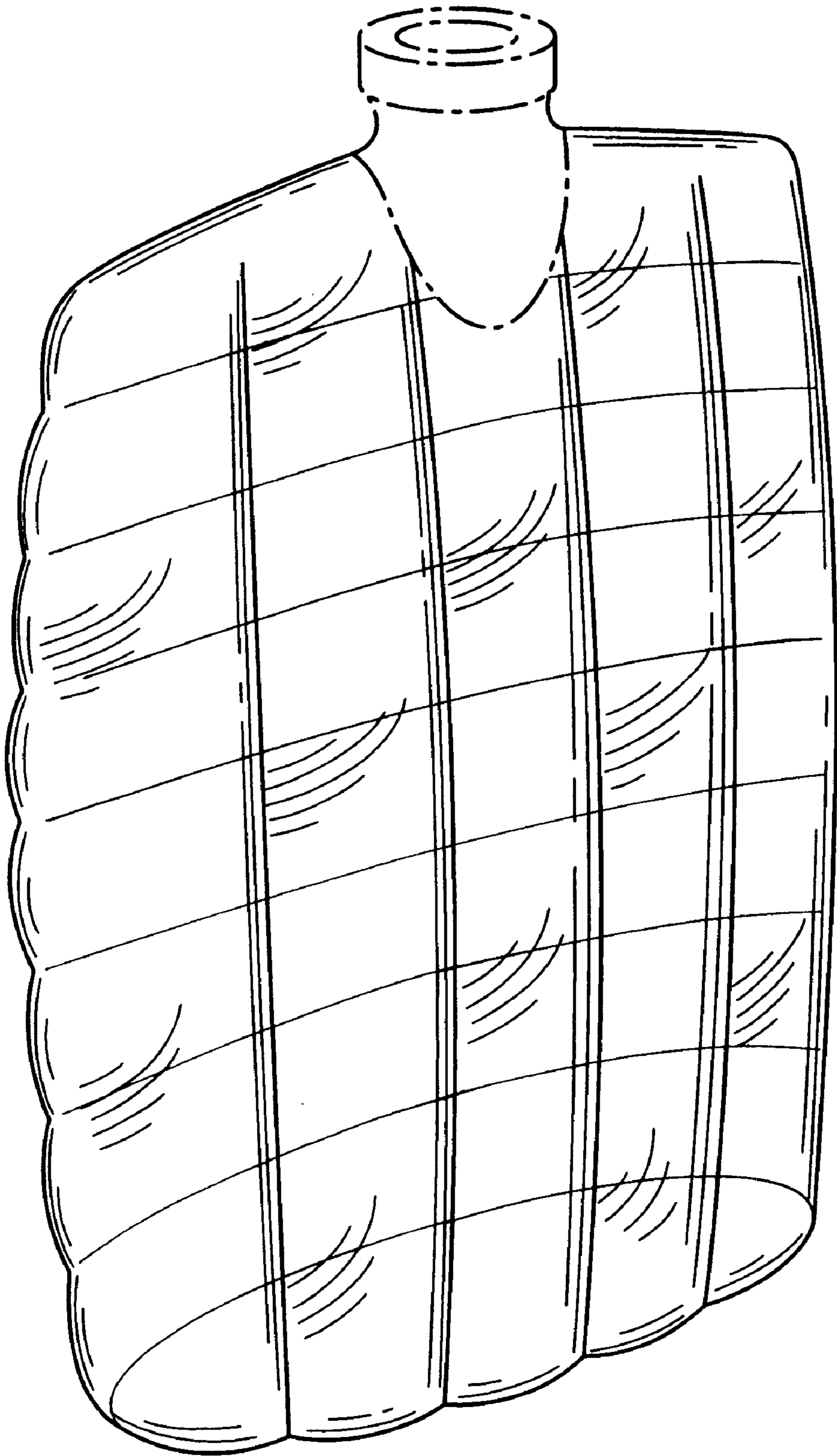

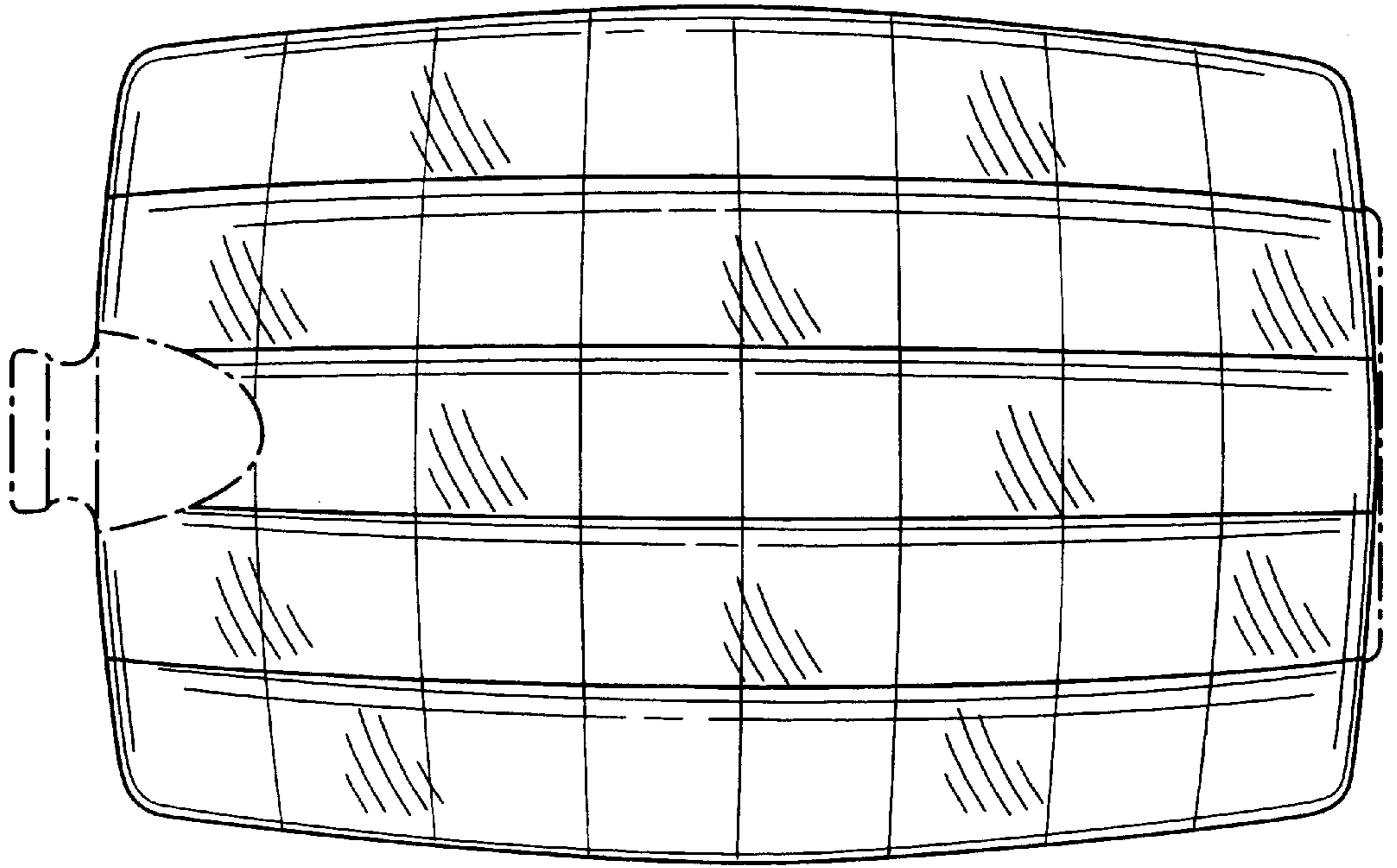

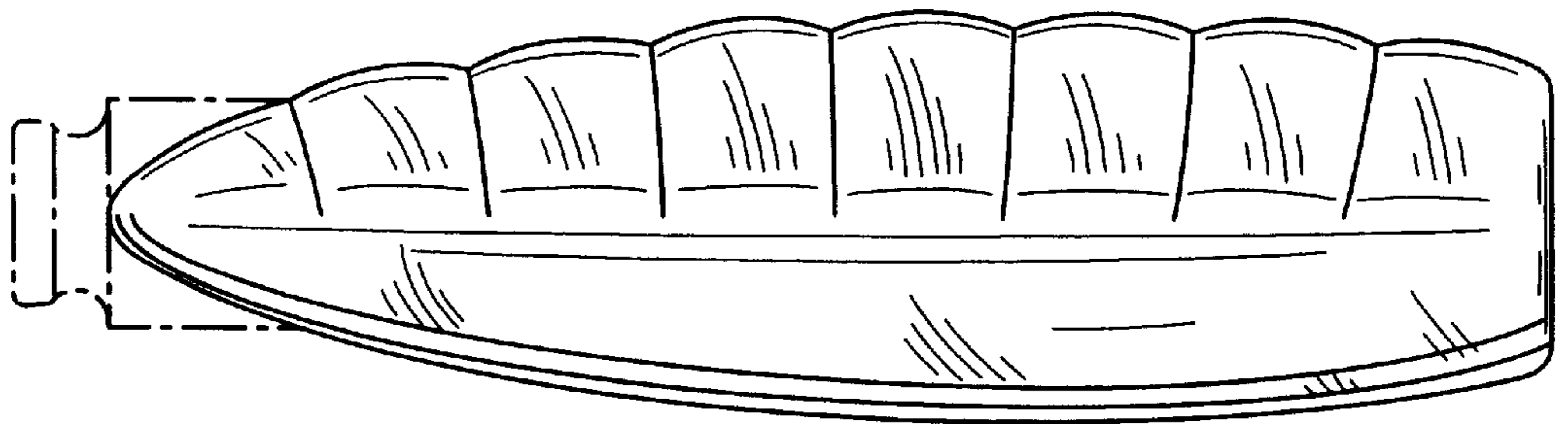

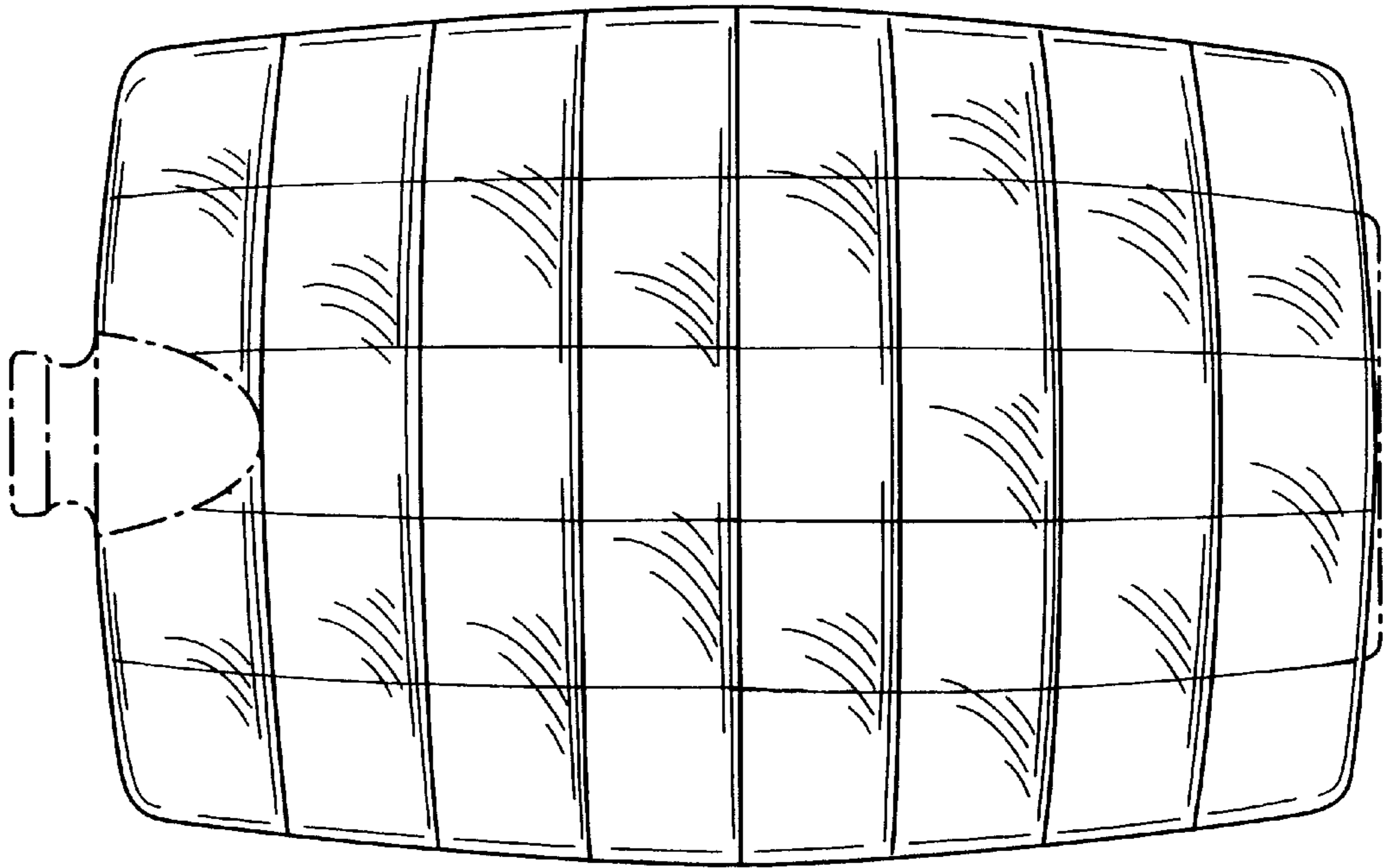

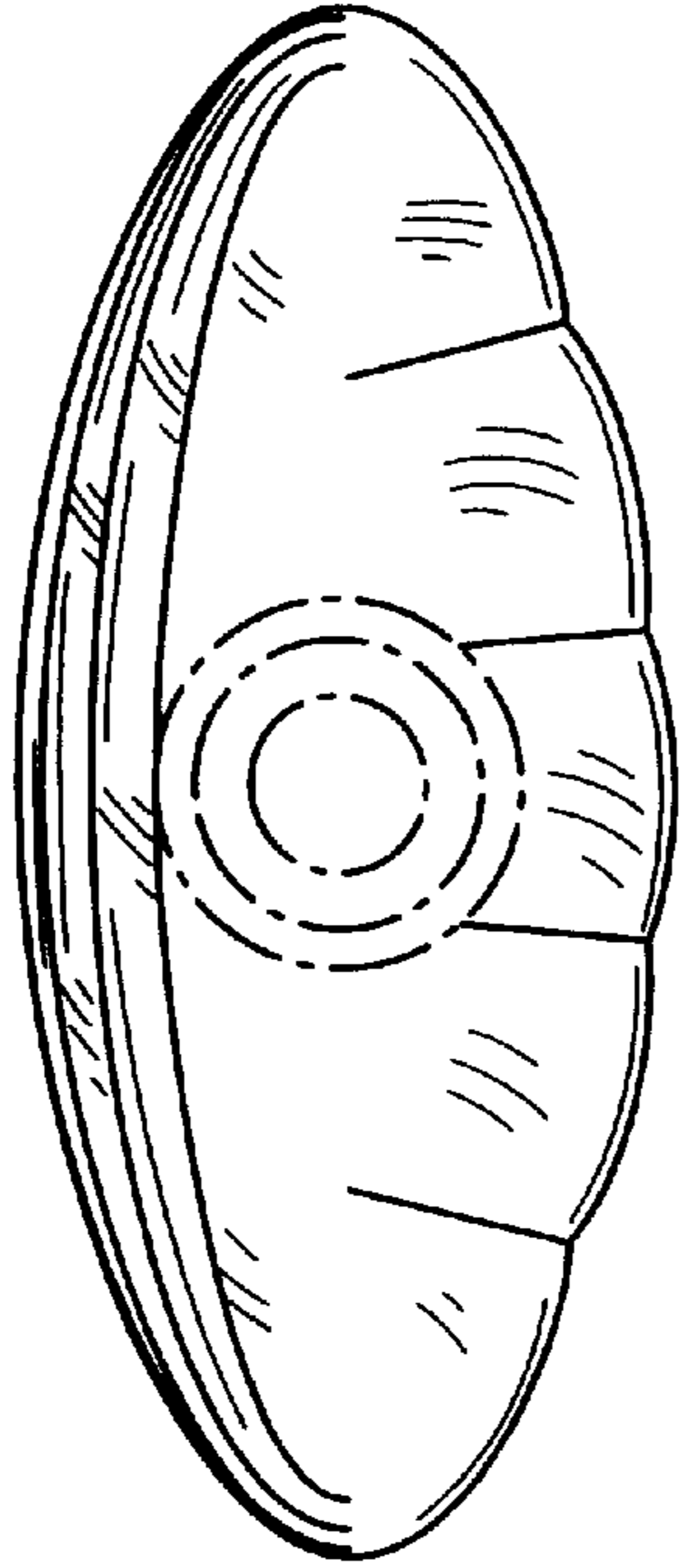

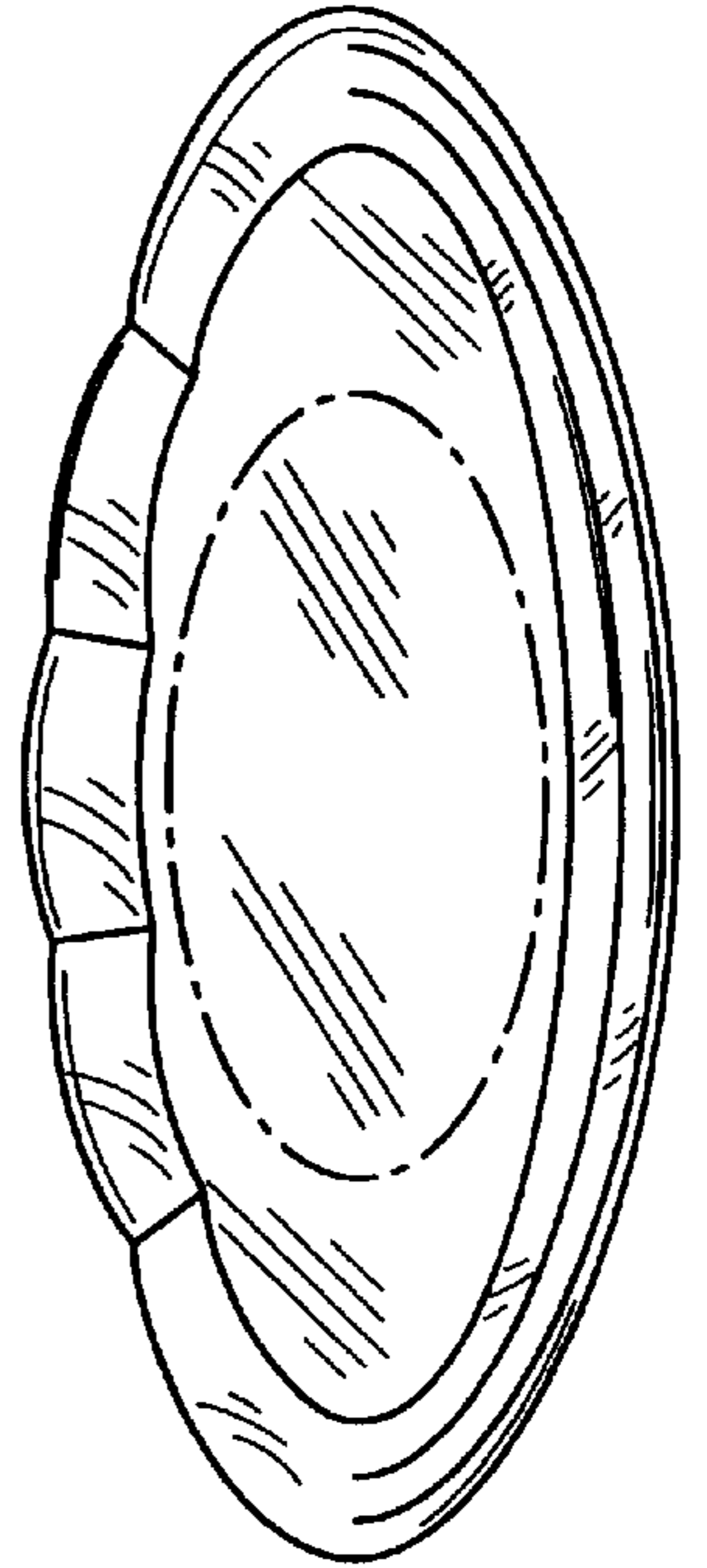

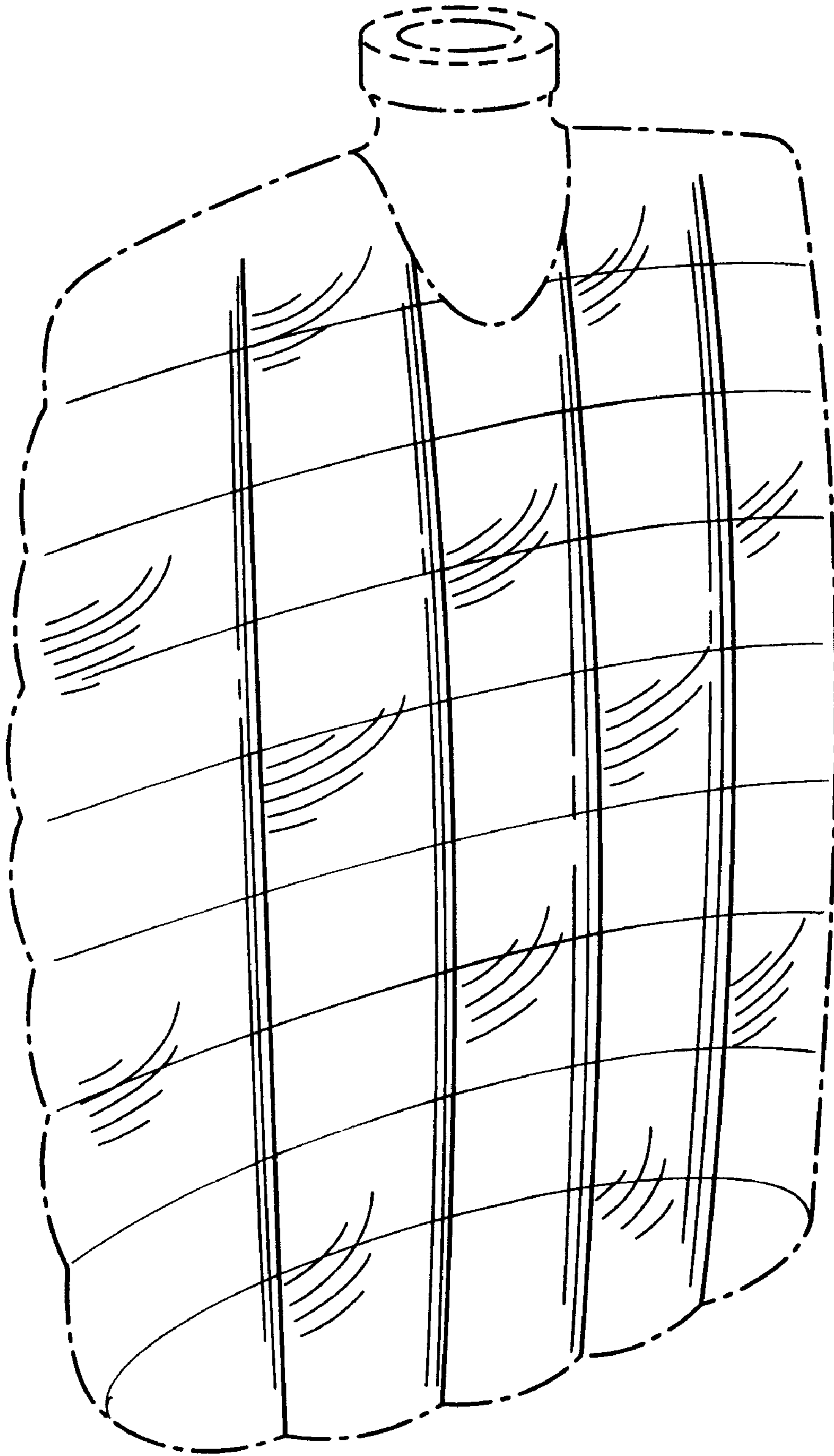

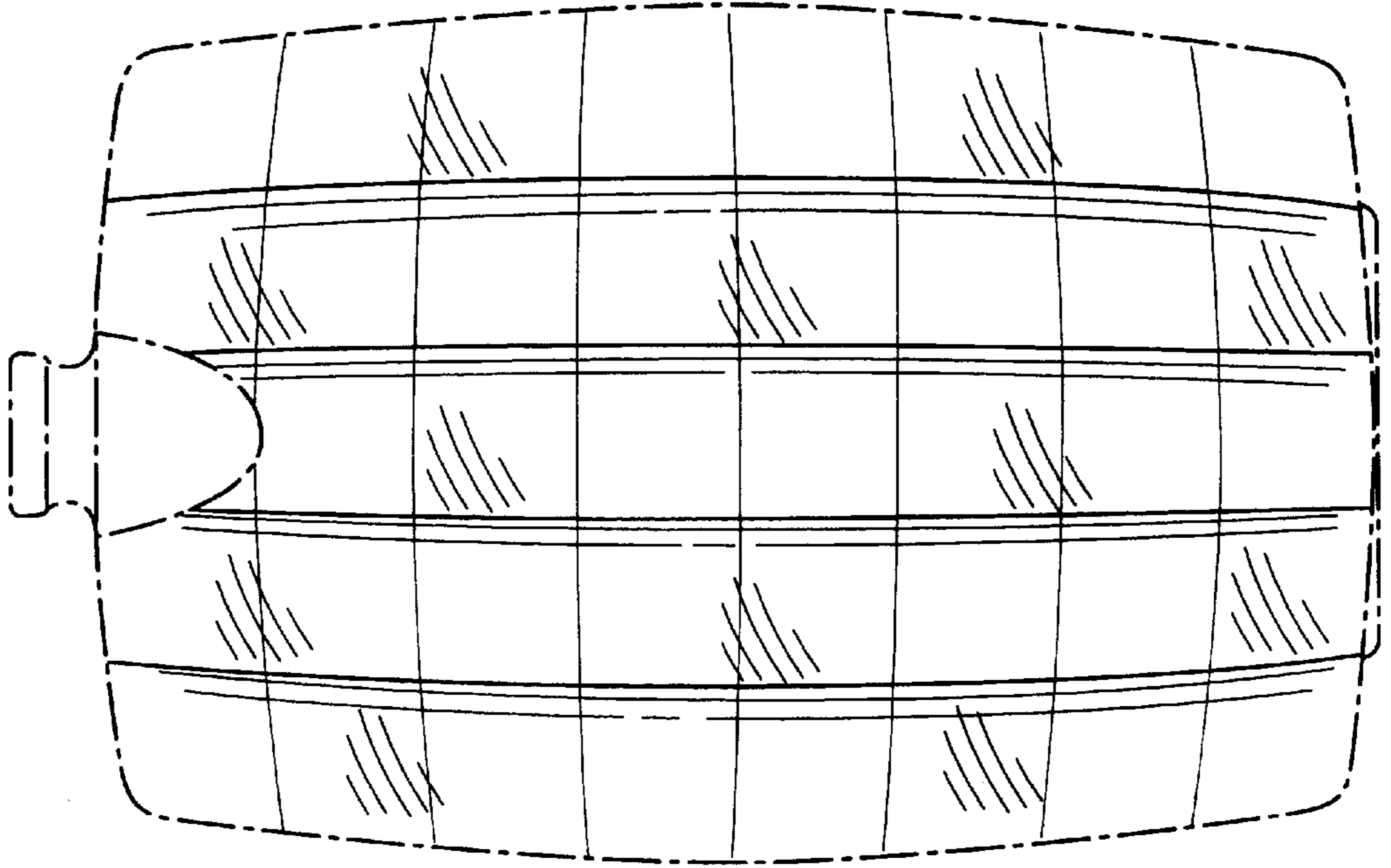

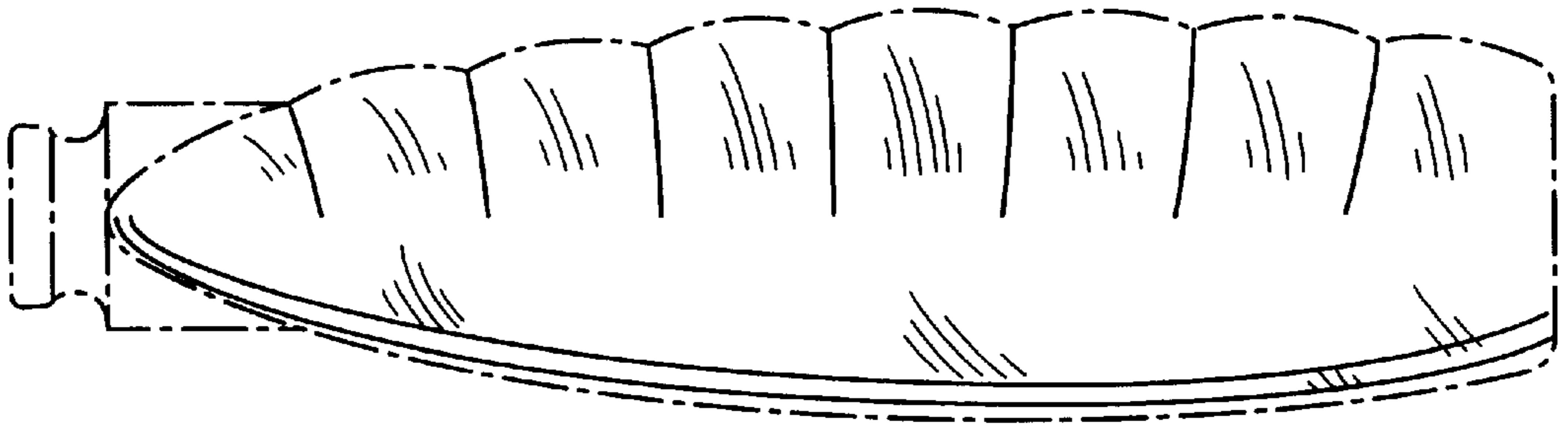

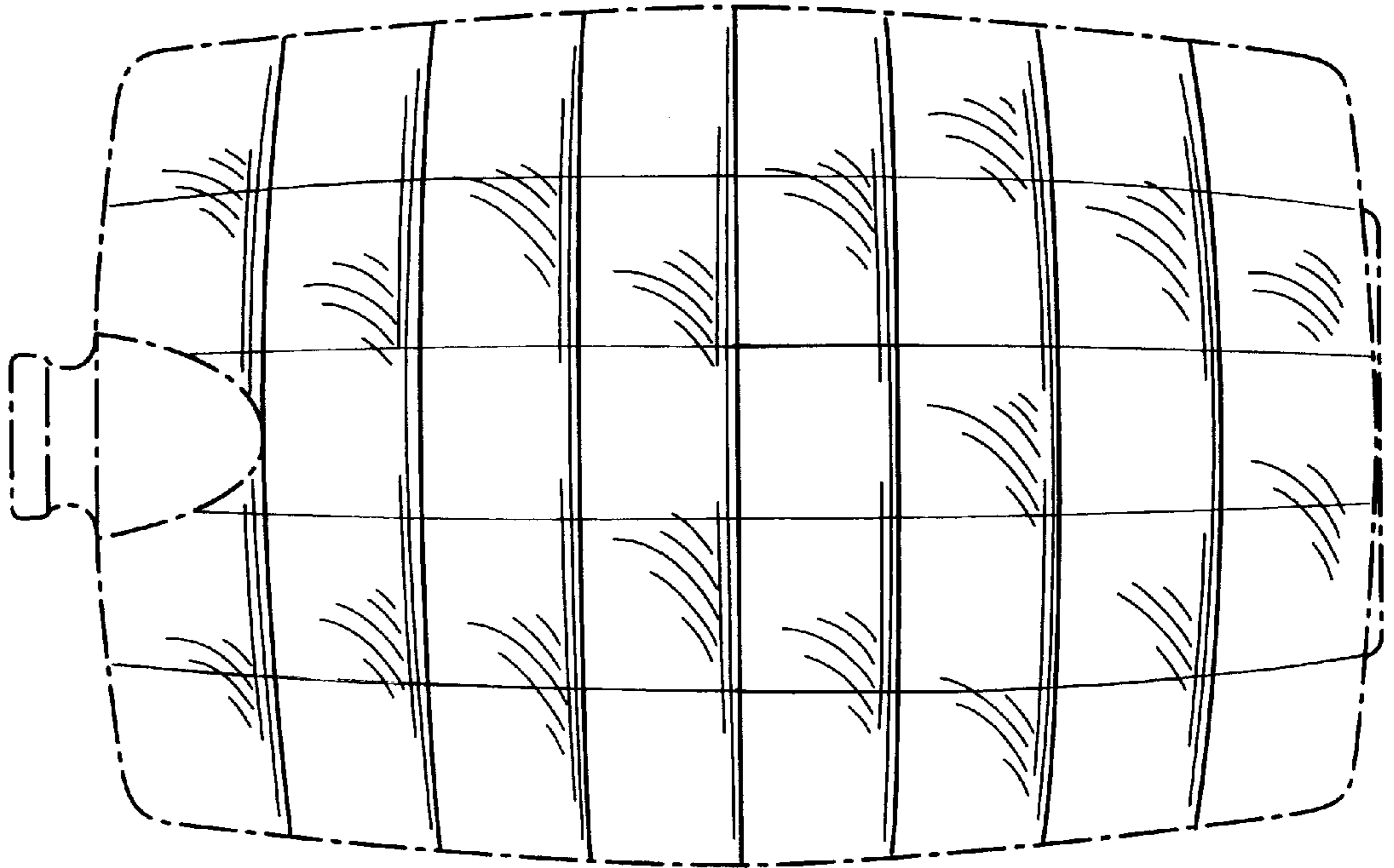

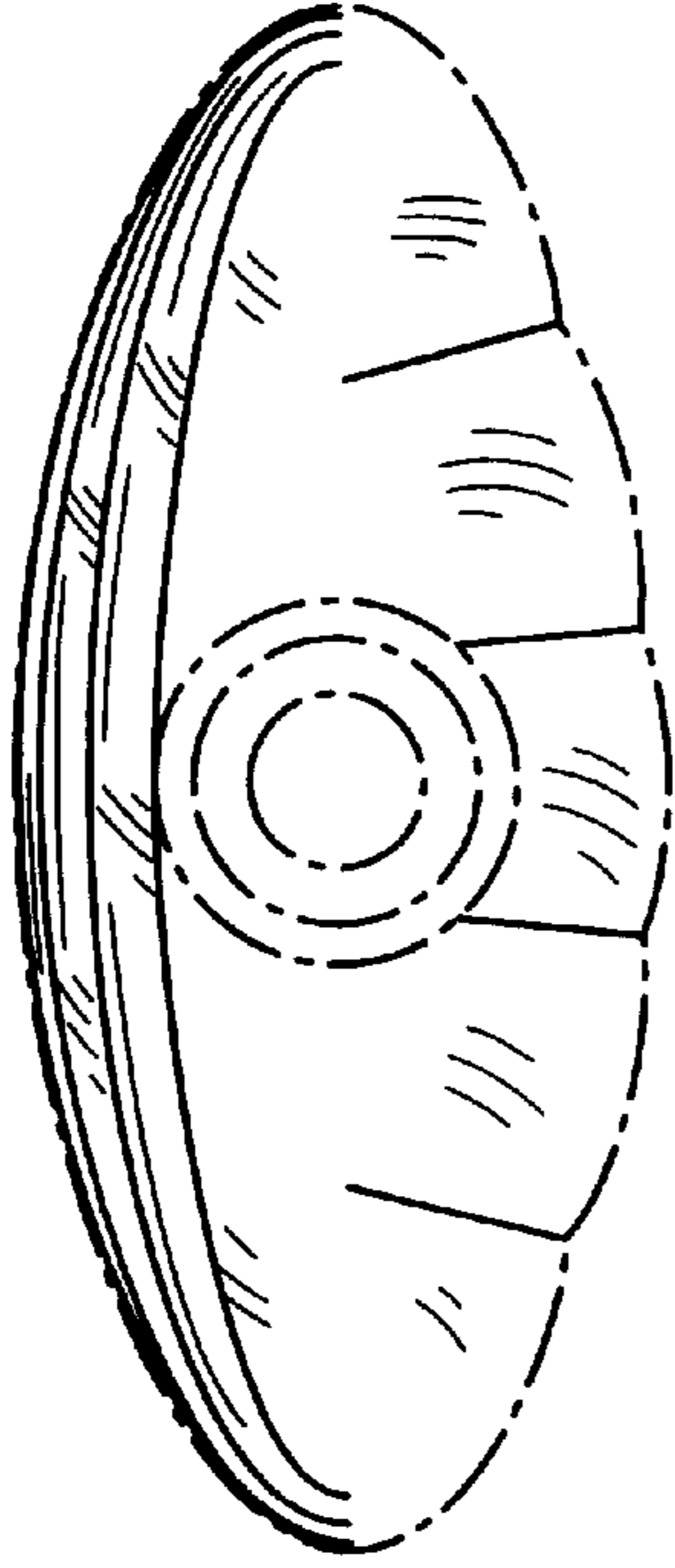
