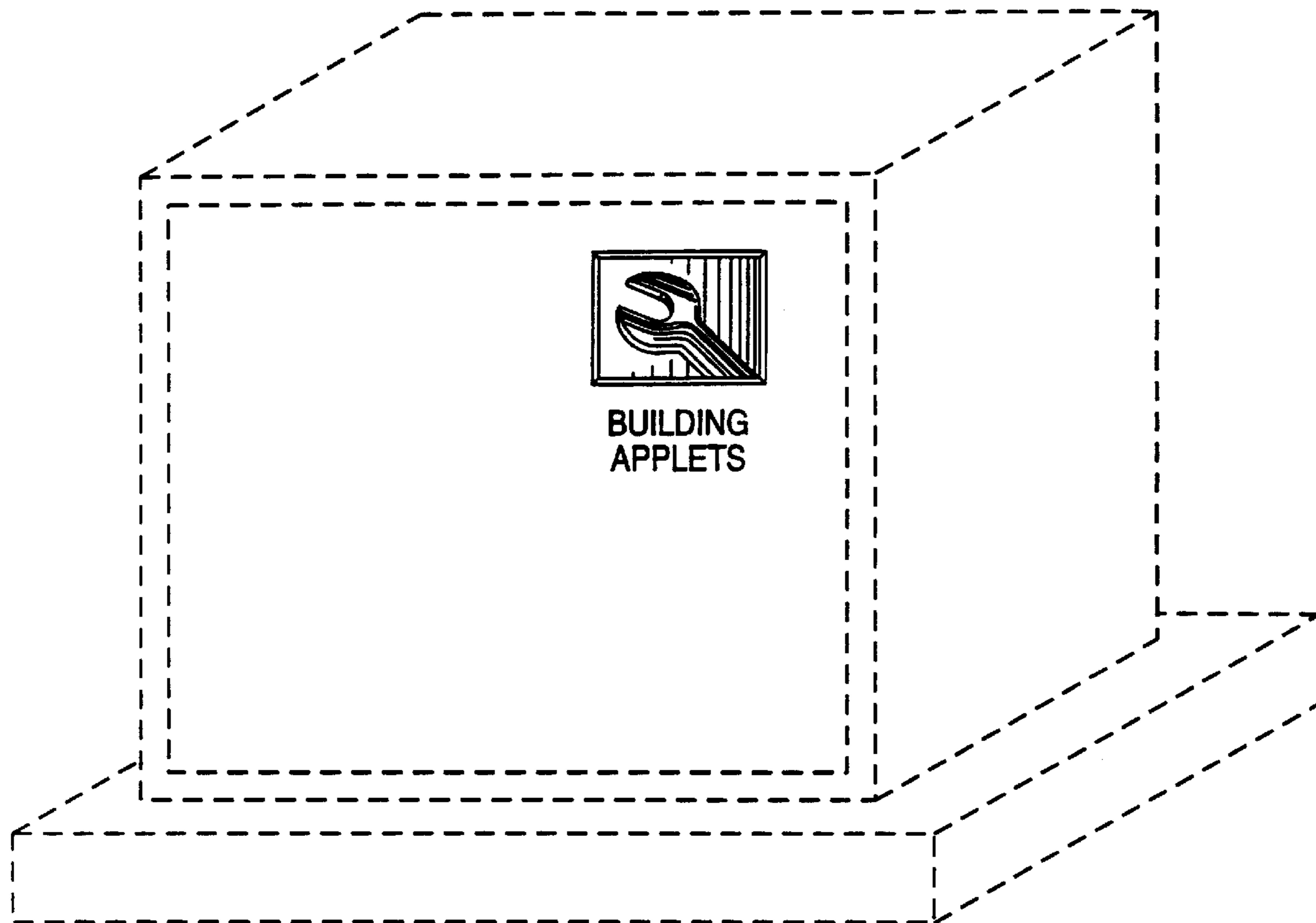
[57] CLAIM

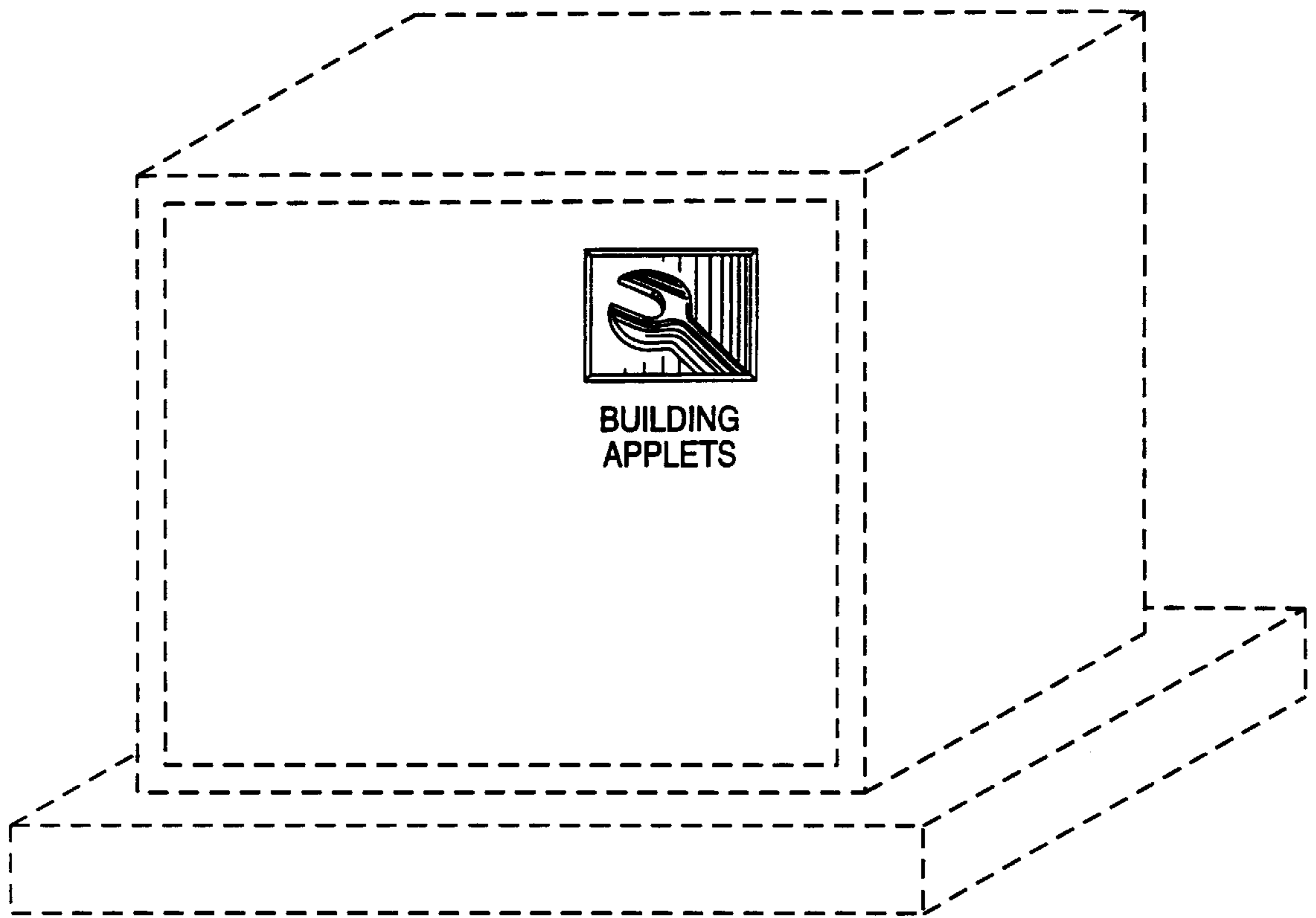

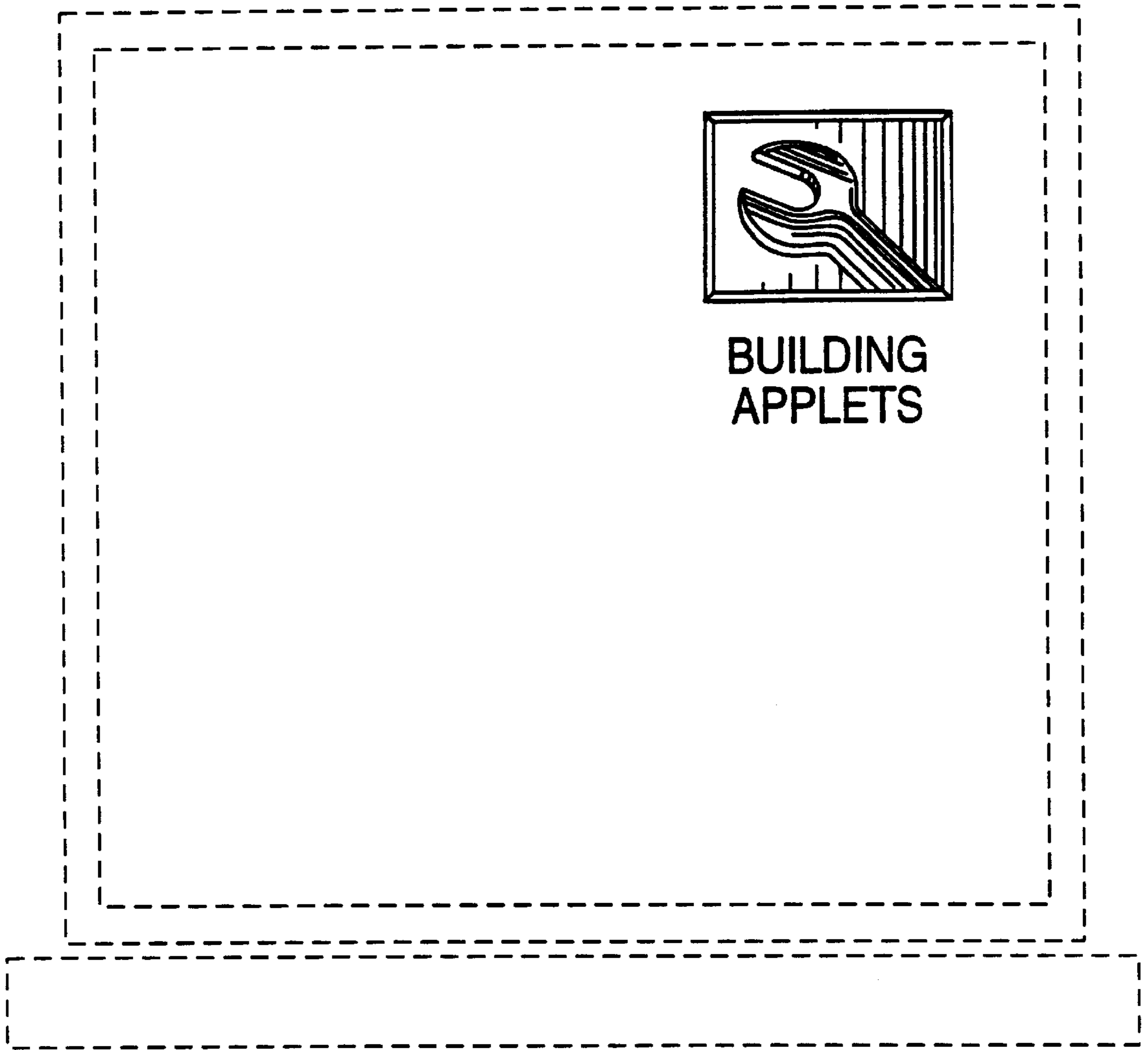
