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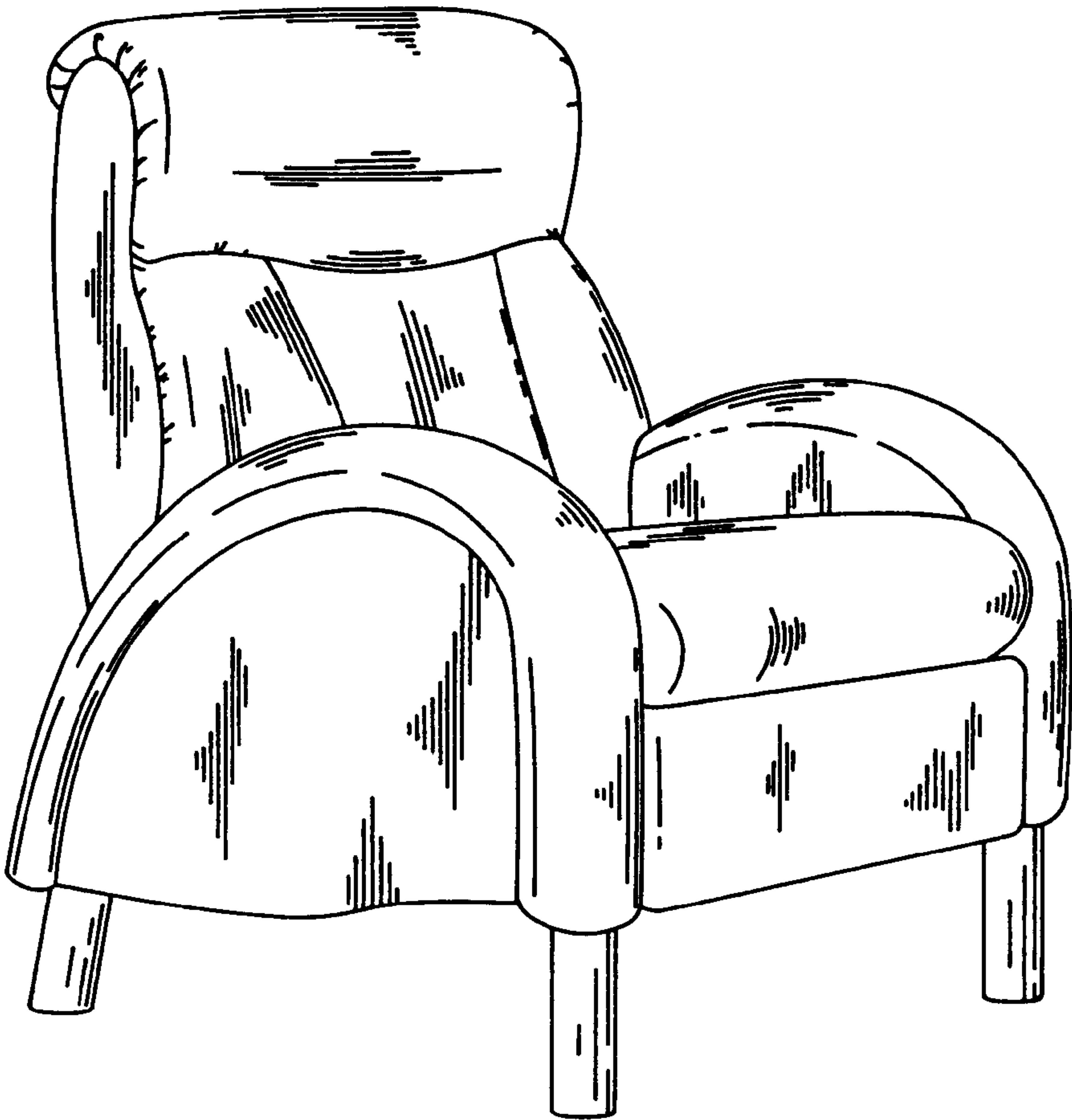

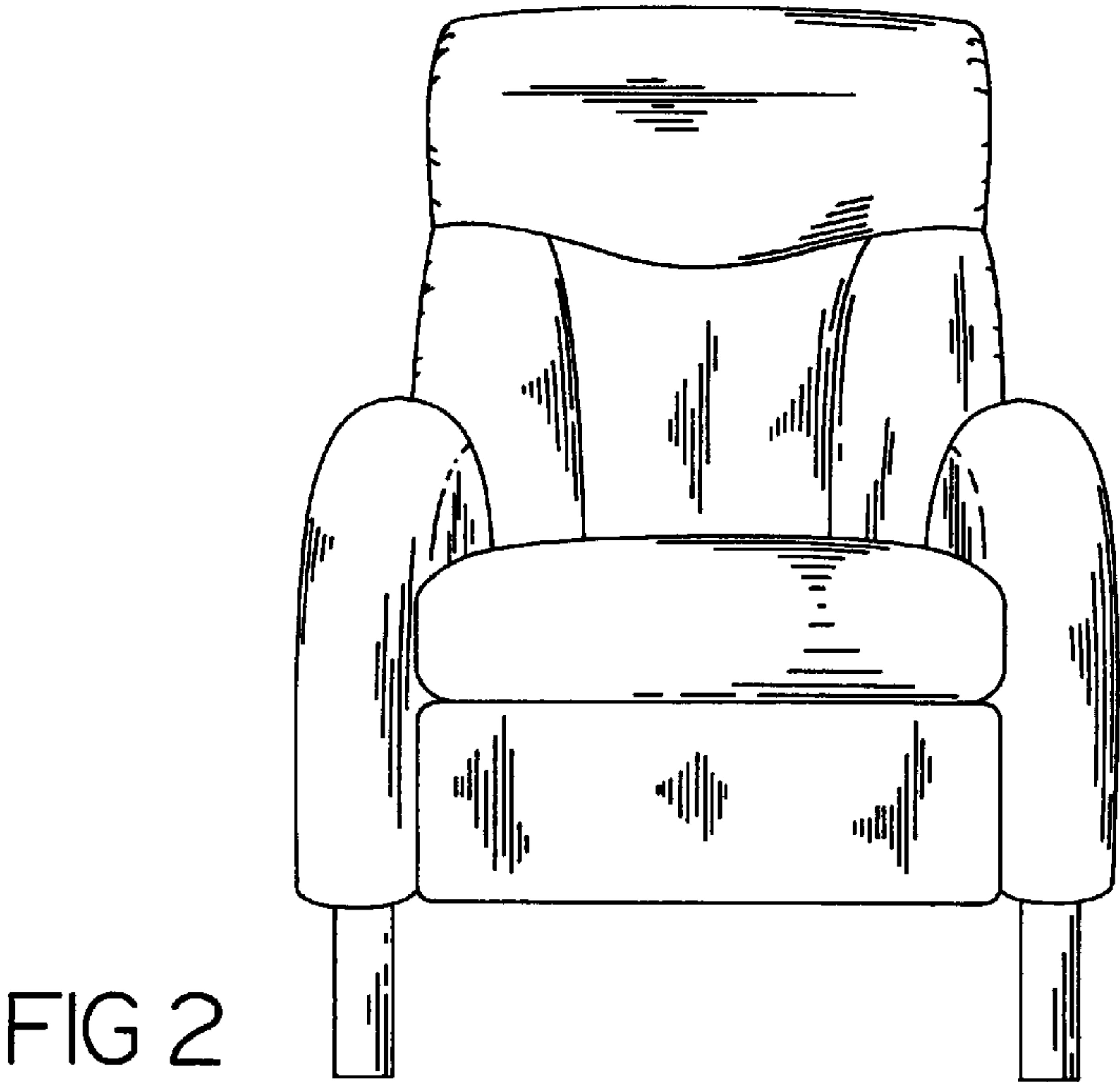
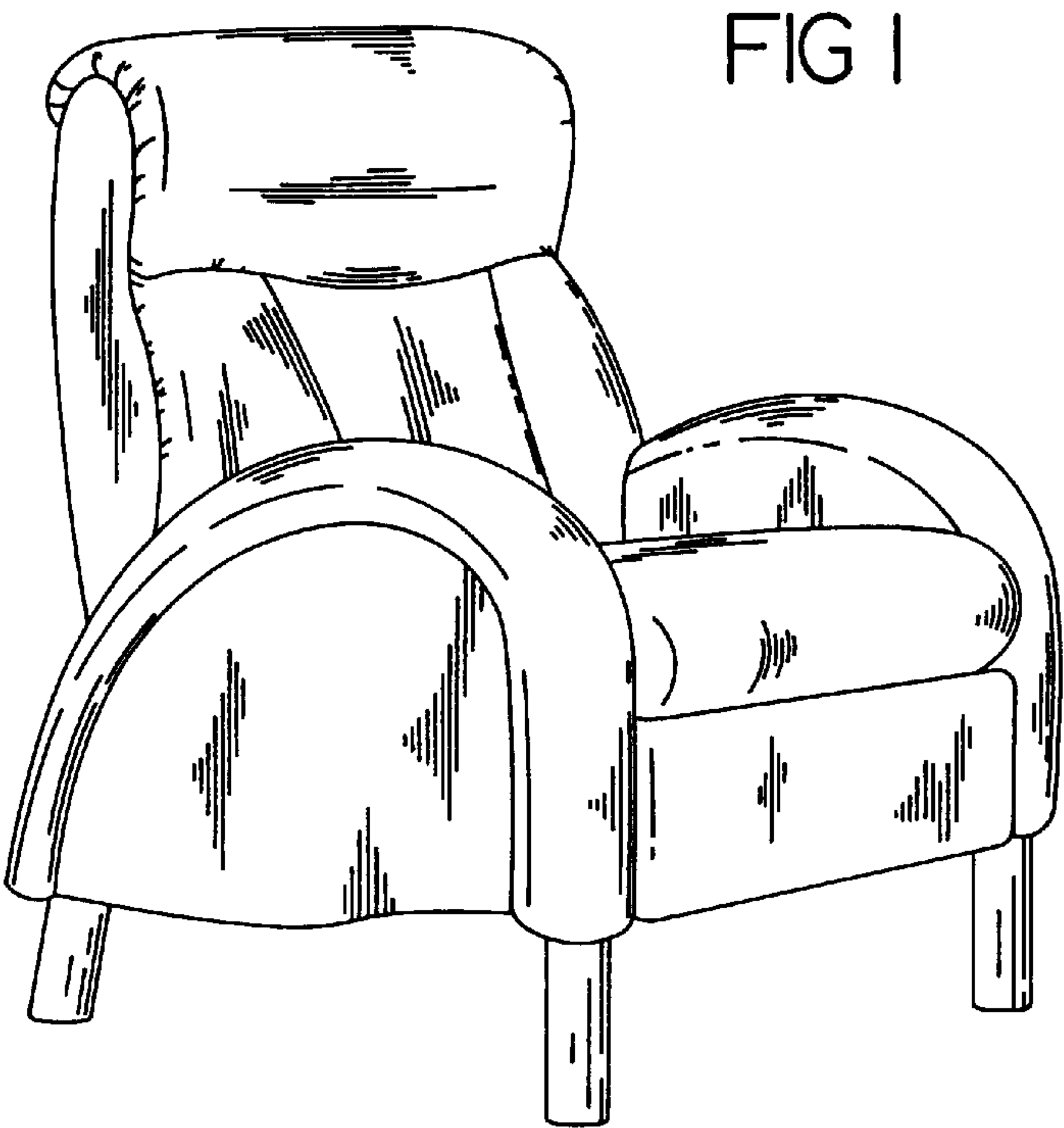
[57] **CLAIM**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a seat according to our new design;

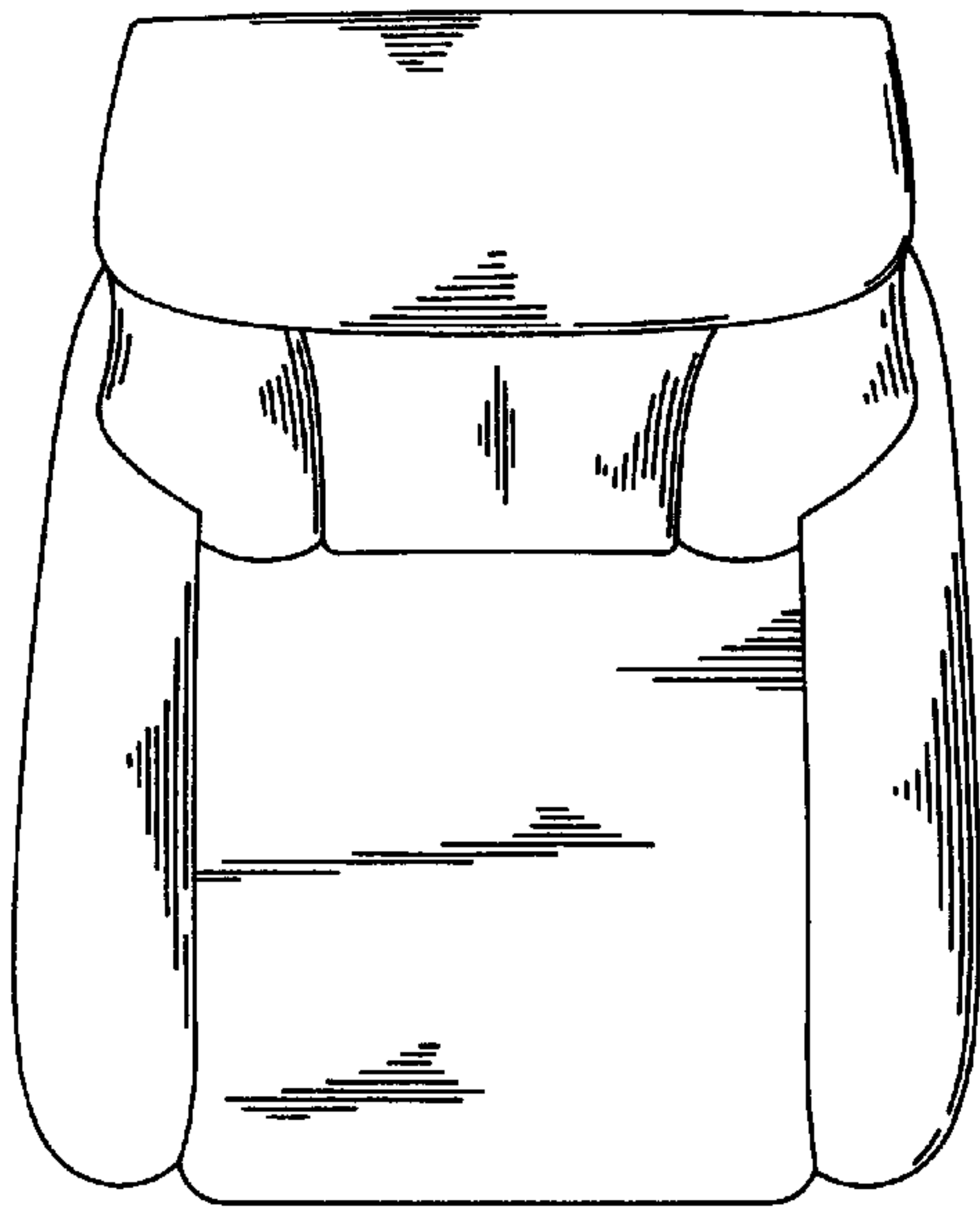

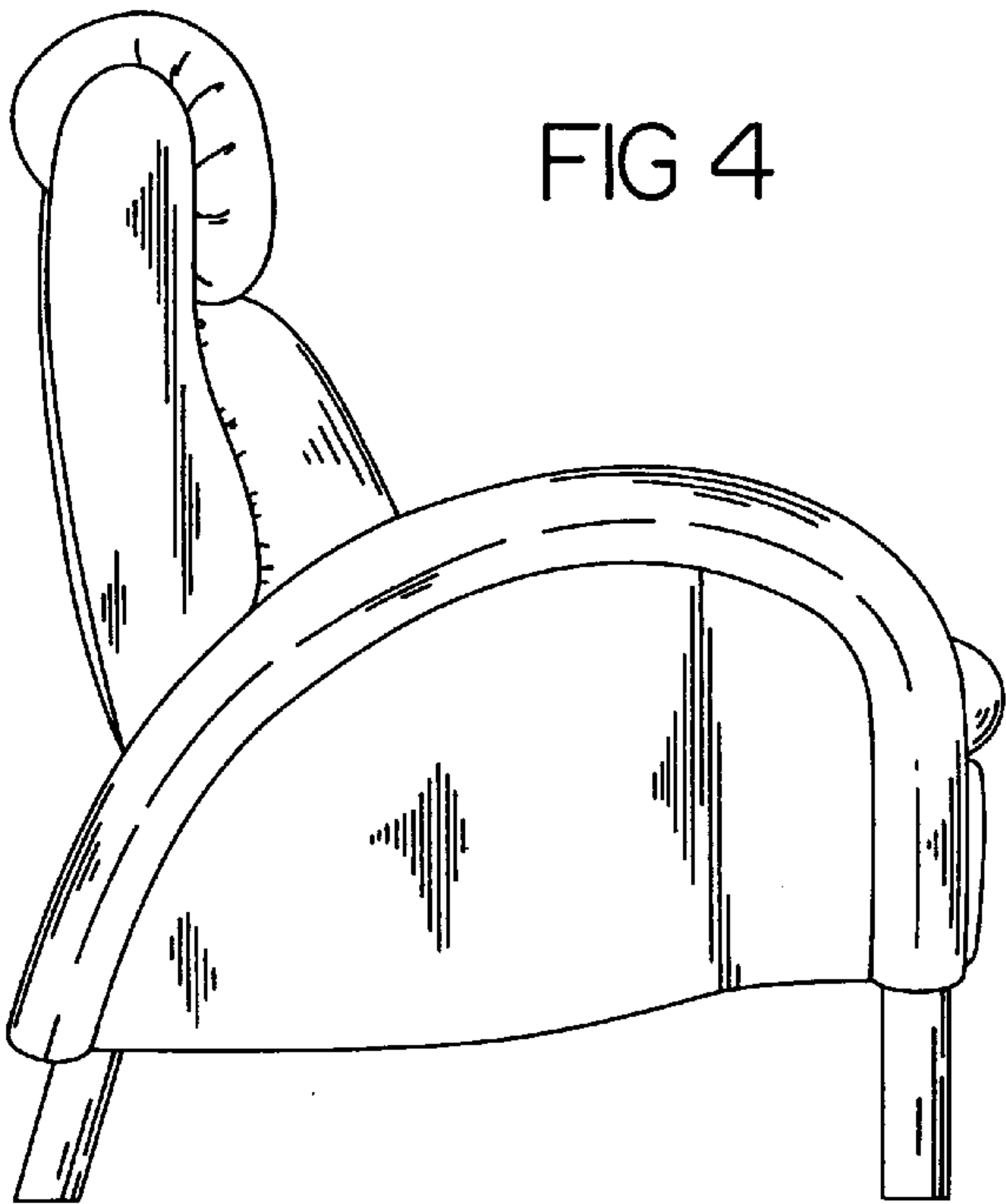

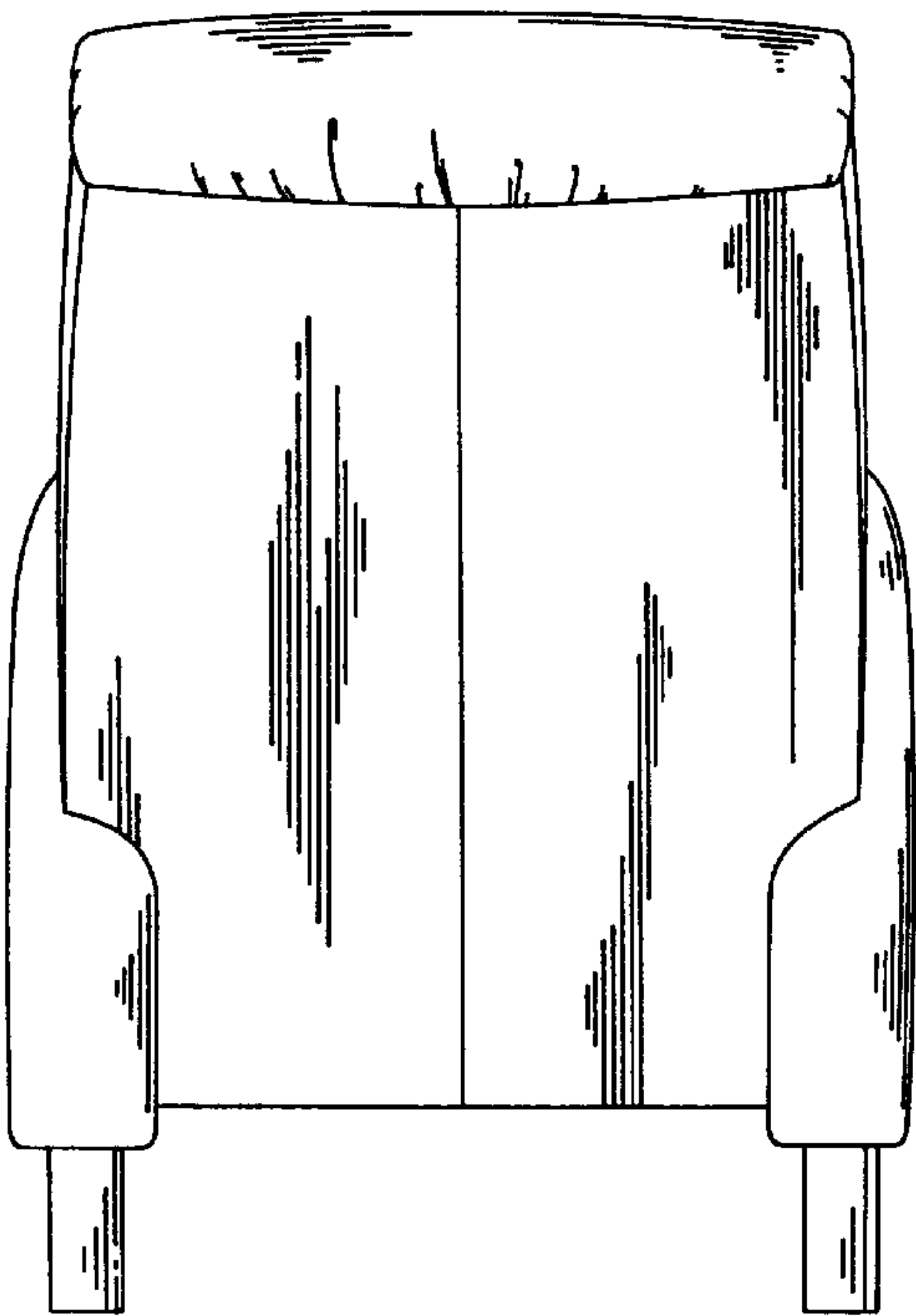
